U'khand fires: IAF helicopter assists in firefighting, blaze doused in many areas

DEHRADUN: The firefighting operation in Uttarakhand's forests with the help of an Indian Air Force (IAF) helicopter continued for the second day on Sunday with the blaze brought to control in several areas, officials said. Efforts have also intensified to extinguish the raging forest fires in the state, especially in the worst-affected areas of Nainital, Haldwani and Ramnagar forest divisions, forest officials here said on Sunday. The forest fires are gradually being controlled with the flames already doused in many areas. The fires in Marora and Khanana civil areas in Maniknath range of the Narendranagar forest division have been completely extinguished, they said.

SAD fields Virsa Singh Valtoha from Khadoor Sahib seat in Pb

CHANDIGARH: The Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) on Sunday announced former MLA Virsa Singh Valtoha as its candidate for Khadoor Sahib Lok Sabha seat in Punjab. With this, the SAD has named candidates for all 13 seats in Punjab and one in Chandigarh. In a post on X, the party said, "Shiromani Akali Dal president Sukhbir Singh Badal today announced party's core committee member and former chief parliamentary secretary S. Virsa Singh Valtoha as the @Akali_Dal_ candidate for the Khadoor Sahib Lok Sabha constituency. With this announcement the party has fielded party candidates on all 14 seats of Punjab and Chandigarh."

India sends holy Sarayu water to Sri Lanka for consecration ceremony of Seetha Amma temple

AYODHYA : India has initiated the process of sending sacred Sarayu river water to Sri Lanka for the consecration ceremony of Seetha Amma Temple, dedicated to Goddess Sita. The consecration ceremony of Seetha Amma Temple will take place on May 19. The decision came following a letter from Sri Lanka's representatives to the Uttar Pradesh government, requesting Sarayu river water for religious ceremonies and the consecration of Goddess Sita's idol at the temple.

CM Mann to meet Kejriwal in Tihar jail on April 30

NEW DELHI: Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann will meet his Delhi counterpart Arvind Kejriwal in Tihar jail on April 30, AAP sources said on Sunday. This will be Mann's second meeting with Kejriwal in Tihar. Kejriwal was arrested on March 21 by the Enforcement Directorate in connection with an excise policy-linked money-laundering case.

BJP strongly supports reservation, Rahul spreading lies: Amit Shah

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Sunday vehemently refuted Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's allegations regarding the BJP's stance on reservations. Accusing Gandhi of spreading misinformation, Shah, while speaking at a poll rally in Uttar Pradesh's Kasganj, assured that reservations for Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) would remain intact under BJP rule.

In his speech, Shah directly addressed Gandhi's claims, saying, "Rahul Baba is spreading lies in the name of backward classes. He says that if BJP wins 400 seats, BJP will remove reservations in the country. He doesn't understand, that we had two full terms with an absolute majority to remove reservation, but Narendra Modi is a supporter of reservation. Today I will give you a Modi Guarantee that the SC, ST, and OBC reservation will neither be removed by the BJP nor will we let anyone else do that."

Shah reiterated the BJP's stance on reservations. He said that BJP's government was in majority, and if the saffron party had any intentions to do so it had ample opportunity to alter reservation policies during its previous ten-year tenure. "Rahul Gandhi is trying to mislead people by spreading canards against us. The BJP has been at the helm of this country for 10 years now.



RSS favours reservations guaranteed under Constitution : Bhagwat

HYDERABAD : Trashing a video claiming that it was against reservation, Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) chief Mohan Bhagwat on Sunday that it has always stood for quotas as are guaranteed and sanctioned under the Constitution. Addressing an event organised to mark the inauguration of Vidya Bharati Vignana Kendra (VBVK) in Hyderabad on Sunday, the Sangh chief said, "A video is being circulated on social media platforms claiming that the Sangh is against reservation. Behind this patently false and misleading video are people, who preach reservation when outside, among the people, but work against the idea behind the scenes. Such claims are totally baseless." "The Sangh has always stood for reservation, as sanctioned and guaranteed under the Constitution, from the very beginning. We believe that reservation should continue as long as it is necessary for those who need it, as they are provided for reasons of backwardness and lack of parity in terms of their living or social standing.

Arvinder Singh Lovely resigns as DPCC chief

In a major setback to the Congress Party at a time when the Lok Sabha election is going on, Delhi Pradesh Congress Committee (DPCC) president Arvinder Singh Lovely resigned from his post on Sunday.

Lovely, in his letter addressed to Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge, cited several reasons for his resignation, one of which was forging an alliance with the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) for the Lok Sabha election.

However, according to sources, the resignation has not yet been accepted by Kharge.

In a three-page letter, Lovely wrote, "The Delhi Congress Unit was against an alliance with a party that was formed on the sole basis of leveling false, fabricated, and

malafide corruption charges against the Congress Party, and in turn, half of the cabinet ministers are presently in jail on corruption charges. Despite that, the party made a decision to ally with the AAP in Delhi."

He further said, "We respected the party's final decision. Not only did I publicly back the decision, but I also ensured that the full state unit fell in line with the High Command's final order. On instructions from the AICC General Secretary (Organisation), I even went to the extent of visiting Mr. Kejriwal's residence on the night of his arrest along with Mr. Subhash Chopra and Mr. Sandeep Dikshit, despite the same being against my position on the matter." He further said that after the alliance, the Congress was allotted three parliamentary seats to fight the general election.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday said that those who turned down the invitation for the consecration of the Ram Temple in Ayodhya will be rejected by the people in the ongoing Lok Sabha elections. He was apparently referring to the Congress party for not attending the event.

Modi said a decision on building the Ram temple should have been taken the very next day of the coun-

try's independence. Targeting the Congress on the issue, he alleged that



the "same forces" tried till the last minute to ensure that the Ram temple was not built and

had approached the court on the last day as well.

"The Congress and its coterie have tried for 70 years that the Ram temple should not be built," the prime minister said addressing a public gathering at this taluka headquarters town in Uttara Kannada district. The trustees of Ram temple ignored all the hurdles put by the Congress and its allies, went to their houses and invited them to attend the consecration ceremony, which was a kind gesture on their part, he said.

Actor Sahil Khan sent to two-day police custody in Mahadev Betting App

A court in Mumbai sent actor Sahil Khan to two-day police custody starting from April 29 in connection with the Mahadev Betting App case which involves irregularities to tune of Rs 15,000 crore.

In the day, the actor was brought to Mumbai from Chhattisgarh on Sunday after being detained by the Mumbai Crime Branch's Special Investigative Team (SIT) in connection with the same case. He was produced before the Shindewadi-Dadar court today.

"I believe in the judiciary of the country," Khan told reporters as he was escorted by security officials.

Actor Sahil Khan's lawyer Mujahid Ansari told a news agency that he has been framed in the matter. "They wanted a remand to investi-

gate. They had produced their ground in the Session Court and the High Court that there are 2000 SIM cards and 1700 bank accounts..." "The court has sent him (Sahil Khan) to a two-day-police custody, April 29 and 30. He will be produced again on May 1...", he said. Replying to a query, he said, "No SIM card or bank account is in Sahil Khan's name. We have cooperated and submitted the bank statement...There is nothing. He has been framed in the matter and been accused of promoting the app..." Mumbai Police has also seized actor Sahil Khan's passport as part of ongoing legal proceedings. Khan was apprehended on Saturday from Chhattisgarh, where he had reportedly been evading authorities for nearly 40 hours. His attempts to secure a pre-arrest bail failed as the Bombay High Court rejected his plea.

After over 4-month ban, Centre allows Onion exports to 6 neighbouring countries

The Centre on Saturday said it has allowed exports of 99,500 tonnes of onions, mainly sourced from Maharashtra, to six neighbouring countries despite the ban on shipments.

The Centre has also allowed exports of 2,000 tonnes of white onion cultivated, especially, for export markets in the Middle East and some European countries.

On December 8, 2023, the government banned export of onions.

In an official statement, the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution said the government has "allowed export of 99,150 tonnes of onion to six neighbouring countries of Bangladesh, UAE, Bhutan, Bahrain, Mauritius and Sri Lanka".

The export prohibition has been imposed to ensure adequate domestic availability against the backdrop of estimated lower Kharif and Rabi crops in 2023-24 compared to the previous year.

The ban was imposed amid an increase in demand in the international market,



it added.

The National Cooperative Exports Limited (NCEL), the agency for the export of onion

to these countries, sourced the domestic onions to be exported through e-platform at L1 prices. NCEL has supplied to the

agency or agencies nominated by the government of the destination country at the negotiated rate on a 100 per cent advance payment basis. The offer rate of NCEL to the buyers takes into account the prevailing prices in the destination market and also international and domestic markets. The quota allocated for export to the six countries is being supplied as per requisition made by the destination country. "As the largest producer of onion in the country, Maharashtra is the major supplier of onions sourced by NCEL for export," the statement said.

Haryana Chief Electoral Officer, Sh. Anurag Agarwal said that the voter turnout in the previous Lok Sabha elections was 70 percent, and this time the target is set to increase it to at least 75 percent. For this, several unique initiatives have been undertaken by the department, including launching the Voter in Queue app, sending polling invitations to voters akin to wedding invitations, and setting up 31 polling booths in the multi-storey societies of Global City Gurugram. The Chief Electoral Officer further said that the election notification will be issued from April 29 onwards, and the fate of the candidates contesting the election will be decided by 1,99,81,982 voters across the state's 10 Lok Sabha constituencies.

He said that in the Ambala assembly constituency, there are 10,51,443 male vot-



ers, 9,35,635 female voters, and 76 transgender voters. Similarly, in the Kurukshetra Lok Sabha constituency, there are 9,38,029 male voters, 8,50,439 female voters, and 23 transgender voters, while in the Sirsa Lok Sabha constituency, there are 10,20,510 male voters, 9,11,339 female voters, and 41 transgender voters.

Sh. Anurag Agarwal further informed that in the Hisar Lok Sabha constituency, there are 9,52,598 male voters,

8,32,569 female voters, and 11 transgender voters, in the Karnal Lok Sabha constituency, there are 11,03,606 male voters, 9,92,721 female voters, and 37 transgender voters, and in the Sonapat Lok Sabha constituency, there are 9,40,969 male voters, 8,20,483 female voters, and 44 transgender voters. Sh. Agarwal said that the number of voters in the Rohtak Lok Sabha constituency is 18,83,383, out of which 9,96,702 are male, 8,86,660 female and 21 are trans-

gender registered voters. Similarly, there are a total of 17,86,942 registered voters in Bhiwani-Mahendragarh Lok Sabha constituency, out of which 9,42,682 are male, 8,44,237 are female and 13 are transgender voters. He said that the Gurugram Lok Sabha constituency has the maximum number of voters of 25,46,916, of which 13,47,521 are male, 11,99,317 are female and 78 are transgender voters, whereas in Faridabad Lok Sabha constituency.

smell also spreads here, due to which there is also a danger of spreading diseases. The Mandi is also full of stray animals, due to which the stray animals keep munching on the grains lying in the open all day and spoil the grains. All these stray animals keep roam-

The stray animals keep defecating in the grains all day and the employees pack the same grains in sacks. Chief Electoral Officer, Maneesh Garg disclosed here today that as many as 813 complaints and grievances were received in the Election Department since the announcement of General Elections and imposition of Model Code of Conduct in the State on 16th March, 2024. Providing details, he said that 485 complaints were received through the National Grievances Service Portal (NGSP)/call centres on toll free number 1800-332-1950 at State and District contact centres. Apart from this, 241 complaints were received through the State and district Model Code of Conduct (MCC) Nodal Officers and 87 complaints have been uploaded on the C-Vigil Portal.



Further stating, the CEO said that out of 485 complaints received through the call centres, 461 have been disposed off and 24 are pending for disposal in which action is being taken as per the norms. Similarly, 241 Complaints were received through MCC nodal officers at the State and District level out of which 176 have been disposed off and 65 complaints are pending due

to want of reports from respective departments and field offices where inquiries were underway. In C-VIGIL portal, 87 complaints have been received out of which 44 complaints have been dropped as these have been found either fake or are test cases filed by the stakeholders to check the portal, and action has been taken on the remaining 43

complaints within 100 minutes. The Election department has thus disposed off 90 percent of complaints received through various mediums and available channels with the public for lodging their grievances from different corners of the State. He said that as per the direction of the ECI, the C-VIGIL complaints were being settled within hundred minutes after receiving the same. The highest number of C-VIGIL complaints has been received in district Una whereas there were no such complaints from the districts Kinnaur, Kullu and Lahaul-Spiti. He stated that the maximum number of complaints were reported against displaying of posters and banners without permission, campaigning beyond permitted hours, general conduct of officials etc.

Agriculture University brings new vegetable Gharkin for farmers

A new vegetable crop Gharkin has been successfully introduced to the farmers in the state by Chaudhary Sarwan Kumar Himachal Pradesh Agricultural University. Disclosing this today, Vice Chancellor Dr. DK Vats said that Gharkin is a warm season vegetable crop belonging to the cucumber family variety of horticultural crops. Being a short duration crop with high yield potential, it is cultivated and consumed mainly in Africa, Brazil and the United States and India. Raw fruits are used for processing as pickles, eaten as a cooked vegetable and used in curries. Gherkin fruits are boiled, fried and eaten fresh as salads. Gherkin is also known for its traditional medicinal value in treating stomach ache, jaundice, piles and preventing kidney stone formation and including it in the diet provides many nutrients like Vitamin A, Folate, Calcium and Iron. Increasing intake may help. Dr. Vats said that this is a new crop for the state and can help farmers increase



their agricultural income. He appreciated Dr. Parveen Sharma, Professor in the Department of Vegetable Crops and Floriculture for successfully growing this vegetable crop and introducing it in hi-tech production. The unit was established under the National Agricultural Higher Education Project.

Tibetan Govt-in-exile stresses on middle way path to resolve Tibet issue

The Central Tibetan Administration has stressed on the "Middle Way" path propounded by the Dalai Lama to resolve the Tibet issue with China, after Beijing called the Tibetan government-in-exile "an organized separatist political group". Tenzin Lekshay, spokesperson of the Central Tibetan Administration (CTA), said the CTA is seeking "genuine autonomy" for the Tibetan people within the Chinese constitution.

He posted on X: "The Middle Way Policy (MWP) of Central Tibetan Administration is to seek genuine autonomy for the Tibetan people within the framework of Chinese constitution & Regional National Autonomy Law of China. Resolving Sino-Tibet conflict through MWP is



mutually beneficial. @MFA.China." He said this in response to the Chinese foreign ministry's comments on the reported "back-channel talks" on the Tibetan issue. Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson Wang Wenbin on Friday said:

"The so-called 'Tibetan government-in-exile' is entirely an organized separatist political group with a political platform and an agenda for 'Tibetan independence.' It is an illicit organization that violates China's Constitution and laws. No country in the world recognizes it. 'The Chinese

government has two basic principles when it comes to contact and talks. First, we would only have contact and talks with the personal representative of the 14th Dalai Lama, not the so-called 'Tibetan government-in-exile' or 'Central Tibetan Administration.'" "The Chinese government will not be dealing with it. Second, any contact or talks will only be about the personal future of the 14th Dalai Lama himself, or at most, a handful of people close to him, not the so-called 'high degree of autonomy for Tibet.'" We hope the 14th Dalai Lama will have a right understanding of the central government's policy, seriously reflect on and thoroughly correct its political propositions and actions, give up any activity aimed at disrupting the social order in Xizang, and return to the right path.

This is the first instance when the emergency response department of Municipal Corporation has procured this kind of equipment to safeguard the life of Fire Personnel. The estimated amount for the procurement of these Personal Protective Gear is approx Rs. 51 lakhs.

This milestone exemplifies the unwavering dedication of MC Chandigarh in staying at the forefront of the emergency preparedness by providing the firefighters with state of the art protective gears while responding to the emergency situation which will bolster their capability to handle complex challenges with utmost confidence and efficiency and will ultimately result in mitigation of loss of valuable life and property. This step is part of the

Municipal Corporation's mission to ensure fire preparedness in the city. MCC has added 7 Bullet Motor Cycles and 14 Water Mist and CAF High Pressure using special AFFF for Fire fighting in narrow lanes, recently. Further, MCC has got a



Tata 407 chassis fabricated with Mini Water Tender for Fire fighting in narrow lanes and for VIP duties and fabricated a Tata 1613 chassis with Water Tender for Fire fighting duties. Additionally, 4 Tata xenon vehicles have been got fabricated with Mini Water Tender based on Water Mist Technology for Fire fighting in narrow lanes.

The MCC has also purchased inflatable emergency lighting tower. The inflatable emergency lighting tower is used at the time of major disasters like building collapse, Fire incident and in rescue operations during night hours. 5 thermal imaging detector have also been purchased for detection in smoke/smog areas having low visibility and purchased 28 Fire Proximity Suits which is one of the most important Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) used by the Fire and Rescue Services Personnel all over the world. Fire Helmets with central touch to work during the fire operation hands free and purchased 03 Water Tender (Type-X), 56 Breathing Apparatus Sets, 24 specialized tools/Combi tools for the Rescue Operations, 3 Breathing Air Compressors i.e. Two Electrical motor Driven and One is Petrol Driven and 5 Water Tender (Type-B). Additionally, refurbishment/replacement of superstructure/chassis of 2 Hydraulic Platform-cum-Turn Table Ladder has been ordered and 7 potable tents purchased for standby duties.

Jalandhar Commissionerate Police intensify crackdown on organized crime

The Commissioner of Police said that he also admitted to possessing another desi pistol, a desi katta of 315 bore and 260 grams of heroin, which was recovered from him. Mr Swapan Sharma said that further investigation into the case is going and details will be shared later.

Boost to defence exports

Traditionally, India has been among the global top five arms importers. However, following a major focus on the policy of self-reliance to deal with an increasingly uncertain world, the situation is changing now. Delivering the first batch of indigenously developed BrahMos supersonic cruise missiles to the Philippines is a significant step towards boosting defence exports. This is expected to open the doors for sales to various other Asian countries. BrahMos missiles, which can fly at almost three times the speed of sound and can hit a target up to a range of 290 kilometres, were delivered over two years after signing a \$375-million deal to supply the weapon systems with the Southeast Asian country. In January 2022, India announced a deal with the Philippines to supply the BrahMos missile, making it the country's first major defence export order. As per the deal, Manila will get three missile batteries for the BrahMos supersonic cruise missile system. The deal also encompassed training for operators and the necessary integrated logistics support package. The operator training of 21 personnel of the Philippine Navy for the missile system was successfully conducted in February 2023. The latest sale enables India to ensure its place as a reliable defence partner to its Southeast Asian neighbours. This will provide the much-needed headway to export the cruise missile to countries like Vietnam and Indonesia. India has set a defence export target of Rs 35,000 crore by 2024-25. Defence exports grew 32.5% last fiscal and crossed the Rs 21,000-crore mark for the first time as the country remains focused on boosting the indigenous defence manufacturing ecosystem as well as military exports. The private sector and the defence public sector undertakings contributed around 60% and 40%, respectively. This is a laudable development because the participation of the private sector must be increased to strengthen defence manufacturing and production. India is currently exporting military hardware to around 85 countries, with around 100 local firms involved. It includes missiles, artillery guns, rockets, armoured vehicles, offshore patrol vessels, personal protective gear, a variety of radars, surveillance systems and ammunition. BrahMos missiles are produced by BrahMos Aerospace Pvt Ltd —a joint venture between the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and the Russian Federation's NPO Mashinostroyeniya.

Philippines denies any deal with China

The Philippines Department of National Defence (DND) has completely rejected China's claims of having any internal agreement on the Ayungin Shoal, Philippine News Agency

In a message to reporters, Wescom spokesperson Captain Ariel Joseph Coloma said, "(There is a) a presence of a CN (Chinese) vessel in the vicinity of our BK conducting the MME. We have reported one PLAN vessel with bow number 793 in the vicinity," Philippine News Agency reported. On Friday, the MME in Palawan waters was led by BRP Ramon Alcaraz (PS-16), with participation from French Navy's FS Vendemiaire (FFH-734), BRP Davao Del Sur (LD-602), and USS Harpers Ferry (LSD-49), Combined Joint Information Bureau chief Lt Colonel John Paul Salgado said in a statement. Salgado said, "During the exercise, BRP Ramon Alcaraz directed the participating units with tactical messages, instructing them to approach from her portside at a distance of no less than 80 yards. BRP Davao Del Sur was the first to approach, followed by FS Vendemiaire and USS Harpers Ferry." He further said that a continuation of cross deck-landing exercise was held and involved BRP Ramon Alcaraz BRP Davao Del Sur, USS Harpers Ferry, and a Philippine Navy AW-109 helicopter (NH-434). The exercise "Balikatan" is aimed at enhancing the participating naval forces interoperability and is scheduled to end on April 29.

quoted Philippines Defence Secretary Gilberto Teodoro Jr as saying. In a statement released on Saturday, Gilberto Teodoro Jr rejected the claims of Chinese officials about two new deals with the Philippines in 2023 to reduce tensions on the disputed territory and called it a part of a "Chinese propaganda effort to steer the Filipino people's attention away from the real issue." Teodoro said, "The DND is not aware of, nor is it a party to, any internal agreement with China on Ayungin Shoal since President Ferdinand R Marcos,

Jr took office." The Ayungin Shoal is a submerged reef in Spratly Islands in the South China Sea (SCS). Gilberto Teodoro Jr said that Philippines Department of National Defence did not have any contact with any Chinese government officials since last year. He further said, "This is all a part of the Chinese propaganda effort to steer the Filipino people's attention away from the real issue and cause of the tensions in the West Philippine Sea, which is China's obstinate refusal to adhere to UNCLOS, which they are a signatory to." Notably, the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS) recognises the Philippine jurisdiction in the SCS. Teodoro said, "We will never enter into any agreement that will compromise our sovereignty and sovereign rights under the UNCLOS, as affirmed by the 2016 Arbitral Ruling," according to Philippine News Agency report. Previously, Philippines National Adviser Eduardo Ano said Beijing must show evidence regarding Philippines' alleged deal with China to keep the status quo in the WPS. Musk's visit to China comes a week after his visit to India was postponed due to 'Tesla obligations.' He was scheduled to meet with Prime Minister Narendra Modi and announce plans to enter the Indian market. Meanwhile, as of now, Musk is seeking to meet senior Chinese officials in Beijing to discuss the rollout of Full-Self Driving (FSD) software in China and to obtain approval to transfer data collected in the country abroad to train algorithms for its autonomous driving technologies, Reuters said, citing one of the two people. In response to a query on social media platform X, the Musk stated that Tesla may make FSD available to customers in China "very

soon." Notably, Musk's visit to China was not made prominently visible in public eyes. According to Reuters, Tesla, since 2021, has stored all data collected by its Chinese fleet in Shanghai as required by Chinese regulators and has not transferred any, back to the United States. The US EV maker rolled out FSD, the most autonomous version of its Autopilot software, four years ago but has yet to make it available in China despite customers urging it to do so.

US condemns Iraq's law to criminalise same-sex marriage

The United States condemned the Iraqi Council of Representatives' passage of the Anti-Prostitution and Homosexuality Law, banning same-sex relations with steep fines and imprisonment for those promoting homosexuality. The law threatens constitutionally protected human rights and fundamental freedoms in Iraq. "The United States is deeply concerned by the Iraqi Council of Representatives' passage of an amendment to existing legislation, officially called the Anti-Prostitution and Homosexuality Law, which threatens constitutionally protected human rights and fundamental freedoms," the US State Department said

in a release. Moreover, the law will limit the rights of certain individuals in a society, undermining the rights of all. "The law bans same-sex relations with steep fines and imprisonment and punishes those who 'promote homosexuality.' Limiting the rights of certain individuals in a society undermines the rights of all," the release added. Further, the amendment can also be used to hamper free speech and expression and inhibit the operations of NGOs across the country. "This amendment threatens those most at risk in Iraqi society. It can be used to hamper free-speech and expression and inhibit

the operations of NGOs across Iraq." The legislation also weakens Iraq's ability to diversify its economy and attract foreign investment. "International business coalitions have already indicated that such discrimination in Iraq will harm business and economic growth in the country," it stated. The US State Department highlighted that respect for human rights and political and economic inclusion is essential for Iraq's security, stability, and prosperity. This legislation is inconsistent with these values and undermines the government's political and economic reform efforts, it added.



Vivo X100 Ultra, Vivo S19 and Vivo S19 Pro Bag 3C Certification Ahead of Anticipated Launch in China

Vivo X100 Ultra is expected to launch in China soon as the company's top-of-the-line model in the X100 series of smartphones and the handset has been certified in China, alongside the Vivo S19 and Vivo S19 Pro. The upcoming Vivo X100 Ultra is expected to run on Qualcomm's flagship Snapdragon 8 Gen 3 chip along with 24GB of RAM and feature a quad camera setup that includes a 200-megapixel periscope telephoto camera. It is equipped with a 5,400mAh battery with support for 80W charging. The three handsets were spotted on China's 3C certification website by MySmartPrice, and the presence of these listings suggests that Vivo will introduce these phones in China in the coming months. The Vivo X100 Ultra is listed with the model number V2366GA, while the Vivo S19 Pro and standard Vivo S19 have the model numbers V2362A and V23664A, respectively, according to the report. It appears that Vivo has listed all three handsets with two charger models — V8073LOA1-CN and V8073LOE0-CN. The specifications on the website reveal that these are 80W chargers, although it is currently unclear whether all models will feature the same charging speed — especially the Vivo S19. Gadgets 360 was able to confirm the presence of these handsets and the charger models on the 3C website.

The video shows the Pixel 8a will include Google's Best Take feature that swaps out faces from multiple group photos or burst photos to 'replace' faces with eyes closed or unwanted expressions.

Kishan committed a Level 1 offence under Article 2.2 of the IPL's Code of Conduct. He admitted to the offence and accepted the Match Referee's sanction. For Level 1 breaches of the Code of Conduct, the Match Referee's decision is final and binding.

In the match, Jake Fraser-McGurk's powerful knock, followed by Rasekh Dar Salam, Mukesh Kumar and Khaleel Ahmed's supercharged pace attack helped Delhi Capitals (DC) defeat Mumbai Indians by 10 runs in their Indian Premier League (IPL) 2024 match here at the Arun Jaitley Stadium on Saturday.

Rasekh was the pick for the home side, he came on as an impact sub and picked up 3 for 34 in this high-scoring affair while Mukesh also returned with a three-wicket haul. For MI, Tilak Varma scored 63 runs while skipper Hardik Pandya scored 46 for MI.

Rohit Sharma and Ishan Kishan started Mumbai's chase fearlessly dealing in boundaries. In the second over of the game, Khaleel Ahmed was hammered by the duo for 14 runs, which included three consecutive boundaries from Kishan.

"Should open with Babar, Rizwan": Ramiz Raja picks Pakistan's opening pair for T20 WC
