BJP will bring out 'White Paper' on Jharkhand's demography to protect tribal lands, rights: Shah

RANCHI: Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Saturday said rampant infiltration has led to the shrinking of the tribal population in Jharkhand and added that if the BJP forms the next government in the state, it will release a 'White Paper on demography to protect tribal lands and rights. Shah expressed confidence in the BJP forming a government in Jharkhand, noting that the party won in 52 of 81 assembly segments in the 2024 Lok Sabha polls. Addressing party workers at Prabhat Tara Ground during the BJP's extended executive committee meeting, he said, "After forming a government in Jharkhand, we will bring out a 'White Paper' on demography to protect tribal people, their lands, reservation, and rights.

Without naming Hemant Soren, he accused Jharkhand's tribal Chief Minister of being involved in "Love Jihad" and "Land Jihad" due to his "vote bank and appeasement policy," which Shah claimed

Bangladesh on Friday announced the imposition of a curfew and the deployment of military forces amid deadly unrest that has spread throughout the country and claimed the lives of over 100 people. Protesting students are demanding that the Sheikh Hasina-led government should scrap a controversial job quota system

INDIAN STUDENTS RETURN The External Affairs Ministry on Saturday said that 778 Indian students have returned via various land ports, with an additional 200 students using regular flight services through Dhaka and Chittagong airports. The Indian High Commission is maintaining contact with over 4000 students remaining in Bangladesh, offering essential support. Assistance has also been extended to students from Nepal and Bhutan upon their request to cross into India.

"In coordination with the local authorities, measures are being taken by the High Commission and the Assistant High Commissions to facilitate safe travel to the border crossing points along the India-Bangladesh International Border. MEA is also coordinating with civil aviation, immigration, land ports and BSF authorities to ensure a smooth passage for our citi-

zens," the MEA said in a statement. External affairs minister S Jais hankar in a post on social media site X said he 'appreciates the concern for families and well wishers of Indian nationals in Bangladesh'



"Appreciate the concern of families and well wishers of Indian nationals in Bangladesh. MEA is fully focused on ensuring their safety and well being. The current situation is as

below," Jaishankar said, resharing the ministry's update on the situation concerning Indian students in Bangladesh. Indian Students persuing education in Bangladesh enter India through Akhaura Border in Agartala.

Meanwhile, Eastern Railway CPRO Kaushik Mitra said that several trains including Kolkata-Dhaka Maitree Express, and Bandhan Express have been cancelled. Bangladesh po-

lice fired live rounds at protesters in the capital Dhaka on Saturday. At least one person was wounded among thousands present in the residential neighbourhood of Rampura for the demonstration, held in defiance of a government curfew imposed to con-tain growing civil unrest.

The CBI on Saturday arrested one of the masterminds, B.Tech graduate from NIT-Jamshedpur, in the NEET-UG paper leak case and two MBBS students who allegedly acted as "solvers", officials said.

With the fresh arrests, the total number of people held so far by the agency in six cases related to the alleged irregularities has now reached 21, they said.

The two MBBS students arrested on Saturday are from a medical school in Bharatpur, Rajasthan.

Second-year MBBS student Kumar Mangalam Bishnoi and first-year stu-dent Deepender Sharma were present in Hazaribagh on May 5, the date of NEET-UG examination, and were allegedly acting as "solvers" for the paper stolen by Pankaj Kumar, an engineer, who was arrested earlier, they said.

They said Sashikant Paswan, alias Sashi, alias Pasu, a B.Tech (Electrical) pass-out from the National Institute of Technology, Jamshedpur, was acting in tandem with Kumar and Rockey, who was also arrested earlier.

Punjab police busts trans-border narco syndicate; big fish among three drug smugglers held

CHARANJIT ARORA AMRITSAR, JULY 20:

Striking a major blow to the trans-border narcotic smuggling amidst the ongoing war against drugs waged on the directions of Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann, Amritsar Commissionerate Police has apprehended three drug smugglers including a big fish identified as Gurbax alias Lala of Chheharta and seized 1 Kg Ice (Methamphetamine), 2.45 Kg Heroin and 520 grams pseudoephedrine— a precursor chemical from their possession, said



that accused Lala used to earn a commission of Rs 50,000 per consignment.

Pertinently, Punjab Po-

teams are on manhunt to nab the kingpin of this narco-syndicate.

The development came after meticulous investigations of backward and forward linkages carried out by the Amritsar Commissionerate Police into the arrest of a local drug peddler Daljit Kaur from Kot Khalsa area on June 16, 2024, who was arrested with 50 grams heroin. The latter's arrest further led to the arrest of her accomplice drug peddler Arshdeep from Chheharta

He said that accused Gurbax alias Lala, who has been facing cases pertaining to murder, Arms Act and NDPS act, was also actively involved in Amritsar Central Jail's 'Fenka' activity. Multiple bidis rolled into packs were also recovered from his possession by the Police teams, he said, while adding that further investigations are on. A case FIR no. 115 dated 16/6/24 had been registered under section 21-B of the NDPS act at Police Station Islamabad.

Significant step towards Waste Management in Haryana: Two Waste-to-Charcoal Plants to be set up in the State Green Coal Plants to be Set Up in Gurugram and Faridabad, Costing Rs. 500 Crore Each

Taking a major step towards waste management in Haryana, waste-tocharcoal plants, also known as green coal plants, will be established in the state with the support of the central government. This project will be the first of its kind green initiative and will be set up in Faridabad and Gurugram

Today, an MoU was signed be-tween NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited (NVVNL), a wholly-owned subsidiary of NTPC Limited, and the Municipal Corporations of Gurugram and Faridabad in the presence of Union Minister, Sh. Manohar Lal, Chief Minister, Sh. Nayab Singh Saini, and Minister of State for Urban Local Bodies, Sh. Subhash Sudha.

The MoU was signed by Smt. A.Mona Sreenivas, Čommissioner, Municipal Corporation Faridabad, Sh. Narhari Singh Banger, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation Gurugram, and Smt. Renu Narang, CEO of NVVNL.

Speaking on this occasion, Chief Minister, Sh. Nayab Singh Saini said that today is a very important day for Haryana as an MoU has been signed for setting up plants to produce green charcoal. According to the agree-ment, NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited (NVVNL), a fully-owned sub-



sidiary of NTPC Limited, will establish waste-to-charcoal plants in Gurugram and Faridabad under the Atmanirbhar Bharat campaign of the Government of India. he said.

Green Coal Plants to be Set Up in Gurugram and Faridabad at a Cost of Rs.500 Crore Each

The Chief Minister said that green coal plants will be set up in Bandhwari, Gurugram, and Motuka, Faridabad, at a cost of around Rs. 500 crore each. These plants will convert 1500 tonnes of waste collected daily from Gurugram and Faridabad into charcoal. The Municipal Corporations of Gurugram and Faridabad will provide 20 acres of land each for these plants. NTPC will soon take possession of the land and start setting up the plants, which are expected to be completed in about 30 months. These plants will be based entirely on indigenous technology.

Gurugram and Faridabad to get relief from waste heaps

Sh. Nayab Singh Saini said that the establishment of these plants will significantly contribute to the realisation of Prime Minister, Sh. Narendra Modi's Swachh Bharat campaign, making Gurugram and Faridabad garbage-free. In the future, the cities will be free from waste heaps. He said that the waste-to-green coal plants in Gurugram and Faridabad will not only provide a permanent solution to the waste problem but will also increase energy production. This torrefied charcoal will be used in power generation plants, reducing the use of mineral coal. He stated that this effort will play a crucial role in significantly enhancing urban cleanliness and promoting environmental sustainability in Gur-ugram and Faridabad, said the Chief Minister.

Strengthening Waste Management with the setting up of Plants in Gurugram and Faridabad, Vikas Gupta

Earlier, Commissioner and Secretary, Urban Local Bodies Department, Sh. Vikas Gupta said that with the increasing urbanization, the generation of waste is also continuously rising, making waste disposal a major challenge in cities. To address this problem, we have initiated this step with NVVNL under the guidance of the Chief Minister. The setting up of these plants in Gurugram and Faridabad will strengthen waste management, he said.

These Plants will be the Largest in India, CEO Renu Narang CEO of NVVNL, Smt. Renu Narang

while providing detailed information about the waste-to-charcoal plants said that currently, NTPC is operating a plant in Varanasi that produces charcoal from 600 tonnes of waste daily. However, the two plants to be established in Haryana will be the largest in India, producing charcoal from 1500 tonnes of waste daily. After their success, this technology will be considered for implementation in other cities, she said.

This initiative aims to implement efficient waste management strategies, including better collection, recycling, and disposal methods. The partnership focuses on exchanging knowledge among stakeholders involved in solid waste management and empowering officials and professionals with expertise and tools to create a clean and healthy urban environment for local residents.

UP turbulence shows it's back to basics for the BJP

The reverberations in the Uttar Pradesh branch of the BJP are a stark reminder that regardless of the return to power in 2024 for a third successive term of the Narendra Modi government some things did change as the Lok Sabha poll numbers came in.

The ruling BJP may have emerged as the single largest party with more seats than the entire 28-party INDIA bloc put together, but it was forced to forge a coalition government. This calls for a reset to thinking in a cooperative alliance mould to face a new reality after 10 years of single party dominance and decisionmaking.

The Lok Sabha elections did not shock or surprise in throwing up results that were in line with the universal trend in the crucial universal polls year of 2024 in which the basic dissatisfaction of voters with the old order was apparent. This was witnessed in the European and British verdicts, too, that saw the right being ditched with change being the most decisive option.

The BJP bucked that trend to an extent but only with deep lessons to be learnt on what did not work this time, which were the harping on religion and the Ram temple, the stoking of communal divisiveness for votes and the seeking of a brute majority for bringing a promised big change even as there was too much emphasis on the hounding of Opposition leaders by Central investigating agencies.

With UP being the electoral key to ruling in New Delhi thanks to the numbers - 80 seats out of 543 the BJP may have to crack the whip to bring the house back in order after discontent turned into dissent with the deputy CM pushing for a change at the top while aiming the gun at Yogi Adityanath.

The time for a full reset of priorities is now and there is no better time than now to begin with the presentation of the Budget early next week through which the BJP can demonstrate that it is willing to go back to basics and look at overall development of the nation, switching back to "vikas" as the plank that brought them to power in 2014.

Not much may have taken place since June 4, 2024, to show that the BJP may have read the signs of the public mood of general disenchantment thoroughly enough, but July 23 might be a better date to mark a day of change as the guidelines to fiscal management and development are laid down. This is the time to show that all of India matters to the ruling dispensation.

India needs to battle to protect tech-vulnerable

ndia has over 800 million Internet users --and more than half of them live in villages. It is home to the world's second largest Internet user base, just behind China, a country with more than a billion netizens. Unsurprisingly, India's e-commerce sector has witnessed exponential growth in recent years. But the country's digital dreams could be scuppered by the long shadow of cyber criminals.

Last month, Krishna Dasgupta, a 72year-old resident of Chittaranjan Park, a South Delhi neighbourhood, lost Rs 83 lakhs after she was placed under "digital arrest" for over 12 hours. The story, widely reported in the media, spotlighted a tactic favoured by cyber criminals who pose as law enforcement officers. They used it to psychologically pressure the victim and make her believe that she was in the dock for money laundering. She was told she was under observation, must remain confined to her room and do exactly as she was instructed, without consulting anyone else.

What started with a phone call led to a series of intimidatory conversations that led to the elderly lady sharing details of her Aadhaar card and cleaning out her savings bank account. It was only after she spoke with her daughter and son-in-law the next day that she realised she had been preyed upon.

Eerily, just last week, I heard a similarly chilling story from a Delhi-based friend who had also been subjected to "digital custody" but luckily got timely advice which prevented monetary loss. In April this year, a 52year-old Bengaluru businessman was tricked into downloading a fraudulent mobile application on WhatsApp by cyber criminals who promised high-return investments. He was new to stock market trading. He lost Rs 5.2



crores. These are not isolated incidents. Cybercrime in varied forms has been steadily rising in India, as in many other countries, in recent years. Online scams got a huge boost during the Covid-19 pandemic when people were confined to their homes. Many Indians fell prey to cyber scamsters. According to the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB), India saw a rise of 24 per cent in cybercrimes registered in 2022 compared to 2021.

In May this year, a statement by the ministry of home affairs pointed out that the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP) had received many complaints regarding intimidation, blackmail, extortion and "digital arrests" by cyber criminals posing as police authorities, Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), Narcotics Department, Reserve Bank of India (RBI), Enforcement Directorate and other law enforcement agencies. The state-

ment revealed that fraudsters typically call a potential victim, insist that he or she has either sent or is the intended recipient of a parcel, which contains illegal goods, drugs, fake passports, other contraband items. Sometimes, they also claim that someone close to the victim has been found to be involved in a crime or an accident and is in their custody. "A demand for money is made to compromise the 'case'. In certain instances, unsuspecting victims are made to undergo 'digital arrest' and remain visually available over Skype or other video conferencing platform to the fraudsters, till their demands are met. The fraudsters are known to use studios modelled on police stations and government of-fices and wear uniforms to appear genuine," the statement noted. The Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C), under the MHA, which coordinates activities related to combating cybercrime, has blocked more than 1,000 Skype IDs involved in such activities, in collaboration with Microsoft, the statement added.

The MHA asked citizens to immediately report any suspected cybercrime to helpline number 1930 or www.cybercrime.gov.in for assistance.

Recently, the cybercrime unit also advised citizens to verify the authenticity of any suspicious e-notices they may get via email by cross-checking with the concerned government official and agency.

"In a disturbing development sweeping across India, cyber fraud is indiscriminately targeting individuals, from those with limited digital know-how in rural settings to the technologically adept in urban locales," notes a report by the National Association of Software and Service Companies (Nasscom) Foundation. It flags a study by a start-up incubated at IIT Kanpur which revealed a worrying trend -- from January 2020 to June 2023, financial scams have overwhelmingly dominated cybercrime in India, accounting for more than 75 per cent of incidents, with UPI and Internet banking frauds making up nearly half. "This research indicates that 77.41 per cent of cybercrimes involve online financial deceit, including debit/credit card fraud, business email compromise, and notably, UPI fraud, which constitutes 47.25 per cent of the cases.

Study shows birth outcome of freezing eggs as effective as regular IVF

S uccess rates of freezing eggs are comparable to those obtained by normal in vitro fertilisation (IVF) and are subject to the same variables of female age and embryo quality, according to a study.

When compared to other similar largescale research conducted on egg freezing in other countries, the findings of this 15-yearog study based on nearl 30 000 fm revealed an overall live birth rate of 26 per cent per embryo transfer, as per the study published in the peer-reviewed journal Reproductive Biomedicine Online. This varied depending on the age at which the eggs were frozen, with a lower rate in the over-35s and only 5 per cent in the over-40s. After transferring all embryos developed from thawed eggs, the total live birth rate was 34 per cent, which increased to 45 per cent in women who had frozen their eggs before the age of 36, according to the study.

The official dog shooter carried a sack to take the bodies of his victims away, leaving trails of blood on the streets and pavements.

My friends and I used our airguns for more innocent purposes such as target practice on empty bottles or tin cans. One of these purposes or uses of the .177 could, I suppose, be deemed less innocent: in our predominantly Parsi neighbourhood in Pune, there was, at the end of a branching-

out street, a red-brick synagogue with a tower. A very nasty old denizen of our street lived next to my granddad and aunts' house where I and my sister stayed in school termtime. This character's backyard adjoined ours. In it he had a large mango tree whose fruit he sold as it ripened to harvesters, who came each season, climbed the tree, picked the fruit and carried it away in sacks

In one of these scandal sheets, he had written an attack on my elder sister, saying that she was seen regularly cycling in the company of non-Parsi boys from her college. The piece was not just disapproving, it implied that she was having forbidden liaisons with these friends.

My aunts were furious. Everyone knew who wrote and published the Synagogue Searchlight. My aunts couldn't retaliate. My friends and I could.

As the mangoes on his tree grew to near-harvesting size, we took turns in the quiet of the morning, before the neighbours were awake, to use them as targets so the slug "bullets" would penetrate their flesh and cause them to rot with lead poisoning. Monsoon slows down in Himachal, 40% less rain than normal
