Delhi Police busts gang of cyber cheats

NÉW DELHI: Delhi Police busted a gang of cyber cheats that allegedly duped more than 200 people including a retired ACP of Delhi Police on the pretext of delivering liquor on their doorstep. Police arrested 23-yearold Azharuddin Khan from Jhenjpuri Kaman, District Bharatpur, Rajasthan, and recovered 3 Android mobile phones and one basic keypad phone. The cyber cell of the Delhi police received a complaint through the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP) by a retired ACP of the Delhi Police and started investigating

CBI to probe 'irregularities' in buying 1,000 low-floor buses by AAP govt

AGENCY NEW DELHI, SEPT 11

The Lieutenant Governor (LG) of Delhi VK Saxena has approved the proposal to forward a complaint to the CBI about the alleged irregularities in the procurement of 1,000 low-floor buses by the Delhi Transport Corporation

The complaint was registered by the Chief Secretary of Delhi Transport Corporation.

The complaint was filed on June 9, which stated the appointment of the Minister of Transport as the Chairman of the Committee for tendering and procurement of buses by DTC was done in a "premediated manner". Irregularities in the bid of July

2019 for procurement of 1000 low floor BS-IV and BS-VI buses and a bid of March 2020 for purchase and annual maintenance contract of low floor BS-VI buses, read the complaint. The said complaint was for-

warded to the Chief Secretary on July 11 for eliciting comments from the concerned departments of the Government of N.C.T of Delhi (GNCTD) and recommend the way forward.

The report, thus, substantiated the claims made in the complaint.



The same discrepancies were clearly brought out in a report by the Deputy Commissioner, DTC.

There were various irregularities found after a detailed examination of the documents by DTC.

The discrepancy in the document read, "The DTC had floated the tender with RFP No CGM/SBU/924/2019/AC for procurement of 1000 buses and it was a single tender for supply of 1000 BS-IV or latest buses. In the prebid, the quantity of 1000 buses was bifurcated into 400 BS-IV buses and 600 BS-VI buses but the tender still remained one only and the bidders could have made the bid for the entire quantity of

these buses of both types".

Another irregularity that was

found was that M/s TATA Motors Ltd made a bid for 600 buses only. At the same time, JBM made a bid for 1000 buses (400 BS-IV and 600 BS-VI) at a rate higher than Tata Motors. In effect, JBM became the single bidder and therefore, the tender should have been

Committee. However, the bidding consultant (DIMTS) and the Tender Committee of DTC did not correctly evaluate the financial bids. The Committee declared M/S TATA Motors Ltd eligible for the bid of 600 BS-VI buses.

It was further found that DTC invited M/s JBM for negotiation for BS-IV buses on the basis of

rates of TATA which never made any bid for this category. This action of DTC was without any justification and the price negotiation with M/s JBM is violative of GFR and CVC guidelines.

Interestingly, there was a specific requirement of front-facing seats in the RFP but both the Con-sultant and DTC Tender Committee did not reject JBM's bid for want of this condition.

The report by the Chief Secretary also brings out clearly that the Committee headed by OP Aggrawal, IAS (Retd.) to look into the charges of irregularities and corruption in the procurement of buses in June 2021, in its report submitted in August 2021, clearly indicted the AAP government for 'procedural deviations in the entire tendering and procurement procedure". Criminal misconduct by public servants in this tender exercise will be ascertained by the investigating agency, i.e. the CBI.

On the basis of this, Chief Secretary recommended referring the matter to CBI, which was approved by the LG. The Aam Admi Party (AAP)

With the arrest of the last accused shooter Deepak Mundi along with his two aides from the Indo-Nepal Border in West Bengal on Sunday, the Punjab police arrested the 23rd accused in Sidhu Moosewala murder

As the Punjab Police arrested the sixth and last shooter identified as Deepak Mundi in the Sidhu Moosewala murder case along with his two aides from the Indo-Nepal Border in West Bengal when the trio were attempting to escape to Nepal, the entire conspiracy and modus operandi as also the link-ups of these gangsters was revealed. The operation was carried out jointly by the Punjab Police's Anti-Gangster Task Force (AGTF) along with Delhi Police

and Central agencies.

As part of its ongoing war against gangsters launched on the directions of Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann, Director General of Police (DGP) Punjab Gaurav Yadav, addressed a press conference here on Sunday, where he informed that Deepak Mudi, the main assassin, had fired indiscriminately at Shubhdeep Singh, the Punjabi Singer killed by gangsters on May

The other two arrested along with Mundi are, Kapil Pandit and Rajinder alias Joker from near Indo-Nepal checkpoint in the area of Kharibari Police Station in Darjeeling district of West Bengal on Saturday. A team of AGTF led by AIG Gurmeet Chauhan and DSP Bikram Brar brought Mundi and his two aides to Punjab by air on Saturday late night.

Centre fixes total number of seats in MCD at 250 NEW DELHI, SEP 11

The central government has fixed the total number of seats in the Municipal Corporation of Delhi at 250 from the

This was stated in a Delhi Gazette notification issued on Saturday.

The total number of seats reserved for the members of the Scheduled Castes in the MCD in proportion to their number is also determined to be 42, it said.

The previous three corporations in Delhi comprised 272 wards. While the North and South corporations accounted for 104 wards each, the East corporation had 64 wards under its ju-



"In pursuance of sub-section (5) of section 3 of the Delhi Municipal Corporation Act 1957, as amended by the Delhi Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Act, 2022, the Central government hereby determines the total number of seats of the Councillors in the Municipal Corporation of Delhi as two hundred and fifty (250)," reads the notification.

"Further, in accordance with subsection (6) (as amended) of section 3 of the aforesaid Act, the Central Govnumber of seats of the Councillors in the Municipal Corporation of Delhi to be reserved for members of Scheduled Castes as forty-two (42), based on the ratio to the total number of seats as the population of Scheduled Castes bears to the total population of Delhi (Census 2011)," it said.

Parliament on April 5 had passed the Delhi Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Bill-2022 to unify three civic bodies in the national capital into a new unified entity, which capped the number of total wards to 250 The Union Home Ministry in July

had set up a three-member commission for carrying out a fresh delimitation of the municipal wards in Delhi.

The exercise, currently underway, Delhi, which would be the first since the reunification of three corporations

The panel comprises Vijay Dev, State Election Commissioner, Delhi, who is its chairman; Pankaj Kumar Singh, Joint Secretary in Union Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs; and Randhir Sahay, Additional Commissioner, MCD.

Figure it out

he installation of Netaji's statue under the imperial canopy near India Gate nudged me into visiting the Central Vista for the first time in many years. I grew up in one of the sarkari colonies near the hexagonal park that encloses the canopy. Many hours of my childhood had been spent cycling past the canopy and down Rajpath, either to borrow books from the British Council library on Rafi Marg or to cycle up the great slope that led up to the Secretariat buildings for the extreme excitement of freewheeling down it again.

I had been reluctant to revisit this childhood place ever since the prime minister had announced its makeover because I didn't trust his aesthetic judgment and didn't want my earliest memories tampered with. Most parts of a modern city are transformed over half a century but the Central Vista hadn't been and there was a certain comfort in that. But in the end, it's absurd trying to unsee the heart of a city, so on Friday, I drove down to see Netaji newly installed.

Getting there wasn't easy. The hexagon is, in effect, a giant roundabout surrounded by a massively wide road where the cars never stop. I found a red light near Shahjahan Road that stopped traffic for just long enough to let me jog across. The nearest radial road that led to the canopy was blocked by police barriers; the only way in was via metal detector gates near Rajpath.

There were hundreds of men in fatigues sitting on the lawns and nearly as many civilians who, like me, had come to look at the statue and reclaim the lawns that had been cordoned off for so long. I can report that at this stage of Narendra Modi's pharaonic project, the vista looks relatively unchanged. The office buildings on either side of Rajpath aren't visible yet and the underground subways that connect pedestrians to the lawns beyond the hexagon use red sandstone that's consistent with the architecture of the concourse. The fountains work and the shallow rectangular pools that flank Rajpath are blue with clear water.

Squinting down Rajpath (it was just past noon and the sun was scorching), the India Gate lawns seemed renovated rather than transformed. It was as if a superior Residents Welfare Association had been given a free hand in fixing the place up and it had done what RWAs do: cordoned it off, expelled the vendors, stopped the maidan cricket and beautified the place by filtering the pools, filtering out the people, and tending the lawns.

Afghanistan tops the list of unhappiest countries

nder the Taliban regime, Afghanistan ranked first among the list of unhappiest countries in terms of physical pain, mental stress, mental disorders triggered by poverty and unemployment, anxiety, and anger, as per a report by a global an-



According to Gallup's Negative Experience Index, a total of 80 pc Afghans are worried and disturbed, 74 pc in mental stresses induced by poverty and unemployment, while the condition of 61 pc of Afghans are defined as "sad." In 2021, worry, tension,

and sadness reached all-time highs in Afghanistan. Moreover, 53 pc of Afghans wished to leave the country in a survey conducted in August and September 2021, reported Khaama Press.

Right after the Taliban took over in August 2021, the first two months were particularly difficult for many Afghan

As Afghanistan continues to witness a debilitating rights situation, the UN body for hu-



concerns over the grave condition pointing out that 25 million people in the country are living in poverty, media reports said.

The United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UN-OCHA) in Afghanistan and the World Food Program (WFP) has voiced concerns over the rising food insecurity and poverty that has gripped the country's people, Afghanistan's local media Tolo News reported. Taking to ÚNOCHA

Afghanistan said that 25 million people in Afghanistan are facing poverty. "19 million people are facing food insecurity, 25 million people are living in poverty, 5.8 million people are in protracted internal displacement, and thousands of houses are damaged by floods and earthquakes. To survive the winter, they require food, nutrition support, warm clothing & a roof over their heads," tweeted OCHA. Meanwhile, the World Food Program has voiced concerns about the economic crisis in Afghanistan. "The economic

crisis wiped out jobs, salaries livelihoods Afghanistan, helping families & communities support themselves is more important than ever," said WFP on Twitter.

"A nation cannot reach prosperity until the poverty and unemployment are eradicated, so the way that can end poverty and unemployment is strengthening the private sector, attracting investment and creating employment in the country," said Abdul Naseer, a political analyst. Moreover, Human rights groups called on United Nations for

stronger accountability in Afghanistan. In an open letter to the UN, they called for the establishment of a dedicated accountability mechanism by the Human Rights Council (HRC), alongside the mandate of the Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Afghanistan, reported Tolo

News.
"The signatory organizations call your attention to the deplorable state of human rights in Afghanistan and in particular the absolute lack of accountability for gross and systematic human rights violations and abuses, including crimes under international law, occurring in Afghanistan, especially against women and girls, ethnic and religious minorities, journalists, and human rights defenders," the let-

ter read. Richard Bennett is the current UN Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Afghanistan, and the renewal of his post was called for in the open letter, reported

Tolo News.
"The Western countries will call for the renewal of Richard Bennett. China and Russia will also accept it but the report of Richard Bennett made from outside Afghanistan. For better transparency, it is better than Richard Bennett to stay in Kabul and write the report from Kabul," said Torek Farhadi, a political analyst.

This comes as the Taliban has repeatedly denied the reports of the violations of human rights, and called them baseless, reported Tolo News. The Taliban stressed that it is committed to human rights and women's rights based on Islamic values.

Since the Taliban seized power in Kabul last year, the human rights situation has been exacerbated by a nationwide economic, financial and humanitarian crisis of unprecedented scale.

The Taliban dismantled the system to respond to gender-based violence, created new barriers to women accessing health care, blocked women's aid workers from doing their jobs, and attacked

women's rights protesters. With the US troops' withdrawal from the country, large-scale violence has been unleashed creating political uncertainty in different parts

of the country.
At least 59 per cent of the pop ulation is now in need of humanitarian assistance - an increase of 6 million people compared with the beginning of 2021, according to UNA-

The King and Members of the Royal Family will take part in the Procession and attend a Service in St Giles' Cathedral to receive the coffin.

Queen Elizabeth's coffin will then lie at rest in St Giles' Cathedral, guarded by Vigils from The Royal Company of Archers, to allow the people of Scotland to pay their respects.

On Tuesday afternoon, the Queen's Coffin will travel from Scotland by Royal Air Force aircraft from Edinburgh Airport, arriving at RAF Northolt later that



evening. The coffin will be accompanied on the journey by the Princess Royal.

The Queen's coffin will then be conveyed to Buckingham Palace by road, to rest in the Bow Room. On the afternoon of Wednesday, the Coffin will be borne in Procession on a Gun Carriage of The King's Troop Royal Horse Artillery from Buckingham Palace to the Palace of Westminster, where The Queen will Lie-in-State in Westminster Hall until the morning of the State Funeral.

The Procession will travel via Queen's Gardens, The Mall, Horse Guards and Horse Guards Arch, Whitehall, Parliament Street, Parliament Square and New Palace Yard. After the coffin arrives at Westminster Hall, The Archbishop of Canterbury will conduct a short service assisted by The Very Reverend Dr David Hoyle, Dean of Westminster, and attended by The King and Members of the Royal Family, after which the Lyingin-State will begin.

India issues advisory for students planning to study in China

ndia has issued a detailed advisory related to study-ing at Chinese medical schools as thousands of enrolled students continue to remain stuck at home amid the

More than 23,000 Indian students enrolled in various Chinese universities have been affected by the Chinese visa ban.

"Embassy of India in Beijing has been receiving several queries from prospective Indian students and their parents with respect to seeking admission for undergraduate clinical medicine programme in China," the embassy said in a statement on September 8.

China in July said that the country has made progress on facilitating the return of Indian students and is working in tandem with relevant departments to see that the first batch of Indian students can come back to study in China

at the earliest. The Indian Embassy also shared the link to a study conducted by the National Board of Examination to highlight that only 6387 out of 40,417 students, who appeared in the FMG Examination from 2015 to 2021 have cleared it.



"The study shows that only 6387 out of 40,417 students, who appeared in FMG Examination from 2015 to 2021 have cleared it. Here, the pass percentage of Indian students who have studied clinical medicine programme in China in that period in these 45 universities was only 16 per cent," it statement further added. Indian students pursuing medicine from Chinese Universities are unable to return to China to attend classes due to COVID-19-induced restrictions. Earlier, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar in his meeting with Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi on the sidelines of the G20 Foreign Ministers' Meeting also stressed the need for expediting the process of return of Indian students to China to attend classes at an early date.



Pakistan in severe liquidity crunch amid ravaging floods

akistan's macroeconomic vulnerabilities are not going anywhere as the country is reeling under a severe dollar liquidity crunch while the recent flash floods have aggravated.

This comes despite a resumption of the IMF programme after a pause of seven months, reported The News International. Top govt sources said that Pakistan's macroeconomic vulnerabilities are not going anywhere without improving dollar injections. Pakistan has not yet made any fresh request to the IMF for the provision of a Rapid Financing Instrument (RFI) or Natural Calamity Response-related funding facility on the expectations of a lukewarm response from the Washington-based international lender. The IMF programme under USD 6.5 billion was restored in late Au-



under Imran Khan-led Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) regime when it provided unfunded fuel and electricity subsidies, reported The News Interna-

Moreover, in the wake of severe floods, the initially estimated losses have accumulated in the range of USD 18 billion, Pakistan's agriculture sector

faces the worst blow as the agriculture growth might remain zero or slide into negative against the envisaged target of 3.9 per cent for the current financial year 2022-23. The worst performance of the agriculture sector will put pressure on increased demand for commodities imports and if Pakistan fails to generate desired levels of dollar inflows it might create food shortages in the current fiscal year, reported The News International. "The situation has aggravated as demand for imports has gone up manifold but the country does not have enough dollars. So in totality, the exchange rate has gone under immense pressure in recent days whereby the ruee nosedived 9 per cent against the US dollar," top official sources said while talking to The News here on Friday.

It is estimated that Pakistan will have to import additional cotton worth USD 2 billion during the current fiscal year because it witnessed severe damages in the wake of flash floods affecting those areas of Sindh where the cotton production was destroyed completely. Now the government will have to dewater the areas where sowing of wheat is done, otherwise, there is a potential threat of less production in the range of 3 to 5 million tonnes. The minor crops of onion and tomato were also damaged in KP and Sindh. The demand for the import of pulses might also go up for the current fiscal year.

Another problem may emerge on

the trade front as the country's exports rely upon imports on accounts of raw material and inter-mediatory goods as value was added for exporting finished products, reported The New International. In the wake of the increased economic losses and reduced GDP growth, the per capita income is projected to slow down. The government had envisaged a GDP growth rate of 5 per cent for the current fiscal year. Moreover, poverty and unemployment will go up manifold from 21.9 per cent to over 36 per cent. Some 37 per cent population was hit by poverty after floods in 118 districts, as estimated by the Pakistan government. A high-profile committee with representation from the Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Planning, State Bank of Pakistan, FBR, PIDE and others evaluated that poverty and unemployment have gone up manifold, rising from 21.9 per cent to over 36 per cent.



Vinay Kumar Tripathi, Chairman and CEO, Railway Board inspected the ongoing works on Katra-Banihal(111 km) section of USBRL Project in Jammu & Kashmir from 09/09/2022 to 10/09/2022. Inspection started from tunnel T-1(3159m). Tunnel excavation of 1860 m has been completed from portal P1 end and 1039 m completed from P2 end. Now, the balance excavation is only 260m. Due to Main boundary thrust location, the progress is very slow. Tunnel excavation requires lot of pre- support measures and also post excavation support systems. Executing agency was advised to complete balance excavation of 260 meters expeditiously by augmenting resources. Northern Railway /Konkan Railway Corporation Limited were directed to closely monitor the progress. After Tunnel T-1, inspection continued with run through in already completed tunnel T-2 having length of 5090m of Main tunnel and parallel escape tunnel of length 5072m. Inderjit Gorava said that Harvana is a state where farmers have to pay the highest market fee of 4 percent in the country, which reduces the price of the crop by Rs 100 to 150 per quintal.
