Education policy should imbibe the values of life


CHANDIGARH, MARCH 11:

Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal said that education is the main factor in the progress of the country and the nation will become self-reliant with inclusive education. The Chief Minister was addressing a meeting organized under the chairmanship of Governor, Sh. Bandaru Dattatraya with vice-chancellors and registrars of private universities of the state at Raj Bhavan here today.

Higher Education Minister, Sh. Mool Chand Sharma, Chairman, Haryana State Higher Education Council, Prof. BK Kuthiala, Advisor, Higher Education, Sh. Brij Kishore, vice-chairman, Higher Education, Dr. KC Sharma, Political Advisor to Chief Minister, Sh. Bharat Bhushan Bharti were also present in the meeting.

New Education Policy imbibes values of life

The Chief Minister thanked the Governor for convening a two-day meeting organized to review the works of the Higher Education Department. He said that



private universities have an important role in implementing the new education policy. "In the new education policy, education related to life values has been included so that the collective development of the person is ensured and he becomes self-reliant," he added.

Citing the example of Swami Vivekananda, he said that education is not just a stack of knowledge but a medium to imbibe the values of life and without it, education is incomplete.

The Chief Minister said that due to Lord Macaulay's education, we could not get real life useful learning. "Life values have been given priority in the new

National Education Policy, so that we can achieve our objectives by imbibing it. The purpose of government and private universities is the same in terms of education. They should adopt the best practices not only of each other but also of universities across the world," he added.

Universities should become self-reliant in field of resources

Sh. Manohar Lal said that the government and private universities should be self-reliant in the field of resources and for this the alumni can make a huge contribution. He said that for this, all the universities can organize Alumni-Day, once in a year and invite their alumni who have settled abroad. "Apart from Alumni funds, assistance can also be taken from CSR Funds for self-reliance," he added.

He further said that the manpower of the college students should also be utilized in various types of surveys. "With this, the universities will get revenue, while there will be intellectual development of the students. The

universities can also generate financial resources by giving their skilled consultancy to various government departments," he said, adding that Manav Rachna University and Ashoka University are working in this regard. He said that the universities should keep updating about the latest techniques and knowledge in the field of research.

Skill education necessary for employment

The Chief Minister said that it is necessary to impart skill education to the youth to eliminate unemployment. "With more expansion of technical education, the youth will become more self-reliant and they will also get employment easily. Skill development has been given prominence in the new education policy," he said. Addressing the meeting, Higher Education Minister, Sh. Mool Chand Sharma said that the state government has set a target to increase the gross enrolment ratio in higher education from 32 percent to 40 percent by 2030. He said that a campaign is being launched to trace the zero dropout of children in the age group of 6 to 18 years.

NEW DELHI: AAP Senior Leader and Rajya Sabha MP Shri Raghav Chadha lambasted the BJP, accusing it of wanting to turn India into an opposition-less nation. He said that BJP wants to make India an autocracy, perhaps even a one party-one leader state, highlighting the BJP's misuse of central agencies like ED-CBI against the opposition. The MP listed out names of prominent leaders like Shri Manish Sisodia of AAP, Smt K Kavitha of BRS, Shri Abhishek Banerjee of TMC among others, saying that if all these leaders joined the BJP, all charges against them would be dropped. He explained how several leaders who had numerous alleged corruption charges against them were cleared of all charges after joining the BJP. He cited the example of the current Chief Minister of Assam, Shri Himanta Biswa Sarma, who had multiple serious corruption cases registered against him while he

was in the Congress. The AAP MP further accused the BJP of becoming "washing machine" that clears charges of corruption against any opposition leader who joins the party. He compared the case of Shri Manish Sisodia to the son of a BJP MLA in Karnataka who was caught with Rs 8 crores of unaccounted and illegal wealth but was not arrested or questioned by any agency.

In a press conference on Saturday, Shri Raghav Chadha said that if leaders like Shri Manish Sisodia, Shri Satyendar Jain, Shri Abhishek Banerjee of the TMC, Shri Sanjay Raut of Shiv Sena, Shri Farooq Abdullah of the NC, Shri DK Shivakumar of the Congress, Smt K Kavitha of the TRS, Shri Tejaswi Yadav of the RJD — leave their own political parties and join the BJP at this time, then the multiple cases registered against them by the ED and ČBI will all be closed.

66 per cent of total income of 7 national parties in 2021-22 came from electoral bonds, other 'unknown' sources: ADR

More than 66 per cent of the total income of seven national parties in 2021-22 came from "unknown sources" like electoral bonds, which accounted for a whopping 83 per cent, according to the Association for Democratic

Reforms (ADR). The seven parties-BJP, Congress, TMC, NCP, CPI, CPI(M) and the National People's Party collected Rs 2,172 crore from unknown sources in 2021-22, the NGO working for electoral reforms

said, citing official data. The income from unknown sources was 66.04 per cent of their total income. And, Rs 1,811.94 crore or 83.41 per cent of the income from unknown sources came through elecgiving the source of income, according to the

At present, political parties are not required to reveal the name of individuals or organisations giving less than Rs 20,000 and those who donated via electoral The ADR stated such

unknown sources include donations via electoral bonds, sale of coupons, relief fund, miscellaneous income, voluntary contributions, and contribution from meetings/morchas.

During the financial year 2021-22, the BJP declared Rs 1,161 crore as income from unknown sources which is 53.45 per cent of the total income of national parties from unknown sources, it said.

This income of BJP is Rs 149.86 crore more than the aggregate of income from unknown sources declared by the other six national parties (Rs 1,011.18 crore)," the ADR said.



India, Australia pitch for better security, trade ties

India-Australia ties are on a good wicket and that was amply illustrated in the red-carpet treatment meted out to the Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese. A number of leaders, including China's President Xi Jinping, the then US President Donald Trump and the former British Prime Minister Boris Johnson, have been through the immersive Gujarat experience on their visits.

Given the very high optics of his joint visit with Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi to the cricket stadium in Ahmedabad, Albanese could easily have gained the impression that he is the most favoured. But then, apart from the hassle of stray Khalistani elements vandalising Hindu temples around Australia and even taking on the Indian diaspora in targeted violence, there is little of cricket's attritional qualities to special IndiaAustralia ties.

Remarkably, the visit of the PMs also seemed to knock some sense into pitch preparation as the surface laid out at the Narendra Modi Stadium was closer to normal than in the previous three Tests played on designer pitches that were stark turners. How political even cricket can get may have been brought out in such intervention, but then cricket and politics have been bedfellows for a very long time in India that the big surface swing it brought to the series should not have come as a surprise.

Mr Albanese may have been in for a few surprises on his visit, like his tour of India's indigenous aircraft carrier INS Vikrant, an honour that is a first for a visiting leader. The pomp and ceremony of a Rashtrapati Bhavan reception only enhanced the sheer good vibes around two of four Quad members tied to a strategic arrangement that reflects India's standing among Western and first world countries today while promising to add to its security.

The country-to-country ties moved on with several Memoranda of Agreements being signed, ranging from sport, culture and innovation to education and renewable energy, with the focus on solar energy and clean hydrogen, on which the world must increasingly keep an eye towards mitigating the deleterious effects of global warming caused by climate change. An agreement to increase mobility of students as well as tech professionals may just help Indians more even as it promotes greater exchanges of people and ideas. A promise to move along even further after a Free Trade Agreement was signed in 2022 was an anticipated outcome from the summit even if much work remains on the nitty-gritty of the proposed Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Agreement.

The first Samba-Tango in South America

▼am feeling like Vasco da Gama in a saree after dis-Lovering a new world: South America. I am "Brazil-Argentina" returned, and not sure whether to keep dancing the samba or break into a tango. The jet lag lasts a week or more, given the vast distance between Mumbai and Rio (13,414 km), to say nothing of the Southern Hemisphere syndrome and its effects, real or imaginary, on sleep patterns. To admit this long and arduous trip has been an overwhelming experience, physically and mentally, is to underplay its impact. One can read detailed and brilliantly written travel guides, watch dozens of National Geographic documentaries and talk to erudite, seasoned, polished diplomats from both countries (Joao de Mendonca Lima Neto, Brazil's consulgeneral in Mumbai, and Guillermo E. Devoto, Argentina's consul-general), but nothing prepares you for the

real thing.
Frankly, Indians have far more in common with Latin America than the United States -- the neo-colonisers of the twenty-first century. Our shared love for heritage and history should make South America a magnet for intrepid travelers. But we didn't encounter any Indians, not even at Brazil's best-known tourist site (Corcovado Mountain), where the imposing, magnificent 125-ft Art Deco statue of



Christ the Redeemer faces the Atlantic Ocean with 92-ft arms spread, and welcomes visitors to Brazil's shores. But it's the bikinis and beaches, the caipiranhas (Brazil's national drink) and the Carnival that dominate our imagination of this, South America's largest country and the world's fifth largest.

Rio's Carnival, often described as "the biggest street party in the world", is just that and much more, as we experienced at Sambadrome, where a crowd of 200,000-plus revellers enjoyed the spectacle without a single glitch or mishap to mar the mega celebrations.

The Amazonian rain forest deserves at least a month

for a truly immersive experience -- we could only spare a few days in the dramatic submerged forests, teeming with exotic species of trees, birds, reptiles -- home to the anaconda! The Amazonian basin is nearly twice the size of India -- can you handle this factoid?

Aaaah... the Girl from Ipanema is not just a song-writer's fantasy. There are hundreds of "tall and tanned and young and lovely" women strolling along the bustling, beautiful city of Rio clad in nothing more formal than skimpy bikinis (our Urfi Javed looks overdressed in comparison), while casually strolling along the crescent shaped strip of Copacabana -

the most famous beach in the world. But wait, they don't change into street wear at all -- there they are, these gorgeous Beyonce/JLo/Shakira clones in fluorescent lame thong-bikinis languorously buying groceries in a busy supermarket, gliding through hotel lobbies, sipping cocktails at trendy bars -- nobody ogles, nobody is surprised. Lazing on deck chairs all day long, Copacabana sees local grandmothers in tiny bikinis playing with grandkids, while young, fit adults indulge in vigorous beach volleyball games. I asked a local: "When do people go to work?" He grinned: "In Rio -

- rarely! But Sao Paolo is different." My one major grouse? No desi chai available anywhere in Brazil. Worse, nobody speaks English. Portuguese only.

Our external affairs minister, Subrahmanyam Jaishankar, has pitched India as an important destination for Brazilian investment. As of 2022, India had \$6 billion investments in Brazil, while Brazil's investments in India is around \$1 billion. But given the presence of several Indian biggies already there (Wipro, Sterlite, United Phosphorus, Tata Motors, Infosys, Sun Pharma, to name a few), it certainly looks like this is the beginning of a beautiful affair. If only Brazil would introduce chai and tasty khaana! Our chaiwallahs are the best in the universe, as our PM Narendra Modi will readily endorse. Vegetarian options? What's that? I am sure Gautam Adani will do something about this soonest... a li'l birdie tells me Adani likes Brazil. A lot. Samba-Garba time! Dhokla is the new empanada

Aaaah... Argentina!
Brazil's Spanish-speaking
cousin, and so entirely different in character! The two
share more than just a border
-- they also share the awe-inspiring Iguazu Falls, which
span the Iguazu River. We enjoyed the falls from both
countries. Interestingly, when
I saw a serpentine line of cars
from Brazil at the Argentine
checkpoint, I wondered why

the neighbors were rushing over on a particularly hot weekend. "To buy alcohol, petrol and groceries," our chatty Argentine driver said with a wink. Everything (almost) is a hefty 50 per cent cheaper, given the exchange rate. What's more, brisk business is transacted with the "blue dollar" (black money, to us). It's a huge parallel economy that's gone half-legit. Parillas (grills) dominate local cuisine since carnivorous Argentina has the second highest consumption of beef in the world, after its neighbor Uruguay. The average citizen consumes 57 kg of beef a year -- most of it grilled, without marination, with a dash of salt, and chimichurri (green chutney) on the side. I'm sure chimichurri goes great with dhokla. Vegetarians, kindly take your own theplas, since all you can expect to find in eateries is potatoes and basic "kachumber"

Messi and Mate are worshipped by fans. Neighbourhood "futbol" and tango clubs (milongas) are recreational passions that see enthusiasts flocking to watch their favourites. Health alert over 'perfect' natural sweetener

compound called erythritol, described as a natural sweetener and promoted as a "perfect and healthy" substitute for sugar, may be linked to elevated risks of heart attacks or strokes, researchers said in a study released on Monday.

People with diabetes or those who are obese are often advised to use products with sugar substitutes such as erythritol, which is about 70 per cent as sweet as sugar and made by fermenting corn.

Large-scale industrial production of

erythritol during the 1990s has helped the sweetener emerge as a major sugar substitute, which is added to processed foods and is available via online shopping platforms in many countries, including India.

One online platform in India that sells erythritol powder describes it as a "perfect and healthy substitute for sugar and artificial sweeteners".

The researchers, who studied over 4,000 people in Europe and the US, have found that people with higher erythritol levels in their blood are at increased risk of experiencing a major cardiovascular event such as a heart attack, stroke or death. They also directly examined the effects of erythritol on whole blood and on platelets — a class of blood cells involved in clot formation — and observed that erythritol enhances the rate of platelet adhesion, the first step in clot formation.

"We need to make sure the foods we eat aren't hidden contributors (to) cardiovascular disease which builds over time,"



said Stanley Hazen, chair of cardiovascular and metabolic diseases at Cleveland Clinic in the US who led the study, published on Monday in the journal Nature Medicine. In one component of the study, Hazen and his colleagues observed that when participants consumed artificially sweetened beverages with erythritol amounts found in many processed foods, their blood levels of erythritol increased for days to levels well above those seen to enhance clotting risks.

The findings, the researchers said, imply that dietary consumption of erythritol could put people at a potentially heightened risk of blood clots. This is of concern because the very people for whom non-sugar sweeteners are prescribed — people with diabetes, obesity or a history of cardiovascular disease — are typically themselves at risk of cardiovascular events.

The researchers said erythritol's safety had been assessed earlier through short-term animal studies.

Daily 11-minute walk can cut early death risk: Cambridge University study

Just 11 minutes, or 75 minutes a week, of moderateintensity physical activity such as a brisk walk would be sufficient to lower the risk of diseases such as heart disease, stroke and a number of cancers, a new University of Cambridge led research has found.

In a study published on Tuesday in the 'British Journal of Sports Medicine', researchers conclude that one in 10 early deaths could be prevented if everyone managed at least half the recommended level of physical activity by the UK's National Health Service (NHS).

Physical activity, particularly when it is moderate-intensity, is known to reduce the risk of cardiovascular disease and cancer, and the NHS recommends that adults do at least 150 minutes of moderate-intensity activity or 75 minutes of vigorous-intensity activity a

"If you are someone who finds the idea of 150 minutes of moderate-intensity physical activity a week a bit daunting, then our findings should be good news," said Dr Soren Brage from the Medical Re-



search Council (MRC) Epidemiology Unit at the University of Cambridge.

"Doing some physical activity is better than doing none. This is also a good starting position – if you find that 75 minutes a week is manageable, then you could try stepping it up gradually to the full recommended amount," he said. Cardiovascular diseases, such as heart disease and stroke, are the leading cause of death globally, responsible for 17.9 million deaths per year in 2019, while cancers were responsible for 9.6 million deaths in 2017. Seventy-five minutes per week of moderate activity was found to

be enough to reduce the risk of developing cardiovascular disease by 17 per cent and cancer by 7 per cent. For some specific cancers, the reduction in risk was greater – head and neck, myeloid leukaemia, myeloma, and gastric cardia cancers were between 14-26 per cent lower risk. For other cancers, such as lung, liver, endometrial, colon, and breast cancer, a 3-11 per cent lower risk was observed. Professor James Woodcock from the MRC Epidemiology Unit said: "We know that physical activity, such as walking or cycling, is good for you, especially if you feel it raises your heart rate.



In my time in the early 1960s, Poona University required all science undergraduates to adopt one "Arts" subject and, if memory serves, for the Arts-wallahs to take on a "science" subject. These universally went for "logic" as their science, Physics,

Chemistry, Biology or Maths being in-



All my science undergraduate class chose "Civics" as their Arts subject. I was the only dissenter who chose to do a course called "Ancient Indian Culture", or AIC. It wasn't just that I wanted to stand out amongst the crowd, or

that I thought I'd find learning about the Indian Constitution and local government excruciatingly boring, it was that I was genuinely interested in finding out what these ancient texts said. I went onto the course not knowing the difference between a Veda and a Vada... okay, maybe that's an exaggeration!

While there were two classes of over a hundred pupils on the Civics course, there were in all nine students in the AIC lectures, eight of them genuine Arts students and myself singularly from the science side. Our professor was called Arjunvadkar, and he openly and suspiciously enquired as to my presence in his lectures. master this field of knowledge. So, what the "flip" was a Parsi adolescent, majoring in Physics, doing in his class?

From his attitude towards me, as he instructed the class week after week, it became clear to me that he regarded his subject as operating in a totally different dimension from the Physics, Chemistry and other sciences being lectured about in the separate grey-stone building of the college. He was absolutely aware that myth and religion were nothing to do with and shouldn't be equated to the mundane understanding of how fast light travelled or what happens when

acids are mixed with alkalis.
Of course, he taught us that the zero

was invented by Aryabhata and that there were "Sutras" -- treatises -- on drama, political strategy, sex and other classificatory topics.

I learnt, if only in a cursory and shallow way, about the Upanishads, about Buddhist philosophy, about the Gomateswara at Sravanavelagola and much else, and knew that this learning was strictly distinct from Newton's laws of motion or the third law of thermodynamics. Myth and science, equally intriguing, but not the same. Now I read that Richard Dawkins, the apostle, if not the "pope", of atheism, has visited New Zealand to promote his latest book. While there, he says he walked into a raging controversy. The NZ government has decreed that science classes have to be taught that Maori "Ways

of Knowing" (Matauranga Maori) have equal standing with "Western sciences". So, students in NZ will be taught that living organisms consist of DNA while being equally certain that life throbs with a vital force conferred by the Earth Mother and the Sky Father.

This government-enforced confounding of science and myth has caused seven professors of New Zealand's universities to write in protest against the travesty and consequently to be forced to resign their posts. Obviously these professors, the most prominent among them being the medical scientist Garth Cooper, of Maori descent himself, has no objection to mythology being taught and absorbed by all NZ students --Maoris, Christians, Muslims... whoever.

Assam to have south east Asia's largest cancer research facility

GUWAHATI: Assam will soon have a cancer research centre which is believed to be the largest in South Asia, officials said on Saturday. The cancer facility has been planned to be built in Kamrup rural district's Amingaon area. According to state health department officers, once the centre comes up, Assam would represent the northeastern states on the world map of research hubs as a result of the state-of-the art facility here. In a workshop held here on Friday under the auspices of the state government's Medical Education and Research Department, experts discussed the project's operational design and road map. Dr D Nori, an internationally renowned oncologist, as well as professors from AIIMS, IIT Guwahati, Gauhati Medical College Hospital, and other top medical institutions took part in the workshop to create a schedule for carrying out the project. A series of consultative sessions were planned, according to Siddharth Singh, commissioner and secretary of the Medical Education & Research Department, to properly describe the project design. Singh further mentioned that the centre would feature a paediatric oncology hospital affiliated for the treatment of cancer in children.

1.3 kg drugs seized near Assam-Mizoram

GUWAHATI: Assam Police have seized 1.3 kg of drugs in Karimganj district near the state's border with Mizoram, officials said on Saturday. The seizure was made from a vehicle on Friday, which also led to the arrest of three persons on charges of drugs peddling. The vehicle was reportedly coming from Mizoram, and the police stopped it at the Kontekchera neighbourhood. 'Yesterday (Friday) night at about 10.30 p.m., we got a tip-off that a car heading from Mizoram was transporting drugs. As a result, we deployed a naka to monitor the route and stopped a car. We discovered 100 drug-filled soap containers totaling 1.3 kg during the examination of the vehicle's hidden compartments," Partha Pratim Das, the superintendent of police of Karimganj, said. He confirmed that the vehicle was coming from the Champhai village in Mizoram. A case has been filed in this matter under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act. Further investigation is underway.

Trainee flight attendant killed on Delhi-Jaipur **Expressway GURUGRAM:** A 24-year-old trainee

flight attendant was killed and her friend sustained injuries after they were hit by a speeding car on the service lane of the Delhi-Jaipur Expressway, police said. The deceased was identified as Anna Harris, of Ratlam, Madhya Pradesh, while the injured was identified as Ayank Khandelwal, who is also a cabin crew with a private airline. According to the police, the victim was staying at a PG accommodation in Sector 69. On Wednesday night, she was out with her four friends, Jatin Sharma, Rahul Tomar, Khandelwal and Shivam, to pick up dinner. They were getting food packed from a roadside dhaba along the NH-48 and during crossing the Kherki Daula toll plaza, a speeding car hit Anna and Ayank and sped away, the police said. Their friends took them to a civil hospital in Sector-10 Gurugram where doctors declared the woman brought dead. Khandelwal suffered injuries and is undergoing treatment at a private hospital, the police said. "The woman's body has been handed over to the family after an autopsy and we registered an FIR against the unidentified driver under relevant sections of the IPC at the Kherki Daula police station. We are scanning the CCTV footage installed at the accident spot," Rajender Kumar, SHO of the police station, said.

DA crisis: Junior entry level staff in Bengal major sufferers

KOLKATA, MAR 11

The junior-most and entry level state government employees seem to be the worst affected due to non-payment of dearness allowance (DA) Currently, the gap of the

state government employees with their counterparts in the Union government stands at 32 per cent and this is after West Bengal minister of state for finance (independent charge) Chandrima Bhattacharya announced an additional three per cent DA for the state government in February. Based on that gap, the joint forum of state government employees -the main forum leading the movement in demand of DA arrear payments -- has put forward some initial calculations, which show that the junior-most and entry level state government employees are major sufferers on this



count. As per the calculation, the staff with basic entry level pay of Rs 18,000 a month and grade pay of Rs 19,000 per month, were supposed to receive Rs 6,840 per month as DA as per the central DA "However, in West Bengal they are receiving just Rs 1,080 a month. This means in a month they are being deprived of a payment of Rs 5,760. If it comes to a year, the amount comes to Rs 69,120," pointed out a forum official. As per the same calculation, junior staff in the basic entry level pay of Rs 1,970 per month and the grade pay of Rs 2,100 per government

month, are receiving lesser DA to the tune of Rs 6,308 per month compared to his or her counterpart in the Union government. "Annually the figure comes to Rs 75,696," the forum official said. He also pointed out that as one state employee progresses in his career and reaches higher grade pay, his or gap in dearness allowance payment compared to the central government employees goes up. Take for example a headmaster in a state-run higher secondary school in the state. "A headmaster in his early fifties, having a grade pay of Rs 5,400 per month, is getting a lesser pay of around Rs 32,000 per month because of this differential pay with the central government employees. Annually, the figure comes to

Main accused behind 'fake' videos of attacks on Bihar migrants in TN arrested PATNA, MAR 11

Bihar Police have arrested the main accused who made 'fake' videos of attacks on migrant workers in Tamil Nadu. According to a Bihar police spokesperson, two accused namely Manish Kasyap and Youraj Singh are absconding and the state police are conducting raids on their possible hideouts. The police have already arrested one of the accused Aman Kumar, a native of Jamui district.

The main accused Rakesh Ranjan Kumar, a native of Gopalganj district had made the fake video in a rented accommodation in Patna's Bangali colony under Jakkanpur police station, with the help of 2 persons on March 6. He has confessed the crime. The whole idea behind making a video in Patna was to mislead the police of Bihar and Tamil Nadu We have cross checked with the landlord of Rakesh Ranjan Kumar and he has also confirmed that the video was made at his house," the spokesperson said. "Accodingly, the investigating team has registered an FIR against Rakesh Ranjan, Manish Kashyap, Youraj Singh and Aman Kumar in Economic Offence Unit (EOU) police station in Patna," he

The police said that a video made by Rakesh Ranjan Kumar was tweeted on March 8 by a person named Manish Kashyap. He had uploaded the video on a YouTube channel named BNR News Honey.

In the video, two people were seen tied with something. The video looked suspicious. During the investigation, it appeared that the video was made by Rakesh Ranjan Kumar. He was taken into custody from Gopalganj and brought to Patna in EOU police station. He eventually confessed the crime, the spokesperson elaborated.

Maha: For 2nd time in 2 months, ED raids NCP leader Hasan Mushrif's premises

KOLHAPUR, MAR 11

For the second time in two months, the Enforcement Directorate (ED) raided the home and other premises of senior Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) leader Hasan Mushrif in connection with alleged irregularities in the purchase of a cooperative sugar mill, here on Saturday. This is the second direct action against Mushrif after he was raided on Jan 11 by the ED at Kolhapur and Pune, besides his relatives and aides. in a pre-dawn operation amid tight security and carried out searches inside his home in Kagal. However, Mushrif has steadfastly denied all allegations and said that the agency's raids are a political move by the ruling BJP at the centre and had even raised questions whether people of a 'particular community' are being systematically hounded. Somaiya has also claimed that Mushrif had allegedly grabbed control of the Appasaheb Nalawade

TN intensifies vigil to monitor solar fencing along elephant paths

CHENNAI, MAR 11

The Tamil Nadu forest department has intensified patrolling along elephant pathways to monitor the solar fences that are illegally erected and with high voltage connectivity.

The Tamil Nadu forest department has woken up to the reality of illegal and high-voltage fences in elephant paths erected by farmers that have led to the death of elephants. According to sources in the Tamil

Nadu forest department, 89 elephants have died of electric shocks from solar fences erected illegally and with high

voltage in the last 10 years. Recently, three female elephants were electrocuted in Dharmapuri.

The Tamil Nadu forest department



has already communicated to the local district collectors and state agriculture department to engage local bodies in monitoring the solar fences erected.

The forest department has also directed the district collectors to direct the farmers to get approval for the solar fence design as well as the voltage that

would be passed through. The Madras High Court had directed to use energisers that are BIS-compliant for voltage regulation. The Madras High Court had also directed the state forest department to regulate solar fencing with post-facto approval but but the order has not been followed. After the death of the three female elephants, the state forest department has taken measures to protect the lives of wild elephants and to stringently monitor the solar fences that are being erected. Manoharan Sukumar, a wildlife activist from Dindigul district, while speaking to IANS said, "The death of three female elephants brought tears to the eyes of animal lovers. The elephants died due to the farmer erecting a solar fence with high voltage






