- The BJP, which was aiming for 370 seats, and set the NDA a target of 400-plus, appears to be running way behind, let down by Uttar Pradesh, which sends a whopping 80 lawmakers to the Lok Sabha. Around 5 pm, the BJP is ahead on 241 seats, the NDA on 296. The INDIA bloc is ahead on 228 seats, the Congress on
- The BJP applecart appears to have been up-set by the heartland state of Uttar Pradesh. which has pushed the INDIA bloc -- Samajwadi Party and the Congress -- ahead in 44 of 80 seats at 7 pm. The BJP is leading on 32. The BJP had swept Uttar Pradesh in 2014 and held of its ground in 2019. This time most exit polls had predicted an edge for the party.
- Two of the other battleground states have also not gone the BJP's way. In Bengal, the party's big hope, it could fare worse than 2019, leading in only 11 seats at 3 pm. Mamata Banerjee's Trinamool Congress appears to have recovered much of the lost ground and is ahead in 31
- Maharashtra appears to have made its disapproval clear of the political manoeuvrings in Shiv Sena and the Nationalist Congress Party. The Uddhav Thackeray faction is ahead on 11 seats to Shinde Sena's 5. The Ajit Pawar faction of NCP is ahead on just one seat and his uncle Sharad Pawar on 7. The BJP and the Congress
- are neck on neck with 12 and 11 seats. The BJP's losses, as expected, are being offset from Odisha, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and to an extent, Telangana.
- In Andhra Pradesh. Chandrababu Naidu is heading for a landslide victory, with a clear lead cies. Sources said the oath ceremony will be on June 9. In Odisha. the BJP is looking forward to ending the 25year run of Naveen Patnaik's Biju Janata
- The campaign has been intense and drawn out, and the mood of the voters difficult to read in this election. Three exit polls have predicted a 400plus score for the BJPled NDA. The rest differ only in the margin of the NDA victory -- con-clusions the Opposition has trashed. Exit polls have always had mixed success in the country.
- As with every election, the BJP unleashed its formidable election machinery early, and launched a star-studded campaign that focussed on development, economy and a vision for the 100-year anniversary of Inde-pendence. Backing it up were the promises met -- the scrapping of Article 370 and the construction of the Ayodhya Ram temple.
- The big difference was the Opposition's offensive against the ruling coalition, a long way from the lack of cohesiveness of 2019. While the beginning was shaky and in parts, patchy -- like the Congress versus Trinamool contest in Bengal and Congress versus AAP in Punjab the narrative on a change in constitution and scrapping of reservation made an im-

Staying way behind the magic figure of 272 on its own, Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led BJP struggled to cross 250 in the Lok Sabha elections

held in seven phases. Even as the BJP-led NDA looks comfortable at 290 to form the next government, the enthusiasm in the BJP camp has dampened. The lower than expected performance in three key states of UP, Maharashtra and West Bengal has dented BJP's prospects to reach 272-mark on its own. In Haryana the saffron party managed to get five seats including Gurugram, Faridabad, Kurukshetra, Bhiwani-Mahendragarh and Karnal whereas Congress grabbed Sirsa, Rohtak, Ambala, Sonipat and Hisar. The former CM, Manohar Lal has registered a thumping victory by a margin of more than two lakh votes in Karnal. The party failed to open its account in Punjab, where Congress emerged as biggest winner with seven seats in its pocket. AAP won three and SAD managed only Bathinda seat. Two seats won by independents. BJP made a clean sweep in Himachal Pradesh, where all four Lok Sabha seats went in its account.

NDA seems to be losing 32 seats in politically crucial Uttar Pradesh, whereas Samajwadi Party led INDI alliance has turned the table and is poised to register a major gain.

According to the Election Commission data, BJP, which had won 62 out of 80 seats in 2019 on its own in 2019 polls, has so far won 3 seats and is leading on 31 seats. SP, which was limited to only five seats in 2019 polls, has one seat and is leading



Rahul Gandhi wins Wayanad, Rae Bareli by huge margins

NEW DELHI: Amid an impressive show of the opposition INDIA bloc in the Lok Sabha elections. Congress leader Rahul Gandhi registered a massive win in Kerala's Wayanad and is closing in on another landslide victory in Uttar Pradesh's Rae

Rahul won Wayanad for the second time by a margin of 3,64,422 votes, defeating CPI's Annie Raja and BJP state president K. Surendran.

In 2014, Rahul's winning margin was more than four lakh votes. He had bagged a total of 706,367 votes while CPI's P. P. Suneer secured 274.597 votes.

In Rae Bareli, as per the latest data from closest rival BJP's Dinesh Pratap Singh by more than 3.8 lakh votes. If the trend continues, Rahul will surpass his mother Sonia Gandhi's winning margin of 1.67 lakh votes from the constituency in 2019.

BJP sweeps LS & Assembly polls in Odisha

BHUBANESWAR: Ruling Biju Janata Dal (BJD) under the leadership of Naveen Patnaik which ruled Odisha consecutively for fifth term, suffered a major jolt in the election, as Opposition BJP riding on Modi wave, is all set to form the double engine government in the state. The BJP also swept the Lok Sabha election, as its candidates are leading with a very comfortable and huge margin in 19 of the 21 Lok Sabha

The ruling BJD which had won 12 Lok Sabha seats in the 2019 election, is leading in only Jajpur(SC) Lok Sabha seat where the sitting MP Sethy is leading over her rival candidate Rabindra Behera by margin of only 4525 votes. On the other hand, Congress sitting MP Saptagiri Ulka is all set to retain the Koraput Lok Sabha seat, as he is leading with a huge margin of 1,28,517 votes over his rival BJD can-

PM Modi wins from Varanasi by over 1.52 lakh votes

LUCKNOW: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday won the Varanasi Lok Sabha seat for the third time in a row after defeating his nearest rival Ajay Rai of Congress by a margin of more than 1.52 lakh votes.

According to the data of the Election Commission while Modi received 6,12,970 votes, about 4,60,457 votes were polled in favour of Congress nominee Ajay Rai. Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) candidate Ather Jamal Lari was placed in third place with only 33,766 votes.

This is for the third time the Prime Minister had won the seat since 2014, when he contested for the first time.

However, this time the margin of votes has reduced as compared to the 2019 Lok Sabha election when he won by more than 4.79 lakh votes.

Manish Tewari wins from Chandigarh

CHANDIGARH: Congress party's Manish Tewari won the Chandigarh Lok Sabha seat, defeating BJP's Sanjay Tandon, according to the Election Commission website.

Tewari, the former Union minister, won by a margin of 2,504 votes, the EC portal showed. The Congress fought the Chandigarh Lok Sabha seat in an alliance with

the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP). Counting of votes for the Ione Chandigarh seat began at 8 am amid tight security arrangements.

GANDHINAGAR: Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader and Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Tuesday won the Gandhinagar Lok Sabha seat of Gujarat by defeating his nearest Congress rival Sonal Patel by a staggering margin of more than 7.44 lakh votes. announced the Election Commission

As per the result declared by the ECI after counting of votes ended for the prestigious seat, Shah got 10,10,972 votes, while Patel received 2,66,256 lakh votes. The BJP stalwart has won from the constituency for a second consecutive time. In the 2019 elections, Shah won the seat by a margin of more than 5.57 lakh votes.

NOTA creates record in MP's Indore seat

NEW DELHI: NOTA created a record with 2.18 lakh voters in Madhya Pradesh's Indore opting for the 'none of the above' option in the Lok Sabha elections, counting for which is underway on Tuesday.

Of the total voters, 14.01 per cent opted for 'None of the Above', which was introduced in 2013 following a Supreme Court order. In the 2019 parliamentary polls, voters in Bihar's Gopalganj had created a record with 51,660 of them, or five per cent, opting for the NOTA option, which is placed as the last option on the electronic voting machine.

KL Sharma defeats Smriti Irani from Amethi by 1.67 lakh votes



AMETHI (UP): Congress candidate Kishori Lal Sharma emerged as a giant killer by defeating Union minister and BJP candidate Smriti Irani by a margin of over 1.67 votes from Amethi, the bastion of the Nehru-Gandhi family in Uttar Pradesh, on Tuesday. According to the Election Commission, Irani bagged 3,72,032 votes, while Sharma polled 5,39,228 votes The BSP candidate got 34,534 votes. Reacting to his win, Sharma expressed his gratitude to the people of Amethi and the Congress party, saying the 18th Lok Sabha election in Amethi will be the biggest example of a strong and empowered democratic country

Anurag Thakur wins Hamirpur seat for fifth time

While Thakur got 6,07,068 votes, Satpal Raizada got 4,24,711 votes. All other ten candidates who were in the field from this seat security lost their deposits.

A massive welcome was accorded to Thakur when his victory was announced.

Party workers danced in joy and took Thakur on their shoulders and sang songs amid dancing.
Thakur thanked the

Sher Singh Ghubaya wins from Ferozepur LS seat

Congress candidate Singh Ghubaya from Ferozepur has been declared as the winner of Ferozepur, with 3242 votes. He secured 266626 votes defeating the next AAP candidate Jagdeep Singh Kaka Brar, who got 263384

The other two candidates who too had a tough fight – Rana Gurmit Singh Sodhi (BJP) who got 255097, Nardev Singh Bobby Mann (SAD) polled 253645.

The total voters polled in Ferozepur were 1119167 (67.02%) – the second highest in Punjab on June 1. It was a 4-cornered contest among the four major political parties -AAP, Congress, SAD and BJP.

Earlier, Congress had played the card of the Rai Sikh community by fielding Sher Singh Ghubaya, who started his career as SAD MLA from Jalalabad in 1997 and after Zora Singh Mann's death; he won in 2009 and 2014. But for the third time, he lost in 2019 from the Con-



gress seat. Earlier, this seat was the master seat of SAD and the last was held by Sukhbir Singh Badal who defeated Sher Singh Ghubaya in the 2014 elections with a difference of 1,98,850 votes.

The voting trend shows that the voting was not for the party but for the candidates' faces or the voters might have in mind that AAP already tried for two years, rejecting the SAD who broke the alliance with the BJP, The BJP

candidate was a Congress leader and it was his first election in the change-over party and INDI block factor has worked as is also evident from the overall trend in its favour.

Despite AAP having 8 MLAs in the Ferozepur Lok Sabha constituency barring Abohar, AAP could not retain this seat but has given a tough fight, along with the other three parties SAD and BJP.

Rana Sodhi, 4-time MLA in 2002, 2007, 2012 and 2017 and one-time Sports Minister and Chief Whip of the CLP in Puniab, switched over to BJP but could not win, giving an unexpected fight to other can-

But he has given a threatening fight, despite switching over the party. No doubt, there was a call from the farmers' community who are camping at the Shambhu border to cast votes other than the BJP but even that got 255097 votes.



INDI Alliance makes comeback in several Hindi heartland states

NEW DELHI, JUNE 4

The INDIA alliance made a major comeback in several politically-crucial Hindi heartland states with the latest trend in counting of votes on Tuesday showing it ahead in 42 seats out of 80 in Uttar Pradesh and registering steady headway in Rajasthan, Bihar, Haryana and Jharkhand. However, Prime Minister Narendra Modi's BJP-led alliance is set to retain power for a third consecutive term but not with an overwhelming majority as predicted by various exit polls.

The most unexpected performance put up by the INDIA (Indian National Developmental Inclusive Alliance) was in politicallycrucial Uttar Pradesh where Samajwadi Party was marching ahead in 35 seats and Congress in seven,

according to the trends.

The BJP is leading in 34 seats, its ally Rashtriya Lok Dal in two constituencies and Apna Dal (Soneylal) and Aazad Samaj Party (Kanshi Ram) in one each.

The opposition bloc's performance in Uttar Pradesh is being seen as a big surprise for the BJP that had almost swept the polls in 2014 with a

stunning performance coming out victorious in 71 seats and held its ground in 2019 by winning 62.

In 2019, the Samajwadi

Party won in five seats, Congress in one and Bahujan Samaj Party in 10. The Indian alliance also

made significant gains in Rajasthan, Haryana, Bihar and Jharkhand but could not

spring a surprise in Madhya Pradesh, Delhi, Uttarakhand and Chhattisgarh.

In Rajasthan, BJP was ahead in 14, while Congress was leading in eight while CPI(M), Rashtriya Loktantrik Party and Bharat Adivasi Party were ahead in one seat each. The BJP had won all the 25 seats in the 2019 polls.

The INDIA alliance also

Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) being ahead in four seats, Congress in two seats, CPI(ML) in two seats.

Editorial Centrism's revival

his year will be crucial for the trajectory of democracy globally. India, the world's largest democracy, will choose its government today. The United States of America, the oldest democracy, will elect its president in a few months. Both democracies operate differently; but they have both witnessed the rise of right-wing populism/authoritarianism.

There are four probable reasons behind the rise of right-wing politics and the corresponding backsliding of Centrism. First, neoliberal philosophers and economists like Robert Nozick and Milton Friedman have argued that the role of capital is to create a level playing field for the people. What it has created though are huge inequalities — economic and social. Second. Centrist parties like the Congress in India have failed to walk the talk when it comes to resolving inequality and, hence, failed to capture the public imagination. Third, the neglect of micro factors, such as identity, and the overreliance on the liberal political discourse and its universal appeal have also contributed to the rightward shift. In India, for instance, Dalits and Adivasis have shifted their allegiance towards the RSS-BJP in recent years despite the ideological contradictions between these communities and Hindutya, Finally, emotion has been meticulously weaponised by right-wing forces, checkmating Left liberals who perceive politics as the domain of rationality and science.

The upsurge of right-wing conservative parties is a reflection of the triumph of deep-rooted resentment. Their success lies in their ability to create the binary of 'us' and 'them'. This category of 'us' is porous and participatory, in the sense that it is open to all those who think they have been deprived in any form — socially, politically, culturally or materially

How should the Centre-Left revive itself? Left-Centrist forces need to concentrate on such aspects as culture, civilisation, and history in order to bring out the inclusive nature of social processes. The Right's exclusionary way of interpreting history and defining culture can be countered with an inclusive reading of history and culture.

Centrism also needs to understand the role of emotion in politics. The success of right-wing populism is mainly due to the efficient exploitation of emotion as a political strategy. In contrast, the Centre-Left has maintained its distance from the emotive dimensions of politics, still relying on reason and logic to organise its politics. By doing so, it has disconnected itself from the marginalised social groups that have forged an alliance with the political Right.

Biden to not attend Ukraine peace summit

S Vice President Kamala Harris will travel to Switzerland next week to participate in a summit aimed at helping chart a path toward peace in Ukraine, the White House said.

Vice President Harris will be accompanied by US National Security Advisor, Jake Sullivan to the Summit on Peace in Ukraine set for June 15-16 in Lucerne, Switzerland.

US President Joe Biden will skip the two-day summit as he is due to be at a starstudded fundraising event for his 2024 reelection campaign in Los Angeles. Biden, who Ukraine President Vladamir Zelenskyy invited will be participating, according to the Hollywood Reporter at the fundraiser event in which host Jimmy Kimmel will moderate a conversation between Biden and former President Barack Obama. It will feature special guests George Clooney and Julia

At the peace conference, they will underscore the Biden-Harris administration's $commitment \ to \ supporting \ Ukraine's \ effort$ to secure a just and lasting peace based on Ukraine's sovereignty and territorial integrity and the principles of the UN Charter, Kir-

The spokesperson said that the war could end tomorrow "if Russian President Vladamir. Putin would simply withdraw his forces from Ukraine. "In the meantime, we will continue, and our allies and partners will continue, to support the people of Ukraine as they fight every day to defend



themselves against this aggression," Kirby said. At a press conference in Brussels last week, Zelenskky had said that US President Biden's absence "would only be met by an applause by Putin - a personal, standing ap-

In response to reporters' queries at the White House gaggle on Monday, Kirby said Biden has been a staunch supporter of the peace deal. "The United States has actively participated in every single one of the previous Ukraine peace summits. Every single one. And as I said earlier, we have been the strongest, most staunch supporter of this peace deal that President Zelenskyy put forward."The Kremlin has maintained that any talks around securing peace in Ukraine should involve Russia, which has not been invited to the summit. Zelenskyy who was in Singapore to attend the Shangi-La Dialogue told the security conference that China was

conference by pressuring leaders of other countries not to attend.

These attempts to disrupt the summit are systematic and are unprecedentedly large in scale, which once again confirms that we are doing everything right," Ukrainian Foreign Minister Dmytro Kuleba said.

Zelenskyy also said that Kviv has confirmation from 106 countries regarding participation in the summit.

Meanwhile, Russian Ambassador to London Andrey Kelin said in an interview with Turkey's TRT World television that Russia is ready for talks but doesn't see any such willingness in Ukraine, reported Russian state media TASS.

"We were prepared a year ago. We are prepared right now," he said. "The problem is that Ukraine has publicly prohibited this type of negotiations by law, by decree. We do

On Thursday, Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov said China could arrange a Russia-Ukraine peace conference.

In an interview with RIA news agency, Lavrov said, ""We share (China's) position that the root causes of the conflict need to be addressed in the first place and legal interests of all parties need to be protected, with subsequent agreements based on the principle of equal and indivisible security.

China, has however said it will not attend the Switzerland summit as there is an "apparent gap between the meeting's arrangement and what China stands for as well as the universal expectation in the international community.

Sheinbaum (61) received nearly 58 per cent of the vote, according to preliminary results from the Mexican electoral office.

Jorge Alvarez Maynez of the Citizens' Movement has received votes between $9.9\,\%$ and 10.8 per cent. According to the quick count results, participation in Mexico's Pres idential election was between 58.9 per cent and 61.7 per cent of nearly 100 million eligible voters, according to CNN report.

After expressing gratitude to the voters for their support, Sheinbaum called it a historical moment. Sheinbaum stated, "For the



Indian embassy warns against 'fake job rackets' targeting youth in Myanmar

The Indian Embassy in Myanmar has warned its citizens to stay away from 'fake job rackets' targeting youth. An advisory issued by the Indian Embassy stated that an increase in incidents has been recorded and in view of the same it reminds its people to follow their advice and not accept any job offers without first checking with the Embassy

"There has been an increase in the incidents of Indian nationals falling victim to the international crime syndicates active in the Myawaddy region on the Myanmar-Thailand border. We would re-emphasize the importance of adhering to our advisories on the subject for not taking any such job offers without consulting the respective Indian Embassies, the Indian Embassy in Myanmar said in a press release on Monday.

The release further states, that this advisory is being issued in continuation of the Embassy's advisories on the above subject, issued on 5th July 2022, 14 October 2022, 28th March 2023 and 13th September 2023.

Charanjit Singh Channi wins in Jalandhar by 1.76 lakh votes

JALANDHAR: Former Punjab Chief Minister and Congress candidate Charanjit Singh Channi (60), who lost both the seats he contested in the February 2022 Assembly elections, scripted victory from the Jalandhar (reserved) Lok Sabha constituency on Saturday after defeating his nearest rival by 1,75,993 votes in a four-way battle involving three turncoats from the major political

Charanjit Singh Channi was leading by a comfortable margin in the initial rounds against his nearest rival and sitting MP Sushil Rinku of the BJP, who switched sides twice in a year

Pawan Kumar Tinu of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and Mohinder Singh Kaypee of the Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) were among the candidates in the fray, both having switched loyalties in the runup to the polls. Santokh Singh Chaudhary of the Congress won from Jalandhar in 2019, but in the May 2023 by-elections necessitated by his sudden demise, his wife Karamjit Kaur was defeated by Congress MLAturned-AAP candidate Rinku, who won by a margin of 58,691 votes

At that time, AAP wrested the Jalandhar seat from the Congress in the high-stake bypoll, ending the party's unbeaten run in the Dalitstrongholdsince 1999.

This time, the Congress reposed faith in three-time legislator Charaniit Singh Channi, the state's first Dalit Chief Minister, to woo the Dalit votes that constitute 32 per cent population in the state, the country's largest.

Charanjit Singh Channi, a former handball player

who led the party in the 2022 Assembly polls, entered politics at the age of 20. He replaced Amarinder Singh as the Chief Minister on September 19, 2021, as a stopgap arrangement before the state went to the polls


