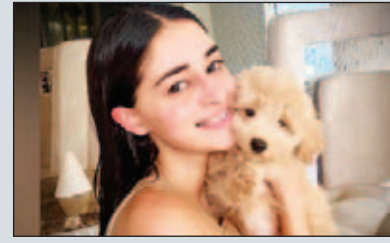

Boiler explosion in Punjab factory, two killed

LUDHIANA: Two labourers were killed after a boiler exploded at a rubber factory here, police said on Thursday. The incident took place in the factory located in an industrial area of Jaspal Bangar village on Wednesday.

The bodies of the deceased have been sent to the Civil Hospital for post-mortem.

AAP launches signature campaign against Kejriwal's arrest

NEW DELHI: The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) on Thursday launched a signature campaign against the arrest of party supremo and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal here.

Two whiteboards were put up in Lajpat Nagar for people to write their messages for Kejriwal, who is currently lodged at Tihar Jail till May 7. He was arrested by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) on March 21 in a money laundering case linked to the now-scrapped Delhi excise policy.

BJP candidate Naveen Jindal files nomination from Kurukshetra

KURUKSHETRA: BJP candidate from Kurukshetra Naveen Jindal filed his nomination papers for the Lok Sabha Elections 2024 in the presence of Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini on Thursday. After filing his nomination, Jindal said, "We will develop all areas. I am getting people's support and love. People have faith in PM Modi's leadership and BJP. The Haryana government has done a lot of developmental work in the last nine and a half years and people have faith in BJP." "We will open Kaushal Vidya Kendra to impart skill training to 10,000 students every year. Further, efforts will be made to tie up with Japan, Australia, Germany, and European countries to provide certified training to them."

Woman shooting video on railway tracks in Haridwar hit by train, dies

HARIDWAR: A 20-year-old, engineering student died after being hit by a train while shooting a video along the tracks at Roorkee here, police said on Thursday. Gangnagar Kotwali police station SHO Govind Ram said the incident occurred Wednesday evening when the victim, Vaishali was standing on the track near the Rahimpur railway gate with a friend.

Congress is dying and Pak is crying, says PM Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi targeted the previous UPA government accusing it of giving "dossiers" to terrorists while alleging a partnership between Congress and Pakistan.

Calling it a "coincidence", the Prime Minister said that the Congress party is weakening in India adding that Pakistan leaders are offering "dua" (prayers) for the party to return to power.

"The weak Congress government used to give dossiers to the masters of terror. But, Modi's strong government kills terrorists on their ground. It is a coincidence, today Congress is getting weaker in India and when here Congress is dying and there Pakistan is crying. Now Pakistani leaders are offering dua for Congress. Pakistan is eager to make 'Shehzaada' the Prime Minister and Congress is already Pakistan's fan. This partnership between Pakistan and Congress has now been completely exposed," PM Modi said while addressing an election rally in Gujarat's Anand on Thursday.

The Prime Minister accused the Congress of lying while calling itself "Mohabbat ka dhukan" (shop of love) and alleged that the latter has become a "factory of fake goods".

"People are asking why the Congress is so agitated. Today Congress has become a fake factory i.e. a factory of fake goods. Why is Congress selling lies by



calling itself Mohabbat ka Dhukan?", he said.

Referring to the UPA rule as 'shaasankal' (reign) and the current NDA rule as 'sevakaal' (service period), PM Modi accused Congress of trying to divide the country.

"These days, the 'shehzaade' of Congress are dancing keeping the Constitution on their heads. But, Congress should answer me why the Constitution, which you are dancing with on your forehead today, was not implemented in all parts of India for 75 years. Today Modi is realising Sardar Saheb's dream of uniting the country. Whereas Congress is busy dividing the country, Congress wants to

create fights in society. Because of Congress, there were various kinds of tamperings with the Constitution of the country for decades," he said.

"The country has seen the rule of Congress for 60 years. Now the country has also seen 10 years of service of BJP. That was the reign, this is the service period," PM Modi added.

The Prime Minister further highlighted the initiatives undertaken during the last years of NDA rule and said, "During 60 years of Congress rule, around 60 per cent of the rural population did not have toilets. In 10 years, the BJP government built 100 per cent toilets.

MEA firmly rejects USCIRF report on religious freedom in India

India on Thursday rejected the report of the US Commission on International Religious Freedom that accused the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) of "reinforcing discriminatory nationalist policies" and said the organisation is completely "biased" and it doesn't even expect from the organization to understand country's diverse, pluralistic and democratic ethos.

"The US Commission on International Religious Freedom (USCIRF) is known as a biased organization with a political agenda. They continue to publish their propaganda on India masquerading as part of an annual report," Ministry of External Affairs official spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said at a press briefing on Thursday.

"We really have no expectation that USCIRF will even seek to understand India's diverse, pluralistic and democratic ethos. Their efforts to interfere in the largest electoral exercise of the world will never succeed," he added.

The United States Commission on International Religious Freedom is a U.S. federal government commission created by the International Religious Freedom Act of 1998. USCIRF Commissioners are appointed by the President and the leadership of both political parties in the Senate and the House of Representatives.

Earlier on Wednesday, the US Commission on International Religious Freedom (USCIRF) which alleged that last year, Indian government failed to address communal

violence disproportionately affecting Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Dalits, Jews, and Adivasis (indigenous peoples).

"In 2023, religious freedom conditions in India continued to deteriorate. The government, led by the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), reinforced discriminatory nationalist policies, perpetuated hateful rhetoric, and failed to address communal violence disproportionately affecting Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Dalits, Jews, and Adivasis (indige-



nopeles). Continued enforcement of the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA), Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA), Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA), and anti-conversion and cow slaughter laws resulted in the arbitrary detention, monitoring, and targeting of religious minorities and those advocating on their behalf," the report said. "Both news media and nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) reporting on religious minorities were subjected to strict monitoring under FCRA regulations."

BJP drops Brij Bhushan amid sexual harassment charge, fields his son

The BJP's heavyweight MP and former wrestling boss Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh won't be contesting the Lok Sabha polls this time. The BJP has instead named his son Karan Bhushan Singh as its candidate from Uttar Pradesh's Kaiserganj. The announcement, made this afternoon, puts a lid on the speculation surrounding the Kaiserganj seat and its high-profile MP. Besides announcing the name of Karan Bhushan Singh, the BJP named Pratap Singh as its candidate from Congress stronghold Rae Bareilly. The Congress is yet to name its pick from the prestige seat, earlier held by Sonia Gandhi.

A six-term MP, Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh suffered a massive political setback due to sexual harassment allegations against him that saw some of the country's top wrestlers hit the streets. The allegations also prompted the BJP to look for another option, as it did not want the row to ruin its poll prospects in the politically-significant state. The party, however, knows the political clout Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh holds in the area. Hence, it has chosen his son as his replacement. Sources in the BJP had earlier told NDTV that the party leadership had spoken to him on the issue and that the heavyweight politician was still insisting on a poll pass.

Manish Sisodia moves Delhi HC for bail in CBI, ED cases on excise policy

Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader and former Deputy chief minister of Delhi Manish Sisodia moved the Delhi High Court on Thursday challenging the trial court order refusing him bail in the excise policy case being investigated by the Directorate of Enforcement (ED) and Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).

Advocates Rajat Bharadwaj and Mohd Irshad mentioned the matter before the bench led by Acting Chief Justice Manmohan and requested for

urgent listing of the matter.

Noting the submissions, the bench said, "Let the concerned judge go through the file if your papers are in order by 12.30 pm today, we will have it tomorrow."

On April 30, the Rouse Avenue Court dismissed the bail petitions of Sisodia for the second time in the case and said, "...This court is not inclined to admit the Applicant to Bail, either regular or interim, at this stage. The application under consideration is accordingly dismissed."

Special Judge Kavari Baweja also said, "It is apparent that the Applicant

Sisodia has been in custody since February 26, 2023, after arrest by the CBI. Thereafter, he was arrested by the ED. Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and BRS Leader K Kavitha were also arrested in the excise policy case.

Noida man arrested for sharing deepfake video of Yogi Adityanath

A man was arrested here by the Special Task Force (STF) of Uttar Pradesh Police for allegedly posting an AI-generated "deepfake" video of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, officials said on Thursday.

The video was used to spread misleading facts, strengthening anti-national elements, Additional Director General of Police (UP STF) Amitabh Yash said.

"On May 1, an AI-generated deepfake video of the Uttar Pradesh chief minister went viral after it was posted on X from a handle. The video was used to spread misleading facts, strengthening anti-national elements," ADGP

Yash said.

He said an FIR under the Indian Penal Code sections 468 (forgery for cheating), 505(2) (statement conducting to public mischief) and under provisions of the Information Technology Act was lodged at the Noida Cyber Crime police station as the Noida unit of the STF started investigating the matter. "On Thursday, accused Shyam Kishor Gupta was arrested and further legal proceedings are being carried out at the local cyber crime police station in Noida," ADGP Yash, who is also the ADG (law and order) for the Uttar Pradesh police, said. He said Shyam Gupta is a resident here and claims to be the president of 'Rehri-Patni' (street vendors) welfare association on his X profile.

Prajwal Revanna not given political clearance for Germany visit: Centre

NEW DELHI: Amid the political row over sex scandal-accused Janata Dal (Secular) MP Prajwal Revanna, the Ministry of External Affairs has said that he travelled to Germany on a diplomatic passport and no political clearance was either sought or given by the ministry. Mr Revanna, who is the grandson of former Prime Minister HD Deve Gowda and nephew of former Karnataka chief minister HD Kumaraswamy, was suspended from the Janata Dal (Secular) over videos in which he can allegedly be seen sexually assaulting multiple women. The Hassan MP had left for Germany on Saturday, a day after voting for the Lok Sabha elections had taken place in the constituency. The videos of the alleged sexual assault had begun circulating online the same day. To a question on whether Mr Revanna was travelling on a diplomatic passport and whether political clearance was given by the ministry, MEA Spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said at the weekly media briefing on Thursday, "No political clearance was either sought from or issued by the MEA in respect of the travel of the said MP to Germany."

From tribal attire to election catwalk: Kangana's Bollywood campaign style heats up HP's political temperature

In the political arena of Lok Sabha, actress Kangana Ranaut is unable to shed her Bollywood charm. It's been nearly a month since her name was officially announced as a candidate, but the way she has been seen in Himachali attire throughout the past year with local leaders, it was a natural feeling that Kangana was going to shine in Himachal. Due to her daring Bollywood style, her demeanor during the campaigns in Himachal is stern, and she is captivating the audience by catwalk on the political stage with her outfits.

The shades of characters from films like Dhaakad, Manikarnika, Queen, and Tejas are clearly visible on her political platform. Her roaring like a lioness from political stages, and the use of sentences and vocabulary against the Congress candidate and the opposition is leaving the people of Himachal Devbhumi astonished.

Her style of attracting crowds in local areas is at least new in Himachal. Wherever she goes, she prepares herself well with the local dress.

In the Mandi parliamentary constituency, there are three tribal assembly seats out of 17 - Lahaul Spiti, Pangri, and Kinnaur. These three seats have traditionally been with the Congress party and particularly the Raja family. It was a new thing for party workers that a political candidate was carrying a team of female makeup and dress assistants with them. There is also a security team and a film direction crew accompanying her. The opposition is taking a jibe at her campaigning in a Bollywood and filmy style. Vikramaditya Singh said, "This is not a film shooting. I will become your devotee if you get Rs 9,000 crore pension for the state from Modi." This is perhaps because Kangana is taking the name of Prime Minister Modi more than local issues in her speeches.

In fact, when Kangana got the ticket, her pictures of attire and modeling were widely circulated on social media. To divert attention from this issue, Kangana wore the Pangri tribal dress in Pangri. When she went to Kinnaur, she adorned the local dress there and went on stage. Similarly, she arrived in Mandi in a suit and saree, and in Rampur, she wore the local Dhatu



and Rezza attires. Rampur is the legacy of former Himachal Chief Minister Virbhadra Singh and his son Vikramaditya, who is now called the son and king of the Rampur Bushahr estate. There, Kangana is using her dress as a shield.

However, sources say that Kangana and her entire team have become a compulsion for BJP in arranging a large num-



ber of rooms for their stay. Many are saying in a muffled voice that the workers and volunteers are party workers, not paid workers.

Vikramaditya has also launched a scathing attack on Kangana, who is known for her daring temperament. Kangana, who seems to be branding Himachali attire, is facing allegations of shooting for politics.

But Kangana is not one to back down. She is challenging the Congress party from the stage. In one meeting, Kangana

directly said that the big and small 'Pappu' of Congress don't understand. From a stage in Mandi, she took a dig at her own party, saying that BJP lost in Himachal by a very small margin due to its own mistakes. Former BJP Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur was also sitting on that stage. Everyone was astonished at this statement. Kangana is calling Vikramaditya a 'Shahzada', while she is being called a political actress.

It is worth noting that Himachal is a very peaceful state, and people here are extremely dignified. On stages, people or leaders remain dignified and speak in a civilized manner. Congress leader Virbhadra Singh, who was the Chief Minister six times, was in the hearts of the people due to his gentle demeanor. Similarly, Jai Ram Thakur, who was the BJP Chief Minister, is known for his extremely affectionate, dignified, and calm behavior among the poor and the public. Be it Chief Minister Sukhu, Shanta, or Prem Kumar Dhumal, they never used harsh, inappropriate, or wrong language on stages or in administrative procedures. This is the first occasion when the cul-

tural arena of politics in the Mandi parliamentary constituency is hampering the dignity of Devbhoomi.

Overall, Kangana's queen persona is fading into her Dhaakad avatar among the public in Mandi, Himachal. However, her victory depends on the senior leaders and workers of the party. That's why as soon as Kangana got the ticket, former BJP Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur reached her house to meet her. In Mandi, Jai Ram and most BJP MLAs are working hard to lead the actress to victory. The fear looms that if she doesn't get the lead, the issue will escalate further. Therefore, the party is supreme.

On the other hand, Vikramaditya is banking on the work and jobs provided by his mother and father in Mandi for four decades. That's why his demeanor is also stern.

In the electoral battleground, the fierce competition is directly linked to the prestige of Jai Ram, Modi, and the Raja family. There is still one month left, and the electoral hues of Mandi, Himachal, will shine brighter.

In view of upcoming Lok Sabha Elections, the first round of randomisation of Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) was held in the presence of political representatives, at the District Administrative Complex, here today. The randomisation was held in the presence of District Election Officer-cum-Deputy Commissioner Aashika Jain and representatives of several political parties.

Deputy Commissioner said that a total of 825 polling booths have been set up in the district on which EVMs as well as VVPAT machines would be installed as per the number of this allocation. She said that EVMs and VVPAT machines equal to the number of polling booths were randomised



today, besides keeping reserved additional 20 percent CU, 20 percent BU and 30 percent VVPAT that can be used in case any machine malfunctions. As per today's randomisation process, 990 BUs, 990 CUs and 1072 VVPATs have been handed over to the AROs of 052-Kharar, 053-SAS Nagar (Mohali) and 112-Derabassi. Kharar has been allocated 334 BUs, 334 CUs and 361 VVPATs against 278 Booths, Mohali has been allocated 301 BUs, 301 CUs, 326 VVPATs against 251 booths while Der-

abassi has been given 355 BUs, 355 CUs and 1072 VVPATs against 296 Booths, added Mrs Jain. She said that after today's randomisation, the EVMs and VVPATs would be shifted by Assistant Returning Officers (AROs) to the strong rooms in their respective constituencies. Randomisation process of EVM and VVPAT machines was shown to the representatives of various political parties and they were also briefed of the next level randomization that would be held at ARO level.

Completion of first phase of online randomization of EVM-VVPAT machines

The first phase of online randomization of EVM-VVPAT machines, which will be used in the Lok Sabha elections and 2 assembly elections in Una district, has been successfully completed. The District Election Officer and Sub-Divisional Magistrate Jatin Lal conducted the process in the presence of representatives of various political parties at the video conference hall of the Deputy Commissioner's office on Thursday. The EVM (Electronic Voting Machine) machines for the Lok Sabha elections were kept at the Up Mohal Bag near the Truck Union, while those for the assembly elections were kept at the Kausal Vikas Kendra Palakwah, and were randomized in the presence

of the District Election Officer and representatives of political parties.

The District Election Officer emphasized that the entire randomization process of EVM and VVPAT machines was carried out online with complete transparency using the Election Commission's software. According to the Election Commission's guidelines, it is mandatory to keep 50 to 60 percent of the EVM and VVPAT machines as reserves so that in case of

any malfunction during voting at polling stations, immediate replacement can be made.

Jatin Lal mentioned that the next randomization will be conducted in the presence of Election Commission observers. The allocated EVM machines will be securely stored in strong rooms at the sub-divisional level. The next process related to EVM machines will be carried out by Sub-Divisional Magistrates at their respective levels.

Sujanpur's Doli polling centre leads in size with 1297 voters

In Hamirpur district, where 532 polling stations have been established for the Lok Sabha elections, the process of filing nomination papers will begin from May 7th to May 14th. The notification for the by-elections in the Badsar and Sujanpur assembly constituencies will also be issued on May 7th, starting the process of filing nomination papers. Voting will take place on June 1st, and the counting of votes will be held on June 4th.

Sujanpur's Doli polling centre with 1297 voters is the largest polling station in Hamirpur district, while Balh Dhatwalia in Badsar will see only 104 voters casting their votes. According to the number of voters, Swahal in Hamirpur has 1296, Chamaraal in Nadaun has 1233, Balyiah in Badsar has 1213, and

Bhalwani in Bhota has 1182 voters who will exercise their franchise. Similarly, based on the number of voters, Nag Lamber in Sujanpur has 106, Buhana in Bhota has 211, Hamirpur Municipal Corporation's Hamirpur-5 has 298, and Basari in Nadaun Vis constituency has 339 polling stations set up for voters.

If the polling party has to walk, then in the Badsar Vis constituency, the polling party will have to trek about 1.5 kilometres off-road to establish a polling station in Kadsai. To reach the Narayah polling station in Nadaun, the polling party will have to walk 800 meters, while reaching Farnohal in Hamirpur will require the polling party to walk half a kilometre. In Bajwala in Bhota, it's 450 meters, and in Nag Lamber in Sujanpur, the polling party will have to walk 300 meters away from the road to reach the polling station.



State govt provides Rs. 4500 crore relief package for disaster-affected without central assistance: Dhiman

Rajesh Dhiman, Minister of Technical Education and Urban Planning, criticized BJP leaders here today, alleging that the BJP's contribution to last year's devastating disaster in Himachal Pradesh was negligible. Dhiman stated that the central government did not provide any relief package under the guise of a special relief package to the disaster-affected people of Himachal Pradesh. He said that the present government, under the leadership of Chief Minister Thakur Sukhvinder Singh, provided a relief package of Rs. 4500 crore from its limited resources, which provided significant

relief to those in difficult times.

He mentioned that the state government had made changes in relief and rehabilitation rules that had been in place for years because the compensation amount under the old rules was very low. With this meagre relief, it was not possible for any disaster-

affected person to rebuild their homes. However, the present state government, adopting a humane approach, increased the compensation amount to an unprecedented Rs. 7 lakh for fully damaged homes.

Partially damaged houses also saw an increase in compensation from 26000 to Rs.1 lakh. Additionally, there was a historic increase in compensation for losses incurred in cowsheds, livestock, and agricultural land. Furthermore, free LPG connections and food supplies were provided to the affected households until March 31, 2024. Cement for rebuilding homes was also made available at government rates. The Minister of

Technical Education emphasized that this relief package, the first of its kind in the state's history, is the most generous package ever provided to disaster-affected people in any situation. He criticized the BJP for only engaging in politics during disasters and not supporting the declaration of the state's disaster as a national disaster. He highlighted that while the Chief Minister repeatedly met with central ministers to obtain special relief packages, the BJP's three MPs never raised the issue in Parliament or with the Prime Minister. He stated that those who have not contributed to the assistance of disaster victims are not entitled to question the state government.

UGC extends applicability of Regulation 2010 for Career Advancement Scheme till 31 Dec 2024



SANJAY AGGARWAL DHARAMSHALA: The University Grants Commission has extended the applicability of UGC Regulation 2010 for Career Advancement Scheme till 31 December 2024. Giving information in this regard, Prof J Singh, President of Akhil Bharatiya Rashtriya Shaikshik Mahasangh, said that now the teachers who complete the eligibility by 31 December 2024, can choose the option of Regulation 2010 for Career Advancement Scheme.

In this regard, the ABRSM has received a formal letter from the University Grants Commission today. It is noteworthy that in UGC Regulation 2018, to get promotion under Career Advancement Scheme, there was an option to choose the 2010 regulation for three years i.e. till July 2021. But it was not possible to complete the mandatory PhD for promotion to the post of Associate Professor and other provisions in the period given for the option in regulation 2018. In this regard, the ABRSM had met the UGC Chairman and Central Education Minister from time to time and presented the teachers' side with facts and arguments and demanded to extend the option period for choosing UGC Regulation 2010 for Career Advancement Scheme till December 2024. Ultimately, UGC has agreed with the facts and arguments presented by ABRSM and taken the expected decision.

Cong govt failed to provide welfare and development in state: Rajiv Bhardwaj

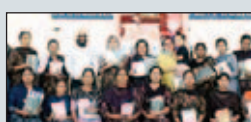

Revanna was booked in an alleged sexual harassment

case on April 28 following complaints by his former housekeeper. The case has been registered under sections 354A, 354D, 506, and 509 of the IPC on charges of sexual harassment, intimidation and outraging the dignity of a woman.

As per the complaint, the victim has claimed that

Prajwal Revanna and his father HD Revanna had sexually assaulted her. Revanna is the grandson of party supremo and former Prime Minister HD Deve Gowda.

"I came to know that notice has been put; I'm ready to face anything; I'm ready to face SIT," HD Revanna, who is also an accused in the case, said earlier.

Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah has written to Prime Minister Modi, requesting him to direct the Ministry of External Affairs and Ministry of Home Affairs to cancel the diplomatic passport issued to Hassan MP Prajwal Revanna and ensure his return to face the law. The JD(S) earlier this week suspended Revanna from the party till the investigation is completed following an uproar over the matter.

Editorial

Northern stamp

Zamaana bade shauk se sun rahaa thaa/ Hum hi so gayen daastan kehte kehte." Few things sum up the attitudes of developing nations towards what constitutes literary merit better than this couplet by Saqib Lakhnavi. "Can the subaltern speak?" Gayatri Chakravorty Spivak had asked in 1988, sparking a post-colonial storm among the world's intellectuals. The question remains, with more to follow: can the subaltern be heard? Can the subaltern even hear itself?

The Sheikh Zayed Book Award recently announced its winners, including, to name a few, Reem Bassiouney's ambitious historical fiction, *Al Halwani: The Fatimid Trilogy*, encompassing the tales of three titanic nation builders from Egyptian history who weren't from Egypt; *The Formation of Post-Classical Philosophy in Islam* by Frank Griffel, which explores the contribution of Islamic philosophy to theology, society and science; and Ahmed Somai's stunning Arabic translation of Giambattista Vico's *The New Science*. Yet the excitement with which this Middle-Eastern award — it received 4,240 submissions from 74 countries — is received can hardly match the fervour with which a Booker or a Pulitzer announcement is greeted.

This isn't unexpected. It is the norm. Take the Sahitya Akademi Award, conferred on writers in multiple Indian languages (including English), won this year by Sanjeev for his socio-political Hindi novel, *Mujhe Pahachaano*, Neelum Saran Gour's *Requiem in Raga Janki*, based on the real-life Hindustani classical singer, Janki Bai Iahabadi, and Sadiqua Nawab Saher's *Rajdev Ki Amrai* in Urdu. Even in India, where these honours are bestowed, the media as well as the average book buyer is more likely to remember and purchase books by Booker winners than those lauded by the Akademi. It's not as if books awarded by the Sheikh Zayed Book Award or the Akademi have to be accepted for their excellence; but even a debate or a discussion on their scholarly or literary merit is notable by its sheer absence.

This is odd especially when you consider that authors from India, or those from the Global South, who get shortlisted or awarded the Pulitzer or the Booker, shoot to prominence instantaneously. Cases in point include Shehan Karunatilaka (*The Seven Moons of Maali Almeida*) and NoViolet Bulawayo (*Glory*). These are undoubtedly fine works. But would they occupy as much of the popular and global literary discourse as they do without the stamp of the Booker? Do awardees of prizes from the Global South itself, such as the Wole Soyinka Prize for Literature in Africa won by Sifiso Mzobe (*Young Blood*).

Protests sweep US universities amid Israel-Gaza conflict

Demonstrations reverberated across US university campuses in the United States as tensions surrounding Israel's military actions in Gaza intensified. The night was marked by widespread arrests in New York and a disturbing attack by counter-protesters in California, Al Jazeera reported.

In New York City, the NYPD reported as many as 282 arrests at Columbia University and the City College of New York, spanning from Tuesday night into Wednesday morning. This crackdown unfolded as law enforcement cleared students who had occupied Columbia University's Hamilton Hall since April 30.

Hamilton Hall, previously synonymous with activism during South Africa's struggle against apartheid, gained a new moniker: "Hind's Hall," in memory of six-year-old Hind Rajab, tragically killed with her family by Israeli forces in Gaza.

Meghnad Bose, a student journalist at Columbia University, recounted witnessing the police intervention firsthand. "I saw firsthand how the police dispersed those protests, arrested them and sometimes got pretty aggressive in making sure the protesters went away," he said, according to Al Jazeera.

Kaz Daughtry, the NYPD's deputy commissioner of operations, in a post on X, highlighted Columbia University's request for police assistance in reclaiming their campus. He said the police were "dispersing the unlawful encampment and persons barricaded inside of university buildings and restoring order".

Meanwhile, at the University of California Los Angeles (UCLA), tensions escalated as pro-Israel counter-protesters clashed



with pro-Palestine demonstrators. Witnesses reported attempts by the assailants to dismantle the pro-Palestine encampment, resorting to violence by hurling objects and wielding sticks.

Sergio Olmos, an investigative journalist reporting from UCLA, observed the chaotic scene as counter-protesters engaged in aggressive behaviour. He detailed their efforts to dismantle the pro-Palestine encampment, including throwing glass bottles and wielding sticks.

The Los Angeles Police Department responded to the escalating violence at UCLA at the university's request, addressing multiple incidents of aggression within the en-

campment.

Despite the turmoil, the pro-Palestine encampment at UCLA persisted, with student protesters holding their ground against the attacks. Rob Reynolds, reporting from Los Angeles, highlighted the resilience of the demonstrators amid adversity.

The surge in protests across US campuses stemmed from heightened tensions following Hamas' attack on southern Israel on October 7 and the prolonged Israeli military campaign in Gaza, resulting in staggering Palestinian casualties, as reported by Al Jazeera. The recent wave of demonstrations gained momentum nearly two weeks prior,

sparked by Columbia University President Minouche Shafik's contentious testimony before a US congressional committee. Critics accused Shafik of prioritizing lawmakers' interests over those of the university's students.

Amid an array of demands, protesters called for divestment from Israel and companies associated with the conflict. They denounced administrators for allegedly exploiting public safety concerns and weaponising accusations of anti-Semitism to suppress dissent.

The wave of arrests extended beyond New York, with 14 protesters detained at Tulane University in New Orleans, alongside arrests at the University of South Florida and the University of Wisconsin, Madison.

The protests garnered international attention, with Francesca Albanese, the UN special rapporteur on the occupied Palestinian territory, condemning the violent police response at US universities. She decried the actions as reflective of a dystopian reality and called for an end to the ongoing genocide. In Los Angeles, Mayor Karen Bass condemned the violence at UCLA as abhorrent and inexcusable. New York City Mayor Eric Adams defended the police crackdown, attributing the protests at Columbia University to individuals unaffiliated with the institution.

Jewish Voice for Peace (JVP) criticised both the NYPD and Columbia University for their handling of the situation. Stefanie Fox, the group's executive director, drew parallels between the university's current actions and its past oppression of student activism during the Vietnam War and South African apartheid era, Al Jazeera reported.

Turkey joining South Africa's genocide lawsuit against Israel



Turkey announced it is joining South Africa's genocide lawsuit against Israel in the International Court of Justice on Wednesday.

"Our legal experts have been studying how to participate in the legal case against Israel at the ICJ," said Turkish Foreign Minister Hakan Fidan as he announced the move. Fidan said an application will soon be filed with the ICJ. During the mid-January hearings, South Africa argued to the judges in the Hague that Israel's military campaign was intended to cause "the destruction of the population" of the Gaza Strip. Israeli representatives, led by former Supreme Court president Aharon Barak, rejected the claims, arguing that Israel has a right to defend itself, respects international law, and that Palestinian casualties were the result of Hamas embedding its tunnels and military infrastructure in civilian areas. Israel, which is not

a member of the ICJ, also argued that the court has no jurisdiction and asked the court to reject the case outright. In a provisional ruling issued on January 26, the ICJ ordered Israel by a vote of 15-2 to "take all measures" to prevent "genocide" in Gaza, but did not order the implementation of a ceasefire. Legal experts said it could take years for a final ruling on whether Israel is committing genocide against the Palestinians. However, a ruling on the genocide claim, while legally binding, would be difficult to enforce.

Meanwhile, Israeli leaders are bracing for the possibility that the International Criminal Court's chief prosecutor, Karim Khan, may soon issue warrants for the arrest of senior Israeli officials for war crimes, including Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, Defense Minister Yoav Gallant, and Chief of the Israel Defense Forces Lt-Gen. Herzi Halevi.

UK begins detention of asylum seekers for deportation to Rwanda



British authorities have commenced the detention of asylum seekers as part of the new initiative aimed at deporting them to Rwanda, with initial flights slated for departure as early as July, the government announced, Al Jazeera reported.

Home Secretary James Cleverly remarked, "Our dedicated enforcement teams are working at pace to swiftly detain those who have no right to be here so we can get flights off the ground." Confirmation of the detention procedures follows the recent enactment of legislation designating Rwanda as a safe third country, circumventing a prior UK Supreme Court ruling that deemed the scheme unlawful on human rights grounds. Prime Minister Rishi Sunak, emphasising his pledge to curb migrant arrivals via small boats from mainland Europe, underscored that detentions would occur

promptly ahead of deportation flights scheduled to commence within "10 to 12 weeks."

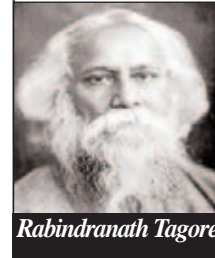
Describing it as "another major milestone" in the Rwanda deportation plan, the UK's Home Office disseminated visual documentation showcasing immigration enforcement officers detaining individuals with handcuffs at various locations, as reported by Al Jazeera. Reacting to the developments, the charity Freedom from Torture condemned the government's actions, asserting, "This government has lost its last ounce of humanity." A senior minister disclosed that the government anticipates deporting 5,700 individuals this year, following Rwanda's "in principle" agreement to accept that number. However, authorities have lost contact with thousands of potential deportees, with only 2,143 currently located for detention, leaving over 3,500 unaccounted for.

Taiwan preparing for possible increase in Chinese military drills

Taiwan is preparing for a possible increase in Chinese military drills as Taiwan's President-elect Lai Ching-te assumes office. Concerns have increased over potential military exercises by China around Taiwan after Lai Ching-te takes oath on May 20, Taiwan News reported.

In response, Taiwan's National Security Bureau (NSB) Director-General Tsai Ming-yeon on Wednesday said the bureau is taking measures to boost national critical infrastructure.

Following a session of the Legislative Yuan, Tsai Ming-yeon said June to November is the season for the People's Liberation Army (PLA) routine military exercises. He said that the period after Lai Ching-te is sworn in as Taiwan's President will be the "hot season" for the PLA's military exercises.

Tsai said, "Whether the CCP will use this (inauguration) as an excuse to conduct military exercises to impose further pressure on



Taiwan is something our National Security Bureau is currently focusing on," according to Taiwan News report.

Asked how NSB plans to bolster national critical infrastructure, he said Taiwan will use dual backup systems and patrol mechanisms, Taiwan News reported.

Earlier today, Taiwan's Ministry of National Defence (MND) said it detected 4 PLA aircraft and 4 PLAN vessels operating around Taiwan. 4 of the aircraft crossed the median line of the Taiwan Strait and entered Taiwan's northern and SW ADIZ. The Ministry of Defence said that the ROC Armed Forces have monitored the situation and responded accordingly.

On May 1, Taiwan's MND reported that 7 PLAN vessels operating around Taiwan were detected up until 6 a.m. ROC Armed Forces monitored the situation and responded accordingly. According to Taiwan's Defence

Ministry, no PLA aircraft had crossed the median line or entered the southwestern air defence identification zone (ADIZ). Following China's activity, Taiwan deployed intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance systems and dispatched naval vessels, and deployed land-based air defence missile systems to monitor the situation.

In April, Taiwan's MND detected Chinese military aircraft 247 times and naval vessels 176 times. Since September 2020, China has intensified the use of "gray zone tactics" by deploying military aircraft and naval vessels over the median line and inside Taiwan's ADIZ, according to Taiwan News report.

According to CSIS, gray zone tactics are defined as "an effort or series of efforts beyond steady-state deterrence and assurance that attempts to achieve one's security objectives without resorting to direct and sizable use of force."

Fortis Scripts History: 16.7kg Tumor Removed in Record Surgery

GURUGRAM: In an extraordinary display of medical expertise and teamwork, Fortis Memorial Research Institute, Gurugram, has achieved a significant milestone by successfully removing a massive 16.7 kg, 58x50 cms non-cancerous tumor from the back of a 27-year-old man. The patient, who hails from the Pacific Islands, had been living with the tumor since 2008. huge tumor from his back, which was hanging like a gunny bag, with the help of multipronged approach. He had visited several hospitals in different countries for treatment but was denied surgery due to the high risk associated with the tumor's size and complexity. After complete evaluation at Fortis Gurugram, the preparatory phase included two procedures to block 11 significant blood vessels to mitigate the risk of excessive bleeding during the tumor removal. The tumor had multiple large arterial and venous

channels, covering the entire back of the patient, and exposing approximately 18% of the body surface as a raw area. Covering this area post-surgery posed a significant challenge. Utilising healthy skin from both thighs for a skin graft would result in an additional raw area, increasing the total exposed surface to about 35-36%. To avoid this, surgeons opted to harvest the graft from the tumor itself, as it was non-cancerous. This innovative approach allowed for the successful coverage of the patient's entire back using the tumor-derived skin graft.

But the Shreyas Iyer-led side will have to find consistency across departments and avoid any slip-ups in order to make it to the final four.

Each of their three losses have come in the last six games for KKR, who



were at the receiving end of a record run chase by Punjab Kings but did well to bounce back with a seven-wicket thrashing of Delhi Capitals.

With the bat, KKR's requisite firepower in the

ranked entwined with an ultra-aggressive approach has delivered the goods more often than not but it is their bowling which needs improvement.

Mitchell Starc has given nearly 12 runs an over while managing a mere

seven wickets in eight outings. On flat, batting-friendly pitches, the lanky Australian's lack of control has also been exploited well by zealous batters.

Harshit Rana is among those with most wickets (11) for KKR this season but the

right-arm seamer will serve a one-match ban for his animated celebrations after dismissing DC's Abhishek Dorel.

Vaibhav Arora's nine scalps in five games make him KKR's best bet with the ball. A small Wankhede Stadium with a batting-friendly wicket tends to encourage scores in excess of 200 and the team would be mindful of that.

Spotlight will also be on Rinku Singh, whose exclusion from India's main squad for the T20 World Cup, has triggered an outpouring of sympathy for the 26-year-old. The power-hitter has not got enough game time this season which probably tilted the scales against him.

For Mumbai Indians, the race to the IPL playoffs seems lost even though the

five-time winners have five more games to play.

Even if Mumbai Indians win each of these, they can only get to 16 points and somewhere in the middle of the points table — not necessarily challenging those who have been consistently good.

Jasprit Bumrah (14 wickets) and Gerald Coetzee (13) have been MI's best bets with the ball but despite their impressive showing, the batters' collective failure has resulted in the team's underwhelming season.

Tilak Varma has been MI's best batter with 343 runs, including three fifties this IPL, but his performances have not been enough to hide the failings of others.

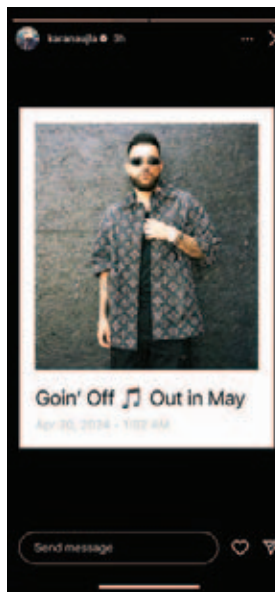

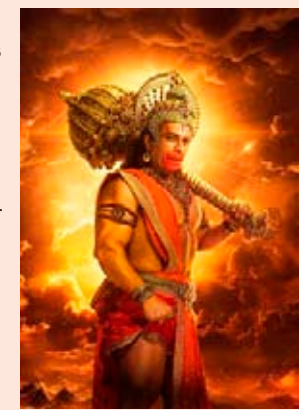
Angoori aur Anita hui arrest!
