CBSE class 10 board exam results declared, 93.60% clear test

NEW DELHI: The CBSE on Monday declared the results for the Class 10 exam with 93.60 per cent students clearing the test. Girls outshine boys by 2.04 percentage points, officials said and added that 94.75 per cent girls cleared the exam. More than 47,000 students have scored above 95 per cent marks and more than 2.12 lakh above 90 per cent, they said.

Surjit Patar cremated with state honours in Ludhiana

LUDHIANA: The mortal remains of renowned Punjabi poet and writer Surjit Patar were consigned to flames here with full state honours on Monday. The 79-year-old Padma Shri recipient died on Saturday at his residence near the Barewal Colony here. A large number of mourners, including Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann and local MLAs, paid their last respects to the famous Punjabi poet.

BJP leader shot dead in Jaunpur

JAUNPUR : A 45-year-old local Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader was shot dead by unidentified persons in Shahganj area of Jaunpur district here in Uttar Pradesh on Monday, police sources said here. Police sources said that Ashutosh Srivastava, a resident of Sabrahath village, was shot dead by unidentified persons in Im-ranganj market around 9:30 a.m. "The assailants escaped from the spot after the incident. A case has been lodged, and efforts are being made to nab the miscreants," they said. Meanwhile, sources said that the deceased had given an appointment to Circle Officer (CO) Shahganj and Police Station Incharge Shahganj a month ago, requesting protection, but the police did not pay any attention.

3 Naxalites killed in encounter with police in Gadchiroli



GADCHIROLI (MAHARASHTRA): Three Naxalites, including two females, were killed in an encounter with security forces in Maharashtra's Gadchiroli district on Monday, police said. An intelligence input was received that some members of the Perimili Dalam of Naxalites were camping in a forest near Katrangat-ta village in Bhamragad taluka with an aim to carry out subversive activities during their ongoing Tactical Counter Offensive Campaign (TCOC) period, Superintendent of Police Neelotpal said. Two units of C-60 commandos, a specialised combat wing of the Gadchiroli police, were immediately sent for a search in the area, he said.

LS Polls: Over 62% voter turnout recorded in phase 4

Bengal tops chart with 76 per cent voting

About 62.31 per cent voter turnout was recorded as of 5 pm across the 96 constituencies in the fourth phase of the Lok Sabha elections on Monday, according to the Election Commission of India (ECI). West Bengal recorded 75.66 per cent voter turnout, which is the highest as of 5 pm today, followed by Andhra Pradesh at 68.04 per cent and Madhya Pradesh at 68.01 per cent. The lowest was recorded in Jammu and Kashmir, 35.75 per cent. Voting percentages in other states participating in the fourth phase polling as of 3 pm are Bihar - 54.14 per cent, Jharkhand - 63.14 per cent, Maharashtra - 52.49 per cent, Odisha - 62.96 per cent, Telangana - 61.16 per cent and Uttar Pradesh - 56.35 per cent, as per the ECI. The voting across the 96 parliamentary constituencies in the nine states and one Union Territory started at 7 am on Monday. The polling for 175 seats in the Andhra Pradesh legislative assembly and 28 out of the 147 seats in the Odisha legislative assembly also started simultaneously with the general elections.

According to the ECI data, about 67.99 per cent voter turnout was recorded in Andhra assembly polls as of 5 pm. The first phase of the four-phase assembly polls in Odisha witnessed a voter turnout of 62.96 per cent.

Of the 96 Lok Sabha seats voting today, 25 are from Andhra Pradesh, 17 from Telangana, 13 from Uttar Pradesh, 11 from Maharashtra, eight each from Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal, five from Bihar, four each from Jharkhand and Odisha, and one from Jammu and Kashmir.

As many as 1,717 candidates are in the fray across the 96 Lok Sabha seats voting today. Prominent figures contest-



BJP, Trinamool workers clash

KOLKATA: Incidents of violence were reported in several parts of West Bengal during polling on Monday in the fourth phase of the Lok Sabha elections. A clash broke out between BJP and Trinamool Congress workers in Durgapur. In Birbhum, BJP workers alleged that their stall outside a polling station was vandalised by workers of the ruling Trinamool Congress. TMC leader Ram Prasad Halder said, "Since 6 am these (BJP) people have been coming with the central forces and trying to influence the voters. We protested against it, and voters also protested. They are trying to bring polling agents from outside. Central forces are threatening the people and influencing them. People of the area are opposing them here. They are trying to bring polling agents from outside." BJP MLA Laxman Ghorui alleged that their polling agents were thrown out of the polling booth located at TN School in Durgapur.

ing today's poll battle included AIMIM chief Asaduddin Owaisi, Samajwadi Party chief Akhilesh Yadav, West Bengal Congress chief Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury, JDU's Rajiv Ranjan Singh (Lalan Singh), TMC leaders Mahua Moitra, Shastrughan Sinha and Yusuf Pathan, Union Minister Arjun Munda, BJP leaders Gi-

riraj Singh, Madhavi Latha, and Andhra Pradesh Congress Chief YS Sharmila, among others.

The remaining three phases of voting will be held on May 20, May 25 and June 1. The results of the seven-phase Lok Sabha elections will be announced on June 4.

India inks contract with Iran to develop, operate Chabahar port for 10 years

After long negotiations, India on Monday inked a contract with Iran to develop and operate the strategic Chabahar Port, located along the Gulf of Oman, for 10 years, marking a new chapter in regional connectivity.

Indian Ports and Shipping Minister Sarbananda Sonowal, who arrived in Tehran today, oversaw the inking of the contract.

Ministry of External Affairs spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal posted on X:

"Scripting a new chapter in bilateral partnership!

Minister @shipmin_india & @moayush @sarbansand-sonwal witnessed the signing

of the long-term contract for the operation of the Shahid Beheshti Port in Chabahar, between India Ports Global Ltd. & Ports and Maritime organisation of Iran.

"The contract will give a



boost to regional connectivity & India's linkages with Afghanistan, Central Asia and Eurasia."

Minister Sonowal is quoted as saying on the occasion:

"With the signature of this contract, we have laid the foundations of India's long-term involvement at Chabahar." Sonowal posted on X: "At Tehran, Iran today, delighted to be part of the signing of the Long Term Bilateral Contract on Chabahar Port Operations in presence of HE Mehrdad Bazzpash, Minister of Roads & Urban Development, Iran. "India will develop and operate Iran's strategic Chabahar Port for 10 years, marking a historic moment in India-Iran ties and regional connectivity. "Led by relentless effort of

Hon'ble PM Shri @narendramodi ji, the agreement not only strengthens links between two great nations but also places India's firm footstep in the global supply chain .

Preneet Kaur files nomination from Patiala

Meanwhile, Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma arrived in Punjab for campaigning for BJP candidates.

PM Modi holds roadshow in Varanasi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi held a six-kilometre-long roadshow in Varanasi on Monday, a day before he is scheduled to file his nomination papers from the Lok Sabha seat in Uttar Pradesh.

Modi garlanded a statue of noted educationist and social reformer Madan Mohan Malviya at the Malviya Chauraha in the Lanka area here before beginning the roadshow.

He was accompanied by Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath. According to sources in the BJP, Modi will also take a dip in the Ganga.

The prime minister is seeking a third consecutive term from the seat that will go to polls on June 1 in the seventh and last phase of the Lok Sabha election. More



than 5,000 'matrashaktis' (women) in saffron attire are walking in the roadshow ahead of the vehicle carrying Modi.

The roadshow will be held till Kashi Vishwanath Dham. It will pass through Sant Ravidas Gate, Assi, Shivala, Sonarpura, Jangambadi and Godaulia. Earlier Prime Minister visited

Takhat Sri Harimandir Ji Patna Sahib Gurudwara on Monday. He paid his obeisance in Darbar Sahib, the birthplace of Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji, the tenth Sikh Guru.

The Prime Minister joined Ardaas and listened to live Kirtan there as well. He also did Darshan of the rare 'shastras' (weapons) used by

Sri Guru Gobind Singh ji. Prime Minister did seva of Chaur Sahib and sat in Paath for "Sarbat Da Bhala".

The Prime Minister also visited langar kitchen (Community Kitchen) there and prepared daal. He also served food to the Sangat present in the Gurudwara.

PM took "karah prasad", for which he paid through digital payment mode.

Prime Minister was presented "Sanmaan Patra" by Gurudwara Committee and portrait of Mata Gujri Ji by Sikh Bibis.

In a post on X, the Prime Minister said, "Sikhism is rooted in the principles of equality, justice and compassion. Central to Sikhism is Seva. This morning in Patna, I also had the honour of taking part in Seva as well. It was a very humbling and special experience."

4 dead, 61 injured after huge billboard falls during Mumbai dust storm

Dozens of people are feared trapped under the debris of a massive billboard that collapsed on a fuel station amid a strong dust storm in Mumbai's Ghatkopar this evening. Police said four people were killed and 61 were injured.

The billboard was opposite the fuel station. Visuals show the structure crashing down right in the middle of the refuelling facility.

The metal frame of the billboard tore through the roof of several cars that were at the fuel station.

The police said teams of the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) are at the site, and are looking for survivors trapped under the debris.

Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis in a post on X said the state government has ordered an investigation into the incident.

Mumbai was caught off guard by the strong dust storm, which crippled transport, uprooted trees and structures, and led to power outage in many districts of the financial capital. The sky turned dark when the

dust storm hit the city, with people posting visuals on social media. Local trains, a section of the metro network, and airport services were temporarily stopped amid a darkening sky. "Due to the inclement weather and dust storms in the city,

ensuring safe and smooth aircraft operations. Committed to efficiency and passenger safety, the airport remains steadfast to prioritise seamless operations," it said.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) Mumbai issued a "nowcast warning"



Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport (CSMIA) temporarily suspended flight operations for around 66 minutes due to low visibility and gusty winds," Mumbai airport said in a statement.

"Operations resumed at 17:03 hours. During this time, the airport saw 15 diversions. CSMIA last week completed its pre-monsoon runway maintenance successfully,

forecasting a thunderstorm accompanied by lightning and moderate to intense rain for Thane, Palghar, and Mumbai.

The metro did not run between Aarey and Andheri East after a billboard landed on the overhead wire. Suburban trains were affected after an overhead equipment pole between Thane and Mulund got bent due to the strong winds.

Haryana Chief Electoral Officer, Sh Anurag Agarwal has said that the cost of bulk SMS sent by the candidate during the campaign in Lok Sabha General Elections-2024 will also be included in the expenditure account of the concerned candidate.

He said that the district administration and the concerned Assistant Returning Officer on getting the information about the use of bulk messages during the election campaign period, will assess the estimate of the expenditure incurred on it from the respective service provider and include the same into the expenditure account of the candidate.

The Chief Electoral Officer said that as per the guidelines issued by the Election Commission of India,



there will be a complete ban on sending bulk SMS of political nature during the period up to 48 hours before the end of polling. During the election campaign in all the districts, mobile service providers have given instructions to bring the information about such bulk SMS to the notice of the monitoring team. The Commission has also issued detailed instructions for the conduct of elections in a free, fair and peaceful manner. He said that the teams will also

keep a close vigil on those sending objectionable SMS during the election campaign. During the course of investigation, the sender of such SMS will be traced and appropriate action will be taken against him as per rules, he added.

He said that this is a simple procedure in which bleeding is less and even big stones can be removed easily. He said that this procedure does not cause any complications



even after surgery. He told that this procedure is minimally invasive and does not require any stitches and with this procedure, stones of older patients as well as children are also treated. He said that if surgery is done through this procedure, the patient is not kept in the hospital for long and recovery is also quick. Adesh Group Chairman Dr. H.S. STF raids another pharma factory in Baddi

BADDI: At a pharmaceutical factory in the industrial area of Baddi, after the success of STF's raid on Smilex Pharma for the illegal manufacture of psychotropic substances and drugs, Punjab Police's Special Task Force (STF) has raided another pharma factory and successfully seized a large quantity of intoxicating pills/capsules, raw materials, and syrup. It is being reported that the STF, along with officials from the Himachal Pradesh Drug Controller Authority, conducted a raid on BioGenetic Drugs and seized a large consignment of psychotropic substances and drugs. Preliminary information reveals that drug control administration officials have seized about 400 kilograms of codeine, 364 boxes of Alprazolam tablets, and approximately 4,000 bottles of cough syrup. Alprax tablets and cough syrup are usually misused by drug abusers, while codeine is used to make cough syrup. The crackdown on drugs seized from the pharma factory continued late into the night. The STF has now initiated action against BioGenetic Drugs for the misuse of psychotropic drugs. Meanwhile, the state Drug Controller Authority has issued notices to the management of the pharma company and demanded records in this case. The state Drug Controller Authority is also under scrutiny in this entire case. According to information, a team from Amritsar, led by the DSP of the Special Task Force (STF), conducted a raid at BioGenetic Drugs Private Limited in Baddi and seized various psychotropic drugs purchased over the past year.

Bank of Baroda earns net profit of Rs 17789 crore, growth of 26.1 percent

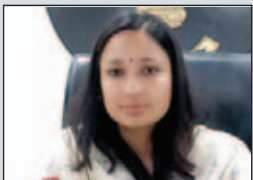

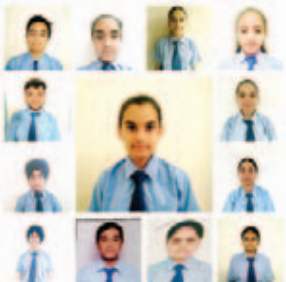

Kejriwal in view of the upcoming Lok Sabha election in Delhi on June 1. The bench, however, said that Kejriwal cannot discharge the functions of the Chief Minister, sign any official files, or use the Chief Minister's Office.

Earlier, the Delhi High Court dismissed pleas seeking directions to remove

Arvind Kejriwal as Chief Minister of Delhi following his arrest by the central agency. Petitioner before it was attempting to drag the court into a political thicket, the Delhi HC had said.

Candidates will have to give criminal records in print, electronic media: DC

According to the guidelines of the Election Commission, after the nomination process is completed and the election symbol is allotted, any candidate against whom any criminal case is registered should publish information about it thrice in electronic media and print media till two days before the date of voting. Will happen. If the candidate belongs to any political party, then it is necessary to inform this information to the party headquarters also, so that the party can give information about the criminal cases of the candidate on its website. District Election Officer and DC Captain Manoj Kumar said that nomination process has been completed today on May 9. He said that during the period from May 10 to May 23, any candidate against



whom any criminal case is registered will be informed about it in major newspapers and TV. It will have to be telecast on channels at least three times on different dates. He said that during nomination, the candidate gives details about his movable and immovable assets, liabilities and criminal cases in Form 26 of the Election Commission. After the order of the Supreme Court in this matter, in the

year 2018, the Election Commission of India had issued instructions that during the election campaign, the candidate with a criminal record and his party should submit information about the criminal cases registered against candidate three times. Information will have to be published in newspapers in -1 format. Similarly, this information will be broadcast three times in electronic media also. DEO said that after the details of the criminal record are published, the candidate has to submit its report to the District Election Officer's office. Under Section 78 of the Representation of the People Act, the candidate will also have to pay the bill for the advertisement of announcement published, so that it can be added to the election expenses of the candidate.

Trade secret

Global geo-economics is undergoing rapid changes. Indian trade diplomacy, too, is changing with the emergence of new priorities and forms. But first, the backstory. The era of Washington Consensus in the 1990s was a period of opening up of international trade. This meant the liberalisation of global trade. The opening up of domestic markets was an essential prerequisite for globalisation. However, liberalisation was to be regulated by a leviathan: the World Trade Organization.

The WTO was formed in 1995. It succeeded the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade. The WTO was mandated to ensure that global markets remained open and that countries would engage in global trade in an orderly manner. Any dispute would be referred to the dispute settlement mechanism whereby the WTO would resolve the matter. Despite high hopes and confidence in the WTO's ability in ensuring parity in global markets, it turned out to be a disappointment. In his book, Globalization and Its Discontents, Joseph Stiglitz, the former chief economist of the World Bank, argued that the WTO has proven to be a failure in protecting the interests of the countries of the Global South from the assertive claims of those from the Global North.

Countries like India have taken recourse to other means to meet their strategic trade interests. Free Trade Agreement diplomacy has become a new tool in its arsenal. In March, the Narendra Modi government signed a comprehensive Trade and Economic Partnership Agreement with the European Free Trade Association member states, Iceland, Norway, Switzerland and Liechtenstein. The TEPA will see these four countries investing \$100 billion in India over the next 15 years, generating close to a million jobs across sectors like pharmaceuticals, chemicals, information technology, Artificial Intelligence and so on. India has also negotiated FTAs with Australia and the United Arab Emirates. An FTA with the United Kingdom is in the works; once implemented, the UK-India FTA will be the first such free trade agreement that India would have with a major Western power.

The EFTA is meant to reduce India's trade deficit with some European nations, all of which have a healthy trade relationship with India. However, China is the main reason why India has invested diplomatic capital in the EFTA. China is India's second-largest trade partner with bilateral trade well over \$100 billion. However, India has a massive trade deficit with China.

Notwithstanding the optimism over the new FTA diplomacy, its potential bottlenecks need to be understood. A key roadblock is the issue of market access. For instance, in the negotiations over the India-UK FTA, London wants more market access for its products, especially in the dairy and the micro, small and medium enterprises sectors.

Turmoil continues in PoJK

Amid a resumption of the march in Pakistan-occupied Jammu and Kashmir (PoJK), President Asif Ali Zardari and Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif made pledges to address the 'genuine demands' of the protesters. However, despite efforts, an agreement between the Jammu Kashmir Joint Awami Action Committee and the PoJK government remained elusive, with the protest movement pressing forward with its march on Muzafarabad, Dawn reported.

Following clashes that resulted in the death of a policeman, relative calm settled over the region, though business centres remained shuttered and public transport suspended in Muzaffarabad and Poonch divisions. Mirpur saw a partial strike, signalling the depth of sentiment driving the protests.

The impasse persisted even after talks between the JAAC core committee and PoJK Chief Secretary Dawood Bareach ended without progress in Rawalakot. A protester from Rawalakot accused the government of employing evasive tactics, exacerbating tensions further, as reported by Dawn.

Participants in the discussions included figures from various regions, including Muzafarabad, Rawalakot, Kotli, and Bagh. However, hopes for a breakthrough were dashed, as one participant, Sardar Umar Nazir Kashmiri, lamented the lack of tangible outcomes, accusing the government of deception and delay.

In response to the ongoing protests, government offices and educational institutions announced closures for the following day. Demonstrators, emboldened by their leaders' firm stance, vowed not to be swayed by empty promises, demanding concrete action on their grievances.

Despite initial optimism among JAAC representatives, hopes for a resolution were dashed, leading to a call for the continuation of protests. Meanwhile, essential businesses in the capital briefly reopened, but the streets remained eerily deserted, reflecting the tense atmosphere gripping the region. Similar scenes unfolded in Rawalakot, with sparse vehicular activity save for those carrying activists from



neighbouring districts. The scheduled rallies from the Mirpur and Poonch divisions indicated a unified front in the protest movement, with locals showing solidarity by welcoming the procession, according to Dawn. Rumours of Ranger intervention added fuel to the fire, sparking fears of further escalation. While the paramilitary force's initial withdrawal was met with relief by some, reports of their return fueled uncertainty and anxiety among the pop-

ulace. In the face of mounting tensions, both President Zardari and Prime Minister Shehbaz urged restraint and dialogue to resolve the crisis.

President Zardari emphasised the importance of responsible action by all stakeholders, warning against exploitation by external forces. Prime Minister Shehbaz echoed these sentiments, expressing deep concern over the situation and calling for a peaceful resolution

through dialogue. He convened a meeting to address the ongoing crisis, emphasising the need to uphold the rule of law and protect public property. In a statement on social media, the Prime Minister reaffirmed his commitment to resolving the situation peacefully, despite attempts by detractors to politicise the issue. He remained optimistic about a swift resolution, urging all parties to engage constructively in dialogue, Dawn reported.

Study reveals key role of Galectin-3 in brain tumour development

A research group at the University of Seville's Department of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology has achieved great progress by identifying the critical role of the protein Galectin-3 in the progression of several forms of brain tumours.

The most prevalent immune system cells in malignant tumours, microglia and macrophages, overexpress Galectin-3, creating an immunosuppressive environment that prevents other immune cells from attacking cancer cells.

In vitro findings have shown that specific inhibition of Galectin-3 in microglial cells promotes expression of proinflammatory markers and reverses the presence of key immunosuppressive biomarkers. In vivo models of brain metastases of breast cancer and glioblastoma, two of the most common and aggressive types of brain tumours in the population, have validated these results. In genetically-modified models where Galectin-3 was knocked out, microglia cells and macrophages displayed a more



inflammatory and anti-tumour state, leading to a reduction in the size of primary tumours and brain metastases by up to fivefold.

These results, although preclinical, have clear translational potential. Thanks to collaborations with Lund University, the research group has access to the TD006 antibody, a selective inhibitor of Galectin-3 currently being tested in clinical trials in Alzheimer's patients.

German Navy sails to Asia in support of allies

A German combat vessel, Frankfurt am Main, along with a frigate, Baden-Wuerttemberg, has started sailing from Europe towards Asia. The move is orchestrated to show Germany's support for its allies against China's aggressive behaviour in the South China Sea.

During its current tour, the fleet will also participate in Rim of the Pacific Exercise (RIMPAC) naval exercises with other fleets belonging to several countries on the Asian and American continents, according to a report in Nikkei Asia.

The 29th Rim of the Pacific (RIMPAC) exercise will take place in June and July 2024. The exercise will take place in the waters around the Hawaiian Islands.

The ships will engage in naval exercises with fleets from Canada, the US, Japan, India, and France.

The key highlight of these exercises will be the US Navy-led RIMPAC manoeuvre, which is the world's largest maritime exercise that takes place every two years off Hawaii. Additionally, during the RIMPAC,



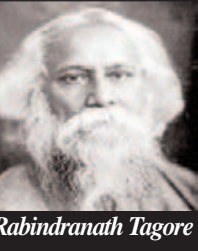
the ships will also be joined by the German Air Force, the report claimed.

The same will also be joined by the Air forces of France and Spain, creating a fleet of European fighter planes. Additionally, Italy also is looking to send its aircraft carrier Cavour, along with its entire fleet of ships including F-35 multirole combat aircraft, to participate in RIMPAC. Separately, France also plans to send the nuclear-powered aircraft carrier Charles de Gaulle to the Indo-Pacific this year.

Issues faced by builders and developers in IBC-2016 - suggested amendments to CIRP regulations

IBC is currently sector agnostic - So are its rules, regulations, procedures. But, it creates problems when specific problems of a sector are either unattended or they cause suffering. So these are two sample problems faced by indian real estate sector due to generic formulations under IBC 2016 One relating to contractor insolvency, another about the scope of the role of Resolution Professional under IBC, which is not suited to real estate sector. Today we deal with first issue:

Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 ('IBC' or 'Code') provides for a mechanism (u/s 14 of the Code), called 'Moratorium' whereby all encumbrances on the 'property' of the 'Corporate Debtor' (the enterprise which is subject to insolvency resolution process under the IBC) ceases. That is, there can be no enforcement of any 'security interest' nor can any other third-party right/title/interest be created on anything that is considered as the 'property' of the Debtor u/s 3(27) of the IBC, under

lution/debt-recovery laws, (such as the RDBBFI Act, the SARFAESI Act, etc.), or

(ii) Even under any Court order pursuant to other laws such as an order by Civil Court for possession of a property under possession of the Corporate Debtor, or an order by National Consumer Commission (for refunds of paid amount, or payment of penalties to allottees of units), or,

(iii) Even under an order by Govt. Authorities such as seizure/attachment of property by Revenue department or recovery of taxes by GST or Income Tax Department, etc.

However, such sweeping/generic restrictions pose certain issues, which are specific to various industries. Therefore, while this blanket ban under 'Moratorium' is well-intended, and is meant to primarily to protect & preserve the value of the beleaguered enterprise (the Corporate Debtor) as

a 'Going Concern', it poses several issues which need some clarifications in view of context specific to various industries. Further, to ensure timely & speedy resolution of insolvency, the IBC provides for time-bound schedule of ac-

tivities right from the stage of initiation of an application before the NCLT (u/s. 7 or u/s 9 of the Code). The appointed Interim Resolution Professional ('IRP') or the 'Resolution Professional ('RP') are required to perform a long list of activities under a tight daily schedule under close watch of the stakeholders and the IBBI (the sectoral Regulator)..

Some of the issues faced by construction companies, seeking take-over of beleaguered real estate companies as successful Resolution applicant are as follows

(A) Inclusion of liabilities created by RP for running the CD, a construction company, as a going concern, in CIRP costs

(B) Absence of sector-specific guidelines on scope of powers of RP for conduct of CD as a going concern during the CIRP period.

(C) Absence of any provisions laying down the role of RP during the transition period between acceptance/rejection of Resolution Plan (by NCLT), and the takeover by the Resolution Applicant / Liquidator

(D) Absence of any procedure for a comprehensive handover by the RP to

the incoming Liquidator or Resolution Applicant

(E) Absence of any acclimatization period for the IRP before being appointed by NCLT

The provisions, again, though well-intended and meant to prevent inordinate delays in insolvency resolution, pose several issues which need clarifications under the IBC. We shall discuss this (these) issue(s) in the next post. Here, we shall discuss issues faced by construction companies, due to moratorium imposed u/s 14 on the property of a contractor(s), who is (are) engaged by construction companies. The issues arising out of Contractor' Insolvency are as follows:

(A) Inability to encash the Performance Bank Guarantee: „h Performance Bank Guarantee ('PBG'): Bank Guarantee posted by a successful bidder (the contractor), with the employer (the construction company who invited & accepted the bid) to essentially assure the employer of performance of obligations under the contract by the contractor. This Bank Guarantee is encashed by the employer upon substantial default by contractor (as per terms/clus-

es of the contract)

(B) Inability of the employer, to forfeit

Security Deposit of the insolvent contractor, necessitated by deficient performance by the contractor in some contracted items „h Security Deposit: A specified proportion, say 1%-5%, from every approved bill is deducted by the employer as security for rectification of defects & deficiencies (whether in quality or in measurement, or both), in any of the works for which the payment is being made under that bill. Upon violation of related conditions of the contract, the employer is within his rights to forfeit such amounts deducted from the relevant bills

(C) Inability of the employer to encash Bank Guarantee(s) posted by the contractor against 'Mobilization Advance' or 'Materials Advance'

Bank Guarantee against Mobilization Advance: Contractors are frequently advanced an amount to help the contractor in expenses to be incurred in mobilizing manpower, tools plant & equipment, materials, etc. at the worksite.

There are clear terms under the

contract (and guidelines issued by the CVC in case the employer is government organization), for recovery of such 'advance' from the contractor' payments approved against interim/running bills. These advances are secured by the employer by seeking a Bank Guarantee of the appropriate amount.

Bank Guarantee against Materials Advance: Contractors are also provided liquidity support in form 'advance', which is secured against the materials delivered at site (for use in the project). This amount is also to be recovered as per terms of the contract, and secured through bank-guarantee as well as the 'materials'".

(D) Inability to encash Bank Guarantee in lieu of Earnest Money Deposit Earnest Money Deposit ('EMD'): Security in form of Bank Guarantee, which is posted by a tenderer/bidder during the tendering process, to guarantee correctness of the bid and to bind the bidder to the terms of the tender. The EMD is forfeited by the construction company (i.e. the procurer, who invites tenders/bids) in the event of violation of any clause(s) of the NIT/ITT by the bidder/tenderer.

Everything you need to know about pawanmuktasana yoga pose



In light of the coronavirus pandemic, a significant number of people have succumbed to unhealthy lifestyles. This may be in the form of unhealthy eating habits, lethargy, weight gain, etc. Pawanmuktasana, a popular yoga pose, also known as Gas Release Pose can be added to one's daily routine in order to combat these issues. The word "Pawanamuktasana" is made of two words, 'Pawan' which means wind and 'Mukta', which translates to release. As the name suggests this asana helps in releasing the accumulated wind in our stomach and intestines. Pawanmuktasana helps reduce binge eating, improves

mental health, regulates bowel movements and assists in weightloss. How To Do Steps Pawanmuktasana Yoga Pose Lie on your back or in a supine position, with your arms beside your body. Inhale. Exhale, bringing your knees toward your chest and pressing your thighs on your abdomen with clasped hands. Inhale again. As you exhale, raise your head off the floor, letting your chin touch your knees. Hold this pose as you take deep, long breaths in and out. Release the pose to return to the starting position, bringing your head down first and then your legs - this is one

round. Do 23 rounds and then relax. Pawanmuktasana Preparatory Poses The beauty of Pawanmuktasana as a pose is that it can be inculcated into every sequence, irrespective of the kind of sequence one is working at. This is a very simple way to get them back, neck, shoulders and legs in action easily, there is not much one can bring as a sequence before this pose. Yet we can do the following before the practice of this pose: Supta Matsyendrasana [Supine Spinal Twist Pose] While on your back, bend the legs at the knees and bring them to the chest. With a deep

breath take both the knees to the left side twisting from the hip and bring it to the floor. Keep the arms stretched out to the side of you in line with your shoulders. This twisting of the hip along with the legs will help in opening the lower back thus working as a preparatory pose for Pawanamuktasana. Ardha Pawanmuktasana [Half Wind Release Pose] From the relaxed pose on your back, inhale and take the left leg at 90 degrees and bend the knee and bring it to the chest and hold with your hands. After a few breaths, raise the head and place the chin on the knee while the other leg is stretched out at 30 degrees from the floor. Repeat with the other leg and hold for a longer duration as breathing here in this pose is not as difficult as in Pawanamuktasana. Pawanmuktasana Relaxing Yoga Poses Pawanamuktasana is considered as both a simple and intermediate pose as the body is not stressed out much in this pose, but a lot of pressure is felt in the neck and chest region. In order to relax the muscles around the chest, neck and abdomen, one can follow it up with some simpler relaxing,

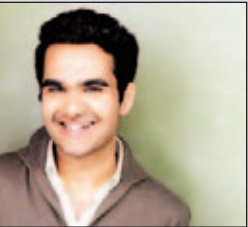

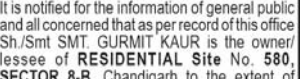

The polling for the fourth phase of the Lok Sabha election is underway.

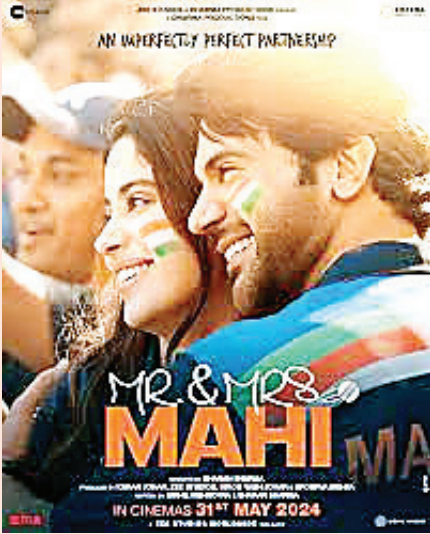
