#### **Centre notifies** appointments of **Justices Rajesh** Bindal, Aravind **Kumar as SC Judges**

**NEW DELHI:** The Union of India on Friday notified the appointments of two more judges to the Supreme Court of India. The Government issued a notification of the appointment of Justice Rajesh Bindal and Justice Aravind Kumar as Judges of the Supreme Court. Justice Rajesh Bindal the Chief Justice of Allahabad High Court and Justice Aravind Kumar the Chief Justice of Gujrat High Court are likely to take oath on Monday as judges of Supreme Court. Law and Justice Minister Kiren Rijiju tweeted stating, "As per the provisions under the Constitution of India, President of India has appointed the following Chief Justices of High Courts as Judges of the Supreme Court. My best to them. 1.Rajesh Bindal, Chief Justice, Allahabad HC. 2. Aravind Kumar, Chief Justice, Gujarat HC."

#### **Rajasthan: Gehlot** apologises for reading old Budget in Assembly

JAIPUR: House proceedings resumed in Rajasthan Legislative Assembly on Friday after Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot apologised for reading the old Budget. CM Ashok Gehlot presented budget 2023 after he said, "I feel sorry, what happened was by mistake." The opposition alleged that CM read the old budget at the start of the budget presentation. Gehlot further stated. "You (Opposition) can point out only if there's a difference between what's written in the budget in my hand and its copies were given to the House members. If a page was added to my budget copy by mistake, how does the matter of leaking of budget arise?"

#### Dress code will now be applicable for all staff in govt health facilities: Anil Vij

CHANDIGARH: Haryana Home, Health and Family Welfare Minister Sh. Anil Vij said that the dress code will now be applicable for all staff working in government health facilities of Haryana. Now, it will now be mandatory for every employee to wear proper uniform. He stated that the designing of the uniform is in the final

stage. Sh. Vij was responding to a question asked by media persons regarding dress code in government health facilities. Health Minister, Sh. Anil Vij apprised that he had recently given direction to make uniform mandatory in all medical facilities of Haryana. Giving the example of private hospitals, Sh. Vij said that when you go to a private hospital, not a single employee is seen without uniform, while in a government hospital it is difficult to differentiate between a patient and an employee.


### Alibaba exits India, sells its entire stake holding in Paytm

AGENCY NEW DELHI, FEB 10

In a block deal, 3.4 per cent equity (or2.1 crore shares) of Paytm's parent company One97 Communications Ltd (OCL) have changed hands on Friday.

Sources in the know of the development say that Chinese multinational Alibaba has sold its entire stake in Paytm in today's block deal.

With this sale, Alibaba is no longer a stakeholder in Paytm. The company had sold around 3.1 per cent of 6.26 per cent equity in Paytm in January.



This latest deal almost completes Alibaba's exit from India since it had earlier sold its stakes in Zomato and BigBasket. The news will bring cheer to the market as it ends the Chinese stake holding in the homegrown Paytm.

Paytm's shares have been rallying in the last few days since it announced operating profitability in its Q3FY23 results with EBITDA before ESOP cost at Rs 31 crore, significantly ahead of its guidance of September 2023.

The fintech giant revenue from operations increased to Rs 2,062 crore (no UPI incentive recorded this quarter), a

growth of 42 per cent on a yearly basis. This was followed by Paytm's robust operating update of January 2023 that it filed with the stock exchange on Febru-

ary 8.

The company has continued to with momentum in its ness sustained growth momentum in its key payments and lending business. Paytm strengthened its leadership in offline payments with the deployment of 6.1 million devices while its average MTU at 89 million registered a 29 per cent growth for the month of January

# ISRO launches SSLV-D2 rocket carrying three satellites

**AGENCY** SRIHARIKOTA, FEB 10

Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) launched the Small Satellite Launch Vehicle - SSLV-D2 from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre at Sriharikota on Friday.

The launch has put ISRO's earth observation satellite EOS-07 and two co-passenger satellites Janus-1 and AzaadiSAT-2 into a 450 km circular orbit around the

According to ISRO, the second developmental flight of SSLV-D2 was scheduled at 09:18 hours IST from the first launch pad at SDSC SHAR in Sriharikota. SSLV-D2 is intended to inject EOS-07, Janus-1 and AzaadiSAT-2 satellites into 450 km circular orbit, in its 15 minutes

Soon after the launch, Mission Director, ISRO Vinoth said "Janus 1 satellite separated. SSLV D2 mission accomplished."

The new vehicle was developed to capture the emerging small and microsatellite commercial market.

'SSLV-D2/EOS-07 Mission is accomplished successfully. SSLV-D2 placed EOS-07, Janus-1, and AzaadiSAT-2 into their in-



tended orbits," the ISRO director

EOS-07 is 156.3 kg satellite designed, developed and realized by ISRO. New experiments inmm-Wave Humidity clude Sounder and Spectrum Monitoring Payload. Janus-1, a 10.2 kg satellite belongs to US-based firm Antaris . It is configured with three solid propulsion stages and a



34 m tall, 2 m diameter vehicle having a lift-off mass of 120 t.

Meanwhile the 8.7 kg satellite AzaadiSAT-2 is a combined effort of about 750 girl students across India guided by Chennai-based Space Kidz India.

#### SC dismisses PIL seeking complete ban on BBC operations in India

**NEW DELHI:** The Supreme Court on Friday dismissed a PIL seeking complete ban on the British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) and BBC India from operating from Indian territory in wake of airing the documentary titled, 'India: The Modi Question' relating to the 2002 Gujarat riots. A bench of Justices Sanjiv Khanna and MM Sundresh said that the plea was misconceived and the court cannot impose censorship. "Completely misconceived, how can this be argued also? You want us to put complete censorship... What is this?" the bench asked from the petitioner's counsel. Hindu Sena president Vishnu Gupta sought a ban on BBC operations in India alleging that it was taking an "anti-India" position. The PIL also sought direction from the NIA to initiate a probe against the anti-India and anti-Indian-government reporting/documentary films/short films including its employee journalist in India .

### Centre drops 'Air Suvidha' for six countries, 2 pc random testing to continue

AGENCY NEW DELHI, FEB 10

The Government of India drops COVID-19 testing and uploading of the 'Air Suvidha' form for international arrivals from China, Singapore, Hong Kong, Korea, Thailand and Japan. However, 2 per cent random testing will continue for international travellers at airports. The Union Health Secretary has written a letter to the Secretary of Aviation in this regard for updating guidelines for International arrivals. "Ministry

of Health & Family Welfare as a part of its proactive yet graded public health response to COVID-19 management has been updating 'Guidelines for International Arrivals' from time to time. In the last update, based on the increasing trajectory of COVID-19 and circulation of mutant variants of the SARS-CoV-2 virus in some countries, the Ministry had mandated requirements of pre-departure COVID-19 testing and uploading of Self-Health Declaration on the Ministry of Civil Aviation's 'Air Suvidha' Portal," the letter reads.

They said that in India every year, an estimated 5 lakh road accidents occur, out of which about two lakh road accidents are due to overspeeding and not wearing a helmet and about one lakh 40 thousand people lose their lives. They said

that today, 150 people were distributed ISI brand helmets as people were motivated to follow the traffic rules correctly. Every driver should wear a helmet and drive within the prescribed speed limit so that road accidents can be curbed and loss of life and property can be prevented. DTO Urmil Shyokand said that if the vehicle is caught exceeding the speed limit set by the Haryana Transport Department, a fine will be imposed under Section 19 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and Section 21 of the Central Motor Vehicle Act, 1989. As per the instruction of the Supreme Court of India, the driving license of the concerned vehicle driver may be suspended for at least three months. He explained that keeping in mind the slogan of "fast speeding, preparing for death", it is important that driving at a speed exceeding the prescribed speed limit not only causes damage to the vehicle, but can also lead to death.

## 3kg heroin, pistol recovered from Tarn Taran

SHASHI PAL JAIN CHANDIGARH/TARN TARAN, FEB 10

The ongoing war against drugs launched on the directions of Chief Minister (CM) Bhagwant Mann dealt a major blow to the cross-border smuggling after Punjab Police in joint operation with Border Security Force (BSF) recovered a parcel containing three packets of Heroin, weighing 3Kg, and 0.30 bore pistol along with magazine and five live cartridges from the border area of village Mianwal in Tarn Taran. The consignment was airdropped by the Pak-based smugglers using a drone from across the border.

Director General of Police (DGP) Punjab Gaurav Yadav said that on information provided by a civilian on hearing drone movement near Indo-Pak border in Khemkaran area on the intervening night of Thursday and Friday, Police teams from Tarn Taran district immediately shared the pin-pointed inputs with the BSF and jointly launched a combing operation in the area, which was within the radius of 1km from the Indo-Pak border. "On deep checking of the surrounding fields, Police and BSF teams have successfully recovered the consignment of 3Kg heroin and a pistol along with ammunition from the area of Mianwal," he said. Pertinently, the development came a day after the Pun-



jab Police arrested a juvenile after recovering 15 packets of heroin, weighing 15Kg, and ?8.40 lakh drug money from his possession during a special naka at Ram Tirath Road in Amritsar. This consignment was also airdropped by Pak-based smugglers using a drone and the accused was going to deliver after retrieving the parcel from the border area of village Kakkar in Amritsar. Sharing more details, Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) Tarn

Taran Gurmeet Chauhan said that investigations are on to ascertain the identity of the Pak smugglers, who sent the consignment via drone, and also their Indian associates, who were to receive this air-dropped consignment. Meanwhile, a case FIR No. 8 Dated 10/2/2023 has been registered under sections 21-C, 23, 27-A and 29 of the NDPS Act and sections 10, 11 and 12 of the Aircraft Act at Khemkaran Police Station in Tarn Taran

in the Gandhi-Nehru family's name...I don't understand why people from their generation don't keep Nehru as their surname, what's the fear and shame?" PM Modi said.

The Prime Minister also accused the Congress of toppling state governments during its rule.

With some opposition parties favouring the restoration of the Old Pension Scheme, PM Modi also touched upon the issue of states' economy.

### **Editorial** False cheer

or f you read India's Economic Survey for the year 2022-23, particularly its chapter on agriculture and Lfood management, you would perhaps be thrilled by its 'all is well' tone. Sectoral growth has been at an alltime high; farmers are buoyed by the Narendra Modi-led government's programmes; from crop productivity, production practices and a mechanisation boost to new market opportunities, the sector is ticking all the boxes to make farmers truly happy. At least, that is the survey's

tone and tenor. But if you travel across the dusty countryside, you see the exact opposite of that sentiment. Old challenges are mounting and farmers are saddled with newer headaches. The slogan of doubling farmers' incomes has fallen flat. While we have seen the number of Farmer Producer Organisations increase in the last three years as a result of the Centre's push, very few of these new institutions show signs of breaking even or aiding farmer members. Floating a company is one thing, making it viable, quite another. You need powerful people at the right places to make that happen. Just ask Adani.

Every year, India produces more from the same unit of land with higher inputs — which means a kilogramme of wheat, lentils, millets or vegetables consumes more fertilisers and energy each year. It is true that there is a growing trend of small and marginal farming families rearing small ruminants to support their income, but without fodder, vaccines or market support from the State. All of it is driven by the individual farmer in his or her fragile capacities.

Then, you read the budget for 2023-24 — the last full budget presented by the Modi 2.0 government and all you see, once again, are slogans. In the last nine years of this regime, there has been a push for quick-fix solutions and lofty slogans devoid of sustained thinking for the long-term robust revival of a broken rural economy or pragmatic economics. As M.S. Swaminathan, the father of India's green revolution, suggested in the voluminous reports he submitted as chair of the National Commission for Farmers over a decade ago, sectoral growth is not equal to farmers' income. There is more than the income spiral: we need to fix a hundred verticals — from soil to market.

In that sense, the Modi government and, in turn, the country wasted a decade of its sweeping majority in Parliament, to give a new deal to the countryside by helping the states — after all, states are the custodians of the agricultural sector. This would have brought the Centre's intentions to fruition.

## How artificial sweetener becomes wastewater tracer

cesulfame is a sugar substitute found in sugar-free beverages and meals. Because it cannot be metabolised in the human body, the sweetener is excreted in wastewater and remains essentially intact even in sewage treatment plants.

According to a new study from the University of Vienna, the sweetener's persistence varies with temperature, much as the concentration of the sweetener in wastewater varies with the seasons. The environmental geosciences team investigated how seasonal oscillations in groundwater flow might be used to trace groundwater flows. Because sugar residues end up in drinking water, acesulfame can be used to determine the source and composition of our water. The research was just published in the journal Water Research.

The sugar substitute acesulfame is one of the most commonly used sweeteners in Europe. It is almost 200 times sweeter than sugar and temperature-stable, making it suitable for sugar-free baking and for sweetening most diet lemonades. Because the human body does not metabolise the substance, it ends up in wastewater when consumed in large quantities and remains there even after treatment, but in fluctuating concentrations.



The new study by the University of Vienna shows that the substance is broken down to varying degrees over the year depending on the temperature.

"For a long time, it was assumed that the potassium salt of acesulfame is not degraded at all in wastewater treatment plants. This is still true, but only in the cold season," said Thilo Hofmann, deputy head of the Centre for Microbiology and Environmental Systems Science at the University of Vienna, adding, "There were already initial indications that at least partial biodegradation takes place in summer. We can prove this in

our study and systematically show for a longer period of time how the concentration of the sweetener in the water changes with the seasons."

Acesulfame is a widely used indicator of wastewater discharges into surface waters and groundwater: since this sweetener is not completely degraded both in wastewater treatment plants and in the environment -- after it has been discharged into water bodies with the treated wastewater -detection of the substance in water indicates that and how much-treated wastewater has entered groundwater, rivers or lakes. "If you follow the traces of the substance, you can ultimately trace flow paths of the wastewater and its mixing with groundwater," Hofmann said. With the knowledge of seasonal fluctuations in the degradation of the substance, acesulfame becomes an even

more meaningful tracer. "Our study shows that the seasonally fluctuating concentration of acesulfame can be used to better visualise and understand the processes in the subsurface, i.e. groundwater flows," said Hofmann. 



## Sea turtles can adapt to rapidly changing world due to surprise changes in genes

round 100 million years ago, a group of land-dwelling turtles Agroup of faile-diversing the took to the oceans, eventually evolving into the sea turtles that we know today. However, the genetic foundations that have enabled them to thrive in oceans throughout the world have remained largely unknown.

In research recently published in the Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences, an international team of 48 researchers led by the University of Massachusetts Amherst in collaboration with the Leibniz Institute for Zoo and Wildlife Research and the Vertebrate Genome Project revealed an incredibly detailed genetic map of two species--



green and leatherback turtles--which is packed with surprises that might hold the key to their survival in a rapidly changing world. A single species' genome contains the genetic set of in-

structions used to build that species, and sequencing any species' genome is an enormous amount of work. This is akin to translating an entire library into a language that scientists can read and has only been possible in the last few decades. For green sea turtles, a "draft" genome, including approximately 100,000 pieces of genetic information, has been available since 2013, "but" says Blair Bentley, a postdoctoral researcher in environmental conservation at UMass Amherst and the lead author of the new research, "these pieces of genetic information weren't precisely mapped out. It was as if you walked into a library and found 100,000 pages lying

on the floor." To more precisely catalogue the turtles' genomes, the international team turned to new technologies including long read sequencing--a technique recently named 2022 Method of the Year by the journal Nature. This has made it possible to sequence genomes from virtually any living species and to do so with far more accuracy than was previously possible. Sequencing of the turtles' genomes was performed both at Rockefeller University, in the Vertebrate Genome Laboratory (VGL), led by Erich Jarvis, who chairs the VGP, and Olivier Fedrigo who is director of the VGL, and at the Max Planck Institute of Molecular Cell Biology and Genetics by

Eugene Myers--all coauthors on the new study. "These advances allowed us to do the equivalent of shelving everything according to the Dewey Decimal System so that we can begin to understand how everything fits together," says Bentley. Once Bentley and his co-authors had correctly organized and annotated the genetic data, they started finding surprises.

The first is that, though greens and leatherbacks diverged from a common ancestor about 60 million years ago, their genomes are remarkably similar. Similar, but not the same. "It's those differences that make them unique," says Lisa Komoroske, professor of environmental conservation at UMass and one of the paper's two senior authors. And it's those differences that may hold the key to each species' long-term survival, especially considering that populations of both greens and leatherbacks have seen precipitous declines due to human

It turns out that green turtles have evolved more genes dedicated to immunity, suggesting an immune system that is better prepared for new pathogens, as well as more olfactory receptors--they have better senses of smell. The leatherback genome also shows that they lower genetic diversity and have historically had lower population levels.
