Unemployment rate rises to 7.80 pc in June: CMIE

MUMBAI: The country's unemployment rate has shot up at 7.80 per cent in June with the loss of 13 million jobs, mainly in the agriculture sector, according to the data released by economic think-tank Centre for Monitoring Indian Economy (CMIE). The massive fall in number of jobs last month was triggered by higher unemployment rate in rural areas, which went up to 8.03 per cent from 6.62 per cent in May. In urban areas, it was slightly better at 7.30 per cent compared to 7.12 per cent recorded in May, according to the CMIE data.

Punjab: Jauramajra gets health, Arora to look after Urban Dev

Five newly inducted Punjab ministers were allocated portfolios on Tuesday, with Chetan Singh Jauramajra got Health and Aman Arora got Housing and Urban Development. Anmol Gagan Mann was allocated Tourism and Cultural Affairs. In a tweet, Chief Minister

Bhagwant Mann shared information about the portfolios allotted to the ministers. Five AAP MLAs were inducted as ministers in the Punjab government on Monday as Mann expanded his cabinet. It was the first cabinet expansion of the Mann-led government after the AAP stormed to power in the state after the Assembly elections earlier this year.

According to the portfolios allocated, Arora got Information and Public Relations, New and Renewable energy resources, Housing and Urban Development departments. Dr Inderbir Singh Nijjar will handle Local Government, Parliamentary Affairs, Conservation of Land and Water and Administrative Reforms departments. Fauja Singh will be the Minister for Freedom Fighters, Defence Services Welfare, Food Processing and Horticulture.



Jauramajra has been given Health and Family Welfare, Medical Education and Research departments. Anmol Gagan Mann will be the Minister for Tourism and Culture Affairs, Investment Promotion, Labour and Removal of Grievances. Gagan Mann is the second woman to be inducted as cabinet minister in the Mann-led government.

With the induction of five more ministers on Monday, the strength of the state cabinet has climbed to 15, including the chief minister. After the AAP formed the government following its resounding victory in the assembly polls, 10 MLAs, including eight first-timers, were inducted as ministers in March.

cer, Gaurav Yadav on Tuesday assumed the additional charge of Director General of Police (Head of Police Force) Punjab. According to the orders issued by the state government, Gaurav Yadav would also continue to hold the charge of the Special DGP Administration Punjab.

After assuming charge, the newly appointed DGP Punjab held a meeting with the top brass of the Punjab Police and assured them that he will continue to work for the further betterment of the state Police. The

DGP, while briefing officers, said that the topmost priority of the Punjab Government, as directed by Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann, is to further strengthen the fight against drugs to make Punjab a drug-free state besides eliminating gangster culture, maintaining law and order, and detection of crime. He stressed on the need to revive basic policing which includes keeping vigil in vulnerable spots and be always ready to handle any kind of anticipated law and order situation, monitoring crime data, inspections of Police Stations, looking after the welfare of Police Personnel, etc. DGP Gaurav Yadav also directed all the CPs/SSPs to increase Police Check Points in their respective jurisdictions and ensure the frisking of maximum vehicles at every Naka, which will help in curtailing criminal activities. He also advised that all the Nakas should be synchronized in a manner that they must get activated promptly on a single call.

Ration card scam exposed in Sirsa

CM Window system started by the Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal to directly address the grievances of the general public by reaching the Chief Minister's office is highly appreciated by the public. Meanwhile, taking major action on the complaint on ration card scam in Sirsa, a vigilance inquiry has been

marked. Divulging more details, Sh. Bhupeshwar Dayal, OSD to the Chief Minister, who is monitoring the complaints on the CM window from the Headquarters Chandigarh, Prem

Jain, a resident of Bhim Colony had lodged a complaint against the District Food and Supply Controller (DFSC), Food, Ĉivil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department, Sirsa alleging that the officers and employees of the office are working hand in gloves to collect the fee in lieu of making corrections in about 30,000 ration cards, as the said fee amount is not being deposited in the treasury. Sh. Bhupeshwar Dayal further shared that talking strict cognizance of the said allegations; stringent action was taken by the Chief Minister's

Office.
DFSC, Sirsa has informed that on January 19, 2021, an amount of Rs 38,800 had been deposited by the department. But the CM window was misled and the department was then asked to file the matter again with the CM Window. It was also informed that an amount of Rs. 8, 88,935 was deposited as a ration card fee by various offices

of the district, shared Sh. Bhupeshwar Day-

He said that when the Chief Minister's Office directly contacted the complainant, he informed that he was never made a party in the investigation nor his

signature was taken while submitting the final report.

Sh. Bhupeshwar Dayal said that as per the guidelines of CM Window, it is mandatory to have the signatures of the complainant as well as the eminent citizen while submitting the final report of action taken by the department on any complaint. Sh. Bhupeshwar Dayal said that later in the complaint it was also informed that though in the said scam the recovery of Rs. 16 to 17 lakh should have been made while actually only Rs. 8.88 lakh has been recovered.

Ex-Haryana CM OP Chautala moves Delhi HC challenging conviction

AGENCY NEW DELHI, JULY 5

Former Haryana Chief Minister Om Prakash Chautala has moved to the Delhi High Court challenging the order of a trial court which sent him to four years of imprisonment in a disproportionate assets (DA) case.

Advocate Harsh Sharma on Tuesday confirmed that the appeal has been moved to the High Court challenging a trial court order of conviction and order of sentence against Chautala.

On May 27, 2022, the Rouse Avenue Court of Delhi ordered four years of imprisonment to Chautala. The Court had also ordered to confiscate four properties of him and also imposed a fine of Rs 50 lakh.

While passing the order, CBI Judge Vikas Dhull had also ordered to send Chautala in the custody of Tihar Jail.

During the argument, Chautala physically appeared and remained present in the courtroom. Appearing for



Chautala, Advocate Harsh cited medical grounds for less punishment and submitted that "I, (OP Chautala), have been infected with polio since birth and I am partially disabled."

CBI's Special Public Prosecutor Ajay Gupta had opposed the submissions of Chautala's lawyer for a grant of concession on the grounds of ill-health and age.
CBI had urged the court

that "maximum punishment shall be given as it would send a message to the society." "The person, in this case, is a public figure and giving minimum punishment would send a wrong message. He is not having clean antecedents. It is the second case, in which he has been convicted," CBI

The Punjab Vigilance Bureau on Tuesday arrested two property dealers namely Rabbi Singh and Banarsi Das for tampering and fabrication of the revenue record regarding mutation of approximately 578 acres (4624 Kanals) of village common land of Majrian in SAS Nagar district in connivance with the officials of revenue department.

Disclosing this here a spokesperson of the Punjab Vigilance Bureau (VB) said that after verification of

NEW DELHI, JULY 5 The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) on Tuesday ordered a probe into the incident where SpiceJet's Delhi-Dubai flight was diverted to Karachi as the fuel

indicator started malfunc-

tioning.

More than 150 passengers are onboard the SpiceJet flight (Delhi-Dubai) that made an emergency landing in Karachi, Pakistan after developing a technical fault.

"On July 5, 2022, M/s SpiceJet B737-8 Max aircraft VT-MXG while operating flight SG-011, Delhi - Dubai, the crew observed unusual fuel quantity reduction from the left tank. They carried out a relevant non-normal checklist, however fuel quantity kept on decreasing. PIC decided to divert the aircraft to Karachi (KHI). Aircraft diverted in coordination with ATC and landed safely at KHI," said DGCA statement.

India's low-cost carrier SpiceJet said the flight was diverted when it was on the way to Dubai and flying on 5000 ft. The conversation be-



ATC Karachi which has been accessed by a news agency, shows that the pilot has asked for a precautionary landing after suspected fuel leakage in the aircraft. "The SpiceJet pilot is heard telling ATC Karachi that the fuel leakage in the aircraft, requesting it for precautionary landing, ATC conversation read access by a news agency. "Karachi ATC confirming him whether any dangerous good on board. The pilots responded negatively. Later Karachi ATC confirms SpiceJet for landing after two minutes," the conversation further read. The plane landed safely at Karachi airport at around 8 am (local time), 53 minutes after being airborne.

Passenger vehicle retail sales up by 40 pc in June as chip supply improves

NEW DELHI, JUL 5

Passenger vehicle retail sales in the country rose 40 per cent in June indicating an improvement in semiconductor supplies even as demand, especially for SUVs, remained robust, auto dealer' body FADA said on Tues-

According to the Federation of Automobile Dealers Associations (FADA), passenger vehicle (PV) registrations rose to 2,60,683 units last month, as compared to 1,85,998 units in June 2021, registering an increase of 40 per cent.

"The PV segment continued to see robust growth. An increase in dis-



ductor availability is now getting easier," FADA President Vinkesh Gulati said in a statement.

Due to chip shortage, however, waiting periods, especially in com-

ue to remain high, he added. Despite long waiting periods,

new vehicle launches are witnessing robust bookings thus reflecting a healthy demand pipeline, Gulati said. Two-wheeler retail sales last

month rose 20 per cent to 11,19,096 units, as compared to 9,30,825 units in the year-ago period, FADA data showed. Gulati noted that poor market sentiment especially in rural India, high cost of ownership, inflationary pressure and June generally being a lean month due to rains kept the two-wheeler sales at low speed. Commercial vehicle retail sales also witnessed an 89 per cent year-on-year increase last month at 67,696 units.

Three-wheeler registrations surged last month to 46,040 units, as against 14,735 units in June last year. Besides, tractor retail sales also increased by 10 per cent at 57,340 units last month, as compared to 52,289 units in June 2021. Overall retail sales increased by 27 per cent at 15,50,855 units in June, as against 12,19,657 units in the year-ago period. Gulati, however, noted that when compared to June 2019, a pre-COVID month, overall sales last month were still down by 9 per cent.On business outlook, he stated that with the prices of almost all essential items having moved northwards, it has put a pressure on the common man's household

What lies ahead

The SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus harboured by bats crossed over to humans. The trigger for every viral pandemic in this century, including HIV, the influenza pandemic of 1918, and now Covid-19, has been a 'spillover' event — an infectious pathogen jumping onto humans after originating in animals. The possibility of a future pandemic is high; a major reason being environmental damage that is bringing humans closer to animals.

Considerable discussions are taking place to prepare ourselves against future pandemics. In a recent commentary in Nature, six eminent scientists stated, "A reactive response to catastrophe need not be the norm." UNESCO-TWAS (The World Academy of Sciences) has set up a Technical Advisory Committee on Covid-19 comprising scientists, including me, from 14 countries of the developing world. This committee noted that "The COVID-19 pandemic has demonstrated... the critical importance of genomic surveillance and data sharing..." Many countries had rapidly put together infrastructure for RNA sequencing and RT-PCR testing. But this was not possible for many countries of the Global South. It may not even be possible in the near future. Therefore, multiple networks of cooperation to share expertise and sequencing facilities must be formed, especially in the Global South, to prevent future pandemics. If the current inequities across countries persist with respect to genomic surveillance, pandemics can never be prevented. To arrest outbreaks and spread of infections, genomic surveillance is necessary but not sufficient. Surveillance data must be freely shared globally. During the initial stages of the present pandemic, many countries did not deposit RNA sequence data to a central database for others to track. Such hesitancy is unacceptable. Nations must come to an agreement on sharing sequence data of infectious pathogens, not just during epidemics but also in normal times.

Frequent episodes of spillover are worrying. Many of these spillovers have resulted in massive mortalities. How can we prevent spillovers? Those six scientists suggested four preventive measures: protection of forests; regulating wildlife trade; biosecuring farms; improving economic security of people to reduce their engagement in high-risk activities.

Deforestation brings us closer to wildlife that host pathogens. Agricultural productivity can be increased even without destroying forests through better management, redistribution of resources, and a strong political will.

India's position on Crypto currency vindicated by global trends

India's conservative position on not encouraging trading in Crypto currency is being rapidly vindicated by the negative experiences of various Crypto funds, with the latest being Singapore's Three Arrows crypto fund. In line with the dip in the overall crypto market valuation, the Singaporebased crypto hedge fund Three Arrows Capital (3AC), one of the high-profile crypto investment firms has run into difficulties and is reportedly in trouble.

Taking into account the latest crash in the crypto assets, many experts believe that India correctly predicted the adverse economic headwinds and perhaps saved a lot of investors from an economic ruin.

To just put things into context, the value of Bitcoin as a crypto asset has tumbled 55 per cent so far in 2022. The crypto market, at large, has fallen by about a third since it hit its peak sometime in November

In line with the downturn in the crypto market, Bloomberg and Reuters quoted sources saying that the Singapore-based crypto hedge fund has entered into the process of liquidation after failing to make payments on a loan of 15,250 bitcoin (approximately USD 324 million) and USD 350 million worth of USDC, a stable coin.

News agency Reuters reported citing sources that a court in the British Virgin Islands, where the Singapore-based hedge fund firm is incorporated, issued the liquidation order on June 27. The Commercial Court there orders a company to be liquidated if it is regarded as insolvent because it cannot pay its debts.

The Singapore-based hedge fund firm 3AC was founded by former Credit Suisse traders Zhu Su, a Singaporean, and Kyle Davies at the kitchen table of their apartment in 2012. Zhu had famously predicted the bottom of the last crypto cycle in December 2018 when bitcoin was worth about



3,850. Further, according blockchain analytics firm Nansen, its blockchain holdings were once worth close to USD 10 billion.

Adding to its woes, the Singapore central bank the Monetary Authority of Singapore (MAS) last week reprimanded 3AC for breaching financial regulations.

On the other hand, the Indian regulator had attempted to ban cryptocurrencies only to be later overturned by the Supreme Court. Supreme Court of India in early 2020 overturned a circular put out by the country's central bank the Reserve Bank of India prohibiting banks and entities regulated by it from providing services in relation to virtual currencies (VCs), terming the circular as "disproportionate".

Taking one more step to dampen the crypto trading in the country, a one per cent tax deducted at source (TDS) on crypto transactions was introduced in the Budget for FY23, which kicked in on July 1. The one per cent TDS liability is the second major provision of India's after the recently introduced 30 per cent capital gains tax on all transactions on virtual assets took effect on April 1, 2022.

India's crypto community has been up in arms over the new provisions and warned that it will have a severely negative impact on crypto trading in the country, especially with the latest global market slump. Sumit Gupta, co-founder and CEO at CoinDCX in a tweet has said that this tax "would do more harm than good". He said developers and entrepreneurs might flee to friendlier jurisdictions, while adding that a 30 per cent taxation rate coupled with one per cent TDS was "unfair."

The Indian government has been very careful not to legitimise crypto trading. The rationale behind imposing taxes on the virtual assets spelt out by the government was that taxing on the crypto was imposed as because people were profiting from it. "We have been cautioning against crypto and look at what has happened to the crypto

market now," said Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Governor Shaktikanta Das in a CNBC-TV18 interview earlier this year after the value of cryptocurrencies took a tumble. He had warned about the dangers of investing in something that has no underlying value. "Our position remains very clear, it will seriously undermine the monetary, financial and macroeconomic stability of India," the Governor had said.

Recently, Das has said that cryptocurrencies are a clear danger and anything that derives value based on make-believe, without any underlying, is just speculation under a sophisticated name. He mentioned this in the foreword of the Financial Stability Report (FSR) released in late June by RBI. "While technology has supported the reach of the financial sector and its benefits must be fully harnessed, its potential to disrupt financial stability has to be guarded

As the financial system gets increasingly digitalised, cyber risks are growing and need special attention," he further said. According to cryptocurrency data aggregator CoinGecko, the total market cap of cryptocurrencies has shrunk by more than a third, down to around USD 930 billion from a high of about USD 3 trillion reached in November of 2021.

Although the crypto market has been on a decline this year, there isn't a specific reason for the same. Analysts have, however, suggested that the wider global economic situation of higher interest rates, and a looming recession, coupled with investors' lower risk appetite have caused the slump. It has caused various calamities in the market. Some believe a crypto winter has arrived. Besides 3AC, among the recent disasters is the collapse of terra USD stablecoin and sister coin luna, and liquidity issues at lenders Celsius Network and Babel Finance.

Russia tries to press its offensive into Ukraine's east



ussian forces tried Monday to press their offensive deeper into eastern Ukraine after taking control of a key stronghold.

The Ukrainian military confirmed that its forces had withdrawn from the city of Lysychansk, the last bulwark of Ukrainian resistance in the Luhansk province, one of the two regions that make up the country's eastern industrial heartland of Donbas. The Russians also control about half of Donetsk, the second province of Donbas. The General Staff of the Ukrainian military said the Russian forces were currently focusing their efforts on pushing toward the line of Siversk, Fedorivka and Bakhmut in the Donetsk region.

The Russian army also has intensified the shelling of key Ukrainian strongholds of Sloviansk and Kramatorsk deeper in the Donetsk region.

On Sunday, six people, including a 9-year-old girl, were killed in the Russian shelling of Sloviansk and another 19 people were wounded, according to local authorities. Kramatorsk also came under fire on Sun-

Russian President Vladimir Putin has made capturing the entire Donbas a key goal in his war in Ukraine, now in its fifth month. Moscow-backed separatists in Donbas have battled Ukrainian forces since 2014 when they declared independence from Kyiv after the Russian annexation of Ukraine's Crimea. Russia formally recognized the selfproclaimed republics days before its Feb. 24 invasion of Ukraine.

After 3 feet of rain, 32,000 in Sydney area may need to flee



than 30,000 residents of Svdney and its surrounds have been Ltold to evacuate or prepare to abandon their homes on Monday as Australia's largest city braces for what could be its worst flooding in 18 months.

Parts of the city of 5 million people are facing a fourth flooding emergency in a year and a half after torrential rain since Friday caused dams to overflow and waterways to break their banks. The latest information we have is that there's a very good chance that the flooding will be worse than any of the other three floods that those areas had in the last 18 months, Emergency Management Minister Murray Watt told Australian Broadcasting Corp.

The current flooding might affect areas that managed to stay dry during the previous floods, Watt added. New South Wales state Premier Dominic Perrottet said 32,000

people were impacted by evacuation orders and warnings. You'd probably expect to see that number increase over the course of the week, Perrottet said. Emergency services had made 116 flood rescues in recent days, 83 of them since 9 p.m. Sunday, he said. Hundreds more requests for help were made by Monday morning.

Australia's Bureau of Meteorology manager Jane Golding said some areas between Newcastle, north of Sydney, and Wollongong, south of Sydney had received more than a meter (39 inches) of rain in the previous 24 hours. Some has received more than 1.5 meters (59 inches). The system that has been generating this weather does show signs that it will ease tomorrow, but throughout today, expect more rain, Golding said. Rain was forecast across New South Wales's coast, including Sydney, all

Mindful interactions and relationships can bring about more harmonious, healthy workplace

new study suggests the real payoffs emerge when An individual's mindfulness is translated into mindful interactions and relationships. Such interactions infused with intentionality, compassion and presence can bring about more harmonious and healthy organizations.

"An understanding of how $individuals \ bring \ \underline{mindfulness}$ with them to work, and how these practices may contribute to interaction and relationship quality, is especially relevant as work landscapes are ever-changing and interdependence is in-



creasingly becoming the norm," management and entrepreneurship in the VCU School of Busisaid Christopher S. Reina, Ph.D., an associate professor of ness. In the study "Your Pres-

ence is Requested: Mindfulness Infusion in Workplace Interactions and Relationships," which was published in Organization Science, Reina and management professors Glen E. Kreiner, Ph.D., of the University of Utah; Alexandra Rheinhardt, Ph.D., of the University of Connecticut; and Christine A. Mihelcic of the University of Richmond explore how individuals bring mindfulness to work and how it infuses their workplace interactions. These practices may be formal, such as engaging in a mindful pause before beginning a meeting, or informal, such as listening to someone with a high level

of attention. The qualitative study draws on the experiences of actual leaders to explain how they bring mindfulness into the workplace. Primary data sources included interviews and on-site participant observation. The researchers conducted 30 formal interviews with managers, professionals and consultants who practice mindfulness in the workplace, and more than 50 informal interviews with a wide variety of individuals who apply mindfulness principles at work. "Interestingly, interviewees not-

them had noticed the emotional effects of their mindful behaviors on interactions and relation-

ships," Reina said.
"We found initial evidence that our interviewees' efforts toward bringing their mindfulness into the workplace were seen by their colleagues as having a positive effect." High-quality connections are shown to improve individual functioning, and positively affect group outcomes, such as psychological safety and

In addition to mindfulness arising within an interaction, the

study also found that mindfulness practices could be used to set individuals up for success in future interactions, such as when preparing for a difficult or important conversation.

"Mindfulness reminds us that our thoughts and emotions are complex," Reina said. "They are contextualized by prior events experienced within a social environment, and within this social environment, individuals must be aware of both their own and others' thoughts and emotions in order to navigate these complexities with skill and com-

Personal data of 1 billion Chinese people up for sale on Dark Web

New Delhi/Beijing: In what could be the biggest-ever data breach, sensitive personal information about more than a billion people has been leaked from a government agency, possibly from China, and put up for sale on Dark Web for 10 Bitcoins. Changpeng Zhao, CEO of cryptocurrency exchange Binance, tweeted that their threat intelligence detected 1 billion resident records for sale on the Dark Web. "It includes name, address, national ID, mobile, police and medical records from one Asian country. Likely due to a bug in an ElasticSearch deployment by a government agency," Zhao claimed in his tweet late on Monday. "This has an impact on hacker detection/prevention measures, mobile numbers used for account takeovers, etc. It is important for all platforms to enhance their security measures in this area," he further posted

HANDIGARH: Ankylosing spondylitis (AS) is a chronic, inflammatory disease that causes spinal fusion over time. It refers to abnormal functioning of the body's immune system, where the system starts mistakenly attacking the body's own normal tissues causing inflammation (swelling) of the joints in the spine. It is important to control disease progression, failure to which there is a risk of permanently damaging other organs or body parts such as the heart, eyes, hips, and

Cause of delay in intervention-While lack of awareness is one important factor for delay in diagnosis among Rheumatic diseases, such as Ankylosing Spondylitis, the other factor responsible for the delay is owing to lack of specialists. Despite the growing need, there are less than 1300 practicing rheumatologists in India, with 1 rheumatologist available for more than 0.5 million arthritis patients.2. It is quite alarming, given that rheumatic diseases are rapidly becoming a growing concern in India where

rheumatology practices are still in their infancy. A Rheumatologist is an expert in treating Ankylosing Spondylitis and must be consulted early in the course of illness. Advanced therapies like biologics used by Rheumatologists to help slow down or stop the disease progression altogether. Biologics have been the most significant advancements towards managing the condition, especially for patients who do not respond well to the traditional disease

modifying drugs Dr Ashit Syngle, Senior Consultant Physician and Rheumatologist, Fortis Multispecialty Hospital, Mohali, said, "Rheumatology, not just in India but across the globe lacks adequate awareness and training facilities. The treatment modalities were limited in the early 90s, but this branch has actually grown now with new modalities into practice thus creating more hope for the patients. There are



advanced treatment therapies like the biologics today, that help control the progression of the disease. Lobbying with the government, national medical agencies, and institutions to bring in more seats for rheumatology can help bridge the gap of knowledge around this disease

Gupta also asked the health authorities to make arrangements for new bed sheets in the hospital. In the surgical ward, Sh Gupta found torn sheets on several beds. The State Government had implemented a scheme about one-and-a-half years ago to provide new and different colored beds sheets in government hospitals every day

in a week, he added. During his visit, patients informed Sh Gupta that Air Conditioners in a few wards of the hospital were not working as a result of which they are facing a lot of inconvenience during the summer season. On this, Sh Gupta directed to get all ACs repaired at the earliest. He said that Civil Hospital of Panchkula is among the best government hospitals in the country and lack of facilities in this hospital would not be tolerated at any cost. Besides, Sh Gupta also directed to make arrangement of water coolers in the hospital to provide clean drinking water to the patients and inspected the Special Newborn Care Unit, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit and Emergency Ward in the hospital and took stock of the health facilities there.

While interacting with patients Sh Gupta made them aware about the ill effects of drugs. He reminded them of the seven srokars for Panchkula, which also includes making Panchkula drugs free. During the inspection of the hospital, Sh Gupta interacted with the patients undergoing treatment at de addiction/Psychiatric ward. He interacted with a 22-year-old youth of Manimajra and apprised him of the ill-effects of drugs on health. NEW DELHI: Star Indian shuttler HS Prannoy on Tuesday regained his place in the world's top 20, riding on his consistent show in the international circuit this season. The 29-year-old from Kerala, who had played a pivotal role in India's monumental Thomas Cup win in May, improved two places to 19 in the men's singles rankings. Prannoy, who had reached a career-best ranking of eight in 2018, has been one of the most consistent male shuttlers in the circuit with a series of quarterfinals and semifinals appearance this season. He is now the third highest ranked Indian male shuttler in the world after Lakshya Sen (10th) and Kidambi Srikanth (11th).

Prannoy, who had reached the finals of Swiss Open in March, surpassed Tokyo Olympian B Sai Praneeth (20th).

Two-time Olympic medallist P V Sindhu maintained her seventh spot in the latest chart, while Saina Nehwal also stayed static on 24th. Chirag Shetty and Satwiksairaj Rankireddy were steady on eighth in the men's doubles rankings, while Ashwini Ponnappa and N Sikki Reddy dropped a rung to 24th

Among others, 2014 Commonwealth Games champion Paruppali Kashyap jumped three places to reach the World No. 36 ranking, riding on his second round appearance at the Malaysia Open Super

The Verma brothers -- Sameer and Sourabh -- were the other two Indians inside the world's top 50. While Sameer stayed at 29th, Sourabh was at the 44th position.

Wriddhiman Saha to join Tripura cricket team

Wriddhiman Saha will join the Tripura team as a player-cum-mentor, an official said on Tuesday. A veteran of 40 Tests, Saha has already got the NOC (No Objection Certificate) from the Cricket Association of Bengal (CAB).

Saha, who will turn 38 in October, took a decision to leave Bengal after CAB joint secretary Debabrata 'Debu' Das alleged that the veteran keeper makes excuses to skip domestic matches for the state. An irate Saha wanted an unconditional apology from Das, which he didn't get and when the official was sent as Indian team's administrative manager to England, it broke the proverbial camel's back. He had said he would never keep any grudge against Bengal and would be ready to serve again if needed in the future. Having made his debut against Hyderabad in 2007, the Siliguri-born Saha has featured in 122 first-class and 102 List A games.

Root-Bairstow lead England to historic win, series ends in draw

It was Root who hit Jadeja for the winning single in the 78th

over of the game.

England finished off at 378/3, with Root (142*) and Bairstow (114*) standing tall.

A 150-run stand between Jonny Bairstow and Joe Root helped turn things in favour of England at the end of the final session of Day Four of the ongoing fifth and final Test against India at Edgbaston in Birmingham on

At the end of the day's play, England's score read 259/3, with Root (76*) and Bairstow (72*) standing tall. Indians were left clueless by the determination and strokeplay of both in-form batters.

England resumed things off after Tea at 107/1, with opener Alex Lees (56*) and Ollie Pope (0*) standing unbeaten at the crease.

Simona Halep's serve was working, her returns were landing, and the points were piling up fast. That's a pretty good combination for a player who just advanced to the Wimbledon quarterfinals by winning her 11th straight match at the All England Club but says she is still trying to get back to her best tennis and regain the confidence she lost while injured.

I worked really hard in the past two, three months. I'm really happy with all that I've done, said Halep, who won the Wimbledon championship in 2019 but missed defending her title last year because of a left calf injury. I got the confidence.
