The Supreme Court on Thursday ruled by a majority judgement of 6:1 that sub-classification within the scheduled caste and scheduled tribes (SC/STs) reservation is permissible.

A 7-judge bench led by Chief Justice of India DY Chandrachud overruled the earlier judgement by a five-judge bench in the EV Chinnaiah matter, which had held that sub-classification was not permissible because SC/STs form homogenous classes.

Besides CJI Chandrachud, other judges on the bench were Justices BR

Gavai, Vikram Nath, Bela M Trivedi, Pankaj Mithal, Manoj Misra. and Satish Chandra Sharma. Justice Bela M Trivedi, in a dissenting opinion, said that she disagreed with the majority judgement.

The Seven Judge Constitution Bench was dealing with issues relating to the sub-classification of reserved communities like SCs and STs.

CJI Chandrachud, while overruling judgement on Chinnaiah that held subclassification of the scheduled classes is impermissible, said that even at the lowest levels, the struggles with the class do not disap-



pear with their representation.

Justice BR Gavai said there are categories within the SC/STs that have faced oppression for centuries and opined that the state must evolve

Hry launches Surcharge Waiver Scheme to settle outstanding electricity bills

BUREAU CHANDIGARH, AUG 1

Haryana Government has introduced the Surcharge Waiver Scheme-2024 to help settle outstanding electricity bills for domestic consumers. This scheme is available to both urban and rural domestic consumers whose electricity bills were due till December 31, 2023 and remain unpaid. It applies to both connected and disconnected domestic consumers.

While giving this information here toady, Dr. Saket Kumar, Managing Director of Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam said that under the Sur-charge Waiver Scheme-2024, the entire surcharge till date on urban and rural domestic electricity connections will be frozen. Consumers will only need to pay the principal amount. Payments can be made either as a lump sum or in installments over the next three monthly or bi-monthly

bills. Those opting for a lump sum payment will receive an additional 5 percent discount on the principal amount. He informed that the frozen surcharge will be waived in proportion to the regular payment of the prescribed installments and the next 3 monthly/ bi-monthly bills. If the consumer does not pay the prescribed installments and the next3 monthly/bi-monthly bills continuously, then the frozen surcharge will be added back.

Monsoon : One-fourth of India still faces rain deficit

While floods in Assam and heavy rainfall-induced landslides in Kerala have drawn global attention, 25 per cent of the 36 meteorological subdivisions in India are still reeling from a rainfall deficit halfway through the monsoon season.

According to India Meteorological Department (IMD) data, the country experienced nine per cent more rainfall than normal in July (306.6 mm compared to the normal of 280.5 mm) with a cumulative precip itation of 453.8 mm against the normal of 445.8 mm since June 1, a surplus of two per cent.



However, the rainfall in July was unevenly distributed, both spatially and temporally. East Uttar Pradesh, Bihar,

Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, and parts of the northeast have recorded significant rainfall deficits. The rainfall deficit in Haryana,

Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu and Kashmir ranged from 35 per cent to 45 per cent.

The rainfall deficit in East and Northeast India increased from 13.3 per cent on June 30 to 19 per cent on July 31, with the region recording 610.2 mm of rainfall against the normal of 752.5 mm so far this monsoon season.

Northwest India recorded 182.4 mm of rainfall in July, compared to the normal of 209.7 mm, a deficit of 13 per cent. The region has received 235 mm of rainfall so far this monsoon season, against the normal of 287.8 mm, a shortfall of 18 per cent.

Central India received 33 per cent more rainfall than normal in

July, with 427.2 mm of precipitation compared to the normal of 321.3 mm. Overall, the region has recorded 574.2 mm of rainfall so far this monsoon season, against the normal of 491.6 mm.

The southern peninsula received 36 per cent more rainfall in July, with 279.2 mm compared to the normal of 204.5 mm. Overall. it has recorded 463.1 mm of rainfall so far this monsoon season, against the normal of 365.5 mm, an excess of 27 per cent.

According to IMD data, the rain-fall deficit in Gangetic West Bengal stands at 40 per cent, with all 15 districts recording below-normal precipitation.

BUREAU CHANDIGARH: The Department of Surgical Oncology, Fortis Cancer Fortis Hospital Mohali, Institute at Fortis Hospital Mohali, has achieved yet another medical feat by successfully treating a 42-year-old woman suffering from low-lying rectal cancer via Robot-aided Sphincter-saving Surgery, which lasted for six hours. The case attains



significance as the Patient was spared a permanent Stoma Bag a plastic bag that collects bowel movement from the digestive tract through an opening in the abdominal wall usually required after surgery of the large and small intestine. The Stoma Bag is either temporary or permanent (if the cancer has affected the sphincter muscle, which controls defecation). The Patient had been experiencing bleeding from the rectum, changes in bowel habit and loss of appetite following which, she approached Dr Jitender Rohila, Consultant, Surgical Oncology and Robotic Surgeon, Fortis Hospital Mohali. Subsequent medical investigations such as Sigmoidoscopy, MRI scan and PET scan revealed that the Patient had Stage 3 low-lying rectal cancer. The biopsy was adenocarcinoma. Initially, the Patient was administered combined radiation therapy and chemotherapy (NACTRT) to shrink the tumour and prepare her for a sphincter-saving surgery. She was reassessed after an MRI scan and a surgery was planned six weeks after the completion of NACTRT.

Skyfall

A combination of factors — natural and man-made — has forced Kerala to confront its worst disaster af-ter the floods of 2018. Over 150 people have lost their lives in deadly landslides in Kerala's Wayanad district with the settlements of Mundakkai and Chooralmala being the worst affected. The death toll has been heavy because the landslides — they came in sharp bursts — struck in the wee hours. The number of casualties, despite the ongoing rescue operations, may rise further. Nearly all 14 of Kerala's districts are vulnerable to landslides. But what exacerbated the scale of the disaster on this occasion was that the landslides coincided with heavy rainfall: Wayanad received over 140 mm of rain around five times its usual volume — between the mornings of Monday and Tuesday. That climate change-induced precipitation can combine with other phenomena to enhance the lethality of natural disasters has been proved, once again.

But, as is often the case, the human hand in the tragedy must not go unnoticed. The Union home minister has alleged that the state government had been warned of an impending disaster in advance. The truth of the matter must be looked into. What remains undeniable though is that the authorities concerned, whether in the state or at the Centre, had turned a blind eve to the growing list of risks over the years. The Western Ghats Ecology Expert Panel had recommended way back in 2011 that 75% of the Western Ghats — they span across six states, including Kerala — be declared an environmentally sensitive zone. Nothing came of it. A report by Kerala's State Disaster Management Authority arguing in favour of relocating families from Wayanad's vulnerable areas was not acted upon either.

Instead, Wayanad witnessed unplanned development, the felling of forests, expanding agriculture and an explosion in unregulated tourism. What is of particular concern is that the hazardous event could not be prevented even with the existence of automated weather stations and a landslide and flood vulnerability map. This points to the distance that predictive technology has to traverse. Investments must be made at the earliest to put up localised early warning systems as well as maps capable of identifying the likely route of the flow of debris, both of which could have minimised the number of deaths. What must also be prevented is the politicisation of the tragedy. Preparations to avert such events in the future should be accorded greater priority than the settling of petty political scores.

Anshuman Gaekwad: Gentle **Giant of Indian Cricket**

n a somber moment for the cricketing world, former Indian cricketer and coach Anshuman Gaekwad passed away on Wednesday at the age of 71, following a prolonged battle with cancer. The news has left fans and the cricket fraternity mourning the loss of a stalwart who made significant contributions both on and off the field.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi expressed his condolences, describing Gaekwad as a "gifted player" and "outstanding coach." His calm and composed approach as a coach helped nurture a new generation of Indian cricketers.

Tension in Gwadar persist as Pak army refused release of peaceful Baloch protesters

Pensions in the Port City of Gwadar persist as the Pakistani defence forces have not released the previously arrested senior leaders of the Baloch Yakjehti Committee (BYC) amid the Baloch Raaji Muchi protests.

According to the latest statement by the BYC on X, one of the arrested leaders Sabiha Baloch was released on Tuesday late at night after increasing dissent from the protestors, however, the whereabouts of two other Baloch activists Sammi Deen Baloch and Sabgath Ullah Baloch remain unknown.

According to that statement on, X, 'Finally, we make it clear to the state and all its institutions to immediately release all the arrested colleagues including our leadership without any ifs and buts, restore internet and mobile network throughout Makran including Gwadar and in all areas of Balochistan. The statement further mentioned that "If the state and its institutions still do not change their terrorist and oppressive behaviour, then

from today we will shut down the entire Balochistan including Quetta for an indefinite period and if any untoward incident occurs during this period, then all the responsibility will be on the state and It will be imposed on its institutions. Through this press conference, we inform BYC workers and Baloch people across Balochistan that peaceful and orderly dharna, protest rallies and wheel jam and shutterdown strikes should be held across Balochistan". Responding to the same situation in Balochistan, a prominent Pakistani journalist, Hamid Mir had previously raised his concerns, while warning that arrests of Baloch leaders and protestors will not yield any positive results. In a post on X the journalist said,

"Sammi and Sabiha have always
