Search operation underway following landslide in Gaurikund: **Uttarakhand CM Dhami**



DEHRADUN: A day after the landslide incident in Gaurikund, Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami on Saturday said that a search operation to trace people who went missing following a landslide triggered by a flashflood in Gaurikund is underway.

Earlier on Friday, a landslide took place in Gaurikund of Rudraprayag district, 16 km before Kedarnath in which three people have been killed and 17 people are missing in a massive landslide. "On the landslide incident in Gaurikund yesterday Uttarakhand CM Pushkar Singh Dhami says, "This incident is extremely sad. Till now, 17 people have been reported missing. The rescue operations are underway," CM Dhami said.

"All the agencies are on the spot...Our priority right now is to find the missing people. Full assistance is being provided," he added. According to the Uttarakhand district administration in the heavy debris that came from the mountain, two roadside shops and dhabas were washed away. In these shops and dhabas, there were 4 local people and 16 people of Nepali origin

State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) search operation is underway.

Meanwhile, CM Dhami was scheduled to visit the spot to review the search and rescue operations but due to bad weather in Rudraprayag his visit has been cancelled

He assured the State Government to provide all requisite support of the Centre in their mitigation efforts to make Odisha disaster resilient

Home Minister appreciated the preparedness of the State, which has made a lot of progress in disaster management after the super cyclone of 1999.

He advised that 'AAPDA Mitra'

and disaster warriors in the state should be imparted multi-disaster training, especially in chemical and nuclear disasters and handling those disasters, which occur without any warning.

Union Home Minister also suggested that the Home Guards volunteers should be strengthened and given training in disaster response. Further for ensuring the maintenance of Multi-purpose cyclone shelters, established in the state, regular funding from the budget head should be provided.

Shah stressed that the State administration should adopt SoPs and take appropriate preparedness and mitigation efforts to save lives from lightning, heat waves and forest fires.

He also emphasised focusing on the safety of animals during disasters. Shah thanked the State Government for providing an excellent response during the Balasore train accident and appreciated the efforts of villagelevel volunteers and the entire state administration machinery.

On Left Wing Extremism, Shah appreciated the efforts of the state government and advised making an investment in infrastructure development in the LWE-affected areas to supplement the efforts of the Central Government.

He assured the state government of the support of central forces to eliminate Left Wing Extremism. He also assured all possible support in strengthening road and communication networks in the affected areas, especially connecting all villages to the internet.

VB NABS ASI WHILE ACCEPTING BRIBE OF RS 20K

CHANDIGARH: Punjab Vigilance Bureau on Saturday nabbed an Assistant Sub-Inspector (ASI), Harjinder Singh, posted at Sadar Police Station Zira in Ferozepur district, while accepting a bribe of Rs 20,000 from Harpreet Singh resident of village Mahianwala.

Divulging the details here today, an official spokesperson of the VB said that the accused ASI was demanding the bribe for not taking action against him in a complaint filed by Gurmail Kaur resident of the same village. The complainant also claimed that ASI Harjinder Singh took Rs 3000 from him on August 4 and now he was demanding Rs 20,000 more as a bribe. The complainant also pro-

duced a call recording in this regard. After preliminary investigation of the complaint.

the spokesperson said that a team of VB laid a trap and arrested the accused ASI while accepting Rs 20,000 from the complainant in the presence of official witnesses.

Additionally, there are mechanisms for the release of Rover, two-way communication-related antennas and other onboard electronin-situ scientific experiments. The ap proved cost of Chandrayaan-3 is Rs. 250 crores (Excluding Launch Vehicle Cost).Chandrayaan-3's development phase commenced in January 2020 with the launch planned sometime in 2021 However, the Covid-19 pandemic brought an unforeseen delay to the mission's progress.Chandrayaan-3 is the ISRO's follow-up attempt after the Chandrayaan-2 mission faced challenges during its soft landing on the lunar surface in 2019 and was eventually deemed to have failed its core mission objectives.

Cybercrime has indeed become a significant concern in today's technological era. The rapid advancement of technology has provided criminals with new opportunities to exploit vulnerabilities and commit various forms of cyber-

crimes Meanwhile, as technology-driven crime becomes more sophisticated, the Manohar Lal-led Haryana Government too has taken proactive measures to tackle cybercrime and tighten the noose

around cyber fraudsters. The successful raid in Nuh district, involving a total of 5,000 personnel in Haryana, where the police uncovered a

cyber fraud worth about Rs 100 crore, not only highlights State's significant accomplishment in the fight against cybercrime but showcases the seriousness with which the state's law enforcement tackled this issue.

This was the biggest ever raid of its kind in India in which 320 hideouts of cyber criminals spread across 14 villages in Nuh district were raided. The steps taken by the Haryana government to

address cybercrime are commendable. A total of 65 cyber criminals were arrested during raids

As per the official data, a total of 65 cyber criminals were arrested during raids, with an additional 25 arrests made in the period before and after the raids. Besides this, Law enforcement seized a

significant number of IT devices, including 66 mobile devices and 5 micro ATM machines. These devices were likely used in carrying out cybercrimes. Numerous fake documents were exposed, including details of 739 fake SIM cards, 307 fake bank accounts, and 199 UPI handles. These fake documents were likely used for illegal activ-

Notably, the criminals attempted to destroy evidence that had been collected during the raids. He said that in the guise of the violence in Nuh strict in the past few last days, an attempt was made to destroy the evidence collected during this raid and a planned attack on the cyber police station. This cyber police station of Nuh has been completed two

years back. The cyber station contained massive fraud and other criminal documents and the miscreants aimed to destroy the evidence to avoid prosecution.

Apart from this, the setting up of 318 cyber help desks one each in a cyber police station and coordination centres demonstrates a comprehensive approach to tackling cyber threats. 29 cyber police stations have also been set up in the state. Integrating the Cyber Crime Helpline -1930 with the Emergency Response Support System-DIAL-112 and coordinating with other states and the national centre at State Level Cyber Crime Coordination Centre in Panchkula also reflects the state government's coordinated effort to effectively combat cybercrime on multiple levels.

Editorial SC relief for Rahul is a boost for democracy too

The Supreme Court's order staying the Surat chief judicial magistrate's conviction of Rahul Gandhi in a criminal defamation case and sentencing him to the maximum punishment of two years in jail indeed offers some relief to the Congress leader. Its impact will, however, be felt much beyond the personal political prospects of the Congress leader and Wayanad MP, and will cover the process of democracy in India as it seeks to redeem judicial accountability, neutrality and independence.

While making known its displeasure at the language used by Mr Gandhi by iterating that it was not in "good taste" and that a person in public life ought to have been more careful while making public speeches, the apex court deliberated specifically on two important aspects of the orders of the lower courts - one, the magistrate awarded Mr Gandhi the maximum punishment of two years in such a way that it would attract provisions of Section 8(3) of the Representation of the People Act that calls for disqualification of an elected legislator convicted for two years; and two, no court bothered to explain why he was handed down the maximum punishment.

The apex court carefully pointed out that the magistrate offered no reason other than his admonition in a contempt proceeding to Mr Gandhi while imposing the maximum sentence. The court's suggestion that the judge should have given reasons when he imposes the maximum punishment in a case involving a non-compoundable, bailable and cognisable offence reflects its extreme discomfiture with the way the trial court went about the sentencing. When it mentioned that, had the sentence been a day lesser, then the legal provisions for disqualification would not have been attracted, many right-thinking people would feel that the court was speaking their mind.

It's very refreshing that the Supreme Court looked at the impact of the magistrate's order not only on the right of one individual "but [on] an entire electorate of a constituency". It is an important marker where the interests of the people, the ultimate arbiters in a democracy, are given due regard. The observation of the apex court that the appellate court and the high court spent voluminous pages in rejecting Mr Gandhi's applications but did not consider some key aspects of the case only reflects an interesting pattern. While the magistrate who convicted Mr Gandhi said a lesser punishment would send a wrong message to the public, the sessions court, on its part, ob-served that "any word spoken by [the] appellant would have large impact in mind of common public".

Beijing's 'wolf warriors' in fresh games: Watch out!

The abrupt replacement by the Communist Party of China (CPC) of its foreign minister Qin Gang, who had served just over six months, and around whose fate there had been considerable speculation before his late July ouster, should make New Delhi ponder on what's really going on in the Middle Kingdom. The return of longtime foreign minister Wang Yi, the tallest living Beijing "wolf warrior" diplomat with a history of abrasive and arrogant interactions with Indian and Western representatives, is reason enough for watchfulness. Mr Wang, previously a State Councillor as well, was "promoted" as head of CPC's Central Foreign Affairs Commission, a post that he continues to hold, making him a kind of "super foreign minister".

India's national security adviser Ajit Doval, who met Wang Yi in South Africa in late July, on the sidelines of a Brics meeting, just a day before the latter returned as foreign minister, can testify to the nature of Mr Wang's doublespeak. The two have a long history -- they have had regular interactions as Special Representatives of their countries on the India-China boundary question, under a mechanism set up in 2003. And just prior to the Doval encounter, Mr Wang met external affairs minister S. Jaishankar in Jakarta, on sidelines of the Asean Regional Forum. At both meetings, Wang spelt out China's line: that both countries should find a mutually acceptable solution to the border problem, normalise ties on all other issues like trade, without letting



'specific issues" define the overall relationship. This, of course, was completely unacceptable to New Delhi, especially after the betrayal, treachery and deception by the CPC's People's Liberation Army at Galwan in June 2020, and the unresolved aggressive stand by the CPC/PLA in eastern Ladakh for the past three years.

Just look at Mr Wang's record: It's not just New Delhi and Washington which have faced the brunt of Beijing's targeted lies and ire -he's audacious enough to sermonise Seoul and Tokyo with racial "nose and hair comparisons" alluding to those of Korean and Japanese ethnicity in comparison, of course, to the "superior" Han people! India's foreign minister and

NSA have had the misfortune of

bearing the brunt of hearing the "old tape recorded" cacophonic semantics of the irrational thoughts of "His Master's Voice". The same nagging, bragging and repetitive monologues faced (for years) by every Indian delegation to China or to multilateral meetings. Can Indians recall the conde-

scending, choreographed and patronising words of previous Dragon "diplomats" in New Delhi's Chanakyapuri: Luo Zhaohui and Sun Weidong? "Let's forget the border dispute; Beijing and Delhi have more in common than a mere land dispute; let not our differences spill over into dispute; we should do more for convergence of interests rather than divergence, for our mu-tual benefit as Asian giants". This is what Mr Wang told Mr Jaishankar

in Jakarta in mid-July: "Our two sides should support, rather than suspect, each other. We must focus our energy and resources on development, and not let specific issues define the overall relationship". The parting shot was like a "warning" to India: Forget about the border: China was not going to relinquish control anytime soon. And "specific issues" related to border violations, the killing of Indian soldiers, the pitching of permanent PLA tents deep inside Indian territory and other cases of violation of sovereignty.

Mr Jaishankar, in Jakarta, made it clear that till there was "peace and tranquility" at the border, there couldn't be any progress in ties. In-dia's NSA, in Johannesburg, too told Mr Wang that the PLA's incursions at the Line of Actual Control in Ladakh since 2020 had "eroded strategic trust and the public and political basis of the relationship" in India, and till this and other "im-pediments" were restored, there couldn't be any normalisation of ties. China, of course, wants its companies and citizens to do unhindered business in India. for Xiaomi. Oppo, Vivo, Huawei and Meizu to sell their telecom products and MG its cars and vehicles (that don't match up to their Japanese and Korean rivals), and a plethora of inferior consumer goods and be allowed to take locals for a ride, to defraud the Indian exchequer through nonpayment of taxes and money-laundering and let Chinese nationals buy land next to India's military installations for 24/7 espionage. Contex-tually, one really wonders about the

psyche and motivation of a section of unscrupulous traders in this country who virtually work as a pressure group for Beijing, against their own country's interests. Are they now so addicted to China's cheap goods to make high profits, almost like the Chinese were once addicted to the opium consumption thrust on them by the British Raj in India?

Regrettably, most Indians can't read Chinese minds, see through their psyche, and anticipate the CPC's malice owing to their lamentable lack of knowledge about Chinese history and culture. Having been almost continuously betrayed by the Dragon since the 1950s, Delhi is inexorably digging its own

grave. At a time when much of the world's finally woken up to China's uncivilised diplomacy and perfidy, the West's pushback has started

crystallising, responding to complaints even from American farmers that China is quietly buying thousands of acres of rural farmland and building bases near military installations.

Beijing is brutally bypassing diplomatic norms to directly approach Western corporations, offering morsels and urging them to betray their own governments and do business directly with Beijing. From the EU to the US, India to Africa, virtually every country is under malicious attack from the CPC. The United States, like India, is under pressure from its businessmen to avoid "unnecessary conflict" because of cash-for-profits.

engue is caused by a virus trans-mitted to humans by mosquitoes. The mosquito causing dengue (and chikungunya) breeds in stagnant water around habitations and bites in the daytime, particularly early morning, or late evening. The infection can evolve rapidly into an epidemic during

the mosquito-breeding season. Symptoms

fatigue, fever, loss of

phases: febrile, critical and recovery. In the initial febrile phase, fever, headache and body pain are the major symptoms. Fever-reducing medicines (paracetamol) and plenty of fluids are required. Most patients usually go into recovery without developing an overt critical phase.

Some patients, however, develop critical symptoms that require hospitalisation and ig. The we signs include vomiting, abdomen pain, severe headache, persisting body pain, bleeding from any site and the inability to have liquids. Presence of any of these indicates a critical situation and the patient needs close monitoring for 48-72 hours in a hospital setting. Monitoring haemoglobin and haematocrit (ratio of the volume of red blood cells to the total blood volume) is more important than even monitoring of platelet count in dengue. These two values need to be checked on the second/third day of fever. These results would serve as the baseline values for the patient and should be closely monitored if symptoms persist or worsen. Sometimes, when the patient's fever breaks, often other symptoms worsen, indicating the beginning of the critical phase.

Mobile use among Kids

handigarh-based skin specialist Dr SD Mehta feels perturbed when he sees his patients handing over mobile phones to their children as young as two. Reviews Dengue, Cholera cases with administrative, health officials

SHASHI PAL JAI **MOHALI, AUG 5**

Reviewing the status of cases Dengue and Cholera in the district, the Deputy Commissioner, Aashika Jain exhorted the Residents Walfare Associations /Maintenance Societies to keep their roofs clean and draining out stagnant water to keep the Dengue larvae away.

The meeting was attended by ADCs, SDMs, Civil Surgeon, SMOs and EOs. The Deputy Commissioner expressing concern over the recovery of dengue Mosquito larvae from the rural as well as urban areas said that we should keep village health and sanitation committees and in urban areas to thwart the rise in dengue cases. She said that presently, the district has recorded 10 dengue cases in August whereas container survey found 308 cases of larvae. The residents who are violating the advisory of the health department of cleaning and drain stagnant water, have been is-



sued 143 Challans. Last month, the container survey found 1085 cases of larvae in which 290 challaned were issued.

She said that fogging and spray activities would be increased in wake of the increasing number of larvae detection in rural and urban areas. She directed the SDMs to lead the campaign "Friday as the dry day" in hot spot belts of larvae detection

The Civil Surgeon Dr Mahesh Kumar Ahuja apprised the administration that the larvae detection hot spots in the district are Kharar and Derabassi where Sunny Enclave, Jhungian Road and Bala ji Society showing more larvae while in Derabassi Trivedi Camp, Zirakpur's Sushma Joynest, Bhabat, Amandeep Colony etc. have more numbers of The Deputy larvae detection

Commissioner instructed the SDMs to take stringent action against those non-coperative developers where vacant plots have become the larvae factory by initiating proceedings under section 133 of CrPC. She said that in villages too, the education to prevent Degue Mosquito breeding, should be intensified.

Asking the ADC (UD) and ADC (RD) to keep a close check on the fogging, spraying and awareness activites through EOs and BDPOs, she also directed the SMOs to be in touch with their respective SDMs to expedite the IEC activities to protect the residents from the deadly disease Dengue. She said that the district had 38 Cholera positive cases, out of which four patients have been undergoing treatment. But as a precaution the EOs, BDPOS and Water Supply and Sanitation officials have been put on alert to keep immediate remedial actions in the particular area like checking of water supply, draining out stagnant water etc
