Toddler among 3 killed in Amritsar

**AMRITSAR:** A 35-year-old man has surrendered before Punjab Police after claiming to have killed three of his family members, including his mother and his two-and-a-half-year-old nephew, police said.

Amritpal Singh surrendered late Wednesday after allegedly killing his mother, Manbir Kaur, sister-in-law Avneet Kaur and nephew Samrath in Kandowali village of Ajnala. The police on Thursday said that Singh's brother has been living in Dubai, while his family was in Amritsar. Singh has been taken into custody and the reason behind the murder is yet to be ascertained. The police have recovered all three bodies and an investigation is underway.

LS polls: Navneet Rana files nomination from Amravati

**AMRAVATI:** Sitting MP and BJP leader Navneet Rana and Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi chief Prakash Ambedkar on Thursday filed nominations for the Amravati and Akola Lok Sabha seats, respectively. Speaking to reporters, Ambedkar said Prime Minister Narendra Modi attacks other parties over dynastic politics but the BJP's Akola candidate Anup Dhotre is son of sitting MP Sanjay Dhotre. Addressing a rally before Rana, who had won the Amravati seat in 2019 as an Independent backed by several opposition parties, filed her nomination papers, Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis said the Supreme Court had set aside the 2021 Bombay High Court order and restored her Scheduled Caste certificate.

HC rejects petition to ban cross-gender massages in spa

**NEW DELHI:** The Delhi High Court has dismissed a petition seeking a direction to the authorities to ban cross-gender massages in spa and massage centres. A bench of Acting Chief Justice Manmohan and Justice Manmeet PS Arora noted that a single judge of the high court is already seized of the matter wherein the validity of Guidelines for Operation of Spas/ Massage Centers in Delhi dated 18th August, 2021, issued by the Delhi government has been challenged.

**Child trapped in borewell rescued after 20-hour operation VIJAYAPURA :** After a 20-hour long operation, the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) and State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) teams successfully rescued a one and a half-year-old child on Thursday who had fallen into an open borewell in Lachyan village in Indi taluk, Vijayapura district. The child who fell into a borewell, approximately 16-feet deep, was taken to a hospital for treatment after the rescue work. Meanwhile, the Karnataka Minister MB Patil congratulated SDRF, police, and Vijayapur district administration for saving the baby after 20 hours of continuous work.

“Jai Shri Ram”: Sanjay Nirupam drops broad hint of future plans

AGENCY MUMBAI, APRIL 4

Expelled Congress leader Sanjay Nirupam, who criticized Nehruvian secularism earlier today, has now dropped a broad hint of his future plans with a resounding “Jai Shri Ram”. Asked what next, the 59-year-old told reporters, “I have plans, certainly I am joining somewhere. Will declare. You can derive meaning out of Jai Shri Ram”.

Mr Nirupam was expelled yesterday over his out-of-turn comments on Congress ally Uddhav Thackeray's Shiv Sena UBT after it announced candidates for 17 seats. Among those was Mumbai North West, a seat Mr Nirupam was eyeing.

The senior leader had won the Mumbai north seat in 2009, but lost the subsequent elections in 2014 and 2019 from Mumbai North and Mumbai North West. Today, he made it clear that he would contest, from the other side if need be.

The Mumbai North West seat is part of the kitty of Shiv Sena led by Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde. The party is yet to announce its candidate.

The Uddhav Thackeray faction has fielded Amot Kirtikar from the seat. Mr Nirupam told reporters, “I will not allow him to become an MP. I will contest and defeat him”.

The former MP, who was penalized by the Congress for “indiscipline” and “anti-party statements”, was defiant. While of a criticism spree, had said, “Secularism doesn't mean disregarding one's own religion... The Nehruvian secularism which has no place for religion in the society, has expired”.



Congress leader Gourav Vallabh joins BJP

**NEW DELHI:** Hours after resigning from the Congress, Congress party spokesperson Prof Gourav Vallabh on Thursday joined the BJP in New Delhi in the presence of General Secretary Vinod Tawad and other senior leaders at the party headquarters.

Before joining the BJP, Gourav Vallabh resigned from the Congress, citing the grand old party as “directionless” and expressed his disagreement over the party's view on the Ram temple consecration.

In a letter to Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge on Thursday, Vallabh wrote that the party “is not able to adjust itself with the youth with new ideas”. “I am not comfortable with the directionless way in which the Congress party is moving ahead. I can neither raise anti-Sanatana slogans nor can I abuse the wealth creators of the country morning and evening. Hence, I am resigning from all the posts and primary membership of the Congress party,” he wrote.

Vallabh also wrote that over the past few years, the party has failed to “realize” expectations of ‘New India.’

Former Bihar Congress President Anil Sharma and RJD leader Upendra Prasad also joined the BJP.

NCW complains to poll panel against Surjewala for remarks on Hema

The National Commission for Women has filed a complaint with the Election Commission against Congress leader Randeep Surjewala for using alleged derogatory remarks against Bharatiya Janata Party candidate from Mathura Hema Malini.

In a post on X, the NCW said “National Commission for Women strongly denounces the deeply offensive remarks made by Randeep Surjewala. The remarks are extremely misogynistic and outrageous to the modesty of a woman. Chairperson Rekha Sharma has formally written to the Chief Election Commission,

The Haryana State Commission for Women has also issued notice to Congress leader Randeep Singh Surjewala over his remarks against actor and BJP MP Hema Malini. DRDO, SFC successfully flight-tested Agni-Prime ballistic missile

The new generation ballistic missile, Agni-Prime, was successfully flight-tested from Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha.

The flight-test was conducted by Strategic Forces Command (SFC), along with Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO)

at around 1700 hrs on Wednesday, an official statement said on Thursday.

The test met all the trial objectives, validating its reliable performance, as confirmed by the data captured by a number of range sensors deployed at different locations, including two down-range ships placed at the terminal point. The launch was witnessed by the Chief of De-

fence Staff, Chief of Strategic Forces Command, and senior officials from DRDO and the Indian Army. Meanwhile, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, while congratulating the DRDO, SFC, and the Armed Forces for the successful test, said that the successful development and induction of the missile will be an excellent force multiplier for the Armed Forces.

# Political parties and candidates should follow ‘Dos’ and ‘Don’ts’ of election : CEO

BUREAU CHANDIGARH, APRIL 4

The Election Commission of India (ECI) has drawn up a list of ‘Dos’ and ‘Don’ts’ to be followed by political parties and contesting candidates till the completion of the process of General Election to Lok Sabha 2024 in Haryana.

Giving more information, Chief Electoral Officer, Haryana, Sh. Anurag Agarwal said that political parties and candidates are advised to follow the guidelines and cooperate in conducting the elections in a free, fair and peaceful manner in the State.

While referring to the Dos to be followed by political parties and contesting candidates, he said that with a view to ensure a level playing field, public places like maidans and helpads must be available impartially to all parties and contesting candidates. He said that during elections, criti-

cism of other political parties and candidates should be restricted only to their policies, programs, past records, and works. With this, the right of every individual for peaceful and undisturbed home life should be fully safeguarded. He further said that the local police authorities should be fully informed and necessary permission is taken well in time, of the venue and time of the proposed meetings, he added. Sh. Anurag Agarwal said that the restrictive or prohibitory orders in force, if any, in the place of the proposed meeting should be fully respected. He said that the permission must be obtained for use of loud-speakers or any other such facilities for the proposed meetings and police assistance should be taken from the police authorities, in case of any disturbance and untoward in-



cident caused by any person.

He said that the time and place of the starting and termination of any procession and the route to be followed should be finalized in advance and prior permissions obtained from the police authorities. The passage of the procession must be without hindrance to traffic. The Chief Electoral Officer said that cooperation should be extended to all election officials to ensure peaceful and orderly voting. He

said that all political workers engaged in elections have to show their badges or identity cards given to them by their parties. The informal identity slip issued to the voters should be on plain (white) paper and on which there should be no mention of any name, party symbol or the name of the candidate on it. He said that restrictions on plying of vehicles during the campaign period and on the poll day should be fully obeyed and any complaint or problem regarding the conduct of elections should be brought to the notice of the Election Commission’s Observer, Returning Officer, Zonal or Sector Magistrate or Chief Electoral Officer/ Election Commission of India.



## Spl DGP calls for synergy between Punjab police, central agencies to ensure fair LS polls

In order to ensure free, fair and peaceful forthcoming General Elections 2024, Special Director General of Police (Spl DGP) Law and Order Arpit Shukla on Thursday chalked out a foolproof strategy with the Border Security Force (BSF) to further strengthen the second line of defence and completely break the supply chain of drugs from across the border.

The Special DGP accompanied by IG Frontier Headquarters, BSF Jalandhar Dr Atul Fulzele was holding a Joint coordination meeting with the senior officers of Punjab Police, BSF, CRPF, ITBP, Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and other central agencies to review security arrangements at the Border and discuss issues pertaining to upcoming Parliamentary Elections 2024. Zonal Director NCB, ADGP State Armed Police (SAP) MF Farooqui, DIG Border Range Rakesh Kaushal and DIG Ferozepur Range Ranjit Singh Dhillon also attended the meeting.



Giving a call for greater synergy and teamwork between BSF and Punjab Police, Spl DGP Arpit Shukla exhorted both forces to work as one team to ensure free and fair elections in the border state.

He said that being positioned at the first line of defence, the BSF needs to be more alert to prevent smuggling and infiltration bids by militants, terrorists or smugglers. He also ordered to enhance the number of Police personnel deployed on night patrolling along the International border. The Spl DGP advised the BSF to use drone de-

tection technology to counter the Drone operations at Punjab borders, which have emerged as the new modus operandi to smuggle drugs from across the border.

He also directed all the SSPs of border districts to conduct regular meetings with Village Level Defence Committee (VLDC) members and sensitise field staff and VLDC members to keep a strict vigil on the movement of drones.

As per the information, there were 325 drone sightings across the border in 2023, of which 118 drones were successfully recovered. Similarly,

26 drones have been recovered in 2024 so far. He instructed the AROs that adequate arrangements should be made in time to ensure the facility of ramps and wheelchairs for disabled voters at hundred percent polling stations as well as availability of clean drinking water.





Other voices

The National People's Congress, the Chinese equivalent of the Indian Parliament, which holds sessions every year in the capital, has just ended. As always, it has given more than a glimpse of issues that rarely make it to the news. Beyond the constant celebration of the rising gross domestic product and economic growth, at the NPC sessions, one hears about hardships that vast sections of the population of this superpower continue to grapple with. These get raised only because there still exist grassroots delegates, members of the communist party who continue to live amid the communities they represent.

Two radical proposals were made at this year's NPC session. The first concerned the taboo subject of sex education. A hospital head proposed that illustrated books on sex education designed by experts with the help of creative writers and psychologists be produced for schoolchildren so that they can equip themselves to face the adult world. A study done by the NGO, Girls' Protection, revealed the shocking statistic of 223 incidents of child sexual abuse in the year 2021.

The same delegate had, at last year's NPC session, proposed that kindergarten children be provided with basic education about their bodies so that they could distinguish between 'bad touch' and 'good touch'. The long-term benefits of providing sex education, the doctor said, would be youngsters having sex at a later age with an awareness of safe sex practices.

The proposal was radical because of the way previous attempts at educating children on sex had bombed. Although Beijing and Shanghai had come out with sex education textbooks way back in 2011, few schools used them. In 2019, two sets of pictorial textbooks for primary school children and those even younger had to be recalled after outrage from parents and netizens. One objection voiced was that the books were 'infiltrated' by Western ideas.

The second proposal concerned social security measures for couriers. That the concept of workers' welfare should seem radical in a country ruled by a communist party is one of the ironies of today's China. With the country going digital with a vengeance, the delivery sector is among the fastest growing, having expanded 20 times since 2012. Last year, 360 million parcels were delivered every day by four million couriers, but the couriers earned just about one yuan per delivery. Many of them are not direct employees of delivery firms, but contracted by a third party.

The delegate, himself a manager in a delivery firm, proposed accident insurance for these workers who must rush through traffic to meet deadlines. Medical expenses, disability compensation and even compensation for death should be included, he said.

# Taiwan's earthquake strongest in 25 years

The Central Weather Administration (CWA) Seismological Center highlighted that the powerful 7.2 magnitude earthquake that rocked Hualien City on Wednesday, was the strongest in 25 years as the last tragic 7.3-magnitude 921 Jiji earthquake hit the country in 1999, leaving over 2,000 dead, reported Focus Taiwan.

Kuo Kai-wen, former director of the CWA Seismology Center, described Wednesday's 7.2 magnitude earthquake as having an energy equivalent to around 32 atomic bombs dropped on Hiroshima, while the 921 Jiji earthquake had the energy of 46 Hiroshima atomic bombs.

The present director of the CWA Seismology Center, Wu Chien-fu said that the 921 Jiji earthquake destroyed hundreds of buildings in central Taiwan, but today's earthquake shook more parts of Taiwan with greater intensity than any other since 1999.

The earthquake's epicentre was located in the Pacific Ocean, 25.0 kilometres south-southeast of Hualien County Hall, at a depth of 15.5 km, according to the Central Weather Administration's Seismology Center, according to Focus Taiwan.

The earthquake's intensity, which gauges the actual effect of a seismic event, was highest in Hualien, where it measured a 6+ on Taiwan's 7-tier intensity scale, the CWA said.

Moreover, the 6+ intensity represents shaking that makes it almost impossible for a person to stand in place and can even throw people in the air, reported Focus Taiwan. The intensity of 5+ was recorded in Yilan County, up the coast from Hualien County, and in Miaoli County, and 5- in Taipei, New Taipei, Taoyuan, Taichung, Hsinchu



County, Changhua County and Nantou County.

However, people at 5+ intensity may also find it hard to stand and loose items topple over.

Wu said it was only the second time an

intensity level of 6+ had occurred in Taiwan since the introduction of the new CWA seismic intensity scale in 2020.

Under the old seismic intensity scale system, with 10 the highest intensity, the 1999 earthquake's highest intensity was measured

at 7 in Nantou's Yuchi Township, Focus Taiwan reported.

Wu said that because Wednesday's earthquake was shallow and close to land, it was felt all over Taiwan, adding that more strong aftershocks could be on the way.

## No issue with oil payment from India: Russia

The Russian Foreign Ministry has said that deliveries of Russian oil to India are steadily high, with no payment issues encountered, the state-owned news agency TASS reported.

"Russian oil supplies to India are maintained at a steadily high level; no problems arise with determining means of payment for oil exported by Russia," Maria Zakharova, the official spokeswoman for the Russian Foreign Ministry, said at a briefing on Wednesday (Local Time).

The priority in payments "is given to national currencies," she highlighted.

"This makes it possible not to depend on the so-called 'rules of the game' imposed by the Westerners when making banking transactions," TASS quoted Zakharova as saying.

External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar in February this year reaffirmed India's stance on buying Russian oil despite sanctions on Moscow amid military conflict with Ukraine.

He said that India and Russia have always shared "stable and friendly ties" and Moscow has never hurt the interests of New Delhi.

In an interview with the German economic daily, Handelsblatt during his visit to Germany for the Munich Security Conference, Jaishankar said that Europe should understand that India cannot have a view of Russia that is identical to the European one.

On being asked about India purchasing Russian oil, Jaishankar said, "Every one conducts a relationship based on



their past experiences. If I look at the history of India post-independence, Russia has never hurt our interests."

He said that India and Europe have talked about their stance and have not emphasised their differences.

He said that Europe shifted a large part of its energy procurement to Middle East after the war erupted between Russia and Ukraine, which was until then the main supplier of energy for India and other nations.

"What should we have done? In many cases, our Middle East suppliers gave priority to Europe because Europe paid higher prices.

Either we would have had no energy because everything would have gone to them. Or we would have ended up paying a lot more because you were paying more. And in a certain way, we stabilised the energy market that way," he added.

## Bridges of Friendship

# Dismantling of 465 monuments of Russian soldiers in Poland

Terming the dismantling of around 465 monuments of Russian soldiers in Poland as "shameful", the Russian Foreign Ministry said that the act by Poland government has set an anti-record for erasing the memory of World War II.

Russian Foreign Ministry Spokeswoman Maria Zakharova, shared a post on X, stating, "As many as 465 monuments to our heroic soldiers have been dismantled in Poland." Zakharova further called it a "shameful act" and said that it has set an anti-record for erasing the memory of World War II.



"It has set a shameful anti-record for erasing the memory of WWII and of the 600,000 Soviet soldiers who sacrificed their lives to save the Polish nation," she added.

Earlier in 2022 also, four communist-era monuments to Red Army soldiers were dismantled in Poland, to remove symbols of Moscow's post-World War II domination and to emphasise their condemnation of the war in Ukraine, the Australian Broadcasting Corporation reported.

The workers used drills and heavy equipment to destroy the 1945 monuments at four different locations across Poland.

Notably, most of them were in the form of concrete obelisks dedicated to Red Army soldiers who fell while fighting to defeat Nazi German troops, according to the Australian Broadcasting Corporation.

The head of the state Institute of National Remembrance, Karol Nawrocki, said that the monuments stood for a system that was guilty of enslaving and murdering its people and other nations, including Poles.

Ever since shedding communist rule in 1989, Poland has been removing the symbols of Moscow's past domination from the public space, taking away monuments and plaques.

However, some have been moved to special storage, reported the Australian Broadcasting Corporation.

The drive does not include cemeteries or current burial sites.

Russia's invasion of Ukraine has added urgency to Poland's efforts as the country is backing Ukraine's struggle against Russia politically, militarily and economically.




