Iran's strike in Balochistan, Pak strongly condemns

ISLAMABAD : Following Iran's strikes on a terrorist group in Balochistan, Pakistan has strongly condemned the "unprovoked violation" of its airspace by Iran, which claimed the lives of two children and injured three girls, Pakistan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs said in a statement. It said that the violation of Pakistan's sovereignty is "completely unacceptable" and warned of serious consequences. Pakistan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs said that Iran has taken this action despite the existence of several channels of communication between the two nations. In a statement, Pakistan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs said, "Pakistan strongly condemns the unprovoked violation of its airspace by Iran and the strike inside Pakistani territory."

MHA cancels FCRA registration of Centre for Policy Research

NEW DELHI: The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has cancelled the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) registration of New Delhi's leading public policy research institute, Centre for Policy Research (CPR) for allegedly violating certain foreign funding norms. "The FCRA has been cancelled via order received on January 10" and the institution will weigh its options to seek justice," Yamini Aiyar, President, CPR said.

ED questions Bhupinder Singh Hooda in money laundering case

NEW DELHI: Former Haryana Chief Minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda has been questioned by the Enforcement Directorate on Wednesday in connection with a money laundering case, the agency sources said. ED filed a prosecution complaint earlier in February 2021, under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002 (PMLA) in the Panchkula Industrial plot allotment scam linking the former Haryana CM and 21 others. According to ED, the case involves the allocation of 14 industrial plots worth Rs 30.34 crore allegedly to the acquaintances of the then Chief Minister of Haryana Bhupinder Singh Hooda in the year 2013.

FRESH VIOLENCE IN MANIPUR



AGENCY IMPHAL, JAN 17

One Manipur Police commando was killed and three others injured when suspected armed militants attacked them in Manipur's Moreh, along Myanmar border, on Wednesday, police said. When the security personnel tried to shift the three injured security personnel to the hospital for medical treatment, some tribals including women, obstructed and clashed with the forces and in the clash a tribal woman was killed and few others were injured in bordering Moreh,

110 km from the state capital Imphal.

Police officials in Imphal said that a police commando Wangkhem Somorjit was killed and three others injured when suspected militants attacked the security forces, who were on a search operation in different vehicles in Moreh under Tengnoupal district to nab the militants.

On Wednesday early morning, armed militants orchestrated a violent attack on the State forces, employing firearms and explosives in Moreh, Tengnoupal district. In the incident, one personnel of 6th Manipur Rifles namely Wangkhem Somorjit Meetei S/o (L) W.

The fresh violence comes amid massive protests by Kuki groups after police arrested two tribals for involvement in the killing of a police officer.

A video of the clash shows armed attackers pushing back a security truck as it tries to enter Moreh.

Earlier, following inputs of "likelihood of breach of peace, disturbance of public tranquillity and grave danger to human lives and property within the revenue jurisdiction of Tengnoupal", the Manipur government imposed a total curfew from 12 am on January 16.

Three Punjab policemen killed in road accident

Three policemen, including a woman from Punjab Armed Police (PAP) Jalandhar, died, and 13 sustained injuries when their bus carrying 30 policemen, collided with a stationary truck near Adda Aima early hours ago on Wednesday.

According to the police report, ill-fated police bus, under the command of Inspector Tarlok Singh, was en route from PAP Jalandhar to Gurdaspur for Law-and-Order duty when it crashed into the parked truck around 7am due to low visibility caused by dense fog.

Hoshiarpur SSP Surendra Lamba, stated that the poor visibility, attributed to dense fog, created challenging driving conditions. The deceased have been identified as bus driver S/Ct Gurpreet Singh, L/Ct Shalu Rana and Assistant Sub Inspector (ASI) Hardev Singh. Their bodies have been placed in the mortuary of Mukerian Civil Hospital. Among the injured were admitted to Civil Hospital, Mukerian. The Mukerian police have initiated an investigation into the incident.



Bhagwant Mann announces Rs 2 crore as financial assistance to each family

CHANDIGARH: Expressing profound grief and sorrow over the death of three cops in a road accident near Hoshiarpur, the Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann on Wednesday announced Rs 2 crore as financial assistance to their families. In a statement, the Chief Minister said that it is unfortunate that these cops had lost their lives in a road mishap adding that this is a huge loss for the state in general and for the aggrieved families of the cops in particular. He said that out of this Rs 2 crore, Rs 1 crore will be given as ex-gratia by the state government whereas another payment of insurance cover worth Rs 1 crore will be made by the HDFC bank.

Delhi: Over 170 flights affected, 20 trains delayed due to fog

The national capital continues to grapple with biting cold and fog, impacting visibility and causing delays and cancellations in flight and train operations on Wednesday morning.

Flight movement to and from Delhi's Indira Gandhi International (IGI) airport remained affected with around 120 flights including international ones getting delayed by several hours. 53 flights were also announced cancelled on Wednesday due to fog and other operational issues.

According to the Delhi Airport Flight Information Display System (FIDS) data, the 120 affected flights included 21 international departures, 23 international arrivals, 33 domestic departures,

and 43 domestic arrivals.

Apart from the 120 flights affected, a total of 53 flights have been cancelled citing fog and other operational reasons, as per the FIDS data recorded till 8 am on Wednesday. This includes 21 domestic arrivals, 16 domestic departures, 13 international departures, and 3 international arrivals. Meanwhile, around 20 passenger trains to Delhi were running behind schedule on Wednesday. According to the Northern Railways, two trains namely Puri-Nizamuddin Purushottam Express and Hyderabad-New Delhi were delayed by around 6-6.30 hours.

Similarly, Azamgarh-Delhi Junction Kaifayat Express and Ambedkarnagar-Katra were also running behind schedule and are likely to arrive late by around five hours.

Canada sees 86 pc drop in study permits to Indian students

The number of study permits Canada issued to Indian students fell sharply late last year after India ejected Canadian diplomats who would process the permits and fewer Indian students applied due to a diplomatic dispute over the murder of a Sikh separatist leader in Canada, a top Canadian official told Reuters.

Immigration Minister Marc Miller added in an interview that he believes the number of study permits to Indians is unlikely to rebound soon. Diplomatic tensions erupted after Canada Prime Minister Justin Trudeau in June said there was evidence connecting Indian government agents to the murder of Hardeep Singh Nijjar in British Columbia.



The tensions are likely to weigh on the numbers going forward, Miller said.

"Our relationship with India

has really halved our ability to process a lot of applications from India," Miller said.

In October, Canada was forced

to pull 41 diplomats, or two-thirds of its staff, out of India on orders from New Delhi.

In addition, the dispute has prompted Indian students to seek to study in other countries, a spokeswoman for the minister said.

Those factors led to an 86% drop in study permits issued to Indians in the fourth quarter of last year from the previous quarter, to 14,910 from 108,940, according to official data that have not been previously reported.

C. Gurusubramanian, counselor for the High Commission of India in Ottawa, said some Indian international students were looking at other options besides Canada due to "concerns, in the recent past, regarding lack of residential and adequate teaching facilities" at some Canadian institutions.

Sikh name cannot be guessed without Singh or Kaur: Dhami

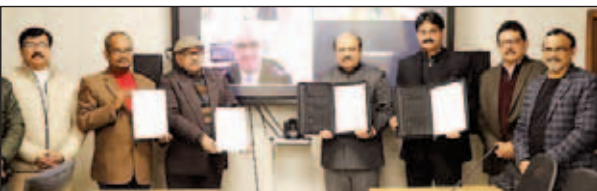

Ustad Mangu’s dream

In true democracy every man and woman is taught to think for himself or herself,” said Mahatma Gandhi. This is the gist of the idea of swaraj, India’s most valuable gift to political philosophy in contemporary times. Swaraj, the core of Gandhian political thought, is centred around the individual-community relationship, the concepts of society, freedom and the State, technological civilisation, and the questions for alternatives. Gandhi had profound faith in the potential of the common man and believed in swaraj as a condition in which the individual would be the complete master of himself.

Gandhi searched for alternatives to existing structures, such as the State, technology, and property. He shared a scepticism for modern civilisation but, instead of harking back to tradition, looked forward to an alternative in which the individual has a vital role. His ideal State was one ruled by selfless individuals. Deeply influenced by Plato’s idealism and concern for moral values, Gandhi preferred the consensus principle that ensured collective welfare over the majority principle.

Gandhi stood for a minimal State that would protect the interests of the common man. Gandhi’s ideal State was one along the lines of Ashoka’s empire, a non-violent and morality-based polity. He loathed the centralisation of power, political and economic. Non-violence was the barometer of progress in Gandhian political dynamics. For Gandhi, the future of civilisation depended on progressive diminution in the use of violence. He pleaded for panchayati raj for realising gram swaraj. In his scheme of things, vyakti swaraj (individual self-rule) is the first step of swaraj, gram swaraj the second, and purna swaraj, the ultimate.

Gandhi’s political philosophy was not utopian; he demonstrated the practical potential of his political ideals. One such instance is the Constitution he helped to design for a princely state called Aundh. On January 21, 1939, the princely state of Aundh (now in Maharashtra) became a village republic based on Gandhi’s ideals, adopting his Swaraj Constitution.

The ‘Aundh experiment’ was a unique occurrence in which an Indian monarch abdicated his throne to allow for people’s self-rule. Gandhi proposed a three-tier government, with each village having a panchayat of five members who would elect a president. The panchayat presidents would elect four taluk presidents and send 12 representatives to the legislative assembly, which would select the state’s prime minister. The Constitution gave every citizen of Aundh a wide array of fundamental rights.

Arctic blast sweeps across US, bringing record-low temperatures

More than 142 million people across the US are under a wind chill alert on Monday, as frigid Arctic air hangs over much of the country. The National Weather Service (NWS) said the heartland of the US will likely experience record-breaking cold, warning people to stay indoors and travel with caution.

The Arctic blast was expected to continue sweeping across the United States, bringing record-low temperatures and sub-zero temperatures to large parts of the country. The National Weather Service predicted that wind chills would reach minus 30 degrees Fahrenheit across the Northern Plains.

Almost 80 per cent of the US experiences subzero temperatures -- schools across the country are closed today as a result.

In its advisory on Monday, the NWS warned of "brutally cold temperatures" that will persist until Wednesday. The cold is thanks to an Arctic air mass that has travelled southeast into the US from western Canada, where it set record-low temperatures. Wind chills taking the temperature to below minus 30 degrees Fahrenheit could extend into the South, reaching the Mississippi Valley.

The storms and frigid temperatures affected everything from air travel to NFL playoff games to Iowa's presidential caucuses. Unfortunately, the cold temperatures have turned deadly and have caused several deaths around the country.

Almost 1,300 flights had been cancelled before 8:30 am ET today as airports across the country struggle with snow and icy conditions. There are more than 11,000 delays, according to the flight-tracking website FlightAware. More than 85,000 US homes and businesses were without power early Tuesday. Tuesday marked two years to the day since at least 1 inch of snow last fell in



Washington, DC, Metro area, a streak that finally came to an end. The snow may still be falling, but it's not keeping everyone indoors. For some kids like 5-year-old Brielle Weitzman, a snow day means sledding and snowmen. By Monday, school districts across the entire DC, Maryland and Virginia area sent out notices to families that schools would remain closed. The snow may still be falling, but it's not keeping everyone indoors, including The Weitzman. "We just returned from Miami, and were pleasantly surprised to see snow all around. When we

woke up this morning it was all magical, the kids wanted to step out and enjoy the snow day," Laurie Weitzman told .

The temperatures will continue to drop tonight heading into overnight so the concern is still slick sidewalks and roadways.

Michelle Morrison, a resident of Maryland who has been bracing himself against the cold and doing his bit to keep the side walk outside his home clear of snow and ice.

"I'm thankful that I can stay at home and just work from home and study from the process of a full time student. I hope every-

body's safe out there today," Michelle Morrison told .

In New York City, there was 1.4 inches on the ground in Central Park this morning, ending a snowless streak that goes back to February 2022, according to the weather service. More snow is expected today, making travel conditions hazardous.

Moderate temperatures are expected midweek, but a new surge of colder air is forecast to drop south over the Northern Plains and midwest, reaching the deep south by the end of the week.

New Zealand's first 'refugee' MP Golriz Ghahraman resigns over allegations of shoplifting

New Zealand legislator, Golriz Ghahraman resigned on Tuesday after claims surfaced that she had shoplifted from two clothing stores, which she said were caused by stress and hurt to her mental health, according to The New York Times.

Ghahraman, a 43-year-old former United Nations human rights lawyer from Iran, rose to attention in 2017 as the first refugee to be sworn in as a member of the country's Parliament.

"I fell short. I'm sorry," said the lawmaker, Golriz Ghahraman, in a statement on Tuesday, adding that "The best thing for my mental health is to resign as a member of Parliament."

Ghahraman, who made no mention of theft in her statement, claimed she couldn't explain her behaviour since it was "not rational in any way."

Following the medical treatment, she said, "I understand I'm not well," adding that a mental health specialist she was seeing claimed her behaviour was consistent with "recent events giving rise to extreme stress response," and was tied to prior trauma, The New York Times reported.

According to James Shaw, a Green Party leader, Ghahraman has been threatened with sexual violence, physical violence, and death threats since the day she was elected, and police have been investigating such threats



on a regular basis. She was subjected to higher amounts of stress than other parliamentarians, Shaw stated at a news conference on Tuesday, according to The New York Times. According to the Green Party, Ghahraman has advocated for refugee and migrant rights throughout her career, as well as stopping New Zealand's military deployments in the Middle East to refocus the country's defence resources on the climate problem.

In 2020, she stated that she had been diagnosed with multiple sclerosis.

Pakistan polls may be delayed due to 'symbol dispute



If orders keep coming to change the election symbols, the elections scheduled for February 8 may have to be delayed again, the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) warned, Dawn reported on Wednesday. Without naming any court, the ECP in a statement pointed out that election symbols were being changed through various forums. The ECP further said that after the allotment of election symbols, it had already ordered the printing of ballot papers to the three printing corporations and the printing work had started a day before. "If the process of changing the election symbols continues in the same way, there is a fear of election delay because the ballot papers will have to be reprinted for which time is already limited and on the other hand, the special paper available for

the ballot papers will also be lost," he said.

The commission also noted an over 33 per cent increase in the number of candidates for the upcoming general elections, as a total of 18,059 are in the run as compared to 11,700 candidates who contested the 2018 polls, according to Dawn.

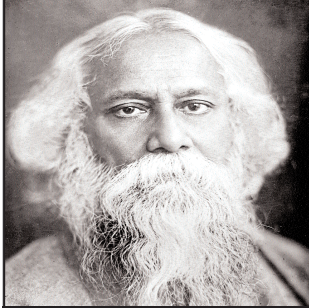
Notably, in the 2018 elections, 800-tonne paper was used for printing 220 million ballot papers, while this time the estimate is 2,070-tonne paper for printing of 260 mn ballot papers particularly after the update of electoral rolls in the backdrop of the delimitation of constituencies.

While the ECP is dealing with this situation, it has repeatedly issued instructions to relevant officials that election symbols should not be changed once the printing has started.

Our Morris Radio

The year was 1965 and the month September. The mood in the country was sombre. The nation was at war with Pakistan. I was 8 years old then. Too young to comprehend the gravity of the situation. At that time people were not allowed to switch on their lights and complete blackout was being enforced. It meant total darkness after dusk. I now understand that in those days, the fighter aircrafts were not equipped with night vision equipments to assist them in identifying the target before dropping bombs. Anything illuminated during the night was taken as a sign of human habitation. With complete blackout, the possibility of air attacks at night was checked. I can still vividly recall how we had meticulously covered our windows with thick black sheets and cardboard leaving no room for even the tiniest ray of light to escape.

The air-raid siren would make people rush to their designated safe spots within their

homes only to come out when all-clear siren was sounded. Once the siren blared, we all got ourselves packed up in a small storeroom. My father and mother would invariably be there at our side while we, a herd of five siblings were huddled beneath a big table lying in a corner

so that the falling roof of the kacha room in the event of bomb shelling may not hit us. This universal instinct of parents to protect their children was a constant reassurance during those trying times.

These are some of the vignettes from my

memory of the war of 1965. There is one more incident of those days that runs through my memory lane with utmost intensity. One fine evening, my father came home carrying a large box. Each one of us was excited to see what the box contained. My father unwrapped the box and pulled out a 3-band radio, soft yellow in color and make 'Morris.' The glimpse of this talking toy brought wide smiles on our faces. It was bought for a princely sum of Rs.80/-, a considerable amount in those days. It was the first radio in the mohalla. A world in itself. On that day, the Prime Minister of the country was to address the nation. In all the gloom of war surrounding everyone in the country, his words were to bring hope for them. The big table which was used in those war days for protecting us, was brought out and placed at a peculiar place in the kacha courtyard of the house. It was adorned with a fine multi-colored table cloth. The newly brought radio was placed over there. My father connected it to a wooden electric switch-

board and a thin black wire was also attached at the back to serve as an antenna the other end of which was placed on the roof-top. This so-called antenna was to ensure better signal and uninterrupted broadcast of the address of the then Prime Minister Lal Bahadur Shastri. As a child, I knew that he commanded great respect and admiration among the masses.

Finally, the moment came. An impromptu audience gathered to listen to what their Prime Minister had to say about the war. That evening our courtyard became the haunt for who's who of not only our mohalla but also of the adjoining area. It was dark, humid and hot. Still, the entire audience was keeping cool and was fully attentive to what their leader was saying. He declared the cessation of war and the blackout too. There were smiles all around. A strange smile on my face too. For the Prime Minister of our country having addressed the people from the ramparts of our kacha courtyard. Thank you 'Morris'.

"I have a different opinion": AB De Villiers on Virat Kohli opening in T20Is

India reached the 100-run mark in 13.2 overs. Rohit reached his 30th T20I fifty in 41 balls, with five fours and three sixes. At the end of 15 overs, India was 109/4, with Rohit (55*) and Rinku (36*) unbeaten. The 16th over by Saleem gave away 22 runs, including two fours and a six. The 19th over bowled by Azmatullah yielded 22 runs for India, including two fours and a six by Rohit and a six by Rinku. Rohit brought up his 5th T20I century, most by a batter in the format.

The final over by Karim Janat leaked 36 runs as Rohit smashed a four and two sixes and Rinku's three sixes came on the final three balls. India finished at 212/4, with Rohit (121*) in 69 balls, with 11 fours and eight sixes) and Rinku (69* in 39 balls, with two fours and six sixes) unbeaten. Both combined to form a 190-run partnership for the fifth wicket. Faheem (3/20) was the pick of the bowlers for Afghanistan.

New Zealand Pakistan

In the second inning, Saim Ayub (10 runs from 13 balls) and Mohammad Rizwan (24 runs from 20 balls) opened for Pakistan to chase down a total of 225 runs from 20 overs. However, the openers failed to make a mark as the Kiwis picked up early wickets.

Babar Azam (58 runs from 37 balls) was the only standout batter for the 'Men in Green' and helped them to take a better position.

AGENCY **JOHANNESBURG** : Former South Africa skipper, AB De Villiers thinks that although the star India batter Virat Kohli has good record while opening but he should not opt for India in the shortest format of the game. While talking on his YouTube channel, the former South African batter states that Kohli will perform better at number three as he has the capability to anchor the innings and can build partnerships with the middle-order batters.

"I have a different opinion. For the most part of my international career, Virat batting at No. 3 was the biggest threat for us when we played against India. I've always felt like he was the glue of the team in the middle-order. No. 3 is not quite middle-order, it is top-order. But he is so good that he often combined with the middle-order, even down to tailenders. It's just impossible to play against that," De Villiers asserted. The former *Yorkshire* and *Chennai Super Kings* batter further opined

that there is high chance of the 35-year-old getting dismissed on an unplayable delivery while opening. "With a new ball, facing the first few deliveries there, I just think that the chances of getting a good delivery up front are so much better. I'm worried about that position. Even though the numbers don't look bad, I have some other stats for you. When Virat faces the very first ball as an opener, his average is 23 and strike rate is 138. When he doesn't face the first ball and is at the non-striker's end, he averages 140 with a strike rate of 173," the 39-year-old added. In the end, the wicketkeeper-batter pointed out the former India skipper's exceptional stats at No. 3 in T20s. "What do like is that No. 3 position. 79 games played there, average of 55 and strike rate of 135. Very solid, match-winner, keeps everyone together, and he allows some of the power hitters to have freedom at the back end of the innings," the Warmbad-born cricketer concluded.

"They are going for World Cup": Parthiv Patel on Rohit, Virat's future

DUNEDIN : Finn Allen's 137-run onslaught powered New Zealand to seal a 45-run win against Pakistan in the 3rd T20I match at University Oval in Dunedin on Wednesday.

In the five-match 20-over

series, the Kiwis gained an unassailable lead over Pakistan after the end of the third T20I game. After winning the toss, Pakistan decided to field first. However, their decision did not go in their favour as they failed to restrict the Kiwis' run rate.

Allen's (137 runs from 62 balls) onslaught put doubts over Pakistan skipper Shaheen Afridi's mind following his decision to ball after winning the toss.

The Blackcaps showed their intent in the powerplay

as the hosts raced to 67/1. Following the early departure of Devon Conway, Allen and Tim Seifert led the charge with the bat and stitched up a 125-run partnership.

In the 18th over Allen struck a six which took New Zealand past the 200-run mark in the first ball of the 18th over. Zaman Khan removed Allen on to the next ball which helped Pakistan to control the flow of leaking runs. The Men in Green conceded just 13 runs in the final two overs. New Zealand

ended up with a total of 224-7 which saw the likes of Harsi Rauf and Afridi conceding 2/60 and 1/43 respectively. Mohammad Wasim's spell of 1/35 (4) was the least expensive among the Pakistan bowlers.

Rohit is yet to score a single run after registering two ducks in the first two games of the series. On the other hand, Kohli missed the first match, returned in the second and scored 29 off 16 deliveries. "I don't see this series as a selection series for the World Cup. I don't think any player performing or not will impact their chances of World Cup selection, specially when you are talking about Rohit Sharma or Virat Kohli. Once you have picked them for the series, it means they are going for the World Cup. For Rohit Sharma personally, he would like to score runs. He likes to set the tone and if he gets in, he would like to make it a big one," Parthiv said as quoted from JoCinema. In both matches, India successfully managed to chase down the targets and registered six-wicket victories. Former cricketer Saba Karim feels that India should once again look to chase down the target and test their batting depth in the final T20I should they get an opportunity. "I hope they do that in Bengaluru. Not only to put the bowlers under scanner but also to check the depth of your batting. Players like Axar Patel and Washington Sundar, who come down the order, may get a look in. Then you can understand if you want to play three seamers or spinners in the playing XI, once Hardik Pandya comes in," Karim said. India have already clinched the series by gaining an unassailable 2-0 lead over Afghanistan. Both teams will face each other at the M Chinnaswamy Stadium in Bengaluru on Wednesday.

Govt unveils plan for air quality improvement in Delhi-NCR Region

In a major step towards tackling air pollution in the Delhi-NCR region, Haryana Chief Secretary Mr. Sanjeev Kaushal disclosed the state's action plan for the year 2024-25. The plan focuses on transitioning the state's bus fleet to cleaner alternatives, including electric, CNG, and BS-VI diesel buses.

Mr. Kaushal shared this information after participating in a virtual meeting convened by the Union Cabinet Secretary on air quality management in Delhi and the NCR region. The plan includes stringent timelines and action items for the replacement of BS-III/IV Diesel Buses.

E-Buses for Gurugram and Faridabad: Mr. Kaushal stated that State Transport Haryana has finalized the procurement of 375 e-buses under the Gross Cost Contract (GCC) model for



operation in nine Municipal Corporation cities of Haryana. He assured that all 375 e-buses would be inducted by June 2024. Mr. Kaushal also mentioned the procurement of 200 e-buses through the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), initiated for induction in Gurugram and Faridabad (100 e-buses each). The induction of all 200 e-buses is expected to be completed by December 2024. State Transport Haryana plans to add 500 new Standard BS-VI diesel buses and 150 HVAC BS-VI diesel
