CU row: Punjab CM constitutes 3-member all-women SIT probe

On directions of Chief Minister Punjab Bhagwant Mann, Director General of Police (DGP) Punjab Gaurav Yadav on Monday constituted a three-member all-woman Special Investigation Team (SIT) under the overall supervision of ADGP Community Affairs Division and Women Affairs Gurpreet Kaur Deo, to ensure the effective and speedy investigation into Chandigarh University case.

The SIT comprises SP Counter Intelligence Ludhiana Rupinder Kaur Bhatti as the In-charge, while, two members include DSP Kharar-1 Rupinder Kaur and DSP AGTF Deepika Singh. The SIT will function under the supervision of DIG Rupnagar Range Gurpreet Singh Bhullar and SSP SAS Nagar Vivek Sheel Soni, and can co-opt any other member, based on functional requirements.

The development came a day after Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann ordered a high-level probe into the matter.

Terming the incident at Chandigarh University as unfortunate, DGP Gaurav Yadav apprised that the investigations are going on at full pace and the Po-



lice on Sunday late evening made three arrests including that of the student and two others from Himachal Pradesh after seizing cer-

tain electronic devices from their possession. He also expressed gratitude to the DGP Himachal Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh

Chandigarh University students end stir

MOHALI: Students of Chandigarh University ended their protest on Monday after getting an affirm assurance from the district and police administration of a fair and transparent investigation into the MMS videos leak.

Chandigarh University will remain closed till September 24 after massive protests by students demanding action on the alleged leak of objectionable videos from its girls' hostel. After the incident, a few students left for their homes. The university suspended the girls' hostel warden, Rajvinder Kaur, for misbehaving with the girl students. The Punjab Police on Monday formed a three-member special investigation team to probe the allegations of recording objectionable videos of the girls students. The SIT is headed by senior IPS officer Gurpreet Kaur Deo.

Police for extending all cooperation to the Punjab Police.

"The SIT will go to the bottom of this matter and whoever is found involved in this case will not be spared," he assured.

While appealing to students, parents, and the community at large to maintain calm and peace, the DGP assured them to protect the privacy and dignity of all the individuals concerned. He also urged the people to rely only on authentic channels for information and not get swayed away by the rumors being spread on various social media platforms, which are sometimes unverified.

The decision comes in the wake of massive protests by students demanding action against the allegations that objectionable videos of several students at the girls' hostel of Chandigarh University in Mohali were recorded by a fellow hosteller and shared on social media. Two accused have been arrested and one detained in connection with the incident.

Visuals today from the campus of the University showed several students carrying their luggage as they left the premises.

Protests that began on Saturday night continued till late on Sunday.

Haryana to give advance subsidy under PMMSY : CM

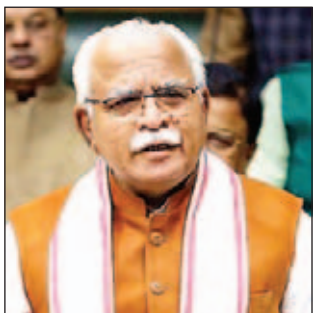

Haryana Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal while announcing a big bonanza for the farmers who are doing the Fisheries business, said that the Haryana Government will give an advance subsidy to the farmers under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) if there is any delay in the subsidy coming from the Central Government.

Besides this, the Chief Minister also announced for setting up of a testing lab related to this business in Sirsa. This will directly benefit the local farmers who are in this business as earlier, the farmers of this district had to especially go to Rohtak for the lab testing facility.

Sh. Manohar Lal was speaking at a workshop of shrimp farmers organized at Chormar Khara village in Sirsa district held on Monday.

He further announced that a wholesale fish market would also be opened in either Jhajjar or Gurugram district for the purchase and sale of fish. This would ensure the economic progress of the farmers. Like the Kisan Credit Card, the government is also providing the facility of credit cards to fish farmers. Similarly, the government is also holding discussions with



banks and insurance companies for providing insurance facilities for fisheries as well, added Sh. Manohar Lal.

The Chief Minister said that power consumption is a big issue in fish farming. At present, the government is providing electricity at the rate of 4.75 per unit to the farmers whose consumption is 20 kW. Fish farmers can also set up solar plants on their plots, for this a subsidy of Rs. 20,000 per horsepower, with a maximum limit of Rs 2 lakh is being given to them.

The Chief Minister said that an aqua park, at a cost of Rs 30 crore would be established in Garwa village in the Bhiwani district. This aqua park will be established on 25 acres. In this, new research related to fish farming, the new variety of fish farming, and research on seeds will be carried out. This will directly benefit the fish farmers, he said.

Sikh delegation meets Modi

Sensex snaps 3-day losing run, climbs 300 pts

MUMBAI: Benchmark indices found firmer ground on Monday after a three-session losing streak, propped up by buying in banking, finance, FMCG and auto counters despite a bearish trend overseas. After a weak beginning, the 30-share BSE Sensex recovered the lost ground and ended 300.44 points or 0.51 per cent higher at 59,141.23. On similar lines, the broader NSE Nifty jumped 91.40 points or 0.52 per cent to close at 17,622.25.

Amarinder Singh also merged his party Punjab Lok Congress (PLC) with BJP.

Earlier in the day, Amarinder Singh met BJP chief JP Nadda in Delhi.

Talking to reporters at the BJP headquarters, Amarinder Singh said he was grateful to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Home Minister Amit



Shah and the BJP president JP Nadda.

Law Minister Kiren Rijiju hailed Amarinder Singh joining the party and said right-thinking people of the

country should be united.

"A sensitive state like Punjab should be handled carefully. During his tenure as CM, he never kept poli-

tics before national security," Rijiju said. Amarinder made the announcement of joining the BJP after he met Union Home Minister Amit Shah on September 12 in Delhi. Amarinder Singh served Congress for long years and resigned as Chief Minister in September last year ahead of assembly polls. He later also resigned from the Congress and formed Punjab Lok Congress which tied up with BJP and SAD (Sanyukt) for the assembly polls held early this year.

Amarinder Singh's joining the BJP is a big shot in the arm for the party in the border state. The BJP now has a credible Sikh face in Punjab who has been active in state politics for several decades.

Thousands attend funeral of Queen Elizabeth at Westminster Abbey

The coffin of Queen Elizabeth II, the longest-serving monarch of the United Kingdom, was carried to Westminster Abbey in London for her state funeral on Monday.

Queen Elizabeth II died on September 8 at Balmoral Castle in Scotland.

Numerous guests ranging from political heads of countries to distinct royal family members and dignitaries from across the world landed in the UK for the funeral of Queen Elizabeth II. The Queen's funeral is the first state funeral in the UK since Winston Churchill's in 1965.

A state funeral means that the UK government has officially declared the day of the funeral as a bank holiday.

President Droupadi Murmu arrived in London to attend Queen Elizabeth II's state funeral on September 17 and offered condolences on behalf of the government of India.

Meanwhile, US President Joe Biden Sunday also expressed his condolences to the royal family.

While mourning the passing of Queen Elizabeth, Biden remembered Queen's warm candour and said, "The way she touched when she leaned over. The way – she had that look like, "Are you okay? Anything I



can do for you? What do you need?" And then also, "Make sure you do what you're supposed to do," Biden said adding that she reminded him of his mother.

Health dept conducts anti-tobacco drive in Mohali, 26 chalans issued



MOHALI (LK BANSAL): Under the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition) (COTPA) Act, 2003, a total of 26 chalans were issued and a fine of 4500 Rs was collected from the violators by the anti-tobacco team of District Health Department here today. Divulging the details, Civil Surgeon Dr. Adarshpal Kaur and Anti-Tobacco Nodal Officer Dr. Navdeep Singh said that the team carried out surprise checks at around 35 kiosks and street vendors selling tobacco products in Phase 6, 1, 5 and 7. 'A total of 26 chalans were issued to the street vendors selling tobacco products in violation of the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition) (COTPA) Act, 2003 and a fine worth Rs 4500 was collected from the violators.' informed Dr. Adarshpal Kaur.

Dr. Adarshpal Kaur said that some street vendors were caught selling cigarettes without any pictorial warning on them whereas some were selling imported cigarettes in violation of the Act. During the raids, it was found that some food vendors were selling tobacco products, which is prohibited under the law. Similarly, some street vendors were selling loose cigarettes. Instructions were given to the violators to put out warnings on the health hazards due to tobacco use. They were also asked to put out advertisements saying that they do not sell tobacco items to those below 18 years of age. Section 4 of the Act prohibits smoking in public places and section 6 prohibits the selling of tobacco products to minors. She said the raids will continue and strict action would be taken against the violators in future. The Civil Surgeon appealed to the citizens to help the health department curb usage of tobacco products and also to effectively implement the anti-tobacco law.

Sisters deaths in Lakhimpur Kheri: SC panel assures strict action

National Commission for Scheduled Castes (NCSC) member on Monday visited Lakhimpur Kheri in Uttar Pradesh where two teenage Dalit sisters were allegedly raped and murdered and their bodies were found hanging from a tree. Anju Bala, a member of the NCSC said she had met the family members of the deceased and assured the family of all possibilities of government help and aid. "The accused have committed a very heinous crime. Such people should be given capital punishment," said Bala. Taking stock of the situation the NCSC member said that the accused will be strictly dealt with. Bala later left for the district headquarters where she will be holding a review meeting with the District Magistrate, police officials and other administrative officials. The deceased sisters were found hanging from a tree in the region on September 15. The Uttar Pradesh police



arrested six people in connection with the incident. The NCSC on Thursday took suo motu cognisance of media reports on the deaths of the sisters and issued a notice to authorities seeking an Action Taken Report (ATR). Additional Director General (ADG) Law and Order Prashant Kumar said: "Junaid, Suhail and Hafeezur Rehman were reportedly arrested during an encounter with the local Nighasan police and SWAT team in the Nighasan police station area on Thursday morning. Following their interrogation, the other accused Karimuddin, and Chhotu Gautam were also arrested." As per police, a 315 bore pistol, two live cartridges and an empty shell have been recovered from the main accused Junaid's son Israel. ADG Kumar further said that as soon as the matter came to the notice of the police late in the evening, a team immediately rushed to the spot. "Apart from the local police, IG Range Laxmi Singh from Lucknow was immediately rushed to the spot. Prompt action was taken under the leadership

of SP, Lakhimpur, Sanjeev Sinha and raids were conducted at different places to arrest the culprits, he added. The accused have been booked under Sections 302, 376 of the Indian Penal Code and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO) Act. Protests broke out after the news came to light with the father of the deceased demanding justice for his daughters stating that the "culprits should be hanged". He also demanded compensation of Rs 1 crore and a government job for one of the family members. My daughters were abducted from the house and then they were raped and murdered. I demand justice, and the culprits should be hanged," said the victim's father. The post-mortem reports confirmed that both girls were raped and strangled. Superintendent of Police (SP) Sanjeev Suman told ANI citing the report that the two minors were murdered after being raped. The girls were lured to the farms and raped by Sohail and Junaid.

Police beat the librarians and professors who came to demand their rights

Convener of the Front, Dr Sohail, said that behind this protest, there is a demand from the government that a panel with the Chief Minister and the

Minister of Higher Education regarding the situation after the announcement of the recruitment of 1158 assistant professors and librarians by the Punjab and Haryana High Court was cancelled and the written decision was issued and a meeting should be held. A case should be fought on a double bench in the High Court against the government's decision to cancel the recruitment by announcing it in the regular press. Under this recruitment process, the employment security of assistant professors who have been appointed in colleges should be guaranteed. For candidates who have received the appointment letters and whose selection lists have not come, to make a permanent arrangement for their employment, this recruitment should be initiated by proceeding sincerely in the High Court.

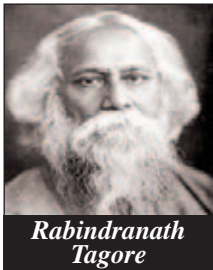

"Up to now, all we have had to treat more severe eczema is immune-suppressing medications, such as oral steroids, which we try to avoid in children because they are associated with so many side effects and thus are not a preferred treatment for a chronic skin disease," Paller said. "The potential long-term impact on the development of the immune system in young children is also of concern with these immunosuppressants." The first "biologic" treatment to treat eczema in a targeted manner or a focused attack on only what researchers have discovered is causing the disease's skin symptoms, has recently been accessible and is called dupilumab. This medication was determined to be efficient and secure in tests involving adults, adolescents, and other school-aged children. However, Paller noted that children under 5 were not assessed for safety and could not receive this drug. The child receives a monthly shot of the drug from a

"By treating more aggressively to calm the immune system activation in these young children with early, severe eczema, we may also reduce the risk of their developing a range of allergic problems, changing their life beyond improving eczema," Paller said.

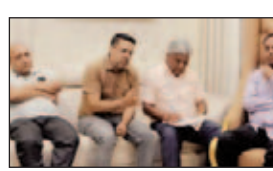

Mixing traditional farming and crop diversification

Pradeep Singh, a progressive farmer of Birarwal village who cultivates wheat and paddy as well as other alternative crops, is becoming an example of the combination of traditional agriculture and crop diversity, and is becoming a torch bearer for other farmers in agriculture. Pradeep Singh, who is farming in 34 acres, said that during the rabi season, he planted 5 acres of wheat, 20 acres of potatoes, 4 acres of vegetables and 2 acres of peas, along with seedless



cucumbers, colored capsicums and Grows mushrooms in winter. Similarly, during the kharif season, 20 acres of paddy, 10 acres of chillies and 4 acres of cucumber were grown with the help of transplanters. The forward-

thinking farmer said that by adopting this type of farming model, compared to planting a single crop, the risk of crop damage and other risks is very low, while also providing a good increase in income. Sharing his farming experience, Pradeep Singh said that after harvesting paddy through super SMS combine, the straw is mixed in the fields using mulch and mulching solution and then other crops including potatoes are sown. He said that by mixing straw in the field, the potato crop benefits the most and the size and yield of potato increases significantly.

The first T20I of the three-match series between India and Australia will start in Mohali on September 20 and it will be on the mind of Men in Blue to head into the ICC T20 World Cup 2022 after downing the defending champions in home conditions.

India will start off their home series against Australia on September 20. The next T20I match will take place in Nagpur on September 23, followed by the third and final T20I match in Hyderabad on September 25.

Though India could not progress past the Super Four phase of Asia Cup 2022, they have some positives coming into this series. The biggest of them all is Virat Kohli regaining his form. 'King Kohli' as he is known to fans, scored 276 runs in five innings during the Asia Cup, which included one century, a highly-anticipated one and two half-centuries. The way ball found the middle of his bat was a sight not seen since a long while and fans would be hoping that they get to see more of it.

He first trapped Corey Anderson leg before wicket when the New Zealander was caught plumb in front of the wickets, offering no shot to an incoming delivery. Edwards, who is known for his "you can't see me" celebration after taking a wicket, followed that up with the dismissals of Swapnil Asnodkar and Ricardo Powell. Both the batters were caught behind by Bhillwara keeper Naman Ojha.

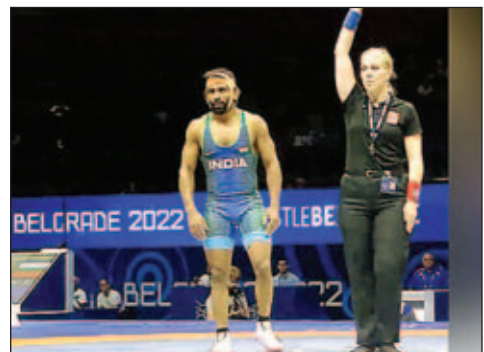

He defeated Rivera in the bout by 11-9. The wrestler, who recently won a gold medal in Commonwealth Games scripted a remarkable comeback to win the match. He won on basis of VPO1-Points and the opponent's scores.

In the initial stages of the match, Punia looked down and out, trailing by 0-6. But then he fought his way back into the match, scoring 11 points and letting his opponent score only three more.



He made his way back into medal contention after a loss to USA's John Michael Diakomihalis in the quarterfinal by 10-0, on basis of Victory by Superiority (VSU).

A hard-fought 7-6 win over Vazgen Tevanyan of Armenia took him to the bronze medal match. He achieved the win on basis of VPO1-Points and the opponent's scores. This is Punia's fourth medal at the Championships, starting his journey with bronze in 2013. He went on to win silver in the 2018 Championships and followed it with another bronze in 2019. Now, he has four championship medals.

This is India's second medal at the ongoing edition of the World Wrestling Championships.
