## SCO Meet: Modi lashes out at Pak, China for supporting terrorism

Food, fuel and fertiliser crisis is a big challenge for all the countries in the world surrounded by controversies, tensions and epidemics and there must be united efforts to deal with it, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Tuesday.

In his opening remarks at the virtual summit of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO), Modi also said that some countries use cross-border terrorism as an instrument of their policy and the grouping must not hesitate to criticise them.

With Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif listening, Modi said there is a need for decisive action to deal with terrorism.

The summit was joined by Chinese President Xi Jinping, his Russian counterpart Vladimir Putin, Sharif and other leaders of

the SCO nations. Terrorism has become a threat to regional and global peace, Modi said, calling for expanding mutual cooperation to deal with terror financing as well.

"We have to fight together against terrorism that may be in any form and any manifestation," Modi said.

India's concerns and expectations regarding Afghanistan are similar to those of most SCO countries, he said.

The prime minister said the SCO has emerged as a key platform for peace, prosperity and development for Eurasia. India's thousands of years old cultural and people-to-people ties with this region (Eurasia) are living testimony to our shared heritage, he said. As chair of the SCO, India has made sustained efforts to take our multifaceted cooperation to new heights, he added. He also said that India supports the proposal of reform and modernisation of the SCO. "I am

happy that Iran is going to join the SCO family as a new member," he added. PM Modi said that India has made efforts to take its multi-faceted cooperation with SCO to new heights.

"We do not only see the SCO (Shanghai Cooperation Organisation) as an extended neighbourhood, but rather as an extended family. As Chair of the SCO, India has made efforts to take our multi-faceted cooperation to new heights," PM Modi said.

PM Modi noted that security, economic development, connectivity, unity, respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity and environmental protection are pillars of India's vision for SCO.

"India has established five pillars of cooperation within the SCO: Startup and innovation, traditional medicine, youth empowerment, digital inclusion, and shared Buddhist heritage," he said.

## BJP appoints new chiefs of four states, Jakhar to lead Punjab

Gearing up for the big 2024 elections, and crucial state polls this year, the Bharatiya Janata Party today announced new chiefs in many states.

G Kishan Reddy, MP and union minister, will now lead the party in poll-bound Telangana, replacing Bandi Sanjay Kumar. BJP MLA Etela Rajender, who served as the first finance minister of Telangana, has been appointed chairman of the BJP's state election management committee for the upcoming Telangana assembly polls. He started his political career with K Chandrashekar Rao-led Bharat Rashtra Samithi and stayed with it till 2021, after which he joined the BJP.

Daggubati Purandeswari, daughter

of Telugu Desam Party founder and former Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister NT Rama Rao, has been appointed Andhra Pradesh BJP president.

Sunil Kumar Jakhar, the former MP who jumped ship from Congress in May last year claiming he wanted to support "nationalism, unity and brotherhood in Punjab", will lead the party in Punjab.

Babulal Marandi, the first Chief Minister of Jharkhand and current Leader of the Opposition in the Jharkhand Legislative Assembly, is BJP Jharkhand president.

Kiran Kumar Reddy, the last Chief Minister of the United Andhra Pradesh before the formation of the Telangana state, has been appointed as member of the party's national executive committee.

## Captain govt allotted prime Waqf Board land to sons of Ansari: Mann

The container was coming to Nardana MIDC of Dhule district carrying gravel from Madhya Pradesh.

Due to a sudden brake failure near Palasner village, the driver lost control of the container.

The container dashed against a two-wheel-



er and a car and then barged into a hotel and overturned.

The container subsequently blew up.

Ten people were killed in this terrible accident.

## India summons Canadian envoy over Khalistani extremists threatening Indian diplomats

India has summoned Canadian High Commissioner in New Delhi over propaganda material, including posters, containing threats to Indian diplomats being circulated in Canada and has served a demarche to the Justin Trudeau government.

According to sources, India on Monday raised concerns over threats to its diplomats in posters being circulated in Canada with information on a pro-Khalistan rally to be held on July 8. The posters contained threats to the Indian ambassador to Canada and the consulate general in Toronto.

The posters purportedly circulated by Sikh extremists

have named Indian High Commissioner to Canada Sanjay Kumar Verma and the Consul General of India, Toronto, Apoorva Srivastava accusing them of playing a role in the June killing of Khalistani Tiger Force chief and designated terrorist Hardeep Singh Nijjar in Canada. The rally is being held in the name of Harjit Singh Nijjar aka Hardeep Singh Nijjar, a Khalistani terrorist who was killed in a targeted shooting in Canada's Surrey on June 18. Earlier today, Canadian Foreign Minister Melanie Joly said that her country is in close contact with Indian officials in light of some "unacceptable" posters that have appeared in Canada, regarding a protest planned for July 8.

## Now restaurants to be opened 24 hours in Haryana

### Commercial LPG gas cylinder price hiked by Rs 7

**NEW DELHI:** Public sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have increased the prices of commercial LPG gas cylinders by Rs 7 a cylinder. After the increase, the retail sales price of a 19kg commercial LPG cylinder in Delhi has increased from Rs 1,773 to Rs 1,780. However, there is no change made in the prices of domestic LPG cylinders.

After this hike, commercial LPG cylinder price in Mumbai will increase from Rs 1,733.50 to Rs 1,740.50, in Chennai, it will increase from Rs 1,945 to Rs 1,952, and in Kolkata, it will increase from Rs 1,895 to Rs 1,902. Before this latest hike there had been two consecutive price cuts for commercial LPG cylinders which were in May and June this year. While in May OMCs reduced the price of a commercial LPG cylinder by Rs 172, in June it was reduced by Rs 83.

### Tina Ambani appears in ED office

**MUMBAI:** Tina Ambani, wife of industrialist Anil Ambani, appeared before the Enforcement Directorate (ED) on Tuesday to record his statement in connection with an investigation into the alleged contravention of the foreign exchange law. She was accompanied by some of the directors of her company, who are waiting outside the ED office at Ballard Estate in south Mumbai while the officials are presently recording her statement. On Monday, Anil Ambani also appeared in the same office and was being questioned in connection with an investigation linked to the alleged contravention of the foreign exchange law.

**NEW DELHI:** Shah Rukh Khan reportedly had a surgery in the US after he met with an accident in Los Angeles during a shoot, reported ETimes. According to the report, the actor is back to India and he is recuperating at home. ETimes quoted a source as saying, "SRK was shooting in Los Angeles for a project and he ended up hurting his nose. He began bleeding and was immediately rushed to a hospital. His team was informed by the doctors that there was nothing to worry and that King Khan would need to undergo a minor surgery to stop the bleeding. Post the operation, SRK was spotted with a bandage on his nose."

The spokesperson informed that after a preliminary investigation of this complaint, a team of VB, Patiala Range laid a trap and arrested the accused driver red-handed while accepting the remaining bribe of Rs 10 thousand from the complainant in the presence of two official witnesses. Subsequently, the Planning Officer and JE were also arrested in this case. In this regard, a case under various sections of the Prevention of Corruption Act has been registered against the accused Planning Officer, JE, and Driver at Police Station VB, Patiala Range. Further investigations, in this case, are in progress.

That the fire started in the morning, if the fire broke out during the day, there could have been loss of life because hundreds of children come to play in this trampoline park every day and dozens of workers also work. Evacuation would have been difficult as only one RG door was constructed to enter and exit this trampoline park and it is difficult for these men to escape from the fire exit that has been constructed and the showroom is completely

closed and there is smoke inside. Due to which the windows had to be broken and the fire brigade personnel controlled the fire only by breaking the windows. However, fire extinguishers are installed in Oxford Street but whenever there is a fire, they do not work because they are not yet operational. However, until the approval is not received from the fire office, the completion certificate is not available and neither the showrooms can be sold, but everything works in Jirakpur, due to which the showrooms have been sold.

Editorial

The harm principle

One feature of the emerging, new India is the growing intolerance between people with differences in actions, beliefs and practices — in short, the inability to tolerate different lifestyles and cultures. If one has to examine the tendency, one has to ask: is tolerance an important virtue in society and whether universal tolerance is possible at all? An obvious response to this question would be to emphasise that tolerance allows people to make their own choices without interference or fear, thereby contributing to freedom and liberty. Such a state of affairs would allow greater autonomy and agency for individuals. Society would be less prone to conflict. One's lifestyle choices would never be a source of stigma or shame. Hence, the food one eats, the clothes one wears, the gods one worships, the social rituals one practises, one's sexual preferences and, above all, one's political beliefs and ideologies would be respected and honoured. However, these differences ought to be open to debate and discussion in public forums. Any society that wishes to improve its quality would have to strive towards universal toleration.

This ideal state of affairs is, actually, not the reality in any society. There are limits to freedoms and liberties, usually sanctioned by the State. The reason for this is as follows: if a society tolerates intolerance — say by tolerating the actions of a violent minority such as a religious sect or a terrorist group — then the intolerant would ultimately gain the upper hand vis-à-vis the tolerant majority and vitiate the entire society. It would be a disaster. This is the famous Paradox of Tolerance pointed out by Karl Popper in his well-known book, The Open Society and its Enemies. If that is indeed the limiting point, then to what extent should a society accept intolerance?

One has to seek a dividing line between what is tolerable and what is submissive. One possibility is to consider actions or practices that cause harm to others. A regulator might consider limiting such actions. Consider an example: banning a political ideology that permits murder as a way of tackling political opposition might be justified to ensure that freedom does not lead to bodily injury or cause harm to others. This is called the Harm Principle as expounded by John Stuart Mill. The Harm Principle allows tolerance to continue to the extent that one's actions, beliefs or practices do not harm other people. In this context, should a society allow actions by individuals that are harmful to themselves? An individual decides to smoke heavily knowing fully well the damage caused by smoking; or should one allow substance abuse like the use of narcotics? Most societies crack down on these actions in some ways, from high taxes to outright bans.

Is US listening to Bangladesh message against China

Over the past few years, the US has been seen to be ignoring Bangladesh's message that China is trying to pressurise Dhaka to get involved in the Belt and Road Initiative, Bangladeshlivenews reported.

According to the publication, a couple of years ago, China had warned Bangladesh from joining the Indo-Pacific initiatives, which was launched by the US, but under Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, the government firmly told Beijing that they would follow their own foreign policy.

Despite being the regional player in South Asia, Bangladesh has received a cold shoulder from the US, which gives lectures on human rights and democracy and pressurises the government on "free and fair" elections. Bangladeshlivenews suggest that the policymakers in the Biden administration must re-think their strategy of pushing Bangladesh on human rights and using various methods like sanctions to get Sheikh Hasina to hold "free and fair" elections scheduled to be conducted early next year. Even, Indian interlocutors have from time to time told their US and other Western counterparts of the relevance of Bangladesh in South Asia. The Biden administration has lately been regularly inviting leaders of several nations as part of the Indo-Pacific strategy to counter China's clout.

Ironically, it was Prime Minister Modi who is said to have convinced the Donald Trump administration to "recognise and accept" Bangladesh's 2018 election results. PM Modi at the time, assured the US that Sheikh Hasina's government would be stable and work towards American strategic and economic interests in the region and that Dhaka would "keep

China at bay and continue playing the fine balancing game". Under Sheikh Hasina, the country of 170 million people has been transformed. The country averaged an annual growth rate of 7 per cent in the decade before the coronavirus pandemic. The World Bank has described Bangladesh as a "remarkable story of poverty reduction and development", with poverty declining from 41.9 per cent in 1991 to 13.5 per cent in 2016 based on the international poverty line of USD 2.15 a day. After decades of being one of the

world's least developed countries, Bangladesh is expected to become a developing country by 2026. Last year, however, the Hasina government sought aid from the International Monetary Fund (IMF) to boost Bangladesh's economy following a slump in foreign reserves, economic disruptions amid the conflict in Ukraine and macroeconomic risks posed by climate change. In January, the IMF agreed to a USD 4.7 billion loan, reported Bangladeshlivenews.

In 2020, then-US Deputy Secretary of State, Stephen Biegun had called Bangladesh a "key partner" in the Indo-Pacific and "a centre-piece of our work in the region", adding that the US was committed to growing the "partnership".

He invited Bangladesh to take part in the Indo-Pacific Business Forum, which aims to advance trade, investment and economic cooperation between the US and Indo-Pacific nations.

In December 2021, the US Treasury Department sanctioned seven leaders of an elite Bangladeshi paramilitary unit accused of carrying out forced disappearances and extrajudicial killings of political opponents. The move followed a warning in

February from Derek Chollet, US State Department Counsellor, that the erosion of democracy in Bangladesh would limit Washington's ability to cooperate with Dhaka. He urged Hasina to ensure free and fair elections. More recently, US Secretary of State Antony Blinken threatened to deny American visas to anyone trying to hinder free and fair democratic elections in Bangladesh.

In response, Dhaka said it would "like to view the announcement in a broader context of its government's unequivocal commitment to holding free and fair elections at all levels". The US obviously did not accept Sheikh Hasina's assertions that conditions in Bangladesh are favourable for such elections.

Pertinently, the US was among the first countries to recognise Bangladesh as an independent nation in 1971, and it is one of Dhaka's largest trading partners, reported Bangladeshlivenews.

In April 2023, Dhaka issued its first official policy on the Indo-Pacific, calling for the establishment of "rules-based multilateral systems" to promote "equitable and sustainable development". This attempt at equipoise may have contributed to Dhaka's deteriorating ties with the

Biden administration. However, the nub of the matter relates to the US administration's perspective on the conduct of free and fair elections in Bangladesh. Recent US-Bangladesh tensions have unfortunately given China the opportunity to step into the vacuum.

Seeing the gap in the US-Bangladesh relationship, China sees an opportunity and wanted to use this moment to take Dhaka on its side. Bangladesh's top trading partner, as well as its largest foreign direct investor and military supplier, encompassing aircraft, tankers, fighter jets and submarines, is China.

In the last six months, senior Chinese officials have visited Dhaka, including a surprise midnight stop by Chinese Foreign Minister Qin Gang right before US Assistant Secretary of State Donald Lu's visit in January. Chinese vice-foreign Minister Sun Weidong travelled to Dhaka in May 2023, as per Bangladeshlivenews.

It is, therefore, imperative for the West to re-look at Bangladesh and focus on building ties with a view to preventing Chinese ingress and not merely work towards pressurizing the Sheikh Hasina government on "free and fair" elections.

India donates 10,000 metric tonnes of wheat to Afghanistan

As Afghanistan continues to grapple with the extreme food crises, India has donated 10,000 metric tonnes of wheat to the landlocked country.

The 10,000 metric tonnes of wheat reached the Herat city of Afghanistan on Tuesday, United Nations World Food Programme (UN-WFP) said in a tweet.

Earlier, another wheat assistance delivery of 40,000 tons was carried out through Pakistan's land border. India shows its dedication to promoting the stability and prosperity of Afghanistan by widening the channels

for aid distribution, as per Khaama Press. Afghanistan, under the Taliban, is facing its worst humanitarian crisis and the women of the country are denied fundamental rights. According to a World Food Programme assessment, Afghanistan is one of the nations with extreme food insecurity, with nine million people affected by severe economic difficulties and hunger. Since the Taliban seized power in August 2021, the law and order situation in the country has only deteriorated, with the rise in cases of terrorism.

New approach to combat effects of birth asphyxia

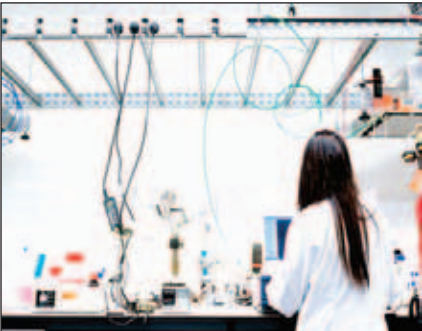
Birth asphyxia is one of the major complications in newborns, leading to the death of babies, however, the use of caffeine is currently considered as a therapeutic strategy against the long-term deleterious consequences of birth asphyxia.

Researchers from the University Hospital Bonn (UKB) and the DZNE tested treatment with 25 different active agents in a small animal model. Seven substances outperformed the standard therapy of artificial cooling: caffeine was the most effective. The findings, which were published in the scientific journal Scientific Reports, could pave the way for new newborn treatment options.

Children, who experience oxygen deprivation during birth - a condition known as "birth asphyxia" -, must be treated immediately because this situation causes brain damage and poses an imminent life threat.

In Germany, such issues are rare, but on a global level, birth asphyxia is one of the main causes of death among newborns. Globally, 1 million newborns die due to birth asphyxia per year. To address this, so-called therapeutic hypothermia has been used for several years.

This involves lowering the babies' body temperature to around 33 degrees Celsius for several days and then gradually raising it again. "The cooling slows down the metabolism and gives the brain the opportunity to regenerate. This increases the chances of survival and reduces the risk of late effects," explains Prof Hemmen Sabir. The scientist and physician is a research group



leader at DZNE and a senior physician in the Department of Neonatology and Pediatric Intensive Care at UKB.

"In high-income countries, the procedure is well established, however, about 40 percent of treated children do not benefit from it. And in low- and middle-income countries, the success rate is even much lower.

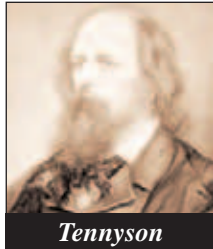
The reasons for this are not entirely clear. However, they could be related to the fact that the newborns there have worse conditions than in high-income countries due to the health status of their mothers and possibly unnoticed infections. In view of this, there is an urgent need for alternative therapies. That's where our study came in."

Study with 25 Active Agents: To date, hypothermia is the only established therapy for treating the consequences of oxygen shortage during childbirth. Drug alternatives have been tested worldwide - mostly in animal studies.

Study reveals positive effects of exercise on blood sugar levels

A study has revealed that exercise gives positive effects on blood sugar levels in people with Type 2 diabetes. The study was published in the journal, 'American Journal of Medicine Open'.

The study provides a comprehensive but straightforward summary of the benefits of exercise on controlling blood glucose levels in people with Type 2 diabetes.

"The challenge with this is that most, if not all, people know exercise is good for them but they don't know the best approach," said Steven Malin, an associate professor in the Department of Kinesiology and Health at the Rutgers School of Arts and Sciences and an author of the study. "We targeted this issue by focusing on a few key parameters: the utility of aerobics versus weightlifting, the time of day that is optimal for exercise, whether to exercise before or after meals and whether we have to lose weight to get benefits or not."



As part of the analysis, researchers sifted through dozens of studies and extracted common conclusions. Some of the key findings include:

- Habitual aerobic exercise: Physical activity, such as cycling, swimming and walking, that increases the heart rate and the body's use of oxygen helps manage blood glucose.

- Resistance exercise: Working muscles using an opposing force such as dumbbells, resistance bands or a person's own body weight benefits insulin sensitivity in those with Type 2 diabetes.

- Movement throughout the day by breaking up sitting time benefits blood glucose control and insulin levels.

- Performing exercise later in the day can result in better control of blood sugar levels as well as improve insulin sensitivity.

"In short, any movement is good and

more is generally better," Malin said. "The combination of aerobic exercise and weightlifting is likely better than either alone. Exercise in the afternoon might work better than exercise in the morning for glucose control, and exercise after a meal may help slightly more than before a meal. And, you don't have to lose weight to see the benefits of exercise. That is because exercise can lower body fat and increase muscle mass."

More than 37 million Americans have diabetes, and between 90 and 95 percent have Type 2 diabetes, according to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. People with Type 2 diabetes are insulin resistant, meaning that their cells don't respond normally to insulin, a hormone that controls the level of sugar, or glucose, in the blood. High blood sugar is damaging to the body and can cause serious health issues.

While insulin resistance is harmful, sci-

entists believe increased insulin sensitivity is beneficial. High insulin sensitivity allows the cells of the body to use blood glucose more effectively, reducing blood sugar.

Malin researches insulin sensitivity and teaches kinesiology, the study of human movement. He and several other faculty members at Rutgers support the concept of "exercise as medicine." The idea, which is supported by the American College of Sports Medicine and is increasingly being borne out by research, is that exercise can be considered a first-line therapy.

"I'm one of those individuals who subscribe to that notion, and in that way, I think of exercise as a drug," Malin said.

"Together, this idea of exercise timing and type is important because it helps medical professionals more accurately recommend exercise prescriptions to combat high blood glucose," Malin concluded.

Latest study reveals 9 out of 10 customers in India want cars with a safety rating

Jalandhar : A study was conducted among customers to gauge their feature preferences, when it comes to choosing a personal car. It revealed a heavy inclination among customers towards the safety features of the car with 9 out of 10 customers who thought all cars in India should have a safety rating. Crash-ratings and number of airbags were the top two features driving the consumer car purchase decision as derived from the survey results. Fuel-efficiency, one of the popular features, occupied third place. About 67% of the respondents consisted of current car owners who owned a car above Rs 5 lakh. Some 33% did not own a car, but intended to purchase one above Rs 5 lakh within a year. The survey was conducted on individuals between 18 and 54 years of age in the SEC A and B

bracket, with 80% respondents being male, and 20% female. The car's crash rating was the top driver of customer car purchase decision with an importance score of 22.3% followed by number of airbags with an importance score of 21.6%. Fuel efficiency emerged as the third most important driver with importance score of 15.0% when purchasing a car. When it comes to crash rating for cars, maximum customer preference of 22.3% was observed for a 5-star rating followed closely by 21.3% preference for a 4-star rating. Crash rating of zero is the least preferred with only 6.8% score. While the awareness about existence of 2 sets of 5-star safety ratings on crash tests is high at about 76%, only about 30% of all customers in India identify child/rear occupants safety rating as being one of those two sets.

"Cancer patients need to undergo biopsy for effective treatment," says Dr. Indu Bansal, Narayana Hospital

REWARI : According to recent statistics, there are approximately 2.25 million cancer patients in India as of March 2023. As per the Indian Council of Medical Research's National Cancer Registry Program (NCRP), the number of cancer patients in Haryana has increased by 1632 in the past two years, with an upward trend also seen in Rewari. Approximately 1 in 10 Indians is at risk of developing cancer, but unfortunately, a majority of cases in our country are diagnosed at the third or fourth stage, making it nearly impossible to provide complete treatment. To confirm cancer diagnosis, a small piece of tissue is extracted from the suspicious lump through a procedure called biopsy. There are several misconceptions surrounding biopsies, which lead people to avoid undergoing necessary examinations.

Dr. Indu Bansal, a senior consultant in radiation oncology at Narayana Hospital in Gurugram, explains that during a biopsy, a small fragment is taken from the lump. Prior to extracting the tissue, the area is numbed,

and then, using ultrasound or CT scan guidance, a tiny piece, similar in size to a grain of rice or a water droplet, is collected from the lump. This sample is preserved in formalin, examined under a microscope, and analyzed to identify the type of cancer. In some cases, additional specialized tests (such as IHC) may be required to provide more information about the cancer type and tailor treatment accordingly.

Dr. Indu highlights that many patients and their relatives refrain from undergoing biopsies due to various concerns. They fear that if a piece is taken and cancer is found, it could worsen the condition. However, even if cancer is present in the body, it will reveal its symptoms sooner or later, even without undergoing a biopsy. Unfortunately, by that time, valuable time for treatment may have been lost. Those who believe that taking a sample will accelerate the spread of the disease should understand that our medical advancements have ensured that no test can cause the disease to spread. On the contrary, these tests aid in understanding the variety of cancer and selecting appropriate medications.

After reviewing the situation, Mr. Harbhajan Singh ETO said that unit number 3 of the thermal plant has been made operational and was producing 600 megawatts of power. The Minister further added that unit number 1 and 2 of this thermal



plant would likely be made operational by Wednesday afternoon. He said that the administration of Talwandi Sabo Thermal Plant was told to ensure that the operations related to the repair or maintenance of the thermal plant should be done during the winter season but this problem has arisen because of a lack on their part. He said that the administration of the thermal plant has been asked to take special care of this matter in the future. Assuring the common

people and especially the farmers that they will be no power shortage in the state, Power Minister Harbhajan Singh ETO said that alternative power arrangements have already been made by the department in advance to deal with any such technical problem. The drones will enable in-time healthcare services in remote areas, provide quick response during emergencies, ensure the easy transportation of time-sensitive goods and materials, serve as efficient carriers for logistics in hilly areas, and contribute to environmental sustainability. Earlier, the Minister also visited the drone exhibition and evinced keen interest in it.

## Dastak campaign against communicable diseases to run from July 17 to 31

**AGENCY LUCKNOW (UTTAR PRADESH) :** The Yogi government is not only taking firm steps to guard the people of Uttar Pradesh against communicable diseases and meningitis in the state but is also monitoring the works being done in this regard in civic bodies across the state through the Directorate of Urban Bodies in Lucknow. It is worth mentioning that the Communicable Diseases Campaign started in Uttar Pradesh on July 1, while the Dastak campaign will run in the state from July 17 to July 31. Regarding the campaign being run in each municipal body, the Directorate of Urban Bodies has directed all the Municipal Commissioners as well as general Managers and executive officers of the Water Works Department and Water Institute and Municipal Council officials to send the daily report of the work done to the Directorate. Additionally, every Saturday and after the end of the campaign, the compiled report will be made available to the Directorate as well as the government. The compiled report will have to be submitted before August 5. The order issued by Dr Nilin Bansal, Director of the Directorate of Urban Bodies, says as per the micro plan prescribed in each body, all the officers must ensure garbage disposal, sanitization, fogging, anti-larva spraying as well as cleaning of drains in the localities of the wards of their respective bodies along with getting defective hand pumps repaired, making clean drinking water available to people.

## "Please wait for some time...": Uttarakhand CM on UCC

**AGENCY NEW DELHI :** Uttarakhand chief minister Pushkar Singh Dhami on Tuesday said that a Uniform Civil Code will soon be implemented in the State and that it will be done "with proper thought." Talking to media persons in New Delhi after meeting Prime Minister Narendra Modi, CM Dhami said, "We will neither take too much time. We will not rush to disarray things. We will give it (UCC) a proper thought".



When asked about the timeline for the implementation of the UCC, he said, "Let us assume it will be implemented very soon. Please wait for some time". He said that everyone in the state has cooperated in this whole exercise, adding that the UCC committee is examining the views of all stakeholders. "The committee has spoken with the representatives of the Tribal leaders as well," he said in response to a query. On PM Modi's recent UCC push and Uttarakhand becoming a role model state with respect to UCC, Dhami said, "Such type work will start in Uttarakhand and it will continue in other parts of the country". When asked what transpired in the meeting with PM Modi, CM Dhami said, "It is the thinking of PM Modi that UCC should be implemented in the country. He has expressed his opinion recently. He is aware of all aspects of the issue". Ahead of his meeting with the PM today, Dhami said that an expert committee is examining the views of more than 2.35 lakh people in the state representing different sections of society. When asked about the Uttarakhand UCC draft being likely a template for the Central law, CM Dhami said, "All aspects should be looked into before arriving at any decision".

## Jharkhand: 6 dead, 3 injured after car falls into well

**AGENCY HAZARIBAGH:** Six people were killed and three were left injured after a car fell into a well near Romi village under Padma block of Hazaribagh, according to the police. "6 people were killed in the accident which took place at around 1:30 pm near Romi village under Padma block of Hazaribagh. With the help of local police and villagers, immediately 3 people were rescued and sent to the hospital, said the police. Reportedly, the driver lost control of the car on the National Highway-33, following this it hit a motorcycle and then fell into a well. Six people including a child died in the accident. The passengers were returning from Darbhanga after

visiting Goddess Kali temple. They had gone to Darbhanga two days back.

## Organ Donation by Manpreet Singh's family kindles hope for 4 at PGIMER

**CHANDIGARH:** The life of Manpreet Singh came to an abrupt end as he was declared brain dead at PGIMER following a fatal head injury. But thanks to the selfless and magnanimous gesture of Organ Donation by his brave heart family that Manpreet Singh's passing away has kindled hope for two terminally ill renal failure patients and restored the sight of two more, thereby, impacting four lives here at PGIMER. Paying rich tributes to the donor family, Prof. Vivek Lal, Director PGIMER stated, "It is an extremely hard decision for anyone to make when you are put in that situation, but families like that of deceased Manpreet Singh definitely instil a sense of confidence not only in the in-

waiting recipients fighting a losing battle but also for the Cadaver Organ Donation Programme. It's a 'gift of life' for the recipients and a huge accomplishment for the entire team of PGIMER involved in the process." The heart-wrenching death of 30-year-old Manpreet Singh from Village Andheri, Tehsil Kharar, SAS Nagar, Punjab is beyond comprehension and extremely difficult to reconcile with. The day of 28th June started like any other usual day for Manpreet Singh and his family. However, destiny had something else in store for him on that day as on his way to work, Manpreet Singh's motorcycle was hit by a speeding car, making him fall on the road

and becoming unconscious due to severe head injury. Immediately, Manpreet Singh was rushed to a GMSH, Sector 16, from where he was referred to PGIMER by the attending doctors, seeing him as unresponsive to the treatment. Manpreet Singh was brought to PGIMER in an extremely critical condition on 29th June and was being treated in the Neuro-Surgery department of PGIMER. However, he could not be retrieved from his critical condition despite the best of the efforts by the treating team and was declared brain dead on 01st July after two meetings of the Brain Death Certification Committee following the protocols of THOA.

Cabinet okays SOPs for three State Police Awards

Haryana Cabinet which met under the Chairmanship of Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal here today approved the drafts of the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for three State Police Awards. Earlier, the Council of Ministers had approved the three State Police Awards namely 'Chief Minister's Medal for Bravery', 'Home Minister's Medal for Excellence in Investigation' and 'DGP's Uttam Seva Medal' to recognize and reward outstanding detection, investigation, bravery and outstanding performance of administrative duties by Haryana Police Personnel.

As per the SOPs, the awardees of the Chief Minister Medal for Bravery and the Home Minister's Medal for Excellence in Investigation will get a one-time cash reward of Rs.2,00,000 and Rs.1,00,000 respectively. Besides



this, the officers, and officials will also get a certificate/scroll signed by the Chief Minister and Home Minister respectively.

As per the SOPs, the awardees of the CM's Medal for Bravery, HM's Medal for Excellence in Investigation will get a medal along with a ribbon display above the left pocket of the uniform, six months extension in service after retirement for Group-B and C for police personnel, applicable only in case they are not availing any other extension in service and the name of

medal awardees shall be published in the Gazette of Haryana and the register of such names will be kept in the Home Department, Haryana.

The awardees of the DGP's Uttam Seva Medal will get a one-time cash reward of Rs. 50,000 along with a certificate/scroll signed by the Director General of Police, Haryana and a ribbon display above the left pocket of the uniform. Further, the name of medal awardees shall be maintained in a register at Police Headquarters, Haryana.

Notably, the provisions including eligibility criteria, Selection Committee, timeline, withdrawal of medal and description/design of medal etc., have also been provided in the drafts of SOPs. Number of Medals will be 1 to 10 in all three categories of awards. Extension in Service will be withdrawn in case the medal is withdrawn as provided in SOPs.

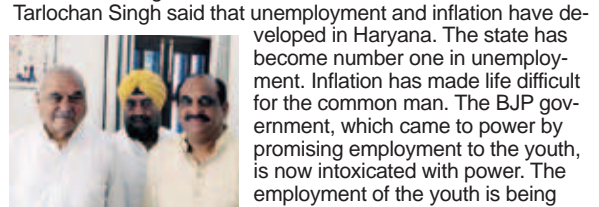
