

## Delhi Police arrests 4 during Greater Kailash robbery bid

**NEW DELHI:** Delhi Police on Saturday arrested four men in a robbery case from Greater Kailash area of New Delhi, and recovered jewellery and Rs 50 lakh from their possession. According to DCP South Chandan Chowdhary, a PCR call was received at Greater Kailash Police Station, regarding some thieves entering a house with some weapons. "Immediately, the police staff reached the house in GK Enclave. The police team equipped with weapons and safely cordoned the house. Thereafter, the team noticed movement of some suspicious persons on the 1st floor of the house and quietly covered the floor of the house by entering the main gate," said Chandan.

## Cong releases 22-point 'charge sheet' against Gujarat BJP govt

**AHMEDABAD:** The Gujarat Congress released a 22-point 'charge sheet' against the state BJP government on Sunday ahead of the upcoming Assembly polls, accusing it of being anti-people. All that an average Gujarati got was "hunger, fear and tyranny," it claimed. The opposition party also highlighted in the 'charge sheet' the recent Morbi bridge collapse incident which claimed 135 lives, and dubbed as "unconstitutional" the release of 11 convicts in the Bilkis Bano gang-rape case and murder of seven members of her family during the Gujarat riots.

## BJP candidate Aman Giri wins Gola Gokarnnath bypolls in UP

**LUCKNOW:** Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) candidate Aman Giri won the Gola Gokarnnath by-election in Uttar Pradesh with a margin of 34,298 votes. According to Election Commission, with 1,24,810 votes Giri got 55.88 per cent of the total votes. SP candidate Vinay Tiwari came second with 40.52 per cent votes. Meanwhile, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath congratulated BJP party workers and voters as party candidate Aman Giri won Gola Gokarnnath by-election.

## Tirupati temple's assets worth over Rs 2.5 lakh crore

# India crush Zimbabwe by 71 runs, to face England in semi-finals

Suryakumar Yadav played yet another breathtaking knock of an unbeaten 61 from 25 balls followed by superb bowling from the bowlers helped India bundle out Zimbabwe for 115 to clinch a 71-run win in their final Group 2, Super 12 match of the ongoing ICC T20 World Cup at Melbourne on Sunday.

India close out the Super 12s with a comfortable win to top their group - they will play England in



Thursday's semi-final at Adelaide. With four wins out of their five matches, India have 8 points.

Defending a target of 187, India got off to a flying start as veteran bowler Bhuvneshwar Kumar started the innings with a wicket on the very first bowl of his first over as he dismissed Zimbabwe opener Wessely Madhevere for zero. Regis Chakabva then came out to bat on the crease. In the second over Arshdeep Singh sent Chakabva packing as he dismissed the batter for zero and left Zimbabwe tottering at 2-2.

## SKY becomes first Indian to smash 1,000 T20I runs in a calendar year

**MELBOURNE:** Star Indian batter Suryakumar Yadav on Sunday became the first Indian player to score 1,000 T20I runs in a calendar year. The batter accomplished this feat in his side's final Super 12 stage match against Zimbabwe at Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG). In the match, Suryakumar put his perfect finishing touches to make sure India finished their innings on a high. He scored 61\* off just 25 balls, consisting of six fours and four sixes. He was striking at a strike rate of 244.00. In 28 innings this year, Suryakumar has scored 1,026 runs at an average of 44.60. One century and nine half-centuries have come out of his bat, with the best score of 117.

# BJP's Bhavya Bishnoi wins Adampur bypolls

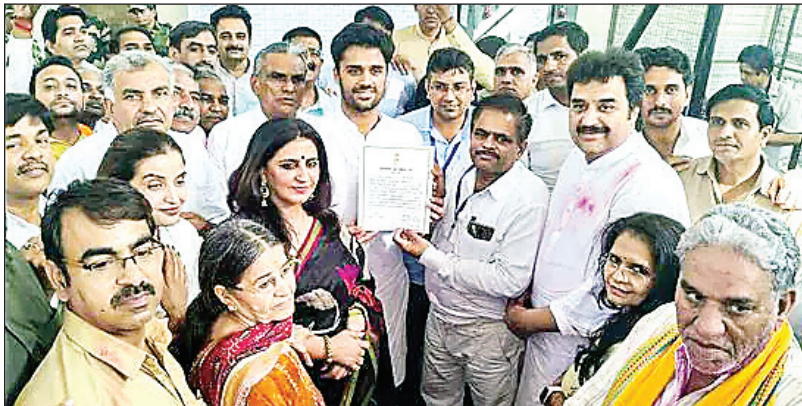
He further expressed gratitude to the Adampur people for trusting them.

Meanwhile, Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar has thanked the people for the "grand victory" of the BJP in Adampur.

"I express my gratitude to the people for providing a 'grand' victory by blooming lotus in Adampur," CM Manohar Lal Khattar tweeted in Hindi. Haryana's Adampur seat--which is considered a stronghold of Bishnoi-- had witnessed the contest between BJP, Congress, Indian National Lok Dal, and the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP).

Bhavya Bishnoi won the Adampur



assembly seat with as many as 67,376 votes, while the Congress-fielded Jai Prakash received 51,662 votes.

Meanwhile, the Indian National Lok Dal-picked candidate, who has also been a Congress rebel, Kurda Ram Nambar-garnered 5,241 and Aam Aadmi Party's Satinder Singh received 3413 votes.

Amid tight security arrangements, the counting of the votes for Adampur seat in Haryana began around 8 am on Sunday morning.

This poll was necessitated after the younger son of former Haryana chief minister Bhajan Lal-- Kuldeep Bishnoi, who is also the father of Bhavya Bish-

noi-- resigned from the post and decided to switch sides from Congress to BJP in August this year.

Earlier in the day, Bhavya Bishnoi had said that the polls were about the "victory margin". He also exuded confidence that Adampur would be celebrating Diwali soon.

"This poll was not about winning or losing, but about the victory margin. With the blessings I've received from my Adampur family since the beginning, I am confident that people will once again celebrate Diwali within a few hours," Bhavya Bishnoi had said.

## Nadda releases party's manifesto in HP, vows to implement UCC

Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) national president JP Nadda on Sunday released the party's manifesto for the Himachal Pradesh Assembly elections with 11 commitments which include the implementation of the Uniform Civil Code and investigation of Waqf properties under the judicial committees in the state. Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur, state party chief Suresh Kashyap, Union Minister Anurag Thakur and others were present during the launch of the manifesto.

Addressing the occasion, the BJP chief detailed the 11 commitments of the party going into the polls hoping to

retain the government.

"First commitment is that the BJP government will bring Uniform Civil Code here. A committee of experts will be set up and according to their report, UCC will be implemented in Himachal. The second commitment is that the Rs 3,000 per year will be added to the Mukhya Mantri Annadata Samman Nidhi, besides the PM Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana. Nearly 10 lakh farmers will be connected with this," Nadda said. Nadda said that the party will increase the job opportunities in the state in a phased manner. "Our third commitment is that our government will increase the job opportunities of over 8 lakh in a phased manner. This will

include govt jobs and works underway in the economic zone. Our fourth commitment is that the BJP government will ensure that all the roads are connected with the pucca roads under the PM Gramin Sadak Yojana in the next five years," he said.

The BJP chief informed that the government will launch programme 'Shakti' to develop infrastructure and transportation nearby religious places.

"Our fifth commitment is that the BJP will launch a programme named 'Shakti' under which Rs 12,000 crore will be spent in 10 years to develop infrastructure and transportation around religious places and temples.

# PDP get another jolt as Sr leader Haq Khan resigns

# Gulmarg receives fresh snowfall in Kashmir

Upper reaches of Kashmir valley including Gulmarg experienced a fresh snowfall while plains lashed by rains resulted in closure of Mughal road connecting Shopian district in south Kashmir to Poonch and Rajouri districts of Jammu region on Sunday.

Meteorological Department Srinagar forecast of widespread light to moderate rain/snow/traces over Jammu and Kashmir during the next 24 hours and decrease in precipitation in the following two days.

Traditional Mughal road connecting Shopian district in south Kashmir to Poonch and Rajouri districts of Jammu region was closed for vehicu-



lar traffic following a fresh snowfall caused at Peer Ki Gali on Sunday. Srinagar-Sonamarg-Gumri (SSG) road connecting Ladakh Union Territory was also closed due to fresh

snowfall on Zojila pass today.

However, traffic on Srinagar-Jammu national highway was playing as usual, a traffic police tweet said.

Famous ski resort of Gulmarg in north Kashmir received a mild snowfall much to the delight of the tourists staying there. The tourists were seen enjoying the snow in the valley of meadow on Sunday.

Gulmarg was the coldest place in Kashmir where the minimum temperature plunged to minus 3.6 degree Celsius on Sunday and it also received 16.8mm of rainfall during the period.

Reports of snowfall were also received from north Kashmir parts including Sadhna Top, 6 inches Machhil 2 inches in frontier Kashmir dis-

trict of Kupwara and Razdan Top and Dawar Gurez in Bandipora district in north Kashmir.

Most parts of Jammu and Kashmir have received moderate rainfall during the night and early morning hours.

Today, mostly cloudy weather is expected with chances of light/moderate rain showers at a few places, however, nothing major is expected, an independent weather observatory Faizan Arif told a news agency.

He said currently, rain/snow activities have stopped at most places as the system has moved in the east direction. Towards evening/night, rain/snow activities will again pick up and can result in moderate rain/snow showers at many places.

## Six years after demonetisation, cash with public at new high

Currency with the public has jumped to a new high of ? 30.88 lakh crore as of October 21, illustrating that cash usage is still robust even six years after the demonetisation move.

At ? 30.88 lakh crore, the currency with the public is 71.84 per cent higher than the level for the fortnight ended November 4, 2016. On November 8, 2016, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had announced the decision to withdraw ? 500 and ? 1,000 denomination notes with the ultimate aim of reducing corruption and black money in the economy.

The intent of the move, which was criticised by many experts for poor planning and execution, was to make India a "less cash" economy.

As per the fortnightly data on money supply released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Friday, the currency with the public increased to ? 30.88 lakh crore as on October 21. The central bank put for Reserve Money had data for the currency in circu-

lation at ? 17.7 lakh crore on November 4, 2016.

Currency with public refers to notes and coins used by people to transact, settle trades, and for buying goods and services. The figure is arrived at after deducting cash with banks from the currency in circulation. Cash usage has been steadily rising in the economy, even as newer and far convenient digital alternatives of payments have become popular. The COVID-19 pandemic, which laid an emphasis on contactless transactions, also gave a fillip to such digital modes. "Although digital payments have been growing gradually in recent years, both in value and volume terms across countries, data also suggests that during the same time, currency in circulation to Gross Domestic Product (GDP) ratio has also increased in consonance with the overall economic growth," it had said. "...an increase in digital payments to GDP ratio over a period of time does not seem to automatically imply a fall in the currency to GDP ratio of the country," it had added.

Arsenal and Utopia

I'm an Arsenal supporter but I'm constantly ambushed by the fluid and footloose nature of club football. Arsenal is due to play Chelsea this weekend and I'm not sure how to deal with the prospect of Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang taking the field for Chelsea, given that he was Arsenal's main striker till earlier this year. I know we're meant to be blasé about the transfer market but I came late to football fandom and I find it hard to boo a player I once rooted for.

As a child in Delhi in the 1960s, I had no interest in league football. I had vaguely heard of Real Madrid, Bayern Munich and Borussia Mönchengladbach but they existed only as curious names. I (and most of my classmates) had no idea what the Bundesliga or La Liga was. The sports pages of Indian newspapers wasted no space on European football and in the total absence of televised coverage, there was no path to international football fandom.

There was, of course, Indian league football. I remember watching Leaders Club playing JCT Phagwara at the Corporation Stadium (now renamed Ambedkar Stadium), as their players hoofed the ball high from one end of the ground to the other, but the passion and skill of club football in India at the time were centred on Calcutta with its great triumvirate of clubs: Mohun Bagan, East Bengal and Mohammedan Sporting.

The main reason behind football's low profile, even though it was played everywhere, in schools and maidans, was that on the international stage, India didn't really figure. Our passion for cricket was fuelled by the fact that even though India's Test team lost more often than it won, Indian teams took part in the top tier of cricket. Middle-class children found solace in the idea that the nation was, at least notionally, a contender.

The one European league that I was aware of was the English First Division and that was by a kind of accident. Every night at around 11 pm, the BBC World Service would put out a fifteen-minute bulletin called Sports Roundup. In the winter, my brother and I would tune in, hoping to catch angrez experts talking about a Test match that India might have been playing at the time.

We were invariably disappointed because winter bulletins were largely given over to league football. Nearly half the bulletin was taken up by the classified football results. I learnt the names of English football clubs by listening half-asleep to a droning chant: Ipswich Town 2, Nottingham Forest nil; Leeds United 1, Arsenal 2 and so on endlessly. I liked the sound of Arsenal more than the others because it was a single punchy word to do with guns but that was the extent of my interest in the game.

"Words" matter in messages about food safety

According to a recent Cornell University-led study, changing the wording concerning expiration dates on perishable food items--which is now uncontrolled and widely variable--could help minimize food waste.

In contrast to "best if used by," some language, such as "best by," has the potential to reduce food waste, according to a consumer survey, however, the results differed depending on the item type. Naturally, the likelihood of rejecting food increases with perishability.

This research has implications for both the market effects of reducing food waste and governmental ideas about date labels.

"Some consumers might do a sniff test to see if food is still good, while others might just look at the date label and throw it away," said Brad Rickard, professor in the Charles H. Dyson School of Applied Economics and Management, and senior author of "Date Labels, Food Waste and Supply Chain Implications," which published in the European Review of Agricultural Economics.

"And the truth is, with very few exceptions, these date labels that are used in the United States are not regulated," Rickard said. "And they're not food safety dates; they're just food quality dates." Co-authors included Abigail Okrent from the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Economic



Research Service, Shuay-Tsyr Ho, an assistant professor of agricultural economics at National Taiwan University, Florine Livat, an associate professor of economics at the Kedge Business School in Talence, France, and a former visiting scholar at Dyson, and Shuay-Tsyr Ho.

The words "use" or "use by" seemed to speak more directly to the perceived food safety consequences of consuming food after the date indicated on the box, which could consequently increase food waste, according to research by Rickard and his colleagues. The phrase "best by" appeared to only apply to food qual-

ity after a specific date and reduced waste. The motivation for this work, Rickard said, stems from the "wild west" landscape of food date labels which is expected to be driven, in part, by manufacturers' desire to sell more products. Nearly a year ago, the Food Date Labeling Act was introduced in both the U.S. House of Representatives and the Senate in an effort to reduce the discarding of safe food. "You go into the yogurt section at the grocery store," he said, "and you see many different labels - some say 'use by,' some say 'best by,' some say 'best if used by' or 'fresh by,' 'sell by.' And there are no rules about this."

15 different food and beverage items that were one day past the specified date code were included in the survey, and participants were asked to rate their likelihood of throwing them away on a scale of 1 to 5, with 5 being extremely likely. The survey's first component's question just asked for the expiration date code (i.e., date/month/year); the second section did the same thing but included a date label with one of ten distinct wording options.

Four of the date label modifications used the phrases "Best if used by," "Best by," "Use by," and "Sell by," which are frequently used in the United States. The oth-

er six included a biosensor, a visual indicator of food quality, and a date label. In order to conduct the poll, the researchers picked biosensors with the hues green (fresh), blue (less fresh), and purple. Biosensors are devices that detect the growth of microbes and change color appropriately (past fresh).

"Best if used by," "Best by," "Use by," and "Sell by" were the four date label variations that were modeled after those that have been extensively used in the United States. The remaining six had a biosensor, which provided a visual indicator of food quality, and a date label. In order to conduct the poll, the researchers picked biosensors with the colors green (fresh), blue (less fresh), and purple. Biosensors, which detect microbe growth and change colors appropriately, are ubiquitous in various European markets but are less common in the U.S. (past fresh).

One of the unintended consequences of a more uniform approach to date labels, the researchers note, is a potential increase in food waste depending on the wording of the label, as well as an increase in the re-purchasing of perishable items high in protein, fat, and cholesterol.

"If you tell all food manufacturers that all their 'best by' dates are now going to 'best if used by' dates, that might actually increase food waste," Rickard said.

South Korea's Navy to participate in Japan's fleet review

Amid escalating nuclear and missile threats from North Korea, a South Korean naval vessel is set to take part in Japan's international fleet review on Sunday for the first time in seven years.

It marks the first time since 2015 for the South's Navy to participate in a fleet review in Japan, reported Yonhap news agency.

The South Korean Navy took part in Japan's fleet review in 2002 and 2015, while the Japan Maritime Self-Defence Force (JMSDF) joined the South's fleet review in 1998 and 2008.

The review comes against North Korea launching a ballistic missile of intercontinental range in the East sea.

Earlier on Thursday, it was reported that Pyongyang had fired an unknown ballistic missile on the Sea of Japan. Media reports had said that the missile is believed to be an intermediate- or long-range missile. During large-scale joint air drills



between the US and South Korea, Seoul scrambled approximately 80 fighter jets after detecting North Korean warplanes on Friday. South Korea's military earlier said an intercontinental ballistic missile (ICBM) was launched from the Sunan area in Pyongyang at around 7:40 am on Thursday. This latest launch marked the country's seventh firing of an ICBM in 2022. However, South Korea's defence source told Yonhap that Thursday's missile seems to have failed in a routine flight.

Over 10 years in power, the North Korean leader has conducted more than 100 missile launches, including intercontinental launches, and four nuclear tests. North Korean leader Kim Jong Un has said numerous times that his country will continue to boost its nuclear potential.

South Korea is one of 14 countries, including host Japan, the United States, Canada and Australia, to take part in the review set to take place in Sagami Bay off Kanagawa Prefecture, about 40 kilometres southeast of Tokyo.

Methods for teaching children forgiveness

According to a new study, teaching youngsters to understand viewpoints of others may make it simpler for them to learn how to forgive others. The study also discovered that encouraging children to apologise sincerely can help them gain forgiveness from others. "Forgiveness is important in children and adults for restoring relationships and limiting future conflicts," says Kelly Lynn Mulvey, lead author of the study and an associate professor of psychology at North Carolina State University. "But we didn't know much about what makes children more likely to forgive others, particularly from early childhood to adolescence. That's what we wanted to explore with our study."

To that end, Mulvey and her collaborators enlisted 185 children, between the ages of 5 and 14, in the study. Researchers conducted an in-depth interview with each child that collected background information and assessed the child's "theory of mind" skills. Theory of mind is your ability to understand that someone else's beliefs, intentions and desires are different from your own.

Researchers then led each child through a series of scenarios involving other children who are "in group" and "out group." Specifically, each study participant was told they were part of a group like the green team. During interviews, researchers described some children in the scenarios as also being on the green team (making them in-group), while other children in the scenarios were on the yellow



team (making them out-group). In each scenario, interviewers asked study participants whether they were willing to forgive a group that left them out of a game or activity.

There were three main findings. First, children are more likely to forgive someone if they have apologized. Second, children are more likely to forgive people who are "in group." Third, the more advanced a child's Theory of Mind skills are, the more likely they are to forgive others.

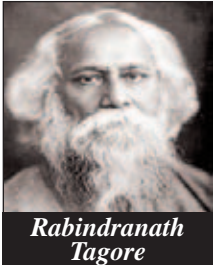
"We found that kids have sophisticated abilities to forgive others," Mulvey says. "Children are capable of restoring relationships with others, and are usually interested in doing so."

The researchers identified two things that parents and teachers may want to focus on related to forgiveness. One is helping kids understand how important it is to apologize in a meaningful way.

"Search within Twitter reminds me of Infoseek in '98! That will also get a lot better pronto," Musk added.

Earlier, Twitter updated its iOS app for Apple iPhone users, including the new USD 7.99

"Get Twitter Blue for USD 7.99/month if you sign up now Blue checkmark: Power to the

people: Your account will get a blue checkmark, just like the celebrities, companies, and politicians you already follow."

Soon after the news went viral, Esther Crawford, a product manager at a micro-blogging site said that the new blue "isn't live yet".

"The new Blue isn't live yet -- the sprint to our launch continues but some folks may see us making updates because we are testing and pushing changes in real-time. The Twitter team is legendary. New Blue... coming soon!" she tweeted.

Twitter also said that some of the features are still not available in the app but will soon be added.

"Coming soon... Half the ads & much better ones: Since you're supporting Twitter in the battle against the bots, we're going to reward you with half the ads and make them twice as

relevant." "Post longer videos: You'll finally be able to post longer videos to Twitter. \*Priority ranking for quality content: Your content will get priority ranking in replies, mentions and searches. This helps lower the visibility of scams, spam, and bots..." Twitter writes in the Apple app store.

Twitter Blue with verification is currently available on iOS in the US, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, and the UK.

On Tuesday, Musk confirmed the reports and announced that the company will charge USD 8 a month for Twitter's subscription service with priority in replies, mentions, and searches.

"Twitter's current lords & peasants system for who has or doesn't have a blue checkmark is bullshit. Power to the people! Blue for USD 8/month," he tweeted.

# Ghaziabad administration orders halt of construction work amid rise in pollution

GHAZIABAD, NOV 6

With the presence of humidity in the weather, the AQI has risen to 450 in the Ghaziabad district of Uttar Pradesh. In view of the deteriorating pollution level, the district administration has ordered shutting of the schools while on the other hand, people are being instructed not to come out of their houses.

Guidelines have been issued to stop the on-going construction work in the area. At the same time, instructions have been issued for complete closure of all the units spreading pollution, but even after the order of the district administration, work is still going on at the construction sites.

The officials of the district administration, Ghaziabad Development Authority, Municipal Corporation and Pollution Control Board have no control over all these pollution spreading units operating in the district. Strict action is also not being taken against these units.

"Looking at the condition of the weather, there are three paper mills which have been kept closed on Saturday and Sunday and there are around 70-80 paper mills which are closed on Wednesday and Thursday," said Vipin Kumar, ADM Ghaziabad. The ADM also said that challan will also be imposed on the sites, which have been running despite the notice. "The administration officers have said that continuous action



is being taken against such works and fine will also be imposed on whichever construction site is running, if any site is going on, then that work will be stopped," said the ADM. "Till now, 15.5 lakhs were challaned by the Municipal Corporation and GDA in the last few days and within the last 5 days, this challan has been recovered by

additional Rs 12.5 lakhs from such works which are causing pollution. Strict action is being taken against all of them, all the officers are keeping a watch on the works that spread pollution. There is a complete ban on all construction works except government construction works," stated further.
