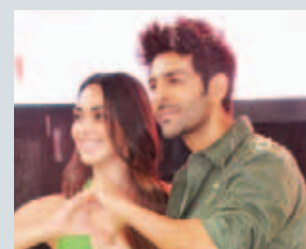

Putin says military stopped civil war

MOSCOW: Military who took part in the suppression of the attempted armed mutiny on June 24 actually stopped the civil war in Russia, acted clearly and harmoniously, Russian President Vladimir Putin said on Tuesday. "You defended the constitutional order, the life, security and freedom of our citizens. You saved our motherland from upheavals, actually stopped the civil war. In a difficult situation, you acted clearly, harmoniously, by deed you proved your loyalty to the people of Russia and the military oath," Putin said in his address to the security forces who were suppressing the rebellion. People and the army were not on the side of the rebels, Putin added.

India's road network now 2nd longest in world

NEW DELHI: India's road network has grown 59 per cent to become the second largest in the world as part of the development work carried out by the government in the last nine years, Union Minister Nitin Gadkari said today. India has nearly 64 lakh km of total road network, which is the second largest in the world. India's National Highways network alone stood at 1,45,240 km today compared to 91,287 km in 2013-14, the Road, Transport and Highways Minister said. He was addressing a conference on '9 Years of the Modi Government' in the national capital. "In the last nine years, India made seven world records in the sector. India's road network is the second largest in the world after the US," he said.

Delhi court adjourns hearing in Brij Bhushan Singh case

NEW DELHI: A Delhi Court adjourned hearing in the alleged sexual harassment case filed against BJP MP and outgoing Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) President Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh to July 1. Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (ACMM) Harjeet Singh Jaspal after seeing the lengthy chargesheet filed against Singh adjourned it for consideration on July, 1. The court after hearing an application of wrestlers seeking a court-monitored probe into their allegations in the matter directed them to withdraw the same as the chargesheet has already been filed. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (CMM) Mahima Rai Singh on June, 22 after hearing the submission on behalf of the Public Prosecutor transferred the chargesheet to the court of Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (ACMM) Harjeet Singh Jaspal for hearing on June, 27.

Country cannot be run on two laws, says PM on UCC

BUREAU BHOPAL, JUNE 27

Battling for the Uniform Civil Code (UCC), Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday said that the country cannot be run with "two laws" when the Constitution of India talks about equality for all. He asked how different rules could apply to different family members.

"Will a family function if there are two different sets of rules for people? Then how will a country run? Our Constitution too guarantees equal rights to all people," PM Modi said in Bhopal today while addressing party workers under the BJP's "Mera Booth Sabse Majboot" campaign.

The Prime Minister further said that people are being instigated in the name of the Uniform Civil Code.

He said that appeasement politics had left many people behind, including the Pasmanda Muslims.

"Pasmanda Muslims have become a victim of politics. Some people are using the politics of appeasement to break the country. The BJP cadre should go and explain this to the Muslims and educate them so that they do not fall victim to such politics," PM Modi said. "If they were really supportive of Muslims the Muslim brothers would not be poor or deprived... Supreme Court has also asked for the implementation of the UCC. But these people are hungry only for vote bank," Modi said.



Modi flags off 5 Vande Bharat Express trains

BHOPAL: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday flagged off five Vande Bharat Express trains from the Rani Kamalapati Railway Station in Madhya Pradesh capital city Bhopal. Ahead of the flagging-off ceremony, the Prime Minister interacted with crew members of the train and some children onboard the Vande Bharat train at Rani Kamalapati railway station. Five Vande Bharat Express trains which were flagged off by the PM include -- Rani Kamalapati-Jabalpur Vande Bharat Express; Khajuraho-Bhopal-Indore Vande Bharat Express; Madgaon (Goa)-Mumbai Vande Bharat Express; Dharwad-Bengaluru Vande Bharat Express; and Hatia-Patna Vande Bharat Express. Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, Governor Mangubhai C Patel, Union Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishaw and Jyotiraditya Scindia were present at the event.

Mann announces upto three time hike in salaries of newly regularized teachers

SHASHI PAL JAIN CHANDIGARH, JUNE 27

In a major gift to the 12700 contractual teachers who's service has been regularised recently by the state government, the Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on Tuesday announced upto three time increase in their emoluments and other benefits of the government job after regularisation of m services.

Announcing this today, the Chief Minister said that these teachers will be known as Associate Teachers, Special Inclusive Teachers and others adding that they will be governed by 'Policy for Welfare of Adhoc, Contractual, Temporary Teachers (Nation Builders) and other employees in School Education Department'. He said that based on their educational qualifications and primary conditions for entry into services their emoluments have been fixed upto completion of 58

years in service. Bhagwant Mann said that these teachers will be entitled for an annual increment of 5% on their salaries every year.

Divulging more details, the Chief Minister said that BA pass Education Provider (Associate Teachers) who were hitherto getting Rs 9500 will



now get Rs 20500 as emolument whereas such teachers with ETT and NTT qualification will get Rs 22000 as compared to salary of Rs 10250 at present. Similarly, he said that such teachers with BA/ MA B Ed degrees who are now getting Rs 11000 as salary will now get emolument worth Rs 23500.

World Cup: India, Pak to face-off in Ahmedabad on Oct 15

Arch-rivals India and Pakistan will square off at the ICC Men's Cricket World Cup 2023 on October 15 at the Narendra Modi Stadium in Ahmedabad.

The opening game of the World Cup is scheduled to place at the same venue on October 5 with a match between defending champions England and New Zealand in Ahmedabad, the ICC announced on Tuesday.

The final will also be held at the same venue on November 19, The first semi-final of the World

Cup will be held on November 15 in Mumbai while the second semi-final will be played on November 16 at the Eden Gardens in Kolkata.

India will open their campaign on October 8 against Australia at Chidambaram Stadium in Chennai. They will be playing a total of eight matches in the league stage.

The much-awaited encounter between India and Pakistan will be the eighth meeting between the two sides at a men's World Cup.

With their jinx broken in the T20



World Cup, Pakistan will be looking to emulate the same in the 50-over format on October 15.

India and Pakistan have faced each other seven times previously - in 1992, 1996, 1999, 2003, 2011, 2015 and 2019.

The only time the two sides did not meet since that first match in 1992 was in 2007, which was a disastrous campaign for both teams as they crashed out of the tournament in the opening round

India have won all of the previous seven encounters, a record they extended to the T20 World Cups as well until recently.

Tomato prices soar across country

Tomato prices have recently shot up in the markets across the country from Rs 10-20 per kg to a price of Rs 80-100 per kg. The reason behind this is the dip in supply due to heatwaves in tomato-growing areas and heavy rain.

Ajay Kedia, a Mumbai-based commodity market expert and head of Kedia Advisory said, "This year, for a variety of reasons, fewer tomatoes were sown than in prior years. As the price of beans surged last year, many farmers switched to growing beans this year. However, a lack of monsoon rains has caused the crops to dry out



and wilt. The limited supply of vegetables, particularly tomatoes are due to crop damage caused by heavy rainfall and extreme heat."

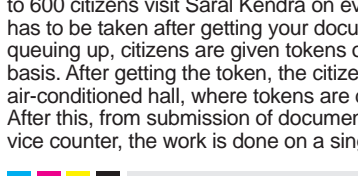
Countries of world convinced of Modi's popularity: Kamboj

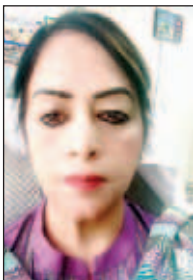

Govt to settle all liabilities of
HP road transport corporation

Himachal Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister, Mukesh Agnihotri on Tuesday said that the state government would do its best to settle all liabilities of the state road corporation in a time bound manner. He said in a statement today that in this series, the decision of the Board of Directors of the Corporation to release 3 percent Dearness Allowance (DA) to the employees and pensioners of the Road Transport Corporation has been notified today. About 15,000 employees and pensioners of the corporation will benefit from this. With this decision, the employees of the corporation will now get 34 per cent dearness allowance instead of 31 per cent. The allowance will be applicable from 1 April 2023. The deputy Chief minister who is also the state Transport department minister said that the order has also been issued today on the decision of the Board of Directors to increase the ex-gratia benefit. Under this, the minimum benefit has been increased from Rs 35 thousand to Rs 55 thousand and the maximum from Rs 1 lakh to Rs 1.5 lakh on the death of a regular employee of the corporation while on duty. Similarly, orders have also been issued to increase this benefit for contract employees from minimum Rs 20 thousand to Rs 35 thousand and maximum benefit from Rs 75 thousand to Rs one lakh. The deputy Chief minister said that the corporation is trying to implement the decisions of the Board of Directors of the recently constituted Road Transport Corporation. According to the decisions of the Board of Directors, the Road Transport Corporation is taking action to raise the means of income and to implement various decisions.

Govt revises rate of edible
oil for NFSA & APL families

The state government is actively implementing its motto of "Vyavstha Parivartan" in the Food and Civil Supply Department, by providing relief to the common man. In line with this, the government has taken significant steps to provide affordable and fortified edible oils to its citizens at lower rates. Chief Minister, Thakur Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu said that the government has finalized the sale rate of fortified Soya refined oil at Rs. 104 per litre for beneficiaries under National Food Security Act (NFSA) and APL families under Public Distribution System in the Fair Price Shops of the State. He said that refined oil would cost Rs. 8 and Rs. 13 cheaper for NFSA and APL families respectively. He further said that this decision will benefit approximately 19 lakh ration card holders including about 7.54 lakh NFSA ration card beneficiaries and about 11.53 lakh APL ration card holders. He said that this is a considerable decrease compared to the previous sale rates of Rs. 112 per litre for NFSA consumers and Rs. 117 per litre for APL consumers. The Chief Minister said that the State Government is taking several measures to provide relief to the people of the State from high prices of essential commodities. Recently, the State Government has also taken a decision to reduce the rate of mustard oil by Rs. 37 per litre and now ration card holders can purchase mustard oil at Rs. 110 per litre from the fair price shops under PDS across the State, he said. Sukhu said "These initiatives demonstrate the state government's commitment to provide essential commodities at lower rates, thereby ensuring the well-being and food security of its citizens."

Atiq's sister moves SC seeking independent
enquiry into killing' of brothers

Atiq Ahmed and Ashraf Ahmed's sister, Aisha Noori, had knocked the doors of the Supreme Court seeking a direction for a probe into the state-sponsored killing' of her two brothers, who were allegedly gunned down by assailants, while in Uttar Pradesh police's custody. Sources in the Supreme Court Registry said that the matter would be heard by the Top Court very soon. "The plea shall be heard by the Top Very soon, keeping in view the sensitivity and importance of the questions raised by the Petitioner," the senior SC registry official said on Monday. Atiq and Ashraf Ahmed, who was under Uttar Pradesh police escort, was talking to reporters on April 15, when a gun was pulled close to their head in Prayagraj and subsequently



killing the duo instantly. This incident happened in full view of media persons and was captured live and subsequently aired on news channels, leading to much public debate. The brothers were killed just two days after Atiq's son Asad was killed in an encounter. Dozens of cases, including kidnapping, murder and extortion, were registered against Atiq Ahmed over the past two decades. A local court sentenced him and two others to

life in jail in March this year in a kidnapping case. Noori, in her petition filed before the Apex Court, has sought an independent probe into the 'custodial and extra-judicial killings' of her brothers, as well as other members of the family all of which occurred just a few days apart from each other.

She said that this was done by the 'high-level state agents' who have allegedly orchestrated a campaign to "kill, arraign,

Removal of additional duties for import of
US apples will not result in any negative
impact on domestic apple producers

NEW DELHI: With the decision of resolution of six outstanding World Trade Organisation (WTO) disputes between US and India through mutually agreed solutions as jointly communicated during the official state visit of the Prime Minister to the USA, India will remove additional duties on eight US products, including apples, leading to restoration of market access for Indian steel and aluminum exports to the US. The decision will not result in any negative impact on domestic apple producers and will result in competition in premium market segment ensuring better quality at better prices for consumers. After removal of this duty, the apples from the US would compete on level playing field with other countries. The decision will ensure that only premium quality apples could be imported for which there exists a specific market segment and specific demand. An additional 20% duty was imposed on US apples in 2019 in response to USA's measure to increase tariffs on certain steel and aluminum products. There is no reduction on Most Favoured Nation (MFN) duty on apples which is still applicable on all imported apples including on USA at 50%. The import of apples from the world has been stable in the range of US\$ 239 – 305 million (except in 2021-22 when it was US\$ 385 million) in the last five financial years since application of these additional duties on US apples. The import of apples from USA has decreased from US\$ 145 million (127,908 Ton) in FY 2018-19 to only US\$ 5.27 million (4,486 Ton) in FY 2022-23. The market share of the US apples was taken by other countries due to imposition of additional retaliatory duty on US apples.

Twilight tales

I saw her in a museum of displaced people, in a neighbourhood in Cape Town where the downtown starts to melt into the desolate. The desolation in District Six is the subject of the museum named after it. In her traditional headscarf and abaya, the woman, sturdied and seasoned with age and suffering, looked displaced in that museum of displacement. And so she belonged there, alive and unsettling among the images of lives and rooms that once belonged to people before they were bulldozed to the ground.

It was one of the saddest losses of life, community, and happiness in the history of South Africa. District Six was a low-income, inner-city neighbourhood occupied primarily by freed slaves and indentured labourers, migrants, artisans and factory workers. It was a picture of the rainbow nation as it existed before apartheid, made up of Xhosas, Indians, a small number of white Afrikaner and English, and a large number of Muslim people classified under apartheid as 'coloured', most of them Cape Malay. But racial mixing was anathema for apartheid city-planning, and in 1966, the neighbourhood was declared a 'whites-only' zone under the Group Areas Act. The demolition of houses and the forced removal of people that started in 1968 led to the displacement of over 60,000 people, who lost their lives, homes, and communities in a place that they had fondly called their own and which had represented, for all its poverty, one of the happiest multicultural and multiracial communities in South Africa before racial segregation.

A Cape Malay woman, then but a girl — the woman in the abaya — has the most vivid memory of being displaced. She remembers it all — the happiness and the intimacy of the neighbourhood, much like Richard Rive's classic novel, 'Buckingham Palace', District Six, the parades and the carnivals, the corner shops and the gossiping neighbours who watched out for one another. When the news came that they would be displaced to make space for a new, white neighbourhood, it was greeted with cheery disbelief — how are they going to displace so many of us from our homes? And then the bulldozers came with their deathly destruction, the arrogance of an engineering modernity that had carved the path from colonialism to the holocaust. Like other acts of hubristic planning, they were to fail staggeringly, with the multiracial population scattered all over Cape Town, notably along the Cape Flats where crime and poverty remain high to this day, and with few whites coming forward to live in the cleared area, much of it remains an empty, desolate stretch of land to this day.

Hormone treatment may help couples with unexplained infertility

A small study of couples facing unexplained infertility reveals that hormone therapy may boost the chances of having a baby.

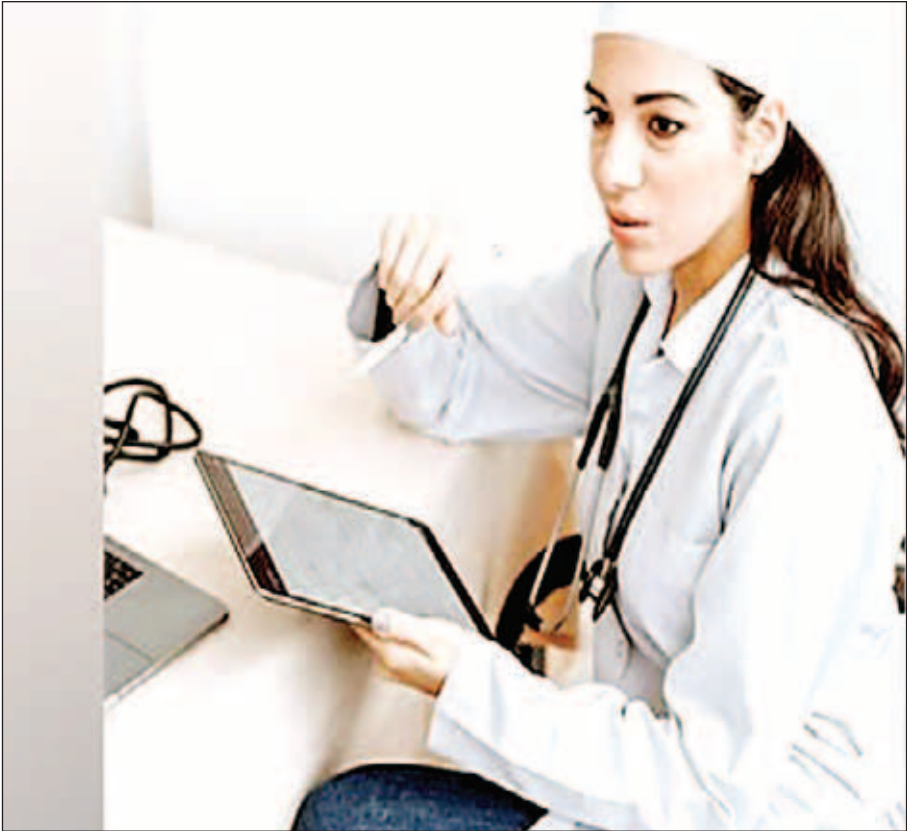
The trial, presented today (Monday) at the 39th annual meeting of the European Society of Human Reproduction and Embryology (ESHRE) [1], compared couples trying to conceive naturally with couples where the woman used a vaginal progesterone treatment during the second half of her menstrual cycle.

The researchers say a larger experiment is now needed, but given the treatment is safe and inexpensive, it could eventually benefit many people suffering from infertility all over the world.

The study was presented by Dr Claudia Raperport, a researcher at Queen Mary University of London, (UK). It included 143 couples who had unexplained infertility, a diagnosis that affects around one-third of couples referred to fertility services.

All the participants used ovulation test kits to plan intercourse for three menstrual cycles. Half of the women were given treatment of 400 milligrams of progesterone via a twice-daily vaginal suppository for 14 days.

Among the women treated with progesterone, 11 out



of 72 (15.3%) had babies. Among the women who were not treated, 5 out of 71 (7.0%) had babies. Although the birth rate was more than doubled with treatment, the small numbers mean that this could have happened by

chance. Among the women treated with progesterone who became pregnant, the rate of miscarriage was 20%, compared with 40% in the untreated group. Among women who took progesterone according to the treat-

ment protocol (throughout the second half of their menstrual cycle and early pregnancy with no breaks), there were no miscarriages. Again, the numbers are too small for researchers to be sure these results did not happen by

chance. Vaginal progesterone has been safely used for over 30 years with minimal side effects alongside other fertility treatments such as IVF. The cost for three months of treatment would be around EUR200 or less.

Dr Raperport said: "The cost of progesterone is minimal compared to the cost of IVF and other fertility treatments. It also carries far less clinical risk, and physical and emotional burden for the couples involved. "We need to do further research to prove these results in a larger group of people, but this trial suggests a potential treatment for couples with unexplained fertility. Given its safety and low price, there is no harm in offering this treatment in the meantime."

It is well established that progesterone levels increase in the second half of the menstrual cycle to help prepare the lining of the womb to receive a fertilised egg. Women are usually offered a test to check the levels of progesterone in their blood.

However, previous research in women experiencing infertility suggests that even when levels of progesterone are high in the blood, this does not always correspond with the changes to the womb lining that are needed for a fertilised egg to implant.

"It could be that treating women with vaginal progesterone is helping the womb to become more receptive to a fertilised egg," she added.

The chair of ESHRE, Professor Carlos Calhaz-Jorge from the Northern Lisbon Hospital Centre and the Hospital de Santa Maria in Lisbon (Portugal), was not involved in this research. He said: "Lots of research has focused on using progesterone to prevent miscarriage once pregnancy has been established. This study indicates that progesterone could also be used from the time a woman ovulates to help a fertilised egg implant in the womb in cases of unexplained infertility."

If it is proven in a larger study, this treatment could reduce miscarriage and increase the chances of having a baby for those couples with unexplained infertility.

Given the low cost of this treatment, it has enormous potential to help some couples avoid more complex treatments, particularly those living in parts of the world where fertility treatments like IVF are unaffordable or unavailable."

Dr Raperport is planning to run a second trial with more couples at several hospitals and is currently seeking funding for this project.

30 per cent surge in cancer cases in Western Afghanistan



According to doctors at a cancer treatment facility in Herat Province, Western Afghanistan has observed a 30 per cent increase in the number of patients seeking cancer treatment, Khaama Press reported.

During the last year, they said that out of 4,000 cancer patients, 50 per cent of them were women.

Out of them, 50 per cent of the women were suffering from breast cancer, according to Dr Farooq Ahamad Sidiqi, Director of the Cancer Centre, as per

Khaama Press. The Khaama Press News Agency is the largest online news service for Afghanistan, established in October 2010 in Kabul, Afghanistan. "Almost out of every two cases of women that come to us, one case is breast cancer."

This statistic has increased compared to the past. We need to know ways to diagnose and treat," added Sidiqi. According to him, most women are unaware of the symptoms of breast cancer, which causes them to wait

until the disease has advanced before seeking medical treatment, according to Khaama Press. Whereas, women suffering from breast cancer also complain furiously about their financial problems. They also claimed that they cannot receive treatment. Due to insufficient diagnostic facilities, medications, technicians and specialized doctors in the country, these people are choosing neighbouring countries, including Pakistan, for medical care, Khaama Press reported.

Japan to allow trial sale of emergency contraception pills sans prescription

In a big step towards joining dozens of other nations that currently allow such sales at pharmacies, Japan's health ministry announced Monday that it will allow the trial sale of emergency contraceptives without a prescription beginning this summer, Kyodo News reported.

A ministry panel has approved the sale of so-called morning-after pills at pharmacies that have trained pharmacists, private rooms, and are available on weekends, nights and holidays through March. They must also be able to coordinate with obstetrics and gynaecology clinics in the area.

As per the current rules, women, even sexual assault victims, have to travel to a clinic or hospital for a prescription to purchase emergency contraception, which works best within 72 hours of unprotected intercourse, as per Kyodo News.

Kyodo News is a Japan-based news agency established in November 1945.

A ministry panel debated selling the medicine without a prescription in 2017, but the ministry stopped short of giving the green light, with critics claiming that making a morning-after pill available would encourage irresponsible use of the drug after intercourse.

According to research conducted by the Health, Labour, and Welfare Ministry, emergency contraception has been available without a prescription in around 90 countries, according to Kyodo News. Clinical research done both at home and abroad show that emergency contraceptive tablets have an



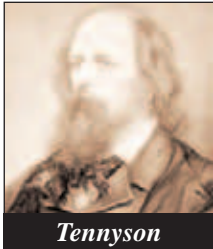
80 per cent efficacy rate. Medical professionals have urged for increased access to the medicine in Japan, arguing that it might give rape victims a vital recourse while potentially lowering the need for abortions.

Following the Cabinet's approval of various gender equality policies in late 2020, debates related to the over-the-counter distribution of emergency contraception pills have resumed. From the end of December to the beginning of January, the health ministry received 46,312 public comments, with the vast majority in favour of the trial sale, Kyodo News reported.

Palestinians launch rocket from Jenin for first time

The Israel Defense Forces confirmed on Monday afternoon that Palestinians in Jenin launched a rocket for the first time. According to the IDF, the rocket exploded in an area under the jurisdiction of the Palestinian Authority and caused no casualties.

The rocket was believed to have exploded in mid-air. Hamas-affiliated Izz ad-Din al-Qassam Brigades in Jenin posted a video of the launch online claiming the rocket was fired at Moshav Ram in



Israel's Gilboa region between Samaria and the Lower Galilee.

Oved Nur, head of the Gilboa Regional Council stressed that the situation in Gilboa was normal, called on residents to be alert, and criticized the government for not taking stronger steps to protect Israelis. "It is important to clarify that for 3 years now we have been warning about the increase in motivation and abilities from the direction of Jenin, and unfortunately we are not receiving prop-

er consideration for the protection of our residents," Nur said in a statement. "On the one hand, it is clear and known to us from first-hand sources that the IDF and the security forces are doing an excellent job, and we give them full backing, on the other hand, there is a significant and urgent need to reinforce security and protection measures required for the Gilboa settlements in general, and those near the fence in particular." Meanwhile, Israeli authorities arrested

a Palestinian man after finding a rocket in an open field in an eastern section of Jerusalem about a month ago.

Abdel Alhakim Buatna, a resident of Ajjul, north of Ramallah, was arrested on suspicion of intending to fire the rocket at Israelis during this year's Jerusalem Day flag parade in May, according to Israeli media reports on Sunday.

It is believed that Buatna tried to build explosive rockets after learning about their production

through the internet, but due to his inexperience and their poor quality, he was unable to launch them. The flag march is an annual highlight of Jerusalem Day festivities, which celebrate the anniversary of the Israeli capital's reunification during the Six-Day War of 1967. Thousands of youths carrying Israeli flags march from downtown Jerusalem to the Old City. Palestinians regularly accuse Israel of using the march to "Judaize" the city.

Uber's new feature reminds riders to buckle-in for safety

CHANDIGARH: Uber has rolled-out its new tech-enabled safety feature, the "audio seatbelt reminder" across India. This industry-first feature is designed to encourage riders to wear their seatbelts to improve safety on the platform. As per a report published by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH), more than 16,000 persons were killed in road accidents in 2021 due to not wearing a seatbelt. This feature prompts riders to buckle-in at the beginning of their first 5 Uber trips and on every 5th trip thereafter. Once a rider books an Uber trip and enters the vehicle, the driver's phone will play an audio reminder asking riders to "please use the rear seat belt for your safety". At the same time, the rider's phone will receive an in-app push notification reminding him to buckle-in before the trip starts.

A complete guide to prenatal yoga for a healthy pregnancy

It has many advantages, including greater circulation, less back discomfort, more flexibility, higher strength, and increased relaxation. This comprehensive introduction to pregnant yoga covers the best times to begin, mantras, meditation, and breathing techniques. Prenatal yoga may normally be started during the first trimester without risk, but you should always speak with your doctor before starting any fitness regimen. If you already practice yoga regularly, you can go on with pregnancy-safe modifications. If you're new to yoga, think about signing up for a prenatal yoga session made just for expectant mothers.

Mantras for pregnant yoga: During your yoga practice, you can repeat mantras aloud or silently in order to build a happy attitude. Here are a few mantras that are appropriate for prenatal yoga. Prenatal yoga meditation: Meditation is a beneficial practice during pregnancy as it aids in mind relaxation, anxiety reduction, and connection with the unborn child. Yoga meditation technique: Sit down in a comfortable position, either on the floor or with support from a cushion or chair. Take a few deep breaths, close your eyes, and focus on your body and your infant. Observe the inhales and exhales of your breath without attempting to alter them. As thoughts come, gently bring your focus back to your breathing and acknowledge them without passing judgment. Spend 5 to 10 minutes in this meditation, then as you feel more at ease extend the time.Prenatal yoga breathing techniques: During pregnancy, pranayama, or breathing techniques, can help you unwind, manage stress, and enhance your general well-being.

Here are some effective breathing exercises: Put one hand on your tummy and sit or sleep comfortably to



practice deep belly breathing. Allow your belly to rise and expand as you inhale softly through your nose. Using your mouth, let your tummy drop as you exhale. Repeat a few times while concentrating on your deep, rhythmic breathing. Using your right thumb, cover your right nostril and take a deep breath through your left nostril to practice alternate nostril breathing. Release your thumb, close your left nostril with your right ring finger, and exhale through your right nostril. Exhale via the left nostril after taking a breath through your right nostril and sealing it with your thumb. For numerous rounds, keep up this pattern of alternating nostrils. Breath of the bee (Bhramari pranayama): Put your eyes closed and inhale deeply. Exhale slowly while mimicking a bee's buzzing sound. Your head and throat should vibrate. Repeat a few times, concentrating on how the music makes you feel relaxed.

One of the more common myths about pregnancy is that all twisting is dangerous. But not all twists are created equal. Patti Quintero is a leading women's wellness expert and doula based in Los Angeles who founded Uma Mother, which provides yoga, meditation, and prenatal and postnatal education for women. She explains that "Advanced closed twists have a compressing effect on the body" and that holding them "can create deep stimulation." An example of a deep closed twist is marichyasana C, in which the elbow crosses the knee. Quintero explains: "Since a pregnant body carries more blood volume and is working with limited space because of organ displacement, it is better to not put this added pressure on the body and blood flow."

Open twists, however, are encouraged during pregnancy as they can help support digestion and blood flow. An example is twisting a crescent lunge with the bottom hand on the floor inside the front foot and the top arm reaching to the sky. (If you opted for prayer hands and hooked the elbow outside the knee, that would become a closed twist.) Other benefits of open twists include strengthening the obliques, which are important lower back stabilizers (specifically, the internal obliques), and opening the chest, which can get tight as the uterus expands and pulls the body's weight forward. While many top pregnancy apps and sites toe the party line that pregnant women should not lie flat anytime after the second trimester, Courtney Satow, a birth doula and pre- and postnatal yoga teacher based in the South Bay area of Los Angeles, says that the timing of when someone should stop is more personal and that a person's body will let them know when it's time to stop.

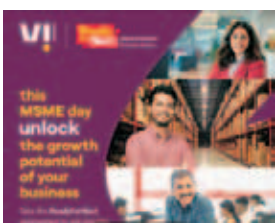

NETFLIX LEAVES NETIZENS FURIOUS FOR RE-RELEASING 'TITANIC' AFTER SUBMERSIBLE TRAGEDY



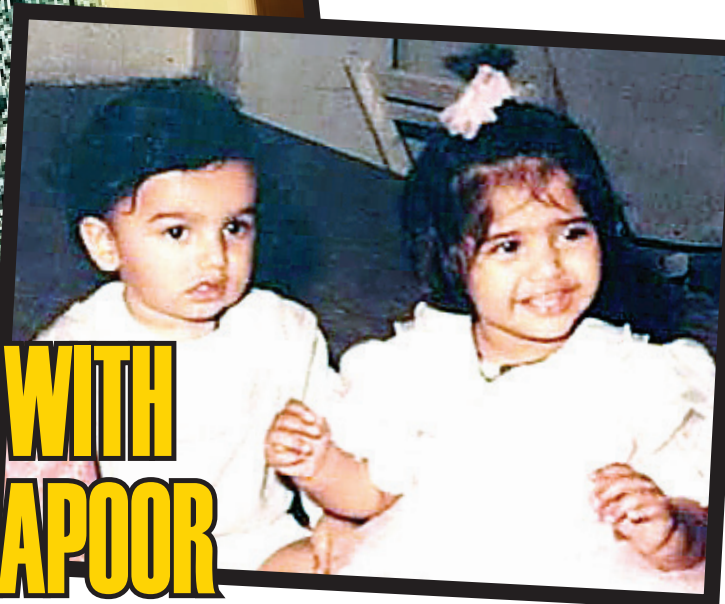
Streaming giant Netflix is being slammed for re-releasing James Cameron's iconic film 'Titanic', just days after the Titan tourist submersible sank, killing all five on-board. As per The Hollywood Reporter, Netflix is bringing back the Oscar-winning 1997 film to the streamer on July 1 in the U.S. and Canada. The OTT platform's decision has irked many social media users. "Anyone else find it f***ing terrifying that they ALREADY have a documentary of the Titanic sun on Netflix? It hasn't even been a f***ing week bruh. Wtf. #setup," a Twitter user wrote. "So Netflix was like 'lets capitalize on this sub thing real quick...gone head

and put TITANIC back in the rotation," another one wrote. "Bad timing," a Twitter user commented. "Horrible," a social media user wrote. Five passengers on the submersible named Titan, which was diving 13,000 feet to view the shipwreck of the British passenger liner Titanic which had sunk in the North Atlantic Ocean in the year 1912, died in a "catastrophic implosion," US Coast Guard authorities confirmed on Thursday (local time) last week, CNN reported. After an extraordinary five-day international search operation near the site of the world's most famous shipwreck, the tail cone and other debris of the submersible were found by a remotely operated vehicle about

1,600 feet from the bow of the Titanic on the ocean floor about 900 east of Cape Cod in Massachusetts. Passengers of the Titan, owned by OceanGate, the private US company that runs submersible tours to the Titanic, were confirmed to have died in the implosion the US Coast Guard authorities said. The Washington Post cited experts to report that the company was operating in a legal gray area out at sea, where the American-made submersible was launched from a Canadian vessel into international waters. A remotely operated vehicle found "five different major pieces of debris" from the Titan submersible, according to Paul Hankins, the US Navy's director of salvage operations and ocean engineering.
