## CEO issues SOPs for last 72 hrs before Punjab poll day

Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) Dr S Karuna Raju on Wednesday issued Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for the last 72 hours before Poll Day in Punjab. Giving details, Dr Raju said that instructions have been issued to all the District Election Officers-cum-Deputy Commissioners that they should make necessary arrangements for third randomisation of polling personnel, Certificate of formation of polling party, accommodation and food for polling parties and deployment of micro-observers, Video Cameras, Still Cameras, Webcasting at polling stations. He also asked them to ensure training to polling personnel, sector officers, EVM management, besides strengthening All Election Expenditure Monitoring team like flying squad teams (FSTs), static surveillance teams (SST), video surveillance teams (VSTs), video viewing team (VVTs), Excise Monitoring Team (EMC), MCMC, DCMC, Accounting Team and 24x7 district EEM Team, Control room during the last 72 hours. The CEO also asked them to intensify monitoring and surveillance by the Flying Squads (FS) and Static Surveillance Teams (SSTs), Assistance from Booth Level awareness group, area of special focus for Expenditure Monitoring, Implementation of Model Code of Conduct for Political Parties and Candidates besides directing them for vehicle permission and ensuring Assured Minimum Facilities at all the Polling Stations.

## Russia makes moves to ease Ukraine tensions

Russia made two overtures to ease tensions around Ukraine reporting a pullback of troops near its neighbour and welcoming talks with the West. But the United States and its allies said they needed evidence of the troop movements and that the threat of a Russian invasion still loomed.

For the second day Tuesday, there were signs of hope that Europe might avoid war following weeks of escalating East-West tensions as Moscow massed around 150,000 troops on three sides of Ukraine and held massive military drills. Those moves led to dire warnings from Washington, London and other European capitals that Russia was preparing to roll into Ukraine.

But the tenor changed this week. President Vladimir Putin said Tuesday



that Russia does not want war and would rely on negotiations in its efforts to eliminate any chance that Ukraine could one day join NATO his key demand in the crisis. At the same time, he did not commit to a full pullback, saying Russia's next moves in the standoff will depend on how the situation evolves.

Russia also offered few details of the pullback, and President Joe Biden said American officials had not verified Russia's claim. He promised that the U.S. would give diplomacy every chance, but he struck a skeptical tone about Moscow's intentions.

## 'Will manufacture Brahmos in Lucknow': Rajnath

LUCKNOW/KANPUR (UP) : Defence Minister Rajnath Singh on Wednesday attacked Samajwadi Party, saying "kattas (locally-made pistols) were commonly made during its government, but under BJP they will be replaced by Brahmos missiles.

Addressing election rallies in Malihabad (Lucknow) and Babupurva (Kanpur), the union minister said such a missile is now going to be made in Lucknow, as can be fired at the enemy from 400-600 kms away.

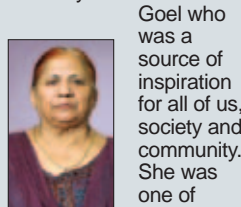
Praising Jai Devi, the BJP candidate from Malihabad seat, and her husband Union Minister Kaushal Kishor, the Minister said Lucknow will see manufacture of big guns ("goli nahi gola")now.

It is the character of BJP that we do what we say. We had said that Article 370 will be abolished, and when we got a majority in Parliament, it was done, he said.

In Kanpur, Singh attacked the SP saying that socialism has not touched it in any way. "A socialist is one who can provide solutions for hunger and fear of the common people. There is only one person who is doing such work in politics and that is our Prime Minister Narendra Modi. He is a socialist in the true sense and is doing socialism," he said. "BJP has done what it said. Whatever has been put in the party's election manifesto, we have done it.

## Lakhs of devotees take holy dip in Ganga in Prayagraj

PRAYAGRAJ: Amid the coronavirus pandemic, lakhs of devotees took the holy dip in the Ganga river here on the auspicious occasion of Magh Purnima on Wednesday. District's Senior Superintendent of Police Ajay Kumar said that elaborate security arrangements have been made for the Magh Purnima and more than 150 CCTV cameras have also been installed. An official of Prayagraj Mela Authority said that since morning, around seven lakh people, including children, elderly and women, have taken the holy dip in the Ganga and Sangam. People are likely to take bath in the Ganges till late evening, he added. The crowd is being monitored from the Integrated Command Control Center, the SSP said. Several fire fighters and 108 divers have also been deployed to deal with any mishap, he added.

## I-T dept searches Chinese telecom major Huawei

NEW DELHI: The Income-tax department has conducted searches at multiple premises of Chinese telecom company Huawei in the country as part of a tax evasion investigation, official sources said on Wednesday. The raids were launched at the company's premises in Delhi, Gurugram (Haryana) and Bengaluru in Karnataka on Tuesday. Sources said the officials looked at financial documents, account books and company records as part of a tax evasion investigation against the company, its Indian businesses and overseas transactions. Some records have been seized too, they said. The company said its operations in the country were "firmly compliant" with the law.

## Disco King Bappi Lahiri passes away

Music composer and singer Bappi Lahiri, who popularised disco music in India, has passed away at the age of 69. Paying tribute to the Disco King, filmmaker Hansal Mehta tweeted: "Another legend gone. BappiLahiri. Had the good fortune of working closely with him when I shot an ad for p&g and then when I worked with White Feather Films for Sanjay Gupta. Man of incredible melody and talent." Ashoke Pandit said, "Shocked to hear about the demise of rockstar Bappi Lahiri ji. Can't believe my next door neighbour is no



more . Your music will always remain in our hearts . Om Shanti!" "Bappi Da was so endearing in person. But, his music had an edge. He introduced a more contemporary style to Hindi film music

with Chalte Chalte, Suraksha and Disco Dancer. Om Shanti Dada. You will be missed," actor Ajay Devgn tweeted. Lahiri was discharged on Monday after being in hospital for a month. However, he was again admitted to the hospital on Tuesday after his health deteriorated. Bappi Lahiri was suffering from multiple health issues. He died due to OSA (obstructive sleep apnea) shortly before midnight," doctors treating him said on Wednesday. He is survived by his son Bappa and daughter Rema. He was also hospitalised last year after he tested positive for coronavirus.

# Sports injury awareness camp held at Virk Hospital

A sports injury awareness camp was organised at Virk Hospital today in which Dr. Amanpreet Singh and Dr. Balbir Singh Virk apprised the players about the prevention and treatment of knee and shoulder injuries. During the camp, 50 per cent discount was announced on the treatment of players from poor and middle class. Wrestlers of Ram Veemshala participated in this seminar. Dr. Amanpreet explained in detail the injuries suffered by the players. In addition to these



ligaments, there are cushion-like structures inside the knee joint. Those are called the inner and outer meniscus. There are four bones around the knee joint.

Thigh bone (femur), main leg bone (tibia), outer leg bone (fibula) and knee cap (patella). The movement of the knee joint mainly occurs between the femur and the tibia. Articular cartilage (a shiny smooth surface) covers the ends of the tibia and femur, and the posterior surface of the patella. Injuries to the knee ligaments or meniscus are common sports injuries, although they can also occur during road traffic accidents. It is a common occurrence during sports to put heavy stress on a bent or straight knee that can injure the knee ligament.

The Indian Council of Medical Research, Department of Health Research, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India on Wednesday issued a fresh advisory on Purposive Testing Strategy for Covid-19 in India. These are for early detection of symptomatic cases for quick isolation and early detection of infections in elderly (>60yr) and individuals with comorbidities like diabetes, hypertension, chronic lung or kidney disease, malignancy, obesity etc so that timely care can be provided. A Government spokesperson said last night that in a community testing may be done in individuals with symptoms and those having comorbidities with a history of



contact with laboratory confirmed Covid positive cases. He added that individuals travelling abroad or international travelers arriving at Indian airports/seaports/ports of entries may be tested for Covid virus as per the guidelines laid down. The spokesperson

said that in hospital settings, the testing may be undertaken as per the decision of the doctor. He further said that no emergency procedure should be delayed due to lack of tests and patients should not be referred to other facilities for lack of a testing facility. He said that all

Still, there will be this problem and if there are shortcomings, then the shortcomings will be removed and if there is any negligence then action will be taken.

Equal embrace

Even as the world's focus remains riveted on the escalating tensions between the United States of America and Russia over Ukraine, Washington unveiled a new strategy for the Indo-Pacific region last week that will draw New Delhi's attention. The first such document issued by the administration of President Joe Biden, the strategy places India at the centre of Washington's efforts to contain China's rise. A fact-sheet on the new approach, released by the White House, lists "supporting India's continued rise and regional leadership" as a key ingredient. This should be welcomed — with a dose of caution. No diplomatic relationship today matters more to India than its ties with the US, one of its biggest trade partners and a key source of military and high-tech equipment. The world's two largest democracies share concerns about Beijing's growing belligerence, especially in its neighbourhood. They are working with other major nations, through military exercises and diplomatic fora like the Quad which also includes Japan and Australia, to offer an alternative to China's model for smaller countries in the region.

Yet, India must remember that the best embraces are those that are not so tight that they become suffocating. Events over the past few years have repeatedly underscored how traditional alliances have weakened. European allies like France and Germany clearly do not see eye to eye with the US on relations with Russia. And the US blindsided France by quietly killing a deal Paris had struck with Canberra to supply submarines, offering its own alternatives instead. Meanwhile, Russia — for decades among India's most steadfast partners — now counts China as its most valuable friend. Russia is also flirting with Pakistan. Given this background, it was refreshing to see India's external affairs minister, S. Jaishankar, deftly juggling New Delhi's interests at a meeting of the Quad's foreign ministers recently. He joined his counterparts from the US, Japan and Australia in criticizing China without naming the country, but calmly sidestepped questions on Russia. It is clear that India was also instrumental in ensuring that the Quad's statement after that meeting did not criticize Russia. That balancing act is not easy, but few countries know how to do it as well as India does. Today, non-alignment is often treated as an outdated relic of a by-gone era. Mr Jaishankar prefers to describe India's strategy as 'multi-alignment'. Whatever it is called, New Delhi must keep its options open. True friends will understand.

# Myanmar's resistance group attacks China-backed facility

A local resistance group attacked Myanmar's military forces guarding the China-backed oil and gas pipelines in Natogyi town in Mandalay Region in Myanmar on Monday, damaging the facility.

The Natogyi-People's Defense Force (NPDPF), the resistance group, said it had no choice but to strike regime soldiers stationed at the off-take point since they had a history of persecuting and looting residents during operations in the region.

The anti-Chinese sentiment is on the rise in Myanmar following the military coup in February, with many in the country believing Beijing to have been involved in the military takeover of the power. There were demands for a boycott of the Chinese goods at the time as well as threats to blow up pipelines if China failed to denounce the military regime.

Myanmar's Military regime arrested nearly a dozen people in the town on Monday and Tuesday, including some with links to the National League for Democracy (NLD), a Natogyi resident told The Irrawaddy on Tuesday.

The NPDPF used two rifle grenades to attack 13 regime personnel providing security for the off-take station. Ko Twantay, a NPDPF spokesperson and Myingyan District-PDF Battalion 4 commander, said, the wall of the off-take station was damaged after being hit by an explosive during the attack. "We just targeted the regime forces, not the pipeline station," Ko Twantay told The Irrawaddy on Tues-



day, reported the news portal. Notably, the oil and gas pipelines, which run from the Rakhine coast to southern China, were constructed in 2011 and began operation in July 2013. The 973-km pipelines pass through Magwe and Mandalay regions and Shan State to China's Yunnan Province.

Myanmar's military regime has been on alert after the attack and has tightened security in Natogyi town, bringing in reinforcements from nearby townships. China has encouraged Myanmar's civilian National Unity

Government to ensure that the country's opposition movement does not jeopardise the Chinese interests.

The Chinese request came after a local opposition group in Sagaing's Tigyaing Township destroyed electricity pylons supporting the China-backed Tagaung Taung nickel-processing factory in early January, reported the news portal.

Myanmar's military junta had earlier designated the National Unity Government as a terrorist group. The National Unity Government was set

up by elected legislators who were barred from taking their seats when the military seized power and detained civilian leaders, including Nobel laureate Aung San Suu Kyi.

The country is in turmoil since the coup on February 1, when the Myanmar military led by Senior General Ming Aung Hlaing overthrew the civilian government and declared a year-long state of emergency. The coup triggered mass protests and was met by deadly violence throughout the country.

### Pakistan witnessing resurgence of terrorism after Taliban's takeover

Recent attacks in which many killed Pakistani soldiers were killed suggest that there is a surge of terror activity in the country since the Taliban took over Kabul, last year.

An Islamabad-based think tank, the Pakistan Institute for Peace Studies, recently published a report endorsing the fear that Pakistan has been slowly sliding into chaos and instability for the last couple of years, reported Diplomat, an international magazine. In January alone, several terrorist incidents rocked Pakistan as major cities including Islamabad and Lahore were targeted. On January 25, in an attack in Kech, Balochistan over 10 Pakistani military personnel were killed. Just over a week later, on February 2, the Noshki and Panjgur districts of the same province saw the killing of seven military personnel, including an officer. Balochistan Liberation Army, a separatist group in Balochistan, claimed the responsibility for the attack. They claimed to have killed "more than 100 enemy personnel" in Noshki and Panjgur. In another terrorist attack, unidentified motor-



cyclists shot a Christian priest and injured his companion in Peshawar. Police suspect the Islamic State (IS) to be behind the attack.

These attacks were mostly carried out by banned outfits including the Tehrik-i-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) and the Baloch Liberation Army (BLA), reported the magazine.

Interior Minister Sheikh Rasheed Ahmad during his appearance on a TV talk show said, "I think that TTP, Daesh [the local name for IS] and other separatist groups are carrying out these activities in collaboration."

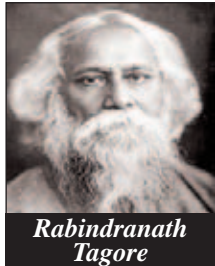

## Heart attack survivors less likely to develop Parkinson's disease, says study

Does heart attack have a connection to Parkinson's disease? According to new research, people who have had a heart attack may be slightly less likely than people in the general population to develop Parkinson's disease later in life. The study was published in the 'Journal of the American Heart Association', an open access, peer-reviewed journal of the American Heart Association. Parkinson's disease is a brain disorder characterized by progressive loss of physical movement, including tremors, slow or slurred speech, and/or stiffness or limited range of motion for walking and other physical activities. There is no cure for Parkinson's disease, and it is also associated with behavioural changes, depression, memory loss and fatigue. Secondary Parkinsonism, which has symptoms similar to Parkinson's disease, may be caused by stroke, psychiatric or cardiovascular medications, or other illnesses. "We have previously found that following a heart attack, the risk of neurovascular complications such as ischemic stroke [clot-caused stroke] or vascular dementia is markedly increased, so the finding of a lower risk of Parkinson's disease was somewhat surprising," said lead study author Jens Sundboll, M.D., PhD, from the departments of clinical epidemiology and cardiology at the Aarhus University Hospital in Aarhus, Denmark. "These findings indicate that the risk of Parkinson's

disease is at least not increased following a heart attack and should not be a worry for patients or a preventive focus for clinicians at follow-up." "It is not known whether this inverse relationship with risk of Parkinson's disease extends to people who have had a heart attack. Therefore, we examined the long-term risk of Parkinson's disease and secondary parkinsonism among



heart attack survivors," Sundboll said. The researchers examined health registries from the Danish National Health Service. They compared the risk of Parkinson's disease and secondary parkinsonism among about 182,000 patients who had a first-time heart attack between 1995 and 2016 (average age 71 years old; 62 per cent male) and more than 909,000 controls matched for age, sex and year of heart attack diagnosis. The results were adjusted for a variety of factors known to influence the risk of either

heart attack or Parkinson's disease. Over a maximum continual follow-up of 21 years, after adjusting for a wide range of potential confounding factors, the analysis found that when compared to the control group: there was a 20 per cent lower risk of Parkinson's disease among people who had a heart attack; and a 28 per cent lower risk of secondary parkinsonism among those who had a heart attack. "For physicians treating patients following a heart attack, these results indicate that cardiac rehabilitation should be focused on preventing ischemic stroke, vascular dementia and other cardiovascular diseases such as a new heart attack and heart failure, since the risk of Parkinson's appears to be decreased in these patients, in comparison to the general population," Sundboll said. Heart attack and Parkinson's disease share certain risk factors, with higher risk found among elderly men and a lower risk among people who drink more coffee and are more physically active. Interestingly, however, some classic risk factors for a heart attack - such as smoking, high cholesterol, high blood pressure and Type 2 diabetes - are associated with a lower risk of Parkinson's disease. In general, more heart attack patients smoke and have elevated cholesterol, either of which may explain the slightly reduced risk of Parkinson's disease among heart attack survivors.

Ramban of (Jammu & Kashmir) at an altitude of 1400 meters, while the North Portal (NP) of the tunnel is located near Arpinchala village Tehsil Khari, District Ramban, in Mahu-Mangat Valley at an altitude of 1600 meters approx.

T-49 tunnel is having two tubes, i.e. one is main tunnel and other being escape tunnel. The tunnel has been constructed by NATM (i.e. New Austrian Tunneling Method), which is a modern technique of drill and blast method.

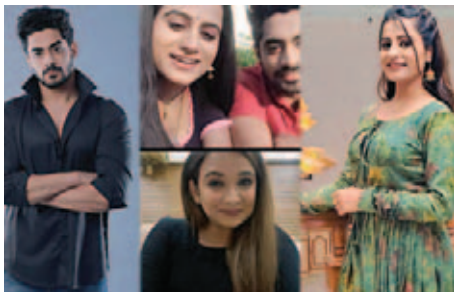
