Kejriwal refuses to appear before ED for 3rd time

NEW DELHI: Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal will skip the Enforcement Directorate (ED) summons in the Delhi Excise Policy case for the third time on Wednesday. Addressing a press conference here on Wednesday, Delhi Health Minister and AAP leader Saurabh Bharadwaj said the summons by ED are illegal and politically motivated. Bharadwaj also questioned the timing of the notice. He said, "At a time when the Lok Sabha elections are near, the BJP is using ED to stop Arvind Kejriwal from campaigning and put him in jail." He said despite the party seeking clarification from the ED on what capacity Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal was being called, Bharadwaj added, "The Delhi Chief Minister is neither an accused nor a witness." The AAP leader said, "For almost one year, Manish Sisodia has been in jail, and the ED has not yet gathered any evidence against him."

SC declines to order SIT or CBI probe in Adani-Hindenburg row

AGENCY NEW DELHI, JAN 3

In a relief to the Adani group of companies, the Supreme Court on Wednesday declined to transfer the probe from Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) to a Special Investigation Team (SIT) or CBI into the Adani-Hindenburg issue over allegations of stock price manipulation by the Indian corporate giant. A bench of Chief Justice of India D Y Chandrachud, PS Pardiwala and Manoj Misra said the scope of power of the apex court to enter into the regulatory domain of SEBI is limited. It said the scope of judicial review is only to see whether any fundamental right has been violated. The SC said the facts of the case do not warrant the transfer of the probe to the SIT or other agency. The SC also said there was no material to doubt the investigation carried out by the SEBI. The verdict of the top court came on a batch of petitions seeking a court-monitored investigation or CBI probe into the allegations made by US-based firm Hindenburg Research against the Adani group



Apex court stays Himachal Pradesh HC order to shift DGP Sanjay Kundu

NEW DELHI: A bench of Chief Justice of India D Y Chandrachud and Justices J B Pardiwala and Manoj Misra asked the high court to decide senior IPS officer Kundu's application for recall within two weeks. Kundu was removed on Tuesday from the post of Himachal DGP and posted as principal secretary, Ayush. The bench said that Kundu's posting as Ayush principal secretary should not be given effect to for now. Considering a plea by Kundu, the court noted that the high court will hear the case on Thursday and the principal grievance is that the high court ordered DGP's transfer without hearing him or having him impleaded in the case. "Till a decision on the petitioner's recall application, the high court order on transfer shall remain stayed. Since the petitioner's new posting is pursuant to the impugned order of the high court, no steps shall be taken," the bench, said. Senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi for the DGP questioned the high court's order to shift him to ensure that he didn't influence the probe into the alleged harassment of Palampur businessman Nishant Sharma. He said Kundu was set to retire in less than four months and an adverse order of the present nature would blemish his 35-year-long career.

The top court asked SEBI to complete within three months its probe into two cases pending out of 24 cases. The case is related to the allegations (part of a report by short-seller Hindenberg Research) that Adani had inflated its share prices.

Water charges for rural households waived off in Haryana

BUREAU CHANDIGARH, JAN 3

In a landmark decision aimed at providing substantial relief to rural households, the Haryana Cabinet, led by Chief Minister Sh. Manohar Lal, has approved the waiver of outstanding water charges, including surcharge and interest, amounting to Rs 372.13 crore. This move is set to benefit crores of water consumers in general categories and Scheduled Castes across the state. An announcement to this effect was made by Chief Minister Sh. Manohar Lal during a Jan Samvad held at Ateli Mandi in the Mahendergarh district. This decision will extend relief to a substantial 28.87 lakh water connection holders in rural areas across the state. However, this waiver does not extend to institutional, commercial, or industrial consumers falling under the Public Health Engineering department. The Cabinet has approved the waiver of water charges amounting to Rs 336.35 crore, accumulated from April 1, 2015, to December 31, 2022, for all types of consumers in villages and rural areas. This encompasses general category as well as Scheduled Castes categories. In addition, the Cabinet has accorded approval for the waiver of surcharge and interest totaling Rs 37.93 crore on



Financial Assistance to individuals suffering from rare diseases

CHANDIGARH: Haryana Cabinet met under the Chairmanship of Chief Minister, Sh. The National Policy for Rare Diseases 2021 identifies 55 rare diseases, causing undue financial strain and societal impact. With an estimated 1000 patients currently suffering from these rare diseases in Haryana, the government aims to alleviate the economic burden faced by affected individuals and their families. This compassionate initiative was announced by Chief Minister on May 11 2023, during the inaugural function at Civil Hospital, Yamuna Nagar.

Soren to remain Jharkhand CM

RANCHI : Legislators of the ruling coalition partners in Jharkhand on Wednesday expressed solidarity with the Hemant Soren government and said the JMM leader will continue as the state chief minister. Coming out from the meeting held here to discuss the present political scenario in the backdrop of the ED's summons to Soren, the lawmakers said they stand united and "solidly" behind Soren and there is no threat to the present government. Senior JMM leader, Mithlesh Thakur, who holds the drinking water and sanitation portfolio, said Soren will continue as the chief minister and JMM will contest the 2024 Lok Sabha and state Assembly polls under his leadership. The meeting was chaired by Soren himself. "The MLAs of the coalition parties are united, there is no threat to the present government. There was no talk of any change in the leadership in the state," a legislator said after the meeting. Soren, the 48-year-old executive president of JMM, has been in the eye of a political storm since the Enforcement Directorate summoned him in connection with its probe into an office-of-profit case.

Punjab signs MoU with Kuantum Papers for boosting water conservation efforts

In a bid to bolster water conservation and management efforts, the Punjab Government today inked a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Kuantum Papers Ltd. The agreement, signed between the Department of Soil and Water Conservation, Punjab and the Hoshiarpur-based paper company, took place in the presence of S. Chetan Singh Jauramajra Minister for Soil and Water Conservation, Punjab. Highlighting the commitment of Chief Minister S. Bhagwant Singh Mann led government to preserving natural resources, the Cabinet Minister said that this groundbreaking partnership with a private sector entity is the first of its kind. This collaboration

will facilitate the company's support and financing for the state's water conservation and management initiatives. S. Chetan Singh Jauramajra remarked that this unique initiative will bolster the private sector's involvement in the state's water conservation for the first time. While welcoming the partnership, the Cabinet Minister stated, "it will significantly boost the government's water conservation programs and lay the groundwork for future public-private collaborations." The Soil and Water Conservation Minister outlined that under this MoU, the company will provide funding for both new and ongoing projects related to water resource conservation and management through the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds or specifically allocated funds.

Union govt issues guidelines for ICU admissions

AGENCY NEW DELHI, JAN 3

The Government of India has come up with guidelines for hospitals on ICU admissions and directed that hospitals cannot admit critically ill patients in the ICU without the consent of the patient and family. According to the latest guidelines, patients who are critically ill should not be admitted to an ICU if they do not give their consent. "Critically ill patients should not be admitted to the ICU; if Patient's or next-of-kin informed refusal to be admitted in ICU." The guidelines have also men-

tioned that the specialist in ICU should also have specific qualifications. The Intensivist should have a postgraduate qualification in Internal Medicine, Anaesthesia, Pulmonary Medicine, Emergency Medicine, or General Surgery with either of the following "An additional qualification in Intensive Care such as DM Critical Care/Pulmonary Critical Care, DNB/FNB Critical Care (National Board of Examinations), Certificate Courses in Critical Care of the ISCCM (IDCCM and IFCCM), Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Critical Care (PDCC/Fellowship) from an NMC



recognised University, or equivalent qualifications from abroad such as

the American Board Certification, Australian or New Zealand Fellowship (FANZCA or FFICANZCA), UK (CCT dual recognition), or equivalent from Canada." "At least one-year training in a reputed ICU abroad. A few candidates of the ISCCM Certificate Course (CTCCM) who have been certified with a 3-year training programme in Intensive Care after M.B.B.S. are also recognised as Intensivists. In addition, persons so qualified or trained must have at least two-years' experience in ICU (at least 50% time spent in the ICU)."

Leopard enters residential area in Gurugram, injures one

A leopard strayed into Narsinghpur village in Gurugram on Wednesday morning. The leopard was later tranquilized by the forest officials in the afternoon and taken away. "The leopard was given two doses of tranquilizer at 11:30 am and 11.45 am. and brought under control," forest officials said. The Forest department team later arrived to catch the leopard. Gurugram Police team also reached the spot. A village youth was injured by the leopard. The leopard hid in the hall of a house in the village. The ongoing conflict between humans and wild-



life animals in urban areas has reached a worrying state. The growing rate of tigers and leopards and their entry towards residential settlements are becoming a cause of concern.

Supertech's RK Arora moves trial court in Delhi with interim bail plea on health grounds

Supertech's chairman and promoter, R K Arora, has moved Delhi's Court seeking grants of interim bail for a period of 90 days on medical and health grounds in relation to a money laundering case. The plea, moved by Arora, stated that he was referred by the jail authorities to Government Hospital Dr Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, wherein the applicant was examined and prescribed various treatments. However, it has been observed by the concerned doctors at Dr Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital that the applicant, accused, is not showing signs of improvement. The applicant is immediately required to be released on interim bail to ensure that his ailments are accurately diagnosed and that effective and adequate medical treatment is provided to him urgently. In case the applicant's health is compromised further while in custody, he and his family will suffer intolerable and irreparable consequences, as stated in the plea. Plea further submitted that prisons provide medical facilities but the services are not comparable to or equivalent to the level of treatment and care one can avail from



private hospitals. The facilities in the jail are of a general nature and character, which is inadequate to monitor the proper health of the applicant, who is suffering from multiple serious ailments. The jail is not equipped to provide the special and intensive treatment and care that the applicant is in need of. The matter was listed for hearing on Wednesday, later adjourned for January 5, 2024 for hearing. Earlier, the trial court took cognizance of the prosecution complaint (chargesheet) filed by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) against him and others and also issued summons to all accused named in the chargesheet and firms through their representatives. ED's Special Public Prosecutors Naveen Kumar Matta, Manish Jain and Mohd Faizan have appeared in the matter before the court.

day. Explaining the rationale behind this initiative, Chief Minister Sh. Manohar Lal informed that the shrinking landholding in Haryana, largely due to industrialization and other developmental activities has prompted the government to explore alternative avenues for the state's agricultural community. Drawing inspiration from successful farming ventures in Madhya Pradesh and other states, Haryana will also replicate this success on an international scale. Responding to a question, the Chief Minister said that state government is committed to curbing the illicit transportation of youth to foreign nations for placement. To facilitate lawful opportunities for interested

individuals, the government has established the Foreign Cooperation Department and the Overseas Placement Cell. These entities are responsible for coordinating the placement of youth seeking opportunities abroad. Comprehensive training for such individuals is conducted through HKRN. In response to a request from Israel, we initiated advertisement, resulting in 4000 youth expressing interest in foreign employment. To ensure their preparedness, these individuals will undergo training at MDU, Rohtak. A subsequent advertisement is scheduled around January 15 to encourage legal pathways for our youth to seek opportunities abroad, he added.

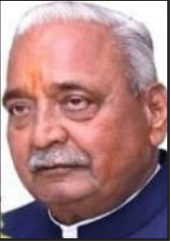

State witnesses net 16.52 pc growth in GST and 10.4 pc growth in Excise: Cheema

Punjab Finance, Planning, Excise, and Taxation Minister Advocate Harpal Singh Cheema on Wednesday said that the state has witnessed a net 16.52 percent growth rate in revenue from Goods and Services Tax (GST) and a 10.4 percent increase in revenue from Excise up to December in the current fiscal year (FY) as compared to FY 2022-23.

Disclosing this in a press release issued here, Finance Minister Harpal Singh Cheema said that the net GST collection up to December in FY 2023-24 was Rs. 15523.74 crore against the net GST collection of Rs. 13322.59 crore during the same period in the FY 2022-23. Thus, the net increase in GST collection amounts to Rs. 2201.15 crore, he added.

Adding further, the Finance Minister said that the revenue from Excise up to December in FY 2022-23 was Rs. 6050.7 crore, whereas, for the current fiscal year it rose to Rs. 6679.84 crore registering an increase of Rs. 629.14 crore. Revealing the figures of state's own tax revenue, Harpal Singh Cheema said that Punjab achieved a growth rate of 14.15 percent in total revenue from VAT, CST, GST, PSDT, and Excise up to December during the current fiscal year as compared to FY 2022-23. He said that revenue from VAT, CST, and PSDT reflects a



growth rate of 12 percent, 26.8 percent, and 5.24 percent respectively. He said that the state's total own tax revenue during the last 9 months was Rs 27931.16 crore against Rs 24468.14 crore collected during the same period in the year 2022. Reiterating the Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann led

He said that the SGPC will take firm action against the murderers of Jathedar Gurdev Singh Kaunke.

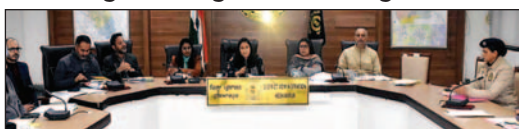

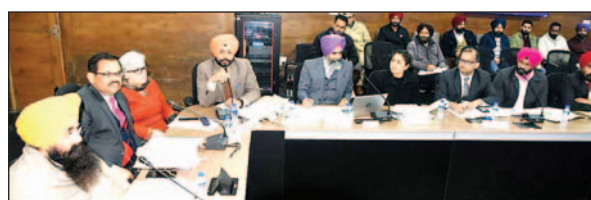

Ideology’s assault

Donald Trump has declared that if he claims the White House this year, he will create an “American Academy”. He will fund it by raising “billions and billions of dollars” from “taxing, fining and suing excessively large private university endowments” to “compete directly” with “very costly” four-year universities. The vicious ideological wars around the Israel-Palestine conflict and their resonant echoes through legislatures, endowment trusts and university leadership are Trump’s immediate context but he has made no secret of the fact that his plan behind this American Academy is to create an antidote to ‘woke’ universities driven by a political awareness foregrounded by the humanities and the social sciences.

With the world’s most powerful cloud computing investors waiting predatorily to monetise the next big leap in the development of Artificial Intelligence and teachers in high schools and colleges struggling with a flood of ChatGPT-aided student work, the future of the humanities, along with human resources on the whole, has become open to many difficult questions. But deep hostilities around educational curriculum and campus activism have made it clear that identity and ideology, the shaping forces behind the humanities, are looming larger than ever worldwide and, in fact, have started to play greater roles than the force of hard data and science in our bizarrely post-truth era. What this implies is that even if and when the means of persuasion and communication are taken over by AI, the end and the goal will remain firmly rooted in real human subjectivities. These are the subjectivities we seek for our private and public selves and, crucially, the identity that we seek to pass on to posterity through teaching, curricula, educational policy, and in the work we publish on academic and public forums.

In the two worlds I’ve known well — in India and in the United States of America — I’ve experienced the adaptation and the exclusion of identities, both conscious and unconscious, in research and teaching in the humanities in many direct and indirect ways. Being on the margin in one situation — a brown non-Westerner — has sharpened my consciousness of privilege in the other as an educated, urban, upper caste Hindu man. In the US, the previous edition of this battle seemed to be about culture wars — whether the opening of the canon was brought about by the closing of the American mind or by the dread of the onslaught of mediocrity in the name of multiculturalism. The sanctity of the canon has doubtless mutated over the last few decades, as have the tone, pitch, and locus of the culture wars.

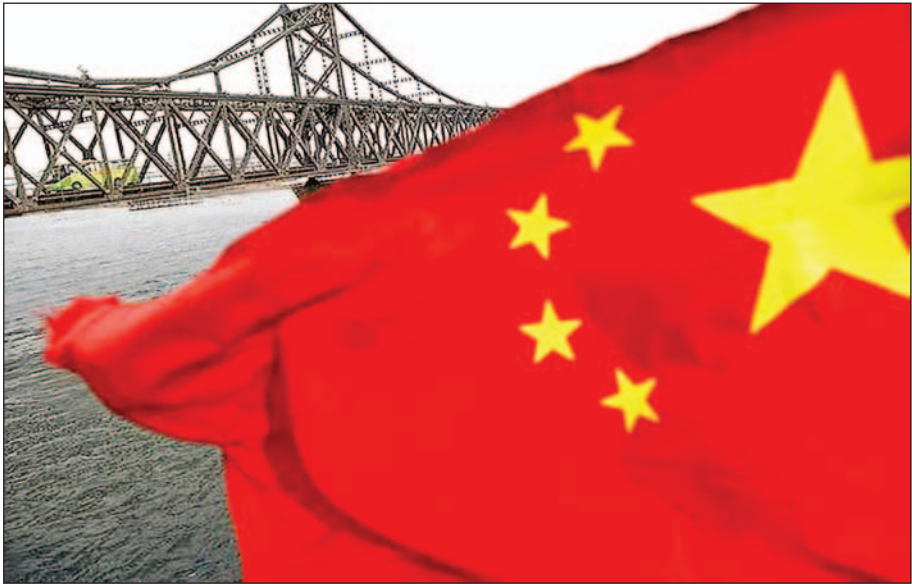
China mediating between Myanmar junta, ethnic rebels mainly due to self-interest

Regional experts believe China's efforts to mediate between the Myanmar junta and ethnic rebels on its northern border are motivated mainly by self-interest. However, Beijing's efforts will unlikely have a significant effect on the conflict, VOA News reported.

According to the experts, China's goals in convening the peace talk between the military and the Three Brotherhood Alliance, held most recently in Kunming on December 20, is two-fold. Experts believe China is making efforts to eliminate cyberfraud operations victimising Chinese citizens and to stabilise trade across the China-Myanmar border. In an interview, Yun Sun, director of the China program at the Stimson Center, said, "So, the economic interest or the border trade is being affected, that is for sure." Yun Sun said, "But that is a minor consideration compared to the cyber campaign. ... The sooner it can be completed, the sooner the cease-fire is, and the sooner the stability can be restored."

The armed conflict between the Myanmar junta and ethnic groups has caused a daily loss of about USD 10 million in bilateral trade between China and Myanmar, according to veteran Myanmar domestic political analyst Than Soe Naing. He said this loss is more damaging for Myanmar than China.

He said, "The flow of goods from the border region is not much compared to China's international economic relations. Our country suffers more." Beijing has taken care to be evenhanded in its statements regarding the talks, as per its public policy of solving problems and pursuing stability in the region through dialogue, VOA News reported. In a statement on December 28, Chinese Foreign Ministry said Beijing "hopes that relevant parties in Myanmar will exercise maximum restraint, actively ease the situation on the ground, together realize the soft landing of



the situation in northern Myanmar and take concrete actions to protect the safety and security of Chinese projects and personnel in Myanmar."

Yun Sun said China's main concern is not to address the issue of territorial control between the military council and ethnic forces in Myanmar. However, China wants to crack down on cyber scams located on the China-Myanmar border. It has been challenging for China.

The anti-junta People's Defense Forces movement has gained momentum since a major offensive in late October, taking over significant amounts of area in the north, VOA News reported. Both analysts believe that the Myanmar junta is now on the defensive and more likely to support a ceasefire. However, Than Soe Naing said the rebels

will continue their offensive and that fighting is likely to intensify throughout northern Shan State.

He said, "China will sit and watch over the issue of who will win between the Military Council versus Spring Revolution forces in Myanmar." He noted China will "come to whoever takes power in Burma" and will cooperate with the forces of whoever wins. However, according to their current practicing international diplomacy position, they will not take sides in this conflict. China will cooperate with whoever is in power.

Even if there is a change in power, China will continue to cooperate with the new one in power," according to the report.

He said China does not want external interference in the Myanmar issue. He said, "I believe China will continue to prevent the involvement of Western democratic forces in these issues in various ways."

In 2023, an alliance of rebel forces in war-torn Myanmar took several key towns from the Myanmar military regime, The New York Times reported. The early successes of the alliance's campaign, which began in Shan State in October last year, encouraged resistance forces in other parts of Myanmar, which have also taken control of several towns. Notably, Shan State is Myanmar's largest state, covering almost one-fourth of the country.

The offensive began on October 27 after three ethnic armies - the Myanmar National Democratic Alliance Army, the Ta'ang National Liberation Army and the Arakan Army announced "Operation 1027." The rebels, which call themselves the Brotherhood Alliance, opened fire on the military and captured trucks and weapons, according to videos posted on social media.

Earlier in November, the People's Defence Forces said it had taken control of Kawlin, a town in the region of Upper Sagaing, and Khampat, a town in the west. Meanwhile, Karenni resistance forces said they have taken control of three military outposts in Mese, The New York Times reported. For two years, the various armed ethnic groups, which have fought against the army for decades, and the People's Defence Forces have combined forces, and they now control large parts of the countryside, according to The New York Times report. However, these groups have operated autonomously and are fragmented throughout Myanmar. The resistance movement has been encouraged by the successes of the Brotherhood Alliance.

Baloch protesters vow to continue protests

The Pakistan caretaker Prime Minister Anwarul-haq-Kakar on Tuesday termed the ongoing Baloch protest against alleged extrajudicial killings in the province as 'irresponsible' and 'provocative', Dawn News reported.

It reported that Kakar, in a press conference on the issues of Balochistan at Lahore's central business district, said that those who are supporting the Baloch protest could go join the "Baloch militants". "Advocates of terrorists in Balochistan should go and join them if they are convinced on the veracity of their issue and fight the state along with them, so that we know where they stand and how to deal with them," he said, alluding to rights activists and journalists standing with the Baloch marchers.

Responding to the media on the issue of police violence against Baloch protesters in Islamabad, the caretaker premier said that some of the people--media persons included--were trying to "mislead everyone, turning themselves into fake heroes of human rights and damaging the state".

The caretaker PM also insisted that those protesting in Islamabad were the "relatives of those fighting against the state" in Balochistan. He, however, added that the state had a beef with militant outfits, not the Baloch people, Dawn News reported. "We still respect their right to protest because their dear and near ones disappeared. But they should also know that they [militants] were



fighting against the state. It is an armed rebellion, with foreign help," he said.

Kakar said those trying to create human rights issues out of the use of water cannons against protesters should also explain who is killing common people in Balochistan. "Who is engaged in armed mutiny against the state of Pakistan? I am sure if these so-called advocates go to Balochistan, they would be killed as well. But please, go and join the BLF or BLA so that the state knows where you stand. The state is clear on how to deal with this menace. Please clarify your position," he demanded. This triggered strong criticism from the Baloch protesters, who later reiterated their intention to continue their protest until their demands will be accepted by the government. Mahrang Baloch, the face of the Baloch movement, reiterated the call to continue the ongoing protest and said that they are ready to make all kinds of sacrifices for the cause.

Tomato plants use their roots to ration water during drought

Plants must be adaptable in order to withstand environmental changes, and the adaptive strategies they employ must frequently be as variable as the changes in climate and conditions to which they adapt. Plant roots create a water-repellent polymer called suberin in response to drought, which prevents water from moving up towards the leaves, where it would soon evaporate. The consequent water loss would be equivalent to leaving the tap running without suberin.

Endodermal cells that line the capillaries inside the roots of some plants produce suberin. Suberin is produced in exodermal cells directly below the epidermis of the root in some plants, such as tomatoes.

The purpose of exodermal suberin has long been unknown, but a new study published in Nature Plants by researchers at the University of California, Davis demonstrates that it fulfills the same function as endodermal suberin and that tomato plants are less able to cope with water stress without it. This knowledge could aid scientists in developing drought-resistant crops.

"This adds exodermal suberin to our toolbox of ways to help plants survive for longer and cope with drought," said Siobhan Brady, professor in the UC Davis Department of Plant Biology and Genome Center, and senior author on the paper. "It's almost like a jigsaw puzzle--if you can figure out which cells have modifications that protect the plant during difficult environmental conditions, you can start to ask questions like, if you build those defenses



up one upon the other, does it make the plant stronger?"

In the new study, postdoctoral scholar Alex Canto-Pastor worked with Brady and an international team of collaborators to uncover the role of exodermal suberin and map the genetic pathways that regulate its production.

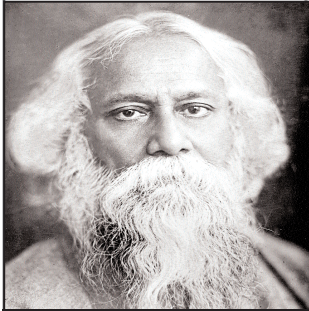
"It's the merging of classical and cutting-edge methodology that lets us look at both the process that's happening in an individual cell and what you see in the whole plant," said Brady.

"So going from super small to big." Brady, Canto-Pastor and colleagues started by identifying all of the genes that are actively used by root exodermal cells. Then they performed gene editing to create mutant strains of tomato plants that lacked functional versions of several genes they suspected might be involved in suberin production.

Research suggests healthy omega-3 fats may slow deadly pulmonary fibrosis

Could the good fats contained in nuts and fish help to reduce the course of potentially lethal lung scarring known as pulmonary fibrosis and so delay the need for lung transplants?

UVA pulmonary researchers looked at the association between blood-plasma levels of omega-3 fatty acids - the heart-healthy fats found in foods such as salmon and flaxseeds - and the progression of pulmonary fibrosis, as well as how long patients could go without needing a transplant. The researchers found that higher levels of omega-3 were associated with better lung function and longer transplant-free survival. While more research is needed, the researchers say their findings warrant clinical trials to determine if interventions that raise omega-3 levels could be a useful tool to improve outcomes for patients with pulmonary fibrosis and other chronic lung diseases.

"We found that higher levels of omega-3 fatty acids in the blood, which reflects several weeks of dietary intake, were linked to better lung function and longer survival," said researcher John Kim, MD, a pulmonary and critical care expert at UVA Health and the University of Virginia School of Medicine. "Our findings suggest omega-3 fatty



acids might be a targetable risk factor in pulmonary fibrosis."

Omega-3 and Pulmonary Fibrosis
Omega-3 fatty acids have already been linked to a

host of health benefits. Studies have suggested, for example, that they may lower the risk of heart disease, stroke-causing blood clots, breast cancer and other cancers, Alzheimer's disease and dementia. Kim and his colleagues wanted to determine if omega-3s could play a protective role in interstitial lung disease, a group of chronic lung diseases that can lead to pulmonary fibrosis. A growing problem around the world, pulmonary fibrosis is an irreversible condition that leaves the lungs unable to exchange oxygen and carbon dioxide properly. This can cause patients to become short of breath, weak, unable to exercise and a host of other symptoms. Smoking is a major risk factor.

The researchers looked at anonymized data on patients with interstitial lung disease collected in the Pulmonary Fibrosis Foundation Registry, as well as information volunteered by patients at UVA Health and the University of Chicago. In total, the scientists reviewed information on more than 300 people with interstitial lung disease. Most were men (pulmonary fibrosis is more common in men than women), and most suffered from "idiopathic" pulmonary fibrosis, one of the conditions that fall under the banner of interstitial lung disease. The re-

searchers found that higher levels of omega-3 fatty acids in the blood plasma were associated with better ability to exchange carbon dioxide and longer survival without the need for a lung transplant. This did not vary much regardless of smoking history or whether the patients had cardiovascular disease.

"Higher levels of omega-3 fatty acids were predictive of better clinical outcomes in pulmonary fibrosis," Kim said. "These findings were consistent whether you had a history of cardiovascular disease, which suggests this may be specific to pulmonary fibrosis."

The doctors say additional research is needed to understand just how omega-3s could be having this protective benefit. They are calling for clinical trials and more mechanistic studies to obtain additional insights and determine if omega-3 fatty acid drugs or dietary changes could improve patient outcomes.

"We need further research to determine if there are specific omega-3 fatty acids that may be beneficial and, if so, what are their underlying mechanisms," Kim said. "Similar to other chronic diseases, we hope to determine whether nutrition related interventions can have a positive impact on pulmonary fibrosis."

Beneficial yoga asanas for a good night's sleep

When it comes to sleep there are various reasons for not being able to get a proper one, at the proper time; stress, electronic devices, afternoon naps, depression, caffeine and alcohol is the most common causes. Doing yoga asanas for sleep will counter these problems and ensure you get a good night's rest. Try these sleep-inducing yoga asanas to get into a proper sleep routine and help you relax and rejuvenate before a new day.

(Standing Forward Bend)

Start with arms raised overhead and come into a forward fold by gliding your arms down. This is commonly referred to as a Swan Dive. Next, ensure your fingers clasp your heels. Bend the knees without locking them or injuring yourself. The more you contract and draw up your quadriceps muscles, the more your hamstrings will open. Inhale and raise your hands to your hips to release. Gradually lift by pressing your tailbone down and contracting your abdominal muscles.

Halasana (Plow Pose)

Start by lying flat on your back and stretching your feet in the opposite direction until they reach the floor. Use a pillow or rolled-up towel for support if you're a newbie. Resting your hands on your lower back is a fine decision. Hold the position for 45-60 seconds. Roll your spine back to the surface and elevate your legs to a 90-degree angle to release. Return your legs to the mat in a systematic manner.

Balasana (Child Pose)

Kneel on your hands and knees on the floor. Spread your knees out, keeping the tops of your toes on the floor and your big toes touching. Rest your forehead on the mat and lay your



undersurface between your thighs. Relax every muscle in your body. Stretch your arms out in front of you, palms down on the floor, or bring them back alongside your

thighs. Stay in this position for two minutes, focusing on regular inhalation and exhalation to reconnect with your breath.

Salabhasana (Locust Pose)

Inhale to get into a plank position, then lower your body to the ground. Clasp your hands together behind your back. Exhale and lower your feet to the ground while you take in a deep breath and raise your chest and arms as high as you can while gazing forward. Allow your hands to slide down and exhale as you return to the downward-facing dog from the locust pose.

Siddhasana (Adept's Pose)

Sit with your legs wide open. Insert the heel of the right leg under the perineum by bending the leg. Lay the right sole flat against the inner left thigh with the navel seated on top of the right heel. Bend your left leg and cross your left ankle over your right.

Siraj's magical spell was completed with a whole ball outside off. Siraj's sixth wicket came in his ninth over, when Verreynne attempted to drive and was caught by a second slip off the outside edge.

ICC Player Rankings: Virat Kohli surges into top 10 in Test rankings

DUBAI: India's batting talisman Virat Kohli started the new year on a good note as he re-entered the top 10 in the ICC Test rankings, climbing to ninth position, the International Cricket Council (ICC) announced the latest ranking update on Wednesday.
"Former India captain Virat Kohli has returned to the top 10 of the ICC Men's Test Player Rankings while South Africa opener Dean Elgar has made a huge jump after his Player of the Match effort in the first Test of the two-match ICC World Test Championship series in Centurion, which the home side won by an innings and 32 runs to take a 1-0 lead," ICC announced in an official statement.
Kohli, a previous top-ranked batter who fell out of the top 10 in mid-2022, has moved up four spots to ninth place with scores of 38 and 76, but is still 103 rating points behind top-ranked Kane Williamson of New Zealand (864 points). Joe Root comes in second with 859



rating points, while Steve Smith comes in third with 820. Meanwhile, India skipper Rohit Sharma dropped four places to 14th position in the Test rankings. On the other

side, South African veteran Dean Elgar is certain to retire as a top-20 batter after his efforts in the first Test in Centurion, jumping 19 places to 17th (680) ahead of his last appearance. Following his comeback to Test cricket, Jasprit Bumrah re-entered the bowlers rankings, finishing fifth (767), just behind compatriot Ravindra Jadeja (774). Marco Jansen's efforts resulted in a three-place climb to 22nd (618), but a five-place jump to 8th in the all-rounder

standings, with a career-best rating of 268. The latest weekly update also considers performances in the second Test between Australia and Pakistan. Australia's Marnus Labuschagne has risen one spot to seventh after scoring a half-century in the first innings, while Alex Carey (up four places to 41st) and Mitchell Marsh (up 16 places to 52nd) have also risen.

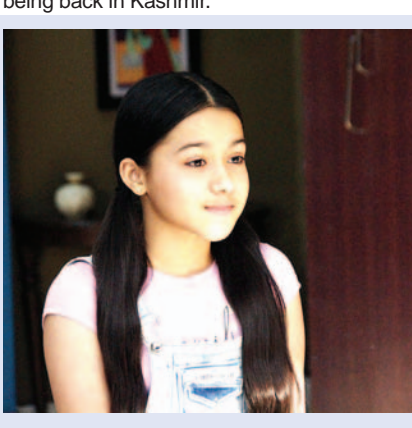
