Yamuna water enters fields



RADAUR: The water level of Yamuna river has increased after heavy rains. Late night, about two lakh 95 thousand cusecs of water that came out of Hathnikund barrage reached Gumthala and Jathlana area early in the morning. Tehsildar Suresh Kumar gave information about this. Announcements were also made in the villages about this. After the rise in the water level of Yamuna river, about three to four feet of water get accumulated in the fields situated in low-lying areas across the Yamuna river due to which the crops of paddy, sug arcane, green fodder and sesame standing in the fields of the farmers got submerged. The damage caused to the farmers can be assessed when the water recedes.

On the other hand, there is also a danger of soil erosion on the river edges. At present, the work of the bridge being built on the Yamuna river has also beer delayed due to the water coming into the Yamuna river. The completion of the bridge construction work may also take more time due to the damage on both the sides. Surjit Singh Bhura, former sarpanch and social worker of village Gumthala, said that about 400 to 500 acres of crops have been submerged by the water of Yamuna river. The water of Yamuna river has accumulated in the green fodder, paddy and sugarcane crops standing in the fields. This is expected to cause huge losses to the farmers. He told that 40 acres of farmer Mahindra Pal. 19 acres of Raipal. 18 acres of Lakhwinder, 22 acres of Surendra Kumar, 17 acres of Mukhtyar Singh, 12 acres of Buta Singh, Man Singh 10 acres, Dilbagh four acres, Hukam Singh About three and a half acres of Malkit six acres. Prakash five acres. Chic Singh's three acres, Kulwant nine acres, Vinod Batra's nine acres, Pawan Kumar's five acres, Palvindra's seven acres, Sukhvindra's five acres, Five acres of Singram Saini, two acres of Qurban, three acres of Naseem etc. have accumulated water. All these farmers are on the other side of Yamuna river. Water has started coming out somewhere on this side too, but after the water recedes, the risk of erosion will remain high.

CBG plant to be set up in **Ludhiana: Aman Arora**

SUMER GARG CHANDIGARH, SEPT 26

Punjab Government led by Chief Minister S Bhagwant Mann will set up an additional Compressed Biogas (CBG) plant at Haibowal Dairy Complex in Ludhiana for scientific disposal of the waste produced from the dairy complex.

Revealing this, Punjab New & Renewable Energy Sources Minister Mr. Aman Arora said that Punjab Energy Development Agency (PEDA) has started the process to set up an additional Compressed Biogas (CBG) Plant with a capacity of 12000 raw biogas (about 4.8 ton CBG) at Haibowal Dairy Complex on Build Operate and Own (BOO) basis. One CBG plant with a capacity to consume 225 ton raw material has already been opera-



tional at the dairy complex. This project is a part of Buddah Nullah Rejuvenation Project, informed the Minister while adding that the Punjab Government will not leave any stone unturned to generate enviornment friendly fuel from waste and concerted efforts are being made in this direction to ensure clean and tion programmes in Punjab. green environment to the

Cabinet Minister said that under this project cattle dung would be collected from the dairy complex. Any shortfall of cattle dung will be met by using vegetable or mandi waste, municipal segregated green waste, agro-waste or types biodegradable waste.

PEDA has invited an e-tender for setting up the CBG plant. The closing date of bid is 26th October, 2022 (till 5 pm). The interested companies can log on to the website eproc.punjab.gov.in for more details. Notably, PEDA is the state nodal agency for promotion and development of renewable energy programmes/projects and energy conserva-

Unseasonal rain caused heavy damage to sugarcane and paddy crops

VB arrest absconding accused for committing fraud with bank

92 tourists from Punjab, Haryana, Delhi trapped in tracking site Triund

In the hills of Triund, the famous trekking site of McLeodganj in the tourist city of Dharamshala, 92 tourists were trapped in the continuous heavy rain and haze. The administration received information on Sunday afternoon that various groups of tourists from Punjab, Haryana, Delhi and Faridkot, including other neighboring states, were stranded in the cold rain-smog and light snowfall in Dhauladhar, incessantly in the hilly areas. Despite the bad weather, a large number of tourists had left for overnight stay in the hills, due to which tourists from Punjab, Haryana, Delhi were stuck due to severe weather and lack of visibility in the haze till morning. Due to excessive rain, the flow of water increased in other small drains including Triund and Bhagsunag drains. During this, due to the heavy fog in the hill, the way and any safe place were not visible to the tourists. At the same time, some local trekkers and guides took tourists in large numbers to the Triund hills despite the bad weather. In this it has come to the fore that these

tourists did not go to Triund through Goolan check post under Mcleodganj police station, while they went from Chohla-Banagotu of Indrunag and other routes towards Kirthani and Mana Dhar of Triund. At the same time, due to heavy rain and storm, even the tents could not stand in the hill, forcing the tourists to get stuck in heavy rains. Along with the tourists, nine guides and helpers were also present, they too were trapped due to the bad weather conditions. According to the information received, the Dharamsala administration first information about people including 11 tourists being trapped from the hills of Triund, from Banagotu down to Mana Dhar. In which information was received about six girls, four boys, tourists and one helper guide. After getting information about this, the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) team along with the Maklodangi Police from the administration left for the spot. In which a team of 15 people including the Inspector came out for the spot. As the team started reaching towards Triund hills amidst heavy rain, during this time 82 tourists of different groups from

different regions were also found stranded.



Raging battle

erala has seen many bitter altercations between state governments and governors. This is not unusual in states where the party in power is opposed to the ruling dispensation at the Centre. Yet, the ongoing spat between the 17-month-old Left Democratic Front government and the governor, Arif Mohammed Khan, has assumed unprecedented dimensions. For the first time in Kerala's history, the governor held a two-hour-long media conference at the Raj Bhavan on September 19 to attack the government and the chief minister, Pinarayi Vijayan.

Crossing constitutional restraints, Khan slammed the government's various policies and said the LDF's ideology is of "foreign origin" that believed in violence as a legitimate political tool. The chief minister has now accused the governor of having political ambitions and being a tool of the sangh parivar to destabilise his government. Khan has indicated that he wouldn't sign the government ordinances intended to curtail the authority of the governor as university chancellor and alter the constitution of the Lokayukta. A veteran with a half-a-century-long chequered political career, Khan has deployed all the tricks of brinkmanship in the ongoing war of attrition. What's new is the high-decibel clash between the governor and the chief minister. The state's two highest functionaries had refrained from attacking each other until now. This continued even when the governor clashed many times with the Communist Party of India (Marxist) or the Congress since he took over in September 2019. But on September 15, the governor took on the chief minister personally for the first time, accusing him of nepotism. Khan was referring to the controversial appointment of Priya Varghese as associate professor of Malayalam at the University of Kannur, allegedly overlooking more deserving candidates. Varghese is the wife of K.K. Ragesh, the CPI(M)'s former Rajya Sabha member, who is now the chief minister's private secretary." Can anyone believe the Chief Minister didn't know this?" Khan asked. He also said he wouldn't allow executive interference in universities."I had said earlier I will give up my chancellor position. And I still do not want to continue, but if I'm the chancellor, I will not be a rubber stamp." Vijayan hit back immediately, calling the governor's outburst ridiculous and not befitting his office. "I don't know what is happening to him. He seems to be venting his frustration from some of his plans getting defeated. Mr Khan should examine himself or get himself examined."

Singapore tourism gets boost from high Indian tourist arrivals

Then the Formula One circus rolls into Singapore this week for the 13th running of the Singapore F1 Grand Prix from September 30 to October 2, it will signal Singapore's strong return as a host of world-class events after the COVID-19 pandemic brought its tourism industry to a screeching halt.

With pent-up demand for exciting live events, crowds from around the world will descend on the city-state in numbers not seen since the first Singapore GP in 2008 when a sell-out crowd of 300,000 attended the event. Since then, the best three-day attendance was the 268,000 achieved in 2019. COVID-19 shut down the world's only street circuit night race in 2020 and

It is estimated that around 40 per cent of the spectators at the Grand Prix are foreigners, no doubt many will be from India.

Indians at the moment, make up the second largest group of visitors to Singapore by country of origin. Up till August, Singapore received a total of 2.96 million visitors. Out of these, 378,490 are from India. Indonesia is the largest source of foreign visitors to Singapore till August at 588,870. Malaysia is in third place with 264,170, followed by Australia (258,670) and Vietnam (177,510).

July and August, saw about 725,000 foreigners entering Singapore each month, the highest so far this year. At this pace and if global travel continues to pick up, Singapore expects to reach approximately 6 million visitors by the end of the year.

COVID-19 caused Singapore's tourism industry to completely shut down. Tourism-dependent businesses including restaurants, hotels and retail shops were shut down (some forever), and workers in the industry had to find other forms of em-

If the first three months of 2020 - just before the pandemic forced border closures around the world - were not counted, Singapore received just 90,000 foreign visitors



330,000 visitors. At its peak, in 2019, Singapore was the fifth most visited city in the world with over 19.1 million visitors, beating more glamorous cities like New York

During the COVID-enforced tourism winter in Singapore, the Singapore Tourism Board (STB) did not sit still. Instead, it went on the offensive to ensure Singapore remains top of mind of potential foreign visitors. STB's regional offices launched new initiatives to engage fans and strengthened Singapore's brand image around the world. It also partnered with technology, media, and tourism industry players in key source markets to jointly promote Singapore as an attractive destination for future

Since the start of the pandemic, STB has been working closely with industry

sector. In February 2020, the Tourism Recovery Action Task Force (TRAC), comprising tourism leaders from both the private and public sectors, was set up to develop and implement joint recovery strategies. TRAC helped to identify opportunities arising from COVID-19, driving and implementing measures to co-create recovery plans and instil confidence in Singa-

pore's tourism sector. During the tourism lull, various training and upskilling activities took place to support industry workers for the time when tourism resumes. These included job redesign initiatives to train existing employees in new skills that allowed them to be redeployed to other areas outside of their specialisations. The result of STB's active efforts to re-positioning Singapore as the top tourism and business destination in Asia

was the rapid recovery of the industry as borders opened.

In the first three months of 2022, Singapore hosted more than 150 local and international events attended by over 37,000

people, according to the tourism board. With COVID restrictions eased and as tourism bounced back as seen by the number of arrivals in the last couple of months, hotels have been busy. Earlier this month, Bloomberg reported that with the raft of high-profile events lined up in the coming months, Hotel rooms in Singapore are the most expensive in almost a decade.

The latest data from STB showed that the average hotel room rate in July rose almost 70 per cent year-on-year to SGD 259 (USD 185) a night since September 2012. Despite this, a stay at a five-star luxury hotel in Singapore is still reasonably priced compared with regional peers.

Navratri: History and significance



China-Nepal rail project

hina's ambitious project in Nepal related to building a railway line in the landlocked nation has few supporters. Although China plans to start a feasi-bility study for the 170 km Trans-Hi-malayan Tibet-Nepal railway, environmental and technical questions remain. Such concerns have been raised by Nepali experts, reported Eye of Nepal.

Moreover, the dispute over the blocked Nepal-China railway line has not yet been resolved. President Xi Jinping said in 2019 that the proposed line would transform the project has not received much support from the Nepalese leadership, engineers or environmentalists, reported Eye of Nepal.

Towards the end of 2018, China conducted a pre-feasibility study of a railway for Nepal, which clearly stated that it was a very difficult project due to the terrain gradient. The study estimates an investment of USD 2.75 billion for the 72.5 km section but unfortunately, the report of the study has not been made public yet, reported Eye of Nepal. As a result, doubts have arisen in Nepal about the feasibility of the proposed railway. Aman Chitrakar of Nepal Railway said that this project will be as difficult as the third pole. He said that the world's most challenging railway engineering project is the 4,500-meter Tibetan Plateau route that reaches Kathmandu through the Himalayas. Technical experts have expressed serious concern about Nepal's lack of capacity, reported Eye of Nepal. While reviewing the



technical reports, it was found that there is no technically qualified railway in Nepal and there is a lack of engineers who can evaluate the pros and cons of the proposed railway line. Apart from the geological challenges, there are also many geopolitical obstacles in the Nepal China Railway.

It has been suggested that the proposed train from Nepal will have an ecological impact and there has not been enough discussion about this line in Nepal.

Nothing has been said yet about what this railway means for Nepalis. Nepal has imported goods worth 1.7 billion dollars from China until July 2021. And in the middle of April 2022, Nepal's export to China was only 50 million US dollars, reported Eve of Nepal Eye of Nepal.


The proposed 170 km railway is part of China's ambitious Belt and Road initiative. Once built, it will connect the Kerung Gyrong in southern Tibet.

Solvent research solves mystery of solar cell durability

olvents that allow solution deposition of one layer without harming the other may make it easier to create high-efficiency solar cells containing layers of 2D and 3D perovskites.

It took some experimentation to determine the best solvent design for applying a 2D top layer of the correct composition and thickness without harming the 3D bottom layer (or vice versa). This type of cell would convert more sunlight into electricity than either layer alone and be more

Aditya Mohite, a chemical and biomolecular engineer at Rice's George R. Brown School of Engineering, and his group announced in Science their accomplishment in creating thin 3D/2D solar cells with a power conversion efficiency of

According to Mohite, this is as efficient as most commercially available solar cells. "This is extremely



but the materials tend to be stressed that get light from both sides, as well by light, humidity and heat. Mohite as back-contacted cells," he says. and many others have worked for "The 2D side absorbs blue and visible years to make perovskite solar cells photons, whereas the 3D side absorbs practical. near-infrared photons." Perovskites

The new advance, he said, largely removes the last major roadblock to commercial production.

"This is significant at multiple levels," Mohite said. "One is that it's fundamentally challenging to make a solution-processed bilayer when both layers are the same material. The problem is they both dissolve in the same solvents.

When you put a 2D layer on top of a 3D layer, the solvent destroys the underlying layer," he said. "But our new method resolves this." According to Mohite, 2D perovskite cells are stable yet inefficient in converting sunlight. Three-dimensional per-ovskites are more efficient but less stable. By combining them, you get the best of both worlds. "This leads to extremely high efficiency since we are now able to generate layers with amazing control for the first time in the field," he added. "It enables us to manage the flow of charge and energy for solar cells, optoelectronic devices, and LEDs.

He claims that the efficiency of test cells subjected to the lab equivalent of 100% sunshine for almost 2,000 hours "does not decline by even 1%." The cells were around 1 micron thick without the glass substrate.

Solution processing is widely used in industry and includes a variety of processes for depositing material on a surface in a liquid, including spin coating, dip coating, blade coating, slot die coating, and others. The pure layer remains when the liquid evaporates.

The key is a balance of two solvent properties: dielectric constant and Gutmann donor number. The dielectric constant is the ratio of a material's electric permeability to its free space. This affects how efficiently a solvent dissolves an ionic substance. The donor number quantifies the solvent molecules' capacity to donate electrons. "If you find the correlation between them, you'll find there are about four solvents that allow you to dissolve perovskites and spin-coat them without destroying the 3D layer," Mohite said.

He claims their research is compatible with roll-to-roll production, which can generate 30 metres of solar cells every minute.

For the first time, this innovation is leading to perovskite device heterostructures with more than one active layer," said co-author Jacky Even, a physics professor at France's National Institute of Science and Technology in Rennes. "The goal of using perovskites to create sophisticated semiconductor structures is going to come true." The next phase will be to develop new applications and investigate new physical phenome-

'Not only does this have ramifications for solar energy, but also for green hydrogen, with cells that can create energy and convert it to hydrogen," Mohite explained. "It may also allow off-grid solar for automobiles, drones, building-integrated photovoltaics, and even agriculture.

Rankings boost for India after T201 series win



AGENCY DUBAI, SEP 26

India's narrow series triumph over Australia has been rewarded with Rohit Sharma's side extending their lead at the top of the ICC Men's T20I team rankings.

Half centuries to Suryakumar Yadav and Virat Kohli helped India clinch a final over thriller in the third and series-deciding match against Australia in Hyderabad on Sunday.

India's success improved their T20I team ranking by one point to 268 points overall, which is a seven-point lead over their closest rival in England with 261 points.

Ironically it was England's narrow loss in the fourth game of their ongoing series against Pakistan that helped India increase their buffer at the head of proceedings, with Matthew Mott's team falling to a narrow three-run loss in Karachi.

That series remains tied at two games apiece, with plenty of rankings points still to play for during the final three matches in Lahore and ahead of the start of the ICC Men's T20 World Cup next month.

England will maintained a second place on the rankings should they win one of those contests, while South Africa will get the chance to stake their claim when they take on India in a three-match series that commences on Wednesday.

Pakistan are currently tied with South Africa for third place on the team rankings

with 258 points but could rise as high as second by winning the remaining three matches against England.

New Zealand remain in fifth place on the T20I team rankings with a total of 252 points, with Kane Williamson's side next in action just prior to the start of the T20 World Cup when they host Pakistan and Bangladesh for a tri-series on home soil.

Sixth-placed Australia drop one point to 250 points overall following their series loss to India, with the reigning T20 World Cup champions still scheduled to play six matches - against West Indies, England and India – before they get the chance to defend their trophy

Kohli becomes India's second highest run-scorer in international cricket



NEW DELHI, SEPT 26

Virat Kohli on Sunday surpassed Rahul Dravid to become the second highest run-scorer for India in international cricket. The star batter accomplished this feat in the third T20I against Australia in Hyderabad. In the match, the 'Chase Master' Kohli was in full flow, switching from attacker to anchor, from anchor to attacker at will. He struck 63 runs in 48 balls, consisting of three fours and

four sixes. His strike rate was also pretty solid at 131.25.

Now, Kohli has a total of 24,078 runs in 471 matches across 525 innings at an average of 53.62. His best individual score in cricket is 254*. 71 centuries have come from his bat along with 125 half-cen-

He has surpassed Indian great Rahul Dravid, who has scored 24,064 international runs for the Indian cricket team. Though Dravid's international cricket run tally stands at 24,208, the rest of his 144 runs have been scored as a part of teams like Asia XI, ICC World XI. The leading run scorer for Team India in international cricket is none other than Master Blaster Sachin Tendulkar. In 664 matches across 782 innings, Tendulkar has scored

his bat, with the best score of 248*. These batters are followed by former skipper Sourav Ganguly (18,433), MS Dhoni (17,092) and Virender Sehwag (16,892). Coming to the third T20I against Australia, visitors Aussies posted 186/7 in their 20 overs. Cameron Green (52 off 21 balls) helped them get to an explosive start. But following that, spinners Yuzvendra Chahal (1/22) and Axar Patel (3/33) helped the Men in Blue make a comeback, restricting Aussies' run flow and leaving them struggling at 117/6 in 13.5 overs. Then a 68run stand between Tim David (54) and Daniel Sams (28*) helped the visitors reach 186/7 in their 20 overs. Axar was India's star with the ball and continued his good run in the series. Chahal, Bhuvneshwar Kumar and Harshal Patel also got one wicket each. Chasing 187, Team India lost openers KL Rahul (1) and skipper Rohit Sharma (17) quickly, leaving them struggling at 2/30. It has been 19 days since an arrest warrant was issued against him by Kath-

"It is my good fortune to be included in the national cricket team at the age of 16. It was not something that could be earned by my little hard work. I have always moved forward with the desire to keep Nepal's name high in the cricket world. I feel proud to make the name of Nepal known through my hard work," he said. Further adding, Lamichhane

claimed "I came to know about the complaint filed against me and the false accusation of rape. This has not only affected and damaged my mental health but physical health as well." Talking about his mental distress, he stated that he is currently in isolation without mentioning his whereabouts, "All these things affected me mentally on the one hand and, on the other hand, I had to go through physical illness. Therefore, I decided to keep myself in isolation for some time," he said.

However, Lamichhane is not in touch with both the police and the Cricket Association of Nepal (CAN) lately. The warrant issued in his name and the lic mentally exhausted him, he has said.

"I have been mentally and physically affected by the portrayal of a criminal based on false allegations, I have been brought back to normal with the advice of doctors and my health is gradually improving and I am planning to return to Nepal as soon as possible to defend the false complaint against me."
