HC sets aside suspension of 7 **BJP MLAs from Delhi Assembly**

NEW DELHI: The Delhi High Court on Wednesday set aside the suspension of seven BJP MLAs from the Legislative Assembly for interrupting Lieutenant Governor V K Saxena's address at the start of the Budget session.

The seven Bharativa Janata Party (BJP) MLAs --Mohan Singh Bisht, Ajay Mahawar, O P Sharma, Abhay Verma, Anil Bajpai Jitender Mahajan and Vijender Gupta -- moved the court last month, challenging their suspension from the Assembly till the conclusion of the proceedings before the privileges committee. "The writ petitions are allowed," Justice Subramonium Prasad said while pronouncing the or-

Rajasthan CM **Bhajan Lal Sharma tests** positive for COVID-19

JAIPUR: Rajasthan Chief Minister Bhaian Lal Sharma tested positive for COVID-19 on Wednesday. "I got my health test done today following some problems related to my health. My Covid report has come positive. I am in self-isolation. I am completely fol-

lowing the advice of doctors and will participate in all the upcoming programs virtually," Sharma said in a post on 'X'.
On receiving the informa-

tion, former Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot wished Sharma a "speedy recovery". "I was informed that Chief Minister Shri Bhajan Lal Sharma has tested positive for Covid. I wish him speedy recovery," Gehlot posted on 'X'. Last month, former Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot also tested positive for COVID-19 and swine flu. In a post on X, the senior Congress leader said, "Due to fever for the last few days, got tested today on the advice of doctors, which confirmed Covid and swine flu. Because of this I will not be able to meet for the next seven days," he wrote on X. The former Chief Minister was admitted to the IDH centre of SMS Hospital in

Jaipur for better recovery.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi met the women victims of sexual assault in Sandesh khali village of West Bengal on Wednesday," sources said.

Issuing a contempt notice to the West Bengal CID, the Calcutta High Court observed on Wednesday that an investigation into the attack on ED officials should be handed over to the CBI and the custody of accused Sheikh Shahjahan be done today.

"The accused is a political influencer. The investigation should be handed over to the CBI and the custody of the accused by 4:15 pm today," the High Court said.

The Delhi Police said that no permission was given to famers to hold protests at Jantar

Mantar and cited the February 26 directive that prohibited protesters from entering The development comes as farmers' organisations gave a call to farmers from

across the country to reach the national capital on Wednesday to press forward their demands, including a legal guarantee on a minimum support price for crops. The call for farmers to

reach Delhi on March 6 was



given three days ago by the Mazdoor Morcha (KMM) and the Samyukta Kisan Morcha (non-political) (SKM), the two main umbrella bodies leading the farmer's

agitation.

Since they launched their 'Dilli Chalo' protest march on February 13, the farmers have been camping at the Shambhu and the Khanauri border points between Puniab and Harvana. The two farmers' organi-

sations have denounced the directive, saying it was an attempt to suppress their voices and undermine their right to peaceful protest.

The primary objective behind the call to march to Delhi on March 6 was to challenge the narrative that farmers cannot protest without tractors and trolleys.

Sources from the farm ers' unions told India Today they were aware of the likelihood of being barred from entering Delhi.

The farmers are seeing 'Dilli Chalo' protest march as "an opportunity to showcase their determination and resilience in the face

of adversity", sources said. Farmers from Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, and Rajasthan are expected to move towards Delhi on buses and trains

Anticipating stiff resistance from the Delhi Police. the farmers have vowed to take out protests similar to the one at Shambhu border in

their respective states. Sarvan Singh Yadav, a protesting farmer who was heading to Delhi from Uttar Pradesh's Firozabad, said, "I and my fellow protesters are

Google Pay, PhonePe gain customers after RBI's curbs on Paytm

Google and Walmart Inc. are rapidly gaining customers from Paytm, the fintech pioneer struggling to navigate central bank restrictions and the potential shutdown of a key payments affiliate.

The value of Paytm payments made on India's state-backed transactions system fell 14% to 1.65 trillion rupees (\$19.9 billion) from January, the National Payments Council of India said on its website Wednesday. Walmart-owned PhonePe and Google's GPay, which both process far more payments than No. 3 Paytm, each had an increase in their pay-

Paytm's decline suggests consum-

disruption to its systems. The new curbs affecting Paytm are kicking in on March 15, and even after that the company expects its digital payments services to keep running as before. Yet the firm's stock has slumped since the regulator unveiled its action in late January, on concern the restrictions will crimp the fintech pioneer's The value of transactions

processed by PhonePe rose nearly 7%, while GPay witnessed an almost 6% rise, NPCI data showed. Also when measured by payments volumes, Paytm declined while PhonePe and GPay

Interface, but it provides them with a massive catchment of hundreds of millions of consumers to whom they can cross-sell services such as insurance and mutual funds. The Reserve Bank of India on Jan. 31 ordered Paytm Payments Bank - which isn't controlled by Paytm but which processes much of its payments and financial services - to halt much of its business. Though Paytm has quickly pulled together other bank partnerships to stay in business, the regulator's move triggered a sharp slide in its stock and hit cus-

tomer sentiment. Shares in Paytm are dow almost 50% since late January.

Police arrest two accused in gunhouse theft case; 12 stolen weapons recovered

The ongoing drive against anti-social elements launched on the directions of Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann got a major breakthrough after Amritsar Commissionerate Police proactively cracked the Gunhouse theft case with the arrest of two accused persons after recovering 12 weapons along with 21 cartridges from their possession, said Director General of Police (DGP) Punjab Gaurav Yadav here on Wednesday.

DGP Gaurav Yadav said that at least 10 teams from CIA staff - 1 and 2 of Amritsar Commissionerate were formed, who meticulously carried out technical and scientific investigations, managed to arrest the accused persons after a hot chase of 1000+ kilometres across five states /

Sharing more details, CP Amritsar Gurpreet Singh Bhullar said that Police teams under the supervision of DCP City Dr Pragya Jain and DCP

Detective Harpreet Singh Mander led by ADCP City-2 Prabhjot Singh Virk and ADCP Detective Navjot Singh thoroughly investigated this blind case and followed the trail of accused persons, who flee from Punjab same day fearing arrest and went to Chandigarh, Panipat, Delhi, Agra, Ayodhya and Haryana U.P, before retiring back to Amritsar. He said that preliminary investigations have revealed that after committing the incident, accused persons had safely concealed the





RBI revises guidelines for issuance of Credit Cards to customers

AGENCY NEW DELHI, MAR 6

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) revised its guidelines for the issuance of credit cards on Wednesday and asked the card issuers not to enter into any agreements with any card networks that restrain them from availing services of other card networks.

The RBI's action comes after it observed that some arrangements existing between card networks and issuers are not conducive to the availability of choice for customers, the Central Bank said in a circular to all card issuers.

"Card issuers shall not enter into any arrangement or agreement with card networks that restrains them from availing the services of

RBI said, adding that card Express Banking Corp., Diners Club International

issuers shall provide an option to their eligible customers to choose from multiple card networks at the time of issue. For existing cardholders, this option may be provided at the time of the next renewal.



Editorial Unsuitable vacancy

On the night the Congress's Himachal Pradesh government was brought to the brink by a revolt in the legislature party — the revolt remains in ferment and the government, the only toehold the Congress has in the north, is yet to be secured from the brink — an email floated into my inbox. It was from one of those who set up Rahul Gandhi's hugely voter-intensive engagements in foreign locations and its timing was as odd as it was unsurprising. Quoted verbatim, this is what the mail said: "Rahul delivering as I send this the keynote address at a Global Leadership Summit at Jesus College, University of Cambridge." Attached came a photograph of Rahul Gandhi at a lectern.

The question sprung up, like the irrepressible jack-in-the-box, yet again: is he the man who'd have us believe he will see off the authoritarian, cultist, divisive majoritarianism of Narendra Modi? He symbolises a pack of good, even noble, ideas, but is he committed to give them bone, blood and body?

Last seen and heard, Rahul Gandhi was on the second chapter of his yatra somewhere in Bihar where the dice had just turned courtesy a no-longer surprising turncoat act by Nitish Kumar. Last seen and heard, Rahul's spokesperson-in-chief was telling whoever wanted to listen that the unravelling of the Bihar Mahagathbandhan would have no impact on the political fortunes of INDIA. Last seen and heard, INDIA had neither instituted a central secretariat in Delhi, a promise properly buried, nor bothered to push the refresh button on the active membership of INDIA — who's still part of it, who isn't any longer. We hear of a rally planned mid-March in Mumbai but not much more. The BJP's first list of candidates is out. Is a final INDIA arrangement on shared seats in place? Between who and who? Is Mamata Banerjee's Trinamul Congress, for instance, on board? The answer could be yes, the answer could be no. A precise answer, it turns out, is a question: who knows?

There was a time that question had a credible, tangible answer. No longer. We shall come to that answer a little tangentially, though not entirely off context. Late last month, the Congress ceded the Bharuch Lok Sabha seat to the Aam Aadmi Party as part of an election tie-up. The Bharuch exchange meant more than just one parliamentary seat given up for another elsewhere. Bharuch is where the late Ahmed Patel came from. Bharuch is where his son, Faisal Patel, wanted to contest on a Congress ticket from. The Patel scions — Faisal and sister Mumtaz — took the spurning in their stride, expressing no more publicly than "disappointment". But other Patel loyalists took it hard. Close aide and five-term Lok Sabha MP (currently in the Rajya Sabha) Naran Rathwa left the Congress along with son, Sangramsinh Rathwa, and joined the Bharatiya Janata

Hearing relaxing words in sleep slows your heart down

Researchers from the GIGA - Centre of Research Cyclotron at the University of Liege discovered that the body reacts to the external world when sleeping, which explains how sensory input might alter sleep quality.

Researchers at ULiege have collaborated with the University of Fribourg in Switzerland to investigate whether the body is truly disconnected from the external world during sleep. To do so, they focused on how heartbeat changes when we hear different words during sleep. They found that relaxing words slowed down cardiac activity as a reflection of deeper sleep and in comparison to neutral words that did not have such a slowing effect. This discovery is presented in Journal of Sleep Research and sheds new light on brainheart interactions during sleep.

Matthieu Koroma (Fund for Scientific Research - FNRS postdoctoral researcher), Christina Schmidt and Athena Demertzi (both Fund for Scientific Research - FNRS Research Associate) from the GIGA Cyclotron Research Center at ULiege teamed up with colleagues from University of Fribourg to lead a previous study analysing brain data (electroencephalogram) showing that relaxing words increased deep sleep duration and sleep quality, showing that we can positively influence sleep using meaningful words.

By that time, the authors hypothesized that the brain also remains able to interpret sensory information in a way that makes our body more relaxed after hearing relaxing words during sleep. In this new study, the authors had the opportunity to analyze cardiac activity (electrocardiogram) to test this hypothesis and found that the heart slows down its activity only after the presentation of re-



laxing, but not control words. Markers of both cardiac and brain activity were then compared to disentangle how much they contributed to the modulation of sleep by auditory information. Cardiac activity has been indeed proposed to directly contribute to the way we perceive the world, but such evidence was so far obtained in wakefulness. With these results, the ULiege researchers showed that it was also true in sleep, offering a new perspective on the essential role of bodily reactions beyond brain data for our under-

standing of sleep.

"Most of sleep research focuses on the brain and rarely investigates bodily activity", says Dr. Schmidt.

"We nevertheless hypothesize that the brain and the body are connected even when we cannot fully communicate, including sleep. Both brain and body information need then to be taken into account for a full understanding of how we think and react to our environment", explains Dr. Demertzi. "We shared freely our methodology following the

principles of Open Science hoping that the tools that helped to make this discovery will inspire other researchers to study the role played by the heart in other sleep functions. Dr. Koroma advocates.

This work offers a more comprehensive approach about the modulation of sleep functions by sensory information. By looking into the cardiac responses to sounds, we may, for example, study in the future the role of the body in the way sounds influence emotional processing of memories during sleep.

Over 96,000 Afghan migrants returned to country in one month



The Taliban-led Ministry of Refugees and Repatriation has said that more than 96,000 migrants from Iran, Pakistan, and Turkey have returned to Afghanistan in a month, according to TOLOnews.

The ministry noted that assistance has been provided to all returnees.

"In the month of Dalw (January), 96,490 migrants came from Pakistan, Iran, and Turkey. We have committees, at the borders they are given travel allowances, food and non-food assistance, and winter clothes, and they are transferred to their original provinces [states]. Each family is given ten thousand in cash assistance," said Abdul Rahman Rashid, the deputy minister of the Ministry of Refugees and Repatriation, according to TOLOnews.

Concurrently, some of the repatriated migrants are requesting that the Tal-

iban provide them with employment possibilities

Payinda discussed the challenges of migration after returning to the nation with his seven-member family from Pakistan. "They would rob us of our money. We came to Afghanistan because we were unable to travel freely or visit the doctor," he remarked. Millions of people have been compelled to flee the nation due to the hostilities of recent years.

"They took my husband, and later my husband called to say that he had been imprisoned, after four days I went and said give us three days, we will leave from here," said Nazanin, one of the returnees from Iran. "The government should provide job opportunities so that no one goes back to Iran again and all of us can progress our lives in our homeland," another returnee, Khairudin said, according to TOLOnews.

Russia, China considering to install nuclear reactor on moon



The head of Russia's space agency, Roscosmos said that Russia and China are mulling a project which aims to install a nuclear reactor on the Moon in 2033-2035, Russia-based TASS reported.

Roscosmos CEO, Yury Borisov, made the announcement at the World Youth Festival.

"Today, we are seriously considering a project to deliver to the Moon and mount a power reactor there jointly with our Chinese partners somewhere between 2033 and 2035." he said.

Borisov stated that such a mission will have to be automated, with the essential technological solutions almost ready for it, according to TASS report.

In March 2021, Russia's State Space Corporation, Roscosmos and the China National Space Administration (CNSA) signed a memorandum of mutual understanding on behalf of their governments on cooperation in developing the International Lunar Research Station (ILRS), TASS reported.

Under the project, China is planning to send three missions, which include Chang'e 6, Chang'e 7 and Chang'e 8. The first lunar missions will test technology required to develop a roadmap for creating a robotic base for experiments and research that could be operated remotely. The first lunar mission is scheduled for 2026. As per the news report, the project should be completed in 2028.

Researchers find how obesity is a risk factor for stillbirth

According to a study, obesity raises the risk of stillbirth as a pregnancy approaches full term. The study's conclusions were released in the Canadian Medical Association Journal,

or CMAJ.
In Canada, the overall risk of still-birth during pregnancy is roughly 0.4%.
"Our findings suggest that an earlier delivery date may help reduce the risk of stillbirth for pregnant people with obesity," says lead author Dr. Naila Ramji, an assistant professor at Dalhousie University and high-risk pregnancy specialist in Fredericton, New Brunswick. Senior author Dr. Laura Gaudet, an associate professor at Queen's University and



high-risk pregnancy specialist, and coauthors at The Ottawa Hospital round out the group.

Although the link between obesity and stillbirth is well-known, there was little research on the association between obesity and stillbirth risk by gestational age, or on the impact of higher classes of obesity.

To address this gap, the researchers analyzed data from the Better Outcomes Registry and Network on 681 178 singleton births, 1956 of which were stillbirths, in Ontario between 2012 and 2018. After adjusting for other stillbirth risk factors like diabetes and high blood pressure, the researchers found that people with

class I obesity (BMI 30-34.9 kg/m2) had double the risk of stillbirth at 39 weeks' gestation compared to those with normal BMI (18.5-24.9 kg/m2). For those in obesity classes II and III (BMI 35-39.9 kg/m2 and BMI 40 kg/m2 and higher, respectively), stillbirth risk at 36 weeks was 2 to 2.5 times that of people with normal BMI. This risk further increased with gestational age, with a more than fourfold risk at 40 weeks.

"For other medical conditions that increase the risk of stillbirth, there are guidelines that recommend delivery at 38 or 39 weeks. Interestingly, the risk thresholds for those conditions are lower than the risks we found associated

with obesity. We worry that implicit biases against people with obesity may be causing the medical community to take the risks they face less seriously," says Dr. Ramji. The authors also looked at whether stillbirths occurred before or during delivery and found a higher risk of stillbirths occurring before delivery in people with class I and II obesity.

They hope that these findings will improve care for this at-risk population. "Pregnant people with obesity, especially those with additional risk factors may benefit from timely referral and greater surveillance closer to term, and the presence of additional risk factors may warrant earlier delivery," said Dr. Ramji.

"Focusing on weight during communications of risk may reinforce weight bias, weight stigma, and discrimination for pregnant people," writes Dr. Cahill, a registered dietitian. "Negative weight-related attitudes, beliefs, assumptions, and judgments prevalent in society, and harmful social stereotypes that are held about people living with obesity, are associated with adverse physical and mental health consequences." She ends by saying that pregnant people living with obesity "....should receive respectful prenatal care, free from stigma, that realizes the goals of both health care providers and patients to ensure positive maternal and fetal outcomes."


