## Justice DY Chandrachud appointed 50th Chief Justice of India

**NEW DELHI:** Justice DY Chandrachud was on Monday appointed the 50th Chief Justice of India, Union law minister Kiren Rijiju said. Justice Chandrachud would be sworn in by President Droupadi Murmu as CJI on November 9. He will succeed Justice UU Lalit, who is serving a short tenure of just 74 days. ## Swati Maliwal claims attack inside her house premises, two cars damaged

**NEW DELHI:** Delhi commission for women chief Swati Maliwal on Monday alleged that a person entered the premises of her house and damaged two of her cars, while she was not at her home. While informing about the incident in a tweet, she said, "A person entered into my house. He attacked and broke a car of mine and of my mother's. Fortunately, I wasn't at home, or else who knows what would have happened," she tweeted. She also complained to the Delhi Police through her tweet.

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal reacted to her tweet and said that the law and order situation in Delhi is very bad and requested the LG of Delhi to "repair" the situation.

## Gyanvapi: Court rejects applications for third party intervention

**VARANASI:** The district court on Monday rejected seven applications pleading to be included as the third party in the ongoing Gyanvapi mosque complex case observing that a third party intervention won't help in justifiable disposal of the case. The order was passed by the District Judge Ajay Krishna Vishvesha on the applications moved under Order 1 Rule 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure (CPC). The court has fixed October 21 as the next date of hearing.

A total 17 application of order 1 rule 10 has been filed by third parties. Seven has been cancelled by the court and rest has been heard and the remaining order will come on October 21. Counsel from the Hindu side, Maan Bahadur Singh, Shivam Gaur and Anupam Dwivedi had objected on the applications of order 1 rule 10 of the CPC.

# BJP wants to send me to jail in 'fake' case: Sisodia on CBI questioning

Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia on Monday dubbed as "fake" the case lodged against him by the CBI in the alleged excise policy scam, and claimed that his questioning was taking place as the BJP was "scared" of the AAP's "popularity" in poll-bound Gujarat.

Sisodia made the remarks ahead of his questioning by the central agency here in the case.

The deputy CM asked AAP volunteers to feel proud if he goes to jail, saying he was a follower of Shahid Bhagat Singh.

Several AAP leaders, including MP Sanjay Singh, were detained after a massive protest by them against the questioning of Manish Sisodia by the CBI in the liquor policy case. Around 100 leaders and workers were detained from outside the CBI office, they will be released soon, a Delhi Police official said.

Dramatic visuals showed the leaders being pushed into a bus by the police. Several women workers, while being taken to the bus, alleged the police "misbehaved" with them.

AAP MP Sanjay Singh



was detained along with other protesters or unlawfully protesting at the CGO complex, where large gatherings are banned, a senior police officer said. The Deputy Chief Minister of Delhi earlier

in the day predicted his arrest as part of what he called a BJP "plan" to stop him from campaigning for the upcoming Gujarat election. He also took out a roadshow in an open-roof SUV on his way

to the CBI office and made many stops, including at Mahatma Gandhi's memorial Raj Ghat, and addressed Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) workers.

Mr Sisodia, 50, left home after a "tilak" ritual, accompanied by AAP leaders like party MP Sanjay Singh and MLAs Atishi and Saurabh Bharadwaj. He also shared a video of his mother blessing him. The CBI has prepared a list of questions and will ask them in "several phases", sources say. The evidence found so far, and statements of others accused in the "liquor scam" will be placed before the Deputy Chief Minister, they say.

## It's a celebration of corruption: BJP

BJP spokesperson Sambit Patra lashed out at the Aam Aadmi Party over the rally carried out by AAP before party leader and Delhi Deputy CM Manish Sisodia was summoned by the CBI.

Earlier today, Sisodia reached CBI headquarters for questioning in the excise policy case. AAP held a rally with the party workers in support of Manish Sisodia on the way to CBI headquarters. BJP spokesperson Sambit Patra attacked AAP for the rally and called it a "celebration of corruption". "When

Rahul Gandhi was summoned by ED, then also Congress started doing drama like this. It will not be an exaggeration to say that it is a celebration of corruption. First, they did corruption while giving liquor licenses in Delhi and now they are doing all this drama," Patra said. "The way Manish Sisodia was raising slogans in an open car on the streets along with his supporters today, it seems as if Aam Aadmi Party has won the World Cup of corruption. Arvind Kejriwal was a part of Anna Hazare's Andolan and used to say that he will finish corruption, but now it seems AAP has itself become the most corrupt party in the country," Patra further said.

# Polling concludes for Cong presidential election

Voting ended for Congress presidential elections on Monday with the delegates casting their vote to choose the party's next chief between former union ministers Mallikarjun Kharge and Shashi Tharoor.

Over 9,000 Pradesh Congress Committee delegates were eligible to cast their vote in the election. Both Kharge and Tharoor campaigned ahead of the polls and Congress will get a leader outside the Nehru-Gandhi family as president after 24 years.

The new party chief will have his task cut out with assembly elections having already been declared in Himachal Pradesh and poised to be held in Gujarat.



The presidential election has taken place at the culmination of the party's organisational elections and has come at a time Congress faces multiple challenges.

Congress interim chief Sonia Gandhi was among those who cast their ballot.

"I have been waiting for a long time," Sonia Gandhi had

said when media persons asked her on the poll. Sonia Gandhi cast her vote at the All India Congress Committee (AICC) headquarters.

Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra accompanied her mother Sonia Gandhi and cast her vote.

The results will be declared on October 19.

## Rahul, Kharge cast votes in K'taka

**BALLARI(KARNATAKA):** Former AICC President Rahul Gandhi on Monday cast his vote for the Congress presidential election at the Bharat Jodo Yatra campsite in Sanganakallu near here. One of the poll contestants, Mallikarjun Kharge cast his vote in Bengaluru. Senior Congress leader Jairam Ramesh hailed the polls as historic. "The Congress presidential polls are free, fair and transparent," he said. Earlier, he had said the Congress is the only party that holds elections for the post of party president and the only one to have a TN Seshan-like central election authority chairman in Madhusudan Mistry.



# Hurriyat office comes under attack over Kashmiri Pandit killing

SRINAGAR:** A group of activists on Monday allegedly ransacked the office of separatist group All Parties Hurriyat Conference (APHC) in Srinagar, officials said. The office was already lying shut.

The protesters removed the office signboard of APHC and wrote "India" at the main gate of the Hurriyat office at Rajbagh.

They said this was done in retaliation against the recent killing of Kashmiri Pandit in Shopian district of Jammu and Kashmir.

They blamed the Hurriyat Conference for the current situation in Jammu and Kashmir.

"The children of Hurriyat leaders are studying abroad and they put guns and stones in the hands of the youth here," said a protester, adding "Hurriyat also incited the youth".



The APHC termed the act of vandalism as "hooliganism".

"..It's a petty attempt at diverting attention from the authorities failure to safeguard the lives of Kashmiri Pandits. It's shameful that the unfortunate killing is being exploited for promoting propaganda against Hurriyat whose activists and leaders are either in jails or under house detention," the APHC said in a statement.

# Stop yatra now, go to HP, Gujarat: Cong leader to Rahul Gandhi

**PANAJI:** Congress MP and former Goa chief minister Francisco Sardinha on Monday said Rahul Gandhi should stop the ongoing Bharat Jodo Yatra and concentrate on the poll-bound states of Himachal Pradesh and Gujarat.

He claimed that Congress is the "only party" which can defeat the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP).

The Congress' Bharat Jodo Yatra is scheduled to cover a distance of 3,570 km in 150 days. It started on September 7 from Kanyakumari in Tamil Nadu and will con-

clude in Jammu and Kashmir.

Rahul Gandhi, who is leading the yatra, has so far covered four states - Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh.

"The Bharat Jodo Yatra is very important for the Congress. We want the party to grow at the grassroot level. He (Rahul Gandhi) has done a fantastic job, but now I want Rahulji to stop immediately and go to Himachal Pradesh and Gujarat where there are elections," Sardinha told reporters in Panaji during polling for the All India Congress Committee (AICC) president's post.

# PM launches single brand 'Bharat' for subsidised fertilisers

Under the scheme, Prime Minister launched Bharat urea bags, which will help companies market fertilizers under the single brand name 'Bharat'.

Following the launch of the above scheme, India will have a common bag design like Bharat urea, Bharat DAP, Bharat MOP etc.

Deputy Commissioner and District Election Officer Shantanu Sharma said that Haryana State Election Commission has issued orders to conduct elections for Zilla Parishad members, Panchayat Samiti members and Sarpanch, Panch posts in Kurukshetra district in the second phase. He appealed to the voters of the district that all the voters should participate enthusiastically in the Panchayati Raj elections and elect the candidates of honest and clean image. Voters should vote irrespective of caste, religion, sect, individual etc. In the orders issued, Deputy Commissioner Shantanu Sharma said that under



Rule 24 of Haryana Panchayati Raj Election Rules 1994, orders have been issued to conduct the general elections-2022 of Zilla Parishad members, Panchayat Samiti members, Sarpanches and Panchs of district Kurukshetra. The notification for Panchayat elections was issued on 15 October 2022 under the instructions of the Election Commission. After

this, the enrollment process will start in the district from October 21. For this, the time has been fixed from 10 am to 3 pm, 28 October will be the last day for nomination, on 29 October there will be scrutiny of nominations, on 31 October candidates can withdraw their nomination till 3 pm. After the withdrawal of nominations by the candidates on October 31, election symbols will be allotted to the candidates and the final list of contesting candidates will be issued on October 31 itself. In Kurukshetra district, on November 9, the voting of Panchayat Samiti members and Zilla Parishad members will be held and on November 12, voting will be held for the post of Sarpanch and Panch. The polling time will be from 7 am to 6 pm.

With the start of the purchase of paddy, the paddy scam has started coming to the fore. In Jundla, the officers of the investigating agencies are allegedly protecting the lifting contractors in the scam with the connivance of Rice Mill, Lifting Agency, DFSC Department and Market Committee. The role of the lifters in this entire scam cannot be denied. Between the purchase of paddy in Jundla and Assandh, 5500 sacks of paddy are getting less, pointing towards the contractor who lifted it. It is not possible to get less of government paddy without the cooperation of the contractor. Who has the contract for lifting in Jundla. His name is Satyavan & Sons. Sources say that this company has played a key role in the paddy scam. There is also an agent's shop in the Jundla grain market of the contractor Satyavan. Jaan agencies have taken action against DFS C market committee and rice millers, but the officers are protecting the contractor who did the lifting. So far the agencies have not taken any action. In this matter, when SP Karnal spoke to Gangaram Poonia,

he told that investigation is going on in this matter right now. If the role of the lifting contractor or his company is found. Then action will be taken against him. The investigation is being done keeping all the points in mind. On the other hand, an officer of DFSS C department said that questions are also being raised on the role of the lifting agencies. Investigation is being done against the lifting agencies of Karnal district. He declined to name any one. On Jundla's question, it was said that if evidence is found against him, action will be taken against him. The needle of suspicion is moving towards Jasbir, an officer of the DFS C department, who has been in discussions so far in the paddy scam. The lifting contractor has been saved due to his political reach. Many BJP leaders say that they will complain to the Chief Minister against the DFSAC officer and the lifting contractor of Jundla Mandi. There are also discussions in Jundla Mandi regarding the role of the lifting contractor's company. There are also discussions that due to a big Congress leader, he has been saved till now. The secretary of the market committee has been suspended in the paddy scam.

This CEC meeting is expected to give a final list of the candidates for assembly elections in the state, after the necessary consultation with the

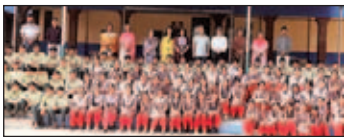

# Punjab seeks resumption of domestic flights from Adampur Pathankot, Sahnewal and Bathinda airports

Punjab Government led by Chief Minister Mr Bhagwant Mann today urged the Government of India to resume domestic flights from Adampur (Jalandhar), Pathankot, Sahnewal and Bathinda airports.

He said the sale of adulterated and substandard food products will not be tolerated at all as under the "Food Safety Standards and Regulation Act", adulterated and substandard milk and milk products cannot be sold under any circumstances.

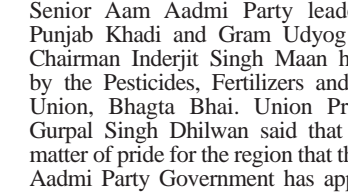
## ‘Relentless global technological-manthan spewed both Amrit and Vish’

## For the first time in history of Tarn Taran Court case settlement through plea bargaining in DSJ Court

A case was settled in the court of Priya Sood, District and Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran. The case was dismissed based on plea bargaining. Hon'ble Sessions Judge Sahib said that in his court, case number no CNR No. - PBTT010076712021 Criminal Appeal No. CRA/6007/2021 the appellant Gurbir Singh, age 32, son of Gurmukh Singh, resident of Mohalla Jaswant Singh, Tarn Taran, filed an appeal in the session against the decision against him. In which he was charged under Section 279 IPC by the lower court Rajesh Ahluwalia, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran 1000/- W. fine under Section 337 I.P.C. to undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months and to pay a fine of 500 Rs. and to undergo simple imprisonment for fifteen days in default of payment of penalty and Section 338 I.P.C. One year's rigorous imprisonment and 1000 Rs. In default of payment of fine and penalty, one month simple imprisonment was

ordered. Against which an appeal was made in the Sessions Court. When this case came under the consideration of the District and Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran. When they came, they informed the appellant about the plea bargaining, then the appellant was ready for it. Then the Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran called the victim party and told him that the appellant is ready for plea bargaining and also told the victim the benefits of this scheme and by holding a meeting of both the parties, the matter was settled 75000 Rs. to which both the appellant and the victim party agreed. As a result of which District and Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran plea bargaining 75000Rs. to the Appellant to the Victim under the (plea bargaining) Scheme. Asked to give and the victim took 75000Rs. This was the first case in Tarn Taran district, in which the appellant took advantage of the Plea Bargaining scheme by admitting his crime and the victim party also benefited. District and Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran said that general public is not aware about this scheme.

Beyond borders

Rishi Sunak was once chastised for appearing to not understand how contactless cards work. It was apparent that the affluent Sunak didn't have to do such things for himself. The British media quickly pointed to the closing speech by the former prime minister, Theresa May, at the Conservative Party conference in 2016: "... today, too many people in positions of power behave as though they have more in common with international elites than with the people down the road..."

Given his meteoric rise in politics, mixed ethnic roots, a billionaire wife with a nondom tax status, Sunak himself the holder of a US green card has been portrayed as a perfect example of an international elite. Not to forget, Boris Johnson had US citizenship, which he renounced only in 2016. The former health secretary and an aspirant for prime ministership, Sajid Javid, was registered as a non-dom while working as an international banker. Several other British politicians would belong to this coterie as well. And Britain is certainly not the only country with its set of well-heeled politicians. Interestingly, in her 2016 speech, May had also said, "... If you believe you're a citizen of the world, you're a citizen of nowhere. You don't understand what the very word citizenship means."

There may be discussions and debates on the ever-evolving meaning of citizenship. Are refugees living in camps in different corners of the globe, countless immigrants in different countries, including those who are put on Rwandabound flights from Britain, the only examples of citizens of nowhere? Should not rootless cosmopolitans—the people who are at home everywhere but belong nowhere—be counted as such too? In this context, it may be pertinent to mention the BBC Radio 4 series, Daliso Chaponda: Citizen of Nowhere, launched in 2018 by the Zambia-born Malawian stand-up comedian, Daliso Chaponda, who lives in England. In the show, Chaponda pressed for a better understanding of different cultures by weaving in his experience of living all over the world as a child with his refugee-turned-diplomat father. The 2019 short film, Citizen of Nowhere, directed by Will Webb, might have been inspired by May's 2016 speech. It depicts the situation of a girl, Mireille, truly a citizen of nowhere—who applies for French citizenship in the wake of Brexit. Mireille gets stuck at home all day waiting for the embassy to call.

During Brexit, Britons had wondered whether Polish plumbers, Romanian staff at supermarkets, Italian lecturers and Indian IT workers in Britain are citizens of nowhere.

How fast-moving glaciers might affect sea level rise

Sea levels are rising as a result of climate change due to ocean expansion and ice melting on land. Sea level rise in the near future will be influenced by a number of factors, some of which include how frequently glaciers calve. These happen when big chunks of ice break off from tidewater glaciers, or glaciers that finish in the ocean, and fall into coastal fjords as icebergs. The more ice enters the ocean as these glaciers move quicker across the land towards it, the faster the sea level rises.

The glaciers of Greenland may melt during the hotter summer months, creating sizable lakes that may eventually flow through to the glacier's base. This lessens the friction between the ice and the ground, causing the ice to slide more quickly for a few days, according to studies on the interior Greenland ice sheet. However, it has not yet been determined whether such drainage episodes alter the tidewater glaciers' flow rate, and thus, the frequency of calving events.

A research team from Columbia University, Oxford University, and the Oxford University Mathematical Institute used GPS observations of the flow speed of Helheim Glacier, the largest single-glacier contributing to sea level rise in Greenland, to look into this. The GPS recorded high-temporal-resolution observations of the glacier's flow reaction to lake drainage, which were a nearly ideal natural experiment.

The Helheim Glacier was found to operate considerably different from the inland ice sheet, which moves quickly and downward during lake drainage events, according to the data. Helheim Glacier, in contrast, showed a relatively minor 'pulse' of movement, when the glacier accelerated for a brief period of time and subsequently slowed down, with no net increase in movement. The researchers determined that this observation was most likely



brought about by the Helheim glacier having an effective system of channels and cavities along its bed by using a computational model of the subglacial drainage system. As a result, the glacier bed can swiftly be cleared of draining fluids without increasing the overall net movement.

Although this seems to be good news for sea level rise implications, the researchers were concerned that glaciers without an effective drainage system, where the surface melt is currently low but may grow in the future owing to climate change, may see a different consequence (such as in Antarctica).

Based on the conditions of colder, Antarctic tidewater glaciers, they performed a mathematical model. The findings suggested that, in these circumstances, lake drainages would result in a net increase in glacier movement. This was primarily caused by the slower evacuation of flood waters via the less effective subglacial drainage system throughout the winter. However, no in-situ observations of Antarctic tidewater glacier responses to lake drainage have been made so far.

The research questions some conventional methods for determining glacial drainage patterns from glacier velocities measured through satellite images (which are currently used in sea level rise models). "What we've observed here at Helheim is that you can have a big input of meltwater into the drainage system during a lake drainage event, but that melt input doesn't

result in an appreciable change in glacier speed when you average over the week of the drainage event," said lead author Associate Professor Laura Stevens (Department of Earth Sciences, Oxford University).

Since the best temporal precision of currently known satellite-derived glacier speeds is only around one week, lake drainage events like the one seen in the Helheim GPS data are typically overlooked. Associate Professor Stevens continued, "These tidewater glaciers are challenging." Before we can safely predict how tidewater glaciers will react to future atmospheric and oceanic warming, we need to learn a lot more about how meltwater drainage functions and modifies tidewater glacier speeds.

19 million Afghans face food insecurity



The World Food Program estimated that nearly 19 million Afghans are facing food insecurity on the occasion of World Food Day. On World Food Day, which was observed on Sunday, residents of Kabul said that the lack of jobs and economic challenges is threatening them with severe food insecurity, reported Tolo News.

The World Food Programme in Afghanistan said that a survey conducted in February and March indicated that nearly 19 million people are facing food insecurity.

"The results of the (survey) show that nearly 19 million or 18.9 million people are facing food insecurity and they need food assistance and hu-

manitarian assistance," said Wahidullah Amani, a spokesman for WFP Afghanistan, reported Tolo News.

"We plan to attract international humanitarian aid, support the small and average industries, and to launch major economic projects to support the infrastructure in Afghanistan," said Abdul Latif Nazari, Deputy Minister of Economy.

"I have seven children. My husband is jobless. When I eat breakfast, we are worried about our lunch, when we eat lunch, we are worried about our dinner," said Suraya, a breadwinner for her family of seven members. The high rate of poverty has compelled dozens of students into hard labour, reported Tolo News.

Dilip Mahalanabis, whose ORS saved lives during 1971 B'desh Liberation War, dies

Dilip Mahalanabis, whose Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS) saved numerous lives during the 1971 Liberation war of Bangladesh, passed away in Kolkata on Sunday, a local media report said.

The doctor was 88 years old when he breathed his last. He used ORS for the first time while treating millions of Bangladeshi refugees in camps near Bangaon in West Bengal in the 1970s.

Mahalanabis cured numerous people suffering from cholera with this ORS and it proved to be a life-giving formula, Bangladesh Live News stated citing a report published in the Bangla Tribune newspaper.

Dilip Mahalanabis has been globally recognized for his extraordinary work. Several international organizations, including the World Health Organization, have also recognized his work which has spanned over the years.

However, he never took out a patent for his invention of Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS) which saved uncountable lives.

In 1990, he was also posted as a clinical research officer at the famous ICDDR,B in Dhaka, a position he performed efficiently for several years, Bangladesh Live News reported citing the Bengali Tribune newspaper.

For the first time after several years of sustained efforts, a resolution has been tabled in the US House of Representatives



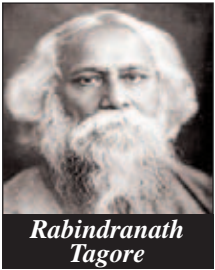
recently, declaring Pakistan Army's action against Bengalis and Hindus in 1971 during the Liberation War of Bangladesh as a "genocide" and "crime against humanity".

Bangladesh Liberation War Affairs Minister AKM Mozammel Haque last month called the greater push for international recognition of genocide carried out on unarmed Bangalees, Bangladesh News Agency reported. Haque said international recognition of the genocide of 1971 could not be realized 51 years after independence. But Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's government declared March 25 as National Genocide Day.

Nicotine dose in one cigarette blocks estrogen production in women's brains: Study



The amount of nicotine in one cigarette inhibits women's brains from producing estrogen. This may explain a variety of behavioural differences in smokers, including the reason why women have a higher resistance to quitting than males. The ECNP Congress in Vienna will mark the debut of this work.

Lead researcher, Associate Professor Erika Comasco (Uppsala University, Sweden) said: "For the first time, we can see that nicotine works to shut down the estrogen production mechanism in the brain of women. We were surprised to see that this effect could be seen even with a single dose of nicotine, equivalent to just one cigarette, showing how powerful the effects of smoking are on a woman's brain. This is a newly-discovered effect, and it's

still preliminary work. We're still not sure what the behavioural or cognitive outcomes are; only that nicotine acts on this area of the brain, however, we note that the affected brain system is a target for addictive drugs, such as nicotine".

The thalamus, a brain region part of the limbic system, has demonstrated the effect. This system is involved in regulating behaviour and emotions. Ten healthy female volunteers participated in the study with the help of researchers from Uppsala University in Sweden. In addition to receiving an intranasal dose of nicotine from a commercial source, the women received an injection of a radioactive tracer bound to an enzyme called aromatase, also known as estrogen synthase, which binds to estrogen.

Aromatase is the enzyme that produces estrogen. The researchers were able to visualize the amount of aromatase present in the brain as well as its location using MRI and PET brain images. Researchers discovered that a single dose slightly decreased the brain-based aromatase level.

It has long been recognised that men and women react to nicotine differently, with women being more resistant to NRT and more likely than men to relapse when trying to give up smoking. However, it is unclear what biological factors led to these variations. This is the first instance where the production of aromatase has been inhibited in humans. The impact on guys wasn't investigated. Professor Comasco continued "This discovery leads us to believe that nicotine's effect

on estrogen production has a significant impact on the brain, but perhaps also on other functions, such as the reproductive system - we don't know that yet. There are significant differences in the way men and women react to smoking. Women seem to be more resistant to nicotine replacement therapy, they experience more relapses, show greater vulnerability to the heritability of smoking, and are at greater risk of developing primary smoking-related illnesses, such as lung cancer and heart attacks. We need now to understand if this action of nicotine on the hormonal system is involved in any of these reactions."

Commenting, Professor Wim van den Brink, Emeritus Professor of Psychiatry and Addiction at the Academic Medical Center, University of Amsterdam said:

"This is indeed an important first finding. Smoking has many adverse effects on men and in women, but this particular effect of nicotine on the reduction of estrogen production in women was not known before. It should be noted, however, that tobacco addiction is a complex disorder with many contributing factors. It's unlikely that this specific effect of nicotine on the thalamus (and the production of estrogen) explains all the observed differences in the development, treatment and outcomes between male and female smokers. It is still a long way from a nicotine-induced reduction in estrogen production to a reduced risk of nicotine addiction and negative effects of treatment and relapse in female cigarette smokers, but this work merits further investigation".

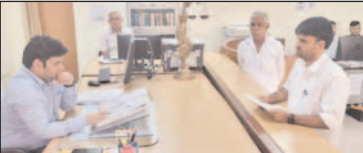

Marsh's wicket invited Steven Smith to the crease. In the 10th over of the innings, Finch and Smith hammered Harshal Patel for 15 runs.

And for 19-year-old girl Ankita Bhandari from Uttarakhand." "Around the world women are uniting in protest against the Iranian government by cutting their hair. Respect Women. A Global Symbol For Women's Revolution. Hair is seen as a symbol of the beauty of women. By chopping off hair it in public, women are showing that they don't care about society's beauty standards and won't let anything or anyone decide how they dress up, behave or live," she continued. Urvashi concluded by saying, "Once women come together and consider one women's issue as an issue of the entire womankind, feminism will see a new vigour."

Urvashi is currently in Australia, and since she revealed that she is there, netizens have been brutally trolling her for "stalking Rishabh Pant".

Mahsa Amini's death sparked demonstrations and clashes with security forces where many lost their lives. More than 100 people have been killed in nationwide protests over the death of Mahsa Amini, according to the Norway-based group Iran Human Rights (IHR) NGO.

Iranian schoolgirls and women have come out in huge numbers to demonstrate by removing their hijabs and staging rallies in protest over Amini's death.

Coming back to Urvashi, she uploaded a video of her last week and wrote, "FIRST IN IRAN #MahsaAmini & NOW IN INDIA....it's happening with me they're bullying me as a Stalker ??? No one cares about me or support me."
