## Four major anti-cancer drugs to get cheaper

NEW DELHI, SEPT 13

Four major anti-cancer drugs have been added to the National List of Essential Medicines (NLEM). The drugs included in the list are Bendamustine Hydrochloride, HCl Trihydrate, Lenalidomide and Leuprolide Acetate.

"Four Anti-cancer drugs have been added to the list like Bendamustine Hydrochloride, Irinotecan HCl Trihydrate, Lenalidomide and Leuprolide acetate, these medicines are effective in various types of cancers and these are affordable also," Vice Chairman, Standing National



Committee on Medicines & Health Care Product told.

Government is also working on trade rationalisation also so that those medicines which are used for common cancer can come into an affordable limit, he said.

Thirty-four drugs including some anti-infectives such as Ivermectin, Mupirocin, Meropenem and psychotherapeutic drug Nicotine Replacement Therapy have also been added to the National List of Essential Medicines taking the total drugs under it to 384.

Besides, 26 drugs such as Ranitidine, Sucralfate, White Petrolatum, Atenolol

and Methyldopa, etc have been deleted from the revised list. The deletion has been done based on the parameters of cost-effectiveness and availability of better drugs. "Union Health Ministry is taking various steps under the vision of Prime Minister Narendra Modi ji towards Sabko Dawai, Sasti Dawai. In this direction, the National List of Essential Medicines (NLEM) plays an important role in ensuring the accessibility of affordable quality medicines at all levels of healthcare. This will give a boost to cost-effective, quality medicines and contribute towards a reduction in out-of-pocket expenditure on healthcare for the citizens,"

stated Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare.

According to the Union Health secretary, the primary purpose of NLEM is to promote the rational use of medicines.

"Just in that context, the primary purpose of the national list of essential medicine is to promote rational use of medicines and when we say rational use, it means that we have to see the cost of the medicine, the safety of the medicine and efficacy of the medicine. So, rational use of medicine is dependent on three parameters of costs, safety, and efficacy," said Rajesh Bhushan, Secretary, Union Health Minister.

## BJP workers clash with cops during protest in Bengal, several detained

Several BJP leaders in West Bengal, including Leader of the Opposition Suwendu Adhikari, were detained by the police today when they were marching to state secretariat 'Nabanna' in Kolkata, as part of a huge protest over alleged corruption by the ruling Trinamool Congress government.

Suwendu Adhikari, BJP MP Locket Chatterjee and other party leaders, including Rahul Sinha, were stopped by the police as they approached the Second Hooghly Bridge near the secretariat, and taken away in a prison van.

The police used tear gas and water cannons to disperse the protesters near the Howrah bridge as they clashed with security officials. A police car was also set on fire. Several BJP workers were detained by the police following the clashes.

Party workers were taken into preventive custody in Raniganj as well.

Hundreds of BJP supporters from across West Bengal arrived in Kolkata and neighbouring Howrah this morning to take part in the 'Nabanna Abhijan' or march to secretariat.



While being dragged away by the police, Mr Adhikari said Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has "turned West Bengal into North Korea".

"Chief Minister Mamata does not have the support of her people and so she is enforcing dictatorship, similar to North Korea, in Bengal. The police will have to pay for what it is doing. The BJP is coming," he said.

Mr Adhikari was leading the march from the Santragachi area, while BJP national vice-president Dilip Ghosh was leading the protest from north Kolkata.

"The TMC government is scared of a public uprising. Even

if they try to stop our protest march, we will resist peacefully. The state administration will be responsible for any untoward development," Mr Ghosh had said earlier today.

Rahul Sinha accused the Mamata Banerjee government of trying to forcibly stop the "democratic protest" by his party.

He alleged that the BJP supporters were prevented from boarding a special train from Alipurduar to Sealdah last evening to take part in the protest march. "They were also lathicharged by the state police," he alleged.

The BJP had arranged seven

trains -- three from north Bengal and four from the south -- for supporters to take part in the 'Nabanna Abhijan'.

BJP state youth wing president Saumitra Khan said "days of the TMC is numbered" and BJP will surely give a reply to all the atrocities committed on party men.

The TMC, in a tweet, said, "BJP4Bengal karyakartas or hooligans?" "Destroying and damaging government property, attacking police personnel, causing chaos and disrupting peace across the state—today's activities of BJP that brought shame upon the entire nation. We strongly condemn such outrageous behaviour," the party said in the microblogging site.

TMC spokesperson Kunal Ghosh alleged that the BJP was fomenting trouble under the garb of protest.

"It is part of a bigger game plan to destabilise West Bengal this festive season. This is not democratic movement. This is goondaism," he added.

Seven trains were hired by the BJP to bring its supporters from north and south Bengal on Monday for the protest march to 'Nabanna'.

## J&K SI recruitment scam: CBI searches several premises

The Central Bureau of Investigation is conducting searches at around 33 locations in the country on Tuesday in an ongoing investigation of a case related to the Sub Inspector recruitment scam of Jammu and Kashmir.

The premises being searched include that of former Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board Chairman Khalid Jehangir, Controller of Examination JKSSB Ashok Kumar, some officials of J&K Police including a Deputy Superintendent of Police and Central Reserve Police Force, CBI officials said.

The raids are being conducted at Jammu, Srinagar, Karnal, Mahendergarh, Rewari in Haryana; Gandhinagar in Gujarat; Delhi; Ghaziabad in Uttar Pradesh and Bangalore in Karnataka.

The CBI registered a case against 33 accused persons last month after the J&K government canceled the police Sub-



Inspector recruitment. The written test for the exam was held on March 27 and the results were declared on June 4. After the list was out there were allegations regarding malpractices in the examination. After the allegations surfaced, the J&K government constituted an Inquiry Committee and it was alleged that the accused against whom FIR was registered by CBI entered into conspiracy with officials of JKSSB, Bengaluru-based private company, beneficiary candidates and others, and caused gross irregularities in conduct of written examination for the posts of Sub-Inspectors.

## Haryana woman gang-raped in Shamli, one arrested

MUZAFFARNAGAR: A 48-year-old woman from Haryana's Panipat was allegedly raped by two youths in Uttar Pradesh's Shamli district, police said on Tuesday.

Superintendent of Police (Shamli) Abhishek Kumar said that based on a complaint filed by the woman's family members, a case has been registered against Mohan and Rahul. While Mohan has been arrested, Rahul is absconding, the police said.

According to the police, Rahul had called the woman on Monday and told her that her two sons, who are lodged in jail, will be released on bail. The duo then allegedly raped and thrashed her and abandoned her in a jungle. The locals found the woman in an unconscious state, they said.

## India to host G-20 summit in 2023

India is scheduled to host the G-20 Leaders' Summit at the level of Heads of State in the capital on September 9 and 10, 2023, the Ministry of External Affairs said on Tuesday.

India will assume the Presidency of the intergovernmental forum of the world's major developed and developing economies for one year from December 1, 2022 to November 30, 2023, the MEA added.

Informing about the summit, the MEA

said that under its Presidency, India is expected to host over 200 G20 meetings across the country, beginning December 2022.

It comprises 19 countries - Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, UK, USA and the European Union. Collectively, the G20 accounts for 85% of global GDP, 75% of international trade and two-thirds of the world population, making it the premier forum for international economic cooperation.

## 8 killed in Secunderabad blaze, PM condoles

At least eight people have been killed and six others injured in a major fire that broke out in an e-bike showroom situated on the ground floor of a multi-storied building in Secunderabad here.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi said he was saddened by the loss of lives due to the fire in Telangana.

"Condolences to the bereaved families. May the injured recover soon," he tweeted as news of the Monday night blaze was reported.

Rs 2 lakh from PMNRF would be paid to the next of kin of each dead and Rs 50,000 each to the injured, the PMO tweeted.

The fire that broke out around 11 pm in the electric bike showroom, spread to a

lodge on the upper floors, police said.

Of those killed, four have been identified as tourists boarding at the lodge. The injured were undergoing treatment at various hospitals including the state-run Gandhi hospital in the city, police said here.

The exact cause of the fire is being investigated, police said. The injured were mostly from among those who panicked and tried to jump down from the lodge above to escape the inferno.

Nearly 25 tourists from different places were in the luxury lodge-cum-hotel when the incident occurred, police added.

Firefighters rushed to the spot and with the help of a crane ladder, rescued several tourists in the night, who were trapped.

## International Gita Mahotsav to be held in Canada from Sep 16 to 19

**Man held for extortion bid on sheller owner**

**NILOKHERI:** The detective staff team of district police Karnal has arrested an accused who had tried to extort lakhs of rupees claiming himself to be a famous gangster Neeraj Bawa. In this regard, a complaint was received at the Karnal Superintendent of Police office on September 5, in which the complainant, Sahil Verma, a sheller owner and a resident of Nilokheri, said that on the night of September 3, he received a call from an unknown number on his mobile phone. As soon as the complainant picked up the phone, the unknown person on the phone identified himself as gangster Neeraj Bawa and said that he was talking from Tihar Jail. After which the unknown person started demanding a sum of Rs 5 lakh from the complainant and threatened to kill him if he did not pay the money. In this regard, a case was registered under sections 384, 506 and 34 IPC at Butana police station on the statement of the complainant and the subsequent investigation of the case was handed over to the team of Detective Staff Karnal. During the investigation, on September 7, the accused Shimal, a resident of Nilokheri district Karnal, was arrested near Mayur Dhaba located on GT Road Karnal along with an illegal pistol. During the remand, it was revealed that Shimal used to work as a driver for the complainant a long time ago.

## Provide shelter to every person of state, directs CM

Haryana Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal ensured that no person will remain homeless across the state. The main objective of the state government is to provide shelter to every poor and needy person of the state. The Chief Minister was presiding over the review meeting of the central government schemes implemented in the state. On this occasion, Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) Urban and Rural, Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana Urban and Rural, Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana, Atal Pension Yojana, Kisan Credit Card Scheme, Pradhan Mantri Svanidhi Yojana, Direct Benefit Transfer Scheme, Pradhan Mantri Gati Shakti Yojana, New National Education Policy, One

District One Product (ODOP) and Amrit Sarovar Mission were reviewed and directions were given to take necessary steps accordingly. After taking precise information about the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, the Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal directed the officers to prioritize the work of providing shelter to homeless and landless people in the state. He said that he is worried about such poor people in the state. He urged the concerned officers to make adequate arrangement of providing houses to all needy people. He further said that there should be no halt in construction work of houses due to shortage of funds. He directed the officers to expedite the construction work and said that they should set



monthly targets and under the said scheme, the work of 100 percent survey should also be completed at the earliest. While reviewing the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, the Chief Minister said that all the link roads connecting village to village should be completed and the target given by the Central Government should be completed in a stipulated time frame. He further directed to make an adequate mechanism under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana so that every beneficiary can get complete benefits under the scheme. During the meeting, the Chief Minister was apprised that Haryana's DBT scheme is leading in the entire country.

## Drug de-addiction awareness programme held

## Pulse Polio programme from Sept 18

Because if even a single child was left out then the safety cycle will break. All children in the age group of 0 to 5 years should be given anti-polio medicine at booths. Along with brick kilns, ensure that children of laborers working in fields and other industrial units should also be covered by mobile teams and given medicines. Under this campaign, a target has been set to provide medicines to 1 lakh 11 thousand 458 children of the district. DC Dr. Sangeeta Tatarwal was giving necessary guidelines to the concerned departments along with health by holding a meeting of District Level Task Force on the subject of Pulse Polio Campaign in the auditorium of the Mini Secretariat. The DC said that on September 18, 619 booths would be set up at various places to provide anti-polio medicines. 2 thousand 390 team members will work in this work and 106 supervisors have also been appointed. With this, anti-polio medicines will be given to children from door to door on September 19 and 20, under which a target has been set to cover 1 lakh 91 thousand 613 houses.



## 1824 teams to identify persons with symptoms of TB

Chief Medical Officer, District Kangra, Dr. Gurudarshan Gupta informed that the National TB Eradication Program aims to reduce the mortality and disease due to TB and prevent the spread of TB infection. The Chief Medical Officer said that Active Case Finding is an important campaign for the eradication of TB, with the aim of finding and treating TB patients at the earliest. Active case finding campaign in district Kangra will start from 12th September and will end on 2nd October. This campaign will run in 13 health blocks of district Kangra, for which the health department has made all the preparations. The Health Department has prepared a micro plan for this campaign. He said that in this campaign, the health department team would go door-to-door in their area to identify persons with possible symptoms of TB and send their sputum to the lab for testing. In this campaign, 1824 teams have been formed inside district Kangra,



which will cover 16 lakh population in district Kangra. In this campaign, a team of health workers will visit every house and screen and ensure the sputum test of a potential TB patient. Along with this, public awareness campaign for TB disease will also be run by health workers in every area of district Kangra. In this campaign, screening for TB will be done on priority basis of high risk population.



## India Pharmacopeia (IP) certification mandatory for IPA in Pharma

The Union Government should make Indian Pharmacopeia (IP) certification mandatory for isopropyl alcohols (IPA) used in pharma applications as usage of imported IPA is fraught with risks. Indian IPA manufacturers allege that cheap imported IPA, fails to meet various critical parameters covered in Pharmacopeia Standards such as UV absorbance test, identification of unsaturated hydrocarbons and rapidly carbonizable material. They further added use of such sub-standard non-pharma grade IPA adversely affects the quality of the drug exposing millions of Indian consumers to severe health hazards. It also jeopardises the reputation of the country's pharma industry.

IPA, commonly called isopropanol, is a colourless, flammable liquid with a strong odor. It is used in the manufacture of a wide variety of industrial and household chemicals and finds major applications in the production of bulk drugs and drug formulations which are vital in the pharma manufacturing process. It is also used as a common ingredient in products such as hand sanitizers, antiseptics and disinfectants. Indian pharmaceutical sector consumes roughly 170,000 MT of the overall India IPA demand of around 240,000 MT in FY21. Of the 170,000 MT of IPA consumed by the pharma industry, only about 12 % is pharma grade, meeting Indian and other Pharmacopeia Standards. The rest is non-pharma grade.

Hard realities

The shortfall in economic growth in the April-June quarter against rosier predictions of most, including the central bank, came as a surprise. Few anticipated the gap between expected and actual performance would be as much (2.5-3 percentage points). It has prompted a tide of downward revisions for the whole year; these follow a previous round, two months ago, due to inflation, higher interest rates, and geopolitical factors. Comparisons have, therefore, been drawn with 2019-20, the pre-pandemic year, in which growth forecasts were regularly disproved each quarter while final GDP grew at 3.8%, almost half the initial prediction. Much before the data release, the possibility of repeat growth downgrades in a worsening context was apprehended and it was discussed here that economic resilience could be tested given the toughening conditions in the forthcoming months. Since then, the cracks have become more apparent while the headwinds are blowing with greater force. There are hard realities that growth expectations must reckon with.

That economic improvement over the initial base, that is before Covid-19, was weak has been routinely noted by many. A disturbing aspect of economic performance in the first quarter is a sequential contraction of almost every portion of aggregate demand; the shrinkages exceed the normal reductions observed each summer season in the past several years. It is not certain if this represents a struggling recovery even before full restoration and it increases uncertainty about the future outlook. The economic fallout of the Russia-Ukraine war took a further toll on prices and volumes — the already-high inflation got fresh impetus from a sharp energy shock and rocketing food prices, as result of which real GDP grew at the same rate as that of inflation (GDP deflator, in this instance). World trade got a knock from dimming demand and disruptions abroad, feeding back to slower exports. Spending by consumers, businesses and government was also lowered in different magnitudes as compared to the January-March period.

The corresponding weakness on the production side is seen in the sequential falls in manufacturing, construction, trade, hospitality, transport, and communication services' segments — the more informal parts of the economy and traditionally job-rich for unskilled and semi-skilled persons. Worryingly, the trade, hospitality, transport category is still 84.5% of its size in April-June 2019, while the construction sector has barely risen above.

Many were shocked by Russia's invasion of Ukraine on February 24, 2022, but not so by government and military officials in China and the US. Indeed, more than six months on from President Vladimir Putin's greatest - and riskiest - gambit, China's military has had plenty of time to digest lessons on how not to conduct an invasion of a neighbouring country.

This is critical because China has nefarious intentions for Taiwan, and what it learns from the Ukrainian "battle lab" could help it succeed where Russia has failed.

Senior Colonel Wu Qian, a Chinese Ministry of National Defence spokesman, said back in March that "Taiwan is not Ukraine" and that the underpinnings are quite different.

This is because, "Taiwan is an inalienable part of China's territory, and the Taiwan question is purely China's internal affair with zero-tolerance of external interference." However, Ian Easton, a Research Fellow at the Project 2049 Institute in the USA, correctly pointed out that, instead, "Taiwan is an independent and sovereign country that has never been part of the territory ruled by the People's Republic of China." Nevertheless, the People's Liberation Army (PLA) officer Wu insisted, "The two sides across the Taiwan Strait must be and will be reunified. It is the trend of history that can never be stopped by anyone or any force." Easton responded by saying, "Peaceful unification' is a Chinese Communist Party (CCP) euphemism that refers to the subversion and coerced annexation of Taiwan's government.

It's a seemingly benign phrase that, in reality, describes the destruction of a nation-state that is ranked among the top ten democracies in the world."

Wu further stated: "It is perfectly justified for China to safeguard its national sovereignty and territorial integrity, and allow no external interference ... The Chinese

Unfortunately, Beijing's arrogant claim to all of Taiwan, and its global isolation and ostracism of the peace-loving democracy, are backed up by a willingness to use both covert and overt measures to change the status quo and take control of Taiwan.

Alarming, Easton warned, "The PRC is engaged in the largest peacetime military build-up undertaken by any country in over a century. Chinese military officers writing in authoritative documents describe the United States as their main enemy and portray the conquest of Taiwan as their number one mission."

Naturally, the PLA is all eyes and ears when it comes to scooping up lessons to be learned from Ukraine. Until now, it is mostly how not to conduct a war, as the Russian assault has turned into a debacle of the highest order. Currently, the front in northeast Ukraine has crumbled, and Russian troops have fled in panic. The latest reports state that Ukrainian troops had driven all

the way to the border with Russia in Kharkiv Oblast. After being forced to retreat from Kyiv early on in the conflict, Russian troops have also fled in disarray from places like Izyum in the northeast. This spectacular failure of Russia's "special military operation" will provide lessons for years to come. Doctor Joel Wuthnow, a Senior Research Fellow at the Centre for the Study of Chinese Military Affairs, at the Institute for National Strategic Studies of the National Defence University in Washington DC, has explored lessons that China and the PLA might pick up as it contemplates a future invasion of Taiwan. In a report entitled "Rightsizing Chinese Military lessons from Ukraine", Wuthnow noted that PLA writings and research have been almost non-existent on the topic so far. Of course, the PLA must distance itself from the mistakes that Russia made, and come up with solutions to the strategy, tactics and weapons that Ukraine is employing. Wuthnow made three assumptions. The first is that PLA decision-makers are teachable.

This might be true, as seen in the force's reaction after the USA and allies decimated Iraq in the 1990-91 Gulf War.

However, today's PLA commanders might be less flexible or open to change than their predecessors.

Wuthnow proffered several arguments for this possibility, such as the Ukraine scenario being very different to a Taiwan one.

Another is that the PLA may be more arrogant now and more confident in its capabilities. A third is "cognitive dissonance", where the PLA's approach over the past three decades may have inadvertently produced intellectual blinders that harm its ability to adapt. The Central Military Commission's make-up will change after the 20th National Party Congress later this year, and it is likely to have members that have no combat experience whatsoever. The second assumption that Wuthnow made is that the PLA possesses a rational strategic planning process.

This will determine whether any lessons drawn from the Ukraine conflict will actually alter how the PLA trains or operates. It should be remembered that the PLA is highly hierarchical and resistant to change, which is why Chairman Xi Jinping had to take it by the scruff of the neck and enforce structural changes.

There is a danger that each PLA service will simply focus on lessons that reinforce what it already believes. The PLA Air Force, for example, might argue that it needs more funding to suppress enemy air defences, or the ground forces might demand more troops after Xi cut numbers by 300,000.

The third assumption is that adaptation will influence China's decision-making calculus. This is connected to the CCP's appetite for risk. Even if the PLA modifies its doctrine or force posture, would China's leaders still be keen to attack Taiwan?

In the short term, Xi might take fewer risks until the lessons of Ukraine are fully understood. In the longer term, he might be more confident if the PLA shows itself to have absorbed vital lessons.

Walking 10,000 steps per day reduces risk of dementia, cancer

Researchers from the University of Sydney in Australia and the University of Southern Denmark discovered that walking 10,000 steps per day reduces the risk of dementia, heart disease, cancer, and mortality. A faster walking pace, such as a power walk, showed benefits that went beyond the number of steps taken.

The studies, published in leading journals JAMA Internal Medicine and JAMA Neurology, monitored 78, 500 adults with wearable trackers - making these the largest studies to objectively track step count in relation to health outcomes.

"The take-home message here is that for protective health benefits people could not only ideally aim for 10,000 steps a day but also aim to walk faster," said co-lead author Dr Matthew Ahmadi, Research Fellow at the University of Sydney's Charles Perkins Centre and Faculty of Medicine and Health.

For less active individuals, our study also demonstrates that as low as 3,800 steps a day can cut the risk of dementia by 25 per cent," said co-lead author Associate Professor Borja del Pozo Cruz from the University of Southern Denmark and senior researcher in health at the University of Cadiz.



Key points:  
- Every 2,000 steps lowered the risk of premature death incrementally by 8 to 11 per cent, up to approximately 10,000 steps a day.  
- Similar associations were seen for cardiovascular disease and cancer incidence.  
- A higher number of steps per day was associated with a lower risk of all-cause dementia  
- 9,800 steps was the optimal dose linked to a lower risk of dementia by 50 per cent, however, the risk was reduced by 25 per cent at as low as 3,800 steps a day.  
- Stepping intensity or a faster pace showed beneficial associations for all outcomes (dementia, heart disease, cancer and death) over and above total daily steps.

Blue Origin rocket experiences booster failure during uncrewed launch



An uncrewed New Shepard rocket launched by Blue Origin experienced a booster failure on Monday, which caused the rocket booster to crash.

However, the capsule carrying experiments escaped and floated safely back to Earth, Jeff Bezos' space company said.

The launch was scheduled for 8:30 a.m. Monday Central Daylight Time from the company's Launch Site One location in West Texas, according to Blue Origin. It was a payload mission with no astronauts on board.

"During today's flight, the capsule escape system successfully separated the capsule from the booster. The booster impacted the ground," Blue Origin tweeted. "There are no reported injuries; all personnel have been accounted for," said the company. The


company tweeted a short video showing the moment the capsule fired emergency thrusters to separate from its booster rocket, around a minute after launching from Blue Origin's base in west Texas. It was the 23rd mission for the New Shepard rocket program, named after the first American in space, and the first to end in failure. NS-23, which had 36 experiments on board, was first set to launch in late August but was delayed due to inclement weather. The incident marks a setback for Blue Origin and the nascent space tourism industry. Blue Origin began flying humans to space on 10-minute rides last year for an unspecified ticket price. It has flown 32 people -- some paying customers and others guests. Notable passengers include founder Jeff Bezos and Star Trek icon, William Shatner.

Children learn from observation and experimentation

Children learn by seeing and experimenting on their own. They also learn from what others say to them, particularly adults and authority figures such as their parents and teachers. When children discover something unexpected, they seek out more information by asking questions or testing claims. Previous research indicates that whether children investigate adults' surprise assertions varies by age, with children over the age of six being more likely to seek out extra information than children aged four and five. However, there has been little research into why children seek information after being given something startling by adults.

A new study published in Child Development by researchers at the University of Toronto and Harvard University aims to answer this question.

"The research shows that as children age, they become more skeptical of what adults tell them," said Samantha Cottrell, senior lab member from the Childhood Learning and Development (ChiLD) Lab at the University of



Toronto. "This explains why older children are more likely to try to verify claims and are more intentional about their exploration of objects."

Across two preregistered studies, researchers set out to clarify whether and why children explore surprising claims.

In the first study, which was conducted in-person between September 2019 and March 2020, 109 children ages four- to six-years-old were recruited

from the Greater Toronto Area, Canada. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the laboratory was shut down for in-person testing in March 2020, which resulted in lower testing numbers than originally planned. Parents of 108 of the 109 children reported on the ethnicity of their child: 49% described their child as White, 21% Mixed Ethnicity or Race and 19% Southeast Asian. Nearly all parents answered questions about their educational background with 18% of

children having parents who did not attend university, 34% having one parent who attended university and 48% having two parents who attended university. Children were presented with three familiar objects: a rock, a piece of sponge-like material and a hacky sack. An experimenter began by asking children, "Do you think this rock is hard or soft?" All children stated that the rock was hard. Children were then randomly assigned to be told something that contradicted their beliefs about the world ("Actually, this rock is soft, not hard") or told something that confirmed their intuition ("That's right, this rock is hard"). Following these statements, all children were again asked, "So, do you think this rock is hard or soft?" Almost all children who heard claims that aligned with their beliefs continued to make the same judgement as before: that the rock was hard. In contrast, few of the children who were told that the rock was soft continued to make the same judgement as before. The experimenter then told children that they had

to leave the room for a phone call and left children to explore the object on their own. Children's behaviour was video-recorded.

The study found that most children regardless of age engaged in testing surprising claims.

The authors hypothesized that previously reported age differences in children's exploration of surprising claims might reflect developments in children's ability to use exploration to test more complex claims. It could also be that with increasing age, the motivation behind children's exploration changes, with younger children exploring because they believed what they had been told and wanted to see the surprising event and older children exploring because they were skeptical of what they had been told.

In the second study, which was conducted between September and December 2020, 154 4- to 7-year-old children were recruited from the same area as in the first study. Parents of 132 of the 154 children reported their ethnicity as 50%

White, 20% Mixed Ethnicity or Race and 17% Southeast Asian.

Nearly all parents answered questions about their educational background with 20% of children having parents who did not attend university, 35% having one parent who attended university and 45% having two parents who attended university. Over Zoom (due to Covid-19 restrictions), an experimenter shared their screen and presented each participating child with eight vignettes. For each vignette, children were told that the adult made a surprising claim (for example, "The rock is soft" or "The sponge is harder than the rock") and were asked what another child should do in response to that claim and why they should do that.

The results indicate that older children (six- and seven-year-olds) were more likely than younger children to suggest an exploration strategy tailored to the claim they heard (that is, touching the rock in the first example but touching the rock and the sponge in the second example).

6 Common Issues Breastfeeding Women Face

Breastfeeding, whether you are for it or not, comes with its share of problems. Issues with lactation or the baby latching, concerns about the baby's weight, and lack of support from family and workplace or healthcare are some common reasons for mothers discontinuing breastfeeding early. Dr Aruna Muralidhar MD MRCOG (UK), FRCOG (UK), senior consultant obstetrician and gynecologist at Fortis Hospital, Bengaluru, says, "Nourishing a baby with breast milk is the best gift that the mother can give in all her life. However, about half of the mothers give up breastfeeding after 6 months and only about 1/3rd of mothers continue to feed their babies till a year." She sheds some light on some common breastfeeding problems and their possible solutions.

**Not Enough Milk**  
"Many women feel that their milk secretion is not enough. However, this is not true most of the time. Not breastfeeding frequently enough can impact milk output. Frequent feeding or pumping stimulates breasts to make more milk by switching on the hormones, prolactin and oxytocin," explains Dr Aruna. Sometimes, the baby has difficulty extracting milk out even if there is enough milk. This could be due to poor latching. This is more likely in premature babies or babies with a structural problem with the mouth, such as tongue-tie, etc.  
**Sore Nipples**  
This is the most common complaint of mothers who have just initiated breastfeeding. "Nipple sensitivity usually goes away after about 30 seconds of



suckling whereas nipple pain due to some injury persists or even gets worse over time with feeding. The latter is due to incorrect technique and poor latch-on. If the baby latches on properly, the nipple is usually free-floating in the baby's mouth and doesn't get in contact with any structure of the mouth. Whereas if the baby only takes in the nipple without taking in the areola, there is more injury. Also, the milk doesn't get expressed," says Dr Aruna. Other ways of maintaining good nipple health and hygiene are to keep them dry and not use harsh soaps or overuse breast pads.

**Inverted Or Flat Nipples**  
Identifying flat or inverted nipples during pregnancy can help prepare them earlier for breastfeeding. "Rolling the nipple between the thumb and forefinger to make it stick out can help. Also, compressing the breast just behind the areola with fingers in a 'V' or 'C' shape to push the nipple outwards can be helpful," suggests Dr Aruna.  
**Baby's Mouth Is Too Small**  
Premature babies are likely to have smaller mouths. The use of nipple shields may help in such circumstances.  
**Breast Tautness**  
Breastfeeding, per se, may not be a major contributor to sagging breasts. Genetics, underlying muscle tone, weight gain, etc. also play a role. "Some ways to help maintain the shape and firmness are wearing a supportive bra, exercising regularly, maintaining a good posture, moisturising regularly and of course, stopping smoking," says Dr Aruna.  
**Too Much Breast Milk**  
Too much is too bad. For mothers with an oversupply of milk, the sudden gush of milk can make the baby choke or cough. Also, babies do not get the hindmilk, which is the last part of the milk supply and has the highest calories. "This problem mostly goes away with time. The milk supply balances out according to demand. In the meantime, holding the baby in an upright position to nurse and using fingers to regulate the flow of milk, making babies burp often, and avoiding pumping between feeds can help overcome this problem," says Dr Aruna.

These miscreants started firing as soon as they



came. A bullet hit Rajendra Singh's left thigh. While another bullet hit his finger. A fire also hit Sanjeev Gupta's feet. After carrying out the incident, these miscreants escaped by firing and threatening to kill the family. It was alleged that this attack was carried out by Jogindra Singh and his jailed son Kala Rana. The police have registered a case in this matter. History was made at the US Open on Sunday when Spanish teen sensation Carlos Alcaraz defeated Casper Ruud to earn his first Grand Slam title and secure the No. 1 ATP Ranking.

US Open finalist Ruud has also made a big jump following the run to his second major final, while Frances Tiafoe stormed his way into the Top 20 after reaching the semi-finals.

The 19-year-old Alcaraz has made history following his title run at the US Open, becoming the youngest World No. 1 in the history of the ATP Rankings. With the pressure on, Alcaraz outclassed Ruud in four hard-fought sets on Arthur Ashe Stadium to earn his sixth tour-level title.

Casper Ruud, a Norwegian, moved up five spots to No. 2 after making it to his second Grand Slam final at the US Open. In a remarkable run, the 23-year-old defeated Tommy Paul, Matteo Berrettini, and Karen Khachanov. In four prior visits to New York, the player had never advanced past the third round.

The 26-year-old Karen Khachanov has jumped 13 spots after he reached his first Grand Slam semi-final at the US Open in Flushing Meadows. Khachanov arrived in New York off the back of a first-round exit in Cincinnati, but quickly discovered his capacity on the US Open hard courts, earning outstanding victories against Montreal champion Pablo Carreno Busta and Washington titlist Nick Kyrgios.

The American Frances Tiafoe has climbed to a career-high No. 19 in the ATP Rankings following his dream run to the semi-finals on home soil in New York.



## Swiatek takes commanding lead

**FLORIDA:** Current World No.1 and 2022 US Open champion Iga Swiatek of Poland continue to build on her lead atop the WTA Rankings after by capturing her seventh singles title of the season, including her second Grand Slam win in New York.

Swiatek has owned the No.1 ranking 24 consecutive weeks, a streak that dates back to April 4. The US Open 2022 finalist Ons Jabeur of Tunisia returned to No.2 in this week's rankings, moving up three spots from No.5.

With 10,365 ranking points, Swiatek now holds a 5,275-point lead over Jabeur, the widest margin between No.1 and No.2 in seven years, when Serena Williams had a 6,591-point lead the week of August 31, 2015. Following her quarterfinal run at the US Open, American teenager Coco Gauff makes her Top 10 debut this week, at No.8, up four spots from No.12. At 18 years, 183 days old, Gauff becomes the youngest player to break into the Top 10 in 16 years, when a 17-year-old Nicole Pietrangeli made her Top 10 debut in 2006. Gauff also is the youngest American to make her Top 10 debut since Serena Williams in 1999.
