## Shiv Sena leader Sanjay Raut sent to judicial custody till August 22

**MUMBAI:** Shiv Sena MP Sanjay Raut was sent to judicial custody till August 22 in connection with the Patra Chawl land case on Monday.

The Court allowed all the medicines to Shiv Sena leader in Judicial custody which he was allowed in ED custody earlier. Earlier on August 1, Raut was sent to Enforcement Directorate's custody till August 4 in the same case. On the same day, ED produced him before a special sessions court after his arrest.

ED officials raided the Shiv Sena leader's home on July 31, and after detaining and questioning him for several hours, arrested him on August 1. On June 28 this year, Sanjay Raut was summoned by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) in connection with the prevention of the money laundering case pertaining to the Rs 1,034 crore Patra Chawl land scam.

## Himachal cloud burst kills one

**SHIMLA:** One person died two others were injured in a cloudburst in Chamba district of Himachal Pradesh on Monday.

The cloud burst covered the areas of Bhadoga, Kihar, Gulel Pargana, Sijhyani Oargana, Banjala Muhall Kilod, Sarog and Thalan Nallah villages. The State Disaster Management Authority said a 15-year-old boy was killed in Bhadoga village. He was identified as Vijay Kumar. Three bridges and 10 vehicles including two cars, two pick-ups and six motorcycles were washed away or damaged in the cloudburst.

## Sensex climbs 465 points; Nifty above 17,500

**MUMBAI:** Equity benchmark Sensex jumped over 465 points on Monday, tracking gains in index majors HDFC twins and Reliance Industries amid positive global market trends.

The 30-share BSE gauge climbed 465.14 points or 0.80 per cent to finish at 58,853.07. During the day, it jumped 546.97 points or 0.93 per cent to 58,934.90.

The broader NSE Nifty gained 127.60 points or 0.73 per cent to end at 17,525.10.

Mahindra & Mahindra was the biggest gainer from the Sensex pack, climbing 3.13 per cent, followed by Bajaj Finserv, NTPC, Axis Bank, HDFC Bank, Larsen & Toubro, HDFC, Dr Reddy's, IndusInd Bank and Reliance Industries.

State Bank of India, Ultra-Tech Cement, Nestle, Wipro and Power Grid were among the major laggards.

# CWG 2022: PV Sindhu, Lakshya clinch singles gold

Two-time Olympic medallist shuttler P V Sindhu on Monday clinched her maiden women's singles gold at the Commonwealth Games 2022 after beating Canada's Michelle Li in the final.

Sindhu registered straight games 21-15, 21-13 victory over the 2014 CWG champion Michelle Li here at National Exhibition Centre. Indian shuttler Lakshya Sen also clinched the country's second badminton gold of the day, defeating Malaysia's



Ng Tze Yong in the final of the men's singles category at the ongoing Commonwealth Games 2022 in Birmingham on Monday.

Sindhu lost to Saina Nehwal in the final at Gold Coast in 2018 to settle for silver.

The Indian ace has emerged victorious on eight of the 10 occasions she has gone up against Michelle Li.

The Canadian player's last win against Sindhu was the women's singles semifinal at the 2014 CWG.

Post that loss, Sindhu has defeated Michelle in sixth-consecutive

matches including a win in the 2016 Olympics group stage fixture and the 2018 CWG semifinal.

Playing with the strap on her left leg Sindhu was stiffer in movements and looked to play shorter rallies against the world No. 13 Michelle.

Sindhu relied heavily on the mix of cross-court drop shots and smashes to go into the break leading 11-8. The Indian ace then built on it post interval to take the opening game.

While the Indian shuttler remained focused and continued

making pinpoint returns, the Canadian made various unforced errors and failed to squeeze longer rallies out of Sindhu.

However, a 57-stroke rally won by Michelle Li when Sindhu was leading 13-9, turned the momentum towards the Canadian shuttler for a brief time.

The former world champion regrouped quickly to snatch back the initiative and complete the set of medals at the Commonwealth Games. It was PV Sindhu's third win over Michelle Li this year and ninth overall in the 11th meeting.

# Govt recommends Electricity Bill to panel

The Electricity (Amendment) Bill 2022 was on Monday introduced in the Lok Sabha amid vocal opposition, and the government then announced that it will be referred to a Parliamentary Standing Committee where all concerns can be discussed.

Power Minister R K Singh accused the opposition MPs of spreading "false propaganda" against the Bill and said it was "pro-people".

As Singh moved the Bill for introduction in the Lok Sabha, several opposition members raised objections. The Minister said the Bill will be sent to a Parliamentary Standing Committee where all concerns can be discussed.

RSP's N K Premchandran called



it "anti-farmer" and said it was against the federal character of the Constitution.

Congress' Manish Tewari said the object of the Electricity Act was to protect consumers and supply electricity to all areas.

"This amendment substantially weakens the power of the state to

achieve this objective by providing for multiple privately owned distribution companies," he said.

Communist Party of India (Marxist) member A M Arif said detailed discussions should be held with states and also pointed out that withdrawal of the Bill was one of the key demands of farmers. "SKM was assured it would be withdrawn," he said. Congress leader in the House Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury also got up to speak but was told by Rajendra Agrawal who was in the chair that his colleague Manish Tewari had already spoken, triggering protests by opposition benches. Soon Speaker Om Birla was back on the Chair. Trinamool Congress' Saugata Roy also mentioned the farmers' protest and said the government had assured the Samyukt Kisan Morcha in writing

# PM to dedicate 2G ethanol plant in Panipat on August 10

On the occasion of World Biofuel Day, Prime Minister Narendra Modi will dedicate the 2nd generation (2G) Ethanol Plant in Panipat, Haryana to the nation on August 10, 2022, at 4:30 pm via video conferencing, said a press release on Monday.

The dedication of the plant is part of a long series of steps taken by the government over the years to boost

the production and usage of biofuels in the country.

This is in line with the Prime Minister's constant endeavour to transform the energy sector into being more affordable, accessible, efficient and sustainable, added the press release.

The 2G Ethanol Plant has been built at an estimated cost of over Rs.



900 crore by Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. (IOCL) and is located close to the Panipat Refinery.

Based on state-of-the-art indigenous technology, the project will turn a new chapter in India's waste-to-wealth endeavours by utilising about 2 lakh tonnes of rice straw (parali) annually to generate around 3 crore litres of Ethanol annually.

Police arrests 141 POs, absconders  
of NDPS act in one month

As part of its special drive launched on the directions of Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann to arrest Proclaimed offenders POs/absconders in NDPS Act cases, Punjab Police has successfully managed to arrest as many as 141 such POs/Absconders over the last one month, said Inspector General of Police (IGP) Headquarters Dr Sukhchain Singh Gill here on Monday.

Talking about new trends in drug smuggling, Dr Gill, who was addressing a weekly Press Conference said that drug suppliers have started roping in women as an alibi to safely carry out drug trafficking. It has also come to notice that Drug peddlers these days prefer public transport systems for smuggling which require more human intelligence to track them, he added. Giving weekly updates on drugs, he said that Punjab Police have arrested 472 drug smugglers/suppliers after registering 354 first information reports (FIRs), including 36 commercial, under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) act across the state in the last one week.



The Police have also recovered 5.53Kg Heroin, 21.9Kg opium, 21.5 Kg Ganja, six quintals of poppy husk and 1.46 lakh tablets / capsules / injections / vials of Pharma opioids besides recovering Rs 23.37 lakh drug money after carrying out cordon and search operations in drug-affected areas beside laying nakas at vulnerable routes across the state, he said. The IGP said that Punjab Police besides tightening the noose around the drug smugglers/suppliers has also been doing all the possible efforts to keep youth away from drugs besides

helping to rehabilitate those who have already fallen prey to this menace.

He said that all the CPs/SSPs have been conducting different activities including public meetings, visiting drug affected villages, conducting seminars, holding joint meetings with MLAs, Sarpanches and Councillors besides involving NGOs and Youth Clubs to work against drugs at their respective districts to sensitise the youth about the harmful and ill-effects of drugs.

He said that as part of the ongoing campaign against drugs, the Barnala Police has organised a four-day Basketball league under-17 (Boys) to motivate youth towards sports and maintain their physical and mental health.

Similarly, Malerkotla Police has launched a massive anti-drug program under the title of 'Saanjhi Sath' under which every SHO along with his team including one lady Police official visits one village every day in the evening time to meet villagers at any common-place in the village, while, the worst affected or hotspot areas are being visited by the GOs to sensitize people about the ill-effects of drugs and motivating them to stay away from drugs, he added.

Animal farmers should prefer to take  
precautions instead of panic: DC

Deputy Commissioner (DC), Sangrur, Jatindra Jorwal today said to all Sub Divisional Magistrates and Block Development & Panchayat Officers of the district, "There is a need to be more vigilant about Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD) which is spreading in livestock these days so that this disease does not spread in the more affected areas and necessary steps should be taken immediately for it's prevention. He also asked the officials to set up isolation centers at suitable places in case of need".

While issuing instructions to the Deputy Director of the Animal Husbandry Department at the District Administrative Complex, the



DC said, "By creating awareness on a large scale through 66 teams formed at the departmental level, the livestock keepers were alerted about the symptoms and precautions of this disease in cow, dhan, so that if any symptoms are seen, the animal Farmers can carefully separate affected animals from other animals. While appealing to the livestock keepers he said that priority should be given to taking precautions instead of panic. The DC while ordering the

animal husbandry department to speed up the sampling and vaccination of animals said that 4099 vaccinations of livestock were done by the departmental teams in the past, so that the spread of this virus could be stopped. Mr. Jorwal said, "When the symptoms of lumpy skin are found, the sick animals should be isolated from the rest of the animals immediately, apart from separating the affected animals, the materials used by them should also be separated.



Teacher booked for

6 died of corona in seven  
days, 1150 new cases

**DHARAMSHALA:** While the concerns of the Health Department have increased regarding the rapidly increasing corona cases in district Kangra, people are still negligent about following the rules and regulations. In district Kangra, from June to August, all the 11 people who lost their lives from Corona were those people who did not take the full dose of Corona Baxin. This has been disclosed by Dr. Gurudarshan Gupta, CMO of Kangra district during the press conference. He said that none of these people who died of corona had completed all the doses of corona vaccine. He has urged everyone that the person who has not got any corona vaccine so far or someone who has just taken only one dose should complete the corona vaccine immediately. Dr. Gurudarshan Gupta said that so far 68 thousand 762 cases have been reported in the district, out of which 1121 cases are still active. He said that 1256 people have lost their lives from Corona. Day by day increase is being recorded in the cases of corona. He said that only 86 cases of corona were reported in a month which increased to 426 and in the month of July, the number of corona increased to 3217. He said that due to the increased concern for us, so far around 1150 new cases have been reported in the month of August. He said that in the month of May, the corona rate was .8, which increased to 3.4 in June and 12.3 in July and it increased to 30.1 in seven days of August.

## 1.67 lakh more doses of goat pox vaccine to reach Punjab by today morning: Laljit Singh Bhullar

Punjab Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and Dairy Development Minister Laljit Singh Bhullar, on Monday, affirmed that second consignment of 1.67 lakh more doses of Goat Pox vaccine will reach Punjab tomorrow morning i.e. August 9, 2022."Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann led government was making all-out efforts to save cattle from lumpy skin disease, said the cabinet Minister, adding that this vaccine, certified by the Indian Veterinary Research

Institute, Izat Nagar (Uttar Pradesh), is being air-lifted from Ahmedabad, which will reach Chandigarh by the morning of August 9.

He said that senior officials of the department have already been instructed to deliver it well before the same day evening to all the districts and disease-affected areas of the state so that healthy cattle can be protected in advance from the infection. Pertinently, the government has distributed more than 66k doses of Goat Pox vaccine in all the districts, which is being administered to healthy animals free of cost.

Coal scam: Court sentences former  
Coal Secy HC Gupta to 3 years jail

A Special CBI Court of Delhi on Monday awarded three years imprisonment to former Coal Secretary HC Gupta in a coal scam case after finding irregularities in the allocation of a Maharashtra coal block.

The court also awarded two years imprisonment to former joint-Secretary K S. Kropcha and four years to director Mukesh Gupta of Nagpur-based firm M/s Grace Industries Ltd in the coal scam case.

The Special judge Arun Bhardwaj (Coal Scam) Rouse Avenue Court on Monday while pronouncing the Judgement on sentencing also imposed a fine of Rs one lakh on HC Gupta, 50,000 Rs on KS Kropcha, two lakhs on Mukesh Gupta and 2 lakhs on Nagpur based firm M/s Grace Industries Ltd.

The same court last week convicted H C Gupta Under section - 120B and section - 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the



Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, K S. Kropcha, Under section - 120B and section - 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, Mukesh Gupta, Director of M/s Grace Industries Ltd. under section - 120B and section - 420 IPC and M/s Grace Industries Ltd. under section - 120B and section - 420 IPC.

The court convicted them in the Coal Scam case related to the allocation of the Lohara East Coal block situated in Maharashtra. CBI had registered

on September 20, 2012 under section - 120B r/w 420 IPC r/w 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the PC Act, 1988. On completion of the investigation, a charge sheet under section - 420 IPC was filed by CBI against M/s Grace Industries Ltd. and Mukesh Gupta, Director of the company in the Court on October 28, 2014.

Learning machines

The economic downturn caused by Covid-19 was the making of one class of business: the edutech industry. The closedown of schools created a need to teach students remotely. The electronic mode was the only possible means. But the way it was adopted prompts deep misgivings. I am actively involved with computer applications in teaching and research. The promise held out by digital learning excites me. Its progress in India fills me with alarm.

The dismal backdrop to my discussion is the digital divide. We are content that for the poor, a single smartphone should be considered a sufficient educational tool for all students in a household. Even that, a parliamentary committee found last year, eluded 77 per cent of the nation's children.

But today, let us think about the fortunate ones with laptops and smartphones for their sole use. When the pandemic broke, their schools soon switched to online classes. But online teaching implies more than a Zoom meeting. It calls for audio-visual techniques for which most schools had neither expertise nor infrastructure. Plain vanilla classroom teaching falters without a classroom.

That is where edutech companies saw their chance. They applied digital technology expertly and intensively to the curricular content. Their instructors exuded a compelling onscreen presence, as conventional teachers had never learnt to do. The result was a package that captivated both children and parents footing the bill. Both parties were connoisseurs of onscreen content: the children from computer games, the parents from infotainment channels. The superstition is rife anyway that anything emerging from a computer is a superior option. In two short years, hitherto uncontested schooling methods acquired the negative label of 'offline teaching'. But might not the new technology truly be superior? The digital revolution has transformed our lives. In intellectual and cultural matters, however, it has generally modified older practices instead of dislodging them altogether. More books are printed today than ever before, alongside the electronic text and the internet. Live performances flourish despite staggering advances in audio-visual recording. The equation between ageless human practice and digital innovation is subtle and complex. With education, the pandemic drastically short-circuited this adjustment. Throughout history, teaching has implied an interaction between teacher and student. A child learns letters and numbers under a teacher's care among a group of peers.

Chinese oil giant Sinopec to enter Lankan fuel market

As Sri Lanka continues to remain in the Chinese debt trap, the biggest petrochemical company in China, Sinopec, is likely to start retail operations in the Lankan fuel market, local media said citing sources.

The sources said that Sinopec is likely to enter Sri Lankan market for importing, distributing and selling petroleum products, reported Daily Mirror.

This comes as Sri Lankan Cabinet Ministers in the month of June approved a proposal to allow more companies from oil-producing nations to import oil and start retail operations in Sri Lanka.

The proposal was tabled by Power and Energy Minister Kanchana Wijesekera.

It is pertinent to note that the economic crisis which is the worst in Sri Lanka's history has prompted an acute shortage of essential items like fuel. Long queues at fuel stations in Sri Lanka are the new normal and prices fluctuate subject to availability.

The economy of the country is bracing for a sharp contraction due to the unavailability of basic inputs for production, an 80 percent depreciation of the currency since March 2022, coupled into a lack of foreign reserves, and the country's failure to meet its international debt obligations.

This recent decision to let the Chinese enter in Sri Lanka's fuel retail operations is prompted by a severe foreign exchange shortage. At present, 90 percent of Sri Lanka's fuel supply is through the State-owned Ceylon Petroleum Corporation, and the remaining 10 percent by Lanka Indian Oil Corporation (IOC). Sinopec is already present at the Port



of Hambantota where it operates an oil depot.

Since the beginning of 2022, Sri Lanka has experienced an escalating economic crisis and the government has defaulted on its foreign loans. The United Nations warned that 5.7 million people "require immediate humanitarian assistance."

While Sri Lanka faces its worst economic crisis since independence with

food and fuel shortages, China has turned a blind eye to the crisis and shifted the blame to the borrower, a media report said. Amid the pandemic, the country was trying to rebuild its economy, but the tourism industry was hit badly, an article in the Global Strat View think-tank read. Tourism in Sri Lanka supports 10 to 15 per cent of the economy.

The effect of the COVID-19 crisis, the loss of tourists, high government ex-

penditure and tax cuts depleting state revenues, and the use of money for initiatives with minimal returns have all contributed to Sri Lanka's economic meltdown.

Sri Lanka turned to China for help and asked for USD 1 billion loan to meet repayments, and a USD 1.5 billion credit line to buy Chinese goods, however, no progress was attained even after months of negotiations.

People feel less in control initially after breakups



During recent research, a new analysis of people who underwent different types of relationship loss found that these experiences were linked with different patterns of short- and long-term sense of control following the loss.

Eva Asselmann of the HMU Health and Medical University in Potsdam, Germany, and Jule Specht of Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, Germany, presented these findings in the open-access journal PLOS ONE.

Previous research has shown that a greater perceived sense of personal control over one's life is associated with better well-being and better health. Romantic relationships are closely linked to perceived control; for instance, evidence suggests a link between perceived control and better

relationship satisfaction. However, less is known about how the loss of a relationship might be linked to changes in perceived control.

To shed new light, Asselmann and Specht analyzed data from three-time points in a multi-decade study of households in Germany. Specifically, they used yearly questionnaire results from 1994, 1995, and 1996 to evaluate changes in perceived control for 1,235 people who experienced separation from their partner, 423 who divorced, and 437 whose partners passed away. Statistical analysis of the questionnaire results suggests that, overall, people who experienced separation from their partner experienced a drop in perceived control in the first year after separation, followed by a gradual increase in later years.

HK hotels cut Covid quarantine to 3 days



Hong Kong eased its Covid hotel quarantine requirements for people arriving from overseas, Chief Executive John Lee said on Monday. Currently, overseas arrivals have to quarantine for seven days at designated hotels.

Coming Friday, those arriving in the city will have to stay at designated quarantine hotels for three days.

They will then undergo another four days of "medical surveillance" either at home or at any hotel.

During the "medical surveillance" period, people can go out but may not enter places that require vaccine passes to be checked, including bars, gyms and amuse-

ment centres, the BBC reported.

They are also barred from participating in any mask-off activities - such as certain forms of exercise - or entering homes for the elderly or disabled people and designated medical venues.

But if they test negative daily during the four-day period, they can take public transport, go to work and enter shopping centres or public markets.

Lee said that the government would "actively control" the number of Covid cases.

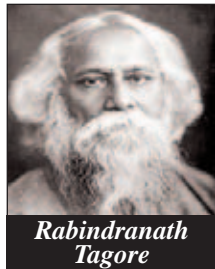

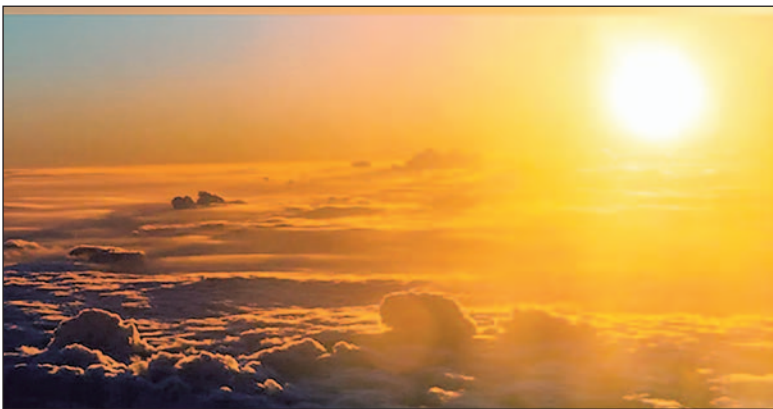
Vitamin D deficiency associated with chronic inflammation: Study

Scientists have discovered a direct link between low levels of vitamin D and high levels of inflammation, providing an important biomarker to identify people at higher risk of or severity of chronic illnesses with an inflammatory component.

The findings of the research were published in the journal 'International Journal of Epidemiology'.

Inflammation is an essential part of the body's healing process. But when it persists, it can contribute to a wide range of complex diseases including type 2 diabetes, heart disease, and autoimmune diseases.

The study examined the genetic data of 294,970 participants in the



UK Biobank, using Mendelian randomization to show the association

between vitamin D and C-reactive protein levels, an indicator of inflam-

mation.

Lead researcher, UniSA's Dr Ang Zhou, said the findings suggest that boosting vitamin D in people with a deficiency may reduce chronic inflammation.

"Inflammation is your body's way of protecting your tissues if you've been injured or have an infection," Dr Zhou said.

"High levels of C-reactive protein are generated by the liver in response to inflammation, so when your body is experiencing chronic inflammation, it also shows higher levels of C-reactive protein.

"This study examined vitamin D and C-reactive proteins and found a one-way relationship between low

levels of vitamin D and high levels of C-reactive protein, expressed as inflammation.

"Boosting vitamin D in people with deficiencies may reduce chronic inflammation, helping them avoid a number of related diseases."

Supported by the National Health and Medical Research Council and published in the International Journal of Epidemiology the study also raises the possibility that having adequate vitamin D concentrations may mitigate complications arising from obesity and reduce the risk or severity of chronic illnesses with an inflammatory component, such as CVDs, diabetes, and autoimmune diseases.

Senior investigator and Director of UniSA's Australian Centre for Precision Health, Professor Elina Hypponen, said these results are important and provide an explanation for some of the controversies in reported associations with vitamin D.

"We have repeatedly seen evidence for health benefits for increasing vitamin D concentrations in individuals with very low levels, while for others, there appears to be little to no benefit." Prof Hypponen said.

"These findings highlight the importance of avoiding clinical vitamin D deficiency, and provide further evidence for the wide-ranging effects of hormonal vitamin D."

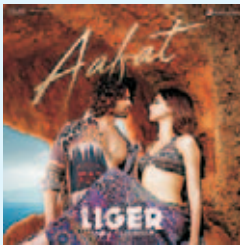

boundaries and asking rate always under check, it was only a matter of time for the Australian bowlers to run through the Indian innings.

India began poorly, losing Smriti Mandhana and Shefali Verma inside the first half of the powerplay.

Harmanpreet and Rodrigues settled in and helped India post a powerplay score of 42/2, only a run behind their opponents. The India captain played the aggressor, while Jemimah played the ideal second fiddle throughout her run-a-ball 33. Harmanpreet looked in total control as she smashed Alana King's first ball back into the attack straight down the ground for four and swatted the last ball flat over deep midwicket, taking India past the 100-run mark in the 14-run 14th over. A desperate Meg Lanning brought in experienced Schutt and broke the third-wicket stand that was nearing century, turning the game on its head.

## Sasikiran, Erigaisi help India bounce back to beat Brazil at 44th Chess Olympiad

**MAMALLAPURAM** : Riding on Krishnan Sasikiran and Arjun Erigaisi's victories, India A got back their rhythm to trounce Brazil by 3-1 in the ninth-round match of the open section at the 44th Chess Olympiad in Mamallapuram, Tamil Nadu on Sunday.

Coming into the match after a loss to Armenia on Saturday, India A started off the game on a winning note when Sasikiran raked in the first point against Andre Diamant in a Nimzo Indian game.

Things appeared to move sedately when a couple of consecutive wrong moves by the bishops on the 42nd and 43rd turn allowed Sasikiran to gain advantage and convert it to victory on the 49th turn.

Erigaisi, on the other hand, went the English way against Sevag Krikor Mekhitarian. After the opponent castled late on the 25th turn, Erigaisi won an exchange and needed 63 moves to force victory.

The other two players, Pentala Harikrishna and Vidit Gujrathi were held to draws in their respective games. Sasikiran shrugged off yesterday's debacle against Armenia, saying: "Sometimes these things happen but we always try to overcome such difficulties as a team by going for a long walk. I am happy that the team is cohesive, we always eat together and discuss a lot of things together." India C also emerged victorious as they thrashed Paraguay by 3-1.

Meanwhile, R Praggnanandhaa defeated Vasif Durarbayli as India B held sixth-seeded Azerbaijan to a 2-2 draw. D Gukesh's winning run came to an end after he conceded his first draw of the event against Shakhriyar Mamedyarov in a well-fought game. Nihal Sarin was also held to a draw by Rauf Mamedov while Raunak Sadhwani ended on the losing side against Nijat Abasov. In another open section match, the USA shrugged off Saturday's loss against India by registering a 2.5-1.5 win against Greece.

Currently, Uzbekistan are sole leaders in the open section with 16 points followed by India B and Armenia with 15 points each. In the women's section, India B and India C defeated Switzerland and Estonia by 4-0 and 3-1 respectively while India A suffered a 1.5-2.5 loss to fourth seed Poland. In one of the crucial games, second seed Ukraine was held to a 2-2 draw by Georgia and thus, India A continued to be at the top position in the women's section but are now joined by Georgia, Poland and Kazakhstan, all having scored 15 points each.
