#### Uchana assembly constituency will become industrial hub- Dushyant

CHANDIGARH: Haryana Deputy Chief Minister, Mr. Dushyant Chautala said that under the PADMA Scheme, 9 locations have been identified in the state for setting up industrial units and applications were sought from farmers for providing land on the e-Bhoomi portal. Under which, proposals of more than 3000 acres have been received from farmers across the state, in which two proposals of 1170 acres have been received for providing land in village Khatkar of Uchana assembly constituency. Addressing the gathering at Chhatar Gushala in Uchana today, the Deputy Chief Minister said that industrial units will be developed at these designated locations.

Editorial

Change of Jharkhand CMs  
a masterstroke by JMM?

The Jharkhand government must go on. It cannot stop for an individual even if he was the scion of the ruling family and chief minister. The process of the government continuing in the hands of a veteran legislator was enabled by the Jharkhand Mukti Morcha deciding in time that the Hemant Soren situation had to be faced head-on rather than wait for a ruling by courts on the legality of the arrest of the chief minister of a state. Also Read - DC Edit | Budget: South feels left out Advertisement In fact, it was a political masterstroke that saw the timely election of Mr Champai Soren as chief minister by JMM legislators who did not give in to moves that would have mirrored the insult to the intelligence of the electorate as delivered in India's political history by a replacement candidate moving from a cowshed to a high state office just to serve a family whose patriarch in the CM's seat was under pressure from investigation. Also Read - DC Edit | Hemant arrest raises questions The proposal that any member of the family should replace Mr Hemant Soren was shot down and Mr Champai Soren elected to be the chief minister and was sworn in by the governor who carried out his constitutional duty by inviting the party with the majority not allowing much time for any trading of MLAs to go on. While he has given him 10 days to prove majority, Champai Soren is to seek the trust vote on Monday.

The highest judiciary may have been chary of ruling on the legality of arrest by the Enforcement Directorate on charges of money laundering and benefiting from tribal land transactions on the strength of forged documents, which Hemant faced. Asking the aggrieved party to go to the high court might mean inordinate delay in any verdict on a crucial issue of whether a CM can be arrested and if so what about the greater political implications of such action and its effect on the polity. It is best that the legality is ruled upon by the highest court in the land. Also Read - DC Edit | Imran's career buried under convictions The matter of states under a party other than the ruling party at the Centre coming under pressure from investigations cannot be left hanging as it is widely known that the Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal is also under the ED lens and, wary of the risks of arrest as it was in the case of Hemant Soren, has been ignoring multiple summonses. The sight of chief ministers refusing to answer ED or CBI summons and complying with the utmost reluctance and after dragging their feet, does not augur well for clean politics when the probity of high constitutional functionalities comes under the scanner, however inspired such moves by the investigators may seem.

Global migration & India:  
Crisis will only get worse

The heady extravaganza of the Rs 3,000-crore Ayodhya celebrations helped to distract attention from the disgrace that an American judge heaped on a Sikh couple for forcing a young relative to slave for them. "The defendants exploited the victim's trust and his desire to attend school in the United States, and then inflicted physical and mental abuse on him, all so they could keep him working for their profit," said assistant attorney-general Kristen Clarke.

The horrified court in North Chesterfield, Virginia, heard how the victim was a minor when he was brought to the United States to work as cashier, cook, cleaner and manager of store records for well-to-do cousins who ran a petrol pump. He was subjected to various forms of coercion, including confiscation of his immigration documents, physical abuse, threats of force and other forms of serious harm as well as degrading living conditions to compel him to work long hours for a pittance.

This horrendous story is a small piece of the much larger tragedy of destitute migration. Boasting of a 35-million-strong diaspora, the world's largest, Indians are proud of sending back the world's highest annual remittances of \$110 billion. Joblessness at home force a phenomenal 2.5 million Indians to migrate every year. It's also a matter of pride that Israel is seeking Indian cannon fodder who wish to avoid the risk of daily massacre. When legal channels are closed, Indians go abroad on fake student visas and drive taxis in Australia or slave in Indian shops in the British Midlands or, as in the court report cited, for exploitative relatives in the United States.

It's to protect themselves from such abuse that British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak and Italy's Prime Minister Gloria Meloni have forged what some might call an un-



holy alliance. For others, it's the only way that developed countries can ward off the threat posed by stagnant economies like India's. Hugging each other at a convention of the political right in Rome, the two Prime Ministers vowed not to let "the Third World" "overwhelm" Europe's dynamic economies. Instead, they will "focus on joint efforts to tackle illegal immigration and organised crime".

Just as Mr Sunak has won a narrow vote of approval for his plan to shunt off unwanted illegal migrants to Rwanda, Ms Meloni has on hand a similar scheme to send migrants to Albania. Neither country has a shining human rights record. Critics of the two strategies fear that hapless migrants, legal or illegal, who are unlucky enough to fall into Rwandan or Albanian hands may end up in the country they were at such pains to leave in the first place. But Britain and Italy counter with the argument that their countrymen cannot continue to be penalised for the inefficiency or callousness (or both) of Afro-Asian

regimes. Out of the 745,000 migrants that reached Britain in 2022-23, 52,530 were irregular refugees, representing a 17 per cent increase in this category from the previous year's figure. Some 85 per cent of these immigrants arrived in small and often leaky boats that braved the waters of the Mediterranean Sea.

The 105,129 people who tried to enter Italy (down from the 2016 record of 181,436) included 13,386 unaccompanied minors. Many of these people were fleeing wars in Syria, Iraq, Sudan or Yemen. Others were trying to escape rigorous living conditions in austere war-torn societies like Afghanistan. Some were victims of chronic unemployment in India and Pakistan. Whatever the cause the remedy was the same. Families had pooled together their meagre resources, sold whatever little land they possessed, and handed over the proceeds to unscrupulous traffickers against a promise to guide them to new hope and a happy life far from the misery they had left behind. The sinister arm of India's pover-

ty makes itself felt again and again even in the distant North American continent. Mexicans understandably dominate the hordes of refugees clamouring for admission on America's southern frontier. But against 425,000 Mexicans, there are 202,000 Indians and 114,121 Chinese. If the global powers led by the United States do not move now to end the onslaught on Gaza and settle the Palestinian question with a speed and efficiency that has so far been notably absent in handling this crisis, the world may be plunged into an even more grave conflict involving not just human movement but also nuclear weapons.

If the solution lies in the two-state formula that has been the mantra ever since the Oslo Accords, the first demand will be for enough contiguous land for a viable Palestinian homeland. Second, Palestine will need funds to repair the devastation caused by Israel's relentless bombardment of Gaza and systematic encroachments on the West Bank which it calls Judea and Samaria, and obviously covets.

The Palestinians can do nothing unless the administration is rooted firmly in the majority's political will and is backed by powerful global support that can counter Israel's persistent obstruction. Failing these conditions, the world can expect more illegal migrants, boat people and refugees than Mr Sunak can pack off to Rwanda or Ms Meloni to Albania. It's a feature of the Palestinian tragedy that no Arab state seems genuinely interested in solving it. Even the quiet moves under US Presidents Donald Trump and Joe Biden to secure advantageous settlements for individual Arab countries under the so-called Abraham Accords did not scratch the surface of the problem. Israel's relentless settlement of Jews in the West Bank has resulted in a colony of 750,000 illegals that can burgeon to over a million.

AIIMS launches AI-based platform  
for Cancer Diagnosis

AIIMS, New Delhi, in collaboration with the Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC), Pune, has recently launched an AI platform, iOncology.ai, for facilitating early detection of Cancer, the official statement released said. Cancer is globally estimated to be the most fatal disease than those from cardiovascular (Lancet, 2019) in high-income countries (HICs), and middle-income countries (MICs). According to the Global Cancer Observatory (GLOBOCAN) estimates, there were 19.3 million incident cancer cases worldwide for the year 2020. India ranked third after China and the United States of America.

A recent study published in the Lancet predicted that cancer cases in India would increase to 2.08 million, accounting for a rise of 57.5 per cent in 2040 from 2020. In India, over 8 lakh deaths were caused due to Cancer in the year 2022. Late detection of cancer remains the main cause of death.

It is globally estimated that out of 80% of cases reported late, only 20% survive. However, 20% of cases detected at an early stage have a survival rate of 80% or higher. Early diagnosis is thus the key to reducing fatalities due to Cancer. One



of the key issues in manual diagnosis of cancer is reporting false negatives, meaning falsely declaring a cancer patient as healthy. The use of AI significantly helps in reducing such false negatives. According to the official statement released by AIIMS Delhi, at the core of this platform lies a sophisticated AI system capable of analyzing complex medical data, including diagnosis, with unprecedented accuracy and efficiency. iOncology.ai platform encapsulates deep learning models. As the volume of data, both clinical and radiological/ histopathology images, increases, this platform thus has the capability of Self-learning to constantly improve its outcome.

14.1 lakh new cancer cases, 9.1 lakh  
deaths in India: WHO

In 2022, India had more than 14.1 lakh new cancer cases and over 9.1 lakh deaths due to the disease, and breast cancer was the most common, according to the latest estimates of the disease's global burden by the World Health Organization (WHO).

Cancers of lip, oral cavity and lung were the most common ones in men, accounting for 15.6 and 8.5 per cent of the new cases, respectively, whereas, cancers of breast and cervix were the most frequent ones in women, making up close to 27 and 18 per cent of the new cases, the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC), WHO's cancer agency has estimated.

It also calculated that the number of people alive within 5 years following a cancer diagnosis was nearly 32.6 lakhs in India. Globally, the agency estimated 2 crore new



cancer cases and 97 lakh deaths, and about 5.3 crore people were alive within 5 years following a cancer diagnosis. About 1 in 5 people develop cancer in their lifetime, and roughly 1 in 9 men and 1 in 12 women die from the disease, it said.

In India, the risk of developing cancer before turning 75 was calculated to be 10.6 per cent, while the risk

of dying from cancer by the same age was found to be 7.2 per cent. Globally, these risks were 20 per cent and 9.6 per cent, respectively.

A majority of countries do not adequately finance priority cancer and palliative (pain-related) care services, as part of universal health coverage (UHC), the WHO said publishing survey results from 115 countries.

How talk about Gaza 'genocide' by  
Bibi's Israel roils UK politics

O Bachchoo, the world struggles With wrong and right Through all human life From days of learning Yearning Discerning Till your hair turns seagull white..." From The Proverbs of Baalan Singh, by Bachchoo Kate Osamor, a Labour MP representing the North London constituency of Edmonton, has been suspended from the party "pending an investigation". Her crime? She posted a social media message to her party members on Holocaust Day contending that the action against the residents of the Gaza Strip by the Benjamin Netanyahu government amounted to "genocide".

Ms Osamor, a shadow cabinet secretary for international development under the previous Labour Party leader, Jeremy Corbyn, listed several other examples of "genocide", including that in Darfur in north Sudan, where an esti-



mated 200,000 members of the Zaghawa and Masalit tribes were slaughtered by the Sudan government and its militia. She reminded the world of this genocide perpetrated by the "Jan-

jaweed" (devil on horseback) militia which began in 2003.

The US secretary of state in 2004, Colin Powell, had labelled their action "genocide". He wasn't expelled from

the US government. Colin Powell is of Afro-American descent. He was characterising black people as the perpetrators of the genocide against other black people. There was no racial dimension to this slaughter -- only tribal differences going back in history. Hitler's Holocaust was based on his contention that he and his fellow Germans belonged to the "pure race" of Aryans and that the Jews were Semites whom he would urge his race to decimate and make extinct. In the case of the murder by bombs and bullets of 30,000 Gazan non-Hamas civilians, of all ages and genders, the demolition of half of the buildings in Gaza's crowded cities, the withholding of food, water, medical supplies, fuel and electricity to the population of Gaza, though it follows the attack on Israel by Hamas, is motivated by three historical divides. The first is

undoubtedly the religious belief that God gave the land that Israel today occupies by force through some Old Testament prophecy. That biblically gave the Jewish people, persecuted and displaced in Europe, the right to reclaim this God-given land from the "Filastin" -- (read biblical Philistines or today's universal term "Palestinians").

The Philistines of the Bible were Semitic people, but at the time of their battles with the Israelites they were not Muslims. That came after the sixth century AD. But they were the same occupants of the Middle Eastern land between Jordan and the Mediterranean Sea. The second dividing factor is territorial hunger. The entire recent history of that region is one of the enforced ethnic cleansing of the Palestinians by European Jewish settlers. The decisive third factor is the support that the West

gives to even the most undemocratic and corrupt Israeli regimes out of guilt for their past historical persecution of Jews and out of wanting Jewish votes which they think -- mistakenly in many cases -- are all pro-Israeli policies, even those of a fascist like "Bibi" Netanyahu.

And then there are the arms and technological sales -- Israel is a vibrant market, not least for Hedge Sunak's father-in-law's international enterprise Infosys. So why has Ms Osamor, of Nigerian origin, been suspended from the Labour Party for her simple statement that this present Israeli government is, through the deployment of its conscripted Israeli Defence Force, committing genocide? It's nothing to do, gentle reader, with the application of the meaning of the word (to which I shall come later).

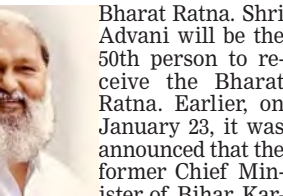

The landmark decision, rendered on January 24, 2024, settles a prolonged debate surrounding the scope of owner rights to license sound recordings.

“PPL's victory in this legal battle is not just a win for us but a triumph for the entire music industry. The Bombay High Court's verdict firmly reinforces the rights of copyright owners and exclusive licensees, providing PPL with the tools to protect against the widespread infringement that undermines the hard-earned investments of genuine music labels. This win underscores

the importance of respecting and preserving the creative endeavours that drive the music industry, securing a future where investors in copyrights, artists and their creations are duly valued and protected,” said G.B. Aayee, MD & CEO at PPL. PPL, founded in 1941, has emerged victorious in multiple suits against over 200 establishments, including notable names such as Social, Farzi Café, and Olive Bar & Kitchen. The court's order, a paradigm shift in copyright dynamics, has far-reaching implications for the music industry. Key findings of the court include the affirmation of PPL's status as the owner and exclusive licensee, recognizing its power to grant licenses under Section 30, and validating assignment deeds and exclusive license agreements. The judgment interprets Section 33(1) not as a restriction on the owner's rights but as a means to protect and facilitate them.
