Kharge set to become next Cong President

NEW DELHI, SEPT 30

Senior Congress leader and Leader of Opposition in Rajya Sabha Mallikarjun Kharge on Friday filed his nomination for the post of Congress president at the party office in the national capital. As per sources his nomination will be supported by various senior leaders of party and he is likely to be next party chief.

"I am going to file my nomination (for Congress president post)", Kharge told media persons while heading towards the party office.

Earlier, Congress MP Shashi Tharoor and Jharkhand leader KN Tripathi filed their nomination for the topmost position.

Ahead of filing his nomination,

Tharoor had visited Raj Ghat to pay homage to Mahatma Gandhi today.

Congress leader Shashi Tharoor on said he will not withdraw his nomination for the party president after Mallikarjun Kharge entered the contest for the chief of the party.

"Those who would like to continue the status quo would not be inclined to vote for me because I represent change, a different approach, and a vision to take the party forward in a different way, as for some years we've been suffering setbacks," Tharoor said while addressing the media after filing his nomination at the AICC office in the national capital.

Meanwhile, Jharkhand Congress leader KN Tripathi also filed his nomination for the party's topmost position and said that "the decision of party



ty leaders is respected".

Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot on Friday said all senior leaders had decided to back veteran Congress leader Mallikarjun Kharge's candidature for the party chief's election.

tion.

Gehlot, who declared on Thursday that he would not contest the election, also announced his support for Kharge after meeting the senior leader at his 10, Rajaji Marg residence here.

"All senior leaders have together decided on Kharge's candidature," Gehlot told reporters outside Kharge's residence.

Former Union minister Shashi Tharoor will be Kharge's challenger.

Asked whether he had offered to resign as Rajasthan chief minister, Gehlot evaded a direct response. Earlier, former Madhya Pradesh CM Digvijaya Singh and Rajasthan CM Ashok Gehlot were also a part of the race which they eventually stated to have dropped.

RBI raises repo rate by 50 bps, EMIs to go up

On expected lines, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Friday raised the repo rate by 50 basis points (bps) to 5.9 per cent in a bid to contain inflation which has been above its comfort level for the past many months. Repo rate is the interest rate RBI charges commercial banks for borrowing cash. If RBI raises the repo rate, banks will increase their lending rate for borrowers. This means loan EMIs for consumers would go up.

The RBI move is in line with the global trends of tightening monetary policy adopted by central banks. "Based on an assessment of



the macro economic situation and its outlook, the MPC (Monetary Policy Committee) decided by a majority of five members out of six to increase the policy repo rate by 50 basis points to 5.9 per cent with immediate effect," RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das while announcing the monetary policy.

Consequently, the standing deposit facility (SDF) rate stands adjusted to 5.65 per cent and the marginal standing facility (MSF) and bank rate to 6.15 per cent. The MPC also decided by a majority five out of six members to remain focussed on withdrawal of accommodation to ensure that inflation remains within the target going forward while supporting growth.

Suicide attacker kills 32 in Kabul

A suicide bomber on Friday attacked an educational institute in the Afghan capital, killing at least 32 people, media reports said.

As many as 27 others were wounded in the blast in the Dasht-e-Barchi neighbourhood of western Kabul, a predominantly Shia Muslim area and home to the minority Hazara community. Al Jazeera quoted police spokesman Khalid Zadran as saying.

"Students were preparing for an exam when a suicide bomber struck at this educational centre. Unfortunately, 19 people have been martyred and 27 others wounded," he said.



Small traders of Haryana to get booths at concessional rates : CM

Haryana Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal today announced that Mukhyamantri Vyapari Kshatipurti Beema Yojana has been implemented to give insurance benefits to small traders. Under this scheme, compensation at the normal insurance rate is given to the traders to compensate for the loss of their stock caused due to fire, flood, etc.

The Chief Minister said this while addressing a programme organized for the Rehabilitation of Rehri market in Sector 9 of Panchkula today.

Sh. Manohar Lal laid the foundation stone of Antyodaya Market and performed Havan. Later he distributed possession letters to 8 allottees and released the brochure of Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran (HSVP).

The Chief Minister announced that all the street vendors of the state including Gurugram, Faridabad would be allotted Pucca booths so



that no trader should face this kind of untoward incident like that happened in sector 9 Panchkula Rehri market on September 1, 2022. Pucca booths will also be made in Rehri Market of Sector 7, 11 and 17 in Panchkula.

Under this scheme, a rebate of 25 percent in the market rate would also be provided to the small traders by HSVP, but this exemption would not be applicable to the encroachers, informed Sh. Manohar Lal.

He said that the booth costs around Rs. 17 lakh as per the current market rate, but after the rebate, a booth measuring 63 square feet will be available for about Rs 13 lakh and 75 percent loan facility has also been provided from the Central Bank.

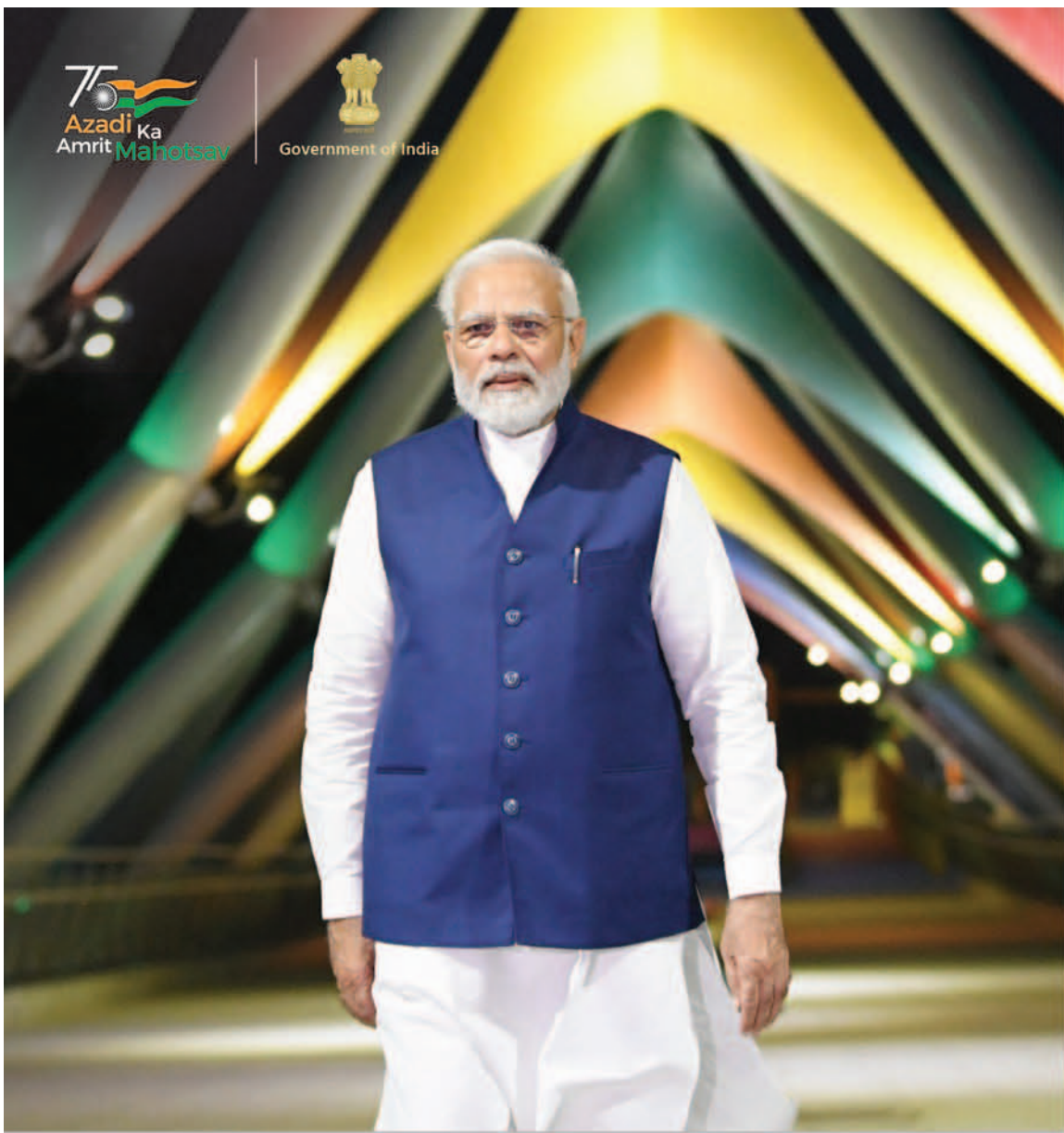

Punjab goods and services tax amendment bill passed

The Punjab Government led by Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on Friday passed the Punjab Goods and Services Tax (Amendment) Bill 2022 in the Punjab Assembly. The Finance, Planning, Excise and Taxation Minister, Advocate Harpal Singh Cheema tabled this bill in the House which was passed with thumping majority. Launching a scathing attack on the opposition for creating unwarranted hue and cry in the House, Cheema said that previous governments had not made any effort to improve the financial health of the state exchequer.

"Now, Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann led Punjab Government has plugged all the loopholes and stopped bogus billing, which will not only benefit the traders but will also increase the revenue of the state," he said.

Revealing the importance of the amendments made in the Bill, Harpal Singh Cheema said that tax evaders will be dealt severely. He said that to check the menace of bogus billing and fraudulent ITC, Section 16 of the Act has been amended to empower the State Government to restrict the availment of ITC by the taxpayer. "To facilitate ease of doing business, time period for availment of ITC has been extended to thirtieth day of November following the end of the financial year in which the supply is carried out, or furnishing of the relevant annual return, whichever is earlier", he added. The Finance Minister said that rationalising the furnishing of returns by the taxpayers, amendment has been passed to be carried in section 37, 38 and 39 of the Act.

He said Section 39 amended to provide for furnishing of details of outward supplies as a condition for furnishing the return to check the menace of bogus billing and fraudulent ITC and to improve compliance.

He further added that late fees is introduced for late filing of statement by taxpayers who are Tax collectors such as e-commerce operators to improve compliance. He said that Section 49 has been amended for improving compliance to empower the government to prescribe restrictions on utilization of ITC by taxpayer. The Finance Minister said that to facilitate ease of doing business, Section 50 has been retrospectively amended to limit the levy of interest only on the ITC wrongly availed and utilized.

He further added that section 54 is amended to provide that time period for claim of such refund shall be two years from the furnishing of return to streamline refunds to SEZ Unit or Developer. Notably, the Union Government, on the recommendation of the GST Council, had amended the Cen-



CM introduces Punjab State Vigilance Commission Repeal Bill

CHANDIGARH: Punjab Chief Minister today moved the Punjab State Vigilance Commission (Repeal) Bill, 2022 that was passed unanimously. Moving a resolution to this regard, the Chief Minister said that the main function of the Punjab State Vigilance Commission is to enquire or cause enquires into complaints alleging commission of offences by a public servant under the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988, Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018. He said that the Commission is also empowered to exercise superintendence and control over the functioning of the Vigilance Bureau and Police establishment in so far as it relates to corruption cases. Bhagwant Mann said that Punjab state Vigilance Commission Act 2020, which was supposed to be enacted on the lines of the Central Vigilance Commission Act 2003, suffers from serious deviations. The Chief Minister said that Vigilance Commission constituted under this Act is, therefore, not serving any useful objectives except being a burden on the State exchequer. He said that as there are multiple agencies in the State to deal with same set stakeholders including full-fledged Vigilance Department. Therefore, Bhagwant Mann said that to avoid overlapping, contradictory findings, resultant delays and gaps in communication, it has become necessary to repeal the Punjab State vigilance Commission Act 2020 (Punjab Act no. 20 of 2020).

Mann slams Cong for wasting precious time of house

CHANDIGARH: Punjab Chief Minister today slammed the Congress leaders for their irresponsible behaviour at the floor of house. The Chief Minister, while taking the Congress leaders to cudgels, said that the Congress leaders have wasted the precious time of the house by frequent disruptions. He asserted that these leaders have mercilessly wasted the tax payer's money by creating ruckus during the proceedings of the house. Bhagwant Mann bemoaned that the session could have been used judiciously for discussing the various issues pertaining to the people of Punjab and the state. Disclosing this official spokesperson said that SDMs were directed to reach out to the villages where maximum incidents of fire have been reported in the past in order to reduce the incidents of stubble fire this year and ensure that the stubble burning incidents



received from Punjab Remote Sensing Centre (PRSC) are visited by the Nodal officers and Patwaris within 48 hours & updated on ATR application developed by PRSC. Red entry of the farmers engaged in stubble burning should be made in Khasra Girdawri. Police department was directed to launch FIR u/s 188 of IPC against the farmers which are found burning the stubble. Agriculture Department was directed to carry out awareness in the villages and persuade the farmers

not to burn stubble. Punjab Pollution Control Board was directed to coordinate with all the stake holder departments. During the meeting it is was informed by Environmental Engineer, PPCB that in compliance of NGT orders Environmental Compensation amounting to Rs. 2500 per incident will be imposed for the site measuring less than 2 acres, amounting to Rs. 5000 per incident will be imposed for the site measuring 2-5 acres, amounting to Rs. 15000 per incident will be imposed for the site meas-

uring more than 5 acres and prosecution of the farmer is to be done u/s 39 of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981. It was informed that 87 no. Nodal Officers, 71 no. Patwaris and 35 no. Cluster Officers have been deputed in the District for monitoring of stubble fire incidents. Environmental Engineer, PPCB informed that only one incident of stubble fire in this season in Derabassi subdivision has been reported in the district so far and challan has been issued in concerned case.

Process to beautify Dal lake started; over 30 machines pressed into service

SRINAGAR, SEPT 30

The Dal Lake, a popular tourist attraction in Jammu and Kashmir, is all set to get a facelift and breathe again as authorities appear determined this time to remove the weeds engulfing a large part of the lake.

For the first time in several years, the Jammu and Kashmir Lake Conservation and Management Authority (LCMA) has pressed into service over two dozen machines to remove the weeds. "There are two types of weeds. One is being controlled due to the presence of some species and the other is being removed completely," said LCMA Vice-Chairman Bashir Ahmad Bhat. Bhat said the one being removed completely had covered an area of 6.5 sq km and this process is likely to be complete by November this year. "In the past two years, we have been able to press over 32 machines for de-weeding while as nearly 500-600 men on a DBTL basis have been engaged and pressed into the service in the season to clean the water



body," he said, adding that besides outsourcing the machines, two high-end weed grabbers have also been procured by the LCMA for the process. "Besides working in the season, we managed to extract as much as weeds in the winter also last year," he said and added that internal channels were focussed this year and nearly 8-9 machines have been pressed into the services for navigation and other related things to beautify

the lake further. To control the sewerage, the houseboats for the first time are being connected with the sewer line. "Around 920 houseboats will be connected with sewerage lines. We have so far connected 84 houseboats from western shore with it and the remaining will be connected by November this year," he said, adding that such a process will help keep the water body clean.

The Bharatiya Kisan Union (Ekta-Ugrahan) held a state committee meeting under the chairmanship of Joginder Singh Ugrahan at Tarkasil Bhawan here today against the Punjab and Central Governments for solving the pressing issues of the farmers. It was decided to set an indefinite protest. He said that by passing a unanimous resolution regarding the demands of the front in the meeting, it was demanded from the Punjab government that in the last year or so, the houses were destroyed along with the crops and other crops destroyed in many districts due to the use of artificial pesticides or by pestilence. Compensation made to



peasant farmers and farm labourers must be distributed immediately.

The mirage factory, which is a source of pollution near Jira, should be closed immediately. For the Bharat Mala Highway project, the repeated use of police force to get corporate possession of the land should be stopped by issuing meagre

compensation and farmers should be given a 30% eviction allowance of the market rate of the area and employment eviction allowance for farm labourers should also be given immediately. The mining law which takes away the right to level/lower one's land should be repealed. By cancelling the anti-farmer terms of average yield and a lower area in Gardauri on the purchase of paddy at MSP, uninterrupted purchases should be continued as before. A bonus of Rs 200 per quintal should be given for keeping stubble without burning, or strict measures should be taken against the farmers who are forced to burn stubble. The compensation for dead cows due to lumpy skin disease should be paid according to the market rate.

Multiple failure

There can never be enough said to condemn the order of the Manipur government requiring prior sanction of a committee it set up for any book on Manipur to be published. It remains to be seen whether the order can stand legal scrutiny, provided there are people willing to challenge its constitutionality, especially from among those in the academia working on Manipur and for whom writing books on Manipur would, understandably, be an important engagement. This latest attack on intellectual freedom was in the making for a long time and is something that has made the Bharatiya Janata Party government in the state distinct from previous governments. A BJP government first assumed power in the state in 2017 and then retained it for another term in 2022. In its first term itself, the government made its intention of silencing critical voices quite clear. The cases of the social activist, Erendro Leichombam, and the television anchor, Kishorechandra Wangkhem, should suffice to sketch this disturbing picture. They were arrested and imprisoned several times for being critical not so much of the government but of the BJP and its leaders. Some of these arrests were on the charge of sedition. But whenever the courts found no grounds of sedition in these cases, rearrest under the National Security Act had become the norm.

Police visits on individuals for not just articles in newspapers but also for social media posts have become commonplace too. These overreactions were understandable, to an extent, during the BJP government's first tenure. It was a minority government hanging on a string, brought to power under controversial circumstances with liberal help from an openly partisan governor at the time. The BJP is comfortably placed in its second term. A large section of the media and other critical voices in the state had been tamed as well.

But a leopard cannot shed its spots: hence, this outrageous order on book-writing. However, much of the blame would have to be shared by the Manipur academia for not being able to honour its gatekeeping role. This slackness on its part allowed the government to intervene.

The consideration for the provocation should make this clear. A PhD thesis by a late brigadier who served in Manipur was published as a book — The Complexity Called Manipur: Roots, Perceptions & Reality. This thesis claims that Manipur, when it merged with India in 1949, constituted only 700 square miles of the Imphal valley.

In April 2008, the Queen bestowed upon her sons, their spouses and their descendants the titles of count and countess of Monpezat. In May 2016, it was also announced that His Royal Highness Prince Christian,



the only one of The Queen's grandchildren, is expected to receive an annuity from the state as an adult.

As a natural extension of this, Her Majesty has decided that as of 1 January 2023, His Royal Highness Prince Joachim's descendants can only use their titles as counts and countess of Monpezat, as the titles of prince and princess that they have held up until now will be discontinued, said the release.

Notably, after the death of the UK's longest-serving monarch Queen Elizabeth II, Denmark's Queen Margrethe II is now Europe's longest-serving monarch. The 82-year-old has been serving the throne in Denmark for 50 years.

China has key role in US' drug problem

Fentanyl, a nameless killer touted as the deadliest drug threat facing the United States, is waging an all-out assault on the most powerful country in the world.

Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid that is 50 times more potent than heroin. Just two milligrams of fentanyl, or the amount that could fit on the tip of a pencil, is considered a potentially lethal dose, according to the US government. "In 2021, a record number of Americans - 107,622 - died from a drug poisoning or overdose. Sixty-six per cent of those deaths can be attributed to synthetic opioids such as fentanyl," the US Justice Department said this week.

On Tuesday, the US government announced the results of an enforcement operation that spanned from May to September and resulted in significant fentanyl seizures across the United States. As part of the One Pill Can Kill initiative, the DEA and its law enforcement partners seized more than 10.2 million fentanyl pills and approximately 980 pounds of fentanyl powder during the period of May 23 through Sept. 8, 2022. The US Justice Department said the amount of fentanyl taken off the streets during this surge is equivalent to more than 36 million lethal doses removed from the illegal drug supply. In an editorial, a Toronto-based think tank highlighted China's role in the trade of synthetic drugs, which has led to



concerns about possible involvement in the US opioid problem.

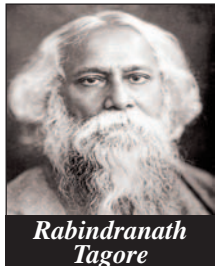
"The production of illegal fentanyl, the majority of which was destined for the American drug market, was outlawed in China three years ago as a result of a vigorous diplomatic campaign by the United States. Since then, most of the illicit fentanyl production has moved from China to Mexico, where it is produced on an industrial scale utilising chemicals imported from China as precursors," the International Forum For Rights And Security (IFFRAS) said. The IFFRAS said the sale of precursor chemicals and the illicit funds obtained from it has supported China's economy at a time when it has struggled to recover from the global financial crisis.

Bird diversity is lower in urban forests



According to a recent study done by Lund University in Sweden, cities have a detrimental impact on bird diversity. Even if the forest areas are of the same quality, urban woods have much fewer bird species than rural forests.

The researchers examined 459 natural woodlands located in or near 32 cities in southern Sweden. They counted the occurrence of different bird species, and the result is clear: in natural forests located in a city center, there are on average a quarter fewer species of forest birds compared to forests outside the city. In terms of endangered species, about half as many species were found in urban forests compared to rural forests.

The results deepen our knowledge of the impact of cities on biodiversity, says William Sidemo Holm, one of the researchers behind the study. It is already well known that urbanization is one of

the main driving forces behind the loss of biodiversity, as cities spread out across the globe. What is not as well known, however, is how cities affect protected natural areas in a city. "Our study demonstrates that you cannot surround nature with urban development and believe that it will remain as it is, there is going to be a negative effect", says William Sidemo Holm, who worked on the study during his time as a doctoral student at Lund University. The researchers wanted to specifically examine similar forests, or habitats. It is therefore not city parks that have been compared to countryside forests, emphasizes William Sidemo Holm. The study is one of the first to compare the diversity of similar habitats along a so-called urban gradient. "This way we know that the results are not driven by differences in the actual habitats, which in this scenario was natural forest. Instead, it was the surrounding en-

vironment that was different", he says. The fact that an urban environment has such a clear negative impact on forest bird diversity may have to do with access to food, the researchers believe. Many birds depend on food resources not only in their immediate vicinity but also in their surroundings, and in cities there are fewer insects, for example. In addition, some species are sensitive to artificial disturbances such as noise and light, which occur more in cities. "Our results highlight the importance of taking surrounding nature into account in urban planning. Above all, it is important to avoid the expansion of cities adjacent to protected environmental areas where there may be endangered species - we found that these are particularly sensitive to urban surroundings", says William Sidemo Holm. The study also showed that urban forests can be important for bird diversity. Although a ma-

majority of the bird species were more common outside the cities, there were species that were more often found in cities, such as the hawfinch. The reason may be that cities have more fruit trees that can provide them with food.

"Our conclusion is that it is important to preserve natural forests both in the cities and outside them in order to maintain local diversity", says William Sidemo Holm. In order to better preserve the biodiversity of cities, more knowledge is needed on how to reduce the negative impact on natural areas from the surrounding urban environment, say the researchers.

"In the future, it would be particularly interesting to investigate whether coherent green infrastructure in cities, or between city and countryside, can increase the opportunities for bird species in the city to find the necessary resources", William Sidemo Holm concludes.

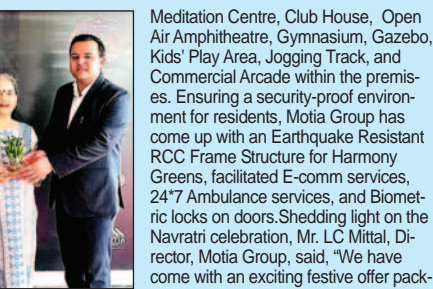

Those suspended officials include Superintending Engineer (SE) of Distribution Circle Ferozepur Er Bhupinder Singh, Divisional Accountant Jaswinder Singh, and Circle Assistant Ashok Kumar. In addition, the department has also terminated the services of a Computer operator involved in these irregularities. As per the information, the

minister had ordered an investigation following a complaint regarding irregularities in the award of Work Orders for the erection of electric lines for providing connections and improvement works in Mamdot Sub Division of PSPCL. Divulging details, Power Minister Harbhajan Singh ETO said that a preliminary inquiry was conducted by the Technical Audit wing of the PSPCL and it was found that officers/officials of the PSPCL had colluded to issue Work Orders for the works, which were already completed in the previous years. The Work Order for works done during 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20 financial years were placed in 2020-21 & 2021-22 amounting worth Rs 41.88 Lakhs, he said, adding that moreover, these work orders were placed at a rate higher than the rate of the previous years when works were actually done, leading to substantial loss to PSPCL.

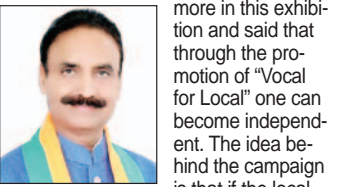
One Time power bill settlement scheme for women till Dec 1



RAMAN GUPTA KAITHAL: Haryana Government has launched One Time Settlement (OTS) scheme to waive off the outstanding interest of the loans of Mahila Vikas Nigam for women, under which the women beneficiary will pay the entire outstanding amount of the original loan in lump sum or if he returns in 6 installments by 1 December 2022, then all his interest will be waived. Giving this information, Deputy Commissioner Dr. Sangeeta Tatarwal said that this scheme will cover women borrowers whose interest is due for payment to the corporation on 31st March 2019. The scheme will be applicable on the principal amount by default as on 31st March 2019 but will not include the principal amount paid thereafter. He said that the borrowers will be allowed to avail the loan within 6 months. Interest rebate will be given only to those borrowers who within 6 months will pay the entire outstanding principal. Beneficiaries of the scheme can advance another loan in future only after a gap of at least one year.

Citizens soon to get status of FIRs on mobiles in State

In Haryana, complainants need not rush to the police stations to obtain information or status about a registered FIR as Haryana Police has developed a module to send SMS to citizens' mobiles when FIR is lodged.

With the new system, people will soon obtain the current status of the FIR on their mobile phones from the comfort of their homes. In addition, the name and mobile number of the Investigating Officer will also be communicated to the complainants through SMS. State Police has developed a module on the Haryana Police website making it possible.

This was revealed by Sh. O.P. Singh, Director, State Crime Record Bureau, Haryana after the 47th meeting of State Empowered Committee chaired by Director General of Police

(DGP), Haryana Sh. P.K. Agrawal.

The meeting was also attended by representatives of National Crime Record Bureau, Home Department, Finance Department, NIC and HARTRON along with other senior officers of Haryana Police from Police Headquarters and field units.

He said that Crime and Criminal Tracking Network & Systems (CCTNS) will be integrated with Integrated Road Accident Database (iRAD) which will help in recognizing the black spots on the roads in the State. Precautionary measures will be taken to save the precious lives of citizens by putting a tap on unfortunate road accidents across the state.

It was apprised in the meeting that the Union Ministry of Home Affairs has recently added a new parameter in the Pragati Dashboard developed by National Crime Record Bureau regarding the response on

Helpline 1930, established for helping the victims of cyber frauds or scams. The State ranks second in the Country after Gujarat with a 99.98% score in all parameters of CCTNS Pragati Dashboard which is being constantly monitored by PMO.

Sh. Singh also informed that various initiatives are being taken to monitor the investigation of criminal cases and to minimize the crimes in the State using the data available in CCTNS. A detailed action plan has been prepared for this purpose by 11-member committee headed by Commissionerate of Police, Faridabad Sh. Vikas Arora. It is also pertinent to mention here that State Crime Record Bureau have been designated as the Nodal Unit for the implementation of CCTNS and the Inter-operable Criminal Justice System (ICJS) in the State just two months ago.
