#### **Kashmir grips** in freezing temperature SRINAGAR: Kashmir val-

ley continued to grip in freezing temperatures, with Pahalgam recording a low of -10.8°C and Gulmarg -10.0°C on Wednesday, officials said.

The Meteorological Centre Srinagar said Kashmir Valley remained gripped under sub-freezing temperatures in view of significant snow accumulation over hilly areas that dropped the minimum temperature over many stations considerably. The MeT office said the weather will remain dry till February 17, with occasionally cloudy evenings during February 14, while during February 18–20 there is a possibility of light snow and rain over J&K.

#### Rupee rises 9 paise to close at **82.96 against US dollar**

MUMBAI: The rupee appreciated 9 paise to close at 82.96 (provisional) against the US dollar on Wednesday, tracking a correction in the greenback against major currencies and fresh foreign capital inflows.

However, a rise in crude oil prices and muted domestic markets capped the sharp gains in the domestic unit, forex traders said. At the interbank foreign exchange market, the local unit opened at 83.03 against the greenback. The unit hit an intraday high of 82.94 and a low of 83.09.

## CM Mann asks officers to take strict action against illegal colonisers

Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann on Wednespare draft of a bill to act sternly against the illegal colonisers for checking the mushrooming up of illegal colonies in the state in future. Chairing a meeting in

wake of recent decision of state government to away with clause of No Objection Certificate (NOC) for registration of land and property, the Chief Minister said that this decision is aimed at facilitating the general public. However, he said that noose around illegal colonisers need to be tightened for which fresh law must be enacted. Bhagwant Singh Mann asked the officers to draft the new bill before the next session of the state assembly so that it can be duly approved in the Vidhan Sabha.

The Chief Minister said that the illegal colonisers dupe the people by showing them green pastures and sell their unapproved colonies to them. He said that the hapless people have to then run pillar



to post for getting the basic civic amenities in these colonies. Bhagwant Singh Mann said that the colonisers mint the money illegally but people have to bear the hardships due to their misdeeds.

The Chief Minister said that this will not be tolerated at any cost and strict action will be taken against the colonisers who are selling the plots before not getting it duly approved. He said that the state government will not allow the mushrooming up of illegal colonies in the state and severest of severe action will be taken against those indulging in this crime.

On February 2, Kejriwal skipped the Enforcement Di

rectorate's summons for the fifth time in connection with the money laundering probe related to irregularities in the Delhi excise policy 2021-22 case. The fresh summons to the Delhi Chief Minister followed the fourth summons, which he had skipped on Jan-

uary 18. While skipping the fifth summons, the party called it "unlawful."

Kejriwal has so far skipped four previous summons issued by the ED on January 18, January 3, November 2, and December 22, calling them "illegal and politically motivated.

About 371,000 troops were spread out across Pakistan to guard the last election

in 2018, about three times more than the number from 2013 polls. "About 650,000 security personnel have been deployed on the ground to ensure the security of the voters," Ejaz told reporters during a media briefing in Islamabad. "Over 137,000

Bumrah rises to the top for the first time on the back of his tremendous match figures of 9/91 during his side's series-equalling 106-run victory over England in the second Test in Vizag, an effort



that saw the right-arm pacer become the first quick from

The nine-wicket haul saw Bumrah earn Player of the Match honours in the second Test and climb three places on the latest Test rankings for bowlers to claim top spot from teammate Ravichandran Ashwin. Ashwin - who has held the premier ranking since March last year - managed just three wickets for India in that same match and drops two places to third on the updated rankings for Test bowlers, with South Africa pace spearhead Kagiso Rabada maintaining his place

in second despite sitting out the Proteas' Test series in New Zealand. It is the first time Bumrah has held the top ranking, with the 30-year-old having never been previously higher than third despite a total of 10 five-wicket hauls for his country from 34 Test match appearances. Two of those five-wicket hauls have come in Test matches in 2024 for Bumrah, with the India pacer collecting figures of 6/61 against South Africa in Cape Town at the start of the year and then an equally impressive spel of 6/45 in his most

gland. Bumrah is just the fourth player from India - and first fast bowler - to top the bowling charts, with Ashwin, Ravindra Jadeja and Bishan Bedi, the only players from the Asian country to have done so previously. Bumrah isn't the only player from India to make an eye-catching jump up the latest ICC rankings, with teammate Yashasvi Jaiswal also rewarded for his magnificent double century during the first innings of that Vizag Test with England. ## Haryana to launch special campaign to relocate 60,000 destitute cows to nearby Gaushalas from Feb 15 to 29 - Manohar Lal

Harvana Chief Minister, Sh Manohar Lal, taking an important step towards making the state free from stray cattle, has directed to launch a special campaign from February 15 to 29 to relocate about 60,000 destitute cows to nearby gaushalas. The primary objective of this campaign is to remove stray cows from the state's roads and mitigate the

risk of road accidents. Sh Manohar Lal was presiding over a meeting regarding the establishment of new gaushalas in the state here today. Animal Husbandry and Dairying Minister Sh J.P.

Dalal was also present.
While giving instructions to the concerned officials of the Gau Sewa Aayog, the Chief Minister said that under this campaign, the



gaushalas should be expedited to

While instructing the officials, the Chief Minister said that the proposals of panchayats for

the Revenue and Disaster Management Department and the Panchayati Raj Department to identify land for cow grazing in villages. In villages where cow grazing land exceeding 10 acres is identified, discussions should be initiated with the Panchayats for establishing gaushalas. Furthermore, a committee comprising officials from the Gau Sewa Aayog, Development and Panchayat Department, and other relevant departments should be formed to oversee this process.

Mr. Manohar Lal instructed the officials of Gau Sewa Aayog to ensure that cows are accommodated within the capacity of the gaushalas. Additionally, he emphasized the need for regular inspections of the gaushalas to ensure proper care and accommodation of

## Govt to kick start mass inoculation drive against lumpy skin disease from 25th

Chief Minister S. Bhagwant Singh Mann led Punjab Government is all set to inoculate as many as 25 lakhs bovines as a preventive measure against the Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD), disclosed Gurmeet Singh Khudian, Minister of Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries, Punjab, while informing that the vaccination drive will be commenced from Febru-

S. Gurmeet Singh Khudian, along with Additional Chief Secretary Animal Husbandry Mr. Vikas Pratap, was reviewing ongoing projects and functioning of the department here at Puniah Bhawan.

The Cabinet Minister said that now, the Goat Pox vaccine is being repeated for the third time as a booster dose to a preventive measure against the disease. Notably, following the outbreak of LSD across the country in last year, the vaccination drive against LSD was carried out for cattle in the state. He also asked the officials to ensure the smooth transportation of the vaccination, besides, maintaining cold chain



efficiently. Emphasising on the need to make a foolproof mechanism to save livestock from diseases, S. Gurmeet Singh Khudian directed the department officials to make a compreĥensive vaccination action plan within a month. He also directed the field staff of the department to sensitise the livestock farmers about the benefits of the different immunisation drives and involve the district administration and panchayats in this noble cause to prevent the livestock from different dis-

eases. ACS Mr. Vikas Pratap apprised the cabinet minister that deworming drive is being carried out across the state at a cost of around Rs 6.37 crore.

The drive will conclude on February 10. Apart from this, medicines worth Rs 1.56 crore have already been sent to Veterinary Hospitals and Dispensaries of the state. He also informed that the department has recently completed the mass immunisation drive against Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD). 

## Families of deceased to be given Rs. 6.5 lakh each

Chief Minister Thakur Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu today met the family members of the deceased and other affected victims of the fire that occurred at Jharmajri in Barotiwala industrial area. Expressing deep condolences with the families of those who lost their life in the blaze, the Chief Minister directed the district administration to provide all possible assistance to them. He also met the families of those missing since the incident and consoled them and paid visit to the hospital to inquire about the well-being of the injured. "The state government stands strongly with the affected families in this hour of grief and it is our responsibility to provide all possible assistance and relief to them", said Sh. Sukhu. The Chief Minister also visited the incident



site and took detailed information from the officers and gave pecessary directions. While directions. interacting with the media, the Chief Minister said that the cause of massive fire was being investigated that necessary amendments would be made in the consulting

stakeholders in order to ensure that such incidents do not happen again. He said that an FIR has also been registered and strict action would be taken against the defaulters. The Chief Minister said that Rs. 6.5 lakh each would be given to the families of the deceased. The injured have been provided Rs 5,000 each as

immediate relief and besides, financial assistance of Rs. 50,000 per person would be provided soon. The State Government has so far distributed Rs. 3.05 lakh as relief to the affected families. He added that smart metering and laying underground electric cables in industrial belts would also be considered. Five people died in the unfortunate incident and one body is yet to be identified. Five were still missing. A total of 37 persons were injured in the fire incident, out of which 13 injured have been discharged from the hospital after treatment. ### Mutilated bodies of missing boy and girl recovered in Billing Valley

The bodies of a young man and a girl missing in the world famous Billing Valley of district Kangra were recovered by the rescue team on Tuesday. The police have handed over the bodies to the relatives after conducting post-mortem in the sub-divisional hospital. It is suspected that both of them died after slipping and falling on ice. The deceased have been identified as Abhinandan Gupta (30), son of Anil Gupta, resident of Shivnagar, Pathankot and Pranita Bala (26), resident of Saheb, Maharashtra. The head of the young man has been badly torn by wild animals and only the bones of the head are visible, whereas there is no damage to the body of the girl. Both the young man and the girl had left for Billing in their private car on Sunday afternoon and after parking the car at turn number seven, they walked on foot towards the take off point in Billing. According to eyewitnesses, both of them were seen going back towards Beed on foot late in the evening. When both of them did not return on Monday, the youth's family member Karanveer informed the police. Both their mobiles were also switched off. On Tuesday morning, the Mountain Para Rescue Team started a search operation led by Rahul along with the police team of Dalip, Vinod, Ravindra and Rekha and the bodies of both were recovered down on one side of the footpath. The young man was also accompanied by his pet German Shepherd dog which was barking near both the dead bodies. The rescue team went in that direction only after hearing the sound of dog barking.


### **CFSL, Chandigarh team starts** investigation of Baddi fire, collect samples from NDRF and SIT

## CBI seizes Rs 2 lakh cash from **Kullu Sub-Postmaster**

The accused identified herself as Mamta Thakur, who was working as sub-postmaster at the sub-post office in Sultanpur in Kullu district of Himachal Pradesh.

## Two Gmail accounts, 3 phones; no searches in 16 hours: Atishi on raids

AGENCY NEW DELHI, FEB 7

Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader Atishi Marlena on Wednesday criticised the Enforcement Directorate (ED), asserting that despite conducting 16-hour raids at the residence of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's secretary and 18-hour raids at the house of AAP Treasurer ND Gupta, no searches were conducted and no evidence was recovered. Addressing the media, Marlene said, "Yesterday, ED, the favourite weapon of the Central Government, raided the house of CM's PS for 16 hours and the house of AAP Treasurer and Rajya Saba MP ND Gupta for 18 hours," Marlena said.

"The ED officers who came during both raids neither did any search, nor did they find any papers, nor did they make any



inquiries, nor did they file any paperwork to tell for which case they had come to raid," she added. Such a raid might have happened for the first time in the history of ED, the minister said.

Marlena further alleged that after the 16-hour raid at the residence of Chief Minister's Personal Secretary Vibhav Kumar, the ED took data from two Gmail accounts and three

mobile phones. ED's Panchnama didn't mention the purpose of the investigation, Marlena said, alleging, "After 16 hours of raids, ED took data from two Gmail accounts and three mobile phones of CM's personal Secretary and his family." "Modi and the BJP have come to know that if there is anyone who is not afraid of them, it is Kejriwal," she said. Marlena

## Tri-lingual poet's court organized by language office





## **Editorial** Collision course

he time has perhaps come—or has it already passed, who can tell, on ground slipping by so swiftly underfoot?—for us to ask a couple of simple but blunt questions of ourselves: who are we, and what do we believe this collective of ours we call India that is Bharat should be? Is there even consonance between the entity called India and the entity called Bharat? Can one be treated as a synonym for the other, or a translation? Or is one becoming lost to the other in ways that should be reason for alarm?

But do we even sense cause for alarm or is this an acceptable — or even proactively invoked — drifting apart of essential notions of who we are? We are in the throes of a seminal separation, such that we are unable or even unwilling to talk to each other, such that we are unprepared to hear the other out, such that the other may no longer be an entity of engagement but, rather, of enmity. We may have wanted — as should happen in civilised pluralities — to be in conversation. We are, instead, in collision, and apparently quite at ease being so. Jawaharlal Nehru was never so blithely knocked and mocked by a successor prime minister as today. Mahatma Gandhi never so widely demonised and his assassin never so unabashedly propitiated. The nation of their imagining and

crafting seldom so disdained and debunked.

But we've proceeded from there, to stations where the rampant disdaining and debunking of India (or Bharat, but which India and which Bharat, the same thing or quite separate things?) pass sans remark and we become inexorably the antonym of what we had set out to be, and remain pledged by dint of allegiance to the document we call our Constitution.

A single issue and its many enactments over the decades until its denouement last month should serve as sufficient illustration. On August 5, 2020, Prime Minister Narendra Modi audaciously revealed to the nation from Ayodhya the prologue to a radical shift. It was a carefully chosen date, the first anniversary of a previous trigger in his scheme of therapy — the diminution and division of the state of Jammu and Kashmir, the scrapping of the flaky and delusional constitutional privileges it remained adorned with. That one act brought on a phosphorescent powder flash of ability we may have never thought we possessed — the ability to rejoice the ravages wreaked upon those we call, for lack of credible alternatives, our own. Indians have seldom celebrated the tragic trussing of other Indians like they did following the abrogations of August 5, 2019 in Kashmir. Modi moved on from there, probably doubly inspired, to the two-part consecrations of Ayodhya — the foundation in 2020, and the finishing last month. And in doing so, he unveiled the absolute amalgamation of Church and State, a devotee nation whose decreed chief deity would henceforth be

## New type of cell therapy shows promise for ARDS patients

study suggested that a new type of cell therapy may improve the prognosis of patients critically unwell with acute respiratory distress syndrome (ARDS) caused by severe COVID-19.

Professor Justin Stebbing of Anglia Ruskin University (ARU) is a joint senior author of a new study published in the journal Nature Communications that looks into the usage of agenT-797, MiNK Therapeutic's allogeneic, unmodified invariant natural killer T (iNKT) cell therapy.

The iNKT cell therapy has the effect of rescuing depleted T cells and inducing an anti-inflammatory cytokine response, perhaps activating antiviral immunity to assist these patients fight infection while also reducing severe, pathogenic inflammation of the lung.

The new research was carried out at three medical centres and found that agenT-797, which is also under investigation in cancer trials, could be manufactured rapidly, had a tolerable safety profile and appeared to have a positive effect on mortality among critically unwell COVID-19 ARDS patients receiving intensive care.

The exploratory trial included 20 mechanically ventilated patients with severe ARDS secondary to Covid-19. Of the 20 patients in the trial, 14 survived (70 per cent) at 30 days (compared to a control group of 10 per cent), and there was an 80 per cent lower occurrence of bacterial pneumonia amongst those who received the highest dosage of agenT-797, compared to those who received fewer cells.

Twenty-one patients were treated overall (the main trial, plus one under compassionate use), which included five who were also receiving veno-venous extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (VV-ECMO), known as 'the most aggressive salvage therapy' for critically ill patients with ARDS. In VV-ECMO, deoxygenated blood is pumped through a membrane lung and returned to the body via a cannula.

This trial is believed to be the first immune cell therapy of any type to be used in critically unwell patients undergoing VV-ECMO. Survival of the VV-ECMO cohort was 80 per cent after 30 and 90 days, and 60 per cent after 120 days. This compares favourably to the overall survival of 51 per cent for patients with Covid-19 who were treated with just VV-ECMO at the same institution, during the same timeframe.

bridge, England, said, "During this small, exploratory study we observed that MiNK's iNKT cell treatment, which is also

being advanced for people with cancer, triggered an anti-inflammatory response in ARDS patients. "Despite a poor prognosis, critically ill patients treated with this therapy showed favourable mortality rates and those treated at the highest dose also had reduced rates of pneumonia, underscoring the potential application of iNKT cells, and agenT-797 in particular, in treating viral diseases and infections more broadly. "AgenT-797 was manufactured rapidly and as opposed to using patients' cells, it is 'off-the-shelf' and made from healthy donors' cells. The potential of this therapy to be used across a number of severe infections warrants randomised controlled

Dr Marc van Dijk, Chief Scientific Officer at MiNK and co-author of the study said, "These published findings reinforce the unique power and potential of iNKT cells to mitigate severe acute respiratory distress.

## **Research reveals body temperature** is linked to depression

People with depression have higher body temperatures, which suggests that reducing their temperatures may have a mental health advantage, according to a new UC San Francisco re-

The study, published in Scientific Reports, doesn't indicate whether depression raises body temperature or a higher temknown whether the higher body temperature observed in people with depression reflects decreased ability to self-cool, increased generation of heat from metabolic processes or a combination of both. Researchers analyzed data from more

than 20,000 international participants who wore a device that measures body temperature, and also self-reported their body temperatures and depression symptoms daily. The seven-month study began in early 2020 and included data from 106

The results showed that with each increasing level of depression symptom severity, participants had higher body temperatures. The body temperature data also showed a trend toward higher de pression scores in people whose temperatures had less fluctuation throughout a 24hour period, but this finding didn't reach significance

The findings shed light on how a novel depression treatment method might work, said Ashley Mason, PhD, the study's lead author and associate professor of psychiatry at UCSF Weill Institute for Neuro-



sciences. A small body of existing, causal studies has found that using hot tubs or saunas can reduce depression, possibly by triggering the body to self-cool, for example, through sweating.

"Ironically, heating people up actually can lead to rebound body temperature lowering that lasts longer than simply cooling people down directly, as through an ice bath," said Mason, who is also a clinical psychologist at the UCSF Osher Center for Integrative Health. "What if we can track the body temperature of people with depression to time heat-based treat-

## Israeli report shows Mediterranean is getting warmer and saltier

srael's Ministry of Environmental Protection, Ministry of Energy and Infrastruc-Lture and its Seas and Lakes Research Institute published the 2022 Mediterranean National Monitoring Report.

The report emphasizes the continuation some" trends: warming, salinization, acidification and rising water levels, alongside waste and pollution in coastal streams that originate from human activity. The decrease in pollutant concentrations in the sea water and on the ground continues.

It is based on a multi-year monitoring of a variety of physical, chemical and biological data required to understand the "health state" of the sea. The monitoring findings indicate the nature of the impact of the actions at the local and global level and reveal unusual events and trends with a long-term impact that Israel is dealing with.

The reports present the monitoring findings based on measurements and samples collected during 2022. The findings were analyzed and compiled into reports in the first half of 2023 and reviewed by the expert advisory committee that met in July 2023 and then by the inter-ministerial steering committee that finally approved the reports in December 2023.

Israel's expanded national monitoring program has been operating since 2019, jointly funded by the Marine Pollution Prevention Fund at the Ministry of Environmental Protection and the Ministry of Energy and




Infrastructure. The implementation is entrusted to the Society for the Exploration of Seas and Lakes of Israel (Haval), according to the State of Israel's commitment to the Barcelona Convention. ## Implementing UCC: Goa to Uttrakhand

he Uttarakhand government introduced legislation on the Uniform Civil Code (UCC) in the state Assembly .The UCC aims to replace distinct personal laws of every religion, focusing on marriage, divorce, adoption, and inheritance, guided by Article 44 of the Constitution. The enforcement of UCC would help narrow down the religious divide in a country like India where people of different religions reside.

Article 162 of the Indian Constitution indicates that the executive power of a State extends to matters with re-

spect to which the Legislature of the State has power to make laws.

As per the provisions of Entry 5 of the Concurrent List of the Seventh Schedule, the constitution of a Committee to introduce and implement Uniform Civil Code (UCC) per se cannot be challenged as being ultra vires to the constitution.

Entry 5 of the Concurrent List deals with "marriage and divorce"; infants and minors; adoption; wills, intestacy, and succession; joint family and partition; all matters in respect of which parties in judicial proceedings were immediately before the commencement of this Constitution subject to their personal law.

If UCC is enacted, Uttarak hand will become the first state in post-Independence India to adopt the UCC, following in the footsteps of Goa (Portuguese Civil Code of 1867), where it has been operational since the days of Portuguese rule.

An Uttarakhand Government-appointed panel, led by retired Supreme Court judge Ranjana Prakash Desai, had drafted a four-volume, 749page report containing several recommendations. It can be noted that in the UCC are a complete ban on polygamy

and child marriage, a standardised marriageable age for girls across all faiths, and a uniform process for divorce.

The UCC aims to check & discourage sanctioned practices such as halala and iddat (Islamic practices a woman must go through after a divorce or the death of the husband), promote the declaration of live-in relationships, and simplify adoption proce-

It excludes population control measures and the Scheduled Tribes, constituting 3 per cent of Uttarakhand's population the Code leaves out most LGBT persons

from its ambit.

Other seminal features of the UCC include equal property rights for sons and daughters, elimination of distinctions between legitimate and illegitimate children, and equal treatment for adopted and biologically born chil-

Uttarakhand govt has consciously excluded the members of the Scheduled Tribes (ST's) from the purview of this Code, and it does not disturb those cuspractices pertaining to family law that are protected under the Constitution.


