LUCKNOW: Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) supremo on Sunday declared her nephew Akash Anand as her heir apparent, who will take up the reins of the party after her. Mayawati made the announcement during an all India meeting of BSP to discuss preparations for the Lok Sabha election next year

The meeting was attended by a large number of national as well fice-bearers According to party sources except Uttar Pradesh and Ut-



28-year-old Akash Anand will handle the party organisation in other states, specially in places where party organisation is weak. It may be noted that Akash Anand, who is son of Mayawati's younger brother Anand Kumar, is already working as the National Coordinator of BSP

Akash, who did his schooling from Gurugram, completed Masters in Business Management from London. He has been active in politics since 2017. In 2019, Akash Anand addressed his first rally in Uttar Pradesh's Agra. The BSP was then a part of the Mahagathbandhan, which was an anti-Congress and anti-BJP bloc formed in the run-up to the 2019 general election under the leadership of Akhilesh Yadav and Mayawati with Ajit Singh's Rashtriya Lok Dal. Earlier this year, in a major shift from the party's usual strategy of not organising padayatras, Akash Anand launched a 14-day 'Sarvajan Hitay, Sarvajan Sukhay' Sankalp Yatra, signalling a repositioning of the BSP's strategy ahead of the Assembly polls in Rajasthan and the crucial Lok Sabha polls next year

Gogamedi murder accused stayed in Chandigarh hotel on fake IDs, planned to go abroad

NEW DELHI: The two persons who allegedly shot Shri Rashtriya Rajput Karni Sena chief Sukhdev Singh Gogamedi in Jaipur were staying on fake IDs at a hotel in Chandigarh while on their run, Delhi Police said on Sunday. Sources said the duo -- Rohit Rathore of Jaipur and Nitin Fauji of Haryana's Mahendragarh -- had planned to flee the country and had been allegedly promised Bs 50,000 each to kill Gogamedi. The two alleged killers were nabbed by the teams of Delhi and Rajasthan police from Hotel Kamal Palace at Sector 24 in Chandigarh on Saturday night. They were accompanied by another associate Udham Singh who had allegedly provided them logistical support for evading arrest. "The trio have been taken to Jaipur by Rajasthan police for further interrogation," Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime) Amit Goel told news agency

Govt starts mass immunisation of livestock against foot and mouth disease

In order to prevent the occurrence of Foot & Mouth Disease (FMD) in the state, Punjab Animal Husbandry Department has started a mass immunisation drive of livestock. Disclosing this here today, Punjab Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and

Fisheries Minister S. Gurmeet Singh Khudian said that as many as 68,45,300 FMD vaccine doses have been procured under National Animal Disease Control Programme. A total of 48,73,277 FMD vaccine doses have already been administered covering around 75% of the livestock population so far under this drive, S. Gurmeet Singh Khudian said while adding that 100% livestock



population (around 65,03,505) will be vaccinated by December 20, 2023. The Cabinet Minister informed that this vaccine is totally free and the service of administring it is being provided by the staff of Punjab Animal Husbandry Department at the doorstep of the livestock/dairy farmers. The main objective of this immunisation drive is to protect our livestock from Foot & Mouth Disease, which has been recognized globally as a serious threat to the livestock population. In order to save the dairy farmer from the severe milk production losses as the FMD is a highly contagious viral disease of livestock that has a significant economic impact, the Cabinet Minister said while urging the state dairy farmers to reach out to their nearest veterinary institutions to get vaccinated their livestock to eradicate this contagious disease

Efforts on to improve overall energy efficiency in urban local bodies to 35-40%

CHANDIGARH, DEC 10

In a bid to improve overall energy efficiency in the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs), Punjab Energy Development Agency (PEDA) organised a technical workshop on "Energy Efficient Electrical Appliances" here at PEDA auditorium.

This workshop was organised under Municipal Demand Side Management program of Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), Ministry of Power, GoI with the coordination of stakeholder departments of Punjab include ULBs, Housing & Urban Development department, Development Authorities, PWD, Water Supply & Sanitation, Mandi Board, Punjab Health Systems Cor-

poration and PSPCL. Addressing the workshop, Chief Executive Officer PEDA Dr. Amarpal Singh emphasised on the importance of energy efficiency & implementation of new and innovative energy efficient technologies in Buildings, Industries & Municipalities in the State. He said that Municipal Demand Side Management (MuDSM) is the program aimed at improving overall energy efficiency of the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) to the tune of 35-40%. The main focus on energy efficiency in ULBs is on street lighting, buildings & water pumping. The MuDSM is described as the planning, implementation and monitoring of utility activities (beyond the con-

sumer meter) designed to

encourage customers to amend their electricity consumption patterns, both with respect to timing and level of electricity demand so as to help the customers, to use electricity more efficiently. The energy directly impacts the living conditions of residents and savings can be used for other purpose works, he added. Director PEDA Mr. M.P. Singh explained about the efforts of MuDSM being the top performer in the country for reducing T&D losses from 14 per cent to 12.05 per cent in the State. He deliberated upon the continuous efforts to translate energy sector strategies into actionable low-carbon solutions driven by PEDA to increase the utilisation of clean and lowcarbon energy in the State.



Farmers incurring loss of Rs 10,000 per acre due to falling pea prices: Lahoria



JANDIALA GURU (KULJIT SINGH): At present, the season of pea crop is going on and it is produced on a large scale, especially in Majha. From here, peas are sent to Haryana, Delhi, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat. Due to this, traders outside here purchase peas. Do it with farmers. While last week the wholesale price of peas was Rs 25 to Rs 30 per kg, now the wholesale price has come down to Rs 12 per kg. While talking to farmer Baljinder Singh, resident of Jandiala, he said that he had sown 4 acres of pea crop.

Today, he got one acre of pea crop plucked. In which only an average of 10 to 12 quintals were obtained from the acre. He told that per acre, pea seeds cost Rs 12 thousand, 2 bags of fertilizer cost Rs 2600, 3 bags of urea fertilizer. Price is around Rs 1 thousand, spray medicine is Rs 3 thousand, total cost is around Rs 20 thousand per acre. Whereas the labor of plucking pea crop is Rs 4 per kg. In this way, the cost to them is Rs 20 thousand per acre while their sales From this we get about Rs 10 thousand. Due to which they are incurring a loss of Rs 10 thousand per acre.

Editorial Marginal figure

few days ago, I attended a programme to felicitate one of my old teachers from Presidency College Professor Mihir Rakshit, an outstanding scholar and a wonderful teacher. There, I was surprised at the presence of a large number of his former students who had not met him since they had left college. They are not academics. They must have forgotten everything that Professor Rakshit had taught. Yet they came to pay their respects. It must have been due to a mix of awe and admiration. Professor Rakshit must have left a mark on their minds over and above the lessons of macroeconomics. When his turn came to speak, Professor Rakshit kept it short, mentioning that he had learnt much more from his brilliant students over the years than they had ever learnt from him. Professor Rakshit belongs to the old school. He is very well read, much beyond the confines of his expertise in macroeconomics. He used to spend 10 hours in his office at college without fail, at least six days a week. His lectures were heavy and often difficult to follow if one had not gone through the assigned readings for the class. At the end of the programme, I wondered: would there ever be the likes of Mihir Rakshit again?

I had been extremely fortunate to come across quite a few outstanding teachers in school, college and university. They were outstanding in distinctly different ways. Quite a few instances come to mind. One professor had the rare ability to stimulate the best in the class to read and think further on the subject of his lecture while ensuring that the weakest in the class understood and appreciated the basics. This was, indeed, a remarkable quality. I had another professor who was extremely erudite but disorganised in the class. He would create an imaginary critic and bring him down in angry monologues. But in his seemingly chaotic lecture, he would dwell on a thought that would suddenly appear as a bright ray of light that made me see things in a different way. I would not miss his class ever. There were other teachers who demanded that you come prepared to class and, if you did, they would take you down great depths of the topic that textbooks hardly ventured into. I had another teacher who would, after making an elegant mathematical presentation of the subject, encourage us to be prepared to convince the janitor of the importance of the matter presented if he were to walk into the class. They all had one thing in common: they encouraged us to think beyond the confines of the syllabus or the textbook, often even beyond the confines of the subject, to doubt and question. To put it succinctly: it was about learning how to learn.

Neck muscle inflammation primary cause of headache: Study

R esearchers disclosed genuine proof of how the neck muscles are implicated in primary headaches in a study presented at the annual meeting of the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA). The findings could lead to improved treat-

The distinct underlying causes of derstood. The most common primary headaches are tension-type headaches and migraines.

'Our imaging approach provides first objective evidence for the very frequent involvement of the neck muscles in primary headaches, such as neck pain in migraine or tension-type headache, using the ability to quantify subtle in-flammation within muscles," said Nico Sollmann, M.D., Ph.D., resident in the Department of Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology at University Hospital Ulm, and the Department of Diagnostic and Interventional Neuroradiology at University Hospital Rechts der Isar in Munich, Germany.

Tension-type headaches affect two out of every three adults in the U.S. People with tension-type headaches often feel a tightening in the head and mild to moderate dull pain on both sides of the head. While these headaches are typically associated with stress and muscle tension, their exact origin is not fully understood. Migraines are characterized by a severe throbbing pain. Migraines generally occur on one side of



the head, or the pain is worse on one side. Migraines may also cause nausea, weakness and light sensitivity. According to the American Migraine Foundation, over 37 million people in the U.S. are affected by migraine, and up to 148 million people worldwide suffer from chronic migraine.

Neck pain is commonly associated with primary headaches. However, no objective biomarkers exist for myofascial involvement. Myofascial pain is associated with inflammation or irritation of muscle or of the connective tissue, known as fascia, that surrounds the muscle. For the study, Dr. Sollmann and colleagues aimed to investigate the involvement of the trapezius muscles in primary headache disorders by quantitative magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) and to explore associations between muscle T2 values and headache and neck pain frequency.

Kuwait expresses regret over US veto on Gaza ceasefire resolution

uwaiti Foreign Minister Sheikh Salem Abdullah Al-Jaber Al-Sabah expressed on Saturday his country's deep regret over the use of the veto in the United Nations Security Council against a resolution calling for an immediate ceasefire in the Gaza Strip and the rescue of the deteriorating humanitarian situation.

Inited Nati Council session on Friday, a resolution calling for an "immediate humanitarian ceasefire in the Gaza Strip", which was proposed by the United Arab Emirates and widely supported internationally, failed to pass. Among the 15 Security Council member states, 13 voted in favor of the resolution, Britain abstained and the United States used its veto.

Sheikh Salem Al-Sabah emphasized that "a ceasefire and the protection of civilians in the Gaza Strip are urgent humanitarian demands that must be achieved as soon as possible, pointing out that he fears "failure to pass the resolution will be considered a new license for the occupying forces to continue their killings, destruction, and displacement of the Palestinian people." The minister also expressed serious concern about the Security Council's failure to respond to the warning from the United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres to invoke Article 99 of the UN Charter. Through this article, the Secretary-General drew the attention of the Council to the fact that what is happening threatens humanitarian order and the collapse of international peace and




security. Sheikh Salem Al-Sabah reiterated his firm position, calling for continued political and diplomatic efforts to meet the

humanitarian needs of Palestinian civilians. Israel has been launching massive airstrikes and a ground offensive in Gaza in response to the Hamas Oct. 7 surprise attack on Israel that killed around 1,200 and in which over 200 were taken hostage. On Tuesday evening, the Hamas-run government media office in Gaza said that the Palestinian death toll had risen to 16,248 as a result of Israel's attacks on the Gaza Strip.



The proponents of this diet claim that you can lose weight by eating foods high in fats and proteins, and avoiding food high in carbs. Atkins diet has been designed by physician Dr Robert C. Atkins, after

whose name the diet is named. His book on the same was also the best-selling diet book in 1972. Although being high in fat, this diet does not raise the LDL (bad cholesterol), though this may happen in some individuals.

Another main reason behind people losing weight through this diet is when people reduce carbohydrate intake and eat more protein, their diet automatically



goes down and thus, they end up consuming fewer calories without even realising.

The 4 phases of Atkins diet

1. Phase 1 (Induction): This phase includes eating under 20 grams of fat every day for two weeks. Highfat, high-protein and low-carb vegetables like leafy green vegetables give your weight loss programme a

2. Phase 2 (Balancing): Start adding more nuts, low carb vegetables and small amounts of fruits back to your diet after 2 weeks.

3. Phase 3 (Fine-tuning): When you feel you are closer to your goal, you can add more carbs to your diet until your weight loss slows down. 4. Phase 4 (Maintenance): You can bring back the

healthy carbs in your diet.

Here's a list of foods that you should avoid when you are on Atkins diet Sugar: Candy, ice-cream, cakes, fruit juices

and soft drinks

- Vegetable oils: Soybean, corn, canola and cottonseed oil should be avoided

- Grains: Wheat, rye, barley and rice - Trans-fat: Fats found in processed food High-carb vegetable: Carrots, turnips (avoid during the induction phase)

- High-carb fruits: Bananas, apples, pears grapes, oranges (avoid during induction

- Potatoes, sweet potatoes, lentils, chickpea, beans should also be avoided during the induction period Food to eat



RCB, known for its Play Bold philosophy, not only snatched players who are good with the ball but also those who are skilful with the bat as well.



Actors Ranveer Singh and Vaani Kapoor starrer romantic comedy film 'Befikre' turned 7 on Saturday.


To mark the occasion, Vaani took to her Ins-
