Haryana Anti-Corruption Bureau Arrests Medical Officer for Bribery

CHANDIGARH: The Haryana Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) team arrested Nitish Parwal, a Medical Officer posted at the Municipal Corporation Faridabad, on charges of soliciting a bribe of Rs. 3 lakh. Parwal allegedly demanded the bribe in exchange for issuing a certificate of waste generator. The arrest took place during a late-evening raid conduct ed by the ACB team, and an FIR (First Information Report) has been registered against him at the Anti-Corruption Bureau Faridabad.

A government spokesperson stated that a tip-off regarding Parwal's demand for a Rs. 3 lakh bribe in exchange for the empanelment certificate was received. Subsequently, the ACB formulated a plan and apprehended him red-handed while accepting the bribe. The entire operation was conducted transparently with witnesses present. The investigation is ongoing, and all evidence is being meticulously collected.

The Bureau's spokesperson urged the public to promptly report any instances of bribe demands from government officials or employees

Four involved in job-providing racket held in Delhi

NEW DELHI: A criminal racket that was involved in offering employment has been busted in New Delhi, with four gang members, including three women, arrested, Delhi Police offi-

cials said. According to the police, the gang operated a 'placement agency' by the name of 'Digi Recruiters' and called over 500 potential victims daily. They obtained bulk data of employment seekers on payment from online job portals, and called victims to various offices in Nehru Place, Kaushambi, among other areas in Delhi, NCR In the process, they cheated large sums in the name of registration, interview, and processing, only to later stop communicating. A multi-victim case under sections 420/406/34 IPC, PS EOW, was registered in Economic Offences Wing, Delhi, on complaints of 29 victims in which it was alleged that they were induced and cheated on the pretext of providing them jobs of drivers, guards, and field boys in

Delhi Metro, among others, police said Police said those criminals had been running their office at Nehru Place, Delhi, since the beginning of 2023. After operating for two-to-three months, the alleged persons had absconded. They had cheated around Rs 7.5 lacs



More relief to the Punjabis from the loot of toll plazas!

CHANDIGARH: Sticking to his commitment to not let anyone loot the people of Punjab, Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann, on Saturday, announced that two toll plazas on Ludhiana-Barnala state highway will be closed on April 2nd at 12PM as their concession period is expiring.

The Dhaka-Halwara-Raikot-Barnala State Highway (SH-13)

is a road with a length of 57.94 km, located in the Ludhiana district. To upgrade this road, the Punjab government approved the Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) scheme in 2007 Rohan Rajdeep Tollways Limited commenced operations under this scheme. According to the agreement, the concession period for this project was 17 years. As per the terms of the agreement, the concession period for this project expires on 02.04.2024, and at 12 PM that day Toll Pala za Raqba (Near Mullanpur Distt. Ludhiana) and Toll Palaza Mehal Kalan (Near Barnala) will cease their operations. After this, no tolls will be collected on this road from the general public, and maintenance will be the responsibility of the Punjab government.

Informing about the same through his X account, CM Mann said that the company, referring to the Covid period and Farmers agitation, requested to increase the time of their tol operations for 448 days but the Punjab government rejected that request. So both the toll plaza will cease their operations and will no longer collect any toll from the general pub

Record food grain production in the state due to improved technology given by scientists: Prof. B.R. Kamboj

CHANDIGARH, MAR 30

Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University organized a seminar on the topic 'Agricultural Scientist - Farmer Dialogue regarding Achievements of Agricultural University'. In the seminar, Vice Chancellor of the University, Prof. B.R. Kamboj acted as the chief guest. The programme was presided over by Former Chairman, HSHEC, Panchkula and former Vice Chancellor, Makhanlal Chaturvedi National University of Journalism and Communication, Bhopal and Chairman, Panchnad Research Institute, Chandigarh The special guest was Jagjit Singh Ghanghas, former chairman of Haryana Electricity Regulatory Commission. This seminar was organized under the aegis of Panchnad Research Institute & Study Centre and CCSHAU Hisar.

Prof. B.R. Kamboj said that due to the continuous research work done by the scientists of Agricultural University, high technologies and hard work of the farmers, there has been a record increase in the food grain production of the state. Food grain production, which was only 2.59 million tonnes at the time of formation of the state, has increased 7 times to 18.43 million tonnes in the year 2022-23. Harvana state is smaller than other

states in terms of area, whereas it is the second largest state contributing to the central food grains stock. More than 60 percent of the country's Basmati rice is exported from Harvana only. He said that the university is preparing and distribut ing more than 20 thousand quintals of seeds of different crops to the farmers annually. One of the aims of the university is to bring agricultural technology to the farmers, in this context the uni versity is regularly providing informaagriculture updates to 6.50 lakh farmers. Apart from this, a data base of 20 farmers from each village of the state has been collected through which agricultural information is being provided.

Prof. Brij Kishore Kuthiala said in his presidential speech that Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University will play an important role in the mission of developed India. Along with establishing dialogue with farmers and youth, he also called for attracting farmers towards agriculture sector and to make agriculture attractive, there is a need for social, economic and psychological change among the youth. It is a matter of great joy that by directly connect ing with the farmers, CCSHAU is not only providing new technologies and varieties to the farmers but is also giving

impetus to its research on the basis of feedback on the problems of the farmers. He said that Panchnad will give more momentum to the campaign of starting dialogue with farmers through CCSHAU. He stressed on the balanced use of pesticides and chemical fertilizers in the agricultural sector.

Special guest Jagjit Singh Ghanghas said that agriculture and power sector are very important for the progress of the nation. Apart from providing cheap electricity to the consumers in the state for the last 10 years, electricity is also being provided to the agricultural sector at the rate of 10 paise per unit. He said that about 13 thousand pending agricultural tube wells have also been connected to electricity. Farmers are also being motivated to do irrigation through solar

pumps. Dr. Neeraj Kumar, Dean and Vice President of the College of Basic Sciences & Humanities, thanked everyone who attended the seminar. Mohit Kumar conducted the stage. On this occasion, State Information Commissioner, Haryana and President of Panchnad Research Institute & Study Centre, Hisar, Dr. Jagbir Singh, Media Advisor Dr. Sandeep Arya and Mohit Kumar and many officials of Panchnad Institute, scientists, farmers and students were present.

Why this sudden concern over protecting judiciary?

uddenly, a group of about 600 lawyers have appeared on the national scene with the noble aim of protecting the independence of the judiciary from the attacks of a vested interest group, and sought the leadership of the Chief Justice of India to save the day. Interestingly, Prime Minister Narendra Modi has joined the chorus and blamed the principal Opposition party for bullying the court

Opposition party for bullying the court.

The charges in the letter to the CJI, dated March 26, are pretty serious. The vested interest group is trying to put pressure on the judiciary and defame courts, especially in cases of corruption involving politicians. These tactics are damaging to our courts and threaten our democratic fabric , the lawyers fear. The group has also concocted the theory of bench fixing which is not just disrespectful and contemptuous but an attack on the honour and dignity of courts , the lawyers said.

They also question the timing of the actions of the group: They do it with very strategic timings, when the nation is all set to head into elections. This remind them of similar antics in 2018-2019 when they took to their 'hit and run' activities, including fabricating wrong parretives.

One would wonder what warranted such an emergency rescue act by the lawyers that is unparalleled in the history of this country. Normally, it is the government of the day that can exert pressure on the judiciary but the petitioners made no such reference. No act of the government is mentioned in the letter either.

While the lawyers refused to identify the so-called vested interest group, the Prime Minister was candid enough to name the Congress, saying to browbeat and bully others is vintage Congress culture. No more than five decades ago had the Congress called for a committed judicing the Prime Minister reasoned.

committed judiciary , the Prime Minister reasoned.

The Prime Minister is right when he dug into the history and brandished the infamous demands made of the judiciary by then Prime Minister Indira Gandhi and her minions. A committed judiciary is a must to further the agenda of the government, her government had said. However, as the Prime Minister himself said it happened some five decades ago when the Congress ruled over the country and its leader was an uncrowned war hero. The Congress, or, for that matter, the entire Opposition combined is in no position to pressure the judiciary, or any instrument of the state, today. In fact, parties in the Opposition have been running pillar to post to retain whatever is left of their own democratic and political rights in the face of the misuse of the law by law enforcement agencies.

Why isn't rising inequality turning into a poll issue?

The view from the penthouse and the pavement is staggeringly different. India s penthouse story is galloping while millions remain poor and 800 million survive on free foodgrains from the government. In 2022, India had 12,495 ultra-highnet-worth individuals (UHNWI), defined as someone with a net worth of \$30 million or more, according to The Wealth Report 2024 by consultancy firm Knight Frank. In 2023, that figure shot up to 13,263, and by 2028, it is expected to become 19,908 -- a 50 per cent jump from 2023, far higher than the global average of a 28.1 per cent rise.

Clearly, India s penthouse dwellers have a lot to celebrate. Significantly, a new working paper from researchers linked to the Paris-based World Inequality Lab points to skyrocketing inequality in the country between 2014-15 and 2022-23, when the rise of top-end inequality has been particularly pronounced in terms of wealth concentration. By 2022-23, the top one per cent income and wealth shares (22.6% and 40.1%) are at their highest historical levels; India s top one per cent income share is among the very highest in the world, higher than even South Africa, Brazil, and the United States, notes the paper, titled Income and Wealth Inequality in India, 1922-2023: The Rise of the Billionaire Raj .

Authored by Nitin Kumar Bharti, Lucas Chancel, Thomas Piketty and Anmol Somanchi, economists affiliated with the World Inequality Lab (WIL), it flags income inequality in 2022-2023. The top one per cent earn on average Rs 5.3 million, 23 times the average Indian (Rs 0.23 million), while the average incomes for the bottom 50 per cent and the middle 40 per cent stood at Rs 71,000 (0.3 times the national average) and Rs 165,000 (0.7 times the national average) respectively. At the very top of the distribution, the richest (approximately) 10,000 individuals (of 920 million Indian adults) earn



on average Rs 480 million (2,069 times the average Indian), it says. Inequality is not news in India. What is remarkable, however, is its escalation in recent years. It would take 941 years for a minimum wage worker in rural India to earn what the top paid executive at a leading Indian garment company earns in a year, says Oxfam, a leading NGO.

Why do so many Indians embrace the India Soaring story when it is not soaring for everyone? In fact, in a country where the

median age is 28, the share of manufacturing, which could generate lots of jobs, has come down to 13 per cent of the overall GDP, compared with 28 per cent in China, according to The World Bank. Even as good times roll for billionaires, India s Human Development Index (HDI) rank is 134 out of 193 countries, according to the UN Development Programme. This, despite numerous government welfare schemes in the past decade and earlier. Many of India s South

Asian neighbours fare better -- Bangladesh ranks 129, Bhutan 125 and Sri Lanka 78 on HDI. All the jaw-dropping data about inequality points to distress on the ground. The glaring cleavage between the distressed and the dazzling, a wafer-thin minority among the super-rich, however, has not translated into a potent political issue as India heads for a general election next month.

Arguably, absolute poverty is coming down if you go by official figures.

How mental health could predict younger women's heart health

eart diseases are generally associated with older adults but the recent increase in heart attacks in young people shows it might be time to revisit the assumption. Now, a new study has found that mental health issues such as anxiety or depression could accelerate the development of cardiovascular risk factors among young and middle-aged women.

The study, presented at the American College of Cardiology s Annual Scientific Session, found that younger women with anxiety or depression were nearly twice as likely to develop high blood pressure, high cholesterol or diabetes over a 10-year period compared to those who did not have these mental health conditions. This puts them nearly on par with men of the same age in terms of heart disease risk, a press statement re-

Young women are often thought of as safe from risks of cardiovascular disease due to the protective effects of estrogen, says study author Giovanni Civieri. "But this study suggests that if a younger woman has depression or anxiety, we should start screening for cardiovascular risk factors to reduce the inci-



dence of cardiovascular disease, Civieri said in the statement. For the study, researchers examined the health records of 71,214 people participating in the Mass General Brigham Biobank, a research program of the Mass General Brigham health system. People who had heart disease or were diagnosed with anxiety or depression after the study began were excluded, the statement elaborated. The findings showed that during a 10-year follow-up period, 38% of participants developed high blood pressure, high cholesterol and/or diabetes.

Banks' GNPAs set to improve further to 2.1% by FY25: Report

The gross non-performing assets (GNPA) of the Indian banking system are set to improve further to up to 2.1 per cent by the end of FY25, a report said on Friday. GNPAs are likely to come at 2.5-2.7 per cent in FY24 and will improve further to 2.1-2.4 per cent by the end of FY25, domestic rating agency Care Ratings said in the report.

It can be noted that the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) began the comprehensive exercise in the middle of the last decade by instructing banks to classify certain stressed assets as NPAs so that the balance sheets represent a true picture.

The rating agency also flagged a list of downside risks, which may result in its estimate not coming true, including a material weakening in asset quality due to the elevated interest rates, the impact of regulatory changes, a



tighter liquidity environment

and global issues.
It said GNPAs surged to 11.2 per cent in FY18 from 3.8 per cent in FY14 due to the AQR process of 2015-16, which pushed banks to recognise NPAs and reduce unnecessary restructuring and added that the stress was em-

anating from the exposure to big-ticket wholesale ad-

Starting from FY19, GN-PAs have been seeing an improvement and touched a decadal low of 3.9 per cent in FY23 and were at 3 per cent in the December quarter of FY24.




