#### 2-month old among 4 killed, 2 hurt in mud houses collapse in J&K

**JAMMU:** Four persons including a two-month old child were killed and two others suffered injuries when mud houses collapsed due to a landslide triggered by heavy rains in Reasi district of Jammu and Kashmir. Police here on Sunday said that in the intervening night of Saturday-Sunday, a woman and her three daughters died while they were asleep. "Due to inclement weather conditions, the mud house of Mohammad Farid collapsed in remote village Kunderdhan Morha Band in Chassana belt," police said. They said that a woman identified as Phalla Akther, 30, wife of Mohammad Farid and daughters namely Nasima Akther, 5, Safen Kousar, 3 and Samreen Kousar (2 months) died on the spot. However, in a separate house collapse incident one Kalu, 60 and his wife Bano Begum, 58 sustained injuries.

#### Punjab's GST mop-up rises 16 pc to over Rs 19,000 cr till Feb

**CHANDIGARH:** The Goods and Services Tax (GST) collection in Punjab jumped 15.69 per cent to Rs 19,222 crore in the current financial year so far, while the state's excise revenue rose 11.71 per cent to Rs 8,093.59 crore. The net GST collection up to February in the current fiscal year stood at Rs 19,222.5 crore, up from Rs 16,615.52 crore collected during the same period of the preceding fiscal, finance minister Harpal Singh Cheema said on Sunday. Cheema further said that the state's excise revenue also witnessed an impressive growth of Rs 842.72 crore with the overall collection of Rs 8,093.59 crore as against Rs 7,244.87 crore recorded during the same period a year ago, according to an official statement.

#### CBI arrests NHA officer in bribery case

**NAGPUR:** The Central Bureau of Investigation has arrested a senior official of the National Highways Authority of India (NHA) Arvind from Nagpur on demanding bribery of 45 lakhs of the total amount for clearing the pending bills. "The said officer has asked for Rs 45 lakh total bribery amount and the first installment," the agency said. "Private individuals and companies are also involved in the bribery case and they are also part of the CBI investigation," they added. CBI is conducting searches in five places in Bhopal and Nagpur at the premises and residences of the accused person.

#### BJP Asansol candidate Pawan Singh steps aside from LS contest

## Farmer leaders give 'rail roko' call for Mar 10, to reach Delhi on 6th

Farmer leaders Sarwan Singh Pandher and Jagjit Singh Dallewal on Sunday gave a call to the farmers across the nation to reach Delhi on March 6 for a protest while they also gave a four-hour 'rail roko' countrywide call for March 10 in support of their various demands.

The two farmer leaders asserted that the farmers' ongoing agitation will be intensified at the existing protest points and will continue till their demands are met by the government.

They were speaking in Bathinda district's Balloh village, the native village of a farmer who died recently during clashes with the Haryana security personnel in Khanauri.

Dallewal announced that a 'rail roko' protest will be held across the country from 12 PM to 4 pm on March 10, seeking people's support to make the agitation successful. "Our program to march to Delhi is as it is, we've not stepped back from it. It has been decided that we will increase our strength on the



borders. On March 6, farmers will come to (Delhi) from all over the country by train, bus, air and we will see whether the government will allow them to sit there or not. On March 10, we will hold 'Rail Roko' protest across the country from 12 pm to 4 pm," he said. Earlier, the Delhi police on Monday opened service lanes at Singhu and Tikri border points with Haryana, two weeks after these were sealed in view of the farmers' "Delhi Chalo" march. "We were in the process of opening service lanes at

Singhu and Tikri borders. Locals will not face problems while commuting," a senior police officer said.

But the deployment of police and paramilitary forces will ensure strict vigil round the clock, the officer added. Last week, the city police removed two huge cement barriers for commuters who walk towards Delhi using a small passage at the Singhu and Tikri borders.

"The process took time as those barriers were made of concrete. Opening of these lanes

will ensure vehicles will reach their destinations easily," said the officer. Singhu and Tikri points were sealed on February 13 as protesting farmers from Punjab began their march to the national capital to press the Centre for their demands, including a legal guarantee on Minimum Support Price (MSP) for crops and farm loan waiver.

Thousands of farmers have been staying put at Khanauri and Shambhu on Punjab's border with Haryana along with their tractor-trolleys and trucks after their march to the national capital to press the Centre for various demands, including a legal guarantee of minimum support price (MSP) for crops, was stopped by security forces.

The march, spearheaded by the Samyukta Kisan Morcha (Non-Political) and Kisan Mazdoor Morcha (KMM), was put on hold by farmer leaders for two days after a protester was killed and around 12 police personnel were injured in clashes at Khanauri. The incident took place when some protesting farmers were trying to head towards barricades.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi today presented a Vision India document for 2047, saying planning for a "Viksit Bharat" (Developed India) by 2047 is a priority area, sources told NDTV. At a meeting of the Council of ministers today, he said

The plan hinges on empowering citizens and creating a sustainable economy. The 25-year-plan envisages India as a developed nation providing leadership to the world in terms of technology and innovation.

The vision document has been



prepared after more than 2700 meetings across ministries from December 2021 to January 2024. The government has examined 450 recommendations and consulted 15 stakeholders. The Prime Minister spoke for an hour in at the meet, which was attended by ministers and

departmental secretaries.

Sources said he spoke about the ? 1 lakh crore in budget to future technologies and ways to harness that so India leads in innovation. He also spoke of age-related demography changes – of ageing populations and the challenge it involves. PM Modi is believed to have asked for Viksit Bharat seminars to be included in the agenda of every department, which have been asked to prepare ideas and action plans.

Business bodies like CII (Confederation of Indian Industries) and FICCI (Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry) should also be urged to start

dialogue on this, he said. PM Modi also asked ministers and officials to go through the records of respective ministries to see how decisions evolved in the past, and how ideas have changed over the last 25 years. He spoke about maximum government and minimum governance, focusing on progressive government and proactive good governance. According to sources, it involved a whole-government approach involving all ministries & wide-ranging consultations with State governments, academia, industry bodies, civil society, scientific organisations and the mobilisation of youth to seek their ideas, suggestions and inputs.

## Shehbaz Sharif becomes Pakistan's PM for second time

Shehbaz Sharif on Sunday became the prime minister of Pakistan for a second time to lead a coalition government after he comfortably won a majority in the newly-elected Parliament. Shehbaz, 72, who was the consensus candidate of the Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) and the Pakistan Peoples Party (PPP), received 201 votes in



the 336-member house. Shehbaz's challenger Omar Ayub Khan of jailed former prime minister Imran Khan's Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) secured 92 votes. Sharif's sole competitor Omar

Ayub Khan, a joint candidate of the Sunni Ittehad Council (SIC) and former Prime Minister Imran Khan's Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf, secured 92 votes, said the speaker. The speaker announced that Sharif had been declared as the prime minister of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan. A total of 169 votes were required through division of the house election in the 336-member National Assembly.

## Harsh Vardhan quits politics, says, "My ENT clinic too awaits my return"

Former Union Health Minister Harsh Vardhan on Sunday announced his decision to quit electoral politics. This came after the BJP on Saturday announced its first list of candidates for the upcoming Lok Sabha elections. Chosing new faces in Delhi, the party dropped four sitting MPs-Harsh Vardhan, Parvesh Verma, Ramesh Bidhuri and Meenakshi Lekhi. Announcing his decision in a long series of posts on X, Vardhan said he is returning to his ENT clinic at Krishna Nagar. "After over thirty years of a glorious electoral career, during which I won all the five assembly and two parliamentary elections that I fought with exemplary margins, and held a multitude of prestigious positions in the party organisation and the governments at the state and centre I finally bow out to return to my roots," he said. "Service to mankind was my motto when I joined MBBS in GSV Medical College, Kanpur fifty years back with a desire to help the poor and needy. A swayamsewak at heart, I have always been an ardent admirer of Deen Dayal Upadhyay ji's Antodaya



philosophy of striving to serve the last man in the queue. It was at the insistence of the then RSS leadership that I jumped into the electoral fray. They could convince me only because for me politics meant opportunity to fight our three main enemies - poverty, disease and ignorance," he added. The former minister's post added: "Without remorse, I must say that it has been a marvelous innings during which my passion to serve the common man was quenched. I served as Delhi Health Minister as well as twice Union Health Minister, a subject close to my heart. I had the rare opportunity bestowed upon me to be able to first work towards creating a Polio free Bharat and then to take care of the health of millions of our countrymen grappling with the dreaded COVID-19 during its first and second phases".

## In BJP's 1st list, message against MPs who made hate speech headlines

As the BJP released its first list of 195 candidates for Lok Sabha polls, some omissions stood out more than the names that made it to the list. These include firebrand leader Pragya Thakur and sitting MPs from Delhi, Parvesh Sahib Singh Verma and Ramesh Bidhuri.

The three leaders have made headlines for their controversial remarks inside and outside Parliament, and the BJP's move to drop them sends a message that the party is taking no chances ahead of an election in which it faces a



joint Opposition. In Bhopal, the BJP has replaced Pragya Thakur with Alok Sharma. An accused in the 2008 Malegaon bombings case, the firebrand leader's nomination last time had sparked a huge row. The

five years since then have seen her getting caught in several controversies. Out on bail on health grounds, Ms Thakur has been seen playing kabaddi and attending garba nights. But the controversy that may have

harmed her the most is a statement in which she called Nathuram Godse, the man who shot Mahatma Gandhi dead, a "patriot". The remark drew a stern response from none other than Prime Minister Narendra Modi. "The remarks made about Gandhiji or Nathuram Godse are very bad and very wrong for society. She has sought an apology, but I would never be able to forgive her fully," he said. Five years on, Ms Thakur has lost her seat. Ms Thakur was at the centre of another row for her remarks on former Mumbai ATS chief Hemant Karkare, who died during the 2008 terror attacks. She had said he

was killed because of her "curse". Party sources said the firebrand leader was not active in her constituency, and that played a key role in her being dropped. A key omission in the BJP list that surprised many was West Delhi MP Parvesh Sahib Singh Verma. A two-time MP and son of former Chief Minister, late Sahib Singh Verma, he is known to have a strong support base. But the 46-year-old leader has been in the news for his inciting remarks. Ahead of the 2020 Delhi elections, Mr Verma had made controversial remarks during the Shaheen Bagh protest and said the demonstrators would be

cleared in an hour if the BJP came to power in the national capital. In 2022, Mr Verma hit headlines again, this time for a public boycott call seemingly aimed at Muslims. "Wherever you see them, if you want to fix their head, if you want to set them straight, then the only cure is total boycott. Raise your hand if you agree," the BJP MP had said. Going into the 2024 polls, the BJP has its goals clear. It wants to keep the focus on Prime Minister Modi's 'Viksit Bharat @2047' call and does not want its leaders to make statements that serve as fodder for the Opposition and embarrass the ruling party.

These announcements were made by the Chief Minister during an MoU signing ceremony organized at Haryana Bhawan, New Delhi for developing Agroha as prominent archaeological site. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Archaeological Survey of India and Department of Archaeological and Museums, Haryana in the presence of Haryana Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal. Haryana Vidhan Sabha Speaker, Sh.



Gyanchand Gupta, who has been recently nominated as Chairman of Agroha Development Project (ADP), along with Haryana Minister for Urban Local Bodies, Dr Kamal Gupta, who is also Co-Chairman of ADP were also present on the occasion.

The Chief Minister said that a statue of Maharaja Agrasen will be set up in the premises of Hisar Airport and the statue would be made with the cooperation of Vaish Samaj. He said that he had named the world's largest

Hisar Airport after the name of Maharaja Agrasen, though none asked for it. He said that the Maharaja Agrasen chair would be set up for taking up research and study on Maharaja Agrasen.

Talking about the evolution of human civilization, the Chief Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal said that evidences have been found that the habitation mainly happened near the rivers and river Saraswati, which has its origin from Aadibadri (Yamunanagar), also flowed through Haryana.

Over a period of time, due to excavations and mining, the river Saraswati got merged with other rivers but pictures received from satellite indicate that the river Saraswati, initiating from Aadibadri fell into the sea after flowing through parts of Haryana, Rajasthan and Gujarat. Many habitations came up along this river, out of which Agroha was one of them. The remains of ancient city Agroha is buried under this mound. This site was excavated from 1978 to 1981. Presently it is a centrally protected monument of National importance. It is an early historical site covering the stages of history from 4th century BCE to the 14th century CE. Buried in these significant ruins are evidences of the capital of the Agroha state, which was the so-called capital of Maharaja Agrasen, the famous king of the Agrawal community.

## Hrypeople get another 'jumla' in form of Prahari Yojana: Varun

Congress MLA from Mullan, Varun Chaudhary, during the Assembly budget session, asked Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar about the district-wise number of people above 80 years of age, the number of government employees who got the responsibility of this program and their designation, regarding the Sentinel Scheme. The duty of meeting the elderly once in two months has been assigned and what is the number of elderly people whom these government employees personally meet and what is frequency/sequence of their meeting, and whether the government provides assistance to the elderly above 80 years of age. Asked for information regarding any data being collected regarding the needs/requirements on which Chief Minister

Shri Manohar Lal Khattar, while giving information on the MLA's question, said that under the Sentinel Scheme, a "Prahari App" was launched on 26.06.2023 in which information is being entered by the Sentinels. Instructions have been given to the guards to enter information about persons above 75 years of age and to meet them regularly. However, there is no specific data available on the Prahari App for senior citizens above 80 years of age. A total of 12,421 employees ranging from constable to sub-inspector and home guard/special police officer have been appointed as sentinels/assistant sentinels and have been given the responsibility of meeting elderly per-

sons once in 15 days. In this regard, Sentinels and Assistant Sentinels are meeting the elderly as per the standing order issued, but under the Sentinel Scheme, such details are not being uploaded in the Sentinel App at present. This type of information is not being collected by Haryana Police under the Sentinel Scheme. Speaking through the media on the information given by the Chief Minister, the MLA said that in the form of Sentinel Scheme, the BJP



government has given another 'jumla' to the people of Haryana that every 15 days the government employees will visit the homes of the elderly and inquire about their condition. While the information shows that this is just an announcement, no work has

been done on this scheme on the ground. MLA said that the Chief Minister had started this Prahari Yojana during the last budget and had said that under this scheme, police officers will meet the elderly people above 80 years of age to know their needs and requirements, but the information shows that till date No police officer has even met any elderly person. Because even the police officers do not know that under this scheme they have to meet the elderly people and what further action has to be taken after the meeting. The police department itself is not aware of this. Complete information about the program is not available. The MLA said that the BJP government should work on the ground for the interests of the people of the state instead of entangling them in statements.

Doomsday thesis

As India hurtles towards a predicted apocalyptic election, the question is not whether the Bharatiya Janata Party will score another resounding victory but how it will use its triumph. That uncertain future recalls my first meeting in 1962 with Nirad C. Chaudhuri. As I wrote in a centenary tribute in Time magazine 35 years later, Chaudhuri sought my opinion on a scattering of tents across the road from the balcony of his flat near Delhi's Kashmiri Gate. I said they housed construction workers who would go away when their job was done. "No!" he exclaimed vehemently. "They will never go away. That is Hindu India coming into its own!"

He did not have in mind the benignity of Rudyard Kipling's short story, The Miracle of Purun Bhagat, in which the author rebuts racism accusations by affirming that "so long as there is a morsel to divide in India, neither priest nor beggar starves." The title of Chaudhuri's last volume of memoirs, taken from Alexander Pope's "Thy hand, great Anarch! lets the curtain fall;/ And universal Darkness buries All", hints at a more sinister conclusion. He may even have come to believe in Churchill's theory of a conspiracy of "Brahmins who mouth and patter the principles of Western Liberalism, and pose as philosophic and democratic politicians... [but] deny the primary rights of existence to nearly sixty millions of their own fellow countrymen whom they call 'untouchable', and whom they have by thousands of years of oppression actually taught to accept this sad position."

The long overdue provision for fast-track citizenship for beleaguered Hindus from several neighbouring countries gives some indication of Narendra Modi's threatened "big decisions" during a third term that is almost taken for granted. Many supposedly revolutionary changes are bound to be little more than semantic. For instance, 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' only repackages Jawaharlal Nehru's familiar 'import substitution' mantra while the original of the proudly advertised 'Amrit Bharat Station Scheme' must seem even more repetitive since the first passenger train between Bombay and Thane in 1853 obviously needed stations. So did the East Indian Railway's Calcutta-Delhi link line finalised by 1846. The drive for 'Akhand Bharat' may no longer hold central position in the BJP's thinking just as consolidation of the sad remains of Gulab Singh's kingdom of Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh may seem more important now than getting back 'Pakistan-occupied Kashmir'.

India-Nepal enhance financial cooperation

Nepal's Ambassador to India, Shankar Sharma on Saturday appreciated the new guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India, which allow multiple financial services between the people of India and Nepal.

He said that now Nepal citizens can send Rs 2 lakh per transaction to Nepal and walk-in customers can remit Rs 50,000 per transaction. The Nepal envoy also said that Unified Payment Interface-Nepal Clearing House Ltd, which is to be inaugurated soon, will further eliminate any inconvenience of carrying cash.

"RBI's updated regulation allows Nepali account holders to send Rs 2 lakhs per transaction (without any limit) to. Walk-in customers can remit Rs. 50,000 per transaction (12 per yr). The soon-to-be-inaugurated UPI/NCHL mechanism will eliminate inconvenience of carrying cash," Sharma posted on X on Saturday.

Last December, Indian Ambassador to Nepal, Naveen Srivastava, announced that the digital payment gateway between India and Nepal is expected to start in the first phase at the end of February 2024.

Protest in PoK on March 5th

The POK rights activist's video statement further highlighted the possibility of a violent outburst by the people, as they are now fed up with the living conditions.

Another general strike is on the way in Pakistan-Occupied Kashmir (POK) on March 5. This general strike is going to be very robust, as the people are now fed up and angry.

Previously, there have been three general strikes; the latest one was on February 5, and now it is exactly one

month after the previous general strike.

The people are going to bring their shutters down, protest, and organise rallies, and this time, unlike the last time, the Joint Awami Action Committee (AAC), trade unions and other social organisations have been threatening that they are going to give a big surprise on March 5.

It seems that there is a likelihood of this protest turning violent, causing a lot of casualties, and arrests.

Moreover, preparations for this strike have already begun in the various parts of PoK, like Kotli, Rawalakot, Muzaffarabad, Bagh and Mirpur. All of these cities have geared up for this strike.

He further said that these strikes are taking place in the backdrop of increased taxes on electricity bills, a lack of flour and wheat, and a lack of basic amenities and public facilities in Pakistani-occupied Kashmir.

No water, medical supplies in US' humanitarian aid airdrops into Gaza



The United States, in collaboration with the Royal Jordanian Air Force, conducted an unprecedented humanitarian airdrop into Gaza, delivering 38,000 meals along the besieged coastal enclave, CNN reported, citing a statement from US Central Command (CENTCOM).

This initiative followed President Joe Biden's remarks that the US would pull out "every stop" to get more aid into the besieged coastal enclave.

The operation, executed by the US Air Force using C-130 aircraft, saw a total of 66 bundles dropped along the Gaza coastline, with each of the three aircraft contributing 22 bundles. Notably, the airdropped supplies consisted solely of meals, with no inclusion of water or medical provisions, as reported by CNN.

"These airdrops are part of a sustained effort to get more aid into Gaza, including by expanding the flow of aid through land

corridors and routes," CENTCOM said in their statement.

White House officials hailed the operation as a success, viewing it as a pivotal test case for future endeavours. A senior administration official, during a call with reporters, said, "The fact that today's airdrop was successful is an important test case to show that we can do this again in the coming days and weeks successfully."

While applauding the accomplishment, President Biden acknowledged on social media that the amount of aid reaching Gaza was still insufficient. He reiterated the US commitment to spare no effort in increasing aid, aligning with his previous declaration to "pull out every stop" to address the humanitarian crisis in Gaza.

In response to the airdrop, the Defence Department plans to conduct additional operations in the coming days, though specific details were not disclosed.

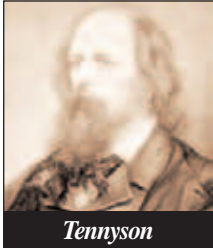

Study reveals role of cholesterol in pain perception

When you stub your toe or hit your head, you know that rubbing the area can help relieve the pain. But how? New research from the work of Scott B. Hansen, Ph.D., demonstrates how physical pressure on cells may reduce pain signals, whereas excessive cholesterol clumps in cell membranes can interfere with that.

The research, carried out at The Herbert Wertheim UF Scripps Institute for Biomedical Innovation & Technology, appears in the scientific journal eLife.

Hansen and his colleagues' discoveries are important for several reasons. They show for the first time that cell membrane lipids, or fats, help send an electrical pulse into cells after experiencing pressure and force. The research illuminates the path that pain signals



take from an injury site to the brain, and connects the many biological players involved. Importantly, the research shows how excess cholesterol in cell

membranes may interfere with pain control."Excess cholesterol is a feature in many diseases and disorders, including diabetes and diseases of aging," said

Hansen, an associate professor of molecular medicine at The Wertheim UF Scripps Institute. "This could be one explanation for why we see more chronic pain in these groups."

The study also adds to mounting evidence that the fatty molecules that make up cell membranes require structure to perform their many duties, he added. "Originally, science thought only proteins had structures with function," said Hansen. "It looks like the lipids can be added to that list."

A cell is made of a fatty exterior membrane encasing a water-based interior. Advanced microscopes and other new technologies are revealing that the cell membrane isn't simply a fatty sac, though. Rather, it's a sophisticated collection of sensors, pores, channels, receptors and cholesterol clumps held in

place by precisely arranged fat molecules.

"There are two types of fats in the membrane, one is fluid, like olive oil, and a second contains cholesterol and is found as tiny, rigid clumps, more like lard," Hansen said. "It wasn't known that those fats might play a role in pain signaling." To feel pain, first, the injury must be sensed. Second, that injury message must convert to a signal that can travel rapidly through the body and be interpreted by the brain. The lipid structure appears to sense the force and convert it into a signal. The signal can then help activate the body's own pain-relieving responses -- so long as there's no interference -- lessening pain's severity. Scientists have previously documented the role of a mechanical force-sensing enzyme called PLD2 in these steps and

its ability to activate a pain-relief providing potassium channel called TREK-1. Missing was an understanding of how PLD2 and TREK-1 could be activated by the membrane. PLD2 lacked the ability to sense tension, the typical way that mechanosensors are engaged. Membrane lipids weren't considered, perhaps because they were poorly understood, due to technical limitations.

"Until recently, the study of these cholesterol-containing lipid clumps, also called lipid rafts, has been difficult, because they are too small to be seen by a regular light microscope," Hansen said. Using a special microscope, Hansen and colleagues documented in several cell types that pressure and stretching, or "shear," caused changes to those fat molecules that temporarily altered the cell's ability to activate pain relief.

The Meteorological Centre Srinagar said that the ski resort of Gulmarg in north Kashmir's Baramulla district received 35cm of snowfall and 44 cm of rainfall during the past 24 hours till 0830 hours on Sunday. Srinagar and other plains of the Kashmir Valley experienced moderate to heavy rains, resulting in the inundation of several low-lying areas. Srinagar received 38.9mm of rainfall during the past 24 hours till 0830 hours on Sunday, while Qazigund on the Srinagar-Jammu national highway in south Kashmir received 81.0mm, Pahalgam 39.5mm and 1.0cm of snowfall, Kupwara 445mm of rainfall and 9.0cm of snowfall, and 38.1mm of rainfall during the period, the MeT office said. It said that there is a possibility of light rain or snow over scattered places during the intervening nights of March 6 and 7, but there is no significant weather activity till March 10 in Jammu and Kashmir. Meanwhile, the night temperature witnessed a drop at most of the stations and stayed below normal in Kashmir Valley on Sunday.
