#### States, UTs conduct mock drills to check preparedness

**NEW DELHI:** On the advice of Prime Minister Narendra Modi to remain cautious and prepared to deal with any eventuality related to COVID-19, mock drills are being conducted on Tuesday in various hospitals across the country in view of rising covid-19 cases in some countries including China, Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya said. This comes after four international travellers from Myanmar tested positive for the Coron-avirus infection at the Delhi airport. "To make sure there isn't a Covid surge in the country, PM Modi has asked us to be careful. The government is also preparing if at the covid cases increase. Today mock drills are conducted across covid hospitals in the country to make sure people get proper treatment," Mansukh Mandaviya said. As there have been reports of a surge in Covid cases in some countries, the operational readiness of health facilities is being reviewed in all States and Union Territories in case of

# Haryana ready to face any Covid situation: Vij

Haryana Health and Family Welfare Minister, Sh. Anil Vij said that few Covid cases are being reported these days. If the cases will increase in the coming days, the state government has made all necessary arrangements to deal with the situation. He urged the people not to create panic in the crisis-like situation if the cases arise. For diagnosis, Reverse Transcription-Polymerase Chain Reaction (RTPCR) machines are made available in every district in the state.

While taking stock of the arrangements being made by the state government to deal with COVID-19 situation during a mock drill conducted at Civil Hospital, Sector 6, Panchkula today, he virtually inquired about the data of health facilities and equipment available in the hospitals of all the districts in the state.

While holding inspection of Flu Corner, ICU, Covid Ward and PSA plants established in the hospital, Sh. Vij said that as per the directions of the Central Government, mock drills were conducted across the country today. The main objective of con-



check the facilities and equipment available in the hospitals to deal with the possibility of Covid-19 crisis in future. He also inquired about health

facilities such as RTPCR machine, PSA plant, beds and manpower etc. available in all the hospitals across the state through the online portal.

He said that at present 26 RT PCR machines are functional in 22 districts of the state. Presently 101 PSA plants are functional in the state. There is no shortage of oxygen in the state. Adequate number of oxygen cylinders and oxygen concentrators are available in the hospitals to deal with every situation.

LUCKNOW: Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has declared that the state will give reservations to Other Backward Classes or OBCs in the local bodies and would hold a survey under the Supreme Court guidelines. The election will not be held before the survey and grant of reservation and if need be, the state will go to the Supreme Court to challenge the Allahabad High Court's order for immediate notifica-tion of elections, he said. "We form a com-

mission that will conduct survey of OBCs on the basis of the Supreme Court guidelines. We will not go to elections without providing reservation to OBCs. If required, we will go to the Supreme Court against the High Court's order," Yogi Adityanath said shortly after the High Court scrapped the state government's draft notification on urban local body elections and ordered that the election be held without reservation for

## Dense to very dense fog conditions to prevail over northwest India

Dense to very dense fog conditions will prevail over northwest India during the next 24 hours and dense fog thereafter for subsequent three to four days, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) predicted on Tuesday.

Cold day conditions are likely to abate over northwest India from tomorrow.

"Due to prevailing light wind and high moisture in lower tropospheric levels, dense to very dense fog is very likely to continue over many parts of Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi, West Uttar Pradesh and in isolated pockets over north Raiasthan during the next 24 hours. Its intensity and spread are likely to reduce thereafter," the IMD said.

Dense fog is very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam and Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura during the next days, according to

# Every eligible person will get BPL card in state: Dushyant

CHANDIGARH, DEC 27

Haryana Deputy Chief Minister, Sh. Dushyant Chautala said that no eligible person in the state will be deprived of getting a BPL card, if any eligible person wants to change his eligibility, then, he can get it rectified by submitting an affidavit to the Additional Deputy Commissioner of his concerned district.

Sh. Chautala informed that according to the data of the Parivar Pehchan Number database, by December 2022, 30,38,942 families (1,21,57,298 members) have been verified to have income less than Rs. 1.80 He gave this information while re-

sponding to a question raised by a member of the House during the winter session of the Vidhan Sabha today.

The Deputy Chief Minister said that all the above families have been

included for issuing ration cards to the BPL (Primary Families) category. He further informed that 9,60,235 families have been excluded from the current list of BPL (PH), AAY and Other Priority Household (OPH).

He said that before integration with Parivar Pehchan Number, where the number of AAY families was 2,47,227, BPL (Primary Household) 8.90.069 families and Other Priority Household (OPH) were 15,57,299 in the State, whereas after integration ber, the number of AAY families is 3,02,000 and BPL (Primary Family) 27,36,942 families.

Responding to a question raised by another member of the House, Sh. Dushyant Chautala said that the norms for issuing and cancelling BPL cards in the state have been set by the Rural Development Department and the Urban Local Bodies Department. According to these, the criteria of total verified annual income of upto Rs 1.80 lakh is considered for issuance of BPL (Priority Household) card, as per the notifications. The process of inclusion and exclusion of BPL beneficiaries is being adopted by the Citizen Resource Information Department (CRID) on the basis of annual income shown in the family identity card. He further informed that on the basis of the data provided by CRID, after March 1, 2022, 12,46,507 BPL (Priority Household) cards were issued.


#### Nehru Yuva Kendra inaugurates a skill-based entrepreneurship training program



DC Dr. Sangeeta Tetarwal said that under the National Tobacco Control Program, the district administration conducts special campaigns from time to time against the violators of the Kotpa Act 2003 and fines them as per rules. She said that under Section 4 of the COTPA (Cigarettes and Other Tobacco

Products Act) 2003, smoking of beedis, cigarettes, hookahs and cigars in any public place is prohibited and there is a fine for violation. Section 5 provides for fine and imprisonment for advertising any tobacco product in shop, TV, newspaper, radio and internet and promoting tobacco products. Section 6A prohibits selling or getting tobacco products sold to minors and mandatory installation of warning boards at shops, violation is punishable. Section 6B prohibits the sale of tobacco products within 100 yards of the outer boundary of any educational institution and attracts fines for violation. Under Section 7, there is a ban on selling any tobacco product without warning, selling and selling loose cigarettes in 85 percent of both its main parts and there is a provision for fine and imprisonment for violation. She appealed to the people to cooperate in this campaign of the Health Department and not to smoke in any public place, so that the people around can be saved from the side effects of passive smoking. Public places like hospitals, courts, railway stations, railway waiting rooms, educational institutions, libraries, hotels, guest houses, dhabas, restaurants etc.

## **EDITORIAL**

## A world transformed

hen the year began, the debate on Ukraine had already started. Vladimir Putin was amassing his troops around Ukraine. It was widely believed that this was part of a diplomatic manoeuvre to push for a renegotiated settlement with Europe. The West was trying to ensure that war doesn't return to Europe. The world was nervous but few believed that a full-fledged war was in the offing.

And, yet, it happened, forever changing the geopolitics of Europe and the world. Since that fateful day on February 24, when the Russian invasion began, it has been estimated that more than 100,000 Russian and 100,000 Ukrainian soldiers have been killed or injured, along with some 40,000 civilian deaths. Over 7.8 million Ukrainians have been made refugees. During his recent visit to the United States of America, Volodymyr Zelensky defiantly told members of the US Congress that his nation will never surrender. "Just like the brave American soldiers who held their lines and fought back Hitler's forces during the Christmas of 1944, brave Ukrainian soldiers are doing the same to Putin's forces this Christmas," he said. In his attempt to convince the US to keep supporting the Ukrainian war effort, Zelensky pitched it as an investment in security for the future even as he predicted a "turning point" in the conflict next year.

But Zelensky also knows that the next few months are critical. Even though Joe Biden pledged a new \$2 billion aid package with an additional \$45 billion in the pipeline, there is growing disquiet among a section of Republicans about the continuing costs of the American war effort. Significantly, there is war fatigue in the US, with a third of Americans no longer backing continued US aid to Ukraine and around half

wanting Ukraine to settle for peace.

Russia will be hoping that a harsh winter will not only dwindle public support for the war in Ukraine but also test the European resolve to stand by Kyiv. Moscow has accused the US of fighting a proxy war in Ukraine and Washington's delivery of Patriot missiles is likely to aggravate this sense further.

The war in Ukraine may or may not end soon, but it has significantly transformed the global landscape. Structurally, it has accelerated the trend towards global polarisation. The West's antagonism vis-à-vis Russia is now firmly embedded in the wider US-China contestation as the Russia-China axis has been cemented further. As Europe strengthens its security outlook and military capabilities, it is being forced to take a relook at its engagement with China.

# India emerges as leading investment destination

India has emerged as a leading investment destination for billionaires worldwide, according to "UBS Billionaire Ambitions Report 2022." The UBS report is based on surveys, questions and information from the UBS Evidence Lab on over 2,500 billionaires across 75 markets.

According to the report, billionaires are looking to put more of their money in India due to the strong growth of the region's econ-

Among the sectors, the billionaires favour energy, possibly due to today's supply constraints and the accelerating secular transition to renewables. In the report, 58 per cent of the billionaire respondents chose India and Southeast Asia as their chosen markets for investment. Only 42 per cent of respondents picked China.

In contrast to the rest of the world, India's billionaire population flourished, as it surpassed the United Kingdom to become the fifth-largest economy in 2022. India with a more youthful labour force also overtook China as the fastest-growing of the world's major economies. At the same time, the number of Indian billionaires grew from 140 last year to 166 with their aggregated wealth expanding by 25.7 per cent to USD 749.8 bil-

The "UBS Billionaire Ambitions Report 2022" published earlier this month said that "North America, with its huge domestic market and vibrant entrepreneurial culture, also remains a popular region. While still ahead of the rest of the world, mainland China lags these regions somewhat." Few seem to be interested in investing in Western Europe despite it being a major economic bloc.

It is not only in investments that China has seen a fall from a year ago. The ranks of billionaires have also fallen. Mainland China's zero-COVID policy slowed the growth after many years as the world's fastest-growing large economy. There were 540 billionaires, down from 626 a year before. After a



decade of significantly increasing, total wealth reduced by a fifth (19.9 per cent) to USD 2.0 trillion. However, China is not alone. With the falling markets, the billionaire population around the world has de-

In March 2022, there were 2,688 billionaires worldwide worth USD 12.7 trillion, down from 2,755 individuals with USD 13.1 trillion in 2021. Asia-Pacific was the region with the largest billionaire population globally at 1,084 with a total wealth of USD 4.2 trillion, in comparison to 1,143 individuals and USD 4.7 trillion a year ago. UBS report noted that the total wealth and number of billionaires is likely to have reduced further since March due to declines in asset prices.

The number of billionaires in the United States, home to about a third of billionaires globally, was also steady witnessing a slight rise from 724 in 2021 to 735. Total wealth increased by 6.9 per cent to USD 4.7 trillion. Notably, finance and investments had the

highest number of billionaires (392 in total) and one of the greatest turnovers. Taken together, their total wealth totalled USD 1.7 trillion. 50 new billionaires were created during the year, while 30 dropped from the list.

The new billionaires included fintech disruptors, private equity and hedge fund partners. The second most populous sector, technology, witnessed a considerable flux. There were 41 new tech billionaires while 57 disappeared, leaving a total of 348 worth USD 2.2 trillion. This instability demonstrates the dynamism of a sector where barriers to entry are low, and innovation is per-

Manufacturers blossomed amid extraordinary demand for durable goods, as well as the emergence of new electric vehicle and battery entrepreneurs. There were 338 manufacturing billionaires in 2022 worth a total of USD 1.1 trillion, with 44 new billionaires joining the list while 37 dropped from the list. This year's UBS billionaire report re-

vealed that 95 per cent of surveyed billionaires believe that they should use their wealth or resources to help tackle global challenges.

Two-thirds said that it is their responsivity to "lead the way" while almost a third be-lieve that they should use their wealth or resources to help tackle these challenges. More than 40 per cent of the billionaires surveyed see smart agriculture as one of the sectors where they can make the greatest impact, along with clean water and poverty allevia-

The surveyed billionaires also see opportunities in green energy as well as waste management and recycling, they believe the government has a greater potential role in these areas."This year's report highlights how many of the wealthiest in society see it as their responsibility to lead the way, using their wealth or resources to help tackle unprecedented environmental and societal challenges," said UBS's George Athanasopoulos, Head of Global Family and Institutional Wealth, and Alice Page, Head of Ultra High Net Worth Solutions Group, in a joint state-

ment.
"The combination of plentiful long-term capital and innovation has the potential to create huge change and opens up new opportunities for a different approach to investing." "We remain realistic about the ability of private capital on its own to solve the world's

While we see this convergence as a clear trend, will it be done on a sufficient scale to help meet the UN's sustainability goals (SDGs) and the race to zero carbon? There are reasons for optimism and those who can connect billionaires to opportunities globally, such as UBS, play an important role in this trend."

From a sector perspective, technology and health continue to draw interest from the surveyed billionaires although these industries of late witnessed a decline in valuations and interest in the public equity markets.

## Women burn fat even after menopause

The estrogen deficiency following menopause is thought to impair women's ability to use fat as an energy source. A study conducted at the Faculty of Sport and Health Sciences of the University of Jyvaskyla shows that menopausal state or blood estrogen levels do not clearor blood estrogen levels do not clearly determine the rate at middle-aged women are able to use fat at rest or during exercise. Higher fat utilization

Estrogen is viewed as a hormone promoting fat burning. After menopause, estrogen levels drop. The resulting estrogen deficiency is thought to reduce women's ability to use fat as an energy source, leading potentially to weight gain and metabolic health impairment. Estrogen levels can be restored with hormone replacement therapy (HRT). A study performed at the University of Jyvaskyla found that the influence of menopause on fat utilization is likely minor compared with nutritional status or fitness levels. When the rate of fat utilization was measured at rest af-



ter overnight fasting, its primary determinant was energy balance. Women whose energy intake was lower compared with their energy expenditure used fat at a higher rate. Higher fat utilization was also characterized by higher blood fatty acid and ketone levels. However, fat utilization of postmenopausal women did not differ from women who had not yet reached menopause or were using HRT. "This was an expected result. Women burn fat also after menopause if their energy intake is less than their expenditure," says Doctoral Researcher Jari Karppinen.

## Death toll from heavy winter storm across US rises to 50

t least 50 people had died in the United States by Monday morning as a result of heavy winter storm-re-

lated incidents, media reported.

Earlier in the day, 34 deaths were reported as extreme cold, wind and snow continued through Christmas. The snowstorm has settled over an unprecedentedly wide area from the Great Lakes near the US-Canada border to the Rio Grande River

At least 12 states, namely Colorado, Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Missouri, Nebraska, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Tennessee and Wisconsin reported a total of 50 deaths, NBC News said. The city of Buffalo in northeastern New York state had the most casualties, with more than a meter of snow falling over the weekend. As of today, at least 14 people had died, the re-

According to city police, the dead were found "outside and in cars."

New York Governor Kathy Hochul called the natural disaster "the most devastating storm in Buffalo's long story history.' According to Hochul, 15,000 people in and around the city remain without electricity, and repair work has been delayed until





## Zorawar Singh and Fateh Singh clung to her grandmother with a Smile and said, ``O Dadee Maan, age does not matter"

more painful but inspiring Astory than"Saka Sirhind(Punjab) may not be found on the pages of world history. My tears trickle down when I dare to write few lines about the barbarous massacre of two children of a great father and brave mother, aged five and seven years by Wazir Khan, Nawab of Sirhind, when these two children displayed unique firmness to stick to their faith.

Guru Gobind singh(1666-1708) is among the most revered of Gurus. Right from childhood he showed great brilliance and foresightedness. Guru Sahib was a profound thinker, writer, philosopher, soldier and saint. Guru Gobind Singh ji was blessed with four sons, namely Ajit Singh. Jujhar Singh ,Zorawar Singh and Fateh Singh. Two eld-



er sons Baba Ajit Singh and Baba Jujhar Singh attained martyrdom in the battle of Chamkaur Sahib. Two younger Sahibzadas, Zorawar Singh, aged seven and his

younger brother Fateh Singh aged five, were with their grandmother, Mata Gujari, at rivulet sirsa near Ropar town.

The imperial army, under

was pursuing them to capture Guru Gobind Singh and his followers , after they had evacuated Ananadpur Sahib. It was bitter cold and utter darkness, the whole family of guru got separated from each other and rushed for safety in different directions, under the protection of God alone. Grand mother, mata Gujri along with two sahibzadas managed to reach Ropar and there she met a person named Gangu, their discharged cook. The grandmother agreed to accept his shelter and protection in his village Kheri near Sirhind . But Gangu betrayed and handed them over to Wazir Khan, nawab of Sirhind. The two children and the grandmother were lodged in the prison cell .They were neither given any food nor warm clothing for the

night. On the following day the grandmother was asked to prepare the children, as they had to be produced in the royal court .Mata Gujri continued advising them to remain firm to their faith, which alone would bring honour to their father and grandfather ,Guru Tegh Bahadur. Zorawar Singh and Fateh Singh clung to her grandmother with a smile and said ,"O dadee mann ,age does not matter.Our father Guru Gobind Singh, was just nine year old when he asked his father to sacrifice his noble life for the protection of the faith of Kashmiri Pandits." The Sahibzadas were produced before Wazir Khan in his court, he tried very kindly and affectionately to impress upon them for changing their faith and acceptance of Islam on promises of royal honours and gifts. But Zo-

rawar Singh replied in a polite tone, "Our faith is more dear to us than the offered royal gifts. The Nawab retorted, "Then you will have to die." Zorawar Singh remained firm and said, "It will be better to die with our faith intact. On this Wazir Khan changed his attitude to learn that the children were not ready to accept Islam.

Suchanand Khatri, his Dewan(Courtier) infuriated him fur-ther, saying, "These children are young ones of a snake and could be bricked alive.Fateh Singh aged five, younger brother could not follow as to why he was made to stand on bricks and mud was put on his feet.

Zorawar Singh told him that the time of their sacrifice had arrived and they should recite Japuji Sahib. The wall fell when it reached shoulder high. Still the

children remained firm in their resolve. They were, therefore, beheaded on 27th December 1704. There is no parallel to the martyrdom of such young boys in the annals of human history.

Todar Mal, a devoted Sikh, learnt about the execution and went to the mother of Guru. With a heavy heart, he broke the sad news to her, regarding the execution of her grandchildren. Hearing the news she looked to God and breathed her last. Todar Mal acquired land for cremation by giving gold coins in lieu of land.

To commemorate the martyrdom of Sahibzads Baba Zorawar Singh and Baba Fathe Singh, every year ,"Shaheedi Jor Mela" is being organised at Fategarh Sahib in Punjab on December 25 to 27.

## Apple Watch 8 series' automated crash notifications feature backfires in ski town

ashington: The Apple Watch 8 series, which was released with the feature to send an automated call to emergency services when the device experiences an abrupt stop, usually a result of a car crash, recently backfired. According to GSM Arena, a tech news-related website, The Colorado Sun has reported that the feature is now backfiring as one US ski town fielded 71 crash notifications. None of these automated calls was an emergency - skiers just stopped abruptly on the slopes without needing medical attention, as per

the outlet. The iPhone 14 series' "crash detection" and "fall detection" features immediately dial 911. The emergency centre then calls the caller back, and if they do not answer, it is presumed that they have been in an accident and that an emergency vehicle needs to be deployed

According to Trina Dummer, the interim director of the Summit County 911 centre, these calls involve "a tremendous amount of resources, from dispatchers to deputies to ski patrollers." but none of them was an actual emergency event Apple acknowledged the issue with skiers and the collision detection system in a response to dispatch supervisors, according to Grand County Sheriff Brett Schroetlin, and indicated a remedy is being developed in Cupertino, as per GSM

Meanwhile, apart from crash detection, Apple Watch Series 8 can track changes in body temperature as little as 0.1 degrees Celsius, checking it every five seconds. It comes in four colours: midnight starlight, silver, and product silver, gold, and graphite.

#### Microsoft employee mistakenly leaks new version of Notepad with tabs

ashington: An employee of the American tech giant Microsoft has accidentally announced that Windows 11's Notepad app is getting a tabs

According to The Verge, an American technology news website, a photo of a version of Notepad with tabs was shared by the employee, a senior product manager at Microsoft.

"Notepad in Windows 11 now has tabs!" he enthusiastically announced with a loudspeaker emoji. The screenshot included a Microsoft internal warning: "Confidential Don't discuss features or take screenshots. It suggested that Microsoft's tabs feature is still in early

internal testing. Minutes later the tweet was deleted but not before Windows Central and several Windows enthusiast Twitte accounts had spotted it.

If Microsoft does implement tabs for Notepad, it will be the first built-in tool to have a tabbed interface, following the addition of tabs to File Explorer earlier this year, reported The Verge.

Microsoft first tried tabs across all Windows 10 apps in a feature called Sets four years ago. This contained tab functionality in Notepad and File Explorer, however Microsoft halted the project and never released it to

The addition of tabs in Notepad could signal a shift towards tabs appearing in more built-in Windows apps Microsoft may have dropped the Sets feature in Windows 10, but that hasn't stopped Windows power users from bringing tabs to life in various parts of the operating system via third-party tools and apps, as per The Verge

## Most heart disease deaths can be prevented by changing diets: Study

os Angeles: Heart diseases are among the most fatal causes of threat to life in the world today.

With healthier diets, more than two-thirds of heart disease-related fatalities may be avoided globally, that was the conclusion of a study published in the journals 'European Society of Cardiology's journal' and European Heart Journal - Quality of Care and Clinical Outcomes The findings had been released on World Food Day

which emphasized the significance of healthy meals that are accessible to all and sustainable. "Our analysis shows that unhealthy diets, high blood

"More than six million deaths could be avoided by reducing intake of processed foods, sugary beverages trans and saturated fats, and added salt and sugar, while increasing intake of fish, fruits, vegetables, nuts and whole grains. Ideally, we should eat 200 to 300 mg of omega 3 fatty acids from seafood each day. On top of that, every day we should aim for 200 to 300 grams of fruit, 290 to 430 grams of vegetables, 16 to 25 grams of nuts, and 100 to 150 grams of whole grains," she added.

The study analysed data provided by the Global Burden of Disease Study 2017, which was conducted in 195 countries between 1990 and 2017.2 In 2017, there were



pressure, and high serum cholesterol are the top three contributors to deaths from heart attacks and angina collectively called ischaemic heart disease," said study author Dr. Xinyao Liu of Central South University Changsha, China, adding, "This was consistent in both developed and developing countries.

126.5 million individuals living with ischaemic heart disease, and 10.6 million new diagnoses of the condition Ischaemic heart disease caused 8.9 million deaths in 2017, which equates to 16% of all deaths, compared with 12.6% of all deaths in 1990. Between 1990 and 2017, age-standardised prevalence

decreased by 11.8%, 27.4%, and 30%, respectively. But absolute numbers almost doubled. Dr. Liu said: "While progress has been made in preventing heart disease and improving survival, particularly in developed countries, the numbers of people affected continues to rise because of population growth and ageing," she said The investigators calculated the impact of 11 risk factors

on death from ischaemic heart disease. These were diet high blood pressure, high serum low-density lipoprotein (LDL) cholesterol, high plasma glucose, tobacco use, high body mass index (BMI), air pollution, low physical activity, impaired kidney function, lead exposure, and alcohol use. Specifically, they estimated the proportion of deaths that could be stopped by eliminating that risk

Assuming all other risk factors remained unchanged

69.2% of ischaemic heart disease deaths worldwide could be prevented if healthier diets were adopted. Meanwhile, 54.4% of these deaths could be avoided if systolic blood pressure was kept at 110-115 mmHq. while 41.9% of deaths could be stopped if serum LDL was kept at 0.7-1.3 mmol/L. About a quarter of deaths (25.5%) could be prevented if serum fasting plasma glucose was kept at 4.8-5.4 mmol/L, while eradicating smoking and second-hand smoke could stop one-fifth (20.6%) of deaths from ischaemic heart disease Notably, tobacco use ranked as fourth highest contributor to ischaemic heart disease deaths in mer but only seventh in women. Between 1990 and 2017. the global prevalence of smoking decreased by 28.4% in men and 34.4% in women. High BMI was the fifth highest contributor to ischaemic heart disease deaths in women and sixth in men. For women, 18.3% of deaths from ischaemic heart disease could be prevented if BMI was kept at 20-25 kg/m2. In both sexes, the percentage contributions of air pollution and lead exposure to age-standardised ischaemic heart disease deaths increased as the country of residence became less developed

The 4,700 mAh capacity of the Galaxy S23+ is further increased by 200 mAh with 45W fast charging. A 5,000 mAh battery and 45W rapid charging, which Samsung has been using in its Ultra handsets since early 2020, will be included in the Galaxy S23 Ultra. Rumours already suggest that Samsung has set the launch date to February 1, meaning there will be over a month for more details to surface, as per GSM Arena.

#### Samsung rolls out Android 13-based One **UI 5 update for Galaxy** F23 smartphone

# Warner grabs headlines with 200, puts Aus in driver's seat

David Warner's double hundred in his 100th Test helped Australia to take control of the second Test match against South Africa at MCG here on Tuesday.

At the close of Day 2, Australia were leading by 197 runs, ending the day at 386/3 in their first innings after the hosts dismissed South Africa for 189 runs. Travis Head and Alex Carey were batting on 48 and 9

Warner hogged the day's limelight as he came out trumps after he was the much-talked about cricketer who was short of runs coming into the match and his removal from the captaincy in the previous IPL.

But his 100th Test redeemed him from all these attacks. Warner found his spirits that made him conquer the physical and mental battle. He hardly gave any chance and the only time he was troubled was when

Anrich Nortje bowled with a lot of steam in the second session.

Warne's first hundred came in 144 balls and got his second in just 110 balls, as he pressed the accelerator when started to get the cramps. He became the first Australian to score a double in his 100th Test, but soon retired after reaching the landmark due to dehydration.

For South Africa it was a difficult day. They could manage three wickets, out of which one was a runout dismissal.

Marnus Labuchagne returned to the hut due to poor communication between him and Warner.

Steven Smith came in, and proved a perfect partner for Warner. They put on a scintillating 239-run stand for the third wicket, before Smith (85) threw it away to Nortje.

Cameron Green got hit on the fingers and became the second Australian to retire hurt. Carey and Head saw the day off and ensured Australia remained in a dominant position.

## Mitchell Starc doubtful for third Test against SA

the third Test against South Africa in Sydney after he dislocated his finger during the first day of the Boxing Day Test at the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG).

As per ESPNCricinfo, Starc dislocated the tip of the middle finger of his left hand, which he uses for bowling, while attempting a catch during day one of the second Test against South

Starc left the field for treatment. He later returned to the field at the end of Proteas first innings after having a brief bowling session in the net at the back of MCG, but he was not required to

Australia's team management confirmed on the second day morning that Starc was cleared to play and he also batted in the nets. But the statement also said, "condition will be reassessed at the completion of the match" and no details of the results of his

Australia has two spare quicks in the squad. Josh Hazlewood and Lance Morris bowled in nets at the second morning at MCG. Morris was called up ahead of Adelaide Test against West Indies to cover up for Starc, who has played last 18 consecutive Tests for Aussies since being only selected for a single out of five Ash-

Australia can also consider adding a specialist spinner to the squad for the third Test as the only Test played in this summer, a Sheffield Shield match between New South Wales and West Australia was great for spinners. NSW off-spinner Chris Green took nine wickets while WA off-spinner Corey Rocchiccioli took eight scalps in a low-scoring game.

# 'Avatar 2' crosses INR 7,000 crores worldwide in 10 days!

ith USD 855 million (equivalent to INR 7,000 crores) in worldwide ticket sales after 10 days in theatres, Disney and 20th Century's high-budget epic 'Avatar: The Way of Water' has become the fifth-highest grossing film of the year.

According to Variety, James Cameron's longawaited sequel has so far brought in USD 253.7 million domestically and USD 600 million overseas. The 'Avatar' sequel is anticipated to generate significant box office revenue in the near future, despite the severe winter weather in North America and the rising rates of COVID, RSV, and the flu worldwide. Variety reports that the USD 350 million budgeted film hopes to surpass the USD 1 billion mark by the end of the year.

Only two other movies in 2022 have been able to surpass it: 'Top Gun: Maverick' and 'Jurassic World Dominion.'

According to Variety, the highest-grossing country outside of North America for 'Avatar 2' has been China, with USD 100.5 million, followed by Korea (USD 53 million), France (USD 52.3 million), India (USD 37 million), and Germany (USD 35.7 million).

However, as per Variety, there are a number of reasons why the sequel will find it difficult to match the success of the first movie, which brought in USD 2.97 billion globally, making it the highestgrossing picture in history.

For starters, the global box office hasn't entirely recovered from the pandemic, and significant markets like China are seeing the infection reemerge. Additionally, the sequel won't be seen in Russia, where the first movie made USD 116 million.
