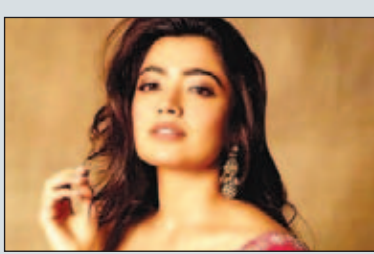

Uttarakhand CM asks secretary to camp in Uttarkashi, monitor Chardham Yatra

DEHRADUN: With an unprecedented number of pilgrims visiting Chardham this year, Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami on Wednesday asked his secretary, an IAS officer, to camp in Uttarkashi and monitor the management of the yatra to Gangotri and Yamunotri. The Chief Minister is also maintaining a constant vigil, an official said. The decision to depute the R Meenakshi Sundaram in Uttarkashi has been taken due to the unprecedented crowds visiting Gangotri and Yamunotri, he said.

"Deeply Saddened": India after ex-Indian Army officer killed in Gaza

NEW DELHI: India on Wednesday said it is "deeply saddened" over the death of Colonel Waibhav Anil Kale (Retd), the Indian national who was working with the UN in Gaza. The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) said India's Permanent Mission to the UN in New York as well as its mission in Tel Aviv and Ramallah are extending all assistance in the repatriation of remains of Kale to India. Kale was killed after the vehicle he was travelling in came under attack in Gaza's Rafah region on Monday. "We are deeply saddened by the death of Colonel Waibhav Anil Kale (Retd), Security Coordination Officer in the UN Department of Safety and Security (DSS) in Gaza on May 13," the MEA said. "We extend our heartfelt condolences to his family and dear ones," it said. "Our Permanent Mission to the UN in New York and our Missions in Tel Aviv and Ramallah are extending all assistance in the repatriation of mortal remains to India and continue to be in touch with relevant authorities regarding the investigation into the incident," the MEA said in a statement.

Rajasthan mine collapse: All 15 HCL officials rescued, 1 feared dead

JAIPUR: All 15 Hindustan Copper Limited officials who had been trapped in a mine in Neem ka Thana district since last night were taken out Wednesday, with one of them is feared dead, an official said. Neem ka Thana Collector Sharad Mehra said 14 rescued were sent to SMS hospital in Jaipur for treatment and one was taken to a company hospital for examination as he is feared dead. Fifteen personnel of the public sector company got trapped in a mine Tuesday night when a cage used to carry the personnel fell down after a rope broke, police said.

Pak HC grants bail to Imran Khan in 190 million pounds corruption case

ISLAMABAD: A High Court in Pakistan on Wednesday granted bail to Imran Khan in the 190 million pounds corruption case, in which the jailed former prime minister and his wife are accused of receiving land worth billions of rupees as a bribe from a real estate tycoon.

14 people given Indian citizenship certificates for first time under CAA

The first set of citizenship certificates to 14 people was issued under the Citizenship (Amendment) Act or CAA today, nearly two months after the Centre notified it, initiating the process of granting Indian nationality to persecuted non-Muslim migrants from Pakistan, Afghanistan and Bangladesh.

Under the CAA, the qualification period of citizenship application has been reduced from 11 to 5 years for undocumented non-Muslim migrants from Pakistan, Bangladesh and Afghanistan who came to India before December 31, 2014.

Union Home Secretary Shri Ajay Kumar Bhalla handed over citizenship certificates to the applicants in Delhi and highlighted salient features of the CAA. Secretary Posts, Director (IB), Registrar General of India and senior officers were also present during the interactive session.

The CAA was enacted in December 2019 to grant Indian nationality to persecuted non-Muslim migrants from Bangladesh, Pakistan and Afghanistan. These include Hindus, Sikhs, Jains, Buddhists, Parsis and Christians. The Act got the president's assent but the rules under which the Indian citizenship was granted were issued only on March 11 this year after



over four years delay. The ruling BJP, which committed to enacting the Citizenship Amendment Bill in its 2019 manifesto, said the implementation was delayed due to the pandemic.

The notification drew sharp criticism from the opposition, which terms the move as discriminatory and motivated by the Lok Sabha elections. The Centre, however, has maintained that the CAA "does not prevent any persecuted Muslim for practising their version of Islam, from applying for Indian citizenship under the existing laws".

Several parts of the country witnessed protests against the decision to implement CAA as some fear the law

could be used to declare them illegal immigrants and take away their Indian citizenship.

The government denies this and says the law is needed to help minorities facing persecution in Muslim-majority nations as per the "evergreen generous culture of India to get Indian citizenship for their happy and prosperous future".

"No Indian citizen would be asked to produce any document to prove citizenship", the Ministry of Home Affairs headed by Amit Shah had said, adding the Citizenship Act doesn't deal with the deportation of illegal immigrants.

SC says arrest of NewsClick founder invalid, orders his release

The Supreme Court on Wednesday declared invalid the arrest and subsequent remand of NewsClick founder and Editor-in-Chief Prabir Purkayastha by the Delhi police in connection with a case under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA).

A bench of Justices BR Gavai and Sandeep Mehta ordered the release of NewsClick founders in the case.

The apex court ordered that Purkayastha be released, subject to him furnishing surety and bail bond.

The bench, in its verdict, took into note that a copy of the remand application and grounds of arrest were not provided to Purkayastha, which violated principles of natural justice.

Pronouncing the verdict, the top court said, "A copy of the remand application was not provided to the appellant. This vitiates the arrest of the appellant... Though we would have released him without surety, since the chargesheet has been filed, we release him with surety and a bail bond."

Purkayastha has been in custody since October 2, 2023.

He has been lodged in Tihar jail under anti-terror law and has applied in a pending case seeking release on medi-



cal grounds.

Purkayastha had approached the apex court, challenging his arrest under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) over alleged Chinese funding to promote anti-national propaganda.

He challenged the Delhi High Court's October 13, 2023, order upholding the trial court order remanding him to police custody. He has since been remanded to judicial custody.

Earlier, NewsClick's human resources department head, Amit Chakravarty, had withdrawn from the Supreme Court his petition against his arrest.

A Delhi court had allowed Chakravarty to turn an approver in the case lodged against the news portal.

Purkayastha and Chakravarty were arrested by the Special Cell of the Delhi Police on October 3 after it

searched 30 locations connected with the online news portal and its journalists in a case filed under the UAPA following allegations that it received money for pro-China propaganda.

They subsequently moved the High Court to challenge the arrest as well as the seven-day police custody and sought immediate release as interim relief. The High Court had rejected their pleas and said it was of the view that "the fact that serious offences affecting stability, integrity, sovereignty and national security have been alleged against the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to pass any favourable orders." According to the FIR, a large amount of funding to the news portal allegedly came from China to "disrupt the sovereignty of India" and cause disaffection against the country.

Kejriwal to start LS election campaign from Amritsar today

National Convenor of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal will be on Punjab's visit from tomorrow, May 16th. He will reach Amritsar on Thursday and from the holy land, he will start his Lok Sabha election campaign in Punjab.

Despite being in jail, Kejriwal is aware of the political situation in Punjab because Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann met him twice in jail and informed him about the political atmosphere of other states including Punjab. Ever since Arvind Kejriwal has come out of jail, there is a new enthusiasm among the leaders and workers of Aam Aadmi Party Punjab.

I never said Hindu or Muslim, I talked about poor families : PM Modi

Clarifying his "infiltrators" and "those with more children" remarks, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday said that he did not only talk about Muslims but spoke about every poor family, adding that the day he starts doing Hindu-Muslim, he will be "unworthy of public life."

In an interview with News 18, PM Modi said that he does not market love towards Muslims, "I do not work for a vote bank. I believe in Sabka Saath, Sabka Vi-

kas." "I am shocked. Who told you that whenever one talks of people with more children, the inference is they are Muslims? Why are you so unjust towards Muslims? This is the situation in poor families too. Where there is poverty, there are more children, irrespective of their social circle. I didn't mention either Hindu or Muslim. I have said that one should have as many children as you can take care of. Don't let a situation arise where the gov-



ernment has to take care of your children," the Prime Minister said on Tuesday.

Heatwave likely over Northwest & East: IMD

A fresh spell of heat wave will likely commence over Northwest India from Thursday and eastern India from May 18, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said on Wednesday.

According to the IMD, isolated pockets of West Rajasthan, Punjab, south Haryana, East Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Bihar are very likely to witness heatwave conditions from May 16 to 19 with the possibility of severe heatwave conditions from May 17 onwards.

"Heat wave conditions very likely in isolated pockets over Gujarat region during 15th-17th; Konkan on 15th & 16th; Saurashtra and Kutch on May 16th & 17th; Delhi, Jharkhand,

Gangetic West Bengal and Odisha on May 18th & 19th," the IMD said.

The weather department has also predicted rainfall with isolated heavy rain accompanied by thunderstorms, lightning and gusty winds over south Peninsular India till May 20.

"Isolated heavy rainfall very likely over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Karaikal, Kerala, Mahe, Coastal and Karnataka from today till 19th May," the IMD said.

The MeT department also forecast isolated heavy rainfall over Arunachal Pradesh from May 16 to 19 and over Assam and Meghalaya from May 17 to 19.

Southwest Monsoon is very likely to advance into South Andaman Sea, some parts of Southeast Bay of Bengal and Nicobar Islands around May 19, it said.

Haryana approves New Excise Policy of for year 2024-25

Haryana Cabinet which met under the Chairmanship of Chief Minister, Sh. Nayab Singh here today accorded approval to the Haryana Police (Merger of Indian Reserve battalion's Police Personnel in District (General Cadre) Rules, 2024.

The Haryana Cabinet also gave nod to the new excise policy of the State for the year 2024-25. The excise policy has been approved for a period of one year starting from June 12, 2024 and has been brought with the approval of Election Commission of India. With the approval of this policy, the department will now start e-auction for allotment of retail vends for the next year. The auction will commence from May 27, 2024. The maximum number of retail L-2/L-14A vends will remain the same in the new

policy. The maximum basic quota of IMFL for 2024-25 will be 700 Lakh Proof Liters and the maximum basic quota of Country Liquor will be 1200 Lakh Proof Liters. The QR code-based Track and trace System that was introduced in 2023-24 for IMFL and Country Liquor will be extended to Imported Foreign Liquor as well. The Minimum Retail Sale Prices of Imported Liquor brands will be fixed by the department to streamline the business. There will be a slight increase in excise duty on IMFL and Country Liquor in the next policy year starting from June 12, 2024. Any person desirous of participating in the e-auction will be required to furnish Aadhar Card/ PPP (Parivar Pehchan Patra), Income Tax Returns for the last three assessment years and must have minimum net worth of Rs. 60 lakhs.

Gwalior 'Rajmata' Madhavi Raje passes away

Madhavi Raje Scindia (70), the queen mother of the Gwalior royal family and mother of Union Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia, passed away on Wednesday. Her last rites will be performed with traditional rituals in Gwalior Thursday afternoon. Sources close to the Scindia family informed that she breathed her last at 9.28 am at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi. Her family members were with her during that time.

Scindia, wife of former Union Minister Madhav Rao Scindia, was unwell for the last three months and was undergoing treatment at AIIMS for about two months. Her condition was critical over the last two weeks and she was on ventilator.

She belonged to the Rana dynasty of Nepal. The head of this dynasty was



Juddha Shumsher Jang Bahadur Rana, who was also the Prime Minister of Nepal.

She was married to the then Maharaja of Gwalior Madhav Rao Scindia on May 8, 1966. Before becoming the daughter-in-law of the Scindia royal family, her name was Kiran Raj Lakshmi.

She and Madhav Rao have a daughter Chitrangada Raje and a son Jyotiraditya Scindia.

The mortal remains of Scindia will be kept for last darshan at her residence at 27 Safdarjung Road between 3 pm to 7 pm. Her mortal remains will be taken to Gwalior by plane tomorrow morning.

After the last darshan at Rani Mahal in the afternoon, the last rites will be performed at around 3.30 pm at Chhatra of Scindia Dynasty in Gwalior, where the last rites of the people of Scindia dynasty have been traditionally performed.

Madhya Pradesh (MP) Chief Minister (CM) Mohan Yadav has expressed deep condolences on her demise. He said, "Received the heart-wrenching news of the demise of Smt. Madhavi Raje Scindia, the revered mother of senior Bharatiya Janata Party leader and Union Minister, Honorable Shri Jyotiraditya Scindia ji. Mother is the basis of life, her death is an irreparable loss to life. I pray to Baba Mahakal to grant the departed

virtuous soul a place at his feet and strength to his family members to bear this deep sorrow."


Expressing condolences, Uttar Pradesh CM Yogi Adityanath said, "The demise of the revered mother of Honorable Union Minister Shri Jyotiraditya Scindia ji is extremely sad. My humble tribute to her! My condolences are with the bereaved family. It is a prayer to Lord Shri Ram to grant the departed soul a place at his feet and the bereaved family members the strength to bear this sorrow."

Senior Congress leader and former CM of MP, Digvijay Singh, said in his condolence message, "Deeply saddened to hear the news of the tragic demise of respected Rajmata Madhavi Raje Scindia. We have shared familial bonds. She had a very polite personality. Our condolences to Shri Jyotiraditya Scindia ji and all the family members. May God grant peace to her soul. 7 lakh 79 thousand 843 metric tons of wheat arrives in Karnal



DR ASHOK KUMAR KARNAL: Deputy Commissioner Uttam Singh said that, 7 lakh 79 thousand 843 metric tonnes of wheat has arrived in the mandis and various procurement centers of the district, which was purchased by government procurement agencies and traders. The agencies have been instructed to speed up the lifting work. He informed that 3 lakh 4 thousand 258 metric tons of wheat was purchased by the Food and Supplies Department, 3 lakh 98 thousand 955 metric tons by HAFED and 67 thousand 866 metric tons of wheat was purchased by Haryana Warehousing Corporation. 8 thousand 764 metric tons of wheat was purchased by traders. The Deputy Commissioner appealed to the farmers not to set fire to the fields after harvesting the crops.

CCSHAU begins admission process for academic session 2024-25

BUREAU CHANDIGARH, MAY 15

Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University (CCSHAU), Hisar has started the admission process for various undergraduate and postgraduate programs. The application process will continue till June 10, 2024. Sharing information in this regard a University Spokesperson said that admission to undergraduate courses will be based on entrance tests. For the 2+4 year B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture program, admission will be based on the Agriculture Aptitude Test after the 10th class. For the four-year programs, including B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.FSc (Bachelor of Fisheries Science), B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science, and B.Sc. (Hons.) Agribusiness Management, admission will be based on an entrance test

after the 12th class. Admission to B.Tech (Agricultural Engineering) and B.Tech (Agricultural Engineering LEET) will be based on merit in the Joint Entrance Test (Mains) 2024 and LEET 2024 conducted by the Haryana State Counselling Society (HSCS). He further said that admission to postgraduate courses in various colleges of the university will also be based on a common entrance test. These courses include Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Extension Education, Agri.meteorology, Agronomy, Fruit Science/Floriculture and Landscaping, Genetics and Plant Breeding, Nematology, Plant Pathology, Plant Protection-Entomology, Seed Science and Technology, Silviculture and Agroforestry, Soil Science and Vegetable Science in the College of Agriculture.

Bio-Chemistry, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Food Science and Technology, Mathematics, Microbiology, Physics, Plant Physiology, Sociology, Statistics, and Zoology are included in the College of Basic and Humanities. Apparel and Textile Science, Extension Education and Communication Management, Food and Nutrition, Human Development and Family Studies, and Resource Management and Consumer Science are included in the College of Community Science. Farm Machinery and Power Engineering, Soil and Water Conservation Engineering, Renewable Energy Engineering, and Processing and Food Engineering are included in the College of Agricultural Engineering and Technology. Agricultural Biotechnology, Bioinformatics, and Molecular Biology and Biotechnology are included in the College of Biotechnology,

while students can seek admission to PhD courses in Bioinformatics and Molecular Biology and Biotechnology. In the year 2021-22, under a project, Basmati paddy was grown in one thousand acres of land of 500 farmers in the district in which chemicals were used judiciously under the guidance of scientists. No trace of poison was found in that rice during testing. Impressed by this project, Dr. Angamuthu, the then Chairman of Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA), came to Karnal in 2022. Apart from this, a project on Agri Smart Agriculture Technology on Tomato was run with NABARD in 2023-24. By using various equipment in tomato crop, the role of pesticides was minimised. 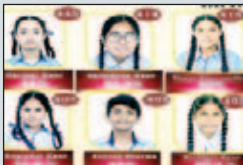
VB nabs patwari taking Rs 15,000 bribe for issuing surviving certificate

being enforced but is in the process of being collected forcefully". Asserting that farmers were in no position to pay water cess for canal irrigation, Mrs Badal said "the farmers of the State and especially the Malwa belt are already reeling from the AAP government's failure to pay compensation for white fly attack on the cotton crop as well as widespread damage to the wheat crop during hail storms". She said farmers had also been promised that all crops would be procured on MSP including pulses

and maize but this did not happen resulting in huge losses to the farming community. Appealing to the people to vote against the anti-farmer AAP party in the forthcoming elections, Mrs Badal said "the SAD will fight to ensure this anti-farmer directive is not implemented". The Bathinda MP said this new directive had come about on the heels of another conspiracy to rob Punjab of its River waters and transfer water to Haryana and Delhi through the Sutlej Yamuna Link (SYL) canal.

No solution in sight to get rid of overflowing sewerage, dharna enters 15th day

BSF intercepts Chinese drone carrying heroin

TARN TARAN : Alert Border Security Force patrol party intercepted a Heroin-carrier drone in Punjab's Tarn Taran border district early Wednesday, the BSF said.

During early hours, vigilant BSF troops on patrol intercepted movement of the drone across border fence in district Tarn Taran. As per protocol, BSF troops tracked its

movement and endeavoured to neutralise it, the BSF Spokesperson said. The drone's likely dropping zone was cordoned and an extensive search was conducted, the spokesperson said. "At about 6.15am, the troops successfully recovered one small drone with one packet of suspected Heroin attached with it ahead of border fence in area of Village Havelian," he added. He said the recovered packet weighing 550g approx was wrapped with transparent adhesive tape inside which two small packets wrapped with yellow adhesive tape were discovered. A ring made of nylon rope was also found attached with the main packet.

Out of the total 80 nomination forms received for the Lok Sabha elections in all the four Parliamentary Constituencies (PC's), wherein 51 candidates submitted their nominations, 40 nominations filed by the candidates were held valid after the scrutiny.

He stated that 23 nomination forms were received for Kangra PC, followed by 22 in Mandi, 20 in Hamirpur and 15 in Shimla PC and as of date, after scrutiny, the candidates whose nominations were found valid stands as 11 in Kangra, 10 in Mandi, 12 in Hamirpur and 7 in Shimla PC. In Kangra PC, the nomination papers found invalid and rejected were

those of Vijay Kumar of Bahujan Samaj Party, Ashish Butail of INC, (both Substitute) and of Sanjay Kumar Rana, an Independent candidate.

Similarly, in Mandi PC the nomination forms rejected were of Sunder Singh Thakur INC, Govind Singh Thakur BJP (as substitute candidates), Laik Ram Negi & Sukh Ram, both Independent candidates.

In Hamirpur the nomination forms of Rattan Chand Katoch BSP, Anjana Devi of INC, Virendar Kanwar BJP (all substitute candidates), were found invalid rejected.

In Shimla, the nomination form of Reena Kashyap BJP, as a substitute candidate was held invalid.

Similarly, for by-polls in the six Assembly Constituencies, (AC's) the total nomination forms

received were 35 with 33 candidates filing their nominations. Total nomination forms received were five each in Dharamshala, Lahaul-Spiti and Kutlehar AC's followed by nine received in Sujampur AC, eight in Gagret and three in Barsar.

After the scrutiny, 25 nominations were found valid viz: four in Dharamshala, three each in Lahaul-Spiti and Barsar, eight in Sujampur and seven in Gagret.

In Dharamshala the nomination form rejected were those of Suresh Kumar of INC, in Lahaul-Spiti the form of Anil Kumar of INC was held invalid, in Gagret the nomination form of Renu Kalia as a covering candidate of INC was rejected after scrutiny. In Sujampur and Barsar all nomination papers were found correct.

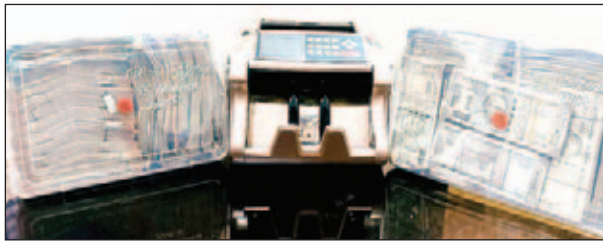

Contravention of the provisions of any of these Sections is punishable by imprisonment for up to 5 years and with a fine. She further said that any violation of these provisions during the election would be dealt with firmly and FIRs/ complaints would be lodged under relevant provisions in the event of any offence under the said sections of the Religious Institutions (Prevention of Misuse), Act 1988.

Strict action to be taken on soliciting votes with help of religious symbols, pictures: Returning Officer

He added that a pregnant woman with high hypertension should undergo regular check-up from a gynecologist as well as from a medical specialist. CS said that preventable causes of maternal deaths such as anaemia, BP, sepsis

CS further said that the pregnant woman be made aware about diet, all the requirements including HB test should be made before the delivery of every pregnant woman. He said that the hospital, where the delivery will be performed should be planned in advance and the delivery should be done in government offices.

Bring Bonnie home

At a relief camp in Nongada, Imphal East district, Manipur, little Bonnie (name changed) was asked to sing a song for the visiting members of the Supreme Court-appointed committee for relief and rehabilitation of internally displaced persons. Unlike many her age, she didn't pick a popular Taylor Swift single or the latest Bollywood chartbuster. Instead, she sang a seitha esei (a lament song) about going back home. Eyes welling with tears, her voice choking up but still melodious, Bonnie's lament would have moved even a person with a heart of stone. Looking around, I saw that those present, whether they understood the meaning of the words or not, were crying. I was no exception. At that moment, I realised what the actual price of a divided society is — the tears of a child unable to return home.

Bonnie is a Meitei and her home, not too far away from the camp, falls in the periphery of a Kuki-dominated area. It is unsafe for her and thousands like her to go back there. Their houses have been razed and some of them burnt to the ground. The same is true for Kukis who lived in the valley in Meitei-dominated regions. As another poster in a relief camp declared, it has been over a year and neither has there been any punishment for the perpetrators of the violence on both sides, nor have people been able to return home. The relief camp is now their prison; the seitha esei, their outlet.

Having assisted the committee with some of its work, I had read the relevant documentation and gathered data on the ethnic conflict in Manipur. But the enormity of the tragedy and the task ahead for the administration became clear to me only after my visit. In the two relief camps which I visited, in Imphal East and Imphal West, two existing structures — a disused community health centre and an expo hall — had been repurposed to accommodate internally displaced persons. Scores of families now live, if they are lucky, in small rooms, otherwise in makeshift enclosures created from tarpaulin sheets or plywood separators.

The administration has provided health facilities, care for newborns, and sewing machines for the residents to restart their livelihoods. An open space in one camp was the anganwadi and nursery school with camp children spending a few hours there. A large room in another camp was the gym where, amongst other things, Zumba classes are held. Despite the adversity, the residents have made the most of a difficult situation. Some have opened shops within the camp; others like Bonnie have taken admission in a local private school. But each of them has a common refrain — they are happy with the arrangements the administration has made but want to go back home desperately.

India, US convene second dialogue on Africa

In a concerted effort to strengthen ties and collaborate on development initiatives in Africa, the second round of the India-US Dialogue on Africa commenced in Washington DC, the Ministry of External Affairs said in an official statement on Tuesday.

The dialogue, spanning over May 14-15, saw high-level participation from both sides, with the Indian delegation jointly led by Puneet R. Kundal, AS (E&SA), and Sevala N. Mude, AS (C&WA), while the US side was spearheaded by Mary Catherine Phee, Assistant Secretary of State for African Affairs.

The primary objective of the India-US dialogue on Africa is to facilitate the exchange of ideas and perspectives, with a focus on developing institutional, technical, and bilateral synergies to effectively collaborate on developmental projects and programs in Africa. By leveraging the respective strengths of India and the United States, the dialogue aims to identify key areas of cooperation in alignment with African priorities.

"The India-US dialogue on Africa aims to share ideas and perspectives and explore ways to develop institutional, technical and bilateral synergies to work together in Africa.

It also targets identification of developmental projects and programs of cooperation in Africa, leveraging the strengths of India and the US, in accordance with African priorities," the ministry said in a statement. Notably, this dialogue marks a significant milestone as the first such engagement between India and the US fol-



lowing the inclusion of the African Union as a permanent member of the G20 during India's presidency of the G20. This recognition underscores the growing importance of Africa on the global stage and highlights the commitment of both India and the US to engage meaningfully with the

continent. The United States and India have partnered on development projects in Africa in the areas of education, energy, agriculture, and health. One example of this cooperation is the Feed the Future India Africa Innovation Transfer Platform, which partners with Technoserve to share

China fully allows visa-free entry of foreign tourist groups via cruise ships



China on Wednesday enforced a policy allowing visa-free entry of foreign tourist groups aboard cruise ships via all cruise ship ports along the country's coastline.

Tourist groups each consisting of two foreigners or more, and organized or received by Chinese travel agencies, can enter China visa free on board cruise ships via the cruise ports in 13 Chinese cities, including Shanghai, Tianjin, Guangzhou, Sanya, and others, according to the National Immigration Administration (NIA). The tourists can stay in China for no longer than 15 days. While in China, they can visit coastal provinces, municipalities and autonomous regions as well as Beijing, according to an NIA statement. Additionally, the NIA announced that seven cruise ports, namely Dalian, Lianyungang, Wenzhou, Zhoushan, Guangzhou, Shenzhen, and Beihai, have been designated as visa-free transit ports for nationals from 54 countries. This move facilitates the transit and departure of foreign travelers from these ports via cruise ships under China's visa-free transit policy, the statement noted.

Biden increases tariffs on imports of electric vehicles, other goods from China

US President Joe Biden has directed his Trade Representative to increase tariffs on USD 18 billion of imports from China, including semiconductors, solar cells, batteries, and critical minerals to 'protect' American workers and businesses, the White House said in a statement on Tuesday.

The White House said that the decision has come in response to China's 'unfair trade practices' and to counteract the resulting harms.

"China's unfair trade practices concerning technology transfer, intellectual property, and innovation are threatening American businesses and workers. China is also flooding global markets with artificially low-priced exports. In response to China's unfair



trade practices and to counteract the resulting harms, today, President Biden is directing his Trade Representative to increase tariffs under Section 301 of the Trade Act of 1974 on USD 18 billion of imports from China to protect American workers and businesses," the White House statement read. The statement on hiked tariffs on imports from China

also noted that the Chinese government has used unfair and non-market practices for too long now. "China's forced technology transfers and intellectual property theft have contributed to its control of 70, 80, and even 90 percent of global production for the critical inputs necessary for our technologies, infrastructure, energy.

Experts developing immune-enhancing therapies to treat TB

Experts are developing revolutionary immune-enhancing medicines known as host-directed therapies, which employ the body's immune system to target TB, to tackle even drug-resistant strains of the illness.

Associate Professor Susanna Brighenti, Centre for Infectious Medicine (CIM), ANA Futura at the Karolinska Institutet, Stockholm, Sweden, will give a presentation at this year's ESCMID Global Congress (formerly ECCMID) in Barcelona.

The reported global number of people newly diagnosed with TB was 7.5 million in 2022, causing an estimated 1.3 million deaths. An estimated 410 000 cases and 160 000 deaths were due to multidrug-resistant TB (MDR-TB).

"Mycobacterium tuberculosis (Mtb) have evolved a remarkable ability to manipulate the human immune response and undermine antimicrobial effector functions in host immune cells," explains Assoc Professor Brighenti. "While some new antimicrobial therapies are coming



through, treatment with antibiotics remains an intensive and long process even for drug-susceptible forms of the disease. Importantly, mutations conferring antibiotic resistance are intrinsic properties of mycobacteria that effectively develop resistance to old as well as new groups of antibiotics, accentuating the need for adjunct treatments. Thus, new treatments

are going to be absolutely vital in the battle against TB."

Host-directed therapies (HDT) aim to strengthen the body's immune responses and represent an underexplored opportunity to improve treatment of TB, particularly MDR-TB. HDT are designed to target several immune pathways in infected cells to restore or induce anti-

microbial functions instead of inhibiting bacterial growth directly. This may involve enhanced production of immune peptides or toxic molecules that contribute to bacterial killing, but it could also include rebalancing of inflammatory responses. Assoc Professor Brighenti will explain how her research collaboration has generated a platform for immune reconstitution in TB, using small molecule compounds including histone deacetylase (HDAC) inhibitors.

"These drugs can regulate transcription of genes in cells such as those in the immune system, and thus enhance the expression of proteins associated with the antibacterial host defence. We have identified several HDAC inhibitors that reduce Mtb growth inside immune cells by some 50-75%, even in the absence of antibiotics," she explains. "That may not sound so impressive, but these immunomodulatory compounds could work well as a complement to standard therapy and exert additive or synergistic effects together with the antibiotics. This would

provide the possibility to reduce the dose and treatment length required with antibiotics to improve patient outcomes." In this way, it is conceivable that the effect of existing antibiotics could be guarded by add-on therapies that restore protective immunity and limit excess inflammation and/or immunosuppression in patients with TB. Standard anti-TB treatment involves daily administration of 4-9 antibiotics, but instead of adding yet another antimicrobial drug to the regimen, an immune-enhancing compound could promote clinical recovery of patients with severe forms of TB and poor prognosis, especially MDR-TB.

Assoc Prof Brighenti says "Implementation of immunotherapy as a complement to standard therapy has revolutionised the treatment of cancer, autoimmunity, and asthma/allergy. Similarly, our research on immune enhancement as a complement to antibiotics may become a game-changing treatment option for patients with TB that has the potential to impact clinical management and prevent

spread of TB infections and drug resistance in this pivotal moment in our history when antimicrobial resistance constitutes a serious threat to human health."

She adds, "Short-term, approved and already available 'off-the-shelf' therapeutics would represent an initial logical step to implement HDTs of patients with TB. This could include for example, HDTs based on glucocorticoid treatment or cytokine neutralisation (eg. anti-IL-6, anti-1b) to reduce inflammation, while metformin, or non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs may also promote or rewire the immune response.

"Long-term, more precise immunomodulatory interventions in TB such as local administration of specific HDAC inhibitors, can be tested in clinical trials with the aim to customise therapy for patients with MDR-TB. Today, several HDAC inhibitors are FDA-approved for different diseases - for example, Vorinostat, Belinostat, and Panobinostat for different cancers, Phenylbutyrate for urea cycle disorders.

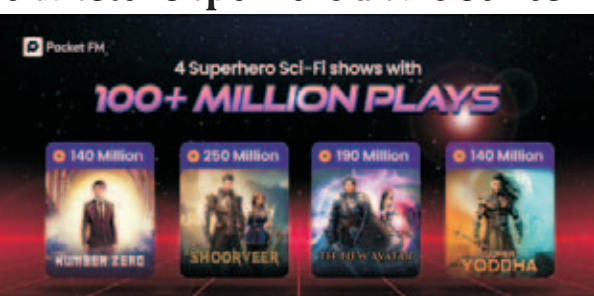

Sunrisers look to seal playoff berth against GT



AGENCY HYDERABAD: Masters of their own fate right now despite being erratic, Sunrisers Hyderabad will hope their destructive batting line-up delivers when they take on Gujarat Titans in pursuit of a playoffs berth in the Indian Premier League here on Thursday.

Another win will be enough for Sunrisers to seal a playoff berth as they need only one point to ensure qualification.

But the Pat Cummins-led side will also want to challenge for the top two spots, which is a possibility considering they have one more game after this match and a healthy net run rate of +0.406.

SRH have 14 points from 12 matches and can reach a maximum of 18 points, which may be enough to ensure a top-two finish if other results go their way.

Not only are the Sunrisers players well-rested ahead of the clash against GT as they got a week off, their morale will also be sky high after nothing yet another record-breaking win against Lucknow Super Giants on May 8.

If the bowlers did a commendable job to restrict LSG to a blow-par score, the opening duo of Travis Head and Abhishek Sharma made a mockery of the hosts by chasing down 166 in just 9.4 overs to notch a 10-wicket win at home.

SRH have made a habit of securing unbelievable victories throughout the season but they have also suffered sizeable defeats, including against GT (by 7 wickets) earlier in the competition.

The boom or bust approach by the batters has either done exceedingly well or has simply let the side down, including three times in the last five games, where SRH lost to RCB (by 35 runs), CSK (by 78 runs) and MI (by 7 wickets).

The 2016 champions would hope Head and Sharma deliver as SRH are heavily dependent on the explosive starts provided by the duo.

They will also want to do a

better job at re-building their innings, especially while chasing. The likes of Nitish Reddy, Heinrich Klassen and Abdul Samad need to manage that better.

On the other hand, the Titans, who have only five wins from 13 games and are on 11 points, are out of the reckoning and will look to end their forgettable campaign on a high.

With former skipper Hardik Pandya moving to

Mumbai Indians this season, GT struggled to find a replacement for the all-rounder who was key to their title-winning run in 2022 and runners-up finish last year.

The absence of pacer Mohammed Shami, who was ruled out of the tournament due to injury, has also hurt them.

GT's bowling hasn't been as effective this season, with inconsistent pacers and leaky spinners.

Their last match against Kolkata Knight Riders was a washout but the bowlers showed promise by taking three wickets in the first three overs against CSK.

Mohit Sharma's variations and knuckle balls were particularly effective, and Rashid Khan's clever bowling was noticeable. They'll hope for an encore.

In the batting department, much will depend on skipper Shubman Gill and B Sai Sudharsan, who revelled in the role of an opener. David Miller has looked off-colour this season and his big hits would be crucial to ensure that the side signs off on a positive note.

Neeraj started off the final with a throw of 82 m. However, DP took the lead with a throw of 82.06 m in his first attempt.

The second attempt of the Olympic gold medalist turned out to be a foul, though he bounced back well with 81.29 m throw in the third attempt. DP Manu still held the lead, though.

Neeraj took the lead in his fourth attempt, throwing at a distance of 82.27 m. Manu could not gain back his lead as he threw 81.47 m on the fourth attempt and fouled on the next two attempts. Neeraj chose not to attempt his last two throws

and bagged the top prize. Jena, however, was not even in contention for the podium spot during all this while, recording a foul and a throw of 75.49 m, then two more fouls and then throws of 73.79 m and 75.25 m respectively, to end an unspectacular night for himself.

Uttam started with a throw of 75.55 m and attained the podium position at number three after the fifth round.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated Atal Bihari Vajpayee Sewri-Nhava Sheva Atal Setu in January. It is like a game-changer for Mumbai's transportation network. Now, 'Pushpa 2' actor Rashmika Mandanna has talked about it and said that "India is not stopping anywhere."
