## Sisodia among 15 persons named in CBI FIR in Delhi excise policy case

Central Bureau of Investigation has registered an FIR against Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia and 14 others in connection with an alleged excise policy case.

Excise officials, liquor company executives, dealers along with unknown public servants and private persons have too been booked in the case.

The aforementioned facts prima facie disclose the commission of offences punishable under section 120-B, 477A IPC and section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 (As amended in 2018).

A total of 15 persons have been named in the FIR including Sisodia for criminal conspiracy, falsification of account and undue advantage.

### Raghav Chadha accuses BJP of misusing central agency

**NEW DELHI:** As Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia came under the CBI's radar and a raid was conducted at Sisodia's residence, the leaders from the Aam Admi Party sounded on one track and so did AAP Member of Parliament Raghav Chadha who lauded the Delhi government led education revolution in the region and said that there were many such raids in the last eight years that resulted in nothing.

The AAP leader also hailed Sisodia's efforts as the education minister and said that the Kejriwal-led government was attracting international acclaim.

"In today's New York Times, there has been a lot of applause for the education revolution of the Kejriwal government. The same morning the BJP's CBI raided the house of Manish Sisodia, the hero of that education revolution," tweeted Chadha.

He further stated that the party is ready for cooperating during the raids.

Pernod Ricard, Amandeep Dhal, Director, Brindco Sales Pvt. Ltd, Sameer Mahendru, Managing Director, Indospirit Group have been mentioned in the FIR copy.

Other names which are included in the FIR are Amit Arora, Director, Buddy Retail Private Limited, Buddy Retail Private Limited, Dinesh Arora, Mahadev Liquors, Sunny Marwah, Authorised Signatory, Arun Ramchandra Pilla, and Arjun Pandey.

Other known public servants and public persons have also been mentioned in the FIR.

Meanwhile, according to a CBI official, searches were conducted in seven States and a Union Territory, including the premises of former Delhi Excise Commissioner Arava Gopi Krishna under whose tenure, the revamped Excise Policy was approved.

Sisodia had in a tweet this morning said that CBI officials had arrived at his residence and had begun searches. "CBI has arrived. We are honest, building a future for lakhs of children.

Unfortunately that in this country, whoever does good work is hassled just like this, that is why our country is still not number-1," the deputy chief minister tweeted.

## Water scarcity obstacle on path to 'developed India': Modi

Reiterating the need for a long-term approach above selfish short-term approach, the Prime Minister emphasized, "It is true that to form a government, one does not have to work that hard as one has to work to build a country. We have all chosen to work for nation building. That is why we are working on the challenges of the present and the future."

## J-K Hawala operator involved in funding of LeT, Al-Badr arrested

In a joint operation between Delhi Police and Jammu and Kashmir Police in assistance with the central agencies, a Hawala operator has been arrested, said officials on Friday.

The accused was allegedly involved in the funding of Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) and Al-Badr terror outfits.

The accused has been identified as Mohammad Yaseen and was arrested from Jammu bus stand along with the terror funding amount of Rs 10 lakh. "Working as an agent in Hawala transactions related to the funding of terror outfits LeT and Al Badr Mohd Yaseen has been apprehended. On 17th Aug 2022, Mohd Yasin gave around Rs 10 lakh to a terror operative Abdul Hamid Mir of Jammu and Kashmir for further use in terrorist activities in the state. In this regard, J&K Police registered a case vide FIR No. 37/2022, dt. 18/08/2022, u/s 13/17/18/40 UA(P) Act, PS

Bus Stand, Jammu and Abdul Hamid Mir r/o Mendhar, Poonch, J&K has been arrested from Jammu Bus Stand along with the terror funding amount of Rs 10 lakh," said a statement. The officials also informed that the money illegally funded from overseas sources was used for funding terror-related activities in the valley. The accused was under cover as a garment trader by profession and was operating from Meena Bazar, Delhi. He worked as a conduit for Hawala money, collecting funds received from sources based abroad and further delivering them to terror operatives in the valley.

## 14 cases registered for using fake documents during Army recruitment

**CHANDIGARH, AUG 19** - Under the Agneepath Scheme, 14 cases of candidates using fake documents to get admission into ongoing Indian Army Recruitment drive at Hisar were caught on Friday. It has been alleged that the candidates have made attempts to enter the recruitment drive using fake or tampered admit cards.

An official spokesperson of Indian Army Recruitment Office said that Army Recruitment

## Rahul Gandhi office vandalism case: 4 Cong workers arrested

Four Congress workers, including two members of party leader Rahul Gandhi's staff, were arrested for allegedly vandalising a picture of Mahatma Gandhi in his Wayanad office, Kerala Police said on Friday.

The incident had occurred on June 24 after which Congress had claimed that workers of the SFI were responsible.

"Four Congress workers including MP Rahul Gandhi's staff have been arrested for vandalising a picture of Mahatma Gandhi in his Wayanad office," said a police official.

Following the incident, several videos went viral on social media that showed angry SFI protesters entering Rahul Gandhi's office and a heated altercation that ensued. Visuals of protestors, allegedly belonging to the Students' Federation of India (SFI), the student's wing of the ruling CPI(M), entering the office of Congress leader Rahul Gandhi also went viral



on social media. Rahul, who reached Wayanad on July 1, had also visited the office at Kalpetta later. "This is my office. But before being my office, this is the office of the people of Wayanad. It is quite unfortunate that the office has been attacked. Violence will never resolve problems. It is not good that they have acted in an irresponsible manner. I don't have any anger or hostility towards them. They are kids and they don't understand the consequences of their act," he said without referring to either SFI or CPI(M). The Kerala police had said that a protest march of around 100 Students' Federation of India (SFI) activists was on and they barged into the office.

## Vigilance unearths vehicles' fitness certificate scam in RTA office Sangrur

Aiming to eradicate corruption in the state the Punjab Vigilance Bureau (VB) during its ongoing campaign has unearthed a scam in Regional Transport Authority (RTA) office Sangrur and registered a criminal case against the RTA, Motor Vehicle Inspector (MVI), two clerks, two middlemen and private agents. In this case the VB has arrested two employees of this office and a middleman.

Disclosing this here today a spokesperson of the State Vigilance Bureau said in this scam involvement of RTA Sangrur, MVI, their clerical staff and private persons has come to light who in connivance with each other



used to collect bribes from various agents operating in the State for issuing fitness certificates to different types of vehicles without following prescribed rules of the state government. He informed that as per rules of transport department all commercial vehicles had to obtain fitness certificate from the RTA office in order to ply on the roads and all such vehicles along with their documents have to be physically inspected by the MVI in his office. Revealing the modus operandi he added that these officials in connivance with agents and middlemen were blatantly issuing fitness certificates without any physical verification of vehicles in lieu of bribes ranging from Rs 2800 to Rs 1000 per vehicle depending on model of vehicle.



### Gold falls Rs 389; silver plunges Rs 1,607

**NEW DELHI:** Gold prices declined Rs 389 to Rs 51,995 per 10 grams in the national capital on Friday following weak global cues, according to HDFC Securities.

The yellow metal had closed at Rs 52,384 per 10 grams in the previous trade.

Silver also plunged Rs 1,607 to Rs 56,247 per kg from Rs 57,854 per kg in the previous trade. In the international market, gold was trading lower at USD 1,753 per ounce while silver was flat at USD 19.23 per ounce. "Gold prices traded under pressure over stronger dollar," said Tapan Patel, Senior Analyst (Commodities) at HDFC Securities.

### Heavy rainfall predicted in HP

**SHIMLA:** The India Meteorological Department (IMD) on Friday warned of very heavy rains besides landslides, flash floods and cloudburst in the next 48 hours in Himachal Pradesh. The bad weather has been predicted for Kangra, Chamba, Mandi, Kullu, Shimla, Sirmour, Solan, Hamirpur, Una, Bilaspur and adjacent areas.

Ten people were struck at Neugal Khadd due to a steady increase in the water level in Kangra district. A landslide occurred at Malakbaa in Chamba district, blocking a road. Heavy rains have already lashed Manali and Dharmshala.

### Flesh trade racket busted in Shimla, 4 held

**SHIMLA:** Himachal Pradesh police busted a flesh trade racket in Shimla and rescued three women who were forced into prostitution, Superintendent of Police, Shimla, Monika Bhutnagur, said on Friday.

She added that four persons were held by the police.

A case was registered at police station Sadar under section four of PITA & 370 IPC Act.

She said that after receiving an input about the crime in Shimla, a team consisting Cyber Cell Shimla and SIU Shimla was constituted. The team busted the sex racket and 4 accused, residents of Rajasthan and UP, were arrested who were running the racket and 3 women were also rescued. Further investigation is going on.

### Mirwaiz not under house arrest: LG

**SRINAGAR:** Jammu and Kashmir Lt Governor Manoj Sinha has said that Kashmiri separatist leader Mirwaiz Umar Farooq is not under house arrest. "He (Umar Farooq) is not under house arrest... His father was killed in an unfortunate incident. Police are placed around him (Mirwaiz) for his protection," Sinha told BBC.

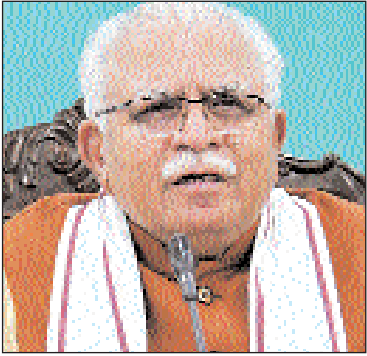

Govt committed to safeguard  
interests of horticulturists: CM

The State Government was committed to safeguard the interests of the farmers and horticulturists by providing ample facilities of marketing, cold storage and CA Stores so as to give boost to their economy. This was stated by the Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur at Oakover today, while addressing a deputation of BJP workers of Jubbil-Nawar-Kotkhai area, led by Chetan Bragta.

Chief Minister said that the state government was reimbursing 6 percent subsidy on purchase of packaging material like cartons and trays, whether purchased through HPMC or open market with effect from 1st April, 2022. He said that horticulturists would have to produce GST paid bill of cartons and trays, sale proof and Aadhar linked bank account details, to get the subsidy. This would provide a big relief to the horticulturalists of the State, added Chief Minister.

Poultry training center to be built in Takarla: Kanwar

Rural Development, Panchayati Raj, Agriculture, Fisheries and Animal Husbandry Minister Virendra Kanwar has said that a training center for poultry farming will be set up at Takarla in district Una. He said that the process of transferring the land in the name of the Central Government for setting up the training center is going on and soon all this process will be completed. Virendra Kanwar said this while addressing a program in Upper Basal. He said that under the leadership of Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur, development works worth crores of rupees have been done in Gram Panchayat Basal in the last four and a half years. He said that a Dairy



Excellence Center is being set up in Basal at a cost of Rs 47 crore, for which an agreement has been signed between the Government of India and Denmark. Robots will do all the work in the Dairy Excellence Center and this center will be fully automated. He said that sub-divisions of Jal Shakti Department, Electricity Department and Public Works Department have been opened in Basal during the tenure of the present government. Along with this, a training center is

also being constructed for the training of Panchayat representatives with an investment of Rs.8 crore. He said that the primary health center has been constructed in Basal itself at a cost of Rs one crore. Apart from this, the State Government is constructing Bamboo Village in Ghandawal, which will provide direct and indirect employment opportunities to about 2500 persons. Kanwar said that the state government has reduced the age of social security pension from 80 years

Police crack kidnapping of

In yet another success in the ongoing drive against anti-social elements launched on the directions of Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann, the Punjab Police on Friday cracked the kidnapping case of a Kharar youth in less than 48-hours after arresting three accused persons who had honey-trapped him.

DIG AGTF-cum-Ropar Range Gurpreet Singh Bhullar said that the Police teams have safely rescued the victim identified as Hitesh Bhumla, a student of B.E. at Chandigarh University Gharuan, who was held captive in sedated condition at a rented accommodation in Ranjit Nagar, Kharar. The kidnappers were demanding Rs 50 lakh as ransom from the parents of the boy. Those arrested have been identified as Ajay Kadian (25) of village



Jattal in Panipat, Haryana; Ajay (22) of village Aabood in Sirsa, Haryana; and Rakhi of village Baroli in Sonapat, Haryana. The Police have also recovered one Honda City Car, five mobile Phones and one .32 bore pistol along with nine bullets from their possession. The DIG, while addressing a press conference said that the police had received a complaint from Hitesh's parents that their son had gone missing and kidnappers are demanding Rs 50 lakhs ransom from them. Acting promptly, the Police teams

have registered the first information report (FIR) under sections 364-A and 365 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) at Police Station Sadar Kharar, and immediately different police teams were formed and an intelligence led operation was initiated, he said.

He said that the team led by DSP Gursheer Singh, In-charge CIA Inspector Shiv Kumar, along with teams of CIA, Kurukshetra was able to nab the accused and recover the victim in early morning on Friday. It bears special mention that District Police Am-

bala, Haridwar and Ghaziabad were active in identifying and nabbing the accused, he added. SSP Mohali Vivek Sheel Soni said that, during investigation, it has been found that the girl Rakhi had made fake social media profiles and after befriending the target on Instagram and Facebook, lured him into meeting her. "Upon meeting, she along with her accomplices kidnapped the victim and demanded ransom from his parents to release him," he said. Further investigations are on, he added.

Patiala admn gears up against African swine fever

The Deputy Commissioner of Patiala Sakshi Sahni today issued necessary guidelines after meeting with the officials of Animal Husbandry Department after the occurrence of African swine fever in pigs in the areas of Cheeka Road, Bilaspur village and Sanauri Adda.

The Deputy Commissioner said that the African Swine Fever disease has been notified by the government. Therefore, according to the law and according to the instructions received, action is being taken by the department from the source of spread of the disease to the affected zone and surveillance zones.

Sakshi Sahni further said that according to the reports available till date, there is no threat of African swine fever disease to humans. He appealed to the animal breeders in the district to contact the



nearest veterinary institute in case of high fever, blood spots on the ears or stomach of pigs and sudden large number of deaths in pigs. Apart from this, the helpline phone number 0175-2970225 can be contacted for more information.

The Deputy Commissioner said that as per the issued guidelines, keeping in mind the health of healthy pigs and as a precautionary measure to prevent the spread of the disease, persons engaged in pig rearing shall not go out of the disease-affected area and out-

siders shall not enter the disease-affected area. He issued orders that there will be a ban on all types of transportation of pigs, including bringing pigs and products made from pigs from the neighboring states of district Patiala. Transportation of any live or dead pig (wild boar etc.), pig meat, pig feed, pig farm equipment/machinery from the affected area to outside or from outside the affected area to the affected area will also be prohibited.

The Deputy Commissioner said that blood and nasal swab samples are being taken as a precautionary measure within a radius of 10 km of the affected area by the Animal Husbandry Department. In a meeting, the DC directed the Deputy Assistant of Animal Husbandry Department, Gurcharan Singh, Director Dr. Gurdarshan Singh and Veterinary Officer Dr. Jeevan Gupta to observe strict compliance the received instructions.

Advisory issues regarding disposal of carcasses of dead animals due to lumpy skin disease

DALJEET AJNOHA HOSHIARPUR, AUG 19

District Magistrate Sandeep Hans has issued orders to implement the advisory issued by the Director Animal Husbandry Department regarding the disposal of carcasses of animals killed due to lumpy skin disease in the district. In the issued orders, he said that in the last time, there have been many deaths of animals due to lumpy skin disease in the state, therefore, under biosecurity measures, the advisory and guidelines issued for disposal of carcasses of animals killed in lumpy skin disease should be adopted. The District Magistrate ordered that the best way to dispose of

the carcasses of animals killed by this disease is to bury the carcass in a pit. He said that before burying the dead body in the pit, it is necessary to take care of some important things. He said that it is important that the area where pits have been dug to suppress cattle should be at least 250 meters away from the population and water source. He said that the pit dug for suppressing the cattle should be 4-6 feet above the water level and it should not be in a bottom pit or in a flooded area. Sandeep Hans said that the size of the pit dug for crushing the cattle should be larger than the size of the animal, so that all the parts of the carcass of the animal are completely inside.

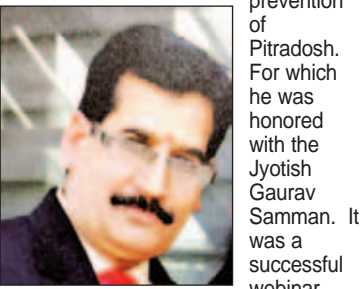

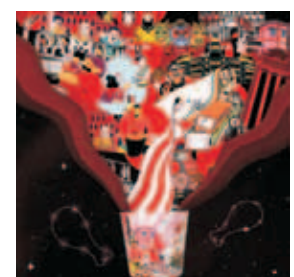

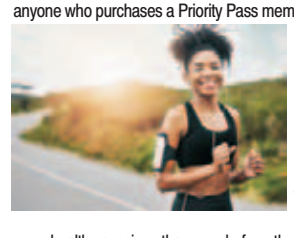

Double trouble

How are we supposed to deal with long, dry spells as well as sudden and extreme rainfall in the same season? Or drought in one state and floods in another, for that matter? While the Bharatiya Janata Party and the Opposition continue with their political machinations, the larger issues before the people on the ground at this point are these: climatic aberrations and consequent losses. We'd do well to smell the coffee and see the elephant in our drawing rooms.

June saw the country receiving abysmal rains, paralysing kharif sowings; central India was badly affected. There was no government in place in Maharashtra at that time. Sowings came a dud, prompting hundreds of thousands of farmers to go for a resowing because the rains failed to show up on time. Then, it started raining cats and dogs in July for long stretches without any let up, leading to floods, soil erosion and flattening everything that had just germinated.

Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, southern Madhya Pradesh and parts of Chhattisgarh have seen massive soil erosion — topsoil washed away with heavy rains, leading to a crisis that will take years before it can be undone. If you lose topsoil, you lose much of your income for years. It's mid-August and many parts of India have witnessed both long, dry spells and extreme to heavy rainfall, causing flash floods that washed away topsoil — over 1.5 million hectares in Maharashtra alone by preliminary estimates — and led to irreversible devastation of kharif crops.

Jharkhand, for instance, is experiencing drought. It hasn't rained there yet and farmers growing paddy in that state are on the brink. Down south or to the west, in Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Maharashtra, farmers have begun offering prayers for the rains to abate. Some areas haven't seen a break from the rain for almost a month now — this is bad for agriculture and surely bad for livestock keepers.

Luckily there hasn't been much loss of life, except in a few sporadic cases, but crop, material and property losses in central India are unprecedented, yet not reported. In Chandrapur, a district with forests and mines, several seasonal rivers are overflowing. So much so that many villages have lost contact with the nearest cities. This, they'd not seen in ages. Unchecked sand mining from river beds has played its part. Extreme rainfall events made it worse.

A young doctor who is part of a network that volunteers to provide medical services in flood- or rain-affected parts of India, put it this way: "Assam, Chittoor, Wardha, Bhandara... the list is long where flash floods caused by extreme and sudden rains have caused immense turmoil and pain to the very poor people.

China under heat wave

Amid a record heat wave, metro stations in Chengdu the capital city of China's Sichuan province have dimmed their lights to save electricity.

The rail system of southwestern city of Chengdu started operating on "power-saving" mode on Wednesday, activating low-power lights and regulating temperatures in stations and train compartments, its operator said in a statement, without specifying how long the measures would last, reported CNN.

The city is home to about 21 million people and the move to dim lights in the Chengdu subway has left travellers in partial darkness.

Photos circulated on social media showed commuters waiting for trains on dimly lit platforms and transiting through darkened stations -- a sharp contrast to the bright fluorescent lighting and illuminated advertising typical of China's public transport stations.

The energy-saving measures are among many being rolled out amid a power shortage caused by China's fiercest regional heat wave in six decades.

Sizzling temperatures above 40 degrees Celsius (104 degrees Fahrenheit) have hit dozens of cities across parts of southwest, central and eastern China, and surging demand for air conditioning is putting pressure on the power grid.

The power crisis has been compounded by a drought, as depleted water levels in the Yangtze River, one of China's most commercially important waterways, and connected water bodies, have reduced the amount of electricity produced at hydropower plants, reported CNN.

Top provincial officials warned Sichuan is facing the "most severe and extreme moment" in power supply, Sichuan Daily reported.

A commentary published by the outlet, the province's official propaganda news arm, called for government offices not to set their air conditioning units any lower than 26 degrees Celsius (78.8 Fahrenheit) and to minimize their elevator use, advising those on lower floors to take

the stairs. It also urged sports and commercial venues to reduce lighting and the use of high-powered electric equipment, turn off fountains, and cut down on nighttime activities, reported CNN.

Moreover, in nearby Chongqing city, authorities ordered factories to suspend operations for seven days to conserve electricity, according to state media.

For one week from Wednesday, all factories in Chongqing should "leave power to the people," a reference to ensuring sufficient electricity is available for residential use, according to state media outlet The Paper, which cited a Chongqing government notice.

The move followed a similar step in Sichuan, which is a key semiconductor and solar panel manufacturing location, as well as lithium mining hub. Authorities

there ordered all factories to cease operations for six days this week to ease a power shortage in the region, reported CNN.

The heat wave is showing no immediate signs of abating, with China's Meteorological Administration on Thursday issuing its highest heat warning, a red alert heat, to at least 237 cities and counties across the country.

A red alert is activated when temperatures are forecast to exceed 40 degrees Celsius, reported CNN.

Another 432 cities and counties were issued the second-highest orange alert warning, where high temperatures were forecast of around 37 degrees Celsius (98 degrees Fahrenheit).

Ground temperatures in China have been rising faster than the global average, government scientists said, and the latest

How dinosaurs carried such enormous burdens



Scientists have cracked an enduring mystery, discovering how sauropod dinosaurs like Brontosaurus and Diplodocus supported their gigantic bodies on land.

A University of Queensland and Monash University-led team used 3D modelling and engineering methods to digitally reconstruct and test the function of the foot bones of different sauropods.

Dr Andreas Jannel conducted the research during his PhD studies at UQ's Dinosaur Lab and said the team found that the hind feet of sauropod had a soft tissue pad beneath the 'heel', cushioning the foot to absorb their immense weight. "We've finally confirmed a long-suspected idea and

we provide, for the first time, biomechanical evidence that a soft tissue pad -- particularly in their back feet would have played a crucial role in reducing locomotor pressures and bone stresses," Dr Jannel said.

"It is mind-blowing to imagine that these giant creatures could have been able to support their own weight on land." Sauropods were the largest terrestrial animals that roamed the Earth for more than 100 million years.

They were first thought to have been semi-aquatic with water buoyancy supporting their massive weight, a theory disproved by the discovery of sauropod tracks in terrestrial deposits in the mid-twentieth century.

Banana peels make sugar cookies more healthful

During a recent study, researchers showed that incorporating banana peel flour into sugar cookie batter makes the treats more healthful.

In taste tests, cookies enriched with some banana peel flour were more satisfying than those baked with wheat flour alone. The findings of the study were reported in ACS Food Science and Technology.

Banana peels aren't always destined for the trash or compost anymore. They're making their way onto people's plates, replacing pork in 'pulled peel' sandwiches and getting fried up into 'bacon'.

Interest in plant-based diets and reducing food waste is increasing, and people want creative ways to use every part of their vegetables and fruits. Banana peels are one such waste that chefs and home cooks have been experimenting with, but these skins are extremely fibrous, making them unpleasant to eat raw.

Recently, scientists found that they can grind the peels into a flour that's rich in fibre, magnesium, potassium and antioxidant compounds. And when small amounts of wheat flour in breads and cakes were replaced with the new flour, the baked goods were more nutritious and had acceptable flavors. However, similar experiments haven't been widely done with cookies. So, Faizan Ahmad and colleagues wanted to substitute some of the wheat flour in sugar cookies with banana peel flour, assessing the cookies' nutritional quality, shelf stability and consumer acceptance. To make banana peel flour, the researchers peeled ripe, undam-



aged bananas and then blanched, dried and ground the skins into a fine powder. They mixed together different amounts of the powder with butter, skimmed milk powder, powdered sugar, vegetable oil and wheat flour, creating five batches of sugar cookies, and baked them.

Increasing the amount of the banana peel flour from 0 to 15 per cent in the batches produced browner and harder products, which could be a result of the increased fibre content from the peels. In addition, cookies with banana peel flour were more healthful, having less fat and protein, higher amounts of phenols and better antioxidant activities than the conventional ones.

A trained panel determined that cookies with the smallest substitution of banana peel flour (7.5 per cent) had the best texture and highest overall acceptability compared to the other batches. This batch also kept well for three months at room temperature, it tasted the same as the wheat-only versions after the lengthy storage period. Because cookies can be enriched with some banana peel flour without impacting their consumer acceptance, the researchers say this addition could make these baked goods more nutritious.



Daily activity is more beneficial than longer periods of exercise

New research indicates a little bit of daily activity is more beneficial than longer periods of exercise spread out across the week and happily, it also suggests you don't have to put in a mountain of work every day.

It's a dilemma faced by many health-conscious people and new research from Edith Cowan University (ECU) is answering the question. This latest research indicates a little bit of daily activity could well be the most beneficial approach, at least for muscle strength. And happily, it also suggests you don't have to put in a mountain of work every day. In collaboration with Niigata University and Nishi



Kyushu University in Japan, the four-week training study had three groups of participants performing an arm resistance exercise and changes in muscle strength and muscle thickness were measured and compared.

The exercise consisted of 'maximal voluntary eccentric bicep contractions' performed on a machine which measures muscle strength in each muscle contraction you would do at the gym.

An eccentric contraction is when the muscle is lengthening; in this case, like lowering a heavy dumbbell in a bicep curl. Two groups performed 30 contractions per week, with one group doing six contractions a day for five days a week (6x5 group), while the other crammed all 30 into a single day, once a week (30x1 group).

Another group only performed six contractions one day a week. After four weeks, the group doing 30 contractions in a single day did not show any increase in muscle strength, although muscle thickness (an indicator of increase in muscle size) increased 5.8 per cent. The group doing six contractions once a week did not show any changes in muscle strength and muscle thickness. However, the 6x5 group saw significant increases in muscle strength -- more than 10 per cent -- with an increase in muscle thickness similar to the 30x1 group. Frequency, not volume. Importantly, the increase in muscle strength of the 6x5 group was similar to the group in a previous study that performed only one three-second maximal eccentric contraction per day for five days a

week for four weeks.

ECU Exercise and Sports Science Professor Ken Nosaka said these studies continue to suggest very manageable amounts of exercise done regularly can have a real effect on people's strength. "People think they have to do a lengthy session of resistance training in the gym, but that's not the case," he said. "Just lowering a heavy dumbbell slowly once or six times a day is enough." Professor Nosaka said while the study required participants to exert maximum effort, early findings from current, ongoing research indicated similar results could be achieved without needing to push as hard as possible.

## Medvedev sinks Shapovalov to book Cincinnati Masters QFs spot

World No. 1 Daniil Medvedev on Thursday produced a great performance in the Western and Southern Open to defeat Denis Shapovalov of Canada in a thrilling hard-fought clash.

The 26-year-old overwhelmed Canadian Shapovalov 7-5, 7-5 in one hour and 45 minutes clash to book a spot in the quarter-finals.

Medvedev shot his flat backhand with consistency, while he stood deep behind the baseline on return to dismiss Canadian's lefty serve and piercing forehand.

In a hard-fought first clash, Shapovalov constantly tried to pull Medvedev around the court, dancing around the ball to strike his forehand into the corners. However, the top seed has become famous for being able to dig deep and perform well under pressure.

Medvedev's watertight ground-strokes forced the Canadian to make one error to multiple on serve at 5-5. Medvedev then swept through his final service game to advance.

World No. 1 will next play American Taylor Fritz after the Indian Wells champion edged Andrey Rublev in three sets.

"The match was pretty tight. I felt that it was a great level. I felt that he was missing a bit more than me but making more points, but that is how Shapo plays," Medvedev said in his on-court interview.

"My goal was to stay there at every point possible and try and put pressure on him when I had the chance. But there were many points where I was just running across the baseline, trying to get back his shots. Generally happy with the level," he added.

On the other hand, Stefanos Tsitsipas advanced to the quarter-finals with a dominant 6-3, 6-3 win against Diego Schwartzman.



## Madison Keys ousts World No.1 Iga Swiatek

**CINCINNATI:** Madison Keys toppled reigning World No.1 Iga Swiatek in the third round of the Western and Southern Open on Thursday. Keys registered a 6-3, 6-4 straight-set victory over Swiatek to enter the quarterfinals.

Keys took 10 games in a row in the middle of the match after Swiatek led 3-2 in the first set. The first six games went with a serve—in which Keys erased the only break point either player shot, in the fourth game—and soon found herself ahead, 6-3, 5-0.

I obviously have not had the best success against World No. 1s, so being able to get a win against Iga, especially after having two losses to her already, means a lot to me, and I think I'm playing some pretty good tennis," WTA.com quoted Keys as saying. "I was really just thinking that I had to focus a lot on why I got in the position of being up 5-Love.

## NZC announces New Zealand A squad for India tour

New Zealand Cricket on Thursday announced the A squad for the India tour.

The A squad featuring seven players with international experience has been selected to tour India for red and white ball fixtures in September.

The matches, all against India A, will be the first time a New Zealand A side has played overseas since the 2018 tour to the United Arab Emirates to play Pakistan A.

Alongside the players with full International experience, the squad also features five players with a chance to represent New Zealand A for the first time: Chad Bowes, Matt Fisher, Ben Lister, Robbie O'Donnell and Joe Walker.

Wellington Firebirds pace-bowler Logan van Beek returns to the NZ A programme after stints with the Netherlands, with the ICC eligibility rules allowing him to play

for both sides concurrently.

Tom Bruce (Central Districts) and Robbie O'Donnell (Auckland) have been named co-captains for the tour which departs on Friday, August 26. New Zealand A last toured India in 2017 and this visit will feature a similar structure, with three four-day matches and three one-day matches in Bangalore and Chennai, respectively. New Zealand selector Gavin Larsen, who will head away with the side as part of the support staff, said the tour represents a huge development opportunity for the playing and coaching group.

"It's great to have A fixtures back on the touring calendar and even more exciting to have the team playing in foreign conditions," Larsen said.

"This programme and tours like these are vital in developing our people and giving them opportunities to test themselves against quality opposition. We have an exciting mix in this group, including players who dominated our last home season

such as Robbie O'Donnell and Tom Bruce, alongside emerging talents in Matt Fisher and Joe Walker," he added. Larsen noted players such as Mark Chapman, Jacob Duffy and Dane Cleaver had experienced success with the BLACKCAPS during the recent series in Europe, and said their experience would be invaluable within this group. "With a mix of red ball and white ball matches it's a great chance to see the players in a variety of situations against what we know will be a very strong home side. The conditions present a great opportunity for the spin bowling group in particular, ahead of future tours and ICC events in the subcontinent," said Larsen.
