Atiq Ahmed's son killed in Jhansi encounter

Dreaded gangster Atiq Ahmed's son Asad, wanted in the Umesh Pal murder case, was gunned down by Uttar Pradesh police in an encounter in Jhansi today. His co-accused Ghulam was also shot dead.

Both Asad and Ghulam had a reward of 5 lakh on their heads. Asad Ahmed had been captured by a CCTV camera during the attack on Pal and was on the run since.

Asad and Ghulam opened fire at a team of Uttar Pradesh Special Task Force around noon today and were killed in retaliatory action, police said. Sophisticated weapons, new



cellphones and SIM cards have been recovered from them, they added.

According to police sources, Asad Ahmed had fled to Lucknow after the killing of Umesh Pal. He later moved to Kanpur and then



Meerut before reaching Delhi, it is learnt. He then decided to flee to Madhya Pradesh. He reached Jhansi and was on his way to the state border on a bike when police intercepted him. Asad was reportedly in disguise. Police sources

said they had an informer in Atiq Ahmed's gang who told them about Asad's whereabouts.

Sharing details about the encounter, police said a team of 12 led by two DSP-rank officers carried out the operation. A total of 42 rounds were fired during the encounter at Babina road in Jhansi.

The encounter killings took place on a day Atiq Ahmed was produced in court in the same murder case and sent to judicial custody for 14 days.

Umesh Pal, a lawyer, was a witness in the 2005 murder of BSP MLA Raju Pal. On February 24, he was shot dead in a daylight attack outside his home in Prayagraj.

ED files case against BBC for irregularities in foreign funds

The Enforcement Directorate has filed a case against BBC India under Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA) for irregularities in foreign funding.

Official sources said that the action was taken to probe irregularities of foreign funding by BBC India, diversion of funds and violation of rules under the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 (FEMA).

The move comes in the wake of searches conducted by Income Tax at the offices of the British broadcaster in New Delhi and Mumbai in February this year.

The broadcaster came under the radar of Indian agencies after it published a controversial documentary, 'India: The Modi Question,' which drew sharp criticism from the Indian government



and tarnished the country's image.

Following a survey by the Income Tax Department, the ED had earlier also sent summons to BBC, calling for an inquiry into the matter.

An officer of BBC's administrative and editorial departments is being questioned at ED's headquarters here.

The government, in January, directed social media platforms to block YouTube videos and Twitter posts sharing links

to the documentary soon after it created controversy. The documentary, which questioned the role of Prime Minister Narendra Modi in the 2002 Gujarat riots, was widely criticized by the Indian government and several sections of the Indian public. The BBC faced allegations of spreading fake news and propaganda, and the Indian government accused the broadcaster of trying to destabilize the country.

UP CM holds key meeting on 'law and order'

LUCKNOW: Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Thursday chaired a high-level meeting on 'law and order' after the killing of gangster-turned-politician Atiq Ahmed's son, Asad, in an encounter. CM Yogi also lauded the Special Task Force (STF) team which was involved in the shootout. According to the Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister's Office, 'Yogi was apprised about the encounter by the Principal Secretary (Home). A report was also placed before the Chief Minister on this whole matter. "After the encounter of former MP Atiq Ahmed's son Asad and his aide, CM Yogi Adityanath took a meeting on law and order. CM Yogi praised UP STF as well as DGP, Special DG law and order and the entire team," UP CMO.

Truck runs over seven pilgrims near Hoshiarpur

HOSHIARPUR: Seven pilgrims died on the spot and 10 were injured when all of them were crushed under the wheels of an out-of-control truck near Charan Chhoh Gangra Sri Guru Ravidas Maharaj, Sri Khuralgarh Sahib here in the wee hours of the morning. DSP Daljit Singh Khakh said that the deceased are mostly residents of Mastan Khara in Muzaffarnagar district of Uttar Pradesh. All the injured persons were admitted in Civil Hospital from where five of them had been referred to PGIMER, Chandigarh under critical condition. The area is sub mountainous and on a slope the truck driver lost control over his vehicle and crushed 17 pedestrians out of which seven died. It is suspected that the brakes of the truck had failed. He said that the deceased men were identified as Rahul and Sudesh Pal and the women included Santosh, Angoori, Kunti, Geeta and Ramoh. The deceased, along with the injured were on a pilgrimage of Charan Chhoh Gang.

Hry CM announces renovation of Phirni in 135 Mahagrams of state

CHANDIGARH: Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal has announced that in the next three months, the work of renovation of Phirni will be done in 135 Mahagrams of the state with a population of above 10,000. It will directly benefit the people of the villages and other passers-by, he added. The Chief Minister was responding to a demand placed regarding construction work of Phirni during the Jan Samvad programme at Uttwar village in Palwal district on Thursday. He also announced the construction of a new 66 KV sub-station to ensure uninterrupted power supply in Uttwar village and other adjoining villages. "If the gram panchayat will provide the land to the corporation in 10 days, then the sub-station construction work will be started with immediate effect," he said. During the Jan Samvad programme, the people of Gulesra village of Dhakalpur panchayat requested for construction of a road up to the village; which was immediately approved by the Chief Minister.



Google CEO Sundar Pichai hints at more layoffs

NEW DELHI: Sundar Pichai, the CEO of Google, has hinted that there may be a second round of layoffs after the company announced that it was firing six per cent of its total workforce or 12,000 employees in January. During an interview with Wall Street Journal, Mr Pichai hinted that more layoffs could soon follow at the company but didn't directly address the prospects.

Amit Shah reviews J-K security in a high-level meeting

ਸਿਖਾਂ ਦੇ ਬਲਿਦਾਨ ਦੀ ਕਹਾਣੀ

ਜਾਨिए कैसे हुई खालसा की स्थापना

ਸਿੱਖਾਂ ਦੇ ਦਸਵੇਂ ਗੁਰੂ ਗੁਰੂ ਗੋਬਿੰਦ ਸਿੰਹ ਜੀ ਨੇ 1699 में बैसाखी के दिन खालसा पंथ की स्थापना की और सिखों को सिंह अर्थात शेर का संज्ञान दिया। यदि साहित्यिक अर्थ की बात करें तो खालसा का अर्थ है खालिस अर्थात शुद्ध यह अरबी शब्द से लिया गया है। खालसा शब्द श्री गुरु संघ साहिब जी में रत कबीर की वाणी में केवल एक बार आता है। इसमें लिखा है, कछु कबीर जब भये खालसा प्रेम भगत जिह जानी, जिसका अर्थ है, कबीर कहते हैं कि वे लोग जो परमात्मा के प्रेम और भक्ति को जानते हैं, वे सबसे शुद्ध हैं। मुगल सम्राट औरंगजेब के डरलाही शरिया शासन के दौरान अपने पिता गुरु तेग बहादुर की बलिदान की बात गुरु गोबिंद सिंह जी ने खालसा पंथ की स्थापना की थी। गुरु गोबिंद सिंह जी ने खालसा को एक योद्धा के रूप में स्थापित किया, जिसका कर्तव्य था कि वह किसी भी प्रकार के धार्मिक उत्पीड़न से निपटो की रक्षा करें। इसके अतिरिक्त, खालसा ने सिख समुदाय के लिए एक राजनीतिक और धार्मिक दृष्टि भी प्रदान की। और उस दिन से, चाहे गुरु जी का खालसा, चाहे गुरु जी की फतेह सिख धर्म का एक अभिन्न अंग बन गया।

गुरु तेग बहादुर और औरंगजेब यह दो समय था, जब औरंगजेब का अत्याचार लगातार ही बढ़ता जा रहा था और देश भर के हिन्दू सहित कश्मीरी पंडित आतंकित थे। वाराणसी, उज्जैन और मधुरा सहित हिन्दुओं की अद्भुत गले कई शहरों में औरंगजेब की फौज सड़ियों को ध्वस्त किए जा रही थी। सन 1669 में हिन्दुओं को नदी किनारे मुलकों का अहिंसक-संस्कार तक करने से रोक दिया गया। शाही आदेश और औरंगजेब की फौजों के ज़रिए हिन्दुओं पर प्रहार हो रहे थे। जम्मू-कश्मीर में शेर अफगान नामक आक्रांता कश्मीरी पंडितों का नाशोनिष्ठान गिरा देना चाहता था और औरंगजेब को उसका संरक्षण प्राप्त था। ऐसे कठिन समय में कश्मीरी पंडितों का एक प्रतिनिधि मंडल गुरु तेग बहादुर की पास पहुँचा और उन्हें अपनी समस्या बताई। औरंगजेब के अत्याचार और क्रूरता की वारता सुनाई तो वो काफी दुखी हो उठे। इतिहास कहता है कि जब गुरु दरबार में निवासा का माहौल था, तब बालक गोबिंद राय को भी वह ठीक नहीं लगा और उन्होंने अपने पिता से कहा 'सवाल किए। वो सुने लगे कि आखिर ऐसा क्या हुआ कि जहाँ दिन-रात भजन-कीर्तन और शास्त्रों की बातें होती थीं, वहाँ आज इस तरह नीरसता का माहौल छाया हुआ है। बच्चे की जिद के आगे गुरु तेग बहादुर जी ने सारी व्याख्या कह डाली। उन्होंने बताया कि इनके दुःखों के निवारण के लिए किसी महापुरुष का बलिदान चाहिए। इस पर बालक गोबिंद राय ने पूछा इस समय भारतवर्ष में आपसे बड़ कर बड़ा सद्गुणों वाला विद्वान और महान महापुरुष कौन है, इतनीसे क्या आपको ही इस बलिदान के लिए स्वयं को प्रस्तुत नहीं करना चाहिए? एक बालक के मुँह से गुरु नामक की शिवाजी और शरणगत की रक्षा के लिए प्राण त्यागने की बातें सुन कर गुरु तेग बहादुर समझ गए कि ये ईश्वर का ही संदेश है। गुरु तेग बहादुर जी औरंगजेब से मिलने के लिए एक प्रतिनिधिमंडल के साथ दिल्ली गए, जहाँ उन्होंने औरंगजेब चुनौती दी कि यदि वे गुरु तेग बहादुर जी को इस्लाम में परिवर्तित कर सकते हैं, तो सभी कश्मीरी पंडित भी धर्मांतरित हो जाएँगे। औरंगजेब ने अपने शिष्टों को गुरु तेग बहादुर जी को किसी भी कीमत पर परिवर्तित करने का आदेश दिया। उन्होंने गुरु तेग बहादुर को धर्म परिवर्तन के लिए मजबूर करने के लिए हर संभव यातना दिया लेकिन असफल रहे। अंततः औरंगजेब के आदेश पर भी गुरु तेग बहादुर का सर धड़ से अलग कर दिया। तीन अन्य सिखों, भाई गति दास, भाई सती दास, और भाई दयाल दास, जो उनके साथ दिल्ली आए थे, को भी भी गुरु तेग बहादुर जी की शहीदी से पहले औरंगजेब ने शहीद कर दिया।

गुरु तेग बहादुर की शहीदी गुरु तेग बहादुर जी की शहीदी के बाद श्री गुरु गोबिंद सिंह सिखों के दसवें गुरु बने। खालसा के गठन से कई महीने पहले, गुरु गोबिंद सिंह जी ने अपने सभी अनुयायियों को 1699 में बैसाखी पर आनंदपुर साहिब आने का निर्देशन भेजा था। आनंदपुर साहिब में हजारों अनुयायी इस शुभ आयोजन के लिए एकत्रित हुए। गुरु गोबिंद सिंह ने निर्देशन में खालसा बनाने के अपने इरादे के बारे में कोई खुराना नहीं दी थी, लेकिन एक धार्मिक रत्ना का उल्लेख किया था। बैसाखी से कुछ समय पहले श्री गुरु गोबिंद सिंह ने मसंदों की संस्था की समाप्त कर दिया। वे मूल रूप से गुरु और अनुयायियों बीच माध्यम की तरह थे। मसंद प्रथा के उन्मूलन के साथ संगत और गुरु की बीच एक सीधा संबंध बन गए। **गुरु के अर्चना-पंथ की स्थापना** सिख धर्म के दसवें गुरु, गुरु गोबिंद सिंह जी ने सिखों को बैसाखी के दिन 30 मार्च 1699 को श्री आनंदपुर साहिब में इकट्ठा होने के लिए कहा। गुरु गोबिंद सिंह जी ने एक पहचानी (जिसे अब श्री केशगढ़ साहिब कहा जाता है) पर एक बड़ी रत्ना को संक्षिप्त किया। उन्होंने सिख परंपरा के अनुसार अपनी तलवार खींची, और फिर इकट्ठा हुए लोगों से एक ऐसे शेरक को आगे आने के लिए कहा, जो अपना सिर बलिदान करने के लिए तैयार हो। एक आगे आया, जिसे गुरु गोबिंद सिंह एक तंबू के अंदर ले गए। कुछ देर बाद गुरु बिना उस शेरक के जीभ में लीट आए, लेकिन तलवार पर लगे खून के साथ। उन्होंने फिर एक और शेरक से शीश की मांग की और लगातार बार बार खून रंगी तलवार के साथ तंबू से लीटने की प्रक्रिया को दोहराया। पीछली शेरक जब उनके साथ तंबू में गया, तब गुरु सभी पीछी लीटित शेरकों के साथ लीट आए। उन्होंने उन्हें पंज प्यारे और सिख परंपरा में पहला खालसा कहा। ये पांच प्यारे थे — दया राम (भाई दया सिंह जी), धर्म दास (भाई धर्म सिंह जी), हिम्मत राय (भाई हिम्मत सिंह जी), मोहकम चंद (भाई मोहकम सिंह जी), और साहिब चंद (भाई साहिब सिंह जी)। गुरु गोबिंद सिंह ने फिर एक लोहे के बर्तन में दोघाड़ी तलवार (खंडे) से हिलाकर अमृत तैयार किया। इसके बाद उन्होंने पंज प्यारे को आदि पंथ के पाठ के साथ निर्देशित किया, इस प्रकार खालसा की स्थापना ने सिख परंपरा में एक नए चरण की शुरुआत की। इसने खालसा योद्धाओं के लिए अमृत पान (अमृत पद) , अमृत समारोह) और आचरण के नियम तैयार किए। पहले पाँच खालसा को अमृत पान करवाने के बाद, गुरु जी ने पीछी को उन्हें खालसा के रूप में अमृत पान करवाने को कहा। इसने गुरु को खालसा बना दिया और उसका नाम गुरु गोबिंद राय जी से बदलकर गुरु गोबिंद सिंह जी कर दिया गया।

खालसा की रचना खालसा की रचना सिख धर्म के दस गुरुओं की शिवाजी पर आधारित है। गुरु गोबिंद सिंह जी चाहते थे कि हर सिख हर तरह से परिपूर्ण हो, यानी भक्ति और शक्ति का संयोजन। सिख धर्म की मुख्य शिक्षाओं में दान और तेम अर्थात तलवार शामिल हैं। उन्होंने प्रत्येक सिख में त्याग, स्वच्छता, ईमानदारी, दान और साहस जैसे पाँच गुण पैदा किए। उन्होंने सिख कोड ऑफ डिजिटलिन भी निर्धारित किया। जिसके अनुसार खालसा तलवार का प्रयोग केवल आपात स्थिति में ही कर सकता है, अर्थात तलवार तब तक नहीं खींची जा सकती जब तक कि सभी शक्तिपूर्ण ढंग व प्रयास विफल नहीं हो जाते। इसका उपयोग केवल आत्मरक्षा और उत्पीड़ितों की रक्षा के लिए किया जा सकता है। उन्होंने खालसा को पंज ककार — केश, कंफा, कच्छरा, कड़ा और कुपाण धारण करने के लिए कहा। सिख धर्म की मूल बातों के अनुसार, एक सच्चा खालसा भेदभाव नहीं करता है या किसी को नीच आत्मा के रूप में नहीं देखता है। वह उत्पीड़ितों की रक्षा में उठ खड़ा होगा और जरूरतमंदों की मदद के लिए दान करेगा

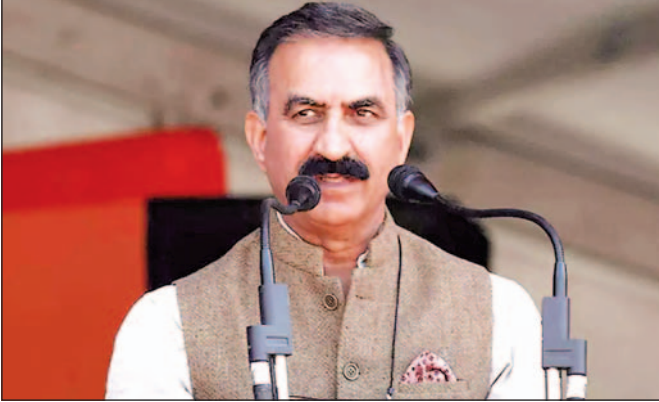

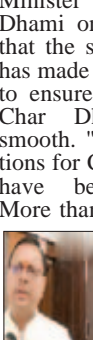

Land-for-jobs scam: ED questions Lalu Prasad's daughter Chanda Yadav

The Enforcement Directorate on Thursday questioned Chanda Yadav, daughter of former Union Railway Minister and Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) supremo Lalu Prasad Yadav in connection with its ongoing money laundering case linked to the alleged land-for-jobs scam. Ministry of Information National Broadcaster to launch a 2 part documentary on India's glory under Modi Chanda arrived at the ED headquarters earlier in the day and was deposited before the investigators following a summons against her. The agency is to record Chanda's statement under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA). She is the fourth among nine children of the RJD chief. This is the third consecutive day when Lalu Yadav's third child is being questioned by the ED officials in the case. The agency sleuths on Wednesday questioned the RJD chief's daughter Ragini Yadav.



His son and Bihar Deputy Chief Minister Tejashwi Yadav was also questioned on Tuesday for over eight hours in connection with the case. Earlier, Lalu Yadav's daughter and Rajya Sabha Member Misa Bharti were questioned by the Enforcement Directorate officials last month. In March, the ED claimed unaccounted cash of Rs 1 crore, \$1,900, 540 gms gold and 1.5 kg of gold jewellery and other incriminating documents were recovered during the raids

conducted at 24 locations in Delhi, Mumbai, Patna and in Ranchi based on specific intelligence inputs. The ED had said that they detected around Rs 600 crore in "proceeds of crime" which were in the form of immovable properties of Rs 350 crore and transactions of Rs 250 Crore routed through various benamidaars. It is alleged that the Prevention of Money Laundering investigation conducted so far has revealed that several pieces of land at prominent locations in

Heart of the matter

According to the South Asia Terrorism Portal, there have already been about 25 insurgency-related incidents spreading over Jammu and Kashmir, the Maoist-affected regions and the Northeast in the first two months of this year. The persistence of such developments connected to our internal security should make us ask a larger question: why do insurgencies fester and why are they being viewed as evolving into terrorism?

David Galula, a French military officer and scholar, argues that for an insurgency to thrive, there ought to be a cause that finds traction with the local population. The insurgency battle is thus a competition between State and non-State actors to win the support of the population. Galula further reminds us that "a counterinsurgent cannot achieve much if the population does not feel protected against the insurgent." Providing this much-needed protection to the population is, however, not the same as focusing on killing insurgents. Kinetic actions are necessary to control violence. But the ultimate defeat of insurgency depends on social, political and economic imperatives.

The inference one draws from the above is that people hold the most crucial agency in such conflicts. Classical counterinsurgency doctrines are premised on 'winning hearts and minds' of the people who are the 'centre of gravity'. This has also been the basic doctrine adopted by the Indian army.

Insurgencies occupy a large space in the realm of our national security. To the credit of our security forces, the levels of violence at present are relatively lower, be it in J&K, the Northeast or in the Maoist-dominated regions. However, the reduction in violence has not resulted in the end of these insurgencies.

There are certain issues that warrant attention to enable us to reform and improve. These issues have primarily to do with the centrality of the local population in conflict zones. A fresh beginning has to be made by identifying the challenges from a correct perspective and showing the willingness to discuss alternatives.

Of late, the agency possessed by the local population has increasingly been undermined as part of the State approach. It is sufficient to say that a refocus is needed on the 'centre of gravity'. In the 1990s, 'counter-insurgency by force' occupied the centre stage. The current dynamics hinge on a war of narratives and ideas that play in the mind of the population, necessitating the diversification of our modus operandi. Continuing with past methodologies will only lead to creating new militants rather than neutralising them.

Sacking of PoK Prime Minister will add to ongoing crisis



On April 11, 2023, the prime minister of Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) Tanveer Ilyas was served with a sentence for contempt of court and removed from his office and his parliamentary seat in the legislative assembly.

A senior minister Khawaja Farooq is expected to be sworn in as the caretaker prime minister until such time that the PoK legislative assembly selects a new prime minister.

The court has applied Article 45, of the interim constitution of Pakistan-occupied Kashmir known as Act 74, to sack Tanveer Ilyas from his office. According to Act 74 "Contempt of Court Article 45, 'Court means the Supreme Court of PoK or the High Court.

A court shall have the power to punish any person who - a) abuses,

interferes with or obstructs the process of the court in any way or disobeys any order of the court; b) scandalizes the court or otherwise does anything which tends to bring the court or a judge of the court into hatred, ridicule or contempt; c) does anything which tends to prejudice the determination of a matter pending before the court' or d) does any other thing which by law consti-

tutes contempt of court. Article 45 also states 'the exercise of the power conferred on a court by this article may be regulated by law and, subject to law, by rules made by the court'.

While attending the hearing Ilyas was presented with evidence in the form of his press statements and video recordings of his speeches in which he had ridiculed and blamed the courts for

creating hurdles against a USD 15 million Saudi Education project from being initiated in PoK. The former prime minister pleaded guilty. The fact that the courts were honouring a stay order against the Saudi education project after a complaint was filed against it is testimony to the tragedy we as an occupied nation have been victim to for the past 75 years. At a time when Pakistan is faced with

its own economic crisis, it has frozen the development funds of PoK. Under these circumstances, Tanveer Ilyas managed to secure USD 15 million worth of educational project from Saudi Arabia as a direct investment in the occupied territory.

For the anti-Imran Khan Pakistani coalition government led by the Pakistan Muslim League (N) and headed by Prime Minister Shahbaz Sharif and the military establishment is tantamount to a crime of disproportionate magnitude. Hence, a decision by the prime minister of the PoK government led by Imran Khan's Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) party's PoK section headed by Tanveer Ilyas became totally unacceptable. This is the first time in the history of our occupation by Pakistan since October 22, 1947, that a sit-

ting prime minister of PoK has been accused of a crime, tried and sentenced by a high court. I have no doubt that there will be serious repercussions caused by this decision despite the fact that Tanveer Ilyas is no friend of the common man or woman of the occupied state. The judgement made by the High Court of Pakistan-occupied Kashmir will be viewed as a witch hunt and as an attack on a prime minister of a people who are considered a lesser being. Meanwhile, according to Article 17 of Act 74 interim constitution of PoK, the president of PoK will nominate the most senior minister to take charge as an acting prime minister. At a time when the people of PoK are suffering from shortages of flour, load shedding, price hike, water shortages.

Moderate exercise safe for people who suffer muscle pain from statins

According to research published in the Journal of the American College of Cardiology, statin therapy does not worsen muscular damage, discomfort, or tiredness in patients who engage in moderate-intensity exercises, such as walking. The findings are reassuring for patients who feel muscular discomfort or exhaustion from statins but still need to exercise to keep their cholesterol levels low and their hearts healthy.

Statin has long been the gold standard for lowering LDL or "bad" cholesterol and preventing cardiovascular disease (CVD) events, but while generally well-tolerated, they can cause muscle pain and weakness in some. Physical activity is also a cornerstone of CVD prevention, especially when combined with statins; however, studies have shown vigorous exercise can increase muscle damage in some statin users, which can lead to decreased physical activity or cause people to stop taking their medication.



Less is known about the impact of moderate exercise. Researchers sought to compare the impact of moderate-intensity exercise on muscle injury in symptomatic and asymptomatic statin users, plus nonstatin using controls. Symptomatic vs. asymptomatic was determined by the presence, localization and onset of muscle cramps, pain and/or weakness using the statin myalgia clinical index score. Researchers also examined the association between leukocyte CoQ10 levels on muscle injury and muscle complaints, since statins may lower CoQ10 levels and reduced levels can predispose people to muscle injury.

All study participants walked 30, 40 or 50 km (18.6, 24.8 or 31 miles, respectively) per day at a self-selected pace for four consecutive days. Statin users had all been on the medication for at least three months. The researchers excluded those with diabetes, hypo- or hyperthyroidism, known hereditary skeletal muscle defects, other diseases known to cause muscle symptoms or those using CoQ10 supplementation. There were no differences in body mass index, waist circumference, physical activity levels or vitamin D3 levels (low vitamin D3 levels have been associated with statin-induced myopathy.

Ukraine to allow Indian medical Students for 'state qualification exam'



Indian medical students, who had returned to New Delhi following Russia's invasion of Ukraine will be allowed to take a key examination from India, Ukraine's First Deputy Foreign Minister Emine Dzhaparova conveyed to India during her recent visit.

According to the official release of the Ministry of External Affairs, Emine Dzhaparova held talks with the Indian side on several issues. Regarding the Indian medical students, the Deputy FM mentioned that Ukraine will allow foreign medical students to take the Unified State Qualification Exam in their country of domicile.

Thousands of Indian medical students were left stranded with their future hanging on the cliff when Russia attacked Ukraine at the end of February 2022 and several were evacuated from Ukraine to India.

During her three-day visit to New Delhi, the First Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs

of Ukraine held bilateral talks with Secretary (West), MEA, Sanjay Verma. The two sides discussed spheres such as economic, defence, humanitarian assistance, and global issues of mutual interest.

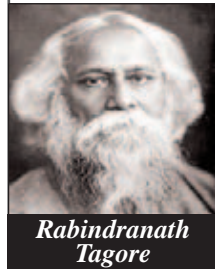

The Ukrainian minister called on the Minister of State for External Affairs and Culture, Meenakshi Lekhi. Older adults perceive AI as more human-like than younger adults



Artificial Intelligence is becoming more prevalent in our daily lives. While these technologies primarily assist us, they may sometimes be utilised in negative ways, such as in fraudulent or scam calls, thus we must be able to recognise them.

According to a recent Baycrest study, older persons tend to be less capable than their younger counterparts to distinguish between computer-generated (AI) speech and human speech. "Findings from this study on computer-generated AI speech suggest that older adults may be at a higher risk of being taken advantage of," says Dr. Bjorn Herrmann, Baycrest's Canada Research Chair in Auditory Aging,

Scientist at Baycrest's Rotman Research Institute and lead author of this study. "While this area of research is still in its infancy, further findings could lead to the development of training programs for older adults to help them navigate these challenges."

In this study, which was the first to examine AI speech recognition in older adults, younger (~30 years) and older (~60 years) adults listened to sentences spoken by 10 different human speakers (five male, five female) and sentences created using 10 AI voices (5 male, 5 female). In one experiment, participants were asked how natural they found the human and AI voices to be. In another, they were asked to identify whether a sen-

tence was spoken by a human or by an AI voice.

Results showed that compared to younger adults, older adults found AI speech more natural and were less able to correctly identify when speech was generated by a computer. The reasons for this remain unclear and are the subject of follow-up research by Dr. Herrmann and his team. While they have ruled out hearing loss and familiarity with AI technology as factors, it could be related to older adults' diminished ability to recognize different emotions in speech. "As we get older, we seem to pay more attention to the actual words in speech than to its rhythm and intonation when trying to get information about the emotions

being communicated," says Dr. Herrmann. "It could be that recognition of AI speech relies on the processing of rhythm and intonation rather than words, which could in turn explain older adults' reduced ability to identify AI speech." In addition to helping develop AI-related training programs, the results of this and future studies could help inform interactive AI technology for older adults. This kind of technology often relies on AI speech and has increasing applicability in medical, long-term care and other support spaces for older adults. For example, therapeutic AI robots can be used to comfort and calm individuals experiencing agitation due to dementia.

Bhartiya Kisan Ganna Sangharsh Samiti has decided to hold a meeting on April 21 to discuss the issue of delay in payment of sugarcane to local farmers by Bhadson Sugar Mill and purchase of sugarcane from outside farmers in cash. In this meeting, a big agitation can be announced against Bhadson Sugar Mill. State President of Bharatiya Kisan Union Ratan Mann was specially present on this occasion. Farmer leaders raised many serious questions on the intention and policy of Bhadson Sugar Mill Management. President of Bharatiya Kisan Ganna Sangharsh Samiti Jasveer Singh said that Bhadson sugar mill management is doing injustice to the farmers. There is a delay in the payment of sugarcane to the farmers in the sugar mill.

According to the rule, the payment of sugarcane should be made within 14 days of the supply of sugarcane in the mill. If the payment of sugarcane is not made to



the farmers during this period, then there is a provision to pay it along with interest. But farmers are not being paid on time. An amount of more than Rs 93 crore was not paid to the farmers. Neglecting the local sugarcane growers, this sugar mill is taking sugarcane from outside farmers and paying for it in cash. While more than Rs 93 crore of sugarcane of the local farmers are pending towards the mill, which the mill management is procrastinating in giving. Due to non-payment of sugarcane to the farmers on time, many problems have arisen financially in front of the farmers. The farmer has to bear the brunt of repaying the market loan.

People of Kharar will soon get surface water supply from Kajauli water works project: Anmol Gagan Mann

CHANDIGARH, APR 13: Under the leadership of Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann, special steps are being taken by the Punjab government to make the best use of water available through natural resources. The project designed by the state government to supply surface water from Kajauli Water Works to overcome the shortage of drinking water due to the continuous fall in the ground water level in Kharar is being done very fast.



Giving information in this regard, Tourism and Cultural Affairs, Labour, Investment Promotion and Hospitality Minister Anmol Gagan Mann said that the people of Kharar have been struggling with water problems for a long time.

She said that to solve the problem of drinking water to the people, the surface water project is being prepared by the state government at a cost of Rs.7.29 crore from Kajauli water works. The minister said that in phase-1 of this

project, 5 MGD of water will be supplied to the area adjacent to Jandpur, Halalpur and Jhungian Road from the existing water treatment plant being constructed by GMADA near Jandpur village of Kharar. She added that with

this project, people will get a big relief from the shortage of clean water.

Apart from this, the minister added that the water treatment plant project being prepared to supply clean drinking water to the people will cost Rs.7.29 crore. She told that the necessary funds related to this project will be provided by the Municipal Council, Kharar. The Minister further said that the project will involve laying of 600/400 mm transmission line along PR-7 road up to Jhungian Road and connection to the existing distribution network.

The Minister explained that this initiative of the state government is an important step towards sustainable

water management in Punjab as it aims to prevent the groundwater level in Kharar city from going down further by using surface water resources. She said that the Punjab Government is dedicated to effective conservation and management of water resources to ensure the sustainable future of the state.

The Cabinet Minister appealed to the public to ensure that they support and participate in such initiatives to protect precious natural resources and promote sustainable development.
