CBI arrests four for trafficking of **Indian nationals**

AGENCY NEW DELHI: The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Wednesday said it has busted a major human trafficking network involved in trafficking of Indian nationals for combat roles in the Russian Army and arrested four in connection with the case. "These traffickers have been operating as an organized network across the country. They were luring Indian nationals through social media platforms like YouTube etc. and also through their local agents for highly paid jobs in Russia," the CBI said in a statement. "The trafficked Indian Nationals were trained in combat roles and deployed at tront bases in Russia - Ukraine War Zone against their wishes." It said. CBI takes over probe in INLD leader Nafe Singh Rathee murder case

NEW DELHI: The CBI has taken over the investigation into the killing of the Indian National Lok Dal's Haryana unit president Nafe Singh Rathee and a party worker by unidentified gunmen in February in Bahadurgarh near Delhi, officials said. During the attack, three private gunmen hired by Rathee for security had also sustained injuries when the assailants opened fire on the former MLA's SUV. The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has re-registered the Haryana government, the officials said, adding that it was routed to the agency by the Centre

Air India Express cancels 80+ flights due to crew shortage

AGENCY NEW DELHI, MAY 8

Air India Express has cancelled more than 80 flights and scores of flights have been delayed as a section of cabin crew members have reported sick to protest against the alleged mismanagement at the Tata Group-owned airline, sources said on Wednesday.

The airline, which is in the process of merging AIX Connect (formerly AirAsia India) with itself, is to operate 360 daily flights during the summer schedule that started in the last week of March. An Air India Express spokesperson said the airline is engaging with the cabin crew members to understand the reasons for reporting sick and also apologised for the flight disruptions.

Discontent has been brewing among a section of the cabin crew at the low-cost carrier for some time now, especially after the start of the merger process.

The sources on Wednesday told PTI that more than 200 cabin crew are believed to have reported sick to protest against the alleged mismanagement at the airline. The cabin crew shortage has resulted in

the cancellation of at least more than 80 flights since Tuesday night and scores of flights were delayed. Flight disruptions are happening at various airports, including Kochi, Calicut and Bangalore, they added. The sources also said



there was chaos at some airports due to the sudden cancellation of flights, including to overseas destinations.

"A section of our cabin crew has reported sick at the last minute, starting last night, resulting in flight delays and cancellations.

While we are engaging with the crew to understand the reasons behind these occurrences, our teams are actively addressing this issue to minimise any inconvenience caused to our guests as a result," the Air India Express spokesperson said in a statement. Apologizing to the customers for the "unexpected disruption", the spokesperson said those impacted by the cancellations will be offered a full refund or complimentary rescheduling to another date. Late last month, a union representing a section of the Air India Express cabin crew alleged that the airline is being mismanaged and there is a lack of equality in the treatment of the staff.

Assam records highest voter turnout at 81.71 pc in phase 3 LS elections

Voting in the third phase of the Lok Sabha elections concluded on Tuesday across 93 Lok Sabha constituencies across 12 states and Union territories with Assam recording the highest voter turnout of 81.71 per cent, according to the data issued by the Election Commission of India (ECI).

The third phase of voting was conducted in Guwahati, Dhubri, Barpeta and Kokrajhar constituencies on May 7. Voting percentages



for other constituencies participating in the third phase of the Lok Sabha polls as per data are- Dhubri (86.80 per cent), Barpeta (82.02 per cent), Kokrajhar (80.44 per cent) and Guwahati (75.67 per cent).

AstraZeneca withdraws COVID-19 vaccine worldwide


The pharmaceutical giant AstraZeneca's COVIĎ-19 vaccine is being withdrawn worldwide after company acknowledged for the first time in court documents that it can cause a rare and dangerous side effect, according to a report in the British Newspaper Telegraph'. AstraZeneca has announced that the vaccine was being



removed from markets for commercial reasons. It further said that the vaccine was no longer being made or supplied, having been superseded by updated

vaccines that fight new variants. The application to withdraw the vaccine was made on March 5 and came into effect on May 7. The vaccine can be no longer used in the European Union following the company's decision to withdraw its 'marketing authorisation."

Similar applications will be submitted in the UK and other nations in the coming months that have given a goahead to the vaccine, known as Vaxzevria.

Parties, candidates should follow 'Dos' and 'Don'ts' of election: CEO

CHANDIGARH, MAY 8

The Election Commission of India (ECI) has drawn up a list of 'Dos' and 'Don'ts' to be followed by political parties and contesting candidates till the completion of the process of General Election to Lok Sabha 2024 in Haryana.

Giving more information, Chief Electoral Officer, Harvana. Sh. Anurag Agarwal said that political parties and candidates are advised to follow the guidelines and cooperate in conducting the elections in a free, fair and peaceful manner in the State.

While referring to the Dos to be followed by political parties and contesting candidates, he said that with a view to ensure a level playing field, public places like maidans and helipads must be available impartially to all parties and contesting candidates. He said that during elections, criticism of other political parties and candidates should be restricted only to their policies, programs, records, and works. this, the right of every individual for peaceful and undisturbed home life should be

fully safeguarded. He further said that the local police authorities should be fully informed and necessary permission is taken well in time, of the venue and time of the proposed meetings, he added.

Anurag Agarwal said that the restrictive or prohibitory orders in force, if any, in the place of the proposed meeting should be fully respected. He said that the permission must be obtained for use of loudspeakers or any other such facilities for the proposed meetings and police assistance should be taken from the police authorities, in case of any disturbance and untoward incident caused by any person.

He said that the time and place of the starting and termination of any procession and the route to be followed should be finalized in advance and prior permissions obtained from the police authorities. The passage of the procession must be without hindrance to traffic.

The Chief Electoral Officer said that cooperation should be extended to all election officials to ensure peaceful and orderly voting. He said that all political workers engaged in elections have to show their badges or identity cards given to them by their parties. The informal identity slip issued to the voters should be on plain (white) paper and on which there should be no mention of any name, party symbol or the name of the candidate on it.

He said that restrictions on plying of vehicles during the campaign period and on the poll day should be fully obeyed and any complaint or problem regarding the conduct of elections should be brought to the notice of the Election Commission's Observer, Returning Officer, Zonal or Sector Magistrate or Chief Electoral Officer/Election Commission of India.

He said that the directions, orders or instructions of the Election Commission/ Returning Officer or District Election Officer, in all matters related to various aspects of elections should be strictly complied with in all matters relating to various aspects of elections.

Do leave the constituency after the campaign period is over if you a person is not a voter or a candidate or candidate's election agent from that constituency. While referring to the Don'ts, Sh. Anurag Agarwal said that no official work should be mixed with campaigning or electioneering and no inducement, financial or otherwise, should be offered to the voter. Apart from this, no appeal on the basis of caste or communal feelings of the electors and no activity which may aggravate differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes, communities, religious or linguistic groups, should be attempted. He said that in order to maintain purity of elections.

CHANDIGARH: The Nomination process for election to the Chandigarh Parliamentary Constituency commenced on May 7th, 2024. The notice of election was officially issued by the Returning Officer, U.T., Chandigarh, on the same day. This notice is available on the website of the Chief Electoral Officer, U.T, Chandigarh, accessible at ceochandigarh.gov.in.

On the second day of the nominations, two independent candidates submitted their nominations, demonstrating early engagement in the electoral process. During the nomination filing process, candidates were provided with various instructions, as specified by the Commission. Notably, candidates were informed about restrictions regarding the printing of campaign

materials such as pamphlets or posters. Section 127A of the R.P. Act, 1951, mandates that all election pamphlets or posters must prominently display the names and addresses of the printer and publisher. Additionally, within a reasonable timeframe after printing, a declaration confirming the identity of the publisher, along with a copy of the document, must be sent to the Chief Electoral Officer of the State. Non-compliance with this provision is subject to penalties, including imprisonment for up to six months, a fine of up to two thousand rupees, or both. Copies of these directives were distributed to each candidate at the time of filing their Nomination Paper. As per the directions of the Commission, Candidates who have criminal cases against them - either pending cases or cases in which candidate has been convicted, shall publish a declaration about such cases, for wide publicity, in TV Channel and newspapers with wide circulation in the constituency area. This declaration is to be published in a particular Format, on three occasions during the campaign period.

Modi govt gave nothing to country except unemployment, inflation: Priyanka

Hour of dissent

e are witnessing today an amazing twin-event re-Validing to Gaza: the fascistic Benjamin Netanyahu regime, backed by a phalanx of metropolitan powers, is slaughtering Palestinians, declaring them to be 'no better than animals'; but common people across the world are spontaneously rising in protest, solidarizing with the Palestinians and holding demonstrations against this genocide. If the former, representing the horrendous world we live in, fills one with disgust, the latter, presaging a new world of peace and fraternity, fills

Of special significance are the demonstrations currently sweeping across American universities demanding that these institutions should 'divest' funds invested in companies linked to Israel and its military complex. Many rightly see parallels between these demonstrations and the anti-Vietnam War protests that had rocked American campuses in the late Sixties. But the present movement is even more significant than the earlier one; first, because there is no draft involved now and, hence, not even a whiff of self-interest behind students' actions; and second, because it comes in the wake of a long period of Islamophobia, of demonising Muslims as the 'Other', and is undeterred by such manufactured antipathy.

Against this we also have a revival of McCarthy-style repression reminiscent of the 1950s. Such repression is defended on the grounds that the Gaza Solidarity Encampment expresses anti-semitism; this, however, is absurd for it portrays an anti-genocide movement as antisemitic, and does so despite the participation in it of large numbers of Jewish students. Stray anti-semitic remarks may have been made by some fringe elements (such elements can be found everywhere), but to call the move-ment anti-semitic amounts to, as the agitating students put it, "weaponizing anti-semitism". In fact, anti-semitism is likely to be far more prevalent among the advocates of repression, several of whom have had links with known fascist elements in the United States of America and abroad (like Stepan Bandera's followers in Ukraine).

Calling the current repression in the US 'Mc-Carthyite' may be defended on the grounds that, as in the Fifties, a group of ultra-Right Republican lawmakers are in the forefront of it; but the differences are also significant. The primary targets at present are not the arts but the universities; the presidents of several universities have been summoned by right-wing lawmakers, asked to use the police against agitating students, and, if hesitant to do so, made to resign. The latest case relates to Columbia University whose president called the New York police to the campus to remove the 'camps' set up by students; it arrested nearly 100 agitating students, but, as the agitation still did not subside, ten members of the Congress led by Elise Stefanik have demanded the president's resignation.

Maldives Foreign Minister's visit

A mid a diplomatic standoff between the two countries, the Maldives Foreign Minister Moosa Zameer will pay an official visit to India on Thursday, the Ministry of External Affairs said in an official statement.

According to the release, the Maldivian Minister will hold a meeting with the External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar to discuss the bilateral and regional issues of mutual

"Moosa Zameer, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Maldives will be in India on an official visit on 09 May 2024. During his visit to New Delhi, Foreign Minister Zameer will meet the External Affairs Minister Dr. S Jaishankar for discussions on bilateral and regional issues of mutual interest," MEA statement said.

' Maldives is India's key maritime neighbour in the Indian Ocean Region (IOR) and Foreign Minister Zameer's visit is expected to lend further momentum to the bilateral cooperation between the two countries," it added.

Earlier, the Maldivian Ministry of Foreign Affairs said that the Foreign Minister Mansoor will visit India from May 8-10.

"The Minister of Foreign Affairs His Excellency Moosa Zameer will undertake an Official Visit to India from 8 to 10 May

2024," the release said.
"During the visit, Minister Zameer will meet with India's Minister of External Affairs Dr S. Jaishankar and hold discussions in deepening and expanding the longstanding partnership between the Maldives and India," it added.

Notably, this will be the first official visit of Foreign Minister Zameer to India since assuming office.

The visit comes as India has said that it will replace its military personnel from Maldives before May 10.

On May 3, India and Maldives held the 4th meeting of the bilateral High-Level Core Group and reviewed the replacement of In-



dian military personnel from the Island nation by May 10 and noted that the government will replace military personnel before the noted time. Earlier, the Mohamed Muizzu-led Maldives government formally requested that India withdraw its troops from

Maldives foreign ministry said in a press release that both sides reviewed the existing bilateral cooperation. "Discussions were held on a wide range of issues of mutual interest, including development and defence cooperation.

"Both sides noted with satisfaction that the Government of India will replace military personnel at the last of the three avia

tion platforms by May 10, and all the logistical arrangements are going ahead as per schedule," the press release added.

It was further agreed that the fifth meeting of the High-Level Core Group will be held in Male on a mutually agreeable date during the month of June/July.

Last month, the Ministry of External Affairs said that the first batch of Indian personnel in the Maldives had been replaced by technical personnel.

The external affairs ministry earlier informed that both India and the Maldives have agreed on a set of mutually workable solutions to enable the continued operation of Indian aviation platforms that provide humanitarian and medical evacuation services to the people of the Maldives

Last month, the MEA said that the first batch of Indian technical personnel reached the Maldives to replace the defence person-

India and the Maldives have held two high-level core group meetings, and the third one is expected to take place soon.

The removal of Indian troops from the country was the main election campaign of Muizzu's party. Currently, there are around 70 Indian troops, along with Dornier 228 maritime patrol aircraft and two HAL Dhruv helicopters, stationed in the Mal-

He said, "I am confident that this visit will be a fruitful one and will open up a new chapter in China-Serbia relations.

Extension of time for completing the investigation and further investigation

There are three different kinds of reports to be made by police officers at three different stages of investigation. (a) Section 157 requires a preliminary report from the officer in charge of a police station to the Magistrate. (b) Section 168 requires reports from a subordinate police officer to the officer in charge of the station. These reports are known as forwarding reports. (c) Section 173 requires a final report of the police officer as soon as investigation is completed to the Magistrate. The report under Sub section (2) of Section 173 is called Completion Report / Charge Sheet.

(2) Sub-section (8) of Section 173 crpc empowers the police to make further investigation. Even afMagistrate and is accepted, it is permissible for the investigating agency to carry out further investigation in the case.

In other words, there is no bar against conducting further investigation under Section 173(8) of the CrPC after the final report submitted under Section 173(2) of the CrPC has been accepted.

(3) The object of incorporating Section 173(8) was to give the investigating agency the power to put before the court new evidence which it comes across even after filing the final report or chargesheet under Section 173(2) of the CrPC, 1973.

(4) Prior to carrying out further investigation under Section 173(8) of the CrPC it is not necessary that the order accepting the final report should be reviewed, recalled or quashed.

(5) Further investigation is merely a continuation of the earlier investigation, hence it cannot be said that the accused are being subjected to investigation twice over. Moreover, investigation cannot be put at par with prosecution and punishment so as to fall within the ambit of Clause (2) of Article 20 of the Constitution.

The principle of double jeopardy would, therefore, not be applicable to further investigation.

(6) There is nothing in the CrPC to suggest that the court is obliged to hear the accused while considering an application for further investigation under Section 173(8) of the CrPC

(7) It can be noted that some

special legislations like the UAPA/Gujarat Control of Terrorism and Organised Crime Act, 2015 permit the prosecuting agencies to seek extension of time to file charge sheet up to a period of 180 days to deny default bail to the accused in heinous offence cases.

The logical and legal consequence of the grant of extension of time is the deprivation of the indefeasible right available to the accused to claim a default bail.

(8) It can also be noted that the public prosecutor filing their report cannot arbitrarily extend the time limit under any of the special statues which prescribe for an extended time limit to complete investigation. The following parameters are to be complied with:

The report of the Public

Prosecutor must be independent of the report of Investigating Officer, if

Independent analysis and application of mind by the Public Prosecutor must be seen from their report, and it must not be a mere repetition of the remand report.

c) The report of the public prosecutor must disclose progress in the investigation and specific reasons must be attributed against each of the accused persons to detain them in custody beyond the statutorv period.

d) Further, it is also mandatory that the said report of the public prosecutor be served upon the accused person, and the accused person has a right to be heard before any order of extension is passed by the Court.

(9) If any of the aforesaid parameters are not complied with, then the prosecution is not entitled for any extension of time, and if any order granting extension is passed. then the same is illegal and liable to be quashed. This can be done by filing an application under Section 482 of the CrPC before the concerned High Court.

(10) The court must see the reasons evidencing the personal satisfaction of the PP as regards the progress of investigation made based on the investigation carried

There should also be enough reasons indicating why the investigation could not be completed within the period of 90 days and how much time will be required for further investigation.

Sanju Samson fined 30 percent match fees for IPL code of conduct breach



NEW DELHI: The Rajasthan Royals (RR) skipper Sanju Samson has been fined 30 per cent of his match fees for violating the IPL's code of conduct during his team's encounter against the Delhi Capitals in the ongoing Indian Premier League (IPL) 2024 at Arun Jaitley Stadium on Tuesday.

"Sanju Samson, captain, of Rajasthan Royals has been fined 30 per cent of his match fees for breaching the IPL Code of Conduct during Match 56 of the TATA Indian Premier League (IPL) 2024 against Delhi Capitals at the Arun Jaitley Stadium, Delhi on May 07, 2024," an official IPL statement stated.

Samson, who top-scored for RR with 86 off 46 balls, was caught at long-on by Shai Hope off Mukesh Kumar's bowling in the 16th over of their 222-run chase. Hope caught the ball near to the boundary edge and briefly stumbled before establishing his balance. Unsure whether his foot hit the boundary cushions, the on-field umpires took the help of TV umpire Michael Gough, who determined that Hope caught the catch cleanly.

Samson then had a lengthy talk with on-field umpires KN Ananthapadmanabhan and Ulhas Gandhe before leaving the pitch.

"Samson committed a Level 1 offence under Article 2.8 of the

IPL's Code of Conduct. He admitted to the offence and accepted the Match Referee's sanction. For Level 1 breaches of the Code of Conduct, the Match Referee's decision is final and binding," the statement further
