RTA employee and truck driver burnt alive

YAMUNANAGAR: In a tragic accident, two people, including a Road Transport Authority (RTA) employee and a truck driver were burnt alive in a road mishap on the Amadapur road, about four kms from Kanalsi Ghat here, on Tuesday morning. The accident occurred when RTA officials noticed a parked truck overloaded with sand at Kanalsi Ghat. They broke the lock of the truck and one of them sat on the wheels to take the vehicle to the RTA office. The truck, being driven by the RTA employee when it reached Amadapur road, about 4 kms from Kanalsi Ghat, it collided with a tree and caught fire.

Expel me, Harish Rawat tells Congress

DEHRADUN: Veteran Congress leader Harish Rawat on Tuesday asked the party to expel him after he was accused by the Uttarakhand Congress Working President of "selling" tickets in the just-held assembly elections. Reacting to the allegations by Ranjit Rawat, the former Chief Minister wrote on his Facebook that the allegation of selling tickets to fight the elections was a very serious one. "The allegation of selling posts and party tickets is very serious. It has been levelled against a person who was the Chief Minister, the State President and is also a member of Congress Working Committee (CWC).

No interim relief for Nawab Malik

MUMBAI: The Bombay High Court on Tuesday rejected a plea filed by Maharashtra Minorities Development Minister Nawab Malik seeking interim release after he was arrested last month by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) in connection with a money laundering case. A Division Bench of Justices PB Varale and SM Modak said: "As certain debatable issues are raised, they require to be heard at length. Considering the grounds assigned by us we are not inclined to allow the prayers in the interim application. The application is rejected."

Hijab not essential religious practice of Islam, says Karnataka High Court

Karnataka High Court on Tuesday dismissed a bunch of petitions filed by Muslim girl students seeking a direction to allow them to wear hijab in classrooms during teaching hours. Pronouncing the judgement, the Court said wearing of hijab by Muslim women is not part of essential religious practice under Islam and prescription of school uniform is only a reasonable restriction which students cannot object. The bench also observed that the state government has the power to issue an order in this regard. The judgement was delivered by a three-judge Bench of Chief Justice Ritu Raj Awasthi and Justices Krishna S Dixit and JM Khazi. On the 11th day, the Court had completed the hearing on the matter and reserved its verdict on February 25. The Bench had passed an interim order ordering students not to wear hijab, saffron shawls or use any religious flags while attending classes in colleges which have a prescribed dress code. The controversy erupted after few Muslim girl students of a government pre-university college had been de-



nied entry because they were wearing hijabs during teaching hours in classroom. They argued that hijab is part of their religion and cultural practice. The matter was first listed before a single bench of Justice Krishna S Dixit which referred to a larger bench observing that "questions of seminal importance" are involved. The respondent, that is the state government, argued that wearing of hijab does not fall within the essential religious practice of Islam and right to

wear hijab cannot be traced to freedom of expression under Article 19(1)(a) of the Constitution. The government also argued that its February 5 order is in consonance with the Education Act and wearing hijab does not stand the test of constitutional morality and individual dignity, laid down by the Supreme Court. The Respondent college and its teachers contended that students must follow the prescribed uniform to maintain discipline and public order. The petitioners

BJP leaders welcome order

NEW DELHI: Several BJP leaders on Tuesday hailed the Karnataka High Court order upholding the ban on wearing hijab in schools and colleges, saying the entire debate on the issue should be seen from the context of women empowerment. The Karnataka High Court on Tuesday dismissed petitions filed by a section of Muslim students from the Government Pre-University Girls College in Udupi seeking permission to wear Hijab inside classrooms, saying the headscarf is not a part of the essential religious practice in Islamic faith.

heavily banked on a verdict of the Constitutional Court of South Africa that upheld the right of a Hindu girl from South India to wear a nose ring to school. They also challenged February 5 Government Order which allegedly targets the Muslim community. Meanwhile, Section 144 (Prohibitory Orders) CrPC was imposed in Bengaluru city and many parts of Karnataka from Tuesday till March 21 by police in view of hijab judgment.

Bhagwant Mann to take oath as Punjab CM today

All the arrangements have been completed for the oath taking ceremony of AAP leader Bhagwant Mann, who will take oath as state Chief Minister at Khatkar Kalan on Wednesday.

He invited the people of the state for his oath-taking ceremony.

He also urged the men to wear 'basanti' (yellow) turbans and women yellow 'dupatta' (shawl) on that day.

The ceremony is set to take place at Khatkar Kalan, the ancestral village of legendary freedom fighter Bhagat Singh, in Nawanshahr district.

Mann (48) also urged the people to build a Punjab that Bhagat Singh had dreamt of.

"Not only me, 3 crore people of Punjab will also take oath along with me. We together have to fulfil the dreams of Bhagat Singh and we will put his thinking into effect on March 16," he said in a video uploaded on his Twitter handle.

"I have not become the chief minister alone. You all have become the chief minister. It will be your own government," he said.



"I urge my brothers and friends to wear 'basanti' colour turbans and sisters to wear basanti 'dupatta'. We will turn Khatkar Kalan into 'basanti' colour that day," the AAP leader appealed in the video message.

In a tweet, Mann said, "Let's together build a Punjab of Shaheed Bhagat Singh ji's dreams. I invite you all to attend the swearing-in ceremony at Khatkar Kalan on Wednesday, March 16." The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) romped home by winning 92 seats in the 117-member Punjab assembly.

Mann won from Dhuri assembly seat after defeating Congress candidate Dalvir Singh Goldy by a margin of 58,206 votes.

BJP will be re-elected in HP : Anurag Thakur

Union Minister for Information and Broadcasting Anurag Thakur on Tuesday said that Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) will repeat its government in Himachal Pradesh after its successful tenure of five years. Thakur said that the party would be re-elected in Himachal just as it did in four other states for which elections were conducted recently. Anurag Thakur was speaking to the press persons after he inaugurated a Kheloo India Residential academy of Table tennis and weight lifting in Rainbow International school at Nagrota Bagwan in Kangra district on Tuesday. He laid the foundation stone of indoor sports hall in the school, a project worth Rs. 10 crores today. He said that it is the dream of the prime minister Narinder Modi to catch people young so that they are trained and chiseled as athletes in Rural India. He said that the project is being launched in Rainbow Inter-



national school as per this initiative to see young people from this hill state shine and manifest their sports talent. He said that sports have been developed tremendously during the present government though much needs to be done in future. He hoped that young athletes who will shine on the national and international level will be among those who will be chiseled in these sports institutions. He thanked the Prime Minister for pinning hope in him and assigned the job as Sah Prabari of Uttar Pradesh as the state repeated government after successful tenure of five years. In reply to a question Thakur said that the issue of the EVM raised by SP leaders was merely a hoax.

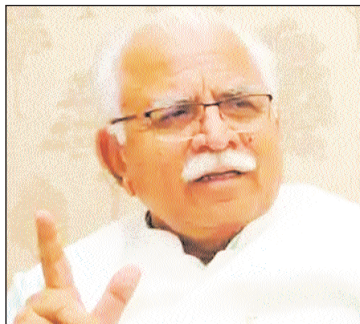
Irregularities in registries to be investigated: Manohar Lal

Haryana Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal, while reiterating his commitment towards the zero-tolerance policy adopted against corruption, today announced that data of land registries done between the years 2010 to 2016, would be investigated to check violation of 7-A norms.

The Chief Minister made this announcement during the discussion on Calling Attention Motion regarding irregularities in the registries during the ongoing Budget session of the Vidhan Sabha.

He said that whenever any case of



corruption has come up before the present state government, the government itself has taken strict cognizance and further action has been taken on

the same. Similarly, in the case of irregularities in the registries, the government itself took cognizance and got the records of the tehsils checked, added Sh. Manohar Lal.

Chief Minister said that violations of 7-A in land registries done between years 2010 to 2016 in 140 Tehsils and sub-tehsils would be investigated and the entire process would be taken forward at a fast pace.

Strict action will be taken against anyone found involved in this entire matter. If required, the records up to the year 2004 will also be investigated, added Sh. Manohar Lal.

Taking a jibe at the opposition, the Chief Minister said that the oppo-

sition never shared any authenticated information. It is we, who have tightened the noose around those involved in corruption. The opposition can only point fingers and works to mislead the people by talking beyond the facts, said Sh. Manohar Lal.

He said that on June 13, 2020, some complaints of irregularities in the registry were received from Gurugram and the Financial Commissioner, Divisional Commissioner and Deputy Commissioners were asked on August 13, 2020, to take cognizance of the same and share the complete data of the violation of 7-A norms in their respective tehsils with the State Government.

20 killed, 28 injured in missile strike by Ukraine, says Russia

The Russian Foreign Ministry said that 20 people have been killed while 28 were injured by a missile launched by the Ukrainian troops.

According to the military, the attack occurred in a residential neighborhood in Donetsk with a Tochka-U tactical missile.

Ukrainian media reported that heavy fighting in Donbas continues. According to Ukraine's Armed Forces, 100 Russian soldiers were killed and six vehicles were destroyed. The Kyiv Independent reported. Russia tried



to break through Ukrainian defenses in Donetsk Oblast, it added. The Kyiv Independent reported that Russia hits Kharkiv with ballistic missiles. Kharkiv Governor Oleh Synyehubov claimed that Kharkiv was hit by short-range Iskander ballistic missile systems stationed in Russia. On February 24, Russia began a special military operation in Ukraine after the Donetsk and Luhansk people's republics requested help in defending themselves. The Russian Defense Ministry said the special operation is targeting Ukrainian military infrastructure only and the civilian population is not in danger.

Around 5.3 lakh police posts lying vacant in country: Centre

Around 5.3 lakh posts are lying vacant in various police stations across the country, Minister of State in the Ministry of Home Affairs Nityanand Rai informed Lok Sabha on Tuesday.

Rai, in a written reply to a question by Indhiya Jananayaga Katchi MP Dr T. R. Paarivendhar on vacancies in police stations across the country.

Minister of State in the Ministry of Home Affairs Rai in his response said that as

per data on Police Organisations compiled by the Bureau of Police Research and Development (BPR&D), sanctioned strength of police is 26,23,225, actual strength is 20,91,488 and 5,31,737 vacancies are there as on January 1, 2020. On being asked regarding the action taken by the government to fill these vacancies and the time by which all these vacant posts are likely to be filled, he replied that "Police" is a State subject falling in List-II (State List) of the Seventh Schedule of the Constitution of India.

More than 1500 Model Sanskriti schools being run in state: Kanwar Pal

Haryana Education Minister, Sh. Kanwar Pal has informed that 138 Government Model Sanskriti Senior Secondary Schools and 1418 Government Model Sanskriti Primary Schools are being run in the state.

Sh. Kanwar Pal was responding to a question during the budget session of Haryana Vidhan Sabha today.

The Education Minister said that the total sanctioned posts of academic staff in Government Model Sanskriti Senior Secondary Schools are 5,275, out of which 1,688 are vacancies and the number of sanctioned posts in Government Model Sanskriti Primary Schools is 12,883, out of which 2,386 posts are vacant. In addition, out of 912 sanctioned posts of non-teaching staff, 495 posts are vacant.

He said that the posting of teachers in Government Model Sanskriti Senior Secondary Schools is done after a difficult selection test. Academic



posts in Government Model Sanskriti Primary Schools are considered as normal posts and are filled through deputation and normal transfer process. He said that the vacant posts of non-teaching staff would be filled through promotion, direct recruitment and transfer.

He said that 380 professors and 106 principals of various subjects have been appointed in these schools through interviews in April and July

2021. Recently 300 professors of various subjects have been provided appointment through CENTA's selection process in February 2022.

Sh. Kanwar Pal informed that the posts of academic staff are non-core posts in Government Model Sanskriti Senior Secondary Schools. Therefore, the posting in Government Model Sanskriti Senior Secondary Schools continues after the selection test through the Centre for Teacher Accreditation. The Education Minister said that the posts of academic staff in Government Model Sanskriti Primary Schools are considered as normal posts and they will be filled through deputation and normal transfer process. Apart from this, the posts of non-academic staff in Government Model Sanskriti Senior Secondary School are treated as normal posts and these posts are to be filled through regular recruitment, transfer, deputation etc. Therefore the demand to fill this direct quota has been sent to the Staff Selection Commission.

Bail jumper criminal nabbed in different cases

Moreover the standard bidding documents issued in Sept 2020 has still not been approved by ministry of power, he added.

Shaheed Bhagat Singh's relatives express resent over pardon to former DIG

The family of Shaheed Bhagat Singh's relatives on Tuesday resented the decision of covertly pardoning a retired Deputy Inspector General (DIG) of Punjab Police, who along with two other cops, was convicted for abducting and eliminating Kuljit Singh Dhatt in 1989.

Deceased Kuljit Singh Dhatt's brother Harbhajan Singh Dhatt, the son-in-law of Parkash Kaur, the younger sister of Shaheed Bhagat Singh, along with his sister-in-law Gurmeet Kaur told media persons here that they were stunned over the decision of covertly pardoning retired Punjab Police DIG SPS Basra. Deceased Kuljit Singh Dhatt's wife Gurmeet Kaur, a resident of village Ambala Jattan, had filed a petition in the Punjab and Haryana High Court for enhancement of punishment against the order of the court of Hoshiarpur Additional Sessions Judge, which convicted SPS Basra and two cops Jaspal Singh and Sita



Ram in FIR No. 81 of May 5, 1996. Two accused, Sardul Singh and AS Sandhu had died during the course of the trial. The court sentenced the accused to five-years of rigorous imprisonment under Section 364 of the IPC, besides imposing a fine of Rs 1 lakh each and in default of payment of fine they would have to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a further period of six months.

They were also awarded rigorous five-year term under section 120-B of the IPC along with a fine

of Rs 10,000 each and in case of default of payment of the fine they would have to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a further period of six months. They were further awarded rigorous two-year term and a fine of Rs 2,000 each under Section 218 of the IPC and in default of payment of fine they would have to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a further period of two months. All the sentences were ordered to run concurrently. The family had fought a long battle of about 25-years to get the decision of Hoshiarpur court which only punished them a meager imprisonment of five-years. They had appealed in the Punjab and Haryana High Court in 2014 against the order of the Hoshiarpur court for the enhancement of punishment to the guilty. Expressing shock over pardoning SPS Basra, Gurmeet Kaur and Harbhajan Singh said that they were waiting for the decision of the Punjab and Haryana High Court that would come in their favour and the guilty persons would be severe-

ly punished. But the new development of pardoning SPS Basra had shaken them. "How could the government take a decision of pardoning S P S Basra when their petition for enhancement of punishment is pending in the Punjab and Haryana High Court," they questioned. They became aware about the Governor's pardon order of SPS Basra when the news item relating to this was recently published in a section of the press. No one had asked them before providing pardon to SPS Basra, they said. Harbhajan Singh claimed that the order of pardoning was covertly issued in the month of July 2021 when Capt Amarinder Singh was the Chief Minister of Punjab. Though, they had not received any invitation to participate in the oath taking ceremony of Bhagwant Singh Mann as Chief Minister of Punjab, but they had decided to go to Khatkar Kalan tomorrow to meet Mann and urged him to intervene in the matter and to get cancelled the decision of pardoning SPS Basra.

Many of these pre-packaged foods are processed with high levels of added sugars, sodium, saturated fats, and refined carbohydrates. Research has found these nutrients of concern are connected to NCDs directly. Welcoming the guests, Surinder Verma of Citizens Awareness Group, said, "Consumption of ultra-processed foods and packaged foods is in the rise in the region and irrespective of the socio-economic background, it is putting the lives of our children and youth at peril."

SC to hear plea seek to cancel bail to Ashish Mishra today

The Supreme Court on Tuesday said it will hear tomorrow the plea seeking to cancel bail to Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Ajay Mishra's son Ashish Mishra, who is an accused in the Lakhimpur Khari incident. A bench headed by Chief Justice of India NV Ramana listed the matter to be heard on Wednesday saying that it will constitute the same bench tomorrow, who was earlier dealing with issues arising out of the Lakhimpur Khari incident. Meanwhile, advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for the petitioner, said that soon one of the prime protected witnesses was brutally attacked, few days after the bail was granted to Ashish Mishra and the alleged attackers also said that now BJP has won the election they will take care of him. Family members of the victims of the Lakhimpur Khari incident have moved the Supreme Court challenging Allahabad High Court order, which granted bail to Ashish Mishra. In the Special Leave Petition, family members



of the deceased have challenged the Allahabad High Court order dated February 10, 2022, wherein Ashish Mishra has granted regular bail. The petitioner said that the Allahabad HC's order is unsustainable in law. They also said that they have approached the Apex Court as the State of Uttar Pradesh has failed to prefer any appeal against the impugned order. "The lack of any discussion in the High Court's order as regards the settled principles for grant of bail is on account of lack of any substantive submissions to this effect by the State as the accused wields substantial influence over the State government as his father is a Union Minister from

the same political party that rules the State," read the petition. "The impugned order is unsustainable in eyes of law as there has been no meaningful and effective assistance by the State to the court in the matter contrary to the object of the first Proviso to Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which provides that in grave offences notice of bail application should ordinarily be given to the Public Prosecutor," said the petitioner. "Even the victims were prevented from bringing the relevant material as regards the settled principles for grant of bail to notice of High Court as their counsel 'got' disconnected from the hearing on 18.01.2022 before

Central University of Punjab organises expert lecture

Tiwari, the Office of the Dean Incharge Academic, Central University of Punjab, Bathinda (CUPB) organized an expert lecture on the topic "Applications of genomics for drought tolerance and disease resistance in soybean". The keynote speaker for this programme was Dr. Milind B. Ratnaparkhe, Principal Scientist (Biotechnology), ICAR-Indian Institute of Soybean Research, Indore. Prof. R.K. Wusirika, Dean Incharge Academics started the proceedings with welcome address. While addressing the participants, Dr. Milind B. Ratnaparkhe stated that the soybean crop has gained popularity at the international level in the last few decades due to its high protein content (40% protein and 20% oil content). He suggested that the adoption of soybean crops by Indian farmers will not only reduce our imports of edible oil but also increase the soil fertility of land due to nitrogen fixation capabilities of this crop as it belongs to Leguminosae



family. He asserted that soybean has made positive impact on various industries including, food and feed industries, pharmaceuticals and Biodiesel production industries. Dr. Ratnaparkhe underlined that the success of genetically modified soybean in US, Brazil and other countries has encouraged the scientists of our country to work on various molecular approaches for soybean improvement. He shared that the research studies conducted by the ICAR-Indian Institute of Soybean Research indicates that molecular breeding, genetic engineering approach and genome editing approaches have the potential to increase soybean yield by improving its drought, water logging, and abiotic-biotic stress tolerance; refining its seed composition; and enhancing disease resistance capabilities.

Small's not beautiful

New signboards are often visible, advertising the names of small finance banks. Promoters with 10-year experience in banking and finance of pre-existing, non-banking finance companies, micro-finance institutions and local area banks with a minimum corpus of Rs 200 crore were invited by the Reserve Bank of India in 2014 to open small finance banks. At least 40% of the initial capital was to be contributed by the promoters. These banks have completed five years in operation with some dominance in states with greater number of banking branches than others. This trend, observed by the RBI, indicates a deviation from their intended target to reach the unbanked and under-served areas and customers.

Fixed deposits in banks and small savings deposits in post offices should come under the lens at this juncture of the discussion. In 2019-20, 84.24% of the household financial savings were made in small savings, fixed deposits in banks, and in insurance. In 2020-21, a gross Rs 93,73,55.25 crore deposits were collected from small savings alone whereas a gross Rs 62,47,58.22 crore could be collected up to November 2021 in the current financial year. These investments are specially backed by state governments as they could borrow from these deposits. Investment in shares and debentures (including mutual funds) formed a minuscule 3.39% of the overall savings for 2019-20. But an unforeseen rise in investment has been spotted, whether in the new issue market or the secondary market, in the last two years. In 2020-21, 1.43 crore new investors were added up. Individual investors pumped in a total of Rs 1,37,000 crore during 2020 and in the first nine months of 2021 in the equity market, out of which Rs 86,000 crore was in 2021 alone. This is indicative of a desperation to make quick money when the interest rate in the deposit market is going down and inflation remains high. With higher interest rates on deposits, the small finance banks have an edge over others. These banks registered an 89% compounded annual growth rate in deposits between 2018-2020.

Currently, the interest rate offered by small finance banks on deposits ranges between 7.75% for senior citizens and 7.25% for others. The PPF earns 7.10%; the senior citizens savings scheme 7.40%; post office deposits yield between 5.5-6.7 per cent; a five-year fixed deposit in public or a private bank offers between 4.9%-5.5%. Bandhan Bank and Yes Bank offer a maximum of 7% interest to senior citizens and 6.25% to other customers. Small finance banks are, evidently, ahead of all of these in terms of interest rates.

As Putin's war drags on, China's discomfiture increases

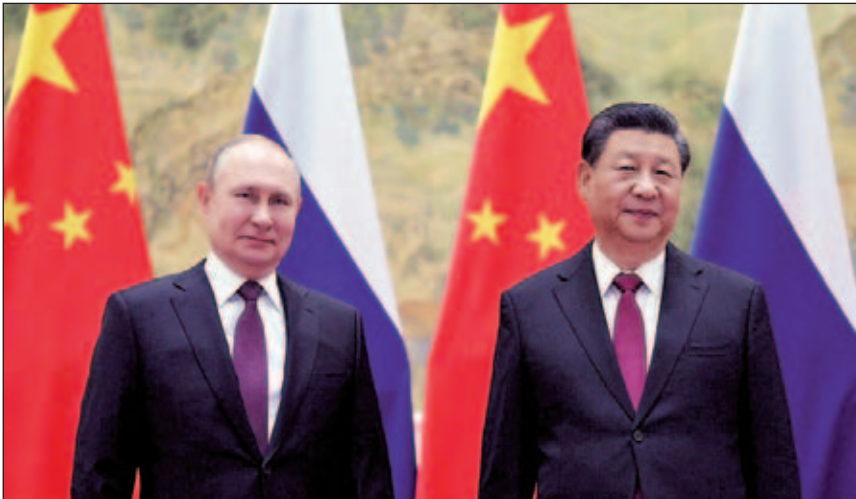
There is a lot of conjecture about the strategic relationship between China and Russia, and the degree of knowledge that Chairman Xi Jinping had before President Vladimir Putin launched his lamentable invasion of Ukraine.

This war is proving to be fraught with risks for China, putting Beijing in an awkward nexus as it tries to juggle support for its ally while pretending to be neutral.

As the Ministry of Truth's adage in George Orwell's classic book Nineteen Eighty-Four went, "War is peace; Freedom is slavery; Ignorance is strength". This is the kind of absurd contradictions that Beijing tries to get away with, obfuscating the truth. In fact, China cannot even bring itself to label Putin's gambit as an "invasion" or "war".

China has tried hard to portray itself as neutral in this conflict, but it is patently obvious that it is not easy walking such a tightrope. Russian talking points are blithely repeated by Chinese officials, one example being the ridiculous notion that the USA has biological warfare laboratories in Ukraine. Zhang Jun, China's Ambassador to the United Nations (UN), told the General Assembly, "The situation has evolved to a point which China does not wish to see. It is not in the interest of any party." This comment went further than any other Chinese official has gone, and sounded positive. However, the same ambassador also remarked that "intensifying unilateral sanctions" was more "deeply concerning" than the intensifying invasion of an independent country. "War is peace; Freedom is slavery; Ignorance is strength".

China's twisted thinking forces it to be creative in its verbal gymnastics as it defends the indefensible. One key principle that China cannot reconcile is the inviolable nature of sovereign territory, which it loves to preach about. Additionally, it decries anyone interfering in the internal affairs of others. Yet Russia has broken both of China's cardinal rules, and has received



no criticism from Beijing. How can Beijing be so hypocritical? Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi thus told Ukrainian counterpart Dmytro Kuleba in a phone call, "The security of one country shouldn't be achieved at the expense of the security of other countries, and the regional security can't be achieved by expanding military blocs."

These are empty words, for Xi refuses to criticize Putin. Not only that, but Beijing has supported Putin's narrative that Russia is the aggrieved party, that NATO is a guilty party, and that Ukraine has deservedly brought this attack upon itself. At home on the internet, for example, or on the world stage, China has staunchly shielded Russia from criticism.

In February, during the Beijing Winter Olympics, China and Russia signed a strategic agreement for a partnership that has "no limits". That seems to be holding true, even as one of the parties wantonly invades another nation.

China and Russia do not implicitly trust each other, but their leaders, who have met 38 times since 2013, have built up rapport. They certainly share values such as spurn-

ing human rights, seeking imperial expansionism, and desiring to leave a legacy as strongman leaders who oversaw their nation's rise to the proper place in the world.

The two countries certainly share similar ambitions of sidelining and diminishing the West, particularly the USA. Other than bland calls for negotiations, there is no evidence that Xi has put any pressure on Putin to end the conflict.

Those who are calling upon Xi to help broker a ceasefire are simply naive. China's principles are no better than Russia's, and it harbors the same militaristic ambitions against Taiwan as Putin does with Ukraine.

Interestingly, a report in the Financial Times quoted US intelligence officials as saying that Moscow may have approached Beijing to obtain military equipment and supplies for use in Ukraine.

It is impossible to corroborate this, but as Putin's war enters its third week, the Russian military has made far slower progress than expected and has suffered colossal losses.

In terms of armored vehicles, for example, the Russian Army has already lost

more than the equivalent of the entire British Army's entire armored vehicle fleet. If China were to offer such overt support, it would underscore Chinese complicity. It is

difficult to see what benefit that would bring to China, as it would make the Ukraine conflict a proxy war involving China. Jake Sullivan, the US National Security Advisor, was due to meet China's Yang Jiechi in Rome on 14 March. Before Sullivan's departure, he warned China not to "bail out" Russia by circumventing Western sanctions. For a week partway through the Olympics, the Chinese Communist Party's (CCP) top leadership disappeared from public view. Presumably, the seven members of the Politburo Standing Committee (PSC) were discussing the brewing Ukraine crisis and how to play it.

Siding with Putin might have brought reward if Russia had knifed through Ukraine militarily, and NATO and the USA had shown weakness and internal dissension. However, the longer the conflict goes on, the heavier is the price for China, and it becomes harder to plead neutrality.

It is unknown whether there was internal debate among the PSC as to the wisest course of action. Xi's style of leadership is top down, and he has been dismantling the collective leadership model since grabbing the reins of power. If the PSC were to demand a change of policy regarding Ukraine, this would amount to personal defeat for Xi.

A year ago, Xi declared, "The East is rising, and the West is in decline." However, he might have been premature in such a conclusion. Indeed, China may have ignored or missed all the danger signs, so serious was Xi in aligning with Russia. Kurt Campbell, the US senior coordinator for Indo-Pacific Policy at the National Security Council, said, "It's undeniable that, right now, China is occupying an awkward nexus in which they're trying to sustain their deep and fundamental relationship with Russia."

The return of the thali

There was a time when almost everyone in India ate out of a thali. The word derives from thaal, a large circular tray, and has some connection with thal/sthal--a place. This is where food was traditionally 'placed' for consumption. It was a paatra (literally a vessel or container) deriving from the Sanskrit word patra meaning a leaf. The earliest thali was obviously fabricated with leaves. The biodegradable pattal and the banana leaves commonly used as a plate in southern and coastal India remind us of this lineage.

Times change and so do our eating habits. Indians gave up metallic thalis and adopted plates of porcelain, melamine, plastic and stainless steel. They also stopped sitting cross-legged on the floor or on low stools and eating with their hands. Thali was slowly erased from our memory. For the present generation, it has become synonymous with a specific set meal.

Thali meals are prefixed with geographical indicators or a particular community tag. Gujarati, Jain and Madras thalis are encountered all over the land. Gujarati thali is vegetarian so is the Jain one that adheres to even stricter commandments eschewing garlic, onion, roots and tubers that grow underground. The Madras thali

is also vegetarian and comes in two versions: limited and full meals. Catering to North Indian patrons, the Udipi restaurants from Karnataka lost no time in introducing a North Indian thali with paneer, chhole, mah di daal and choice of bread: tandoori roti, paratha or kulcha.

In recent years the non-vegetarian south Indian thali has made a strong debut. Karaikudi-Chettinad recipes from Tamil Nadu and delicacies from Syrian Christian or Mopla Muslim repertoire in Kerala have won a small but loyal clientele. Andhra Pradesh took the lead in showcasing its ultra-hot meat and exceptional seafood in its regional thali. Restaurants like 'Oh Calcutta' and '6 Bally Gunj' have popularised culinary classics from East (present-day Bangladesh) and West Bengal with tantalising menus that include fish, fowl and flesh.

The array of thalis that we can choose from is bewildering with prices ranging from twenty rupees to a thousand times more. The roadside kiosks and pushcarts sell a set thali with two parathas, dahi and achar or three puris and sabzi for 20-30 rupees. Add a fiver and you could have a more substantial meal of four rotis, half a plate of chawal, two vegetables and dal.

NASA continue to work with Russian counterpart

While Russian forces invade Ukraine and the West responds with unprecedented sanctions, US space agency NASA said they are continuing to work with their Russian counterparts.

"NASA continues working with all our international partners, including the State Space Corporation Roscosmos, for the ongoing safe operations of the International Space Station," a NASA spokesperson Dan Huot told.

"The new export control measures will continue to allow US-Russia civil space cooperation. No changes are planned to the agency's support for ongoing in orbit and ground station operations." Huot added.

This comes after Dmitry Rogozin, the head of Russia's space agency Roscosmos and a longtime ally of Putin, took to social media and warned that US sanctions could have "dire" consequences for the International Space Station program.

There were some fears after Russia invaded Ukraine that the Russian Space Agency would ditch Vande Hei, an American astronaut who is scheduled to return to Earth in a Russian capsule from the International Space Station on March 30. Despite the concerns, NASA said Vande Hei will be on the Soyuz rocket later this month. NASA has said that Vande Hei's plans to touch down in Kazakhstan have not changed. The Russia-Ukraine crisis three weeks ago has caused space programs to cancel launches and to break contracts. Concerns



over Russia's willingness to help return Vande Hei to Earth came up after President Biden announced a series of economic sanctions on Moscow in response to its invasion of Ukraine. The sanctions would "degrade their aerospace industry, including their space program," Biden said during a White House news conference.

For the past 24 years, the US and Russia have worked together to construct and maintain the ISS where research has led to some of the most important discoveries of the 21st century.

The ISS has been permanently occupied for more than 20 years with its main operators being the United States and Russia. American astronauts routinely return back to Earth on the Russian Soyuz capsules.

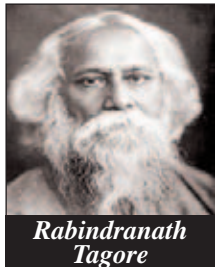

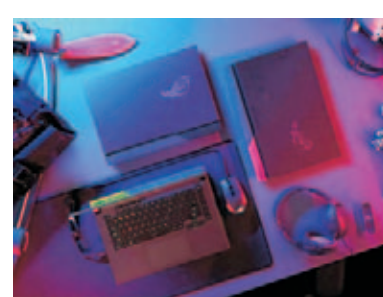

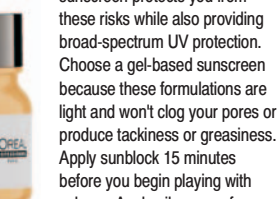

The Women's FA Cup has grown in stature, with 417 teams entering the competition this season, while interest has significantly increased over the last decade, which resulted in the Final being permanently moved to Wembley Stadium in 2015. Now that the uplift in prize fund for the Women's FA Cup has been agreed, work will begin on how that money is divided and allocated, with the aim being for all clubs that enter the competition to benefit. Sue Campbell, director of women's football, said: "I'm delighted to be able to make this announcement of increased funding for the Vitality Women's FA Cup because it's going to benefit so many clubs across the women's football pyramid."

Nadal will now face Reilly Opelka of the United States of America in the Round of 16 who defeated Canada's Denis Shapovalov 6-7 (4-7), 6-4, 6-4. The Canadian Shapovalov won the opening set in a tie-breaker but the American made a comeback to win the next two. Reigning US Open Champion Daniil Medvedev lost his Round of 32 matches against France's Gael Monfils 4-6, 6-3, 6-1 which lasted for two hours and six minutes. The Russian will now lose his world number one ranking to 20-time grand slam winner Novak Djokovic.

Amy Jones urges her side to enjoy cricket ahead of clash with India

Amy Jones has urged England to focus on enjoying their cricket as they look to get their title defence back on track against India at the ICC Women's Cricket World Cup 2022.

England suffered their third consecutive loss of the tournament against South Africa last time out, losing by three wickets following previous defeats to Australia and West Indies.

That result was underpinned by more fielding errors, including dropped chances and a missed stumping, but Jones believes England are more than capable of righting those wrongs.

"After the West Indies game, we dropped and missed a lot of chances, so we spoke about that as a group, obviously not wanting to put a huge amount of pressure on the first opportunity that comes in the

next game," she said in an official statement.

"We just spoke about how we want to be really positive, really supportive of each other out there and just do the little things right, like attacking the ball and getting some good energy going. The chances will be created from that and we know our skill level is good enough to take those chances. It was unfortunate that we missed a few last time out, but with the games coming so quick you have to look individually if there's any quick learnings you can make," she added. Jones was one of England's standout performers against South Africa, contributing a maiden World Cup half-century, and the wicketkeeper admitted it was nice to be back among the runs after a lean spell. "It's obviously good to score some runs as I've obviously been quite short of runs recently so it was a bit of a relief to be honest."

He is somebody who can change the game: Rohit praises Rishabh

India skipper Rohit Sharma praised wicketkeeper-batter Rishabh Pant for his batting style and said that he is a player who can change the game.

India beat Sri Lanka by 238 runs in the second Test on Monday at the M Chinnaswamy Stadium to clinch the two-match series 2-0.

"We know how he bats and, as a team, we just want to give him that freedom to bat in the way that he wants to bat. But also keep in mind certain situations of the game, where the game is going, we have conveyed that to him but we want to stick with his game plan as a team," said Rohit Sharma during a post-match press conference.

"It just seems to get better and get better, his game-plans. There will be times when you will smash your head and say 'why did he play that



shot', but again, we need to be ready to accept that with him when he bats. He is somebody who can change the game literally in half an hour or 40 minutes of the game. I think what comes with Rishabh Pant, we are

ready to accept that," he added.

This series was the first time when Rohit led the team in Test cricket. He said that he tried to work on his instinct and tried to analyze the game.

"There are a few senior members in the team who understand the game well and have their input as well. I have my reading of the game as well. But eventually, you work on instinct and my captaincy philosophy is to take a call on that point that seems right to you, keeping in mind of where the game is going. I try to analyse these things on the ground," he said.

The skipper further praised pacer Jasprit Bumrah for his fiery bowling performance in the two-match series. "To come out and bowl like that in this kind of conditions shows how much skill and ability he has. Someone like Bumrah, he's never out of the game whatever the conditions are," said the skipper. "To bowl on certain pitches, you need certain skill-sets. And he seems to bring those skill-sets into the game depending on what sort of assistance he has from the pitch.
