## Strong tremors in Delhi-NCR as earthquake strikes Pakistan

**NEW DELHI:** An earthquake of magnitude 5.8 hit Pakistan on Thursday, and tremors were felt in the Jammu-Kashmir and Delhi-NCR regions. Earlier on Sunday, earthquake tremors were felt in Delhi and surrounding areas. However, there were no reports of any injuries or damage. An earthquake of 3.8 magnitude was recorded in Haryana's Jhajjar with tremors in Delhi and surrounding areas on Sunday morning, National Center for Seismology had said. "An earthquake of Magnitude 3.8 jolted the national capital and surrounding areas at around 1.19 am. The epicentre of the earthquake was in Jhajjar."

## India detects 11 Omicron sub-variants in international passengers in last 10 days

**NEW DELHI:** Eleven variants of COVID-19 were detected during testing of international passengers at airports and seaports in India between December 24 to January 3, official sources have said. Eleven Omicron sub-variants were found during testing of international travellers and all these variants earlier reported as present in the country, the sources said. A total of 19,227 samples of international travellers were tested, out of which 124 were found positive and were isolated they said.

## Kabaddi coach from Punjab shot dead in Philippines

**MANILA:** A kabaddi coach from Punjab's Moga, Gurpreet Singh Gindru (43) was shot dead in the capital city of the Philippines on Tuesday, said Manila Police. Gurpreet had gone to the Philippines around four years back to make his living. The 43-year-old was allegedly shot in the head by unidentified miscreants who broke into his home after he returned from work. The attackers had not been identified, nor has the reason been found out why Kabaddi coach Gurpreet was shot dead by the assailants, as per a statement issued by the Manila police to the local media. In another incident, a man from Punjab was killed in Canada's Ontario. Mohit Sharma (28), was found dead in the back seat of a car in a secluded place. Notably, there is a rise in reports of hate crimes against the Indian diaspora abroad.

# Thousands can't be uprooted overnight, SC stays eviction in Haldwani

Thousands can't be uprooted overnight, the Supreme Court on Thursday said while putting a stay on the Uttarakhand High Court's decision ordering the State authorities to remove encroachments from railway land in Haldwani's Banbhoolpur area.

A bench of Justices Sanjay Kishan Kaul and Abhay S Oka issued notices to the Indian Railways and Uttarakhand government on the pleas.

"There cannot be uprooting of 50,000 people overnight," said the bench, adding that there has to be segregation of people who have no right on the land and the need for rehabilitation while recognising the need for railways.

Noting that people are living there for decades, the bench said there should be measures for rehabilitation since the issue involves a human angle.

Posting the case for hearing on February 7, the bench said that it has put to the Additional Solicitor General Aishwarya Bhati that full rehabilitation of the persons in the area is needed.

"Issue notice. In the meantime, there shall be a stay of the directions passed in the impugned order. There should also restrain any more construction or development on the land," said the bench in its order.



During the hearing, the apex court said, "What is troubling us is how do you deal with a situation where people bought the land in the auction and took possession after 1947 and acquired title. You (railways) may acquire the land but what to do now? People live for 60-70 years some rehabilitation has to be done. There must be a culmination to the issue and we do not encourage what is going on."

ASG Bhati for Indian Railways said that this strip of land belongs to the railways. Their claim is that it is their land, they are not asking for rehabilitation.

## Will proceed as per court's order, says Uttarakhand CM

**HALDAWANI:** Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami on Thursday said that the government would proceed according to the Supreme Court's order staying a December 20 direction of the Uttarakhand High Court which had directed eviction of thousands of families occupying railway land in Haldwani district within a week.

"We've said earlier also that

it is a railway land. We will proceed as per the court's order," said Dhami today reacting to apex court's putting a stay on the High Court's order to remove encroachments from railway land in Haldwani's Banbhoolpur area.

The apex court issued a notice to the Uttarakhand government and India Railways on the pleas challenging the Uttarakhand High Court's decision.

He was also an Indian National Congress nominee on the Radcliffe Commission that defined the boundaries of India and Pakistan.

## Srinagar records season's coldest night at -6.4 Deg C

Unabated cold continues to shiver Kashmir valley as Srinagar experienced the coldest night of the season at -6.4 degree Celsius on Thursday.

The Meteorological Centre office said that Srinagar recorded a low of minus 6.4 degree Celsius on Thursday against minus 5.2 degree Celsius recorded the previous night. It was 4.3 degree Celsius below normal during this period of the season.

This was the second lowest temperature witnessed in Srinagar during the last five years in the month of January. The city recorded a minimum of minus 8.8 degree



Celsius on January 31, 2021, Faizan Arif, an independent weather observer, told a news agency.

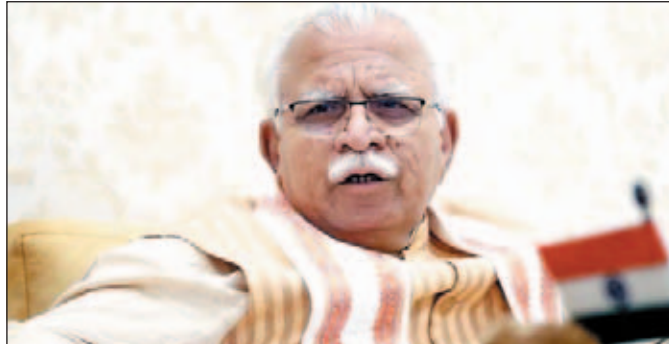
On December 25 the minimum temperature had plunged to seasons lowest at minus 5.8 degree Celsius in Srinagar this year.

Major parts of Dal Lake and other water bodies froze as a thick layer of icy surface emerged on Thursday due to the intense plummeting temperatures. Shikara men were seen breaking the icy surface of the lake to make the way forward.

Kupwara also recorded the season's lowest minimum temperature at minus 6.2 degree Celsius on Thursday against minus 6.0 degree Celsius the previous night. It was 3.7 degree below normal during the period of the season for the frontier Kashmir district.

Tourist resort of Pahalgam in south Kashmir remained the coldest place with a low of minus 9.2 degree Celsius against minus 9.4 degree Celsius despite a slight improvement in temperature witnessed today. Gulmarg in north Kashmir had a low of minimum 7.5 degree Celsius on Thursday against minus 8.4 degree Celsius recorded a day ago.

## SYL row: Tribunal will decide distribution of water, says Manohar Lal

Haryana Chief Minister said that the Supreme Court, in its decision has clearly said that SYL should be built and both Haryana and Punjab should come to a mutual agreement for its construction. However, despite these directions, Punjab Chief Minister and his administrative wing are adamant about not resolving this issue.

"Instead of discussing this pivotal issue, the Punjab Chief Minister and his administrative wing repeatedly say that there is no water in the state. Rather they are asking to discuss sharing of water whereas a separate tribunal has been set up for discussing issues related to water sharing. Distribution of water will be done according to the recommendation of the tribunal," said

Sh. Manohar Lal while interacting with the media persons in New Delhi today.

Reacting to the statement made by Delhi Chief Minister, the Chief Minister said that if Arvind Kejriwal has any formula to resolve the SYL issue, he should share the same with Bhagwant Mann. The Punjab Chief Minister should share the formula with Haryana whenever the next meeting is held. Also, if not with us, then Arvind Kejriwal can also share the same formula with the Supreme Court.

The Chief Minister said that meeting the needs of drinking water is the utmost priority of any government. Most of the water that Haryana is giving to Delhi is used for drinking purposes. Delhi is getting its complete water share from Haryana as per Supreme Court's orders, he added.

person should be between 18 to 55 years and educational qualification should be 10th pass only. He said that it costs about two lakh 70 thousand rupees to open a Vita booth. This also includes the cost of shop racks and packed goods. Under this scheme Haryana Agro 15% and bank 85% loan is provided. He told that to open Vita booth, Vita booth can be set up in 12 by 12 square feet. For this no security amount is taken from BPL family also. Only Rs 10,000 is taken from AntyodayaPatra and Rs 50,000 as security from general category applicants. For this, the educational qualification of the applicant should be 10th pass and age should be minimum 18 and maximum 55 years. He said that the Vita Booth of Haryana Dairy Federation and Haryana Agro Industries are giving a better option to the youth to open every interest store.



EDITORIAL

Errant concern

The exchange of words of Pakistan's foreign minister, Bilawal Bhutto Zardari, with his Indian counterpart at the United Nations last month may well have embarrassed even the trenchant critics of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. While India's Opposition have harsh words to say about Modi, the Bharatiya Janata Party, and the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh, it may not be at ease when the attacks stem from the government of a hostile neighbour. The invocation of the 2002 Gujarat riots wasn't the first occasion that Pakistan has jumped in to make gratuitous comments on India's internal politics. Whether it was the Ayodhya dispute, a communal riot or other issues confronting Indian Muslims, Pakistan has rarely lost an opportunity to provide its own running commentary. A large part of this distressing habit stems from a deeply ingrained belief in Pakistan that India's unity is fragile, and that sooner or later fissiparous tendencies will prevail. Consequently, and not least in retaliation for India's role in breaking up Pakistan in 1971, Islamabad has deemed it necessary to provide both covert and overt support to movements that have separatist potential. Apart from nurturing an insurgency in Jammu and Kashmir, Pakistan has given generous support to the Khalistan movement in Punjab, not to mention the more modest assistance to the many separatist movements in the Northeast.

While opportunistic support to potentially disruptive forces in India has been a facet of Pakistan's unending bid to weaken its more powerful neighbour, it is guided by expediency. If the situation so demands, Islamabad will not hesitate to wash its hands off the Khalistanis who they now count as assets. However, a similar cynicism is unlikely to guide Pakistan's approach to issues governing India's Muslim minority. The reasons are grounded in history.

Regardless of the contemporary significance of the major ethnic communities — Punjabis, Sindhis, Pathans and Baluchis — that constitute the four pillars of Pakistani nationhood, it is important to bear in mind that undivided India's Muslim-majority provinces were relative latecomers to Muhammad Ali Jinnah's movement. (Bengal may have been the exception.) Pakistan, in the eyes of its founding fathers, was a movement for a Muslim homeland in the Indian subcontinent, a place where Indian Muslims could live and prosper without being constrained by the Hindu majority of India. The greatest appeal of the Pakistan movement from its inception in 1940 to the elections of 1946 was among the Muslim minority in places such as the United Provinces, Bihar, Central Provinces, and the Bombay Presidency.

India-Bhutan relationship: A testimony of friendship and camaraderie

The relationship between India and Bhutan is based on the pillars of trust, goodwill and mutual understanding. The two neighbours have a close civilisational, cultural and economic relationship that dates back centuries. Bhutan considers India as gyagar, meaning the holy land, as Buddhism originated in India, which is the religion followed by the majority of Bhutanese.

The relationship between the two countries further strengthened with the establishment of diplomatic relations between them in 1968. The basis of this relationship is formed on the solid foundation of the Indo-Bhutan Friendship Treaty of 1949 which emphasises "perpetual peace and friendship, free trade and commerce, and equal justice to each other's citizens." Bhutan not only shares a 699 kilometres long boundary with India adjoining four Indian states but is also a key player in two of India's cardinal foreign policy elements - Neighbourhood Policy and Act East Policy.

For India, Bhutan's socio-economic development and territorial integrity have always been a key plank in its foreign policy agenda. The two countries have a close strategic partnership, with India providing assistance to Bhutan in various sectors, including economic development, infrastructure, education, health and security.

India is not only Bhutan's biggest development partner but also the most important trading partner both as a source and market for its trade in goods and services. India provides not only the transit route to a landlocked Bhutan but is also the biggest market for a number of Bhutan's exports including hydroelectricity, semi-finished products, ferrosilicon and dolomite.

Bolstering strategic relations, India deployed its Military Training Team (IM-TRAT) in Bhutan to train the Bhutanese security forces in 1961 and since then has been responsible for Bhutanese security. A



number of engagements pertaining to security and border management issues, threat perceptions, coordination of Indo-Bhutan border entry exit points, and sharing of real-time information, among other aspects are being undertaken by the two countries on a regular basis. The Doklam standoff between Indian and Chinese forces in 2017 has made the security matter even more important and has led to even better coordination and partnership between Indian and Bhutanese forces to secure the strategic areas.

The Indo-Bhutan relationship has development cooperation and hydroelectricity generation as its cornerstone. The two countries have committed to jointly develop 10,000 MW of hydroelectricity capacity in Bhutan. The completion of the 720 MW Mangdechhu hydropower project in Bhutan has been deemed an achievement of the

partnership between the two countries. This has propelled discussions of the Sankosh Hydropower Project building between the two countries.

The two countries did not deter from their commitment even during the COVID-19 pandemic and commissioned the first-ever joint venture project - the 600 MW Kholongchhu hydropower project during the testing time. The project is aimed at generating surplus hydroelectricity for Bhutan which will be exported to India aiding Bhutan's revenue as well as employment generation. India's assistance to Bhutan's development is not limited to the hydropower sector but encompasses almost all the sectors including education, health, infrastructure, social services, environmental protection and technology advancement, amongst others. As per Bhutan's 12th Five

Year Plan (2018-2023), India is providing grant assistance to the tune of INR 4,500 crores, along with a transitional Trade Support Facility of INR 400 crores over a five-year period to reinforce the economic linkages.

In the realm of scientific and technological cooperation, the recent launch of a joint India-Bhutan SAT satellite by ISRO marks a new era of India - Bhutan relations. This satellite is expected to enable Bhutan by providing real-time data and high-resolution images for land mapping and facilitating managing its natural resources, forests and agriculture.

This development is in line with the growing India-Bhutan relations in new avenues such as advanced technology, space and digital systems.

Several key initiatives have already been launched in the fields of digital and space, such as RuPay, the integration of Bhutan's DrukREN with India's national Knowledge Network and the establishment of Ground Earth Station by ISRO to harness the services of South Asia Satellite. Thus, India is enabling the development of Bhutan's digital and space infrastructure so as to harness the potential of Bhutanese youth via skill development and employment generation.

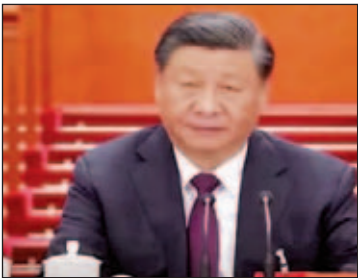
Through digital and space cooperation, not only India is spreading its technological footprint but Bhutan is also getting benefited from India's investments, research and development, technological know-how and expertise in bringing about transformation in various sectors in Bhutan of the 21st Century. The ties between India and Bhutan have over time matured into comprehensive partnerships and cooperation on a wider range of issues spanning energy security, business and trade, security and intelligence sharing, digitisation, space technology and conservation biology sectors, amongst others.

Beijing intimidates female journalists for critical coverage of China

China has been intimidating women journalists and researchers online to silence them and discredit their critical coverage of China, according to think tank Australian Strategic Policy Institute (ASPI).

The increased harassment over the past year directed at women analysts of Asian descent is likely the result of an orchestrated campaign by the Chinese government, research by a think tank said.

China is not going to stop trolling journalists because of an advocacy campaign," Hoffman wrote. "What we can do is put in place strong digital safety measures and online abuse policies in newsrooms that will help to mitigate the impact of these attacks." A 2022 report by the International Center for Journalists found nearly three-quarters of women journalists it surveyed had experienced online threats. Of those, 30 per cent said they self-censored on social media and 20 per cent had quit posting entirely. Some said the harassment led them to quit their jobs or even their profession altogether.



Harassment largely ranged from insults about an individual's appearance to accusations of being a traitor or threats of violence and rape.

The harassment "illustrates how online attacks can be used by authoritarian governments beyond borders to intimidate and silence journalists," Nadine Hoffman, deputy director of the Washington-based International Women's Media Foundation (IWMF), wrote in an email to VOA According to June and November reports from ASPI, a network popularly dubbed Spamouflage is likely behind the harassment. "Spamouflage" refers to an extensive network of Beijing-linked accounts first identified in 2019.

Amid shrinking domestic market, startups in Japan look overseas

Amid a shrinking domestic market, startup companies in Japan are starting to look to invest overseas, reports NHK World. For instance the tech company Opn developed a system for restaurant customers to order and pay by smartphone. It has expanded to Southeast Asia. In November this year, it acquired a US firm with an eye on the North American market, reported NHK World.

Hasegawa Jun, CEO of Opn said, "It's critical for every firm to find a market that can facilitate its growth and then try to break in," as Japanese startups cannot survive in the domestic market alone.

Underscoring the rise in labour costs, another Japanese startup firm has decided to sell robots that prepare food such as soba noodles. It also wants to export a model that makes French fries to the US, reported NHK World.

The Japan External Trade Organization supported startups that want to enter foreign markets. It said that in the fiscal year that ends in March over 120 companies are taking part, which is more than double the figure from two years ago, reported NHK World. Not only the startups, but the Japanese Government too is looking to spread its economic footprints in South Asia. India



has become one of the favourite destinations owing to a shared common heritage of Buddhist ideals and a strong people-to-people bond that goes beyond economic alliances.

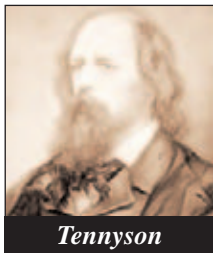

Iran frees actor Taraneh Alidoosti after 18 days in custody



Iranian authorities on Wednesday released actor Taraneh Alidoosti on bail after keeping her in jail for more than two weeks, CNN reported citing state-aligned ISNA.

Last year, in December, Alidoosti was arrested for criticizing the execution of a man who was involved in the nationwide protests. She condemned the hanging of Mohsen Shekari, who was killed in December in the first known execution linked to the protests.

Alidoosti's lawyer told ISNA that she was released on bail. After her release, various photos of her got flourished on social media space. She was seen with flowers and supporters after her release, according to CNN.

Alidoosti, who starred in the 2016 Oscar-winning film "The Salesman" and has appeared in various popular Iranian TV shows, is known for her

activism in the MeToo movement in Iran's cinema industry and was one of several Iranian celebrities to express support for the protests.

Earlier, 'Avengers' star Mark Ruffalo shared a photo which stated that over 600 artists worldwide have already signed the petition for the freedom of Alidoosti.

The open letter, titled "Free Taraneh Alidoosti," was signed by notable figures including Emma Thompson, Mark Ruffalo, Penelope Cruz, Kate Winslet and Kristen Stewart, according to CNN.

He wrote, "Over 600 artists worldwide have signed an open letter calling for the release of award-winning actor and writer Taraneh Alidoosti. We demand her freedom. Join us. Petition link below." In the tweet, Ruffalo also attached a list of some of the artists who have come out to support the cause. It included stars like Jason Momoa, Amma Thomp-

son, Penelope Cruz, Kate Winslet, John Oliver and Kristen Stewart among others.

Alidoosti was arrested as there was a "lack of evidence for her claims," CNN reported citing Fars news agency. In November, she shared a picture of herself on Instagram without the Islamic hijab and holding a sign reading "Women, Life, Freedom" to offer support for the protest movement.

After Shekari's execution, Taraneh Alidoosti in another post said, "Your silence means supporting tyranny and tyrants," adding that "every international organization who is watching this bloodshed and not taking action, is a disgrace to humanity," according to CNN. Since then, her account on Instagram has been deleted.

A decade of direct mutual funds: Investors amass 1000s of crores of extra returns by saving on commissions, says ET Money

Chandigarh: Direct Mutual Funds officially completed ten years of existence on January 05, 2023, allowing Indian investors to earn 1% more than regular funds by saving on commissions. 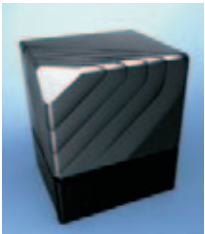

FIR 184/18 was registered under sections of office burning. Manny Bindra, who promotes gun culture on his Facebook even today, promotes Jarnail Singh Bhindranwala. In the case of Viresh Shandilya, Ambala's CJM Saurabh Gupta had issued non-bailable warrants (non-bailable warrants) on which Ambala police had to arrest and present him in the CJM court of Ambala on 12 January 2023. Farmer leaders said that earlier Haryana used to get the highest rate, but this time government did not increase the rate, due to which there is a lot of anger among the farmers. Rate of sugarcane in Punjab is more than ours. Haryana Government should increase the rate of sugarcane to 450 per quintal and this protest will continue till the 9th in the same way. If the government does not accept the demands, then on January 10, there will be a huge mahapanchayat of farmers inside Karnal, in which any decision can be taken. The farmers have to say directly that the Haryana government, instead of being friendly to the farmers, has become an anti-farmer government.
