No doctor to give him CPR, elderly dies at Jammu hospital

BANIHAL/JAMMU: A 71-year-old man died on Wednesday allegedly because there was no one to give him CPR at a hospital in Ramban district, an official said. Ghulam Nabi Bhat, who was suffering from Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease, was rushed to Sub-District Hospital in Banihal by his son Altaf Ahmad, but he was forced to perform Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) on him because there was no doctor or paramedical staff available at the moment. A video of the son trying to revive his father on a hospital bed has gone viral since.

151 sitting MPs and MLAs face cases of crimes against women

NEW DELHI: As many as 151 sitting MPs and MLAs have declared cases related to crimes against women in their election affidavits, with West Bengal having the highest number of lawmakers facing such cases, according to a recent report by a poll rights body. For the report, the Association for Democratic Reforms examined 4,693 out of 4,809 affidavits of sitting MPs and MLAs submitted to the Election Commission of India during elections between 2019 and 2024. The organisation identified 16 MPs and 135 MLAs facing cases related to crimes against women. West Bengal tops the list with 25 sitting MPs and MLAs facing charges related to crimes against women, followed by Andhra Pradesh with 21 and Odisha with 17, according to the report that comes amid the nationwide protests over the alleged rape and murder of a trainee doctor in a state-run hospital in Kolkata.

Man kills mother after argument in UP's Shamli

MUZAFFARNAGAR (UP): A 60-year-old woman was on Wednesday killed by her son in Shamli district over a dispute, police said. Shajoo was attacked by Shoban, 26, with a spade and died on the spot. The accused has been arrested, police said. According to police, the duo had a heated argument over a petty issue in their house in Chosana town in the Jhinhana area of Shamli.

Bharat Bandh: Mixed response in Bihar, Jharkhand; No impact in Haryana and Punjab

AGENCY PATNA, AUG 21

A nationwide strike, known as "Bharat Bandh," was observed across the country in response to a recent Supreme Court ruling on SC/ST reservations.

The Patna Police baton charged the people protesting in support of a day-long 'Bharat Bandh' on Wednesday against the SC's recent judgement.

An atmosphere similar to lockdown is also being seen in Rajasthan's Bikaner district. Meanwhile, Bandh failed to get response in Haryana and Chandigarh. As per reports, no impact of Bharat Bandh was seen in Jind, Rewari, Ambala, Sirsa, Rohtak, Kathal, Panipat, Kurukshetra, Karnal, and UT Chandigarh. The markets were open, and vehicles were playing on roads as usual. Educational institutions, government offices, banks, and petrol pumps were working as usual. There was no impact on essential services such as medical care, drinking water, public transport, rail services, etc. The state government made adequate security arrangements to maintain law and order in view of the Bharat Bandh call. Similarly in Punjab also no impact of Bandh was seen in most of places.

The police administration was also keeping a close watch on the area with full alertness so that no unusual incident takes place.

The impact of the bandh was seen in Jharkhand's capital city, Ranchi. The roads of Harmu Chowk, Kathal Mode, and Chapu Toli Chowk, have been completely blocked. The bandh supporters



were protesting by burning tyres on the road.

The police were also on alert in Uttar Pradesh's Noida where forces were deployed in large numbers. The Joint Commissioner of Police of Noida, Shiv Hari Meena, said that the Police are conducting foot marches to ensure law and order is not disturbed.

"We are also taking care that the general public does not face any kind of problem. The police team is keeping an eye on the people creating anarchists," he added.

Meanwhile, Union Minister Jayant Singh Chaudhary said, "The Supreme Court had commented, after which the Law Minister also clarified it in Parliament. The Cabinet has also clarified its opinion, so now there is nothing left."

The apex court in a landmark ruling on August 1, ruled that states have the power to sub-classify SCs and STs and said that the authority concerned, while deciding if the class is adequately represented, must calculate adequacy based on effective and not quantitative representation.

The Supreme Court ruled by a majority judgement of 6:1, that sub-classification within the SCs and STs reservation is permissible. As many as six separate opinions were delivered in the case.

The judgement was delivered by the seven-judge bench led by Chief Justice of India DY Chandrachud, which overruled earlier judgement in the EV Chinnaiah matter, which had held that sub-classification was not permissible because SC/STs form homogenous classes.

Central Force takes over security at Kolkata Hospital

Top officers of Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), which guards airports and Parliament, reached Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College and Hospital this morning for a recce. The paramilitary force has been tasked with taking over security arrangements at the state-run hospital after a shocking incident of vandalism in the aftermath of a 31-year-old doctor's rape and murder that has shaken the nation.

Senior CISF officer K Pratap Singh, who visited the hospital this morning, told the media, "Let us do our job. We have come here for some assignment. Let us finish our work, then senior officers will brief you. I am doing my job mandated by higher authorities."

The central force's recce comes after the Supreme Court yesterday questioned the city police's response when a mob stormed the hospital in the early hours of August 15 and damaged medical equipment and supplies on two floors. The mob violence took place during a 'reclaim the night' protest in Kolkata and several other cities to seek justice for the doctor.

"We are unable to comprehend how the State was not prepared to deal with the incident of vandalization of the premises of the hospital," the

Supreme Court said yesterday.

The court noted that a majority of doctors of the hospital have left the campus after the August 15 mob violence. It is necessary to create a safe environment so that doctors can return and treat patients. Solicitor General Tushar Mehta then assured the court that central forces will guard the premises. Senior Advocate Ka-

fused to answer questions from the media.

Over the past five days, Sandip Ghosh has been questioned for a total of 64 hours, according to CBI officials.

Separately, the Bengal government has formed a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to probe allegations of financial irregularities during Sandip Ghosh's tenure as principal of the state-run institution.



pil Sibal, appearing for West Bengal government, said he has no objection.

At the hospital, a huge protest is on to demand justice for the victim of the horrifying rape-murder.

Sandip Ghosh, former principal of RG Kar Medical College, reached the CBI's office in Kolkata this morning for the sixth round of questioning in connection with the investigation into the heinous crime. Mr Ghosh, whose handling of the situation after the doctor's body was found at a seminar hall on August 9 has come under the scanner, re-

pal of the state-run institution.

Left red-faced after the top court's remarks on police response during the mob attack, the Bengal government has now suspended three officers in connection with the incident of vandalism. The suspended cops include two Assistant Police Commissioners, sources have told news agency a news agency. "Three officers have been suspended... Two are Assistant Police Commissioners and one is an inspector," an official said, adding that further investigation into the matter is underway.

EC halts result announcements of recruitments till completion of Haryana Assembly polls

The Election Commission of India (ECI) on Wednesday stopped the result announcements of the ongoing recruitment process in Haryana until the completion of assembly elections in the state.

The elections to the 90 assembly constituencies in Haryana will be held in a single phase on October 1 and the counting of votes will take place on October 4.

The Commission took cognizance of the complaint received from Congress leader Jai Ram Ramesh, regarding violation of the Model Code of Conduct in the process of recruitment against 5600 vacancies for the post of Constable in the Haryana Police, 76 posts of TGT and PTI by Haryana Staff Selection Commission (HSSC) and recruitment for various posts by Haryana Public Service Commission (HPSC).

The Commission sought a detailed report from the State Government and found that 600 posts of Female Constables (General duty) and 4000 posts of Male Constables (General Duty) were requisitioned/ uploaded on the HSSC

portal by DGP Haryana on 03.07.2024 and 1000 posts of Male Constable (IRB) were requisitioned/ uploaded on the HSSC portal on July 9, 2024.

"The advertisement regarding 5600 posts of police constable and 76 posts of TGT



and a news agency were published on the website of HSSC at 01:45 pm on 16.08.2024. The recruitment relates to regular appointments and there was no separate announcement in this regard and only advertisement was issued on 16.08.2024 at 01:45 PM on HSSC website, for the posts already referred to HSSC by the sponsoring authority i.e. DGP, State of Haryana," the Commission stated.

It further stated that with respect to the recruitment for the 38 posts by HPSC, the recruitment was already under process before August 16, 2024.

Kiran Choudhry files nomination for RS seat from Haryana

BUREAU CHANDIGARH, AUG 21

BJP leader Kiran Choudhry on Wednesday filed her nomination as the party candidate for the Rajya Sabha bypoll from Haryana.

Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini and several BJP MLAs were present when Choudhry submitted her nomination papers in the Legislative Assembly complex.

The BJP named Choudhry as its nominee for the bypoll shortly after she resigned from the Vidhan Sabha on Tuesday, nearly two months after she switched from the Congress.

Given the BJP's numbers in the assembly, it is set to win the seat.

The bypoll for the lone Rajya Sabha seat in Haryana was necessitat-



ed after Congress leader Deepender Singh Hooda was elected to the Lok Sabha from Rohtak.

A former Haryana minister, Choudhry, 69, joined the BJP along with her daughter Shruti and their

supporters in June. She represented Tosham constituency in the assembly.

Elections to the 12 vacant Rajya Sabha seats in nine states will be held on September 3.

Wednesday is the last day for fil-

ing nominations for the seat.

The scrutiny of nomination papers will take place on August 22 while candidates can withdraw their nominations until August 27.

If necessary, voting will be held on September 3 at the Haryana Vidhan Sabha Secretariat from 9 am to 4 pm.

After Choudhry's resignation as MLA, the BJP has 41 members in the 90-member assembly, the Congress 28 and the JJP 10. There are five Independents in the assembly, the INLD and the Haryana Lokhit Party (HLP) have one member each and four seats are vacant.

The BJP also enjoys the support of Independent MLA Nayan Pal Rawat and HLP MLA Gopal Kanda. Three Independents support the Congress.

AAP to contest assembly election in J&K

Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) on Wednesday announced that it will contest the next month assembly election in Jammu and Kashmir with "full strength".

AAP leader Imran Hussain said the people of Jammu and Kashmir have been exploited by the leaders for their own political gains and on religious issues and AAP is the lone party in the country which is delivering for the common man.

"It is big news for the people that AAP is going to contest the assembly election in Jammu and Kashmir", Hussain told media persons in Srinagar today.

Indian astronaut to fly to International Space Station by April 2025

An Indian astronaut will fly to the International Space Station by April next year as part of the NASA-ISRO collaborative initiative, Science and Technology Minister Jitendra Singh said today.

Two Indian astronaut-designates Group Captains Shubhanshu Shukla and Prashanth Balakrishnan Nair are undergoing training in the US for the Axiom Space Ax-4 mission. ISRO has assigned Shukla for the Ax-4 mission while Nair would be the backup candidate.

"An Indian astronaut will

travel to the ISS by April next year," Mr Singh told a press conference in New Delhi ahead of the first-ever National Space Day celebrations to mark the landing of Vikram lander on the Moon on August 23 last year.

The theme for the National Space Day is 'Touching Lives while Touching the Moon: India's Space Saga'. On the occasion, ISRO will release on August 23 the scientific data collected by the Chandrayaan-3 mission that could be used by researchers. More than one thousand events have been organised across the country over the last two months.

72% employers intend to hire freshers in 2024: Report

A new report reveals that 72 per cent of employers across India intend to hire freshers in the latter half of 2024. This upward trend in hiring intent is based on a comprehensive survey of over 603 companies nationwide, reflecting a 4 per cent increase from the previous half-year and a notable 7 per cent rise compared to the same period in 2023, a report by TeamLease EdTech said.

"The increase in hiring intent for freshers is an encouraging sign. It reflects growing confidence among employers and pres-



ents valuable opportunities for fresh talent entering the workforce," Shantanu Rojo, Founder and CEO of TeamLease EdTech,

said.

India's unemployment rate has declined to 3.1 per cent as per the latest National Statistical Of-

fice (NSO) data, though challenges persist for graduates and freshers seeking employment.

The report says that industries such as e-commerce, tech startups, engineering, infrastructure, and retail are leading the charge in fresher hiring. Bengaluru tops the list, with 74 per cent of employers indicating plans to bring on new graduates, followed by Mumbai at 60 per cent and Chennai at 54 per cent.

In terms of specific roles, the demand for Full Stack Developers, SEO Executives, Digital Sales Associates, and UI/UX Designers remains high. According to the report, employers are increasing-

ly seeking candidates with specialized skills in cybersecurity, cloud computing, data analytics, and search engine optimization.

"The need of the hour is to constantly learn, not just for freshers but also for managers and employees as workplaces undergo transformation," Mr Rojo said.

To address the skills gap, 70 per cent of employers surveyed recommended enhancing academic curricula with experiential learning, while 62 per cent advocated for stronger partnerships between industry and academia.

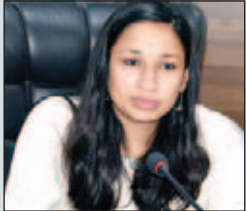

AAP on UPSC lateral entry: BJP aims to abolish Baba Saheb's constitution and reservation

ments to more than 63 IAS-level posts through lateral entry, bypassing reservation rules. The government intended to make 45 more appointments in the same manner but had to cancel it under pressure. Earlier, the central government abolished reservation for many posts, such as sweepers and persons working in government departments through outsourcing. Additionally, reservation has been removed from numerous outsourced recruit-

Govt mulls providing Rs 1500 financial aid, free transportation for people living with HIV

Coming out with a plan to provide much needed hand-holding to the children infected and affected by HIV in the state, Chief Minister S. Bhagwant Singh Mann led Punjab Government is all set to implement a major initiative to grant a monthly financial assistance of Rs. 1500 aid to children of HIV infected parents.

This was disclosed by Punjab Health and Family Welfare Minister Dr. Balbir Singh, while chairing the 1st meeting of the State Council on AIDS at Prayas Bhawan here, on Wednesday.

Dr. Balbir Singh shared that the State Council put forth a proposal to offer free transportation service for infected patients from their homes to the treatment facility—Anti-Retroviral Therapy Centre once a month.

Additionally, they have planned to establish a task force to develop tailored programs for individuals living with HIV, aiming to enhance their employability and enable them to lead a dignified life. He further added that the



meeting agreed to authorise the acceptance of documents verified by the Medical Officer of the Anti-Retroviral Therapy Centre (ART Centre) for various social welfare schemes implemented by different departments. This decision aims to ensure that individuals affected by HIV do not encounter obstacles or discrimination when accessing the benefits of these welfare programs.

Dr. Balbir Singh directed the Industry and Labour departments to ask Industry establishments to implement the HIV/AIDS Policy, besides designating a complaint officer to address issues of stigma and discrimination in all industries with 100 or more employees. Additionally, all industries were urged to incorporate HIV prevention and welfare concerns for individ-

uals living with HIV into their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives.

While asking to organise HIV testing camps in the state, the Health Minister also directed the officials concerned to launch a mass-level Information, Education and Communication (IEC) drive across the state to raise awareness about the disease. He emphasised that people should be sensitised about prevention, care and support programmes. The Health Minister categorically said that people living with HIV have the right to live a normal life and it's crucial for everyone to understand that HIV doesn't spread through touching, air or water. Transmission occurs through unprotected sex, sharing needles, syringes or other injecting equipment.

stating that out of every Rs. 100 spent by the present government in this fiscal year, Rs. 25 is allocated to salaries, Rs. 17 to pensions, Rs. 11 to interest payments, Rs. 9 to debt repayment, Rs. 10 to grants for autonomous institutions and the remaining Rs. 28 to capital expenditures and other activities. He also

noted a reduction in the revenue deficit grant for Himachal Pradesh, which has decreased from Rs. 10,000 crore in 2021-22 to Rs 3,000 crore by 2025-26. Despite this, the government's vision is to make the state self-reliant through systemic changes. "I will not allow the government treasury to be

misused for political gains, asserted the Chief Minister". He emphasized that subsidies on electricity and water would be rationalized to ensure that only the needy gets desirable benefits. He highlighted the positive impact of these measures on the state's economy, which has improved by twenty percent in the past year, along with an increase in GST collection.

Thakur Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu further addressed the financial challenges inherited from the previous BJP government, including a debt of Rs. 75,000 crore and outstanding liabilities of Rs. 10,000 crore. Despite these challenges, the current government has provided a seven percent dearness allowance (DA) to employees and plans to pay arrears to 28,000 pensioners over the age of 75 this year.

Rajendra Rana criticizes Sukhu Govt for insensitivity, predicts its downfall

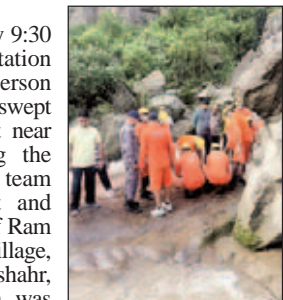

He said that if the sheller owners do not store the paddy in their cellars, then the paddy of the farmers of Punjab will not be sold in the markets, due to which the agriculture of Punjab will face a big blow. He said that the Punjab government should contact the central government and hold the hand of the millers so that the miller owners should be given 1% instead of dry 1/2% in the last 23-24 season. RK blading should be given 6 rupees per quintal. Such bad behavior of the sheller industry by the government. It is necessary to join hands in time



so that the sheller industry of Punjab can be saved. He demanded that in the upcoming season of 2024-25, the central government should reduce the rice yield by 1%, reduce the yield of rice to 62 kg instead of 67 kg, give special relief to the solar industry in electricity rates and mealings. Increase in the rate of 50 rupees but along with quintaling, the levy security of 11 lakhs will be returned soon. He said that the state government should arrange the space for planting rice in the godowns of Punjab by contacting the center. He said that if the Punjab government does not intervene in this matter while there is time and does not resolve the issue, then in the upcoming paddy season, the Punjab government will have to bear a huge loss.

Viable shelters

While growing up, I clearly remember five distinct seasons. Each season had its specific spans marked by seasonal activities, flowers, vegetables and fruits. These days appear to be different. Now, it's mostly summer with a few months of rain, winter, and then summer again. This year, summer announced itself with unbearably hot days and nights that didn't cool down. The question, therefore, is how to mitigate such extreme weather conditions. The Middle East, which has survived harsh weather, has adapted to its harsh environment with advancements in construction technology. Buildings of all types are governed by strict by-laws regulating thermal insulation requirements of walls, roofs and façades. There are defined 'u-value' (thermal transmittance) requirements that can only be achieved through the insulation of buildings.

We can look back to our past for such materials and construction techniques. What we will find is that we always knew how to insulate our huts, bungalows, and buildings but traded this knowledge for rapid urbanisation. Thick stone or mud walls, cavity walls, shading pergolas and courtyards were some of the features that were staple for any construction before we moved on to giving contractors a free rein to build 'matchboxes'. Construction technology has evolved over the years, allowing large spans with flat slabs or post-tension slabs, or steel structures with extensive Manhattan-like glass facades, but the insulation of buildings has largely been limited to large buildings complying with sustainability certifications like LEED or GRIHA. This may have addressed the need for urbanisation in response to ever-increasing urban migration but it has left us unprepared for the present and the future.

In this context of insulating buildings or passive thermal protection, it is worth noting the five principles of Passivhaus (a leading international design standard on sustainability and comfort) — super-insulated envelopes, airtight construction, high-performance glazing, thermal-bridge-free detailing to prevent heat transfer, and heat-recovery ventilation. Passive thermal protection of buildings can be achieved through insulation materials on the building envelope. For example, extruded polystyrene, expanded polystyrene or rockwool on walls and roofs, pre-insulated blockwork with EPS, aerated concrete blockwork, pre-insulated corrugated roofing, double-glazed unit curtain wall and windows and so on complying with defined u-value requirements of thermal protection with membrane or liquid applied waterproofing are part of construction of any kind in the Middle East.

Gaijatra festival in Nepal

People in Nepal on Tuesday marked festival of Gaijatra, commemorating beloved ones whom they lost within a year converging parades of cow and the sexual minorities. The Kathmandu Durbar Square, a UNESCO World Heritage site saw the parade of people disguised as cow accepting alms and donations following beliefs that it would give salvation to the departed souls of their loved ones.

The brief pilgrimage brought thousands of people dressed as cow and lunatics going around city wearing odd costumes commemorating those who died within one year. The bereaved families offer fruits, bread, beaten rice, curd, and money to those participating in the procession including the cows.

"We have been celebrating Gaijatra as inheritance from our ancestors, we take part in the Gaijatra commemorating our beloved ones who passed away. This would give salvation to the souls of our ancestors, we parade around the city disguising as a cow," Bishow Bijayraj Joshi told ANI.

This festival of cows commonly called "Gai Jatra" or the "Cow Festival" falls on first day of the waning moon in the month of Bhadra (Bhadra Sukla Pratipada) fifth month of the Lunar calendar. It is mostly observed by Newari and Tharu communities of Nepal.

Coinciding with the festival, the sexual minorities of the Himalayan Nation also took an annual pride parade. Hundreds of sexual minorities or the members of LGBTQI+ community paraded through the alleyways of Kathmandu in



commemoration of their deceased colleagues in past one year.

Speaking to ANI, Preti Petter, program coordinator at the Blue Diamond Society, an umbrella organization of Nepali sexual minorities said, "This is the 21st Pride Parade in Gaijatra. It has been 21 years that we have been celebrating this because everybody we exist in the society, we want to show all the world that Nepali queer community exists in the society with huge respect and in this 21st Gaijatra Pride Parade we came from all over the country to celebrate our dignity, identity, respect and unique identity in the society."

"In addition, this year as well many of the lives passed away from our community. We really want to remember them and really like to support their

identity and dignity in this parade," Petter added.

The 21st series of the Gaijatra Pride parade started from touristic Thamel area which marched through inner alleyways of Kathmandu and reached the Kathmandu Durbar Square. Hundreds of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer and Intersex (LGBTQI+) persons took part in the procession with excitement and cheers. Having one of progressive constitution to grant right and recognition to sexual minorities, Nepal from last census of 2021 has started collecting the data of LGBTQI+ as well. As per the latest census of 2021 there are a total of 2, 928 people who identified themselves as "others" in terms of gender or sexual orientation. The census of 2021 also set the mark as the first census of

the nation to start recording the population of sexual minorities.

As per the organisers, the parades as such are held on Cow festival to respect and commemorate the LGBTI loved ones, and occupies public space in a way that speaks to Nepali traditions as well as to raise their voice for their rights.

The prevalent folklore also states that taking out a parade on Gaijatra will take the soul of the deceased to the heaven. Following the folklore, people have been parading round the city disguising themselves as cow or other dressings.

According to the beliefs, the festival derives its name from the religious belief that the deceased, during their journey to heaven, crosses a legendary river by grabbing the tail of a cow.

The tails of cows demonstrated on Tuesday have been also credited for helping the deceased one to get across Baitarni, a legendary river to get into heaven. The persons who are demonstrated with attire of cow also have an artificial tail which has the same propose.

The Garuda Purana, one of the scriptures mentions that on the 11th day of death rites, people have to perform "Brishotsarga"- release an ox/bull, with a belief that it would give peace to the deceased soul. As it would be costlier, some historians claim Gai Jatra is celebrated as an alternative to it on the day of Bhadra Krishna Pratipada and has since been celebrated. While some of manuscript mentions that the festival started as 'saa yaa(t)' or 'gai yatra' meaning 'journey of the cow' during the time of Jayasthiti Malla, around 600 years ago.

Obese children more likely to develop immune-related diseases: Study

Immune-mediated Skin Disorders (IMSDs) like psoriasis, atopic dermatitis and alopecia areata might all be influenced by childhood obesity, according to research on Wednesday.

Keeping a healthy weight may help reduce the likelihood of certain skin diseases occurring, said the research that analysed 21,61,900 Korean children from 2009 to 2020. The analysis aimed to determine whether obesity or dynamic changes in body weight were associated with the development of IMSDs.

Children with IMSDs and their families experience negative consequences to their quality of life, including emotional, physical, social, and functional wellness.

While several biologics have shown promise in the treatment of paediatric psoriasis and atopic dermatitis, there are still significant obstacles in the management of children with IMSDs due to a paucity of clinical trials and shortage of treatment choices. The prevalence of childhood obesity has increased significantly



cantly in recent years, making it an unquestionable public health emergency that has been made worse by the pandemic's effects and countrywide lockdowns.

Uncertainty surrounds the exact mechanisms by which obesity contributes to the development of chronic inflammatory skin illnesses, such as psoriasis, atopic dermatitis, and skin cancers.

"Previously, many studies have looked at the link between childhood obesity and IMSDs.

in agtech. The mission will conclude in Bengaluru with participation in Agri Tech India 2024, India's largest agtech conference, the statement said.

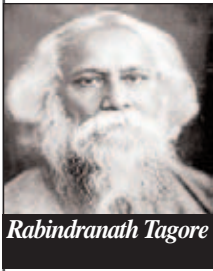

However, a minority shareholder Manu Rishi Gupta, who holds 0.002% of ICICI Securities, and Quantum Mutual Fund with a 0.08% stake, opposed the delisting separately, claiming that the swap ratio was unfavourable to minority shareholders. However, NCLT dismissed their objections and upheld the scheme which was previously approved by 93.8% shareholders of ICICI Securities.

A calm exterior can hide a turbulent mind

The silence depressed me. It wasn't the silence of silence. It was my own silence: Sylvia Plath, The Bell Jar. In her famous semi-autobiographical novel, The Bell Jar, American writer Sylvia Plath had expressed the anguish of a depressed mind as it hurtled downward with great exactitude. She described the feeling as one of being trapped inside a bell jar - a dour, claustrophobic experience that cannot be wished away. Most people who suffer from depression are said to experience the same all-encompassing entrapment. For them, it is not an existential crisis but an emotional turbulence that cannot be quietened by external stimuli. Yet, most people suffering from depression appear "normal" to other people around them, though normalcy is, by and large, a comparative state of being.

Our social conditioning and general perceptions of acceptable behaviour guide us when it comes to putting up a front in public. This is no different for a person suffering from depression. S/he will consciously try to behave as normally as possible, only because everyone is expected to be in a state of normalcy all the time and any sign of emotional instability is dubbed abnormal. The person may not even be aware of the extra effort that is going into appearing normal.

For a person with depression, behaving acceptably

is an imbibed affectation and may not always be reflective of the person's actual state of mind. A smiling, calm exterior may not be the true behavioural marker of what is going on inside, though depression does take its toll and manifests itself despite attempts by the person to deliberately control temperamental changes. Human emotions are symbiotic and we tend to pick up emotional cues from each other that can affect our mood graph for a period of time. A boss who has had a fight with his/her spouse can let off steam on team members and make them feel agitated or tremulous

for the rest of the day, and maybe for the next few days as well. The boss's spouse may have been affected by their child's incessant tantrums the previous evening. The child may have been feeling unwell or deprived or have had a bad day in school. The chain of reactive changes in moods goes around in multiple loops. As much as one happy person can improve the moods of most people around in a domino effect, the reverse is also true. It is this awareness, that our individual behaviour affects the emotional well-being of those around us, that can tether a person to

behaving in a certain way, and subsequently create perceptions of normalcy. The first and primary criterion that enables a person to realize that he/she may be suffering from depression is self-assessment of mental well-being. Others, like family members, friends and colleagues, may notice a slight shift in temperament. But as mentioned above, masking depressive phases by pretending that "all is well" is so deeply ingrained into our psyche that often a person is able to put up a front that makes it difficult for others to assess his/her true mental condition.

Along with this, keeping and carrying firearms and ammunition in the revenue limits of district Kurukshetra, even by license holders has been prohibited as there was likely to cause disturbance in the maintenance of peace and public order. It has become necessary to ban the carrying of firearms and weapons and to deposit all the firearms and ammunition in the possession of license

holders with the concerned police stations or registered arms dealers. Therefore, under Section 163 of the Indian Civil Defense Code 2023 and the Arms Act Under the 1959, orders have been issued to ban all license holders from carrying firearms and weapons. This order will not apply to authorized security guards posted in various banks/private banks those have licenses in the name of banks/authorized security guards posted in various ATMs. This will be applicable to all except the security guards deployed in the vans carrying cash for filling cash in ATMs and safe transportation in District Kurukshetra. This order will also not apply to police and other public servants deployed on duty.
