### **Hry purchases 8.06 Lakh MT** of paddy so far

CHANDIGARH: In Haryana, procurement of paddy and millet is progressing seamlessly in the mandis during the Kharif Marketing Season - 2023. As of now, the state has successfully procured 8.06 paddy and 1.14 lakh MT of millet. A total payment of Rs 690 crore has been disbursed directly into the accounts of over 32,000 farmers for their crop purchases through the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT)

system.
In a farmer-centric move to accommodate the early arrival of Kharif crops, Chief Minister Sh Manohar Lal took the decision to commence procurement in September, ahead of the traditional October 1st. Haryana has thereby become the first state in India to initiate the procurement of Kharif crops earlier than

### No relief for TDP **Chief Chandrababu** Naidu in SC

**NEW DELHI:** The Supreme Court has not given any immediate relief to Telugu Desam Party (TDP) National President and former Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu after the latter challenged the Andhra Pradesh Court Order which rejected his petition for quashing the FIR registered by CID in the skill development scam case and the consequential remand order of the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) Court in Vijayawada. The Top Court did not pass any order on his petition on Tuesday and posted the matter for further hearing to next Monday. The Apex Court two-judge bench, headed by Justice Aniruddha Bose and Bela M Trivedi asked State of Andhra Pradesh to produce the entire compilation of documents and records of the case, which were there before the AP HC. The Supreme Court said we won't pass any order today on the former AP CM Chandrababu Naidu's petition to quash FIR in relation to skill development scam. "We will list the matter for hearing on October 9," the Judges said.

### Sensex down 316.31 pts

MUMBAI: The BSE Sensex on Tuesday dropped 316.31 pts to close at 65,512.10 because of foreign fund outflows amid sluggish Asian Market. The Nifty of National Stock Exchange (NSE) fell 109.55 pts at 19,528.75.

The Sensex opened weak at 65,813.42, easing 15 pts. During the session, it was plummeted 484 pts at 65,344.59, days low, before closing at 65,512.10, from its previous close. The stocks that dragged the market were Oil and Gas by 1.30 pc followed by Auto by 1.21 pc. Energy by 1.15 pc and Power by 0.82 pc.

# Strong tremors in Delhi after 6.2 magnitude earthquake in Nepal

AGENCY NEW DELHI, OCT 3

Strong tremors were felt in Delhi Tuesday after multiple earthquakes hit Nepal - of 4.6 and 6.2 magnitude within 25 minutes of each other, a third of 3.8 magnitude 15 minutes after, and a fourth of 3.1 magnitude 13 minutes later, at 3.19 PM IST. The first earthquake hit at 2.25

PM. According to the National Centre for Seismology, there was also a 5.2 magnitude earthquake in Arunachal Pradesh at 3.27 PM IST and a 3.3 magnitude disturbance in Uttarakhand minutes later.

The epicentre for the strongest quake was 206 km southeast of Joshimath in Uttarakhand and 284 north of Lucknow

On X (formerly Twitter), the NCS said: "Earthquake of Magnitude: 6.2, Occurred on 03-10-2023, 14:51:04 IST, Lat: 29.39 & Long: 81.23, Depth: 5 Km ,Location: Nepal.

The earthquake was felt in Delhi and other parts of the national capital region. Delhi-NCR residents reported strong tremors after the second earthquake and evacuated offices buildings. Videos of people rushing out of buildings flooded social media.

'We hope you all are safe. Please come out of your buildings to a safe spot, but do not panic. DO NOT USE ELEVATORS! For any

emergency help, dial 112," Delhi Police said in

a statement.

There are reports that tremors were felt in Uttar Pradesh's Lucknow, Hapur, and Amroha as well. Parts of Uttarakhand also experienced tremors following the back-to-back earthquakes in Nepal. Tremors were felt in Chandigarh, Jaipur and other parts of north India as well, news agency said

No reports of damage, injuries or deaths have emerged from Nepal so far.

On Monday tremors were felt in Assam and other north-east states after a 5.2 magnitude earthquake in Meghalaya. The quake hit at 6.15 PM. The epicentre in the North Garo Hills, three km from the district headquarters at Resubelpara. Nepal lies in one of the world's most active tectonic zones (Seismic Zone IV and V), making it extremely vulnerable to earthquakes. In April 2015 a 7.8 magnitude earthquake killed more than 8,000 people and injuring over 21,000.

# 7 more patients die at Nanded hospital, 31 deaths in 48 hours

AGENCY MUMBAI, OCT 3

A dirty toilet in a government hospital in Maharashtra's Nanded, where 31 people have died in 48 hours, was cleaned by no less than the dean after an MP from the ruling Shiv Sena instructed him to do so.

After the deaths made national headlines, Shiv Sena (Shinde faction) MP Hemant Patil visited the Shankarrao Chavan Government Hospital on Tuesday and took stock of the situation there. On spotting a filthy toilet, Mr Patil caught hold of the hospital's dean, Shyamrao Wakode, and asked him to clean it. Videos show the MP standing

and holding a pipe as the dean empties the toilet, putting a container, a bottle, and a toilet brush on a window. Mr Patil can then be seen spraying water into the toilet as Mr Wakode, armed with a wiper, directs streams of dirty water into the com-On Monday, the hospital had re-

ported 24 deaths in 24 hours and the number rose to 31 in 48 hours on Tuesday. The condition of 71 patients said to be critical.

Mr Wakode had, on Monday, rejected allegations of medical negligence and said there was no shortage of medicines or doctors. He had said the patients were given proper care, but did not respond to the treatment. The opposition has trained its guns on the Eknath Shinde-led gov-

ernment in Maharashtra, which is composed of the Shiv Sena (Shinde faction), the BJP and the Ajit Pawar faction of the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP). "The BJP government



spends thousands of crores on publicity, but there is no money to buy medicines of children," Congress leader Rahul Gandhi asked in a post on X, formerly Twitter. In Mumbai teams of the Delhi police special cell & Mumbai police conducted searches at the residence of activist Teesta Setalvad.

Minister of Information and Broadcasting Anurag

Thakur defended the police action against NewsClick saying that if anyone has done something, investigation agencies are free to carry out investigations.

"I don't need to justify... If anyone has committed anything wrong, search agencies are free to carry out investigations against them under set guidelines," Thakur told reportes in Bhubaneswar.

The opposition parties however were quick to criticise the police action and blamed the centre for targeting journalists.

RJD leader and MP Manoj Jha alleged that these raids against NewsClick are being conducted under the Centre's direction.

## 107 MPs and MLAs have hate speech cases against them: ADR

A total of 107 MPs and MLAs have hate speech cases against them and 480 candidates with such cases have contested elections in the last five years, according to poll rights body Asso-

ciation for Democratic Reforms (ADR). The ADR and National Election Watch (NEW) have analysed the self-sworn affida-

vits of all the incumbent MPs and MLAs, besides the unsuccessful candidates in the Assembly and Lok Sabha polls held in the country in the said peri-

The analysis reveals that many of the MPs and MLAs, who are designated lawmakers, have actually declared cases related to "hate speech" against themselves. The analysis is based on the affidavits submitted by the MPs and MLAs prior to the last election they contested.

sis, 33 MPs have declared cases related to hate speech against themselves -- seven from Uttar Pradesh, four from Tamil Nadu, three each from Bihar, Karnataka and

## Pierre Agostini, Ferenc Krausz, Anne L'Huillier win Nobel Prize in Physics

AGENCY STOCKHOLM, OCT 3

Scientists Pierre Agostini, Ferenc Krausz and Anne L'Huillier have been awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics "for experimental methods that generate attosecond pulses of light for the study of electron dynamics in matter.

In a post shared on X, the award-giving body stated, "The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences has decided to award the 2023 #NobelPrize in Physics to Pierre Agostini, Ferenc Krausz and Anne L'Huillier "for experimental methods that generate attosecond pulses of light for the study of electron dynamics in matter.'

The three physics laureates - Pierre Agostini, Ferenc Krausz and Anne L'Huillier have created flashes of light that are short enough to take snapshots of electrons' extremely rapid movements.

been used to explore the detailed physics of atoms and molecules, and they have potential applications in areas from electronics to medicine. These can also be used to

identify different molecules, like in medical diagnostics.

Redressal of complaints of consumers of districts falling under Rohtak zone (Karnal, Panipat, Sonipat, Jhajjar and Rohtak) on October 6 in office of Chief Engineer Rohtak, 4th floor, conference hall of Rajiv Gandhi Vidyut Bhawan Rohtak, 11 am to 1 pm. He said that wrong bills of consumers of districts falling under Rohtak zone matters related to electricity rates, matters related to meter security, matters related to faulty meters and voltage related matters will be resolved. During this period, cases like electricity theft, misuse of electricity and fatal non-fatal accidents will not be considered. Claim for each month calculated on the basis of average electricity charges paid by the consumer during the last six months before the complaint relating to financial disputes is submitted to the Forum for settlement of any dispute between the consumer and the Corporation. The consumer will have to deposit the amount or an amount equal to electricity charges payable by him, whichever is less. During this, consumer will have to certify that matter is not pending before the court, authority or forum as the matters pending in such court or forum will not be considered during the meet-



## SC to hear Bihar caste census matter on October 6

NEW DELHI, OCT 3

The Supreme Court of India has said that it will take up for hearing on October 6 the matter of the caste census in Bihar after the petitioner's lawyer mentioned before the apex court that the Bihar Government had published caste survey data.

The matter was brought before a bench consisting of Justices Sanjiv Khanna and SVN Bhatti. The petitioner's lawyer apprised the court that the Bihar Government has already published the caste survey data, prompting concerns and legal challenges from various quarters.

Among the petitioners are organizations like Ek Soch Ek Prayas and Youth for Equality, who have contested the legality and authority of the caste-based survey. The Central Government also entered the legal fray, filing an affidavit with the Supreme Court, emphasizing that the



1948, exclusive authority upon the Central Government to conduct census-related activities

The affidavit reaffirmed the government's commitment to uplift Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBCs), and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) in with constitutional provisions and applicable laws.

One of the petitions, represented by advocate Tanya Shree on behalf of petitioner Akhilesh Kumar, contested the Patna High Court's dismissal of pleas challenging the Nitish Kumar government's decision to conduct the caste-based survey. The High Court's order was issued on August 1. The petitioner had argued that the state of Bihar lacked the constitutional competence to

nitiate a caste-based survey and usurped the exclusive authority of the Union Government in conducting a census. The petitioner had highlighted that Bihar government's notification dated June 6, 2022, and the subsequent appointment of a District Magistrate for supervision violate constitutional provisions, including distribution of powers between the state and the union.

The petitioner contended that the entire exercise is without legislative competence and is riddled with malafide intentions.

The petitioner underscored that only the Union Government possesses the authority to conduct a census in India, rendering the Bihar State Government's notification null and void.

The Patna High Court had previously dismissed similar pleas contesting the caste-based survey ordered by the Nitish Kumar administration.

## **High rhetoric**

Indian delegation to the High-Level Segment of this year s annual session of the United Nations General Assembly its 78th. The HLS attracts world leaders who traditionally make statements in the General Debate. These are regarded as authoritative articulations of their countries domestic and foreign policies, achievements and aspirations. Since assuming office in May 2014, Prime Minister Narendra Modi has been personally present at the HLS thrice and, in 2020, he delivered India s statement virtually. The late Sushma Swaraj, one of India s ablest external affairs ministers, headed the Indian delegation to the HLS on four occasions. Both Modi and Swaraj made their UNGA addresses in Hindi.

When he spoke at the UNGA in 2022 as well as this year, Jaishankar did so in English. While Modi and Swaraj referred to India as Bharat this was the correct way of naming the country as they were speaking in Hindi the English language interpreters named the country India. This is because internationally the country s name is India. Jaishankar referred to the country as India in his statement but in keeping with the Bharatiya Janata Party s new penchant for calling it Bharat even in English, Jaishankar could not resist beginning his statement by saying, Namaste from Bharat (Contrast this with Swaraj s simple namaste ) and concluding his address with the words, India that is Bharat . To avoid these artificial, contrived and awkward formulations, it would be preferable if Jaishankar learns to deliver the UNGA statements in Hindi if he wishes to show that he is truly part of the present grounded and authentic leadership, which, he has asserted, is taking India to a glori-

In his address, Jaishankar avoided direct references to the current geopolitical controversies, including the Ukraine war. He enunciated basic, if idealistic, principles such as the need for global equity and justice. He also focused on the present East-West divide and the large North-South gap. He emphasised that the world must not countenance that political convenience determines responses to terrorism, extremism and violence. Similarly, respect for territorial integrity and non-interference in internal affairs cannot be exercises in cherry picking. However, from his earlier avatar as a hardheaded, erudite and top diplomat, Jaishankar would know that it is one matter to declaim and quite another to pursue interests.


# China mocks Taiwan's first indigenous submarine

hina responded with mocking derision when Taiwan unveiled its first Indigenous Defense Submarine (IDS), which displaces approximately 2,700 tons, at a ceremony in Kaohsiung on 28 September. Taiwan is planning to construct up to eight such submarines and, despite China s rhetoric, they will present significant challenges to China s military in any potential conflict. Senior Colonel Wu Qian, a spokesman

for China s Ministry of National Defense, described Taiwan s submarine program as a broom attempting to hold hack the tide . He also called the effort idiotic nonsense With bluster typical of Chinese official-

dom whenever it comes to the topic of Taiwan, Senior Colonel Wu said that, no matter how many weapons Taiwan builds, they will not be able to stop the general trend of national reunification, or shake the staunch determination, strong will and strong capabilities of the People s Liberation Army (PLA) to defend national sovereignty and territorial

Taiwan s first IDS was christened Hai Kun, and the design is rather conventional as is befitting for the country s first ever attempt at building a submarine. Construction of this diesel-electric submarine commenced on 24 November 2020, following a contract signed with shipbuilder CSBC Corporation. This boat is approximately 70m long, and is Taiwan s first submarine to feature X-shaped rudders. Such rudders offer better underwater maneuverability compared to a traditional cruciform configuration. Harbor acceptance tests of the first IDS were to occur on 1 October, ahead of sea trials scheduled for around April 2024. Retired admiral Huang Shu-kuang, head of the submarine program, said that the future ROCS Hai Kun would be



handed over to the Republic of China Navy (ROCN) by the end of 2024. In similar dismissive fashion to the PLAs Senior Colonel Wu, a story published in the Chinese tabloid Global Times on 25 September said any Taiwanese ambition to prevent the PLA Navy (PLAN) from entering the Pacific Ocean is just an illusion of the island attempting to resist reunification by force . It quoted an unnamed Chinese expert asserting that: If a conflict breaks out, the island s submarines will be easily detected and dealt with by the PLA, and they will pose only limited threats. Such reasoning is flawed, however. Submarines are notoriously difficult to track, and their sudden appearance can cause may-

hem. The expert quoted in the Global Times report failed to mention that anti-submarine warfare is a major weakness of the PLAN. Because of this, submarines therefore represent a good choice for Taiwan. They will be critical to Taiwan s asymmetric warfare preparations to defend against any coercive military action by the PLA. In fact, the IDS program is a key deterrent in case Beijing ever thinks an amphibious invasion or naval blockade is the best course of action to subjugate Taiwan.

In any future conflict, Taiwanese submarines have the ability to torpedo Chinese warships, to lay sea mines near Chinese ports to blockade them, to conduct reconnaissance, to disrupt Chinese merchant shipping, to insert and extract special forces, and to launch cruise missiles against Chinese military facilities near the coast. That they will pose only limited threats is a gross and

deliberate understatement.
Nonetheless, it should be remembered that the center of gravity for any fighting be-tween China and Taiwan would be in the sea and air domains that separate the two countries. Waters in the Taiwan Strait are shallower than the deep waters found to the east of Taiwan, and this makes them less suitable for submarine operations.

However, with the PLAN and PLA Air Force now routinely rehearsing operations to the east of Taiwan and even circumnavigations, Taiwan s submarine fleet would get plenty of

target practice. Of course, Taiwan is a critical link in the so-called First Island Chain, an imaginary line that runs through archipelagos running from Japan, through Taiwan and the Philippines down to Malaysia. If Taiwan fell, this chain would be irrevocably snapped and the PLAN would have bases in Taiwan with which to launch submarines and warships deep into the Pacific Ocean, Dr. Collin Koh, Senior Fellow at the Institute of Defence and Strategic Studies at the S. Rajaratnam School of International Studies in Singapore, told: Taiwan s naval modernization stems from, first and foremost, the growing military threat posed by mainland China, and it also reflects the much broader associated quest for defense self-reliance, which in no small part stems from uncertainty about a possible US military intervention in the event of a major-scale aggression by Beijing, such as an armed

## Bangladesh dengue outbreak: Death toll crosses 1000

people in Bangladesh have died of dengue fever in 2023, shows official data. Al Jazeera reported.

The deaths reported are nearly four times more

At least 1,017 people

have died in the first nine months of 2023 and nearly 209,000 have become infected, making it Bangladesh s worst recorded outbreak of the mosquito-borne disease since the first tallied epidemic in 2000. Among the dead are 112 children aged 15 and under, including

The country s hospitals are struggling to make space for patients as the disease spreads rapidly in the densely populated

South Asian country. Dengue is a disease endemic to tropical areas and causes high fevers, headaches, nausea, vomiting, muscle pain and, in the most serious cases, bleeding that can lead to



death. The World Health Organization (WHO) has warned that dengue and other diseases caused by mosquito-borne viruses, such as chikungunya, yellow fever and Zika, are spreading faster and further due to climate change. There is no vaccine or drug that specifically treats dengue, which is common in South Asia during the June-to-September monsoon season as the Aedes aegypti mosquito that spreads the disease thrives in stagnant water. Hospitals in Bangladesh have in recent years begun

to admit patients suffering from the disease during winter months. Those with repeat infections are at greater risk of complications. Bangladesh has recorded cases of dengue from the 1960s, but documented its first outbreak of dengue haemorrhagic fever, a severe and sometimes fatal symptom of the disease, in 2000.

The virus that causes the disease is now endemic to Bangladesh, which has seen a trend of worsening outbreaks since the turn of the century, as per Al Jazeera.

## Afghan refugees in Iran rises to 5 million in past two years



the number of Afghan refugees in Iran has surged from approximately 2 million to 5 million over the past two years, reported Khaama Press. Iranian Interior Ministry stated that before the Taliban took over Afghanistan, 2 million people lived in Iran but the number has now risen to 5 million, reported Khaama Press citing Iranian media.

Moreover, Afghan people have been forced to move to Iran due to unemployment and an uncertain future in Afghanistan.

Recently, a member of Iran's National Security and Foreign Policy Commission Fadahossein Maleki announced that the "migration trend from Afghanistan" has been reviewed by this commission.

Maleki on Sunday told the Iranian Labour News Agency (ILNA), "The influx of many migrants, most of whom enter illegally, has raised concerns for our people, and these concerns are valid.

Furthermore, he called on Iran's representative to the President's Office for Afghan Affairs to reconsider their strategies regarding the Taliban, Khaama Press reported.



## Chulha continues to keep its unique position in society

The clay stoves that symbolize our culture and traditions are still displayed today, embodying the ideals and values of our culture. The mention of the Chulha brings to mind the taste of the roti made by a mother's hands, felt between the

Even in modern times, the charm of Matiyare Chulhas and Haare (hearths) remains intact, as it is reflected even in the roasted bread, carrying the blessings and love of mothers. Dishes made on these stoves are still served from rural kitchens.

A glimpse into the real-life cultural, historical, and rural environment reveals that the Chulha encompasses the entire social scene in its essence. While there have been changes in the appearance of stoves over time, the Chulha has remained an integral part of people's lives since ancient times. It is difficult to determine when and how the Chulha originated, but a closer look at history suggests that its development occurred according to the needs of the time. The Chulha and Haar have always been

essential for human survival. Even today, the Chulha holds its own place in society in one form or an-

From a spiritual perspective, the Ramayana and Mahabharata describe Chulhas or similar cooking methods. Even gods have praised the significance of the Chulha. With social changes, the forms of Chulhas have also evolved, but the Chulha still maintains its unique identity in soci-

How women make Chulhas -Traditional Chulhas are made by housewives using raw clay, cow dung, and bricks. These women are skilled in identifying the type of clay

that can make durable Chulhas and Haare. They often mix a little cow dung or straw in the clay before shaping the Chulha. Afterward, they place sand or ash underneath and build the Chulha on it. If only

clay is used, it is molded on top of sand or ash, making it easier to lift and place elsewhere when dried. Some women also use bricks for Chulha con-

struction. In the current era, gas stoves have become more common, but in rural areas, especially in families connected to farming, clay stoves are still in use.

A symbol of purity - The tradition of keeping Chulhas and Haare clean is ancient and still prevalent today. In the morning, women clean the Chulha with a mixture of raw clay in a kulhadi (a type of shovel) before cooking. This process not only ensures cleanliness but also strengthens the Chulha. In rural regions, it is considered inauspicious to enter the Chulha area wearing shoes or

bringing impure objects. Wearing shoes or carrying impure items near the Chulha can provoke comments like "The wandering jogi has brought shoes; he should burn them in the Chulha." In this way, the

Chulha holds great significance, especially in rural Haryana. Some elderly women still prefer to light the Chulha with dried cow dung or straw in the evening instead of using matches, considering it auspEnglis Leave aside the younger generation, they seem disinterested in traditional relationships. The purpose of the author's article is to suggest that you should cook on a traditional stove again. In my village, Kalayat in Kaithal district, I had the opportunity to sit with the 80-year-old elder Sultan Singh and his fellow villager Jaswant Singh. When the topic of stoves came up, Sultan Singh said that times have changed, but the importance of the stove remains the same. In every household, the stove should always keep burning, and the sun of good fortune should continue to shine.

Some might say that the author Dharmaveer Singh is stuck in the world of stoves. This is true to some extent, but don't forget that scientists who sent Chandrayaan to the moon and Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who has taken the nation to new

heights, also have some connection with the roti made on stoves, somewhere deep in their hearts. Many daughters like minister-scientists, Kalpana Chawla, have written inspiring history on the surface of the Earth.

We have grown up eating rotis made by our mothers on stoves. The main objective is to introduce the new generation to our tradition, to make them aware of the circumstances in which our elders made us educated and successful. We should not forget them so that the present and future generations learn from the social and moral values embedded in our culture and continue to be the torchbearers of culture in the country and society. In this regard, there is no two opinion that the importance of the stove will always remain, whether they are clay stoves or gas stoves. It is important that in modern times, the significance of matiyare (clay) stoves and hearths continues from east to west, north to south.

## New research: Snacking on almonds can support weight management

body of scientific evidence suggesting that almonds can improve diet quality

and aid in weight management. They may also support weight loss as part of a reduced-calorie diet among adults with overweight or obesity

The first study[1], published in Obesity and funded by the Almond Board of California, tracked 140 Australians aged 25-65 years with overweight or obesity for nine months. For the first three months of the study, the participants reduced their daily calories by 30% through either a nut-free or almond-enriched diet (with almonds providing 15% of their daily calorie needs, which is approximately 1.0-1.76 ounces/30-50 g). On both diets,

participants lost an average of 15 pounds (7 kg) and improved their lean body mass after three months. Moreover, they continued to lose weight about 2 pounds (approximately 1 kg), during the subsequent six months.

Participants who ate almonds also saw improvements in some lipoprotein subfractions (the different types of lipoproteins that carry cholesterol and triglycerides in the blood), which may reduce cardiovascular risks. Scientific evidence suggests but does not prove that eating 1.5 ounces per day of most nuts, as part of a diet low in saturated fat and cholesterol, may reduce the risk of heart disease. Future research should investigate different doses of almonds and test people with additional heart disease and diabetes risk factors, as the results are not generalizable to populations with chronic diseases

The second study was a 12-month study[2], published in the American Journal of Clinical Nutrition and also funded by the Almond Board of California, which found that almonds, when eaten long term as a snack, can improve overall diet quality without causing weight gain among healthy non-obese, habitual snacking adults in New Zealand. Half of the 136 participants were assigned to eat either 1.5 ounces (43 g) of almonds or 10% of their daily calorie needs (whichever was greater) while the remaining

participants in the control group consumed a caloriematched high-carbohydrate snack.


### Health of 50 people examined in heart check-up camp in Kirti Nagar


